HAMID BEY THE STORY OF MY LIFE What I Learned in the Egyptian Temple



Part XII

During these 9,000 years, there have been about thirty Masters who have served as its leaders and directors. You see this means that their average span of life during all this period is about 300 years. The present Master is only about 125 years old. He has been a Temple Master only about 50 years, and his reasonable anticipation of service is a minimum of one hundred years yet to come. He is a very wise man. He had earned the grade of eleven rings when unusually young, which goes to show that he is a ripened soul who came into the world with extraordinary ability, as you Americans speak of it.

The body of each Temple Master during all these years has been preserved by a secret process, and each one stands in a niche in the Temple wall, quite lifelike. The organs of the body of each were removed when death occurred, and were petrified by a process which does not change the cell structure, nor alter the living, natural color. The organs, such as the heart, liver, stomach and lungs, have been sliced open, placed about, and made into table tops and polished so that they shine as brilliantly as highly polished marble.

The entrails of each table are marked to correspond with the markings by each statue, and our Masters instructed us concerning the structure and conditions of the organs, explaining how long each lived, relating the personal method of living, including the method of eating, the mental practices and emotional processes.

We were taught in this practical, concrete manner, how a Master, who is able to live 300 years, has changed and determined the cellular structure of his body and the degree of his vitality.

Near by, just for comparison, are the organs of an ordinary person who lived but a comparatively short time. We found the organs compact—that is, the cells were not free, the tissue was not open and the cells separated and were apart from each other. The tissue of the Master was as different from that of the ordinary, uninformed person as a shriveled arm is inferior to the cell structure of a finely developed athlete. When one has seen such concrete examples of body change because of the physical and mental habits of the builder, one sees there are large varieties of souls who inhabit the earth. One becomes convinced that the quality of the body shows the quality of the soul. And one is ever thereafter inspired so to live that if the body were to be examined after the soul has departed by one who understands, the body would speak complimentary words concerning its creator and keeper.

We found that certain types of practices produce the same results, no matter who the person might be. We found and were convinced until there is no longer any reason to doubt that these Masters have the secret of comparatively perpetual youth. True, they die when their time comes, but no doubt they are able to leave their bodies at will, just because their own Law of life demands that they go when their work is done and their life purposes accomplished. But they never die before their time from diseases which they ignorantly create in their bodies.

When I had finished this training I felt that I had a new hold on life, from all angles. My students want to know what I learned which would so dependably produce health and natural life span. In my classwork I attempt to go into detail concerning this and it seems that personal instruction and influence is necessary to get the largest and most satisfactory results.

However, there is one fundamental requirement which seems so foreign to the present Western mind that I will speak of it at least sufficiently to start my readers to questioning and thinking on this most important and necessary subject.

A Study in Energy

All our thinking is accomplished by a power known as Energy. All our body powers are expressed through energy. This energy is not wholly unlike electricity, although it is infinitely more refined. Sometimes this energy is called Magnetism, and its emanations around a person are recognized and felt, and that causes some people to be known as "Magnetic," which is used synonymously with "Attractive and charming." It is also well known that such magnetic and attractive people have an advantage over the non-magnetic, in that they wield a power over people and circumstances which is impossible for one less favored.

Energy is power and is sometimes likened to steam in a boiler. The analogy is close enough to serve our purpose for illustration. The steam, when under pressure and placed behind a piston rod, has the power to turn the wheels of commerce and develop material civilization.

This same steam might blow up the boiler, kill the engineer, and generally wreck havoc. In other words, the same steam might destroy, but can also be directed to a good and desirable purpose. Another illustration is electricity. This is rapidly becoming a servant of the race, as power to take us where we want to go, and to heat and light our homes, cook our food, wash our clothing, and generally do our bidding. And yet this same energy is used to kill our criminals, and unless it is scientifically harnessed and directed it becomes our destroyer.

Now, within the human body there is constantly being manufactured and distributed an energy which is capable of every variety of activity needed in building and repairing the body, feeding and nurturing the mind and enabling us to live lives of activity and usefulness.

This energy can be appropriated consciously by wise people, straight from the air through certain known, mathematical methods of breathing. It is allpervading and all-permeating. It is free energy, ready and waiting the command of mind to get into action. It can and will fill the body to overflowing, giving a superabundance of vitality, working power, and capacity for enjoyment. This free energy may be spoken of as the Breath of the Divine. Its abundant use is possible only for one who is wise in the mechanics of its appropriation and application. Those who know this secret are never depleted and weary in the ordinary sense of the word.

All living things and beings combine the earthly essentials with this Divine quality in such diluted quantities as they are capable of handling and personal power results in meagre quantities and qualities, even in the most depleted of the human family. This energy can be converted into sickness and death by the methods of living and the type of emotions. But it has an infinite variety of expressions possible and an unknown capacity for condensation and compensation, or pliability of performance.

This energy obeys the fundamental life. It first builds the physical vehicle, or the body organs and functions. In other words, it obeys the law of selfpreservation, which is basic. And so the human body is this energy organized, systematized, and crystallized into living matter.

Personal life obeys this law of self-preservation first, and then it next extends itself into a race law, which is race preservation. And so, this energy is drawn off from the body as a whole and converted into sex energy for the purpose of procreation.

The Coptic Cult does not recommend or demand that their students or priests live celebate lives. They marry and raise their families as do the rest of the world. In fact, they are taught that one of the duties to the race is to give bodies to others who need earth experience, and they consider it a sacrifice, a duty, and a blessing or privilege. It is first a sacrifice because in becoming a parent both the father and mother give their very life blood and most precious energy to provide a body for the offspring. They consider it both a duty and privilege because a duty is always a privilege, also, in that when one is of service to another that service builds a personal Karma which will insure a service which will sometime be received as the law of action and reaction ripens. Therefore, Coptic Priests are family men unless they wish to graduate into those levels of personal unfoldment above eight rings. Such high grade development makes such perpetual and strenuous demands upon the time, thought, aspirations, and energies of the individual that they live necessarily the most secluded and consecrated lives. This is a practice which produces most powerful personal qualities and abilities, always of a very specialized character. Only very ripened souls would wish to or be capable of undergoing the strict training necessary to make such grades of attainment.

If you see my implications, you can begin to see what terrible mistakes are being made in America today in emphasizing the sex function and thereby developing it until its power enables it to take charge of the mind and impulses, when it constantly demands expression and consumes all the energy which might be conserved and appropriated to a more desirable, more permanent, and ultimately satisfactory purpose.

Few Christians realize that the Old Testament in Oriental symbology tells the story that the sex function is the Judas of the personality since, when it demands its own expression, it robs the entire being. Few realize that in it is symbolized the "Rejected stone, which is yet to be the keystone of the arch, or the cornerstone of the building." Few realize that this sex energy is the most high powered energy which the body is capable of making, and that it is infinitely convertible and applicable. And only those who are Wise in this subject know how the race today is reducing body, mind, and impulses into inferiority and slavery to sex demands, nor how vital and free one can be who conquers the traitor and harnesses his energies.

It is useless to make demands upon anyone. The ordinary religious training, or attempted influence to make demands, "Thou shalt not," does not raise any individual to a very high standard of perfection. It is only when an individual is taught why and how and encouraged by explaining how much more desirable is the ultimate end or result of one kind of living as compared with one inferior in its consequences that earnest effort will be made to improve. Such instruction should belong to the church and all people, young and old, should be trained much more carefully in this than in adding a column of figures.

The Master Temple has had three women as its directors during its 9,000 years' history. These women were Masters in the same way as their brothers. The present cycle of unfoldment does not inspire women to wish to become such Masters. They are trained in exactly the same way as the men. They

THE TRUTH ABOUT ASTROLOGY

IVING in such an awe-inspiring Universe, man, with his limited knowledge, is possessed by fear and reverence for the Great Unknown. In the presence of the phenomena of Nature, he is mystified by the workings of her unseen forces. Not being able to understand or to control the forces of Nature, in his weakness and ignorance, man becomes their plaything.

This is the inevitable result of conditions at this stage of development in his Cosmic evolution. If he knew the approaching dangers or the beneficient extents, it is evident that he would prepare himself accordingly to meet these new conditions and to use them to his advantage.

This situation created in him the first desire to apprehend the future and to want to know beforehand, if possible, what was going to happen to him.

Origin of the Oracles and of Astrology

This primitive inner desire and necessity of man caused the establishment and the operation of the Oracles and of the "Manteia" of antiquity in all lands and in all civilizations, in all periods of time.

One of the most important ways and the most reliable means of divination then was astrology, as it continues to be today. The vast field of its scope, the variety of Cosmic forces, the influences of heavenly bodies involved and the immense diversity of planetary positions throughout the year, which must be taken into consideration, make astrology one of the deepest and one of the most difficult sciences to be mastered by man. In ancient times astrology was considered the basic science of all knowledge. In the courts of the kings and emperors astrologers occupied the most distinguished place among the counselors of the ruler.

Materialistic Science versus Astrology

Unfortunately in our day with the development of the materialistic sciences and with the advancement of astronomy (through the perfection of the telescope) astrology has not only been placed in the background but has been discarded from the roster of sciences and is even regarded with disrepute. Astrologers are labeled as charlatans and as ignorant persons "who still hold to ancient superstitions."

Let us see if there is any truth in this opinion and in this labeling of astrology and of astrologers as such by our so-called intellectuals.

Today with the marked advancement in materialistic science man's consciousness has departed from the spiritual, the invisible, and the Cosmic, and has been focused on the material, the visible and the limited. This is the inevitable result of individual mental pride for our mental progress against individual humility for our spiritual limitation. For this reason the fulfillment of all prophecies concerning past events is being characterized as mere coincidence. Prophecies and predictions of things and of events concerning the future are just nonsense and charlatanism. Is this true?

The Oneness of All Things

Our Universe is based upon and is formed of a twofold reality—intelligent Cosmic Life force, Spirit; and living Cosmic Matter, the material Universe. Everything in the Cosmos is composed of these two principles. This truth leads us to the conclusion that the sun, the moon, the planets, and the rest of the celestial bodies are composed of these same two principles, Spirit and Matter, of which all things, beings, and man are also composed.

The great difference and the immense variety observed in all things and in all beings lies in the different arrangement and in the countless combinations of atoms, of the degree of evolution of matter and of the degree of development of the group or of the individual consciousness of the spiritual entity that manifests in all things, in animals, and in man.

This Oneness of origin of all things brings us to the realization of a Cosmic relationship and of a mutual influence among similar material substance, which manifests in attractive qualities among them or in repulsive qualities among dissimilar material substances.

Force always manifests through matter. This is the Law. A force directed upon objects of a similar substance will always manifest in the same way with variations according to the individual characteristics of those objects.

For instance, if we place a magnet on a table around which are iron filings of different size and of different purity, each iron particle will be influenced and attracted according to its individual characteristics as to size, the degree of its purity, and its distance from the magnet.

For the same reason and by the working of the same law, if the note C is played on a piano all musical instruments in the room tuned to this note C will be influenced by the sound vibration and they will all vibrate accordingly. This mutual phenomenon is based upon the law of Vibration which rules supreme throughout Nature.

Interspace Radio Influence

The same principle and the same Law applies, also, in our Radio communications. Through a special broadcasting apparatus, sound is transmuted and is sent out as an electrical impulse, as an etheric vibration of a certain pitch, color, and duration. This vibration of electrical force will influence and be received by all radios tuned to the same wave length and within the proper radius from the broadcasting station. This influence of the broadcasting station will be felt and reproduced, forcing all receiving radio sets to act mechanically in unison and in accordance with the original impulse sent, in spite of their previous individual state.

Now suppose that each man on earth were equipped with the proper mechanism to receive these electrical vibrations through the ether, serving, so to speak, as a living conscious radio. In such case he would receive all the radio impulses sent out by the distant broadcasting radio station and be influenced by them.

If, for instance, the radio broadcast is our American anthem, all men within the radius of this broadcasting station would receive the tunes of this song and each one would repeat it according to his own perfection and strength of voice, by singing it. The reason this cannot be accomplished, in practice, by man today is that he has not yet developed a corresponding sense to receive such radio impulses of etheric vibrations, as he receives air vibrations of the sounds that he hears. His present faculty of hearing is the result of many millions of years of conscious development as the result of dire necessity.

If one takes into consideration that even at present the basic principle in the learning of a language is the proper training of the human ear to distinguish the vibrations of the different sounds of the words spoken (the result of many years of effort), he will realize the immense variety of forces and vibrations in Nature which play continuously through him even though he is not yet fully aware of most of them due to the coarseness of his senses and to his general undevelopment.

However, all of these unnoticed

Cosmic and planetary vibrations influence his inner nature, his feelings, his disposition, and his frame of mind in a mysterious way which he does not understand. Between man, the Microcosm, and Nature the Macrocosm, there exists a mathematical relationship and there is necessarily a continuous invisible influence between them.

Radiology versus Astrology

May we, therefore, call this mutual influence between radio broadcasting station and all radio sets tuned to the same wave length and within the proper radius, as well as the laws by which the latter are influenced by the former, RADIOLOGY.

Now if we reverse the process and in the place of the radio broadcasting station we place the sun, the moon, and the planets of our solar system with their powerful and continuously sent out Cosmic radiations of many kinds, which effect life in all of its stages of development, in all things, beings, and in man on earth, we have ASTROLOGY. Therefore, Astrology (from the Greek word astra for stars) can be defined as the science which deals with the influence of the radiations of these celectial bodies and man.

According to this syllogism, if the limited radio mechanical communication, as explained above, is true, then this unlimited Cosmic communication of celestial vibrations and astro-influences on man on earth must necessarily be true also. There is no other way of reasoning. Therefore, as radiology is a true material science, astrology is a true spiritual science. And since in radiology a long period of training is required for a man to understand the profession and to become an expert radio man, one can imagine that longer time and more intensive training are required in the deep study and mastery of the divine science of astrology in order to become a competent, reliable astrologer.

Facts versus Opinions

If the present critics of astrology, before talking against a science of which they know nothing or very little, would take the necessary time and put forth the effort to study this science, I am sure they would become the champion advocates of astrology. This transformation took place some centuries ago in the distinguished Episcopalean clergyman, the Reverend John Butler, B.D., Rector of Litchborough, who at that time felt in himself the call to exterminate the astrologers of England. In order to gain more information so as to attack astrology and its advocates more vigorously, he decided to read "moderately" on the subject. The great miracle occurred which is best expressed in his own words.

"Myself also must needs acknowledge that some years since I also was one of those enemies to this noble science, who buffeted in the dark I knew not what until soberly tempted to taste a few lines reading of this subject, although it was with a serious purpose to take up the apter occasion to throw dirt at it; yet by this means attaining to understand who it was I spoke to, it begot in me a reverence for these grey hairs, which as unjustly as ignorantly I had despised. And while I study thus I find that next unto Theology, nothing leads me more near unto this sight of God, than this sacred astrological study of the great works of Nature."

Some of the greatest minds of the world in all times and in all civilizations were astrologers, such as: Pythagoras, Plato, Ptolemy, Sir Isaac Newton, Copernious, Galileo, Kepler, Brahe, Lord Bacon, Nicholas Culpeper, Berosus, the initiated priest of the Chaldeans, the Egyptian priests Petosiris and Necepse, Orpheus, Homer, Hesiod, Aratus, Aeschylus, Horace, Virgil, Dante, Milton, Byron, Sir Walter Scott, Goethe, Schiller, William Lily, Shakespeare, Nostradamus, Hippocrates, the father of medicine, Giordano Bruno, C. Flammarion, Baron Napier, the inventor of logarithmus, Flamsteed, the first astronomer Royal and founder of Greenwich Observatory, Jacob Goehne, the Cardinal, Duc de Richelieu, Pope Sylvester, Pope John XX, John XXI, Sixtus IV, Julius II, Alexander IV, Leo X, Paul III and many other great men, ancient and modern.

Therefore, the opinion and the teachings of these master minds upon whose knowledge and wisdom our civilization and our spiritual progress are based have more weight about the science of astrology than the feeble cries of some of our modern intellectual agitators against it.

FEAR NOT

O you fear what people may think or say about you? If so, ask yourself whom you are striving to please, God or man? If you are doing that which you sincerely believe to be the will of your higher guidance, then why fear the imperfect judgment of those who may be less unfolded and less sincerely following their divine guidance than yourself.

Do you fear old age? Such fear generates the negative thought-pictures of old age and you naturally begin to react to them, whereas had you realized that old age can be mellow, gracious, wise, beloved, and beautiful, you would be reacting to those constructive thought-pictures instead of to the negative, and would forget the vears.

Also, there should be no fear of death if you remember that death is not a going out into the darkness of the unknown, alone and unprotected. It simply means leaving this physical world, which is not your home but where you have only been visiting a few short years, and returning to your real home whence you came to earth; returning right into the arms of a joyous reception committee composed of your loved ones and friends who have gone before.

Do you fear poverty? That fear naturally paralyzes the avenues of supply which would otherwise flow to you or with which you would be brought into contact. Hence fear draws poverty to you.

Neither should you fear the outcome of any project, position, responsibility or enterprise which, after earnest prayer and meditation, you are guided to undertake. For the Source which guided you to undertake it will give you the power to carry it through if you rely utterly upon that power.

Nor should you fear any temptation, test, or trial which the Great Law brings to you, for it would not come to you had you not the ability to conquer, not in your own human strength alone, but with the help of the Christ within if you will call upon and trust Him.

How can you prepare yourself and conquer fear? First, by recognizing that you are not a mere mortal or human being, but really are a glorious, immortal Spiritual Being whom nothing in this world or in the unseen worlds can harm. The most that could happen might be something that might harm your physical body or your personality if drawn to you through fear or other magnetic conditions. But nothing can harm you, the Real Self or Spiritual Being. Since the Real Self is absolutely fearless, you should strive to let It manifest more and more perfectly through your personality.

As we have said elsewhere: "This specter, Fear, while it seems a giant, is in reality but a shadow of the night. Let the candidate realize the divinity of his Real Self, that It is deathless, immortal, and cannot be harmed. Let him repeat constantly-especially before going to sleep-'I am fearless because my Real Self is divine and there is nothing to fear. Divine Love is the law of my being and I can trust in this great Law to conquer all conditions. With it I am strong, powerful, forceful. Manifesting this love I cannot be discouraged, frightened or turned aside from the Path of duty or spiritual attainment. As he permits his consciousness to dwell in this thought there will grow up in him the strength and power to conquer."

As we wrote one pupil: "To accomplish this, use either our Prayer for Light or the Praver to the Divine Indweller and see yourself so filled with the blazing white light of the Christforce that it radiates out from you in all directions, filling your aura full to overflowing and radiating outward with such dazzling radiance that it will neutralize any negative forces that may be sent against you; for they cannot flow into your aura against the out-flowing current of the Christ-force with which you have filled yourself. That radiant light will also blind and drive away any inharmonious or antagonistic entity, and will consume all opposition.

Therefore, realize that you do not have to fight. The blazing white light which you radiate will take care of all that. To fight, you have to think of your opponents, and to think of them is to open your consciousness and aura to their force. But if you concentrate, not on fighting, but upon filling yourself with the Christ-light, then their forces cannot reach you or enter your mind or aura. The light will take care of them without your having to fight. "Love your enemies" therefore is the basic rule.

"At night especially, use our *Protecting Invocation* and see yourself filled with the Light and surrounded by your blazing white aura, which forms the "Ring Pass Not" within which no inharmonious entity or force can intrude without being consumed by that Divine Fire. It literally forms a "rampart of living' flame to protect you from all harm." When this is thoroughly visualized and felt, then relax and go peacefully to sleep in perfect confidence that the Light of the Christ will protect you on all planes."

Another student wrote: "I am not afraid of anyone harming me, but that sudden sickness or death may come at any time. It really has taken the joy out of life for me... I have been very nervous for many years and have developed diabetes. Also I hold resentment against one who should be my support and help, but who has held me back every step of the way."

We replied: "The basis of your nervous condition and organic inharmonics is largely a mental one, due to the fact that you hold resentment. A careful study of our lesson, Judge Not, will show you that resentment is a very disintegrating and degenerating

force. And since you receive back the return current from everything you send out, you have been devitalizing yourself by every wave of resentment you have sent out, as it returns to you, its sender. No wonder you feel the possibility of sudden illness or death, for you have been generating the forces which produce just such conditions and are being warned against them from within. Therefore, you cannot expect full freedom from nervousness, fear of death, or from your physical illness as long as you continue to send out the disintegrating forces of resentment and the paralyzing force of fear."

"Never mind what anyone has done to you. That is past and gone, and will be taken care of by karmic law in due season. It is holding onto it that holds you back. Realize that no one can hold you back but yourself, unless you are so negative and lacking in courage quietly to assert your rights, that you permit it.

"Remember that you must *forget* as well as *forgive*; for as long as you are holding on to the memory of the condition and your resentment, you have not really forgiven."

"Why should you fear sudden death when you know that death on this plane is only the birth of your consciousness back into the higher world whence you came, and to which your consciousness died when it was born into this earth plane?

"Once realize that you are an immortal Soul here on earth only for a short visit, it is of relatively little importance on which plane you manifest so long as you are doing your best to manifest the peace, harmony, and love of your Real Self. So why fear your return, whether sudden or otherwise? Make up your mind that you will be willing and glad to return to vour Father's home whenever He wishes. And place absolute trust in Him to be taken care of while you are here, especially now that you have determined to stop sending out the disintegrating forces whose unhappy results you have been reaping, and have resolved to radiate all-conquering love instead.



THE GREAT PYRAMID

AVID, in his 40th Psalm tells us, "I waited patiently for the Lord; and he inclined unto me, and heard my cry. He brought me up also out of the horrible pit, out of the miry clay, and set my feet upon a rock, and established my goings."

At the period of the Exodus we find the Twelve Tribes of Israel taking the upward path and making their journey to the land of light. During the Arian Age we learn of the separation of the twelve tribes. Ten tribes dispersed and scattered all over the world while the other tribes remained in Jerusalem and became known as the Jews.

Even though the twelve tribes had become separated they still traveled toward the light. The greatest change within their ranks came when the Jews refused to accept Jesus as their Saviour.

The upward passage symbolizes the twelve tribes traveling toward the light. In looking at the Pyramid diagram, one notices a passageway branching off from the main upward passage. This passageway leads to the Queen's Chamber. The symbolism of the Queen's Chamber is Hebrew in character and both the passageway and the chamber indicate the turning away from the path of light symbolized by Jesus, the Christ.

From this point the tribes known as the Jews depart from the road of light. Did not Jesus say, "I am the light of the world; he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life."-St. John 8:12. The Jews had taken the pathway away from the direct light by their denial of Jesus as their Saviour and now they journeyed away from God's full grace and glory. Ever since this time the Jews have been wanderers without a home, but they will be saved when they unite with the Gentiles in acknowledging the Son of God.

With this period of separation man entered the Piscean Age and we notice that the intersection indicates the birth and death of Jesus and man's entrance into the passage of Grace. This passage of light symbolizes Jesus who died for man's sin. In St. John 1:17 we read, "For the law was given by Moses, but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ."

The refusal of the Jews to acknowledge the Christ is written in both the interior and the exterior of this "altar to the Lord." In the interior we noted the passageway that led to the Oueen's Chamber and as we look at the exterior of the building the words of I Peter 2:4 begins to have greater meaning. We read, "To whom coming, as unto a living stone, disallowed indeed of men, but chosen of God and precious" and "Unto you therefore which believe he is precious: but unto them which are disobedient, the stone which the builders disallowed, the same is the head of the corner." (Verse 7).

Scriptures in I Peter 2:5 tells us, "Ye, as living stones, are built upon a spiritual house." The Tribes of Israel had been building their spiritual house unto the Lord throughout the previous ages but now Bible history tells us that the Jews refused to accept Jesus as their Saviour and therefore symbolically this relates to the cornerstone which they refused.

There can be only one true corner stone "the head of the corner" and the only place where this stone can fit is the apex or true corner stone of the Great Pyramid. St. Matthew in chapter 21, verse 42 relates how "Jesus saith unto them, Did ye never read the scriptures, The stone which the builders rejected, the same is become head of the corner; this is the Lord's doing, and it is marvelous in our eyes?"

Even though the Jews have disallowed the chief corner stone which is Jesus, they must be united again with Israel to find their place in the light. For almost two thousand years, while man has lived through the Piscean Age symbolic of Christ, the Son, the Jews have been wanderers and without a homeland.

We now realize that Bible history and the Great Pyramid tell of the ages of man. In the Pyramid we find there is a chamber for each age. The Taurian Age is symbolized by the pit; the Arian Age by the Queen's Chamber; the Piscean Age by the Grand Gallery and the King's Chamber; while the Aquarian Age will be symbolized by a chamber yet to be discovered.

The Book of Revelation tells of a new Jerusalem. It is not improbable that we shall find another chamber more beautiful than those already known which will symbolize the new era and dispensation of man when he shall be his brother's keeper. As we now are living in the period of exploration who can say that the archeologists may not find a new chamber which at the present time is unrevealed.

As man is so very much better equipped, both mentally and spiritually, it is not improbable that he will find a new passageway that will lead to the new chamber at its proper appointed time. This will be a chamber symbolic of the new heaven and the new earth.

. We are told in the Book of Revelations of the events that are to be and we read that after the wars and rumors of wars peace shall reign upon the earth.

St. John in the 3rd verse of the 21st chapter of the Book of Revelations tells us, "Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God."

We are living again in a transitional period when the old edict is passing and a new era is being ushered in. The Bible, the Pyramid, and history in the making are recording these facts.

After passing through the upward passage, we notice a great step and this marks the great change. The scale of measurement in the Pyramid has increased and we today are facing facts from a closer range than ever before. It is as if we have a full-size detail of the plan of life. This step takes us to the floor of the King's Chamber and to the events of the twentieth century A. D.

"But of that day and hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels of heaven, but my Father only.

"Therefore be ye ready; for in such an hour as ye think not the Son of man cometh."

The quest for beauty has soared, been suppressed, and has burst out again until now we have the nth degree of scientific means for what has proven to be the standardization of the feminine face—plastic surgery, electricity, manipulators, vibrators, packs, everything to try to drive beauty into faces from without.

Growing old gracefully is an art. With the subscription to this idea, paradoxically enough, youth is perpetuated.

Age is sometimes manifected in an individual through an insidious in-



feriority, the easiest alibi being "that they are not as young as they used to be."

What a labyrinth of ruts stretch . themselves over the face of this earth. easy little ditches of habits that the lazy step into so willingly. Thinking the same thoughts, parting their hair the same, clothing themselves the same, year in and year out. Forgetting that there are lovely green hills of new activities to be scaled, up and above where they have been trudging for so long-limitless horizons that eternally beckon throughout life; vistas that youth itself cannot recognize, that only the mellowness of years can appreciate. Therefore, we say, you should do things that you haven't done for years, or perhaps have never done, and learn how your years of experience help you to accomplish these untried adventures.

Beauty is defined as harmony, and harmony should follow long years of full living. In other words, beauty and age should be synomymous. Harmony corresponds to the basic law of the universe, so it is only the disobedience to the natural laws that forces age to take on the hideous aspect it has. We all have the same potentialities. It is only our lack of expression that keeps them hidden from the world. There is no other reason why we see perfect harmony registered in one individual and disharmony in another.

To acquire natural beauty, we must, of course, adhere to diet and exercise, remembering that our skin is the screen that first records any disturbance within. If we are eating wrongly, our skin responds in a like manner.

The normal skin should not be dull and dry appearing, but have a lustre that is caused by the normal functioning of the sebaceous glands. Usually a deficiency of natural oils in the diet is the cause of a dry skin and hair. More olive oil, olives, butter, and so forth, if your weight can stand it, in your diet should remedy this skin deficiency. The application of softening and lubricating creams give a certain amount of assistance but, as in all outward manifestations, the cause within must be remedied first.

Uncleanliness, too, causes a great many skin distresses. Warm soap and water with a dash of cold water for rinsing is the best beauty treatment available for the normal skin. Those that feel that their complexions tend toward dryness may use a softening cream or oil before retiring.

A good treatment for anyone trying to keep their normal skin in condition is to wash the face daily with soap and water, followed immediately with a thorough rinse of ice or icecold water. Rainwater is, of course, the best to use for facial purposes because of its softness and freedom from minerals. Distilled bottled water, too, may be used or any water may be made harmless by dissolving baking soda in it.

ANCIENT EGYPT IN THE LIGHT OF TRUTH



HE secret records claim that these "Followers of Horus" ruled over the destinies of humankind for some thirteen thousand years—in the wake of the Put or Paut (Fig. 50) cycle of 9,000 years as assigned to the earthly overlordship of god Ptah (Fig. 51). Since figures vary—there are several estimates as of several different chronologies of gods and demigods—it would be sheer folly to stress the kind of data which belongs to legendary mythology rather than history proper.

However, one thing is certain: The Paut Atu Her-Seshti (Fig. 52) "Great Company of Horus" were a historic body of Mystery Teachers and master masons who once upon a time ruled over the destinies of Ancient Egypt, themselves a hierarchial body the onetime ecclesiastical and secular authority of whom corresponded to that exercised by the Holy See of the Church of Rome during the Holy Roman Empire period.

The Middle-Empire period of Ancient Egypt witnessed the rapid decline of prestige and power of the famed "Company of Horus" from whom the early dynastic "Horus kings" of Ancient Egypt had derived their authority of regal office.

Once the most famous body of MysteryTeachers of the ancient world and credited, by legendary mythology, with celestial-divine origins via their namesake Horus the Heru (Fig. 53), the "Company of Horus" had been the onetime equivalent of the latterday "Company of Jesus," the Jesuits —who patterned their ecclesiastical political super-organization after the original "Society" or "Company" of "Horus-Followers."

Originally, the "Company of Horus" had their headquarters in the famed Per-Hetj (Fig. 54) "White House" of Het-Ka-Ptah or Het-Ptah-Ka (Fig. 55) the "Shrine of the Double of Ptah"-principal typename of Memphis, Ancient Egypt. With the decline of their political power and ecclesiastical prestige, this famous body of ancient Mystery Teachers and master masons transferred their headquarters in late-dynastic times to the city of Sais in the Delta regions (not far from modern Alexandria). It was there that the Her-Seshti Mystery Teachers initiated, among others, Solon, Pythagoras, Herodotus, Iamblichus, Appolonius of Tyana, and Hor-Apollo.

The one-time hierarch of this the only historic body of illuminati mentioned in ancient history was the famous Imhotep or Iu-Em-Hetep (Fig. 56) "Peace Prince," the original Aesculaeopios, Imouthis, Harpokrates, whom antiquity deified as the "god of greatest taumathurgist and the wisest healing" and "silent speech," the wisest man on record.

He is immortalized in the papyrus of the Legend of the Seven Years' Famine in the time of emperor Tjeser (Zoser) the "Holy One" (IIIrd dynasty; about B. C. 4400), the account of which smacks strongly of the Biblical version Joseph, son of Jacob!

Among the many religious cults of Ancient Egypt, two cults in particular, contemporary and closely linked by dint of mystic affiinity, deserve prominent mention.

Principal among Ancient Egypt's Mystery Schools, the two cults in question were the Incarnation cult of Atum-Iu (Fig. 57) of Annu-Qemat (Fig. 58) of the Heliopolis-of-the-South and the Resurrection cult of Ptah (Fig. 59) of Het-Ka-Ptah or Het-Ptah-Ka (Fig. 60) of ancient Memphis, northern Egypt.

The southern Egyptian Incarnation cult of Atum-Iu (Fig. 61) the "ever-coming Adam," centered about a mystical, non-historical type-representation of the Logos manifected in the person of messianic mangod Horus-Iesa the Heru (Fig. 62). In his mystic form of Atum-Iu, god Heru the Aegypto-Gnostic Horus-Iesa represented the "evercoming Adam," or Adam-come (to earth), as the Verbum of Maat-Cheru (Fig. 63) the World-made-Flesh-made Truth," in fulfillment of the Hidden, Divine Father's promise.

As such, the messianic mangod the godson represented the mundane counterpart of elemental Adam the Atmu or Atum (Fig. 64) "god of mankind" as the Atum-Iu (Fig. 65) "Adam-come" or Iu-Sa (Fig. 66) "evercoming son" — type-name of Aegypto-Gnostic Horus-Iesa, the first "Jesus" by name—as the "Living Word," and "The Way," incarnated in the flesh mortal, in the Adamic image.

In this form the messianic mangod and Logos child represented the mundane counterpart of his non-earthly heavenborn, divine, first form. Thus Atum-Iu the "Adam-come" or Iu-Sa "ever-coming son" of the Advent predicted in advance, served as type-representation of Temu (Fig. 67) "mortal mankind," created in the image of elemental, non-human Adam the Atmu or Atum (Fig. 68) "god of mankind," as those born in the flesh mortal and about to become immortal. divine, by way of identification with the Divine Father on-high and via resurrection of the spirit-soul from the moribund carnal body.

However, the Incarnation cult of Atum-Iu, of Heliopolis-of-the-South, concerned itself with the elemental, pre-human aspects and the mundanephysical phases prior death, rather than the Greater Mysteries of Lifein-Death and Larger (After) Life of the resurrected spirit-soul proper.

Thus the cult of Atum-Iu, as typified by Horus the Younger, the Iesa or Iu-Sa "evercoming son" of the Advent and the Nativity, represented the Lesser Mysteries of the messianic man-god incarnated in the flesh mortal. This as the earthly counterpart of elemental "first man" Adam the Atum "god of mankind," and as the mundane alter ego of Har-ur or Heru-Ur (Fig. 69) the Haroeris or "Horus the Great" as Elder (Divine) Horus.

As such, Atum-Iu or Iu-Sa the "Adam-come" and Aegypto-Gnostic Horus-Iesa, typified the Lesser Mystery of the messianic mangod incarnated in the flesh mortal as the Logos manifested in the Adamic type-image and as the Moses or Meses (Fig. 70) "child," also known as Harpocrates or Heru-Pa-Khart (Fig. 71), the "miracle child" (by way of Immaculate Conception) of "virgin-mother" Auset (Fig. 72) the Isis.

Thus Atum-Iu or Iu-Sa represented the mortal counterpart of Elder (Divine) Horus, as the "living link" between elemental Adam the Atum "god of mankind," and Temu "mortal mankind" in the Adamic image.

Thus, then, in brief were the Lesser Mysteries of the Incarnation cult of Atum-Iu, as mystically related to the more profound, more occult Resurrection cult of Ptah of ancient Memphis, Egypt. And thus the evidence that the ancient Egyptian Incarnation cult of Atum-Iu or Iu-Sa inspired the Biblical version of the messianic man-god Jesus—the Iesa and Aber-Amentho of the early-Christian gnostics, the Copts!—of the lesser aspects of the Messianic Mystery.

The more profound, less popular Resurrection cult of Ptah (Fig. 73), prototype of Osiris, Serapis, Priapus, Lazarus, Christos, dramatized the Greater Mystries in the form of Passion Plays. These mystic rites were first celebrated at ancient Memphis the Het-Ka-Ptah or Het-Ptah-Ka (Fig. 74) "Shrine of the Double of Ptah," the capital city of early-dynastic Egypt and the original headquarters of the most famous body of Mystery Teachers — the Her-Seshti or Heru-Shesti or Shesu-Heru (Fig. 75) "Company of Horus."

The Resurrection cult of Ptah (who represents Ancient Egypt's greatest mystery) concerned itself with the more occult phases of the Greater Mysteries of Life-in-Death and After (Larger) Life.

In this the most mysterious cult of Ancient Egypt, the pygmy mummygod Ptah (Fig. 76) was represented by a Ka (Fig. 77) "Double"—of the other, second greatest mystery of Ancient Egypt—in the form of the twicerisen Neb-Qrst (Fig. 78) "Lord of theBier" (of resurrections). This as a Greater Mystery which inspired the latter-day Biblical version of Lord Christ as the immortal-divine other Self of the messianic mangod Iesa or Jesus!

As such Heru (Fig. 79) the Horus or Iesa typified the twice-risen mangod in the Greater Mysteries of Lifein-Death and After (Larger) Life. This was during and after the resurrection of the spirit-soul from the entombed, mortal body, represented by the typical mummy, which had been the mundane-mortal vehicle and carnal "temple" of the messianic mangod during His earth life. In his character of Neb-Qrst "Lord of the Bier," Heru the Horus and Iesa represented the Ka (Fig. 80) "double" of Ptah (Fig. 81)—by way of occult "link" . between this world and alien dimensions in The Beyond. Thus Horus-Iesa represented the transfigurated-Transsubstantiated other, Greater Self of elemental Adam the Atum (Fig. 82) "god of mankind"—by way of elemental alchemy during and after physical-corporeal death of the type-mummy. As such the twice-risen mangod was the Sahu (Fig. 83) "Lord of Elementals" become the

Atum-Hehi (Fig. 84) "eternal Adam (Adamas Kadmon) as Heru-Maat-Cheru (Fig. 85) "Horus the Wordmade-Flesh-made Truth," and as the Horus-Iesa reunited with his divine, other Self (Elder Horus-become one and indivisible with His Divine Father Amen (Fig. 86) the "Hidden One" or Supreme Being of the Absolute-at-Large!

have separate departments in the Temple and are never permitted to see each other or associate with each other until they are about 18 or 20 years of age, which corresponds to 28 and 30 in America, as all people of hot countries mature much earlier, both physically and mentally, than in temperate or cold climates.

But this does not mean that these young people do not know anything about the opposite sex. There is NOTHING which they are not taught, and it is taught in such perfect fashion, in such an effective manner, that when they meet absolutely nothing is thought about the difference between the sexes. Theirs is such a perfect understanding of the meaning of sex, and the possibilities of the personal use of the sex forces, except when reproduction is desired, that no emphasis is possible on this subject.

In my teaching work here in America I have been surprised to look over lecture audiences and those in church services and find most of those who attend are women. I find many women who go to a lecture under terrific protest from their husbands who tell them what fools they are to follow such folly as lectures on personal efficiency.

I find one of the great problems of America, which crops out in the prevalence of divorce, is the sex problem. The problem seems to arise because of the fact that all boys and men are taught to over-estimate the desirability of sex expression, without any training concerning the value of sex conservation. Thus, as a consequence, they are over-sexed, make too much demand upon their wives, who soon resent an unnatural intrusion of one person upon the life and well-being of another, and trouble follows which wrecks the home.

The present cycle tends toward creating superiority in the woman as compared with her male companion. Unless American men arouse themselves and learn their errors in estimating values, they will find themselves seriously left behind in race evolution, and America will be a country governed and controlled by women, even as it has been one legislated by the men and for the men, with no regard until recent times even of the political right of their women. Unless the men find out that there is a functional law of necessity for personal freedom in every avenue of personal life, their attempted violation of the law of sex will reduce them to the place where they will scarcely be of sufficiently good quality to serve even as ancestors for thir offspring. The women of the future are destined to be the power and directors of our race destiny, unless the churches arise and give scientific instruction which will appeal to and reach the scientific mind of the present day man. Only then will the church begin to live up to its privileges.

Our Final Training

I am asked just what happened in this final Temple as compared with that which occurred in the primary school. In answer let me say that nothing spectacular happened. Before we enter this Temple of Triumph, we have been taught all the basic wisdom; we have been practicing and developing our personal abilities. Here we continue our endeavor with one added factor, which is of importance although to an ordinary observer it might seem of little value.

This added factor is much like the blooming of a flower in a few hours, which has been budding for weeks. We have passed certain of the budding stages of our development when we enter this Temple, and during the eight months of my stay I was constantly emphasizing those practices which would of themselves prove my ability.

The great and final test comes to us in the following fashion: In this Temple there is cultivated a flower which does not grow anywhere in the world except central Africa. It is a beautiful white flower and, when it is in full bloom, its flower petals gradually open and close in periods of about three minutes, requiring one and a half minutes for the opening and like time for the closing.

When this flower opens it throws out a sweet perfume, and it only begins its closing process when its stock of perfume is exhausted. While it is closing it gathers a new supply, whereupon it gradually opens again, and so it continues rhythmically hour by hour.

This perfume is pleasant to the senses, but it is a deadly poison for the human body, and it is used by us to prove our personal physical and mental control. The method used is this: The flower is located in the center of a series of circles which are arranged so that the spaces between the circles are sufficient for a student to sit and meditate. There are eleven spaces in all, and the flower is the twelfth. We begin our practice by sitting for one hour, if possible, in the outermost space, or that farthest away from the flower.

As we develop the ability to keep the body independent of the poison, we sit in a space closer to the flower. It is in this practice that we gain our rings on our headdress. Each space conquered gives us one ring. And so, as our ability improves, we come closer to the flower but, also, with each step toward it, the poison is more powerful and the endeavor is more strenuous.

One who has proved his ability to sit within the first space away from the flower is an eleven. I personally made the grade of seven, when I felt that I had enough, and left the Temple and came into the world. I do not think I will attempt to make any higher grade in this life, as I prefer the rounding experience of general association such as I am now gaining in America with my family and friendship ties, which all normal and regular beings appreciate most of all.

The real meaning of this practice is this: The flower represents, or symbolizes, nature. Nature is *always* our giver of degrees. No school, no human being, no organization, Nothing or No One, can ever give you a degree. It is only our powers of adjustment to the forces in nature which determines or shows forth our weakness or strength. And so, when we wear any number of rings, we have earned them, and every step has been a real and basic personal victory. There is no "Ponying" through, as is common in universities where the President confers the degree and hands the candidate the sheepskin.
