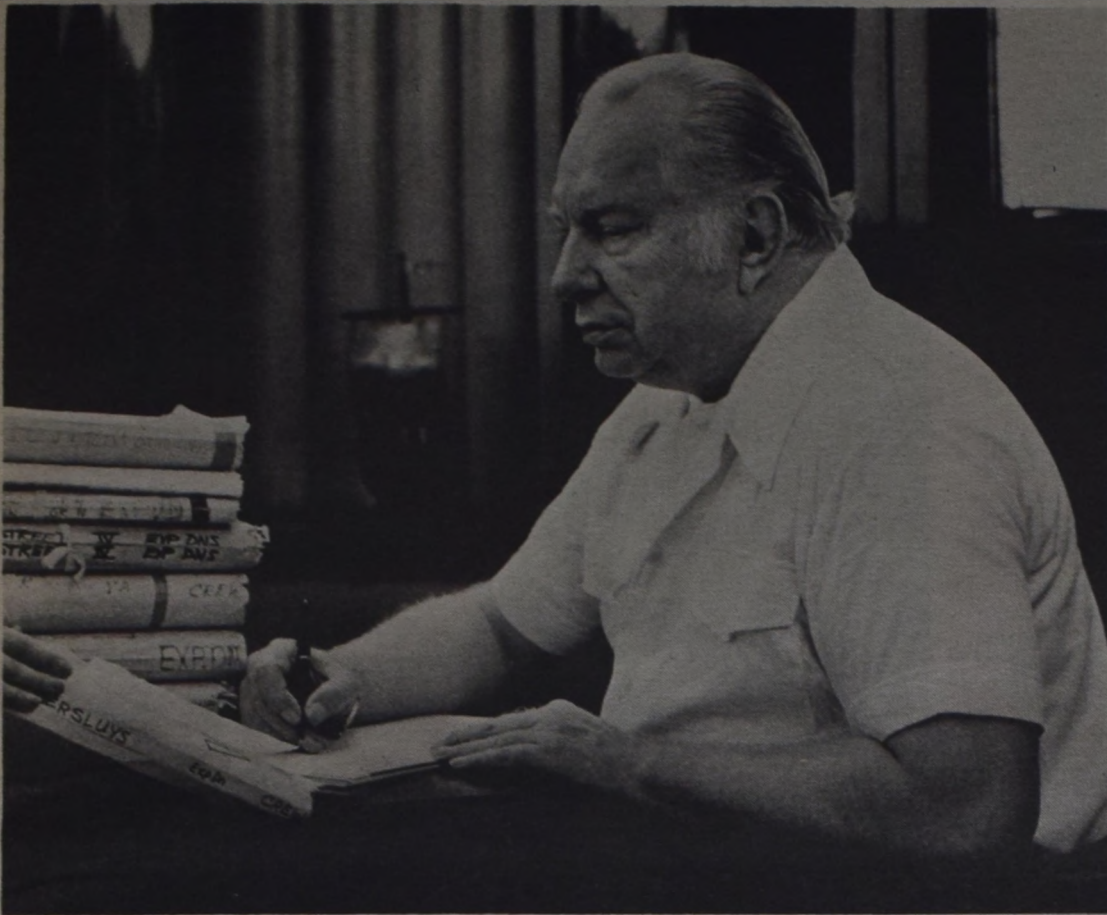

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Introduction to Standard Tech

The width of tolerance on standard tech probably couldn't be measured with an engineering micrometer. It is absolutely exactly hairline.

Now, what do you have to do, what do you have to be in order to run tech that close? You have to be the most screaming expert you ever heard of. You have to know all of the width and body of the Saint Hill Course, the research line, all the books; because that is a pathway. That is a roadway. And knowing all that, you know the total boundaries that tech can reach. Now in through that data is an absolutely hairline little knife-edge pass! And you have to know all of that to have a grip on where the path is, and exactly what you do.

Standard tech is so standard that you can practically drop a nickel in the auditor, and he runs off the session. You have to be pretty good, because look at the bait that is thrown to you all the time. All you do is consider these widely different cases as just bait on a hook, trying to get you to bite. "Everybody is so different." I'm afraid they're just about as different as the same spot of ink sitting on the same spot of ink.

The session control and self control which an auditor requires to actually go down that highway so he just runs the pc requires refusing all invitations to the bait, yet seeing that ARC isn't broken. And there is the way it is.

Now if the case proves to be a very resistive case, and they don't seem to be able to do anything with him, you will find out that we can't do anything to him only if he has already been subjected to the unusual. So standard tech has to include

cases which have been run very non-standardly.

Absolutely standard tech, complete utter *hairline* standard tech, used in organizations throughout the world, will at least triple the stats of each org within ninety days. Scientology is so much hotter than anybody thinks it is. That is fantastic! You don't have to take my say so, you'll find it out as you go along the line.

From this point on we have a very narrow track. And having an extremely narrow track that we can follow, we have to have confidence that it will give us gain. That confidence is born out of experience. It will give you the gains, and we have to have a uniform application of it. We have to be able to patch up every non-standard run case there is. That sounds like a tall order, but standard tech patches them up very easily.

You can only repair so many repairs and then you have to take the guy who has been fixing it up so that repairing repairs has to be done, and get him grooved up so that when he is put to repairing something with a perfectly valid C/S — case supervision — he actually does it, and doesn't produce something else that has to be repaired.

Standard tech isn't what I say it is. It is what works. And what works has already been established. So it isn't for me to say it is different. And it isn't for anybody else to say it's different either, because we fought for it and we won it the hard way. Now let's consolidate it. Now, let's get it practiced!

The history of standard tech is a very long history. It is a very hard-fought-for

history. There is a tremendous quantity of technology in Scientology and Dianetics. It is one of the largest broadest bodies of information on the subject of human behavior that has ever appeared in the universe. And I say that without fear of challenge, because I know what has appeared on the back track. It is so stupidly feeble because it consists of no more than crass superstition. The triumph is that out of this large body of material which embraces everything known to man or beast, there is hardly anything unexplored in that whole subject. Out of that whole, mad, wide ocean of material, there is this hairline that goes right straight through the middle of the material. So you have to know where the ocean is in order to get on the hairline. And that is quite an achievement.

I'll tell you how the hairline was chosen and why it became that terribly narrow path which we now call standard tech. It is composed of those things which, if they are out, inhibit and

prohibit all case gain. It is a negative assessment. If the points of standard tech are present, unresolved, the case will not gain. So obviously, the resolution of these points in their proper sequence is standard tech.

If a fellow has an ARC break he cannot be audited. If he is audited without the ARC break being handled he will go immediately into a sad effect. And months later will be found just sadder and sadder and sadder. If the fellow has a present time problem — you try to audit the individual with the present time problem — you get no case change of any kind whatsoever. It just parks itself right there. He doesn't become sadder but the case doesn't change.

So, standard tech is the highway. And it is built out of those points which, if they are present, no advance can occur. And there aren't any more points. An awful adventurous statement, but it is true. There aren't any more points. There's another trick, or two perhaps. There are a couple of ways to do one or two of these things. But the variability, even on those, is weighted in favor of just one thing to do. So, we should come curving down the line with standard tech. It goes right straight where we're supposed to go, and you can hold the case into that groove — and it is a groove. It is very narrow.

I can see it now, trying to get an academy auditor to see the light. You have just supervised this case, and Archibald Swangolen is the auditor. And at the moment he goes in he finds the case supervision cannot work. It says: "Make sure that you get the ARC break, because the PC is very sad." So he goes in there and he's just sure it is because the PC has a missed withhold, which is why he ran Grade IV before he ran... At this point you say: "Wait a minute, what are you doing?" He replies: "Oh, well, you see somebody came the other day, and they said it was always best to get off the service facsimile as soon as possible because then you could get the overts."


You will be in the optimum position to be able to say: "We do not care who came the other day. There is only one way to do standard tech. And there is only one way it is done. And there is only one PC, and

that is a standard PC. And you haven't got a standard PC. Let us go into this quietly, and back through this folder and find where you missed the ARC break to begin with, and do it the right way, shall we?"

In case supervision you must first know that standard tech will solve the case. You must know that your direction of standard tech, to be done, will solve the case, if the auditor will follow your C/S, and if he will keep his TRs in and finish the cycle of action on the case as it rolls along. And your confidence must be such that Aloysius Q. Squashbottom, himself in person, can emerge as the world's most unstandard piece of balderdash, spend hours bragging to everybody how he's very different, and you still go in against this case. You do this, and you order and enforce the running of standard tech and Mr. Squashbottom's case will fall apart.

The attitude of an auditor handling standard tech is that of total confidence. That confidence is something that is gained — that is won. If by doing these actions you obtain an exactly predictable result, confidence is born. It is a very funny thing at this stage of the game to be talking about anything as positive as Scientology as something in which you have to have confidence. But the funny part of it is, people have run into many cases that have been mis-audited so that the cases appear different. That is, until you look back and find out that the guy has been talking to his first six auditors, has tried to tell his PTP [Present Time Problem] to those first six auditors, and none of them ever handled it. And then you realize that you'd better handle the PTP.

So therefore it's rather a simple world you're dealing with. But you cannot adventure into this world of standard tech without a total, total grip on the technology itself. The standardness of standard tech is knowing standard tech so well that you don't have to think about standard tech in order to do standard tech — it simply is.

It's hard to imagine someone not having this Class VIII data—it's so vital to life and I'd think everyone would live better and happier if they had

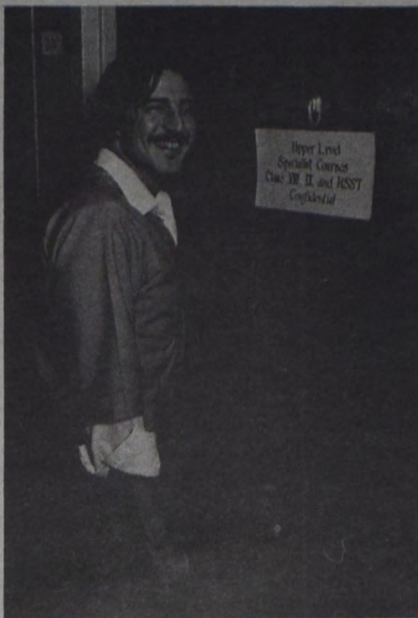
and applied this Tech. I know it's changing my life and I love it.

The Purpose of Class VIII

In Class VIII Tech no longer is hopefully applied. Auditing is no longer gauged only against result. There is no more "auditing is what you get away with" at VIII.

A flawless, invariable administration of processes with flawless TRs, using ONLY the basics, is Class VIII.

The purpose is to administer Tech without variables, using only highly standardized processes and actions, using only a flawless TR approach, all within the new Auditor's Code.

The impact of this action produces 100% results. It produces fantastically fast results. And it produces more result that has ever before been attained.

Using the Class VIII standard C/S approach there are *no* bogged cases..

The first thing a student on Class VIII has to learn is that there IS an exact right way to do auditing, an exact right way to solve cases.

If he grasps this, can do this, can select the correct VIII C/S and get it exactly applied, the result can be achieved.

It is too simple for many to grasp at

once.

The ultimate comedy is a student who arrives at course offering "improvements". He is confessing that he's never applied Scientology straight and has *often* failed on pcs.

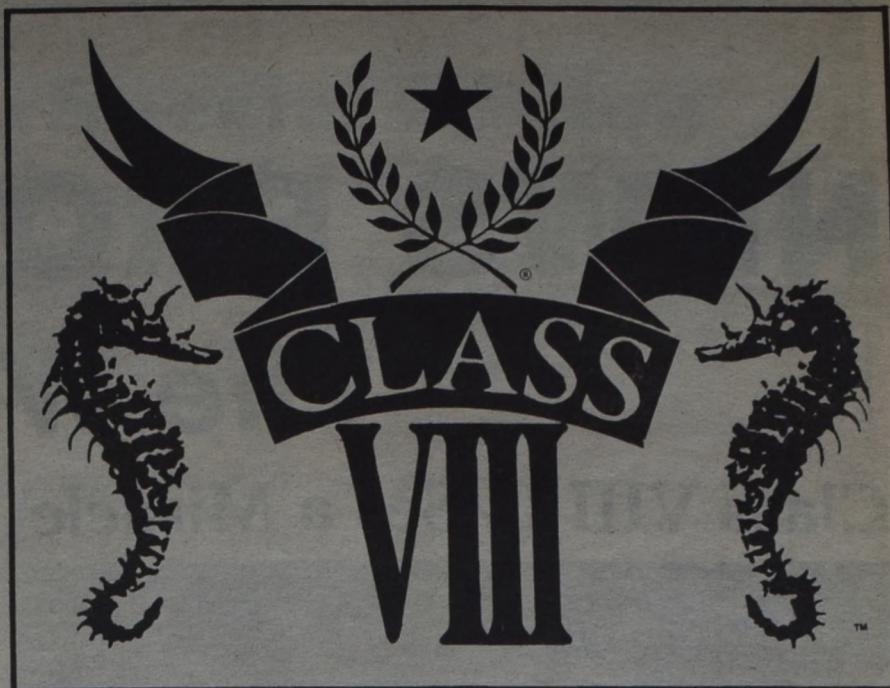
The cycle of the decline of an auditor is: (a) he fails to apply the missing bit of Standard Tech, (b) he then has an "unsolvable" case before him, (c) he then dreams up some unusual solution, (d) every so often his unusual solution improves that one pc a bit, (e) he now tries to apply it to all pcs, (f) he thereafter consistently fails.

A student also has a cycle of decline: (a) he recognizes his basics, (b) someone invalidates his correct data, (c) he ceases to see what the basics are, (d) he muddles along.

In Class VIII we bring the basics back in and reinforce them until the auditor will do them and *nothing else*.

From this we get a "magical" high velocity case gain curve upwards on *all* cases.

The beginning Class VIII auditor often has the idea that the *result* of the session



is what he will be gauged by. This is NOT true. We *know* what the result of Standard Tech will be when flawlessly administered. We are not "waiting to see". We are not experimenting. There are no different or difficult pcs.

The student on VIII is gauged by the flawless handling of the session and his admin.

You see we know what Standard Tech does. It's up to the auditor to learn to be UNCOMPROMISINGLY STANDARD.

When we have brought about this frame of mind and standard rendition in

the auditor we have made a Class VIII. Until we do, we have not.

The purpose of the course, then, is to produce an uncompromising zealot for Standard Tech whose reality is such that he will not do or tolerate sloppy rendition.

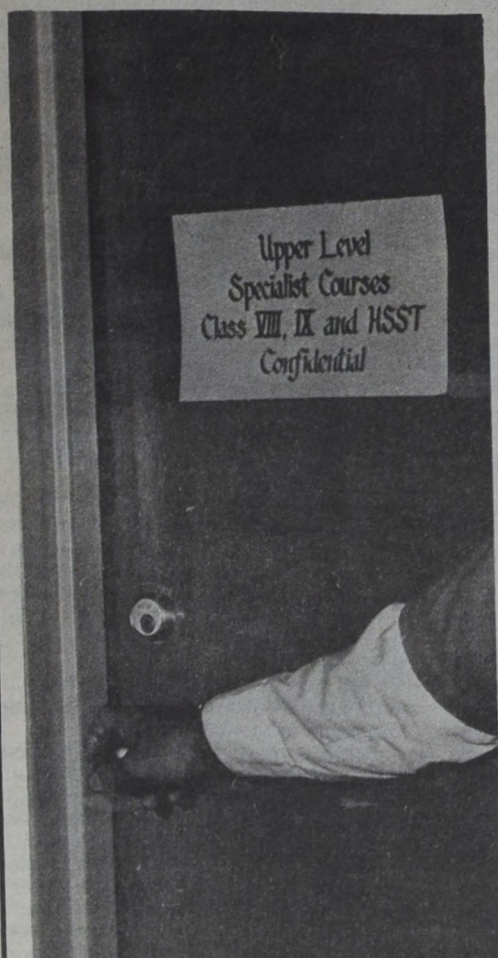
There is something here in Standard Tech. It is the exact Auditor's Code, the exact TRs, the exact processes, the 100% result. It can be learned, it can be done.

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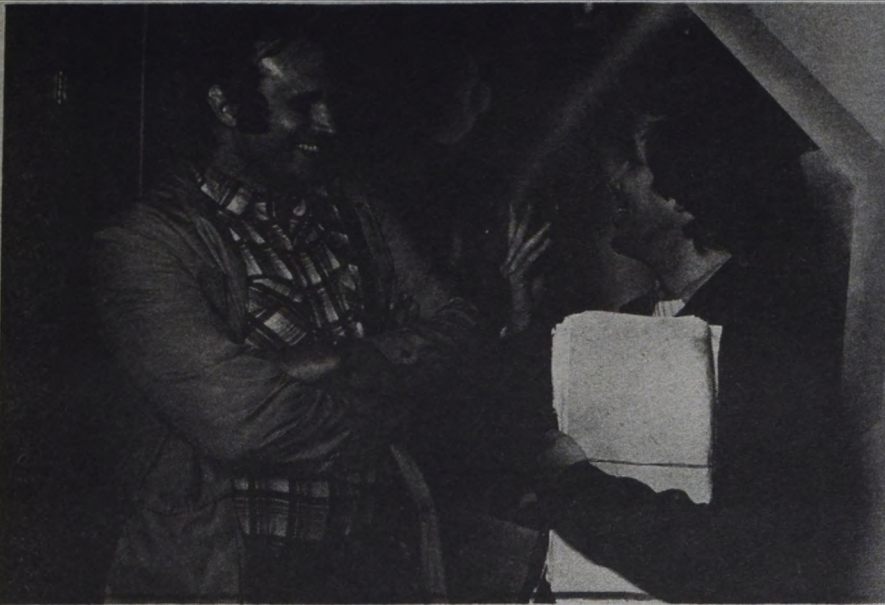

Class VIII C/Ses a Miracle

In the Los Angeles area recently a baby fell into a swimming pool. The baby was rushed to the hospital but the doctors gave up on saving his life and the baby was pronounced dead. A Scientologist, Yael Landau, however, heard about it. Not willing to give up easily she called Mike Lewis, Class IX Auditor, and asked him what she could do. Mike gave her C/S instructions and during a long night of running assists, the baby began to recover!

Mike points out that per the Grade Chart, assists can be given by any Scientologist. "Yael is not a trained auditor—but she is a Scientologist, and as a Scientologist she saved that baby's life. You don't need to be all the way at the top of the Grade Chart to be a Scientologist doing your job."

Mike stresses the importance of being Class VIII in aiding the baby's spiritual recovery. "You walk into a hospital and there are all these agreements for sickness: 'Well, I guess the Doctor knows what's best, I mean, after all, it's just a baby and he's an unconscious baby and he doesn't know what I'm saying, right? I mean babies can't talk...' These are heavy agreements. I know had I not studied the Class 8 materials I probably would have on many occasions folded up my tent and moved out. I had to buck Yael up several times because of the big onslaught of counterintention from all the family's friends and relatives and so on."

"About a week ago the baby was pronounced well enough to move out of the hospital."

"Pretty much as the thetan in charge of the area, and having LRH's viewpoint that the Tech does work clears away any clouds of mystery and eliminates the necessity for faith. I know if I had walked into the hospital when I was a Class IV or a Class VI, I would have had to use a little faith, as opposed to certainty. It's a very dramatic thing, faith. Saving babies' lives

is a very dramatic thing also, but when you're Class VIII you're not wondering if you will get results anymore because you know you're going to get results. As a Class VIII the only thing you're interested in is the exactness of technical application."

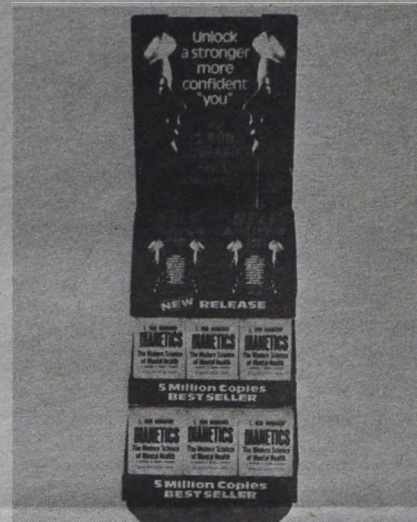
Before his career as an auditor Mike was a successful playwright in the Washington, DC area. Currently, in addition to his duties as an auditor and C/S in connection with Celebrity Center North Hollywood, he has one play being performed on what is now nearing a three month run, and has two major productions scheduled for 1983 in New York. His current play, "Sunrise on the Earth", is about a disembodied thetan who has just died. Speaking as an old man, the thetan is deciding whether or not to come back and pick up another body. Mike says, "I wrote it as an experiment. I wanted to see if non-Scientologists could have it, and apparently they can—they give it rousing applause every night."

Mike points to upper level training as a great help in handling life. "You save a lot of time because you don't have to do much wondering anymore about things that are already known. Once I did Class VIII I didn't have to wonder about whether the Tech is going to work or not, or whether this case is going to be solved or not. You don't even have to spend time wondering about whether you're going to be OK or whether the planet is going to get cleared or not."

"I found that used to get in my road. Now I can just go ahead and get the work done without having to worry about whether it's going to get done or not."

"Once you do Class VIII you get a sense that this is the most important thing you could possibly do ever on either side of the Grade Chart. LRH really counts on Class VIIIs. He talks to those VIII students the way he doesn't talk to anyone else at all, because he knows that you're aboard now, you're one of the team."

Expansion News! National DIANETICS™ Campaign Hits!



The route to Class VIII starts here! Book displays like this are in stores all over the US.

The first weeks of the US national DIANETICS™ books campaign saw tremendous results across the country, from Portland, Maine to San Diego. Within six days of the start of the campaign of very professionally done TV and printed ads, 17% of the stores contacted in a nationwide survey had already sold out of DMSMH (DIANETICS™ *Modern Science of Mental Health*) and *Self Analysis*!

In Los Angeles, surveys indicate that from 40% to 50% more people were aware of DIANETICS books—nearly 8 out of 10 had already heard of the book.

As the days of the campaign rolled on the great news rolled in:

In upstate Minnesota a chiropractor saw the commercials on TV, located his closest Church in Twin Cities, and called them. He was already reading DMSMH, but called to ask if he and his wife (also a chiropractor) could start on the course. He and his wife have routed onto course now—he says he now understands why people have crooked backs!

A woman had a test evaluation done for her at the Hollywood Test Center. The evaluator started to explain to her the concept of the reactive mind. She said, "Oh yes, I know about the reactive mind. I saw it on the ad!"

Another woman in Los Angeles who read DMSMH called the Los Angeles Church and signed up for her Life Repair auditing. She also received some Book One auditing. When she started she was withdrawn and in grief; her husband had been killed in a car 6 months ago, and she was afraid to drive a car. After 12 hours of auditing, she was now in communication, smiling, ready to drive again, and ready to train to become an auditor herself!

That's not all—her auditor reported that when she first bought DMSMH, she was so blown out by it that she wanted to talk to her friends, etc. about it. Since she couldn't find anybody else who had read the book yet, she started paying her friends

to read it!

DIANETICA, the Spanish edition of DMSMH, is booming in the US as well as its English counterpart! Due to the huge demand being generated by Spanish speaking public, there are now staff in the LA Church whose full time job is to create the Spanish program. There is a Spanish seminar leader, a Spanish speaking course supervisor, and a Spanish speaking Book One auditor.

LA Volcanus, a large Spanish distributor that distributes to 8 western states, was closed to carry 12 LRH titles. Their initial order to Bridge Publications was for over 5,000 books—a big first order! They said their decision was largely influenced by our advertising and publicity and by the news of the book moving toward "bestseller status".

The major distributor of Spanish books in the New York area was closed for 2,000 DIANETICA books as an initial order. Edinsa, the major wholesaler in Southern California reports that 4,300 of their first 5,000 DIANETICA books have been sold. They report it is among their top ten best-sellers. So many, many Spanish-speaking Americans are getting their *Libro Uno*!

And DMSMH is moving toward best-seller status—the statistics and best-seller lists prove it! In the Waldenbooks Bookstores (one of the nation's largest bookstore chains), by the time the campaign was barely three weeks old, Book One was listed as #29 on their "front list". The "front list" is a list of more than 250 of the top bestselling titles, released this year.

Book One has always been a steady bestseller on the "back list" at Waldenbooks. The "back list" is a list of books that are perennial high-sellers. For a book that was first published more than thirty years ago to again climb to "front list" status with all the brand new titles is an event in publishing history!

And not only that—*Self Analysis* is not far behind! It is #80 on the Waldenbooks front list, and at last report, is still climbing. *Self Analysis* has recently been redesigned with a beautiful new cover, and is the first new LRH book to be released to the general public in some time.

Book One is soaring up another "Best-seller" list in the book industry, that of the major distributor in the country, Ingram's, which distributes to over 10,000 bookstores. DMSMH rose to #10 and, at the peak of the advertising jumped to #4 on the quality paperback bestseller list!

This list is the barometer of how books are selling nationally. This is one of the key lists that get phoned into the *New York Times* each week so they can make up their list of the top ten. (*Self Analysis* is already #43 on Ingram's list as well!) And DMSMH was also #1 on Ingram's West National list, the list for the western half of the country.

Here is an example of how fast the books are selling: a Scientologist went into a branch of a big bookstore chain in Chicago to purchase a *Self Analysis*. The clerk in the store had to call 17 other stores before he found one that had a *Self Analysis* or DMSMH left as they had all sold out!

The reorders for DMSMH are flooding in and the books are flooding out faster and faster to meet the demand!

More and more indicators are showing up that the news of Book One and DIANETICS Tech are spreading at an incredible rate: Bridge Publications recently got a business call from a company in Philadelphia which supplies hand tooled leather cases for the Mark VI E-Meter™. The businessman called to let them know a delivery was coming, and then he went on to say how Book One was "the talk of the town. I hear about it on TV two or three times a day, and everybody's talking

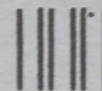
Mailing Instructions

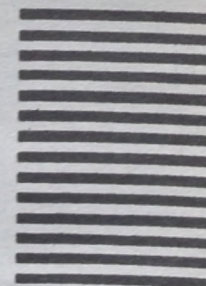
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Focus on Success— Class VIIIs— Winning with Standard Tech in Auditing and in Life

From your Auditing you get a tremendous increase in ARC, understanding, when you get up to OT III, but then you start to realize, and start to look around and see there's an awful lot going on around here. Nobody's taking care of it—nobody's doing anything about it to make sure it continues."

"The things you learn on Class VIII are the basic rules that are common to any

thetan. These are the basics. You're finding out about how thetans react and think and don't think.

"When you separate out from MEST, what do you have left? And where do you go to find out about that? The Class VIII Course is where you find out about it. If you want to find out about MEST I suppose you can do that, but *everything else* is contained in the VIII Course, as far as I can see."

So insists Dan Jacobs, highly successful auditor, Class VIII, on Solo NOTs, and soon to be on Class IX. Dan and his wife Myrna, who is Class IX, HSST and audited NOTs completion, have been auditing for several years.

Since early in their careers as Scientologists, Myrna and Dan have relied heavily on training, and it has paid off. Myrna says, "Every aspect of our lives is in amazingly good shape, and I really do credit it mostly to the training. I don't see how anybody can get along without it."

Dan relates, "We have *always* put training at the top of our list. Always. Right from the beginning. We started out on the HQS Course and every step along the way has proven invaluable. There's no value that we could ever put on it."

"We've given up and set aside other things along the way. We started out with *nothing*. But training always has been the answer for us."

Myrna adds, "It was OK to give up MEST. It all works out in the end because as your havingness comes up, as your training and processing levels come up, you can have the MEST you want and get rid of what you don't want."

Dan says, "The point is there are a lot of

things you can study—we've both been to college and we studied a lot of things—and there are a lot of things that you can put your time and your attention on and energies into. This is the only one that I've ever found that pays off far, far beyond your wildest expectations because it's something you can use continually in every endeavor that you find yourself exposed to."

Embarking on a 5 year plan to get to OT and Class 6 in 1971, Myrna and Dan did full time training first in San Francisco. After auditing in Missions there for two years they came to ASHO for the Briefing Course. They have high praises for ASHO and the service they've received. Dan says, "We've always considered ASHO Day our home. The fondest memories I have are of doing the training and just working flat out on it. That's the way we did it. We've always had tremendous support and help from all the staff from the Letter Registrars to the Registrars and the Supervisors—everybody. Nothing but support all the way along the line."

After completing Class VI and doing more professional auditing, Myrna and Dan did Class VIII. Dan relates how Class VIII changed him. "It handles the way you handle and approach every aspect of your life. It was the biggest single change in my life bar none. You could just see through a confusion and see the basic truths and align it, no matter what was being thrown at you. It's the Technology that aligned every other technology."

"It simplifies life totally," Myrna agrees, "because it applies to everything. Of course it makes it very easy to stay standard with the Tech because you know that Standard Tech involves very very few things really. It looks like a lot when you start but it's not a lot. Dan adds, "I was 'Auditor of the Year' for three years in Northern California. I can take a pc, and have done so constantly, 'audited' by others, and take that Class VIII viewpoint that the guy looks screwed up *only* because something Standard was reported to have been done that wasn't. So you just do whatever was supposed to be done, standardly, and the guy FLYS! It literally falls apart. It just cracks right through the case. Where you can screw it up and "do" repair list after repair list, you just do it right in the first place, you don't have to repair it. It's just simple."

Asked what about the Class VIII Course affected her the most, Myrna replied, "Responsibility level, beyond a doubt. You're given the responsibility to see that the Tech is standard and stays standard for the duration of how long it takes to Clear this universe."

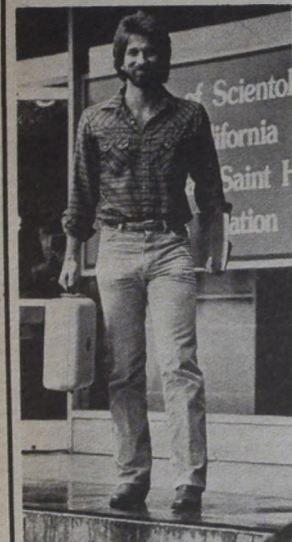
Dan adds that, "On Class VIII what you get is just a much higher level of understanding—knowledge, of a very much higher level of control and expertness, professionalism, and the responsibility isn't a hard burden that you have to carry. It's just always been there—it's automatic—you just have it."

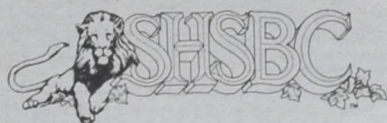
