

## "Neither Do I Condemn Thee"

ANY people go through life filled with fear and self-condemnation, both for this life and for the hereafter. Their minds are so filled with fear that it often inhibits their creative processes and the great good they might do. They need so much the lesson from Isaiah,

"Remember ye not the former things, neither consider the things of old. Behold I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; Shall ye not know it? I will even make a way in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert."

It is futile to center our thoughts on past sins and short-comings. God never condemns his children, any more than an earthly parent condemns a child for a mistake. He realizes the child is growing, that it has not reached full understanding, and knows that as he learns he will do better.

The Christ did not look on the sins of Mary Magdalene, but rather called attention to those around her who were condemning her, saying, "He that is without sin let him first cast a stone at her," and when none could qualify, he turned to her and said: "Neither do I condemn thee. Go and sin no more." That is what we need to center our minds on, not the past, but our future conduct, and our future time and opportunities, which if used rightly will right past wrongs through universal service.

The Master also told the thief on the cross, (a sinner according to world standards) "This day shalt thou be with me in Paradise," showing that there is also no condemnation by Divine Mind in the Hereafter, as so many people, steeped in religious fears believe, sometimes to the point of mental unbalance. These people greatly need a more proper balance in their lives, of joy, harmony, social contacts and healthy recreation to compensate for too much hard work, sickness, disappointments, etc., which they often wrongly believe are Godsent for their sins.

It is true that we all have to appear before the judgment seat of Christ, but that is a daily process that the conscience within us sees to, rather than a piled up accumulation which we are judged for after life leaves the body.

Paul told us: "I die daily," and we all die daily to the old

that we may resurrect the new and better. He also told us "Christ in you your hope of Glory," and this is the judgment seat we face daily, "the Christ within."

"For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ: that. every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad."—2 Cor. 5:10.

One has only to look about him among his friends and acquaintances to see how this judgment for his thoughts and actions is affecting the lives and health of his friends.

"Behold I will bring evil upon this people, even the fruits of their thoughts."—Jer. 6:19.

God has not created a world for condemnation of self or others. He has created a world of beauty, joy and harmony, and asks us to "Rejoice and be glad in it." The Indwelling Christ is the only arbiter, and we may always go to Him no matter what we have done or left undone, and hear Him say: "Neither do I condemn thee, henceforth follow thou Me."

Martin Luther once said that written through all the gospels was this word: Forgiveness of sins! And divine love manifests supreme through all the teachings of Jesus.

Nature dies once a year that the glorious resurrection may come in the Spring, but God has ordained it that man may die daily to the old and resurrect the new and better in his life. Each one of us faces the tribunal of the Spirit daily, as we go to our couch to rest and reflect on the day's happenings. Then God "giveth His beloved sleep," that we may forget yesterday and start afresh each day.

It is said that "confession is good for the soul." If we have done something that troubles us, that we know we should not have done, confessing it to God or to some trusted friend or

healer, lifts the burden and we go free.

The promise, "the Son of Man hath power to forgive sins," has two interpretations, not just the generally accepted one that Christ, the Son of God, has power to forgive sins, but that the son of man, (that is, all of God's children who fully realize their oneness with the Father) also has power to forgive sins by easing the mind and lifting the burden of one who has disobeyed some law, and fallen short of the perfection his or her soul is seeking.

When we do wrong our soul is ever mindful, and endeavors to seek its Source to be absolved and start afresh on the for-

ward Path.

If it is advantageous for us to confess our sins, it is more so to confess (acknowledge) our blessings, our healings, and our protection from any mishaps we may encounter during the average day.

Do not forget to acknowledge and give thanks to God, which is a continual recognition of His Omnipresence. When Jesus was doing His healings up and down the roads of ancient Palestine, we know He had too high a consciousness to be overly concerned with the adulation and praise of the multitude, but He evidently knew it was necessary for men to recognize the power of God manifesting in their lives and to acknowledge same by giving thanks. We remember Him saying, "Were there not ten cleansed? but where are the nine?" Only one gave thanks and acknowledged the great blessing received, and to him He said, "Arise, go thy way, thy faith hath made thee whole."

So many take their blessings or their healings as a matter of course. They go to a healer to solve their problem, or to help them to overcome some physical infirmity. If the demonstration is made quickly, they sometimes remember to acknowledge the help, but if the healing is gradual, as often happens to those who have long been disobeying the laws of Nature and have some chronic condition, they often fail to give either silent or verbal thanks to God or to the healer whose services they requested and who has faithfully worked for them. They dismiss it casually, assuming it came about naturally, and would have happened anyway.

When you go to God direct, or to a healer, expect your healing, be on the lookout for every little symptom of improvement, and give thanks both to God and to the one you have asked to work for you. Your faith will be strengthened, and so will the healer's who will work all the harder for you, knowing the healing has started, and will now go forward more rapidly through the combined faith.

"When two or more are met together (in consciousness) and of one accord (toward a given goal) it shall be done for them as they ask of our Father in Heaven."

We are told, "acknowledge Him in all thy ways and He will direct thy paths." Acknowledging God's immanence many times a day, keeps us in closer walk with Him, quickens our faith and keeps us under the protection and guidance of His Almighty Power.

"There is now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus," that is when we recognize the Indwelling Christ both in ourselves and others, guiding us ever toward the good.

# Help We Can Give Our Children

known as an expansion of consciousness or inner awareness. I had been studying world religions and philosophies for some years and Light from within came, proving to me the truth of the studies to which I had given much time. All the known characteristics of release from fear for the future, and a sense of joyous exaltation accompanied the experience. It was as though a house long dark had been lit by the turning of a switch.

I saw that the ills and problems of people individually and collectively were caused by ignorance of the great spiritual laws that I had been learning. With this insight came the desire to aid others to open their minds and hearts to the Reality that I had discovered and this was especially true for my son.

At first it was difficult for him to understand the significance of what I told him about my new and deeper understanding or why I should feel more in harmony with life. He was too young to read inspired books that had been helpful to me; too immature to get much from church services or lectures on metaphysics or philosophy. In giving thought to the ways and means of awakening his interest I struck upon the plan of cutting quotations from world famous men which appeared on a calendar each year. These noble thoughts we pasted on a large piece of cardboard so that he could keep them near his desk. I looked up books that would appeal to his imagination and that could show him that the power of Spirit could meet his boyhood problems, just as it could give answer to those of older people. There were not many, but through the ones that were available he began to see that he could be helped to do his best in his studies and on the athletic field through prayer and the practice of silence, permitting "the still small voice" to speak to him.

It was helpful to our relationship to explain to him that in trying to progress I was desirous of discovering and overcom-

ing my own weaknesses and limitations; that I would be grateful to have him tell me lovingly when he saw me make mistakes or felt that I was inconsistent. We decided to tell each other so that I would not be alone in correcting him. This system of mutual aid was most constructive and he was quick to discern my failures.

As the months went by the thought came to me to use every annoying situation that he had to face to show him that he could receive a solution under Divine Will, and that he could be given his part in it under Higher intuition if he sought it. Over a period of years, slowly he saw the Great Law work in his own experience and grasped the value of seeking the spiritual course instead of relying simply upon human judgment.

When his friends were beset with troubles I tried to analyze the reasons for him, in the light of wisdom's teaching, and point out to the best of my ability why they were having to face such problems. At times I failed dismally by giving him a sense of pressure and coercion. Without fail at such moments he would become resentful and rightly so. It would sometimes take months of waiting before his mind opened again to be willing to talk about any of it.

At one time he took a violent dislike to a teaching that had been of help to me. It was hard not to try to convince him of its merits and benefits, but something prompted me to drop the whole subject and help him to see the values in other methods. After all the objective of all metaphysical and spiritual teaching is the same. I realized that it is wrong to force anyone into any channel, and felt that if I were really to lead I could find the approach that appealed to his mind.

This happened, and as a result he himself has experienced the inner awakening of mind and heart which I had wished for him. He has become a source of strength to his own friends and has also given inspiration to many acquaintances who have been confused and bewildered. He has found himself, and has discovered step by step the work that he has been meant to do.

When a boy begins to receive inner direction he can stand alone and live life on an effective basis, and have a beneficial influence as well upon others whose lives he touches. Is this not the answer to what youth can give in leadership to people, and later to the country? Our youth today are the leaders of tomorrow. In their hands will lie the progress of the reconstruction after-war period. Is it not important to help them to

be strong and well equipped to fulfill their responsibilities? We parents can give them only what we have ourselves, so that the challenge to us is to find those answers within our own hearts and lives, that will enable us to make contagious the understanding that we are trying to impart to them. Only the vitality of our own conviction can fire our children to seek, after which development their growth and vision may far surpass our own. They may evolve in ways that we know not of, and attain knowledge beyond our horizons of awareness.

But in the beginning we can give them no more than we possess. To learn how to do that has been an experience for which I am deeply grateful. The capacities and abilities of youth can reach new heights of progress during the years ahead if we parents can articulate for them the highest that we know now. Through our effort they can be enabled to live and expand old Truths to ever greater practicability and usefulness.

# Applying the Resurrection

Aul was a master worker in the invisible. Ever since the day when on that memorable journey to D light shone round about him and he had heard the voice of Jesus whom he knew had been crucified, calling him into his service he walked amid miracles and went everywhere preaching Jesus and the resurrection with signs following.

To him, as to all thinking men, the resurrection of Jesus was the supreme fact in human history. After his great awakening life was full of a new meaning. He now saw all things in the light of the resurrection. Death was swallowed up in victory. Henceforth he felt the leaven of the resurrection working in his own soul bringing life and immortality to light and giving him power to deal effectively with every earthly condition. He knew that the power of the resurrection was a principle in God, in nature and in man.

While the power of the resurrection breathes through all of his writings, in no place does he apply it more significantly than in the words chosen for our text:

"But if the Spirit of him who raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you."

In all the years of my healing ministry I have found nothing more effective for bringing God's healing power into manifestation than the use of these words.

They who meditate upon them day and night until their mystic glory is revealed will reach that place of power where their words bring resurrection to all who come to them for help.

Marvelous to know that when the vision of God is upon us we can think of persons in any part of the world and repeat such a passage as our text and they will feel its healing power. Better still to know a secret that was given me by a wise teacher: "Words born of a high soul consciousness will awaken in whoever repeats them in prayerful meditation, the consciousness from which they sprang."

Jesus always identified himself with life. "I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly." Living in the consciousness of resurrection his words brought resurrection and still bring resurrection. When any baffling problem confronts you, if you simply relax, breathe deeply and realize "the healing power of the resurrection is now working freely in my mind and body" you will soon feel a peace that brings enlightenment and a health that has foundations whose builder and maker is God.

A very beautiful case of spiritual healing through the use of the 23rd Psalm was recently told in our Tuesday healing meeting by one of our consecrated women. I will give it in her own words.

"Seven years ago I was stricken with arthritis. From being a strong, active woman, I was, in a few weeks, unable to walk without help and so low in mind and body as not to care what happened.

Doctors agreed that there was little hope of recovery. One predicted that in six months I would be bed-ridden, if alive at all; another that my memory, already faulty, might fail entirely. It is a fearsome thing to be unable to recall even your own name without tremendous effort.

The old cry of infection was raised. A major operation fol-

lowed, not with the hope of restoration of the destroyed surfaces of the knee joints, but in hope of checking the disease.

Things seemed to grow worse instead of better. I need not list all of the misery. Pain was intense and but for the tender, compassionate love of my family, I doubt if I could have lived through it. Now looking back, I know that it was worth all to realize such depth of self-sacrificing love.

A Unity student offered me books but, almost rudely, I told her no. I think she must have prayed for me anyway because on that night—the worst night of my life, and the best—I found myself repeating the Twenty-third Psalm. Instantly the pain stopped. The glad realization came to me that if pain could be stopped by the Psalm then by the same means I could regain health.

Day and night I repeated the words till my very body took up the rhythm. In a few weeks I was able to creep down into the sunny garden. And Oh, the glad day when I walked to a friend's house a block away. Now five miles do not daunt me.

Several people whom I know and some whom I have never even met have been helped through hearing this experience. and using the 23rd Psalm in this way. Mr. Morgan's "Healing Waters" has since been of great help to me in washing away troubles.

In analyzing my own case and that of others I am convinced that the condition called arthritis is often brought on by a damming up of the emotions and by stored resentment. As soon as we open ourselves to love the idea causing the condition is washed away and healing takes place."

A very important principle is involved in this testimony. After the Unity student's offer had been refused our friend says, "I believe she prayed for me anyway for that very night I found myself repeating the 23rd Psalm." This reveals the open door which no man can shut. The Unity student could not treat the lady without her consent but she could pray for her and the Spirit answered by revealing the healing message in the 23rd Psalm.

Blessed to know that we not only can but should pray for all men in all places with or without their consent just as I am praying now that all who ever will read this lesson may have an awakening that will lift them above the clouds of sense into the glorious liberty of the children of God.

# Death-Doorway to Larger Life

And that the dead are raised has been indicated by Moses in the passage on the Bush, when he calls the Lord "God of Abraham, and God of Isaac, and God of Jacob." God is not a God of dead people, but of the living, for all live to Him.—Luke 20:37 (Moffatt's trans.)

Conan Doyle, famed for his Sherlock Holmes stories, addressing a gathering of 8,000 people in England, asked those to stand who had contacted departed loved ones killed on the war fronts, and about 6.000 stood up.

THAT peace of mind and solace has come to thousands of mothers and fathers, relatives and friends, to be assured that their loved ones were alive and that they would

see them again.

In almost every instance where contact has been made, advice has come from the departed not to grieve or sorrow, but to turn to the tasks of life with joy, and to take advantage of the wonderful opportunities life offers here on this plane for soul growth.

Occasionally we see notices in the papers requesting that there be no mourning. This is one of the signs of the new enlightenment. The death of Ellen Terry, and others, has made a deep impression on many minds, for she requested that no one come to her funeral sad or wearing black. Her request was observed, and all came dressed as if to attend a garden party or other social function.

The wearing of black has come down to us from pagan times and many because of tradition or precedent wear this robe of gloom for a long period. Often if this or other customs are not in some degree respected, one is accused of being unsympathetic or heartless.

The Chinese and Japanese are wiser than we in this respect, for they wear white, and one of the striking things at the interment of the last Mikado, was the white mourning robes worn

by the priests and populace in the procession.

The wearing of black has an unwholesome effect not only upon the wearer, but upon others. Color-therapeutists tell us that black is depressing to the spirit, and should never be worn, especially not by the young. It is the emblem of hopelessness, despair, death, and was used by pirates for their flag.

All who mourn or grieve create an atmosphere about them that has an unwholesome effect upon other members of the family and particularly on children who are in their most im-

pressionable years.

The study of mind and mental influences shows that our thoughts are constantly bombarding the atmosphere about us with radioactive particles which carry the quality of our thinking. If our thoughts are melancholy or gloomy, the atmosphere about us is charged with morbid vibrations. If our thoughts are bright, cheerful, happy, the atmosphere is redolent with light and healing influences that make for health, happiness and general well-being. A person with a radiant aura is surely a blessing to all who come into his presence.

And why should we give so much attention to this house of clay which after all is only a temporary dwelling place for the ego or soul to function in to expand faculties and unfold latent powers. The soul is native to Eternal Spheres, realms of benediction, and its short stay here is only a sojourn on

foreign soil.

Doctors and ministers who realize the harmful effects of grief are advising the bereaved not to dwell upon their loss, but to enter into the joy of living, make new friends, attend social functions; take interest in civic improvements, engage in some kind of useful service; go to the movies, play games, anything that will divert their minds from the cause of grief. This advice is in exact agreement with what the departed always recommend. The last thing they desire is that we mourn for them. They have entered into a larger life, into a new joy and happiness with greater opportunities for growth and creative service, and they desire that we do the same here.

Cremation is universally practised by the Hindus and the idea came to them from the original Brahmins in an age of great enlightenment. It is recommended by all higher intelligences as the simplest, least costly, and most sanitary means of disposing of the discarded form—the worn-out or outgrown garment of the soul.

A great deal of attention and money is still lavished on cemeteries, and huge sums spent on tombstones, monuments and mausoleums. In some cemeteries repose family mausoleums that cost hundreds of thousands of dollars. What waste follows in the path of ignorance? What a vast amount of good this money spent on the dead could do for the living. Many

of the wealthy after passing out, are pained and distressed when they see how they squandered large sums of money on self and show that could have brought immense good to large numbers of the human family- if spent usefully and benevolently.

A woman we are acquainted with, formerly prominent in high social circles, who lived a sort of butterfly existence, one day received word that her son had committed suicide. He had been the apple of her eye, and his death was a staggering blow to her from which she could not easily rally. The light seemed to go out of her life. One day, as sometimes happens under right conditions, he appeared to her in her house and conversed with her at length, enlightening her mind on many subjects, and opening up to her new and unsuspected vistas of life, a life of beauty, hope, new vision and service. One thing he advised her to do was to read and study Truth literature and since then she had read over five hundred books on New Thought and kindred subjects.

The Tyrolese have a saying which is very true, "For every man God has His plan."

When one seeks God with an open mind, light and more light filters through to the consciousness and gradually all doubts are cleared away in the new understanding. He sees with an illumined vision. In this elevated consciousness he knows and expresses more and more of the Divine attributes—joy, health, peace, poise, power, beauty, love, wisdom.

What a man manifests while encased in this house of clay is only a fraction of his larger Self. He has dormant powers that he little realizes he possesses, until death liberates him. His larger self—the soul or super-conscious—can be brought into realization here to a large extent through intensive training, but men are so engaged in material pursuits, money making, that little attention is given to the spiritual life and the eternal verities.

When one incarnates into earth-life his soul goes into a sort of semi-sleep, not remembering the plane it came from or its past experiences through many stages of unfoldment. The process is akin to that experience each night when we fall asleep, forgetting all until we awaken again to a new day. A life-time here is only a day to the soul.

Lord Tennyson who is considered to have had cosmic consciousness (awakening to some degree of the soul consciousness while in the body) beautifully expresses this process in the following lines:

Our birth is but a sleep and a forgetting;
The soul that rises with us, our life's star,
Hath had elsewhere its setting,
And cometh from afar.
Not in entire forgetfulness,
And not in utter nakedness,
But trailing clouds of glory, do we come
From God, who is our home.

# The Ninety-first Psalm

of consolation and protection, to millions through the centuries. It is called the Psalm of protection. The first two verses contain the keys to its fulfillment. Repeating this Psalm over and over again brings one gradually to the realization of the Secret Place of the Most High. God lives in calmness and peace, and to get its great lesson, meditate upon this Psalm in quietness and confidence. "Be still and know that I am God." As we repeat this psalm we get rid of worry and fear, and build up a faith in God's enfolding Presence. This puts us in a receptive attitude to receive, to be impressed and inspired.

It has been the experience of thousands on the Battle fronts who memorized this Psalm and used it as a prayer, to be saved from dangers and death. Something always happened to shift them out of the danger zone or protect them in some way. God has a thousand ways to help one in any need.

A couple of years ago a man from Canada who had been a member of our Blessing League for several years called to see us. He told us of the wonderful protection he had had in the last world-war, which he attributed to the constant repetition of the Ninety-first and the One Hundred and Twenty-first Psalms, which he had memorized and used as prayers during his duty at the battle fronts. The following is taken from one of his recent letters:

"In regard to my experience in the last war with the Ninetyfirst Psalm, I am very glad to relate it again to you. I was in the Mechanical Transport of the Canadian Army, and on the night of May 21st, 1918, we parked our lorries close to a battery of Royal Horse Artillery, and whether the Germans were out to get the artillery or the transport column is hard to say. Anyway, they sent over bombing planes and one dropped two bombs close to us, about ten feet apart and twenty feet from my lorry. Both my mate and myself were sleeping in the lorry, that is to say, we were lying down. You could not sleep with the terrible battle going on outside, with bombs dropping and machine guns and anti-aircraft guns blazing. I admit I was very much afraid, as it is always worse when you are trying to rest and not carrying out your regular duties. When you are on duty you are keyed to carrying out your duties no matter what happens. I was repeating the Ninetyfirst Psalm and had just reached the verse:

'Thou shalt not fear for the terror by night 'Nor for the arrow that flieth by day,'

when the bombs fell. I was lifted up by the blast of the explosion and fell back unhurt into the lorry, the upper part of which was blown to smithereens. A metal cup that was on a shelf just behind my head, was found underneath me afterwards driven into the woodwork the full length of its side. I still have the battered metal cup, and how that cup could have received such a force as to drive it into the woodwork and me not receive a scratch was truly miraculous. No one was hurt either in my lorry or the one next to it, which was also riddled with shrapnel. The craters made by these bombs were fifteen feet in diameter and seven feet deep, so you can imagine how terrific the explosion was. I used the Ninety-first and the One Hundred and Twenty-first Psalms continually while I was at the front, and I noticed in driving on roads under shell fire that the shells nearly always exploded just ahead of me or behind me after I had passed on."-A. M. Stewart.

Mr. Stewart also sent a small booklet entitled, "Prayer, and The Terror by Night," which was written by Lieut. Frank Lee, R. N. V. R., while he was commanding one of His Majesty's submarine chasers in the Mediterranean. The boat was at the dock at Valetta, Malta, having come in from patrol for a much-needed re-fit. Half the crew were on shore leave. Mr. Lee was strolling the deck when his hand came in contact with a letter he had received in the last mail from his mother in Canada. He took it out and read again: "My son, I want you to promise me that you will read the Ninety-first Psalm every day, and especially that part, 'Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night nor for the arrow that flieth by day.' And also where it says, 'He shall give His angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways.' And, remember, son, I am praying for you continually, and I know that His promises will be kept."

He put the letter back in his pocket and went down the ward-room hatch to his cabin and got out his Bible. He turned to the Ninety-first Psalm and read it slowly, thoughtfully, pondering the passage, "Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night." He thought of the grim floating mines with their sensitive fingers, and the deadly torpedoes that struck without warning. He read on, "He shall give His angels charge over thee." Angels! Divine messengers from God to men. "Angels and mother's prayers, what could they not bring?"

His meditation was suddenly broken by the commotion of someone coming hastily down the ladder, who had a message from the commander. "Prepare to proceed to sea at once; I shall go with you." Lieut. Lee suddenly realized he had only half his crew and a disabled engine. The commander came aboard with a strained look and said. "Another troop ship sunk." They cleared the harbor and started toward their destination with all speed possible. As they approached the scene they could see through their binoculars the sea strewn with dark objects and small boats and rafts, all that remained of the grim tragedy. They were in the danger zone now. For some reason his mother's words came to him, "Remember, son, I am praying for you continually." Suddenly something told him to go forward without delay. "The urge was as distinct and imperative as though the commander had spoken. He rushed to the bow, and there directly in the path of the boat was a floating mine, its curved surface breaking the water. They were rushing upon it with reckless speed. It seemed as if it were only a matter of seconds when the boat would strike it and send them into eternity.

"I wheeled, took a single step and stopped. I knew I could

never make the wheel house. Clapping my hands to a megaphone I shouted, 'Hard astarboard! Full speed astern.'

"Would the coxswain understand? Could the chief, working alone, reach both engines in time? Would that patched starboard engine catch? Only God knew the answer.

"I saw the coxswain give the wheel a superhuman twist. The ship lurched to starboard. Over my shoulder I saw the barrel-shaped menace, its black prongs of destruction now discernible almost beneath our bows. I closed my eyes. Then the engines went into reverse, first the starboard, and an instant later the port. The ship shuddered from stem to stern and writhed as if in deadly pain. I was thrown to the deck, and my head crashed against a stanchion. A sailor helped me to my feet. As my head cleared, still dazed, I looked over the side. There it was only a few feet away, bobbing harmlessly on the sea. We backed up a bit, and gave the gunner his chance. The first shot did it, and the ugly mine sank beneath the waves."

On a small card containing the Ninety-first Psalm, sent out by The Truth Center of San Jose, Calif.,\* under the title "Protection for Soldiers," are the following words:

F. L. Rawson, noted engineer, in his book, "Life Understood," gives an account of a British regiment under command of Col. Whittlesey, which served in the World War for more than four years without losing a man. This unparalleled record was made possible by means of active cooperation of all the officers and men in memorizing and repeating regularly the words of the Ninety-first Psalm.

Ponce de Leon braved the dangers and hardships of a long ocean voyage to get to a fountain whose waters were reputed

to restore youth to old age. He returned disappointed.

Christ the great miracle-worker ever looked within. "The Father that dwelleth in Me, He doeth the works." "I and the Father are one." "He that believeth on Me (lives my teachings) out of his heart shall flow Rivers of Living Water."

Christ also stated, "Behold, the Kingdom of Heaven is within you," not in the distant skies. The Kingdom is where God dwells, and God dwells everywhere. "In Him we live and move and have our being." The Kingdom of God is a perfect Kingdom where health, peace, joy, love, vitality, beauty, all goodness and loveliness abound, and these things manifest more and more as we find the Kingdom within. "Seek first the Kingdom of Heaven and its righteousness and all these things shall be added unto you."

There are many places on earth where healing is done.
