Recently a lady who had "passed over" remarked to me that it would be wonderful if all that she had become aware of could be made known and understood by those to whom I lecture. I agreed. However, I told her that one of the most difficult tasks we have is to employ words that would best describe the conditions that we had found to be Since words are expressions of true. thoughts and nothing more, we are constantly groping for the best of right words to describe a particular situation or a condition that we encountered.

There are many accounts of life in the afterworld. Since they all differ, it could be a little confusing to those on the earth plane. But it must be remembered that the astral world is a vast plane of consciousness, and that no two entities who arrive there will have experiences that are exactly the same.

This brings us to our first question, one similarly or exactly the same as is asked at almost every seance or gathering where questions are invited:

Margie, asks Dorothy G., if in the astral plane there is no such thing as time, then how do you plan for a gathering? How does everyone know he or she should be at a certain place at a particular time?

Simply because we travel at a high rate of speed, Dorothy. Our velocity is many, many times faster than you can attain in the world in which you are functioning. When we should be at a certain place, we merely focus it in our minds, very much as you would line up a lens with the tip of a finger. By merely looking through it and focusing it, we are are there. Since we have not the travel problem you do, it is possible to come into others' vibrations through their thoughts. As we are not encumbered in any way, we can be on the scene in a split second, so to speak.

▶ Why is it that so many psychic experiences do not seem to have any logic or meaning to them? Five years ago, for example, in a dream I saw a large music box. Later I saw the same music box at the pier in Long Beach. I have never seen it since, nor did my experience carry any significance of which I am aware.

▷ Margie, are psychic experiences com mon?

If you are a normal person, living a normal life, and have not sought in the field of the occult, there has been some time in your life when you have had an experience you could not explain or understand. If you have followed the normal pattern, you may have felt that you could never tell anyone of this experience, and perhaps did not even discuss it with anyone.

▶ Is it possible to see a spirit leave the body at death?

It is possible to see the spirit leave the physical body at the time of death. It is not very probable, however, because at this time many are too confused to see. There have been a number of people who even have taken the initiative in the field of psychic research, those having the power to see, to do this . . even to photograph the spirit leaving the body. In this respect, there are quite a few differences of opinion. Normally it leaves the solar plexus, then follows up the breast, and then goes out through the head. It takes a period of approximately a half-hour for the spirit to be completely severed from the physical body.

If there is a violent death, such as an explosion where the body is blown to bits, that is a different matter altogether. Suddenly that person will find himself in the immediate atmosphere. Usually, such people are cared for and taken into a state of oblivion for a short period of time, since their experience may have been a very great shock to them.

▶ Do you have pets in the astral? Yes, we do. Domestic animals are among us the same as they are on the earth plane, for we too have a great desire for them. There are some communities where we find animals which

among ferocious animals that, if you had seen them coming toward you on the earth plane, you would think they were going to gobble you up. Not so over here. Although they may go through the motions at the beginning, they soon recognize the futility of it, and cease carrying on such activity, thus automatically become tame. This is especially so when they are around people. We would not have elephants in our back yard - - certainly not - - but we do have animals in our environment.

Is it true that most people who marry have met in the astral world before they met here? . . asks Larry B.

Not in every case, Larry. It is true that if there is an affinity, and the couple had lived an appreciable number of lives together in the past, it is possible for them to meet in the astral plane and nurture the relationship along. The marriage would then be consummated very rapidly for having been nurtured on the inner plane. Most certainly not everyone who marries has met in the astral world before he and she meet on the earth plane.

What happens to an alcoholic or drug addict after he or she dies? . Is he or she still an alcoholic or a drug addict? asks P. B.

Alcoholism, because it has to do with the mind and affects the mind, carries over when leaving the physical body into what is now the astral outer mind. The alcoholic, passing over, thinks he needs alcohol in the astral world, and thinks it will have the same reaction there. In like token is the drug addict.

This is easily eliminated once the individual realizes it is a losing game to be concerned about having alcohol or living in an atmosphere of alcohol or dope. When he realizes it is not necessary to continue that way, that it is a futile activity, he gradually works out of alcoholism and drug addiction; such afflictions have no more control over him, he becomes rehabilitated and aspires to higher realms.

A Little Journey Into The Supernatural

SEVERAL TIMES in my life I have had a curious and arresting experience. I have felt that everything I was seeing and hearing had been seen and heard before, and that I knew exactly what was going to happen next.

I have heard of others who have had this odd sensation when entering a strange house, or at a turn in some un-familiar road. The whole interior of the dwelling is intimately known, though never seen before. Every detail of the alien landscape is as recognizable as the face of an old friend. The sensation is very brief, but very sharp.

Thinking afterward about these episodes which I myself have experienced, I have wondered if there would be a way to break the spell. What would happen, for instance, if I said to a friend: "Stop. I know exactly what you are about to say and the precise words you will use, because we have lived this moment before."

I know I would have no such power of action, however. The experience of reliving a past experience is so sudden, so vivid, so engrossing that it literally stops you in your tracks. It imposes a silent acceptance during the period of its short, despotic reign over the mind.

I have seen references to this peculiar condition in books. Walter Scott confided to his journal on February 17,1828. "At dinner time I was strangely haunted by what I would call the sense of preexistence . . a confused idea that nothing that passed was said for the first time, that the same topics had been discussed, and the same persons had stated the same opinions on the same subjects."

I had no idea how widely the experience had been shared, however, until I read an article about it in The New Yorker Magazine. It is by Berton Roueche, and it is called, "An Emotion of Weirdness."

From this study I learned that the condition has an accepted name. It is called deja vu, the French phrase for OCTOBER 1963 CHIMES



"already seen." The name is ingenious, but it fails to convey the fact that all the senses . . hearing, touch, smell, taste . . are involved in this odd phenomenon, as well as the sense of vision.

Roueche evidently has explored deeply along this bypath of the mind. He includes many literary allusions to such varied writers as Marcel Proust, John Buchan, Charles Dickens, and Dante. He has discovered a considerable body of serious material on the About one person in three subject. has had the experience at some time, and many have undergone it repeatedly. It occurs most frequently among young adults between twenty and thirty-five.

Explanations Offered

Back in 1844 Arthur Ladbrooke Wigan was striving to explain deja vu as a delusion arising from the twin hemispheres of the brain. One hemisphere is momentarily active and the other somnolent, he reasons. This causes the mind to receive a fresh image that for the moment takes on the nature of a memory.

Other explanations vary all the way from the coldly practical, to the mystic, to the psychiatric. To some minds deja vu is a proof of the theory of reincarna-The inexplicable memory, they tion. hold, springs from a previous existence.

William James explained it as a distant memory of something actually experienced, but which the mind cannot for the moment identify.

One of the adherents of the Freudian school of psychiatry writes of the expe-rience as "a defense mechanism which the mind sets up against some real or imagined threat which serves to reassure the individual that he is not venturing into an entirely new field. He now appreciates that the situation is not too greatly fraught with danger in the immediate future since he has been in it, heard it, smelled it before, and survived."

None of these answers is satisfactory to my mind. None explains why the sensation occurs with such dramatic intensity at a moment of mere idleness, or why it appears with such clarity of outline, as though all the senses were sharpened beyond their usual wont.

None accounts for the air of revelation that makes the experience so startling. None explains how a room or a path through the woods never trodden before suddenly is as familiar as the palm of one's own hand.

My own most memorable experience with deja vu occurred a good many years ago, but I recall it with abnormal exactness.

I had had at that time a recurrent dream over a period of several months. In it, I found myself approaching a very beautiful building that stood in an open space of green grass. The scene always was bathed in the serene light of a morning that follows a rainy night, when the world looks new-washed and limpidly pure.

In answering this eternal question, Jamma Dass of Nairobi, Kenya writes in Oomoto, a Japanese Spiritual organ, that "the force which drags us back to earth is that of worldly desires, to fulfill which we are born again on earth, or any other planet, where our desires can be suitably fulfilled. Therefore, on earth we are what we desired to be, and it is no use blaming others for our misfortunes. After completing the program we had in mind before leaving the etheric world and before we had taken birth on earth, we leave this world taking with us our character which we built here by selfless noble deeds or evil deeds with selfish motives."

A SLIGHT CASE OF PANIC

The Mexican Magazine, Policia, recently reported that it had been substantiated by various police officers in the Capitol that sometime after 2 a.m. a woman would appear near the plaza de Tlaltelolco begging for alms from taxi drivers and pedestrians, then right before their astonished gaze would disappear, creating a panic among all who saw it happen . . except possibly among those who had studied something about such phenomena, so states the Boletin Oficial de la Central Espirita Mexicana.

THE POWER OF ONE LITTLE LIGHT

Telling us what just one person can do or be as a power for good is this excerpt from the writings of the Om-On-O publication of Ohio. "The auric field of one individual can be expanded to fully encompass an entire city, thus by your single concentrated effort could an entire population be carried into Sunship . . or a planer, or a system, or a galaxie, or a universe. As your auric field is increased it comes to enfold all life through which you pass . . elemental, angelic, human, and Divine. Concern yourselves, therefore, not with personalities, but be concerned with the extent of your emanation of Light; carry with you in complete confidence all those you hold dear and all life through which you pass."

A S HAS SO OFTEN been predicted, this is the age in which science is not only proving religion, but is proving that man is a spiritual being, living in a spiritual world.

As scientists - biologists - Dr. J. B. Rhine and his wife, Dr. Louisa E. Rhine, began their search forty years ago into the question of life after death. This led them into further research substantiating claims that communication with the spirit world was possible. Under Professor William McDougall at Duke University, the Parapsychology Laboratory was established where these investigations continued and led to intensive research on what came to be known as extrasensory perception, or ESP. The work done here paved the way for the establishment of other academic research centers, both in the United States and abroad, and the confirmation by other scientists of their findings.

Sixth in a series of articles featuring Life After Death appearing in Guideposts Magazine are Dr. Rhine's comments on what science has to say about the immortality of man. Among his conclusions are many interesting statements bearing out the prophecies for our time: " . . . It is in line with proven scientific research that there is something in man that has a wholly different set of properties from those of his physical body . . and it is this finding that makes survival a logical possibility. We know now that man is, as he has long intuitively believed, a spiritual being. That much seems definite."

In his investigations of different types of ESP - - telepathy, clairvoyance, and precognition - - Dr. Rhine has found that the human mind can transcend time and space, and that independent of material barriers it can make contact with other minds. Apparently non-physical power, the conclusion is that it may very well be called spiritual. If so, the question arises: Does it belong to a part of man that can survive the physical process known as death? Because of the many phenomena in this field of ESP, it is difficult for a scientist to answer. Many experiences of individuals and mediums would seem to verify it, but as evidence for survival, to the scientist this is not usually admissible or acceptable. Interestingly enough, however, Dr. "Much of the evidence Rhine states: that has seemed most convincing toward an affirmative answer on this question of survival after death has come from mediums, persons who act as links of communication between the spiritual world and ours." Dr. Rhine states this is particularly impressive when information is given not normally available to the medium, such as the diagnosis of a condition not suspected, but later verified by X-ray. Another significant type of proof for survival he cites is where in-

formation transmitted to a living person is known only to the deceased and the method of transmission is beyond the capabilities of the person through whom the information comes. He gives as an example a case submitted by a student at Northwestern University wherein a pre-school four year old boy's scribblings were found to be an old-fashioned square-type shorthand message from his recently deceased father to his mother, then living in Oregon, telling of the location of a safety deposit box in the East which she had not known to exist.

Despite the highly complex unit of mind and body, Dr. Rhine sees no separateness of the two, and sees that the spiritual side of man is no less real than the physical, and is, in fact, incomparably more important. It is knowledge of its reach and independence that is still incomplete.

As Dr. Rhine has so interestingly described the work of parapsychology in his challenging book, New World of the Mind, and how this new science has penetrated the physical barrier that has long hidden man's true nature from the the scientists of the past, he reveals also how "it has become literally the science of the spiritual aspect of nature." The spiritual powers of man, what spiritual capacities represent in the individual, how much of man is transphysical, whether a separable spirit personality is conceivable, and the great hidden system of operations behind all phenomena are among those questions yet to be explored and answered by this new science.

Through further exploration of this 'new world of the mind,' Dr. Rhine sees its expansion into an order of significance for a spiritual universe as beyond the dreams of religion's own prophets and mystics. He even supposes that if "some kind of world of independent

spirit agency can be discovered," which he has stated there is reason to think may be possible, "its establishment would manifestly bring to religious life an incomparably greater meaning and potency. The discovery would do for religion something like what the germ theory did for medicine. It would open the range of religious exploration to horizons beyond all present conceptions. It has always been so when new areas are discovered." In giving reassurance as to what research in this field may bring forth, Dr. Rhine reminds us that "the eventual processing of new contributions to knowledge has always permitted the 'laws of nature' to emerge triumphant. In that assurance of history lies the promise of an orderly new world of spiritual reality . . ."

"... Let us get on with the discovery of this side (the spiritual) of man's nature," says Dr. Rhine, "both in its potential for human life and its potential beyond the grave. We need this larger understanding." How many wonderful, fantastic, awe-inspiring discoveries are almost upon us! And how fortunate we are to live in a time that produces men and women like the Rhines and that witnesses the dispelling of superstition, mental darkness and enslavement, that before our very eyes we are seeing the veil being rent between the worlds.

EXPLORING ASTRALLY

D ID A FLORIDA WOMAN seated in a room in Miami, project her spirit to Mexico and explore an ancient tomb in Yucatan?

Was this psychic trip, this "astral journey," so vivid and the details so clear that it caused an archeologist some months later actually to discover the lost tomb?

Many examples of astral trips can be found in occult literature. Perhaps many persons who thought they were having vivid dreams were actually roaming around in spirit, while their physical



bodies remained in bed. There have been many instances of persons, especially during sickness, who "saw" their bodies lying on the bed while their spirits were elsewhere in the room.

The Bible has many examples of prophets "being taken by spirit" to distant places while their physical bodies remained behind. Occultists say that, on such flights, the spirit is attached to the body by a thread, or elastic, tenuous substance often called the *silver cord*. It can stretch indefinitely, allowing flights covering thousands of miles, but still remains connected to the body. Only death causes it to be severed from the body.

Enid Joan Brady of Holly Hill, Florida told of an astral trip she made in a recent issue of Orion Magazine, from which we quote the following interesting excerpts:

"Early in 1962, while on one of my visits to Miami, a group of people asked me to sit in a state of trance for them. When I do consent to such a request, it gives me an opportunity to indulge in astral exploration. Due to my friend, Manson Valentine, having made many trips to Mexico, and his having explored a goodly number of interesting caves in the Yucatan area, I thought it would be worthwhile to visit the Yucatan peninsula while in this particular trance meeting.

"Our mutual interest in archeology, particularly as it relates to religion and the lost continent of Atlantis, had led Dr. Valentine (with the Miami Museum of Science) and me into numerous talks regarding these subjects. While on this particular astral exploration, I discovered what appeared to me to be an old temple. It was hidden from the eyes of former explorers by dense foliage and undergrowth. Since I was not hampered by being in my physical body, I was able to go into this temple and have a good look around. It was obvious, even to my inexperienced eyes, that this was no ordinary ruin.

"One of the things that captivated me was the circle cross carved in the stone. Research on the circle cross had helped us to evaluate what has been found in this temple...

"Upon returning to my body, the group asked where I had gone. It had been such a thrilling experience, with so much to see, that at first it seemed I would be unable to relate everything to them at one time. However, after most of the people in attendance had gone, Dr. and Mrs. Valentine, with several of our close friends, continued to discuss my discovery.

"As Dr. Valentine was to go to Yucatan later in the spring, he, of course, would try to find my hidden temple. He and Dr. Michel d'Obrenovic, an associate, found the temple I had seen on my astral journey . . just as it had been described to them. Going into it was just as thrilling to them as it had been for me earlier . . .

"The doctors discovered that the temple was built over a very large cave formation and there are many sealed passages in the cave . . this being a good indication it is the burial place of a great master or leader.

"Everything, so far, points to the temple being that of the great master, Kukulcan, who lived about 20,000 years ago.

"There is every reason to believe that this new found cave and temple is of pre-Flood origin and might well have been a part of Atlantis. (Edgar Cayce, the famed psychic, said Atlantis was once joined to the Yucatan peninsula.)

"The Kukican temple and cave are rich in ancient symbols. The parts that the two doctors were able to explore on their first visit are as awesome as they are varied - the great number of carved hands (some of them painted red), the circle cross, and a strange humming sound.

"One of the most interesting things is a sealed door with a large recessed cross. The lintel of this door is of solid stone.. another indication of its ancient origin.

"I am not permitted at this time to divulge all the pertinent and fascinating facts and findings. However, as soon as the expedition is in full operation, a complete report will be made."

The Body Jells The Story

T SEEMS A LITTLE STRANGE, doesn't it, that the average person judges at a glance with fair accuracy the the type of thinking he sees in faces on the street, yet feels that the remainder of the body indicates only superficially the mental processes of an individual. He has so permitted his own observations to be overshadowed by the almost universal assumption that the body originates thought in the brain, produces pain from physical conditions, and harbors disease because of bacteria that rarely does he take time to reason that if the face tells the story of character, the body also tells the story of motives, mental reactions, emotions, frustrations, sensibilities, loves and hates. If he is seized with a pain in the tummy, he rushes to the medicine cabinet, wonders what he may have eaten at his last meal, and imagines that something is developing that may send him to a doctor.

Psychosomatic medicine has awakened mankind to the mental nature of some diseases. Even this advanced approach, however, hesitates before the assumption that all disease can be traced to mental or psychological causes. Much of the reluctance is due to the fact that, as in psychiatry, the assumption is that the cause must exist within the individual's own consciousness. If the cause is not found there after much patient questioning and self-analysis, the conclusion is likely to be that thought processes are not responsible for his physical condition.

The fact is, that one's body can suffer from outside thought as well as from that which originates within his own consciousness . . as one accepts that thought . . consciously or uncon-Take, as an example, what sciously. has come to be known as "the common cold." Discounting, for the moment, exposure to weather conditions that logically would seem to account for a cold, it will be found that this unpleasant

physical.condition often is easily trace-

able to the acceptance of another's mental attitude.

It was the writer's early experience in metaphysics to have made the discovery that his apparent susceptibility to one cold seizure after another throughout the period from October to April was due to susceptibility to or acceptance of criticism. Being eager to please, looking for compliments, being much concerned over others' opinion of him, unintentionally he opened his consciousness to any antagonistic expression to the contrary and promptly physicalized this opposition in the symptoms of a cold, which usually went through all its diabolical phases before normalcy was restored fully. When he awakened to the fact that he was "taking cold" from the cold thoughts others sent to him, he resolved to "turn the other cheek," refusing to take such mental brickbats by rejecting the complimentary bouquets for which he had formed such avidity. Re-Many years of freedom - - even sult:

during winter coldness to which many others were succumbing. Since he was learning to close the door of his consciousness to the thoughts of others, for what would be considered either good or bad, he realized he was no longer afraid of what a spell of wet, cold weather might do to him.

What a significant revelation this discovery was to the writer! He began to realize that one reason for the apparent failure of materia medica to find a reliable cure for a cold is that originally a cold in the body was caused from cold thoughts . . especially those from outside sources. This ancient origin has persisted down through the centuries until now the common cold is looked on a very serious precursor to many as other ailments, some of them fatal.

One might pose another question: Is it really strange that this Pandora Box of cold can result in many dire diseases, and that cold hatred, wars, rebellion of one kind or another, and man's inhumanity to man are rife in the world? If man permits himself to get riled up over exhibitions of the carnal mind, he should not be surprised if he awakens with a cold the following morning.

Parenthetically, it might be added that there are other mental conditions that 'account for the common cold, but enough has been said to show that it is not only what may be in an individual's consciousness that needs investigation, but also what mental arrows he may be accepting that are aimed at him from In the experience above rewithout. ferred to, the writer closed his own mind to receptivity, but first had to become aware of the cause of his continuous colds.

Let us examine cancer from the mental side . . its true etiological explanation. This is called a malignant disease - - and well it may be, for it originates from malignant thoughts some-

When you have the fourth dimensional vision, you see the whole picture You can then look at a person and see the present, past and probable future according to the decisions and present beliefs contained in the body and mind of the individual. Then you cease judging from appearances, for you see below the the surface of things. Then you get the realization that the level of consciousness and the state of beingness which you say you desire is available for you right now. It is yours for the taking - for the accepting. And what about others? . Your job is to see perfection for yourself. We have but to look about us to see that way of life we desire now being expressed by others, which proves that the state of beingness does exist now. Understanding this, we never envy another or covet that which belongs to another, but we simply accept our own perfect experience.

The greater the level of awareness, the greater the freedom of expression. A man can have nothing on this level unless it is first established on the

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inner plane. When it is established, then it is impossible for anyone else to take it away from him.

The next step is into the level of blueprints, patterns and mental designs. This is termed the fifth dimension, and is a more subtle level back of the fourth dimension. On this level of awareness we are conscious of thought forms and basic patterns which are common to the race of man and which become embodied in every cycle. Much of the material coming into expression through the consciousness has not been picked up from others, or created now, but it is coming through from the realm of patterns and designs where it always existed. This is true for ideas, inventions, so-called discoveries and patterns of living. When we can relax the conscious mind and refrain from effort, often we can have the experience of having the right answer come to us 'out of the blue' in response to our desire for an answer to a question we might have. The realization of truth is not the result of our assembling a lot of information, for information is not truth. The perception of Truth dawns when we are able to let go of the storehouse of assembled facts. You may even say with the old Prophets, "Yet in my flesh shall I see God" . . yet while

TEACHING SPIRIT TRUTH

In talking to non-Spiritualists, I have found one common denominator of convincing appeal . . namely, those words of Jesus Christ recorded by Saint John in the 14th chapter . . "These things have I spoken unto you while yet abiding with you. But the Comforter, even the Holy Spirit whom the Father will send in My name, He shall teach you all things."

The Holy Spirit or Holy Ghost in the true meaning, consists of guides who minister to each and every one of us as guardian angels. Therefore, since your guardian angel (in the words of Christ) is "to teach you all things" . . . how in heaven's name can this spirit accomplish such a thing without some kind of contact?

Consequently, Spirit communication is a promise of Christ . . . and to deny such a possibility is to deny Jesus of Nazareth. But still, many a cocksure non-Spiritualistic Christian will say . . 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LESSONS FOR STUDENTS . . .

WHAT IS THE MEDIUM-TRANCE ?

Professor William James stated his belief on what the medium-trance is when he said that it was different from any other trance of which we have knowledge and that it seems to be borne out by the fact that spirit messages are given in this condition, as well as telepathic, clairvoyant and premonitory messages of all kinds. No one knows at present exactly what the medium-trance is, however, or, for that matter, any other kind is granted, the nature and character of of trance.

TYPES OF TRANCE

Both trance and catalepsy are known to occur spontaneously; both may also be induced artificially by hypnotism. Both often are mistaken for death. In many respects they are very similar. In catalepsy the body is rigid; in trance this is rarely the case - - forming a distinction between the two states. Dr. Franz Hartmann further distinguishes them: "There seems hardly any limit to the time during which a person may remain in a trance; but catalepsy is due to some obstruction in the organic mechanism of the body on account of its exhausted nervous power. The activity of life begins again as soon as the impediment is removed or the nervous energy has recuperated its strength."

LIGHT AND DEEP TRANCE

There are all grades and degrees of trance, from the very light stage - - in which there is but little difference from the ordinary waking consciousness - - to that degree of deep trance where the medium is totally unconscious of every-thing that passes around him. Very deep trance of this character is rare, but many of the most famous mediums have received their best message work while in that condition. Many test-mediums and sensitives, on the other hand, pass into a stage of trance so light that no one but an expert could detect any trance at all. Yet in many such cases no memory of the condition remains after the trance is finished. These light trances differ but slightly from cases of day-dreams, absent-mindedness, etc., when we say to a person, half in joke: "You are in a trance!"

SPIRIT CONTROL DURING TRANCE

In trance, we may assume that there is a gradual and fluctuating control of the medium's mind and body by the communicating spirit, and that, as one vacates or is driven out by the invading intelligence, the latter is able to control the medium more and more effectually. Just as "two solid bodies cannot be in the same place at the same time," so two spirit intelligences cannot occupy and control the same body at the same moment.

When once the fact of spirit control this control remains to be solved. How does Spirit manipulate the brain and nervous mechanism of the medium to bring about the desired results? What parts of the brain are used . . and how? These and many similar questions may take many years of scientific research before they can be answered with any degree of confidence.

METHODS OF CONVEYING INFORMATION DURING TRANCE

(1) The intelligences acting upon the mediums are almost invariably of a superior character and therefore must mold the organism by constant use for the expression of higher forms of thought.

(2) The relation of the medium to the manifesting intelligence is that of a pupil to teacher, sometimes that of a child to a wise and loving parent, and sometimes both these relations combine with a subtle and ennobling spirituality.

(3) There is always a mutual spiritual relation, even though the medium is not humanly conscious of it. No one can be a medium for the perfect expression of spiritual messages or discourses who does not consent to the procedure and cooperate with the manifesting spirit.

(4) As the master-musician improves the instrument he plays upon, so also a spirit controlling a human organism for the purpose of expressing wholesome thought imparts a greater power both to the brain and spirit of the medium. It is often difficult for spirits to control a medium sufficiently to manifest in any way through him.

TYPES OF CONTROL

There are various types of control used by spirits in trance-mediumship.

Telepathic method - wherein (a) thought is conveyed direct to the mindof the medium when in light trance, then given to the sitter in speech or writing.

(b) Pictographic method - wherein spirits present certain images or pictures to the clairvoyant eye of the medium, seen and interpreted either directly or symbolically.

(c) Sense-impression method - where in general sensations or impressions are conveyed to the medium who takes on the condition of the communicating spirit and describes pains felt in various parts of the body.

(d) Direct-control method - wherein the spirit removes the medium's own spirit from his body while in deep trance and manipulates it as he would an instrument by acting upon the nervous system directly, much in the same way that we act upon our own nervous systems throughout life.

Doubtless there are other methods which spirits employ, plus combining all of these methods on some occasions.

In cases of so-called "ecstasy," the spirit of the medium obtains the information himself, either by clairvoyant vision or by partially separating itself from the body and visiting the spiritual world directly. Such visions are therefore most descriptive of the spiritual world, what is happening there, and usually are revelations that are more or less symbolic.

HOW TO ENTER TRANCE

In order to induce trance spontaneously in yourself, you should proceed more or less as follows: Begin by gazing for some time at a bright object such as reflected light coming from a mirror, crystal-ball, etc. This will tend to tire the eyes and nerves slightly and bring about a dazed condition which is usually the beginning of trance. While looking at the bright object, breathe deeply and regularly through the nose and from the diaphragm. If you have already practised deep breathing, you should be able to do this at will without thinking of it consciously.

While looking at the bright object, do not concentrate or think of anything in particular beyond keeping yourself con-scious and remembering all the time that you are yourself, that you are not leaving your body and that you are not going to become totally unconscious.

During this process the room should be as quiet as possible - though some monotonous sound, such as the ticking of a clock, might assist matters. Do not listen to this consciously, however. Abolish all feelings of fear and anxiety, for such mental states will prevent you from entering the trance condition. "Let yourself go" and develop as far as posible.

SYMPTOMS OF TRANCE-MEDIUMSHIP

You must not imagine that the beginnings of your mediumship will be (continued on page 31)

I should like to quote from Chapter 55 of Mr. Dowling's book, The Aquarian Gospel, which describes that sublime moment when Jesus got His seventh degree title, The Christ.

"1. The work of Jesus in the Chamber of the Dead was done, and in the temple purple room He stood before the hierophant.

"2. And He was clothed in purple robes; and all the brothers stood. The hierophant arose and said,

THE MYSTIC MEANING OF THE BROTHERHOOD TESTS

Fish, Four Thousand Men, and Seven Baskets Full of Leavings. . appearing in the first and last parts, in that order, for a purpose.

When Jesus sought admittance to the Temple of the Sacred Brotherhood in the city of the sun called Heliopolis in Egypt, He became a neophyte among the greatest masters in the occult sciences. In the registry book, He was listed as The Logos-Circle-Seven. The Logos is the perfect word; the circle is the symbol of the perfect man; and seven is the number of the perfect man. That was the meaning of His mystic name and number.

While in Egypt, in the Sacred Temple of the masters, Jesus read the sacred texts and thought out the meanings of the mystic hieroglyphic symbols. "7. 'This is your great Passover rite. You are a neophyte no more, but now a master mind.

"8. 'Now, man can do no more; but God Himself will speak, and will confirm your title and degree.

"9. 'Go on your way, for you must preach the gospel of good will to men and peace on earth; must open up the prison doors and set the captives free.'

"10. And while the hierophant yet spoke, the temple bells rang out; a pure white dove descended from above and sat on Jesus' head.

"11. And then a voice that shook the very temple said, 'THIS IS THE CHRIST,' and every living creature said, 'AMEN.'

"12. The great doors of the temple swung ajar; the Logos journeyed on His way, a conqueror."

He was then fully prepared for His mission. So, with the vigor of living faith and the strength of indomitable will power, He journeyed to Jerusalem and stayed in Galilee where His life's passion soon commenced.

PSYCHIC HEALING

THROUGHOUT THE WORLD, nor just

in Australia, psychic healing is becoming more widely discussed every day, and is receiving more credence.

Yet in the storm of pain, there are those who feel it is wishful thinking, and there are those who associate it with pagan paintings, symbols on the wall, incantations of black and white magic, and with such things that we should not tamper with or investigate. Yet if we analyze healing, and analyze psychic healing, we find that both achieve exactly the same ends. Psychic healing is obtained, however, without pain, without drugs, without bloodshed. Is this fact . . or is it fallacy?

It is irrefutable, absolute fact, my friends. Unfortunately, though, throughout the world in the field of psychic healing, we do have fraudulence and misrepresentation. But if we are wise in our seeking, if we use the gift of reason, we shall explore for ourselves to the fullest, and we shall satisfy ourselves that this is Truth.

Close your eyes, if you will sometime, and visualize around yourself, emanating away from your body . . say four or five inches . . bands' and frequencies of color, the colors of the rainbow, but not necessarily in that order, all the colors of the spectrum that make up white . . the frequency of perfection.

Look upon your body as a vast machine, one of the most perfect ever created, one that stands misuse, abuse, and years of toil before it finally breaks down . . a magnificent pulsating machine doing infinite deeds and delicate operations, doing them consciously and while unconscious, doing them diligently even while you abuse it and forget it.

The human body, which is a mass of millions and millions of cells, each a tiny universe unto itself, emits from itself out from your skin every moment of the day and night, tiny ejections of power, of stimulae. Everywhere about you are millions of these tiny emana-OCTOBER 1963 CHIMES

tions, continually pulsating and generating around your body a magnetic field, a field that is essentially you. It is as much you as your finger prints. It is not like anyone else. It is you, for it is the reaction of your personality within that aura, within that colorscope around you. It is the manifestation of the manner of person you are, what mental state you are in, and the height of spirituality you have obtained. If you are a quiet, intelligent, and calm person, the color shall be fluent, rhythmical and beautiful. But if you are one dominated by sex, by drink, and by drug, one who allows temper to sway reason, one who becomes weak in the face of physical appetites, then that aura - that magnetic field - that colorscope - becomes a broken thing, a pathetic thing, with no reason, no harmony, and no rhythm. We see instead of a person who stands straight and tall, one who is broken, who has neither personality or determination, one who has become the flotsam and jetsam to be found in every city of the world.

This auric flow around your body is fed not only with stimulae from within, it is fed and stimulated by cosmic energy from without. Millions of tiny impulses of cosmic radiation play on the aura around your body and give to you, through that auric field, the stimulus of the cosmic. Many of you have had the experience of being depleted, of being indolent and listless, and after having gone for a walk on a hill in the wind, or walked along the beach, perhaps spoken to a friend, or stood for a moment and enjoyed a child's laughter, and have found the stimulus of such experiences to have been as though you had taken a glass of wine. Temporarily you forgot the tensions within yourself, and through the fluency of the aura came the stimulus, the reality, and the strength which is the spiritual world around you.

Let us look for a moment at the ailing body..one beset with tuberculosis, for example. The person becomes weaker and more depleted; he is taken to doctors, then placed in a sanitorium and nursed for a long period of time. Very often the semblance of a cure takes place. What happens to the aura? What happens to the magnetic field? What happens when cancer assails the body and the liver is affected? What happens when gallstones form and a tremendous colic ensues? What happens when the kidneys break down from Brights Disease?

Every organ in the body, and every. twin organ, throws a cross stimulus, or cross frequency, into this magnetic field. Those who are psychic are aware of that aura. A clairvoyant can draw the aura, and can color it truthfully and faithfully; it can be photographed as it has been on several occasions. It is a reality; it is matter. Those who diagnose psychically can see within the aura and see its breaks, the cessation of fluency, the disharmony and disruption caused by disease. Having seen that disruption in the color flow of the aura, a psychic practitioner is able to diagnose the condition and its cause. Psychic diagnosis is one of the most magnificent attributes man can have. To do this, the psychic practitioner does not see the body as flesh, but sees the body as you see your watch when the face has been removed. All those tiny pulsating organisms are there, and through exaggeration to the psychic eye, the change of color, and how the stimulus or regular beat of an organ is affected, a diagnosis is made and psychic healing begins.

There is, of course, that phase of psychic healing which entails the projection of love, and the projection of prayer. I was delighted to see that one of the leading clergymen in Sydney acknowledged the laying on of hands over

(continued from page 25) television just recently, a step, at least, in the right direction.

Thousands of men profess to be followers of the fusion of Jesus and the Christ, yet would run from anyone who wanted to cure them psychically. Yet lesus so eloquently said - and they wondered at His words - "Verily, I say unto you, greater things . . . " He did did not say that with the death of His physical body miracles would cease. He promised to those who would follow that this gift He had shown would be theirs also, that it was not any miracle, but a natural function of Divine Law which anyone can use. It is easier to use it than going to your sink, taking out a medicine glass, a bottle, and pouring out a drink of some vile potion that may or may not suit you.

The aura is your magnetic field. Let us say you are lying on a bed, that your liver is affected . . a great mass within producing indescribable pain. You are told surgery is inevitable. You know what surgery on the liver can mean, so in desperation you go to see a psychic. Within your aura there is a break, an interruption in the magnificent rhythm of your magnetic field. The practitioner, or medium, acts as an intermediary between a healing guide, a doctor, a practitioner on our side of life and the patient. Through the healer passes a frequency sufficient to mend the break and to recreate the fluency of the magnetic field around the body. Having done this, the patient begins to absorb his own cosmic stimulus. Then the practitioner exerts his own will, not in hypnotism, not in magic, not in voodoo, but in quiet concentration he envisions or pictures the organ concerned as perfectly and completely healed. He has no doubts, no fears, no emotional linkage with the person to be healed. He is separate and apart from his problems as healing takes place. Through his hands are projected frequencies or vibrations which, in these days of television and radio should be easy to understand. They pass through the walls of your house to entertain you every night. They don't knock for admission, neither do you have to leave the window open in order that you shall be able to 'see the pictures. The vibrations are of an etheric frequency . . just as psychic healing is. Many of you may have been thinking of someone far away, wishing there could be healing for a friend, a daughter, or a brother, perhaps, about whom you are worried. Healing can be done by any one of you in some degree, and by those of you with mediumistic tendencies to a much greater degree. Through prayer and the function of concentration; any of you can be successful. First, however, you must eliminate distance from your mind, for the con-

cept of distance exists only in physical values. It takes just as long to think of the man sitting in the seat next to you as it does to think of a man in Canada. It takes just as long to think of a man in Canada as it does to think of a man in Finland, or as it does to think of a man in Africa. Thus, we eliminate distance. We can reach each as quickly as the man next door, because the frequency of thought and the frequency of prayer are the waves that carry healing. If we are emotionally linked with the person who is ill, let us also strip ourselves of all fear. Let us take away any distrust, and realize that we can make things better, even though we ourselves may not be sufficiently strong to effect a cure. We can be instrumental in alleviating and improving a condition, whether the person receiving it is aware of it or not. At some quiet time in your day, you can sit for ten minutes, contemplating and meditating on the uni-You will want to lose yourverse. self in it, to become insignificant and to disappear.

Having attained a status of quiet and repose, project the thought of perfection of body and mind for five minutes. If the person to whom you are sending this love is sympathetic, ask them by letter, or phone, to sit at the same time with you. Ask that person to stop being afraid, to stop thinking of their illness, and to relax as much as possible that these frequencies being sent out shall penetrate the magnetic field of their body. We give credence to our Australian natives, the aboriginals, pointing the bone. Yet we say it is al-right to put them in a hospital. But, they soon die, don't they, for they know what they are doing. We give credence to that, yet you have so many opportunities to understand, to know, to learn that you have a hidden power within yourselves that you too may use this same wonder, this same gift . . a gift from God. This is not just a gift from the man, Jesus, but a gift from the Creator.

When God placed man on the earth, He did not desire man to be beset with disease and ugliness. He created man in perfection, but man disobeyed law after law; man flaunted discipline; man ate unwisely, drank unwisely and lived unwisely; he devastated his lands; he made himself a weakly thing.

If any is to be reinstated in the self physically, the first thing to understand is this: You are not a body with a mind. You are a mind that has experienced things for millions of years, temporally housed . . and I stress temporally . . in mortality. The tiny duration of your days in a physical world can be so much greater, so much more wonderful, exhilarating and stimulating, if you would coordinate more fully with the power of Spirit and utilize it. You have no hesitation whatsoever in utilizing the power of electricity. You do not use it up, but experience its power as it passes through your hands. This fantastic cosmic energy all around, you will not see or use up. In fact, you have scarcely touched the storehouse of it.

In the years that are ahead of this earth, years of trial and years of tribulation, are years when men will discover new things and; in discovering them, frighten even themselves. If you can be strong in the knowledge of the power of spirit, you shall have no fear. If your faith shall be such as to know that you are protected, no power on earth will destroy you, for the aura around your body will be such that by your strength, the extra fibering of your spiritual power, it stands between you and anything that could hurt you. It can make you twice the person you now are, one to whom people will listen, one who has something of value to say, and one who will not be thrown into confusion by the problems of those million things that crop up in every mortal year.

Psychic healing is the reinstatement of God in His world. He created you in perfection, and to my mind, this world will have completed its mission when man is perfect again, and when all things are perfect. Man shall speak in one tongue; nation shall no longer rise against nation; and man shall be healthy, cleansed and strong.

Those things that are failing you now are mainly things of your own creation. If you would use the gift of reason and consider what you eat, what you drink, how you live and what you think, already you would have begun to heal yourself, and psychically would be better to help a friend even though you may be far removed from one another physically, and even without that person's knowledge. You can exercise the power of projection of love, and the power of the projection of purposeful constructive thought long before you will have developed the gift of mediumship. You can send healing vibrations and strengthening stimulae whenever you desire. You can, by the power of thought, not only be instrumental in healing your family and friends, you can do the same with nations.

When you pray at night, instead of praying for the things you want in your own tiny heart and world, pray that those who guide the nations shall do so in wisdom. Instead of harboring fear thoughts of war, atomic energy, or catastrophies, before you go to sleep at night, send forth thoughts of peace to all the world, for in this way each positive thought sent out into the ether cancels out one of negation.

Those things which are alien to perfection can only be made perfect by the intervention and ministrations of the power that is Spirit.

where along the line. The difficulty in healing cancer - which is really not accomplished through surgery - is that it originates in all kinds of malice: hatred, revenge, jealousy, undermining animosity, envy, deep resentment, malicious gossip, anger, vicious opposition, or incurable condemnation. Such malignant motives are not healed by waving a wand, injecting a serum, or removing a breast.

Take for example, the case of a dear old lady, dependent on her daughter for sustenance, still always pleasant, helpful, self-effacing. A diagnosis reveals she has incipient cancer of her face. There is nothing in her own disposition to account (outwardly, at least) for this condition, if malignant growths are the result of a growing malignancy of thoughts. But, look a little deeper. You will see a son-in-law directing at her a constant volley of angry and vicious thoughts. He feels justified in his antagonism to her presence in his household, for his children must not make any noise when grandma is asleep; he and his wife cannot go to the movies. because someone must babysit with the old lady; he cannot have his friends in for a poker party because she is a strict religionist, opposed to gambling, drinking and smoking. Over a period of years his resentment of her presence, even though he keeps it well concealed, is directed at the face of his mother-inlaw. She accepts these malignant ' thoughts, perhaps unknowingly, and they eventuate in this malignant disease.

Examples can be multiplied ad infinitum of the mental nature of disease, many cases of which originate in the thought or environment of the prospective mother during pregnancy. "'As a man thinketh" is more than a well known Scriptural quotation, but even so, it does not tell the whole story. He may, indeed, objectify upon his body the effects of his own innermost thoughts, but often in the study of mental etiology one must look for the cause in the mentalities of those about him.

The influence of fear upon a sensitive patient is recognized in all forms of therapy, but only the metaphysician recognizes the degree to which the fearful picturing of disease accounts for its physical manifestation. Said Job, "The thing I greatly feared is come upon me." To say that a majority of cases of cancer, for instance, represent this form of outpicturing of the widely advertised seven symptoms might appear brash. Yet there are so many cases in which none of the primary evidences of malignant causation can be found, one might conclude that only the secondary picture . . fear . . is responsible for the

manifestations in the body. This fear is engendered by the constant suggestion that if a cancer goes beyond a certain stage it is impossible to cure it through surgery. The sensitive patient becomes terrorized by the possibility that he may be too late to save his life. Hence every pimple or outbreak on the skin, every twinge of pain in his "innards," sets up an almost hysterical, fear that he has contracted cancer. Very few medical men appreciate the degree to which their constant warnings operate as propaganda in favor of the disease, instead of allaying the fear of it.

Anyone who has seen on television the healing ministries of religious leaders or groups, regardless of whether he accepts such healings as bona fide, must admit that disease is mental, else prayers, incantations, and fanatic rituals could not produce even the appearance of cure. The skeptic insists that only physical ministrations of some kind can effect true healing. No one who understands metaphysics would try to convince him of his mistake in assuming that the body creates its own discords, so only bodily therapy can be successful and conclusive. That is the trend of medical practice, and it must continue until it is proven that the ministry of the greatest Healer the world has ever known is being repeated on earth today in these world-wide campaigns that represent the resurgence of religious conviction, that by spiritual means, and in the spiritual body rather than the physical, the extermination of disease from human experience will take place. That great Healer, speaking of similar contro-versies, counseled, "Let both grow together until the harvest"... in order that the tares might be separated from the wheat. The metaphysician is content to rest his case on that counsel, sure that in the end the mental aspects of disease will be all that need be considered, and that spiritual methods will be the only means of healing. Mean-while, it is good to be grateful for the tens of thousands of consecrated men and women who devote their lives to alleviate the suffering and heal the sick by material methods which conform to the level of consciousness acceptable to present day humanity. 00

Was there some previous relationship that caused this? asks Genevieve C.

Not necessarily, for often you meet people you dislike and have no reason to be against them. You have had nothing against them, yet you find yourself thoroughly disliking them. Usually there are two reasons for this. First, the vibrations emanating from the person causes you friction and distress, whether positive or negative. Then, too, the person may resemble slightly a person with whom you have had an unpleasant experience, or who dealt unfairly with you. This fact automatically rises to the surface of your objective mind, and, when it does, you feel distressed in that person's presence.

5 A student asks - - You said once that one cannot 'become' a trance medium, that one either is a trance medium or he is not. Do you care to elaborate on this?

I would not advocate anyone who is without his band of protective forces developing that particular phase of mediumship. Usually a person who is able to go into trance and produce spirit phenomena is one who has been destined to give himself over to this and be very flexible. That is why the flexibility of Rev. Zenor is so noticeable, so unusual. It was something very carefully carried out from the beginning, brought about normally, but planned on the inner planes before he was brought here to earth, and why so many interesting things have been brought through him over a period of years.

When we remark that you cannot 'become' a trance medium, we do not mean that you cannot train yourself, for we refer only to some methods that would be available. You cannot become a hypnotist by reading a book on hypnotism, nor can you become a trance medium by reading a book on trance mediumship. A trance medium is one who is worked on, played on by Spirit. Anyone who would be sensitive to, and give himself over to any Tom, Dick and Harry of the astral world could be asking for serious trouble if he did not have a strong band of forces to protect him. I am very doubtful about people who set themselves up as trance mediums overnight.

Trance mediumship is the most unusual phase of mediumship. Usually the entranced medium furnishes more ectoplasm and creates more phenomena than when he is aware of what is going on. The different phases of mediumship are very interesting and I shall bring you more on this subject in later discussions.

profitable or pleasant at all times, because they probably will not be. Nearly all successful mediums will tell you they passed through a trying period during the early stages of their mediumship. This, however, passes if you are progressing along the right road in your unfoldment. If you can consult an experienced medium, or sit with one during your psychic unfoldment, things will be much easier and safer for you.

The oncoming of trance is often signified by certain physical and psychical manifestations which should not alarm you when they appear: hiccoughs, sudden and spasmodic pains and cramps, a feeling of "all-goneness," nausea, flashes of light, faintness, or a sensation that everything is turning black before you. However, sometimes there is only a delightful sensation of falling asleep on a bed of roses. In these cases the student has developed properly and systematically and his guides or controls are also wise and helpful.

gone some vast cataclysm. The band of people I was about to join were the sole survivors of the human race who had come together to make a plan for the future. The men and women I saw as I neared them were not familiar to me. They were not sad, nor ill, nor distraught, but wrapt in a kind of mute ecstasy as they moved toward the majestic doors of the edifice.

Then one day, for the first time in my life, I found myself in front of Salisbury Cathedral in England. Suddenly I stood stock still . . hardly daring to breathe. This ancient church, waiting for me so quietly in its setting of dewy greensward, was the building of my dream in every detail. I knew the soaring line of the spires, the intricate carving of the doorway, the very feel of the stones under my feet. It was as though I had spent year upon year of my life in that very spot.

Stumbling into the church, still dazed and awed by my experience, I moved up the aisle and sat down for a moment to rest and gather my wits. As I raised my eyes, I saw directly before me the cenotaph of Robert Bingham, a remote collateral ancestor of whom I had read.

He was the bishop of that see for seventeen years. He was the man who had passed across that very spot of ground, over and over again each day. He was the man who knew that scene . . so new to my outward experience . . as well as he knew the palm of his own hand.

Bishop Bingham, however, died in 1246, and was laid to his rest seven long centuries ago.
