More than a hundred centuries B. C. the belief in the immortality of the soul was a dominant factor in the religion of the Pre-Incas.

It is soul knowledge filtering through to the conscious mind and taking different forms among different peoples. The soul knows its own immortality.

Kant said, "A dream which all men dream together and which they must dream, is no longer a dream but a reality."

Descartes said, "The universality of an instinct justifies belief in that to which the instinct points. Not even primitive fetish worshippers believed in extinction."

The Soul's Binoculars

Some years ago a certain weekly magazine published the personal experiences of a well known college professor, who for four consecutive years had experienced an almost uninterrupted flow of answered prayers.

Asked about his plan or system of prayer he gave the key, which is very simple, in the following brief sentence. "A miracle, is simply looking at Reality through the lens of the imagination, and then letting this bring to pass the thing which is spoken of as a miracle."

This brings to mind a very impressive cartoon we saw lately in which a large surface of the round globe was shown with Uncle Sam looming up as a large and formidable man on one side, looking across to the other side of the globe where Herr Hitler (also large and formidable) was standing with a Japanese, (diminutive in stature), who had just been handed wrong side foremost a very irregular and crooked binocular, through which he saw Uncle Sam greatly reduced, and was saying with unfeigned surprise, "I had no idea he was so small."

The thought occurred to me in glancing at this cartoon that looking through the small end of the soul's binoculars usually brings the miscalculations and mistakes of life, while looking through the magnifying lens brings the miracles.

That which we set either our minds or our hearts upon, that we both magnify and multiply.

The Psalmist David realized this when he sang, "My soul doth magnify the Lord," for when we magnify the Lord in our thoughts daily and hourly, we are magnifying Reality—that which is complete, perfect, changeless and deathless.

The soul of man was given free will in vision (imagination) as well as in all other things. All of us have the choice of looking through the small or the large end of this wonderful faculty God has given us. We can magnify poverty, distress, disease, and see only lack and the impossibility of opportunity and progress, or we can magnify the Lord in ourselves, in our friends, (also in our enemies to make them friends). We can magnify and see Him only in all our problems, or in any situation in life and thus lift ourselves into that consciousness where our souls meet

the Great Oversoul in complete recognition and the miracle is

wrought."

We have the power to magnify either disease or health in our bodies;—poverty or plenty in our environment; failure or success in our business or vocation; love, hate or indifference in our relations with other people.

You can better your own conditions, and those of others, only by keeping your eye single to this transforming idea. "I and my Father are one" in divine love, power, wisdom, perfection—and all things are possible with Him, and through Him."

If you have been looking through the small lens of your imagination (the imaging faculty God has given you to create with) then "Be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind," and practice patiently and persistently the Christ principle until you can say, "My soul (unfailingly) doth magnify the Lord."

Our minds are ever linked with the Universal Mind, and ideas, (especially when we are in need) are always being impressed upon us from God's Infinite avenues of aid. As Emerson expressed it, "Nothing ever happens, everything is pushed from behind." If you study your own life you will find that many times help has been thrust upon your consciousness.

Some years ago I read of the experience of a well known metaphysical writer and healer, whose name has escaped me, but whose method of self-healing has never been erased from my memory. This man had spent many years in a very successful career of healing, then was called upon to meet a great test of faith. He was suddenly taken very ill, and although he faithfully used all that he knew of Truth, employed other healers (and even physicians if my memory serves me correctly) the malady persisted, and he continually grew worse. He prayed and affirmed and concentrated until his faith was well nigh exhausted, and his strength gone, until he felt he had failed in the injunction, "Physician heal thyself," and that his days were numbered.

Then at the lowest ebb came a resurrecting idea. Somewhere he read of the countless trillions of cells, which make up the human body, and he suddenly realized that his illness, though severe, involved only a very small proportion of the total number of these intelligent entities of his body, and that the predominating healthy cells were still willing workers, doing all they possibly could, through the Divine Intelligence within them, to restore balance in his body. It was an arresting thought. He saw that he had been using the lens of his imagination to

magnify the diseased cells by centering his thoughts upon them, instead of focussing upon the infinitely larger army of healthy cells.

Instantly he was transformed by the renewing of his mind, and then and there he determined to right about face and to magnify the good (God) within, and in a short space of time he found his healing, and also a greatly magnified faith in God, which he was able to impart to others.

Alter Your Life

There is no need to be unhappy. There is no need to be sad. There is no need to be disappointed, or oppressed or aggrieved. There is no need for illness or failure or discouragement, There is no necessity for anything but success, good health, prosperity, and an abounding interest and joy in life.

That the lives of many people are full of dreary things is unfortunately only too true; but there is no necessity for them to be there. They are there only because their victims suppose them to be inevitable, not because they are so. As long as you accept a negative condition at its own valuation, so long will you remain in bondage to it; but you have only to assert your birthright as a free man or woman and you will be free.

Success and happiness are the natural condition of mankind. It is actually easier for us to demonstrate these things than the reverse. Bad habits of thinking and acting may obscure this fact for a time, just as a wrong way of walking or sitting or holding a pen or a musical instrument may seem to be easier than the proper way, because we have accustomed ourselves to it; but the proper way is the easier nevertheless.

Unhappiness, frustration, poverty, loneliness are really bad habits that their victims have become accustomed to bear with more or less fortitude, believing that there is no way out, whereas there is a way; and that way is simply to acquire good habits of mind instead of bad ones—habits of working with the Law instead of against it.

You should never "put up" with anything. You should never be willing to accept less than Health, Harmony and Happiness. These things are your Divine Right as the sons and daughters of God, and it is only a bad habit, unconscious, as a rule, that causes you to be satisfied with less. In the depths of his being man always feels intuitively that there is a way out of his difficulties if only he can find it, and his natural instincts all point in the same direction. The infant, as yet uncontaminated by the defeatist suggestions of his elders, simply refuses to tolerate inharmony on any terms and therefore he demonstrates over it. When he is hungry he tells the world with a confident insistence that commands attention, while many a sophisticated adult goes without. Does he find a pin sticking in some part of his anatomy? Not for him a sigh of resignation to the supposed "will of God" (it is really blasphemy to say that evil or suffering could ever be the will of God, All Good), or a whine about never having any luck, or a sigh that what cannot be cured must be endured. No, the defeatest view of life has not yet touched him, his instincts tell him that life and harmony are inseparable. And sure enough that pin is located and removed even if everything else has to come to a stop until it is done.

But "shades of the prison-house begin to close about the growing boy," and by the time he is old enough to think rationally the Race habit will have trained him to use his reason largely in the inverted way.

Refuse to tolerate anything less than harmony. You can have prosperity no matter what your present circumstances may be. You can have health and physical fitness. You can have a happy and joyous life. You can have a good home of your own, You can have congenial friends and comrades. You can have a full, free, joyous life, independent and untrammeled. You can become your own master or your own mistress. But to do this you must definitely seize the rudder of your own destiny and steer boldly and firmly for the port that you intend to make.

What are you doing about your future? Are you content to let things just drift along as they are, hoping, like Mr. Micawber for something to "turn up"? If you are, be assured that there is no secret in that way. Nothing ever will turn up unless you exercise your Free Will and go out and turn it up for yourself by becoming acquainted with the Laws of Life, and apply-

ing them to your own individual conditions. That is the only way. Otherwise the years will pass all too swiftly, leaving you just where you are now, if not worse off, for there is no limit to the result of thought either for good or evil.

Man has dominion over all things when he knows the Law of Being and obeys it. The Law gives you power to bring any condition into your life that is not harmful. The Law gives you power to overcome your own weaknesses and faults of character, no matter how often you may have failed in the past or how tenacious they may have seemed to be. The Law gives you power to attain prosperity and position without infringing the rights and opportunities of anyone else in the world. The Law gives you Freedom; freedom of soul, and body, and environment.

The Law gives you Independence so that you can build your own life in your own way, in accordance with your own ideas and ideals; and plan out your future along the lines that you yourself desire. If you do not know what you really want to make you happy, then the Law will tell you what you want, and get it for you too. And the Law rightly understood and applied will save you from the danger of what is called "outlining" with all its risks and limitations.

The Law will endow you with the gift of what is called Originality; Originality is the doing of things in a new way which is a better way, and different from anyone else's way; and Originality, as distinct from its counterfeits which are eccentricity and mere posing, means success in your work.

The Law will give you authority over the past as well as the future. The Law will make you the master of Karma instead of its slave.

Oh, how I love Thy Law.

You need not be shabby and restricted. You need not go on living or working with people you dislike. You need not be ailing or tired or overworked, if you will study the law and apply it.

Do not put off your study of the Law any longer. Procrastination, we are told, is the thief of time; and another proverb says still more emphatically that Hell itself is paved, not with evil intentions, but with good ones.

It is of the postponer that the Law says, Thou shalt hear the Never Never whispered by the phantom years, but the path of the Wise (the righteous or Right Thinker) shineth more and more unto the Perfect Day.

Take stock of your life this very day. Sit down quietly by yourself with pencil and paper, and write down the three things that you most wish for in life. Be quite frank about this. Write down the things you really wish for, not things that you think you ought to wish for. Be specific, not vague. Then write down underneath three things or conditions that you wish to remove from your life. Again be definite and specific, and not vague.

If you do this candidly, you now have an extremely valuable analysis of your own mentality. In course of time this will tell you a great many things about yourself which you do not at present suspect, things far beyond the range of the actual six points themselves and as your knowledge of spiritual Truth increases, you will be able to handle the new knowledge about yourself in a surprising way.

Now having got your six points in front of you, work on each one separately for a few minutes with all the spiritual and metaphysical knowledge that you possess. Remember, it is not really very important how much of this knowledge you have so long as you make use of all that you do have. It is a spiritual law that to use ninety percent of a small amount of knowledge is more practically effective than to use only say fifty percent of a large amount. Repeat this treatment every day for a month, without missing a single day, and by the end of that time it will be very unusual if a really striking change for the better has not manifested itself in your conditions.

For those unfamiliar with spiritual treatment, a simple but quite effective method of working is this: Claim gently but definitely that the Great Creative Life Force of the Universe is bringing each of the first three into your life, in Its own way, in Its own time,, and in its own form. Then claim that the same Great Power is dissolving each of the latter three, also in Its own way. Do not try to dictate the exact form in which the new conditions shall come about. Do not be tense or vehement. Do not let anyone else know that you are doing this. Do not look impatiently every day for results, but make your treatment and forget it until next day. And in quietness and confidence shall be your strength.

Divine Magnetism

FTEN we find in homes a member of the family who is very magnetic, who could heal the sick by laying on of hands, but not knowing this makes no effort.

Often it is only a little magnetic force, imparted through love and the touch of the hand, that carries a sick person over to the point where his own vital energies carry him on to the crest of health.

In laying on of hands, the magnetic force of the healer is imparted to the patient and acts on his finer bodies, almost in the same way a blood transfusion acts on an anemic. However, blood transfusions are not natural, and will be done away with when these higher healing agencies are better known. The vitalizing force can be transmitted through thought and touch more easily and more effectively,

Ramananda, a wonderful healer from India, who was able to see the healing forces at work while he was treating, tells of a child, two and a half years old who was dying of tuberculosis of the bowels. "The doctor said, only half an hour to live; just skin and bones, but when treated opened his eyes and began crying loudly, and would not stop until warm milk and biscuits were given him. Next day he was up on his feet after a long night's sleep. It was beautiful to see the blood rushing to his limbs. Where it came from no material laws can explain. Today he is a chubby lad and growing tall. This was in a mining town of Australia."

Mothers often heal their children by instinctively placing their hands on the head or part affected.

There is a woman in Cuba who has one of the largest collections of apes in the world. She has studied their lives and habits for many years. She tells of a chimpanzee mother giving birth to a baby. It was born dead. Thereupon the mother took the arms of the baby and worked them to and fro as life-guards do in resuscitating a drowned man. She put her mouth up to the baby's mouth and forced air into its lungs. In a little while the infant chimpanzee began to move and the mother lifted it to her breast and nursed it. It grew to be a healthy, normal chimpanzee.

I mention this account to show that men and women, a far

higher order of intelligence, have similar instincts, that dictate a remedy in emergencies, which are often unheeded because of race beliefs and other barriers in the mind.

Animals in their native state are always healthy. They eat only such things as instinct sanctions. A dog will always smell his food before eating it. If it is not good for him he will not touch it. When a dog is hungry and smells meat the gastric juices begin to flow. If the food is something he does not need the fluids are not secreted and so he leaves it alone. We all have the same instinct, but constant disregard blunts this natureguide and we become creatures of many disorders.

In the presence of sickness we can often render great help by carrying out what we instinctively feel like doing. In talking to healers we have often heard some such remark in reference to a difficult case "I don't know why I acted thus but seemed to be obeying an inner prompting, and the healing was accomplished."

A woman I used to know told me of some very unusual healings she was instrumental in bringing about. She followed an instinct that often led to strange proceedings. Once she saw a newsboy in a large city, with a crutch and a pigmy leg, like a doll's leg dangling at his side. She got an impression that she could heal the leg. So she inquired for his address and got permission from his mother to take him to her farm. One of the first impressions she got was to follow the plowman and gather angle worms. These she put into bottles and exposed to the sun until they dissolved into an oil (which probably contained valuable mineral and magnetic properties of the earth.) This she rubbed daily on the boy's leg, at the same time manipulating it; and speaking the healing word to it. It began to grow and in a few month's time matched the other leg. This healer who was clairvoyant said she saw Indian forces helping her from the invisible side. The Indians were a very magnetic race of people as a result of living close to nature and had many great healers in their ranks. They had a profound understanding of the healing forces of nature.

This healer was in our band of helpers for several years, and was a woman of unusual intelligence, and unquestioned integ-

rity.

Why should we doubt such things? Christ accomplished these same results and many times over told us we could do the same. You find all this in the New Testament. All healers know this law and have participated in many healings that can be classed as miracles.

Remember we are living in a world largely materialistic,

which is so blind that it does not see that all life is a miracle, and that we are surrounded by countless inexplicable things that because they happen to be, and we have grown gradually accustomed to them, we accept without question.

But in spite of seeing this simple formula work accurately in taking a trip, in many of the things much dearer to our hearts we do not follow it..

We say, "I'd love to have a summer place in the country," but go right on working and living in the city, without once looking into the possibilities (the road map) of this desire. Yet I know several families who live at a beach all summer, much less expensively than they could live at home.

We say, "I'd like to get into the advertising business. There's loads of money in that." But we keep right on selling mayonnaise.

I know a woman who complained because she never had any fun. Yet, when I invited her to a bridge party, she promptly answered, "I'd love to come, but I cannot possibly, I can't leave the children."

I happen to know that the high school girl next door would have stayed with the children gladly, but my friend never stopped to figure out how she could come, because her mind was so set on the fact that she couldn't.

I met a business man who said, "I wish I could meet Mr. X. I think I could sell him an idea."

"Well, why don't you?" I asked.

"Oh, I could never get in to see him. He's so important and so busy, you have to have an introduction and then get past a string of secretaries."

My friend had never tried, he was so sure he couldn't. Yet I know of two outstanding examples of people who worked the other way.

One day, a friend of mine called up and said, "I am going to England this summer." Now this girl is only a secretary with a secretary's pay, and she has more than the average secretary's obligations. But she had an invitation to visit friends in England, and she was to have a month's vacation. With only that, she dug out her road map and proceeded straight ahead. What clothes she bought in the next two months she bought with the idea of the trip in mind. She talked her trip. She planned everything about it. And when she was making a mortgage interest payment on her mother's house, she asked the banker, "How would you like to loan me three hundred dollars? I want to go to England."

He handed her a blank note. And before she left on her trip, she got a raise in pay which, in the course of the next few months would repay the loan with no cut in her present income.

I know a girl who had an advertising plan to sell. Because she was so young and so ignorant of what couldn't be done, she barged into the office of one of the biggest companies in the country, at *noon*, without an appointment—without an introduction; asked to see the vice-president, and *saw him*! Furthermore, she got the order.

"But," you say, "they were exceptional cases. Everyone can-

not go to England, and certainly everyone cannot barge into a busy man's office and sell him something."

And again I say, "Why not? Thousands of others have done it, and you can never tell until you have tried. And even then you cannot say, 'I can't do it' until you have tried with the positive attitude."

The remarkable and absolutely true thing which happens is, that unusual circumstances always enter into the activities of the positive person, and what we look upon as "luck," gives him some astounding boost. It isn't luck. It is God, the life force; the powerful action of mighty forces which always operate in the positive direction, getting behind the positive person and pushing him along with strength, ideas, and circumstances far beyond those he could possibly produce himself.

Most of the things which hold us back are only mentally created hazards, our own assurance that we cannot do the thing we want to do. Why not, I ask? I doubt if any of these are things that have not been done before. I doubt if we would find any armies, any police, or even any single person barring our progress if we went ahead with our plans. Actually, the whole world needs people with initiative, and welcomes them with open aims. Our only defeat lies in the fact that we say, "I want to go to Albany," and then, with all our thoughts, words, fears and emotions, we turn our backs upon that goal and head in the opposite direction.

No wonder we don't get where we want to go, and often do get somewhere we don't want to go. If we could recognize the effect of our mental preparation, our attitude of, "Of course I shall," instead of "I cannot possibly," we might exercise more self-discipline in heading our vehicle in the direction we want and keeping it there. We might more often get what we do want instead of what we do not (consciously) want.

He Foretold Hitler

He Saw Full Course of History. Called Nazi Leader "Histor."

Nostradamus shut himself up behind locked doors in Paris and tried to see into the future, states "Tit-Bits." Night after night he studied books of ancient Egyptian lore and hurriedly burned the yellowed pages as soon as he had committed the contents to memory.

Then he published his great book of prophecies, "The Centuries." Ever since then the name of Nostradamus has been an enigma in the minds of men. He not only correctly foretold the date of his own death, but from his vantage-point in 1555 he looked ahead and saw the full course of history.

It isn't often that forecasts can be preserved with impunity, yet those of Nostradamus tick over with startling accuracy every time. The French Revolution began in 1792. He foreshadowed "the revolution of the century" for that year. After four Saturnian revolutions of about thirty years, he declared France would go against another enemy. This tots up to 1914.

GAOL OR MAD-HOUSE ?

He also forecast the Franco-Prussian War of 1870, the Great Fire of London, the British Revolution of 1648—and Napoleon. "From a common soldier will be made an Empire. From a short coat he will go to a long mantle," the prophecy read. "Valiant in arms, he will be a thorn in the side of church and priests." All this was fulfilled.

How's this, too, for a 250-year forecast concerning Louis XVI, and his flight to Varennes: "The night will come to the forest of Rheims," wrote Nostradamus. "A black monk in grey, under the name of Cap, will cause tempest, fire, blood, and knife." In actual fact, Louis XVI, fled in monastic disguise through the forest of Rheims by night, was arrested at Varennes, returned to face the guillotine, and was given the name of Capet. It is an astonishing prevision of names and places.

In our own immediate day, more startling still, Nostradamus foresaw Hitler, and even named him. True, he calls him "Hister," but spelling was never his strong point, and this Hister was scheduled in 1940 to lead Germany in invading France, after feigning friendship for her. "France by a neglect shall be assaulted on five sides. Tunis, Algeria shall be moved."

Great destruction was to be caused, Paris would be gained, and even so Hister would eventually end in an iron cage. Does this mean ultimate madness or imprisonment for Hitler?

INVASION OF ITALY

Looking ahead just a few more months, he sees a German invasion of Switzerland and Italy, the Pope in flight from Rome—and the end of the war in 1944 with an ultimate victory for the French by a newly-risen "king" at Poitiers. Will time prove Nostradamus right yet again? His prophecies, numerous as they were, have rarely failed.

In his own lifetime he foretold the fate of each of the children of Catherine de Medicis, the exact form of death of Charles IX, and many other events of his day. Between now and 1948 war is forecast between Russia and Japan. In 1999 a terrible leader from the north of Asia will assault Paris from the sky:—

"The great city will be desolate.

"Not one of the inhabitants will remain there.

"Walls, temples and virgins will be violated.

"Multitudes will die by fire, iron, cannon."

In 7000, according to this great seer, the greatest deluge since the Flood will herald the final catastrophe. Nostradamus has been a mystery through the ages, and today the riddle of his second-sight is stranger than ever.

When man loses faith in the immortality of the soul, moral decay sets in, materialism spreads, and unless the tide is stemmed by new vision chaos ensues. "Where there is no vision (and faith) the people perish." This book gives the new vision.

Renan said, "There is no lever capable of raising an entire people, if once they have lost their faith in the immortality of the soul."

In the first pages James says, "While I was on earth—alive, as you call it—I thought I knew a lot, but now that I have begun to learn a very little, I see that I failed to know what is in truth about the most essential thing of all—namely, you cannot prove by your intellect those things which can be proved only by life. I mean, Jesus Christ said: 'I am the Way, the Truth and the Life.' If you want to prove the Truth of the Gospels—the New Testament record of the Life of Christ—there is only one way in which it can be done; that is, by living it out in your daily life. I thought that I could reason about religion, and I neglected the simple method of living the religion myself."

Early in the book James refers to the horrors of the last war and says, "I tell you it is nothing compared to what is to come." This was said twenty years ago.

If man would follow the Christ path, love God and do His Will, only peace and pleasantness would be the lot of all. All would be prosperous and have plenty, with a thousand things to make them glad that are now denied them.

We were surprised after reading this book that so valuable a contribution to the growing literature of communication (light from higher intelligences coming to man) had not come to our attention, for we have been keenly alive for years to such revelations.

1111 Books Received

THY KINGDOM COME. Price \$1.00. Published by Wm. Kullgren, Beacon Light Publishers. Atascadero, California. This is a very interesting book on prophecy in three parts, originally edited by Dewitt B. Lucas. The first part of this remarkable book consists of a series of letters dictated posthumously by Emlitta King (a woman of great spiritual power and illumination who passed into the Spirit World on September 4, 1932) to her husband. There are in all seventeen letters, commencing January 2, 1933, and ending January 19. The remarkable spiritual affinity between her and her husband enabled her to impress these communications upon him through automatic writing.

In the first letter she stated "I wish to start the record of these very remarkable, interesting and almost unbelievable things, happenings and occurrences that have been given to me by very advanced spiritual entities who are closer to the Source than any I have ever met—the most astounding and world-breaking facts that will remake mankind and civilizations on this planet during the next fifty years." She stated that the conflagration would flare up about 1940, and eventually all nations would be involved; that the fighting would last three years, and stop suddenly through the fall of a great rock, or planetoid; that the Christ will come again by 1945, restore order out of chaos, make all things new, and build a new civilization in which evil will not exist for a thousand years.
