Scientology: The Way to a Better Society

The degree to which an individual is withdrawn from the society or driven away from the game is the degree to which he will do evil.

If we get a bright child that wants to play with a doll, and we drive the child away from playing with the doll, then the child starts to break the doll. And then if we drive the child a little bit further away from breaking the doll, the child after a while messes half-heartedly with the doll. And if given any opportunity at all, the child would simply wind up the doll and let it run from there on and sit back bored in the corner, not caring what happened to the doll. Do you see that this could happen?

Well, the beingness and livingness of Man not only can do but does do just this. The degree to which he is driven out of the game is the degree to which he and his society are dying. And when we have a whole society that's no longer willing to work, when we have a whole society where the people in it have been forbidden to contribute to its existence and continuance, we have a society that doesn't function

very well.

LIVINGNESS AND THE MACHINE

The machine starts running and the man stops living to the degree that he doesn't want to live and that he doesn't care. It's a fascinating thing, horrible to contemplate. He becomes more and more an electronic brain or a clock and less and less of the livingness. Livingness itself works along with the machine.

The electronic brain boys and I get along fine, except we have this one point of horrible

Love, RON argument. I'm always pointing out to them that although their computers will answer all kinds of questions, they have this slight liability: they can't feed themselves the questions to answer.

I keep pointing out to them, "You are standing there feeding the questions to it. You wrote it down on the punched tape, and it was fed to the machine by a living being. And its answers are being read by you and me, and that machine is incapable of appreciating us."

And they say, "No no no, you've got the wrong idea. The machine thinks. It does everything necessary to think. And if you figure it out right, a bank of these machines could ask each other questions, and you'd have a society."

No, we would have to have a fellow to sit up there and hand out the questions to all of these computing machines. Somebody would have to run this thing. It's less and less self-determined. It's less and less successful. The society will win which has in itself the most self-determinism, and that society will lose which has in itself the least

GOOD AND EVIL

We could say that as an individual grows older in a society which isn't functioning very well, he would be driven further and further from his actual abilities, from caring, from participating. He can get back to a point where he doesn't care really whether he lives or dies. And when he gets back to that point, then he does good or evil — it doesn't matter. He's just running an electronic brain. He as an individual is no less alive, no less dead, but he as an individual just doesn't care. He doesn't even care whether he knows about it or not.

What's the end product of all this? A stimulusresponse mechanism would have no responsibility for the state of its fellow man, would it? That electronic brain doesn't care who feeds it what. It has no idea who feeds it what. It simply goes round and round, giving out the answers to anybody.

Somebody can come along and put a big sign on it that says, "Security. You will not give any more answers to the Russians when they walk in and feed them to you." Russian walks in, it answers. Somebody comes in and says, "Machine, you shouldn't have done that." POW! The machine doesn't run. Somebody says, "Well, it was a traitor."


That's what would happen if you had a total stimulus-response mechanism. You'd have something without any choice, without any criteria, with no idea of right and wrong, or good and evil, and with no idea of caring whether it lived or not. And you'd have a machine all right. And that machine would be very adequate. It would do good or evil as life interpreted it, and no more. It would have no morals, no ethics, nothing.

And so, we can get an automatic society if we've driven out of it the willingness to work, the willingness to participate and the willingness to play a game. A society is actually, whichever way you want to look at it, good or evil, and reflects and mirrors any master that is good or evil, to the degree that no one is playing the game

WILLINGNESS TO PARTICIPATE

All we have to do is get this livingness, this beingness, to look a little harder, care a little more and be willing to participate a little further. He gets brighter, he gets better, he gets more capable. And not only that, but his motives get better and better and better. How could his motives get otherwise, since his motives, natively, are very good motives? It's only the machine motives that are bad.

When he's totally alive, when the individual really does care, as in a moment of emergency such as we've seen a few of in our lifetimes, the whole guy is there. He's interested, all the way. And he does everything that he's doing without any recourse to machinery. House burns up, there's a grand piano in the living room. A couple of kids grab it and put it out on the front lawn. The fire is put out, and it takes five men from the moving company to put it back. Did you ever hear of things like this?

The totality of presence brings about almost the totality of action, and it doesn't depend on machinery because machinery can't run that fast. An examination of the stimulus-response mechanism shows that it has too slow a reaction time. It has interestingly long communication lags, when one is running on that machine. A being all there doesn't have any.

So the more he participates with the game, the better the game gets.

Delete from the society its willingness to participate and its willingness to work and you've killed the society. That's all you have to do. There aren't even dead bodies lying around. They're animated, they've got chains on their ankles. They're working. Or are they? They don't care.

THE ONLY RICHES

The only riches which one has amongst a working people is the willingness to work. And when one's killed that, he's killed all there

The goodness and beingness of Man actually is his livingness and beingness, is himself, is you sitting right where you are on some gradient of caring or being willing to live.

So therefore one actually can't make people worse than they are. The person just backs off into status quo, cares that much less. The whole thing goes on automatic, and there it sits, running. It's a clock. It doesn't care what happens to you. It doesn't care what happens to me or to itself. People can be driven off just this much because if you drive them off any further than

that they simply die.

You could take shock, pain, duress, the whip, punishment, fear, and all it does is drive the man back off so that he cares less and the whole thing goes on automatic and becomes a machine.


And then we have a great machine society that doesn't care whether it lives or dies, simply goes on with its cog wheels running, without morals, without ethics, without goals or ambitions. And such a society then, as a totality,

All we've got to do in working with somebody is just show him that it's safe, that it's decent, that it's good and that it's worthwhile to participate in this game. And his abilities rise right straight up to the zenith. We haven't put anything new there. We have just said, "Look, you too can play this game." The individual says, "Well, a lot of people have been telling me I haven't been able to play this game. They've been telling me I couldn't play this game. They've been telling me the one thing I mustn't do is play this game.3

And you say, "They were wrong. Come on, play the game." The fellow says, "Well, all right. Okay. Maybe I can."

Now all of a sudden he's brighter, better and more able. He finds out mysteriously enough, that regardless of what he thought, regardless of what he was educated to believe, nine times out of ten there wasn't any game in progress. It wasn't really bad or good. And when he comes in to participate he finds, in any society running on automatic, that he has to originate a new game, not by revolution, but by injecting new thinkingness, new beingness, new livingness, new loyalty into the game. And only in that way can he make a game that he's willing to play.





Thoughtful of Others: Scientologists Work Toward a Better Society

The Association of Scientologists for Reform, a non-profit organization separate from the Church itself, sponsors reform groups in many areas where concerned Scientologists can put their creed to

work. Thoughtful of others and sensitive to suppression and abusive conditions in any form, Scientologists have moved out into reform fields all over the world.

Reduced Crime

According to a July 1975 Gallup poll, crime is the number one worry in the

About 70% of all crime in this country is committed by repeat offenders. The FBI estimates that 85% of those released from jails, prisons and reform schools wind up back shortly in a similiar institu-

Out of a growing awareness and concern about rising crime, the Committee to Re-Involve Ex-Offenders (CREO) was formed to get at the root of the crime problem: our current system does not rehabilitiate or correct criminals.

By investigation of just what WAS going on in the prisons, CREO brought

the following to light:

1. Training to bring the criminal back into society as a productive individual is grossly inadequate. In California state prisons, only 25% of prisoners are in-

volved in a training program. 34% work in some way in correctional industry or maintenance. 35% are idle. Worse, of those taking vocational training, six months after release only 15% were found employed.

2. The use of mind-affecting drugs by prison psychiatrists is widespread. This is all the more alarming considering drug abuse is second only to robbery in frequency of offense! Several cases have been reported where inmates were not allowed off drugs even at their own request. Nothing effective, either, is done to stop the flow of illicit drugs into state penitentiaries.

3. A lifestyle of violence is fostered in the prisons themselves. Violence in prisons is increasing even more rapidly

than violence in the street. 4. Use of prisoners as guinea pigs further reduces their self-respect and exposes them to possible permanent damage. According to recent FDA statistics, 90% of new drugs are first tested on prison inmates. "Prisoners make much better subjects than chimpanzees and they are a lot cheaper," said one doctor. Due to the meager amounts of money convicts are given, even very small incentives are enough to induce the prisoner to participate in experiments which have unknown and often danger-

CREO is working around the country to orient our current system toward rehabilitating the prisoner, not just incarcerating him. CREO urges vocational training be used to give the offender something productive he can do when he returns to society.

CREO has stressed that education is also needed to help the offender understand the society in which he is seeking to survive. Effective personal counseling and drug rehabilitation programs are needed to stop the revolving door of prison-release-return to prison.

CREO has called for an end of use of mind-affecting drugs which only lessen the prisoner's ability to cope with the outside world and do not handle the causes of the problems that got him into

A bill is now pending in the California legislature to stop human experimentation on prisoners. CREO members worked heavily with legislators on the proposal of this bill, which is a first step toward reducing crime by halting the process of degradation in today's prisons.

Sane Treatment for Mental Patients

The Citizens Commission on Human Rights (CCHR) was formed in 1969 by Rev. Kenneth Whitman and attorney John J. Matonis, to free a 35 year old Hungarian refugee from Haverford State Hospital in Pennsylvania. The refugee, Victor Gyory, unable to speak English, was being given electro-convulsive therapy against his will. Securing his release led to further investigation into human experimentation, involuntary commitment, barbaric psychiatric treatments and the desperate need for reform in the mental health field.

Tours of mental hospitals conducted nationally by CCHR over the last 5 years have resulted in correction of unsanitary and illegal activities in New York and Missouri. In Massachusetts, legislation to ensure proper medical care for mental patients was filed after CCHR study of conditions in New England mental hospitals. In Austin and Houston, CCHR established a phone line where individuals can contact the commission

Earlier this year, testimony from CCHR prevented passage of a Hampshire bill which would have allowed children to receive psychiatric treatment without the knowledge or consent of

In Florida and Massachusetts, legislation has now been filed at the prompting of CCHR to eliminate involuntary commitment without due process of law. Also

in Massachusetts, a 10,000 citizen petition has been sent to the Governor calling for formation of an independent task force to investigate psychiatric abuses of over-drugging, electroshock and psychosurgery.

Over 100,000 signatures from U.S. citizens have been collected and presented to U.S. senators through CCHR activity, asking that Subchapter 36(B) of controversial Senate Bill 1, which would allow anyone to be incarcerated in a mental institution without a hearing or due process of law, be stricken from the bill

In their continuing struggle to bring a decent level of human rights to mental patients, a chapter of CCHR in South Africa recently exposed that privately owned mental institutions there had netted a cool \$10 million in 1975 from forcing state mental patients, most of them black, to live and work in slave labor camp conditions. "Patients" are committed, there by examination of a committed there by examination of a district surgeon, after being picked up for such reasons as "wandering at large," "acting abnormally" or "because of a

Concerned citizens, laymen and professionals alike, joined by a common respect for the rights and dignity of the individual, are working in CCHR to prevent abuses in the name of "mental health," so that those actually in need of help can be given sane assistance instead of damaging treatment or exploitation.

Caring About the Aged

What happens to the aged when they

can no longer care for themselves? Too often, their needs are neglected.

The Gerus Society and its New England branch, NEEDS (New England Elderly Demands Society), have been publishing the findings of their surveys of nursing homes and state hospitals.

The majority of nursing homes have very poor custodial care, it was found, and there exists a real need for proper medical, not psychiatric, care. An environment where the person is respected as an individual and given some chance for recreation and participation seemed to be the most successful, though rare, answer.

Overuse of psychiatric drugs for seda-tion with inadequate review of side effects was found to be especially prevalent. Hearings in L.A. County have also exposed "kickbacks" to nursing homes on drug prescriptions. Further, reports the Gerus Society, the President of the American Society of Consultant Phar-macists testified to a Senate Subcommittee that administration of medication is careless – the rate of medications administered in error is from 20-50%

Of nursing homes across the U.S. more than 60% do not meet federal standards which have been in the books since 1967 but not enforced.

Currently, little encouragement is given for returning patients to their homes in the community. The Gerus Society has called for dignity for the aged, and use of the vast resources the elderly represent so they can continue to contribute to society.

Local coordinator for the Los Angeles Gerus Society has been Jane Copley, Saint Hill Special Briefing Course graduate, a registered nurse who supervised an extended care unit for the elderly in Washington D.C. several years ago. She has recently returned to her home in Florida where she plans to take on the Florida chapter of the Gerus

Trustworthy Help for Alcoholics

More than 10 million Americans suffer from alcoholism, yet trustworthy help has not been available to many of those who seek it.

The National Alliance on Alcoholism Prevention and Treatment was formed when Scientologists began to uncover instances of alcoholics receiving highly abusive treatment in the name of mental

'Drugs, the Answer to Alcoholism?" a report recently released by the NAAPT reveals statistics and case histories that show the approach of substituting drugs for alcohol (95% of alcoholics seeking medical attention are treated with drugs) has failed miserably. "I was in worse shape than when I went in on the alcohol," writes one patient. "They don't tell you what the side effects are. When you're are those drugs you're not able to come on those drugs you're not able to cope with reality — the drugs were the worst influence I ever had on my life," writes

Alcoholism programs have not fared well under the control of Mental Health. According to the 1973-74 audit in California, the NAAPT revealed, of \$24 million state funds appropriated for alcoholism treatment to the Dept. of Health, only \$13 million were used and the remaining \$11 million were expended for non-related mental health programs.

In response to this startling disclosure, last October Gov. Brown of California signed into law Senate Bill 744, which removed monetary control of alcohol rehabilitation programs from domination by the mental health industry. One of the most vocal supporters of the bill was the NAAPT, who has strongly pointed out that the massive failure to cope with this problem on the part of the mental health system has resulted in serious increase in alcoholism in this country.

Amazed at how little most physicians were found to know about treatment for alcoholism, NAAPT has authored legislation to require medical students to devote a certain number of units to study of alcoholism.

After NAAPT investigation into New England hospital alcoholic wards, four bills were proposed prohibiting the use of shock and mind-altering drugs on alcoholics. Endorsed by the Boston City Council, both bills were filed in December 1975 in the Massachusetts State Legislature.

A recent survey of Los Angeles clergy NAAPT disclosed that 72% feel alcoholism is a spiritual affliction, and 52% feel individual counseling is the best means of handling it. Certainly such programs have consistently demonstrated better results than the life-destroying treatments alcoholics have received at the hands of psychiatry. The alcoholic and his family deserve treatment worthy of their trust when they seek help.

Dignity for the Retarded

After visiting facilities nationwide, the Task Force on Mental Retardation has documented abuses and formulated short and long range solutions to upgrade

Staff and parent complaints at facilities for the mentally retarded centered around results of psychiatric treatment, lack of real education to enable the mentally retarded to become productive members of society, lack of simple human rights, neglect and general lack of success.

In New England, the chapter director for the Task Force has been appointed to work with parents and Dept. of Mental Health personnel on a committee to re-write state rules and regulations for the mentally retarded.

The principal objective of the Task Force is to see that the mentally retarded are not treated as "mentally ill" and warehoused in institutions, but given the opportunity for a better life with dignity in special communities which would best suit their needs.

Responsible Health care

Why is it that while health costs are rising, quality of care in America continues to decline?

The Committee on Public Health and Safety (COPHS) was formed to collect data which would lead to an answer.

In New England, COPHS has been able on many occasions to present testimony to the Massachusetts legislature on the health care issue. Further investigation is underway by the Massachusetts State Health Care Committee on rising costs and declining service.

The Federal Trade Commission has asked COPHS to submit a report on the American Medical Association's involvement in this, which has been done. The FTC has also requested a submission from COPHS on possible Anti-Trust Law violations by the AMA.

A recent COPHS report traces the much talked about increase in malpractice cases to three main factors: doctors not keeping abreast of modern medical techniques; (2) many meritorious malpractice cases in the past going undetected and (3) a deterioration of the traditional doctor-patient relationship into "assembly line medicine" with less doctor time being spent with the patient than before.

The COPHS investigation also uncovered evidence of collusion in California between AMA societies and insurance companies to create a monopoly which has heavily contributed to skyrocketing malpractice insurance premiums.

COPHS has called for more responsible health care.

Real Justice for All

The National Commission on Law Enforcement and Social Justice (NCLE) was started with the purpose of investi-gating the practice of police organizations falsifying records and dossiers on citizens and circulating these false reports without giving the citizen a chance to obtain or correct them. NCLE has made interna-tional headline news recently by discover-ing the hidden NAZI history of the controversial police organization,

The two year study of Interpol by the NCLE resulted in 240 pages of documents linking Interpol to Nazi involvement and cooperation with communist countries. The release of this report has placed Interpol under the close scrutiny of five congressional investigations. Over 200,000 citizens recently signed a petition to have the U.S. withdraw membership in Interpol, and other countries are beginning to follow suit.

A bill has now been introduced to the U.S. House of Representatives which would require that any information on Americans kept overseas by Interpol be made available for re-call. Legislators in Massachusetts and California have proposed bills which would ban any cooperation with Interpol in those states.

The aim of NCLE is to bring about real justice for all, by preventing law enforcement systems from being used injustly to falsify information for the purpose of character assasination. In discovering the hidden story of Interpol, NCLE has also focused international attention on an autonomous intelligence network that poses a major threat to world peace.

Narconon programs inside prison walls have also been proven very effective at rehabilitation. An initial study in Delaware showed that 70% of those inmates who participated in Narconon remained free of further involvement with the judicial system upon release. In contrast, the prison's regular rate of recidivism is 65% – which means at best 35% stay out of jail normally.

Narconon is now recognized as the

official drug rehabilitation program in West Berlin. Narconon programs are also operating in Sweden, England and Canada, as well as the U.S.



The last five months have seen an average of one new Narconon opening each month. New community Narconon programs now exist in Minnesota, Arizona, Hawaii, New York and Massachusetts. New programs are currently being set up in Michigan, Illinois, Florida, Wyoming, and California (San Diego and Sacramento). A new prison program in Mexico has 50 inmates on the program with an enthusiastic 52 more signed up.

Writes one former addict: "When I came to Narconon in 1972 I had been using \$150 a day in heroin. I'd been addicted for 15 years. I'd taken my habit around the country with me and had tried several times to stop. But the

habit around the country with me and had tried several times to stop. But the 'cure' seemed as bad as the habit, in fact worse — attack therapy, the heavy Group encounter scene. So, I stayed an addict. It's been four years now since I came to Narconon and I haven't touched drugs. I have complete certainty that I can live without them. I'm a partner in a small business now and make a good living






