M., 30th—Moon square Mercury and Saturn, trine Mars. The tendency of the first two aspects is towards nervousness and irritability, but the good aspect of Mars gives opportunity to direct excessive mental activity to practical means and results. Moon in Aquarius.

T., 31st—Moon square to Jupiter. Be not hasty to judge or jump at conclusions, as your reasoning is apt to err today. Avoid risky financial matters. Choose the planetary hours of Venus for important affairs today. Moon enters Pisces at 10:10 P. M.

"MEDITATION"

The time given for Moon's entry into the different zodiacal signs in the foregoing chapter is the Pacific Standard time. Rocky Mountain time is one hour in advance; Central time two hours; Eastern time three hours; Inter-Colonial time four hours, and Greenwich time eight hours in advance.

The words quoted in capital letters at the end of each date have been carefully selected as watch words for concentration by those who are seeking to develop self-control or other desirable victories. # Lunation 9:29 A. M., Washington, D. C., Mean Time.

At moment of conjunction the sign Scorpio is ascending with Jupiter in first house applying to an opposition with Saturn, who is posited in the seventh space. A concerted movement, by capitalists and those who are opposed to the interests of the common people, will take place to depress general conditions, especially as regards labor. Relations with foreign powers will be deceptive, disappointing and fraught with delays.

Uranus in third house denotes considerable travel and the usual catastrophies occasioned thereby. The science of aerial navigation will progress much more rapidly when Uranus is no longer afflicted by the opposition of Neptune, a delusive influence which prevents the real vital principles to be discovered. After the opposition is past they will be found and applied with successful results of practical utility. At present aviators would do well to remain on the ground on those days when the Moon afflicts Uranus.

Mars, ruler of the ascendant and also ruler of the sixth house, posited in the eighth, denotes much sickness affecting head, lungs and bladder. The rate of mortality will be high.

Neptune in ninth house denotes disasters at sea and religious and scientific dissentions, but psychical interests will be advanced.

Venus and Mercury in the midheaven are favorable influences for our President and tend to favor the people in minor ways.

The luminaries in eleventh house semi-square to Jupiter in ascendant indicate some adverse moves on the part of legislators with disagreements and possibly deaths.

# AN ANNULAR ECLIPSE OF THE SUN OCTOBER 22, 1911.

At 4:09 A. M. Greenwich mean time the Sun is eclipsed in the twenty-seventh degree of Libra. This eclipse is ominous because it follows so closely after an opposition of Jupiter to Saturn (four days) and also because Sun is conjunction Mercury and just beginning to leave a square of Uranus.

The eclipse begins at 74 degrees 42 minutes east longitude and latitude 38 degrees 4 minutes north, and ends on the earth generally at 7:06 A. M. in longitude east 162 degrees 21 minutes, latitude south 14 degrees 38 minutes. This eclipse is invisible to us, but the line of central eclipse will begin in Southern Pacific Ocean and will run through New Guinea, Borneo, the China Sea, Thibet and Persia, where it will produce various disastrous events, among which are epidemics, volcanic eruptions and seismic disturbances. Charlestown, Puerto Rico, Austria and Japan will also be affected.

The opposition of Jupiter and Saturn will cause stormy and wet weather generally. It brings contest between the great and lowly and detriment to estate of the rich.

In 93 degrees west longitude Saturn will be on nadir,

producing seismic disturbance in the Central States of America, Texas and Isthmus of Tehauntepec, while it will be rising at the Canaries and Maderia, denoting volcanic eruptions. Saturn culminates at Bengal.



PREDICTIONS.

The odd numbered signs of the zodiac, l. e., Aries, Gemini, Leo, Libra, Sagittarius and Aquarius, govern the left side of body in a male horoscope and the right side in a female nativity. Conversely with the even numbered signs.

For instance, in a female's natus we find Saturn in Gemini afflicted in third house (Oriental, and therefore denoting accidents), and the lady has broken her right arm on one occasion and injured it on several others, and has also injured the lower limbs (Saturn's domain).

Thus, in a chart like this, with the above rule in mind, it is easy to predict first: accidents; second, to arm and knee; third, on right side of body. Hereby, also, is shown that Astrology is not an unholy proceedings, nor is it guess work, but its predictions, of whatever nature, are legitimately based upon deductions derived from regular mathematical and astronomical calculations.

This any one, who understands the least of the science will say is enough, for there are records of all ages to testify that such an aspect could not be expected to pass by without leaving behind it many fresh examples of its fatality, and a forewarning which portends death, or indeed accidental mischance, should not be tempted on any consideration by those who embark in aerial expeditions.

The reason I give of the life of his fair companion

having been so wonderfully preserved is that Venus,<sup>†</sup> Georgium Sidus (Uranus) and Mars, being mutually in trine with one another, was a most lucky aspect for her, as a female, and foreshowed her recovery.<sup>\*</sup>

\*At the time Mr. Harris ascended in his balloon, May 25, 1824, four hours, nine minutes P. M., the sign Libra arose in the horizon, and Saturn was in the house of death, with Venus, lady of the Ascendant, and significator of the aeronaut, applying to the fatal conjunction of this baneful star, who also ruled the fourth house, and this plainly showed the fatal conclusion which took place.

[<sup>†</sup>The older books on Astrology assigned Saturn as ruler of the sign Aquarius as well as of Capricorn, but in modern Astrology we give the planet Uranus to Aquarius, which ruled cusp of fourth house at above time, and, while we arrive at the same final judgment as the former author we do so in a different manner. towit: Venus, ruler of ascendant, is applying to conjunction with cusp of house of death; the cusp is afflicted on its other side by the proximity of Saturn, and as Uranus, ruler of the end of the matter is in the house of aerial navigation (third house) conjunction Neptune and opposition Jupiter, it signifies a disastrous ending with death to the aeronaut. That his partner in the enterprise was so miraculously saved is because Mars, ruler of seventh, is in its own "terms" in the sign Virgo and applying closely to a trine with Saturn and furthermore because the seventh house was graced by the presence of the Moon therein in semisextile to Saturn and quintile to Jupiter.]

# ANSWERS TO CORRESPONDENTS.

Q. Should a similar addition be made in the case of "time when Luna will enter each sign?"

Ans. The tables of "Moon's Place in the Zodiac," "Moon's Phases" and "Sun's Entry" as given in the "Planetary Daily Guide" each year are useful for any part of the world, if due allowance in time is given by the readers in various places. The tables are made for "Pacific Standard Time" (120th meridian). For every degree of terrestial longitude east of the 120th meridian add four minutes to the clock time; thus New York City would be three hours in advance, as it is 45 degrees east; Calcutta is 208 degrees east of the 120th meridian, consequently time there is 13 hours 52 minutes later or in advance of Pacific time.

To places west of the 120th meridian four minutes of time should be subtracted for each degree of longitude west, as thus, as Honolulu is 38 degrees west of the 120th meridian time there is two hours and 32 minutes earlier, slower or less than Pacific time.

The reason for using the 120th meridian particularly

is that a very large number of our subscribers live adjacent thereto and it is just as easy to make calculations from this as any other meridian.

American dealers who import books have to pay this duty upon their arrival and consequently must add it in their advertised price. English publishers do not make allowance for this in their advertisements, consequently their prices seem to be the lowest, while in reality they are not, for if the customer sends to Europe he must purchase a money order, pay postage on if, wait five or six weeks for book, and then go to the customs house and pay duty at rate of 25 per cent valuation; whereas, if he purchases direct from an American dealer, this trouble and time is saved and the ultimate cost is the same.

We prepay postage and customs duty on everything ordered of us, unless otherwise stated.


