Man's Adventure in

PART I.

Excerpts from address given at the 1962 Annual Conference
of The Association for Research and Enlightenment

This is the generation of time and space. We are now perhaps the most *space-conscious* and *time-conscious* people in the entire history of the human race. It is well for us to remember, however, in our search outward into the infinities of things, that we should take an occasional pause for reflection about the time and space dimensions within ourselves. Some have tried to estimate the largest possible existing distance between man and some other remote object, and it was finally decided that *the largest interval as yet unconquered is the interval between the minds of two human beings*. This is an interesting thought and we should realize that these great distances between human beings are created by such forces as intolerance, selfishness, and ignorance. So while we are trying to conquer space around us, let us look at the *space inside ourselves*.

Actually, the mystery of the internal man is as great as any mystery of the universe around him. Man looks out into heaven, or into the vast area of sky, and he sees a few planets wandering around, and he sees the twinkling optimism of some distant star, but when he looks inside himself, he sees the largest vacuum known to man. This is a serious statement; but when we look inside - - what do we see? The answer is, "Nothing." If you do not believe this, try it. You will find that it is almost impossible to look inside, because all our faculties and powers impel us to look outward; and our sensory perceptions will not easily reverse their direction. So we look outward, and we see many things; we look inward, and we cannot even see the principal complex that is disturbing us; we do not know very much about the internal mystery. Yet we are inclined to suspect that the innermost and the furthestmost are the same thing; that if we go deep enough into man, we find the Infinite; and if we go deep enough into the Infinite, perhaps we will find the mysterious

link of life that seems to lurk within ourselves.

Man is forever attempting to conquer the world around him, but all too often, he is conquered by the disorder of the world within him. Today, we are much worried about atomics, about Asia, about Mr. Krushchev, and little Mr. Castro. These are our problem children. We really are bewildered by them because we have not solved the basic impulses of human beings. We do not know why man feels the way he feels, why he thinks the way he thinks; and until some of these mysteries are solved, the life we live is going to be one sad adventure down through the mystery of time.

If space is a problem, time also presents certain dimensions of difficulty. First of all, what is time? Does time have any existence outside of man? Did the human being create the concept of time as a means of dividing infinity? Is man living in a real time, or is he living in an infinity which he has divided into time for a series of purposes? At least we know that we have taken a mysterious thing called time and we have divided it into past, present, and future. Past is one of the most dangerous dimensions of time, because under the hypnosis of our own past, we burden the future with unhappy memories, with traditions, prejudices and other heritages of doubt and opinion, which may be a constant burden, also, upon our present existence. Then we have the present time. NOW is the appointed time. But at this particular generation in our development, the present moment is not especially reassuring. So with the past very difficult, and the present not so reassuring, we always have the future. We have been mortgaging it for ages, and about the best thing we have bestowed so far upon the future is unpaid debts. The future is also a rather dim time dimension. We are not so sure that it is

very much more than a mysterious vacuum which we fill with hopeful expectancies. Being unable to exist in a satisfactory manner today, we survive upon the hope that things will be better. *Why*, we do not know; *when*, we do not know.

Time, of course, measures events. Actually, it has very little meaning except what happens while this time seems to be passing. Growth, for example, reveals a constructive motion in time. Time can be the invitation to life, or it can be the incessant reminder of death. How many of us realize that the greatest of all destroyers of life, as far as we know such things, is simply time itself? For according to the dictates of time, within the next hundred years, time will take better than five billion human lives by the perfectly natural process of old age and death.

Perhaps we have not realized that time and space have a common denominator in eternity. All time disappears in, or is absorbed into, the vast ocean of eternity. This eternity can be divided into fragments of time, but it pervades every division of time. Just as creatures born in time die, so time itself dies in eternity. Space, also, ends in eternity - - an eternity of infinite expanse - - and all things that exist in space have eternity as their origin and as their ultimate condition. Thus, everything we know about, and everything that we contemplate, arises from an unknown cause, enjoys a mysterious duration, and vanishes again in a strange alchemy of effects which we cannot trace or fully understand.

The great adventure in time and space, therefore, is this *adventure*



of our own existence. No matter what happens, no matter how rapidly we move, no matter how far we go, we must always be where we are. We must always live with ourselves. We can never outrace the weaknesses of our own natures. We can never travel so much more rapidly than right, that we can outrun our own ignorance. Wherever he is, whatever he is doing, man must live with himself; for man himself, time and space are all that he knows.

It is appropriate and proper that a thoughtful person should recognize himself as a *citizen of time and space and eternity in every moment of his existence.* He must recognize that if he has any significance at all, this significance must transcend not only the small world in which we live, but the small span through which we pass. There is nothing very cosmic about living in Oshkosh for seventy years, nor any other place. The significance to the

universe itself must be far greater than what we know. A man will say, "In a short period of fifty years, I have built a ten million dollar business;" but experience says that in a short period of five minutes, he can die and leave it all behind. We become so hypnotized by the monthly bills that we come to conclude that the universe is a series of notes, with something ever coming due. We now have a new cycle - - the annual cycle distinguished by income tax; so that we measure life now from one payment to the next, and measure success in terms of being able to meet that payment. We live in the immediate, and it is very small, unsatisfying, and inadequate. Yet we do not know just how to break through.

By the very circumstance of our inheritance - - cultural and educational - - we live very largely in a little world of our own creation. We are reaching out with our building programs, covering more and more of the soil with monuments to our own interests, attitudes, and beliefs. Little by little, the great universe is disappearing under an intensive program of freeways - - freeways that lead from one attitude to the same attitude, not to a different one; a magnificent road that leads us quickly from our house to the house of our most intimate friend forty-two miles away. We cover the forty two miles with ease, but there is great doubt whether we ever understand our friend when we get to him. Our friendships are so brittle that the slightest shadow or tension may destroy years of patient relationships.

So let us think a little about what to do to escape the pressures that time and space have created for us. Time has created the pressure of urgency. It has become the superintendent of every job, the executive of every position and employment. Time is constantly hanging over us, warning us that the weeks and the months and the years are

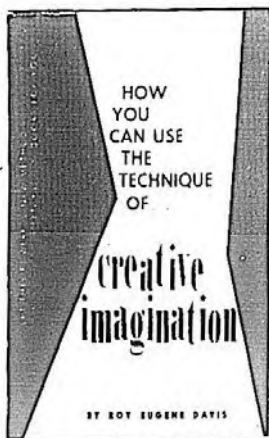

TWO "PSYCHICS" IN ONE FAMILY

Chang Ling, a Chinese scholar in spirit, stood in the middle of the room as he has done many times in the past. This particular time, however, his manifestation was slightly different for the hour was 3 a.m. - - and I was blissfully sound asleep!

Alas, I was not to remain blissfully asleep because Chang Ling created a powerful spiritual vibratory state of attunement, and up in bed I sat to see him standing in the room before me. A ray of bright light illuminated the area where he stood, and by now all sleep was gone. I could see he was directing me to look at the far end of the room. There clearly to be seen was a small dog sitting beneath what appeared to be an archway of Chinese design.

A misty formation, similar to delicate billowy clouds, surrounded the dog - - and I experienced the sensation of being able to see a long, long way into those clouds. The Chinese motif archway and the clouds of great horizons were to have special significance for me.

Long ago count was lost as to the number of times spirit manifestations, message work and envisionments have blessed my working hours in the quest to enlighten spiritually those who sought such aid. However, it was the first time Chang Ling manifested himself for the purpose of directing the enlightenment to and for me.

His hand stretched out, he pointed to the dog at the far end of the room. He said that before the day ended I would own that dog! . . . and that the dog would know me when she saw me. That was early in August, 1962 in the state of Florida.

Chang Ling stated that I did not need further proof of spirit existence, but thought that I might enjoy being enlightened by the direct demonstration of spirit attunement in the form of a four-footed bundle of

energy, intelligence and loyalty - - namely . . . that of a dog!

My nocturnal visitor folded his arms, stepped back in the room, the radiant light faded, the far end of the room darkened . . . and silence settled upon the room. I settled back on the bed in full intention to give thought to all that had transpired - - when I fell sound asleep.

Several hours later when I awakened I started telling those at home of my plans to go get a dog. Suddenly I realized what I had said, and I uttered. . . "a dog?" Then it came to me that I had been visited during the night by Chang Ling, and all he had said became clear to me.

I called a dear friend and asked if she would drive me out Beach Drive in Jacksonville. She said she would be happy to do so, and in a few moments we were on our way to the kennels. We did not know we were two hours too soon to get into the kennels as they did not open until one o'clock that particular day. Almost as if the attendant knew we were coming, he said he would make a special consideration in our case. He took us into the building, and we walked through two rooms without stopping to view any of the dogs, making our way to the third room, as if guided by a higher force to do so.

There in the third room, sitting at the far end of a large compartment sat a small Manchester dog (whose origin is traced to China) looking out at me as if saying to herself. . . "Well, it took you quite a while to get here!"

I asked the attendant if I might see that dog a little closer and if it

might be brought out so I could touch it. The sound of my voice brought the dog to the front of the compartment, and the attendant then easily reached in and lifted it from compartment.

Instantly the dog came to my side and pressed its tiny body firmly to my legs as if trying to cement itself to me lest we become parted again. As Chang Ling had stated, before that very day reached the hour of noon, papers were signed and ownership of the dog was completed.

I was told spiritually that I would know the right name to give her when the time came to address her, and quite as predicted, when I reached down to pat her, I uttered the words. . . SUZIE BELLE. . . as if she had been called that for years, and she looked up and recognized the sound alertly.

Suzie Belle made it known to me that day, and in the many days since that have followed she was all that Chang Ling said she would be - - - and more!

During my day's work, if a spiritual state of attunement is inharmonious or adverse, Suzie Belle at times instantly has arisen to her feet and quickly left the room. If she does not leave the room, she often lifts her head and looks directly around the room with a speculating glance. By the same token, if the spiritual state of attunement in the room where I am meditating and working spiritually is radiating harmoniously, she will romp in what appears to be a state of "happi-

ness," or repose in perfect contentment and ease.

It is a well known fact that all animals are psychic; indeed, a few are psychically *developed*. Certainly did not take long to realize that Suzie Belle could 'see' spirit entities in the room.

Suzie Belle has a lighter side to her moods also, so we will detour from specific spirit attunement to some every-day-happenings. Witness the fun derived from her *telephone accomplishments*. When our dear friend, Mr. Henry W. Hill of San Antonio, Texas calls us on the telephone Suzie Belle is right there Johnny-on-the-Spot to place her ear to the receiver to listen to our friend talk to her. Holding the receiver to her little ear, she presses so hard against it lest she miss one single word that one has to grasp the receiver with firmness. Her facial expression changes over and over as she listens to the comments on the telephone. When the conversation she hears on the telephone is completed, then and only then - - and without fail - - she proceeds to kiss the telephone.

Other people visiting our home have witnessed Suzie Belle's telephone etiquette and have been amazed at her apparent control of the situation, for she gives the impression that being called to the telephone to listen in on friends calling her is just the normal, usual procedure for any well-mannered dog of the day!

Many times during a week's work when I have a thought in my mind that the moment is at hand to keep this appointment or do this or that shopping, Suzie Belle will arise and quickly go to the door, all ready and enthusiastic about the prospect of going to town. Yet not a word has been uttered or a gesture made in those instances about going anywhere! None-the-less, she 'heard' and 'understood.'

A dog is a very loyal, unselfish soul . . . caring not if his or her master is rich or poor, color or creed not being important, and will live in a tent or a mansion, or go through any peril just to be with its master. All of this he does from the goodness of his heart and love of his master. Indeed . . . a dog is Man's Best Friend.

The arm of the writer is controlled by a spiritual intelligence wishing to convey information and teach us more of the spiritual laws. Lessons frequently are given concerning the other side of life, information so badly needed to further our spiritual growth

Unfortunately, in many instances as this gift is unfolding, the physical instrument, the medium, begins to ask material questions concern-

writing." Sometimes they become the slaves of their own imagination. Once I knew a lady who would not even go shopping unless "the pencil said she could," and the result was a nervous breakdown.

When sitting for this phase of mediumship, one should become absolutely *impersonal*. When I had this phase of mediumship some years ago I could read a book and my arm would still write independently, but I never knew what was being written. When the writing was finished, the pencil just dropped from my fingers.

ing business, family life, and sometimes stoops to asking questions about neighbors and friends.

What kind of entity would give such information? How can it be reliable? Friends knowing this person is developing automatic writing ask for writings. . . "see what you can get for me . . . Are we going to take this trip ? . . Are we going to sell our house ?" . . etc.

The result can be only chaos and, in the end, as I have seen many times, worry and poor health for the writer. It stands to reason that any spirit of a high order is not going to answer such questions, for in order to grow as individuals we must learn to solve our own material problems.

Asking questions about other people, trying to find out about their personal affairs which certainly are not our concern can only attract a spirit who is ignorant and still tied to material things. After all, the law of attraction holds good on all planes for everything. However, in most instances of this kind, Spirit has nothing to do with it. The writer's arm moves subject to his OWN wishes and imagination; the *subconscious* takes the place of a controlling spirit.

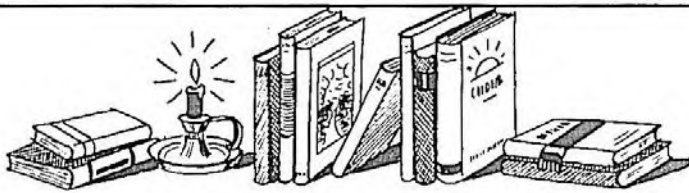
I have met the individual who has the honest belief he possesses this gift just because the pencil has moved, and will scarcely undertake anything of importance, even trivial business, unless they "sit for

ings, all lessons given by Spirit. Not once in the three years that I was used as an instrument for these writings did I receive a personal message. Several entities used my arm; when they had completed their work through this automatic writing, that phase of mediumship suddenly ceased entirely. No matter when or where I sat to see if it would return, to this day it never has. At the time of its usage I always sat at a certain time on certain days. My arm was controlled by a powerful force, and as soon as the subject was finished, my hand then relaxed and the pencil fell on the paper.

I have met people who sit for this writing every day, several times a day, but this is most unwise. One can overdo anything. Usually our spirit friends will be there waiting, so we must not fail them.

Then, too, we must prove that the writing is coming from Spirit. "By their fruits ye shall know them." Are we getting worthwhile information? Are we receiving something that benefits us spiritually? If we do not get anything that helps us spiritually, something we can pass on to others, it is best left alone.

Often it takes weeks, and even months, to establish contact with our spirit friends. Once established, we must be certain we are attracting the right kind. We are particular whom we invite into our

With the advent of the industrial age and the increase of scientific knowledge, we have been made increasingly aware of the need for physical protection. We have been taught how to use safety measures to protect health, life and property. Today no surgeon would dream of entering an operating room without taking every precaution to protect himself and his patient, but we have little knowledge of spiritual protection. As we read Paul's letter to the Ephesians, Chapter 6, verses 11 to 17, we see that he taught those who would follow the Light to "put on" or clothe themselves in "the whole Armor of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil." Long before Paul's day the Mystics taught their students the laws of protection which they called, "The Ring Pass Not."

In a sense, ministers, truth teachers and healers are spiritual physicians and they need to know how to protect themselves and those who come to them for help. Many wonderful souls have been lost to the world and were unable to finish the work that their Heavenly Father had given them to do because they did not know the laws of protection. God has so freely given this great protecting power to all His children. This power is ever present, but we need to recognize and make use of it, for "faith without works is dead." The laws of spiritual protection are to be found all through the Bible. One of the most well-known promises of protection is in the 91st Psalm, and the keyword is "dwelleth." This means to stay, to live, to reside in, not to run in and out, but to build such a strong awareness and consciousness that - - - "In Him we live and move and have our being."

There are many other words of protection in the Bible, such as hand, pavilion, name and armor, and these are but a few of them. Spiritual protection can be seen by those who have their spiritual faculties developed and have extended vision. The Christ spoke of these extended senses when He said, "they seeing see not; and hearing they hear not."

The Armor of God appears as a dazzling white Light completely surrounding the person so clothed, "Let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the Armor of Light." The vibrations of this radiance are of such high frequency that they do not last, and this protection should be renewed at least twice a day. Use it in the morning upon arising, at night be-

fore going to sleep . . . and oftener if necessary. "I will greatly rejoice in the Lord for He hath clothed me with the garments of salvation."

This protecting power can be placed around yourself, or your loved ones, through the use of the Word of God when said by you *in faith*.

Whenever you feel the need of protection, say to yourself silently, or aloud, "IN THE NAME AND THROUGH THE POWER AND BY THE WORD OF JESUS CHRIST, A WALL OF LIVING FLAME IS BUILT AROUND ME, (you can bring in others and material objects also) . . . AND I GIVE THANKS TO THE FATHER THAT IT IS DONE. AMEN."

Be sure to use this protection whenever and wherever you travel - - your own car or that of another, trains, boats, or planes. If your mode of travel is by plane, include the plane, all who are aboard, the luggage, etc. Simply change the wording to meet the particular need. Use it to protect your children each day as they go to and from school, also for your home, your garden and your pets. When using this statement, it is only necessary to repeat the words once, for you have concentrated the power of the Holy Name and encircled yourself with it. "Whatever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus."

There are times in all our lives when we find that negative thoughts and emotions sweep over us and cloud our better judgment. Whenever you find yourself emotionally disturbed, irritated or critical, as the result of your own thinking, or because the thoughts or emotions of others have impinged themselves upon you, it is possible to bring the situation under control by cleansing your *aura*. You can sweep these thoughts out of your feeling world by visualizing your aura flooded with the pure, white Light of the Christ as you say:

"IN THE NAME AND THROUGH THE POWER AND BY THE WORD OF JESUS CHRIST, MY AURA IS CLEANSED AND PURIFIED WITH HIS PURE, WHITE LIGHT AND I GIVE THANKS TO THE FATHER THAT IT IS DONE, AMEN."

Your aura is like a kaleidoscope, which continually changes in form and color. The radiations are bright and beautiful or dark and muddy, depending upon the thoughts entertained. Use this auric cleansing as a spiritual bath and it will help you to control your thoughts, desires, and feelings. We take time to bathe our bodies - - but we should also take time daily to cleanse and purify our thoughts and emotions with His Holy Light.

astral projection

Astral projection is to many stu-
dents a fascinating subject of study.
It is a phase of development replete
with possibilities of soul growth and
the accumulation of spiritual know-
ledge. In this way the *real* self may
emerge from its vehicle of clay, and
transcend bodily limitations to
gather information and experiences
which otherwise would be impos-
sible to do.

First of all, let us understand
what the astral body is, its function,
and its inherent possibilities. In
his magnificent work on the subject,
"The Projection of the Astral
Body," Mr. Muldoon defines it as:
"the double or the etherial counter-
part of the physical body which it
resembles and with which it nor-
mally coincides. It is thought to be
composed of semi-fluidic and subtle
forms of matter, invisible to the
physical eye."

It is this astral body or etherial
counterpart which withdraws from
the physical body during normal
sleep, or during periods of uncon-
sciousness, fainting, or anaesthesia.
This type of projection rarely pro-
duces memory of the experience, as
is the case with conscious or con-
trolled projection. It is in this
latter condition that one may con-
sciously visit scenes or persons at
a distance, or gather information un-
available while in the normal state.
In both types of projection, the
astral body is firmly connected to
the physical body by the silver cord. If
by shock, accident, or if for any
reason the cord is severed, death
would be the immediate result. For-
tunately, however, this is extremely
rare.

Another propensity of the astral
body is its ability to travel great
distances at speeds which defy
thought. It can also pass through
solid matter which seemingly offers
it no resistance. It responds read-
ily and apparently without confu-
sion, to the direction of intelligence
or mind.

Often intelligence functions during
the time the astral counterpart is
disengaging itself from the physical
body. This can be with or without
pain or discomfort during the emer-
gence. It is more natural and com-
mon . . . certainly more pleasing and

desirable . . . that no intelligence
manifest until the projection has
been completed, or at least no
memory of the process remains.

We are all acquainted with the
process of sleep-walking, whether
we have ourselves experienced it or
merely have heard of such cases.
This is a state in which persons,
sound asleep, walk about, sing,
swim, or do any number of things at
the direction of the subconscious
mind. We might say that the same
thing happens during astral projec-
tion, not to the physical body, of
course, but to the astral counter-
part of the body. Mr. Muldoon calls
this type of projection, *Astral Som-
nambulism*, and such a term is emi-
nently fitting.

In astral extrusion one may find
oneself standing stationary, walk-
ing, or moving at normal speed, or
advancing effortlessly and rapidly
through space. One is not aware
of the astral feet touching the floor
or road, or whatever the body is
passing over; rather one seems to
float easily somewhat above it.
There is also the projection to far
places which is accomplished in a
flash without any feeling of aware-
ness of moving . . . one simply is
there! . . . or safely back in the body
again without apparent time having
elapsed.

(Next month we shall learn HOW to
develop and use these powers.)

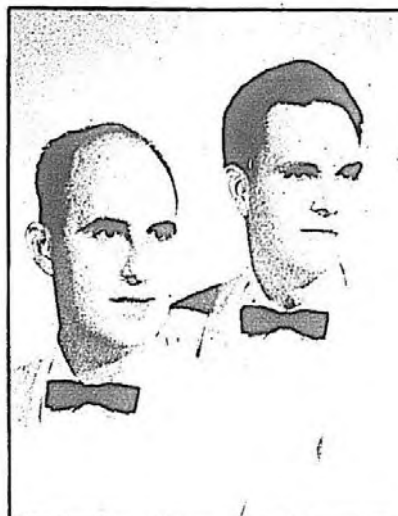

homes; we should be just as particular whom we allow to control our hand to write.

Just because the pencil moves does not prove we have automatic writing. At first the pencil will wander across the paper making lines and scratches, but this is often muscular reaction. Once the arm is *controlled*, there can be no mistake about it. I would like to make this comparison. When one is fishing, the hook is baited and thrown into the water. Nothing happens as we sit and wait for a fish to bite. The line floats limply in the water. Suddenly a fish takes the bait. There is no mistaking it; a force is there pulling on the line.

So it is with automatic writing. We cannot mistake the power that at last controls the arm and makes the pencil write. The handwriting is different from our own in automatic writing, for a different personality is asserting itself. Very often at that time we become conscious of a spirit presence near us. We are not always controlled by the same spirit. Let us open our minds to receive lessons from any good source. There are many teachers in the great beyond *willing* and *anxious* to help us once we open the door for them. We are the Pupils. They are the Teachers.

For the guidance of newcomers to this work, I should like to quote the following excerpt from the wonderful book, "Spirit Teachings," by the great medium, Rev. W. Stainton Moses.

"I have been scrupulously careful never to attempt automatic writing when I am physically ill or in pain, mentally worried or anxious, or near any person so suffering, or in the midst of influences that are disturbing. To this precaution I attribute much of the regular and equable character of my communications. As a rule they are curiously fluent; the books in which they are written show no erasure or alteration, and the tone of the message is very level and sustained."

slipping by. The tyranny of time affects everyone, and under this tyranny we have become a highly neurotic civilization.

Space also problems us. I am inclined to suspect that this effort to shoot ourselves to some distant star or to orbit around the earth is much more a *neurotic compulsion* than a scientific phenomenon. I believe the recent space hero said, among other things, that it was very quiet and relaxing out there; that far from being boring, it was a rather pleasant interlude - - away from salesmanship pressures, and far from the tensions of the everyday and the commonplace. When an individual has reached the degree of psychological complexity where he can do very little with himself, he has a tremendous instinct and impulse to create empire. Nearly all our great empire-builders have been miserable little people without friends, without love, and without self-understanding. So when we are frustrated in the common, simple, kindly, things, we attempt enormous, important, world-shaking events - - largely to get our minds off ourselves.

It seems to me that our grandiose effort to conquer space is perhaps a psychosomatic symbol of the strange evasion by which we avoid the effort to conquer ourselves. We all know this problem; it arises every day. An individual with a bad disposition can almost always be found giving lessons in conduct. A person who has never shown any integration of his own personality can solve the problems of everyone but himself - - or thinks he can. So it is in this world. Man, somehow defeated in the effort to find out the meaning and purpose for himself, has become an empire-builder and a space conqueror. In this he is telling us the simple story of his own unhappiness. Yet there must be some other way to approach this problem. We must find ways and means of existence - not a disaster. How are we going to make this adventure possible? ing happily, constructively, and intelligently in time and space. Our life here should be an adventure. . . not a disaster.

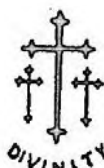

The desire to live forever on earth intrigues the minds of many who are having a happy time on earth expressing themselves in various ways as they personally desire. Others, having suffered sickness, pain and disillusionments of various kinds and, having no vision of future peaceful expressions on earth through the physical body, often yearn for "oblivion" (as they put it, and sometimes say, "I don't care when I die. I only want to be free of troubles.")

Some people believe that death of the physical body is annihilation. As one man put it, "When you're dead, you're dead . . . and that's all there is to it!"

One thing is sure; *If one waits long enough, he will certainly find out whether he is alive later in the*

invisible world, or he certainly will not.

Science, in its effort to penetrate the veil between the Invisible and Visible Realms around this planet called Earth, certainly has proved, even to the senses of man, that *there is an invisible substance* (called ether) which takes on form according to thought images, and this substance seems to "come and go" all around us.
