




THANK THEE, GOD




HOW TO CALL ON YOUR PSYCHIC PRESENCE

Preparing for our Psychic Presence

Seek and ye shall find, it is written. First, however, you must know what you are seeking. The first thing we seek is the solution of our problems. For some of us those problems are legion, intertangled in one huge mass, like an ivy vine gone wild. So we begin at the beginning, offering each detail of each problem to our inner Psychic Presence. God's redeeming force, His knowledge and healing actions. eradicates problems, shows us the solutions, if we listen to the clues, the whispered intuition, coming from our own Psychic Presence.

Personal success of every kind is available to those who harmonize their powers. Success at home, and in business is the result of decisions made and actions carried out by even-tempered mind energy, decisions based on the inner-self, decisions of confidence and good will, decisions from our soul.

In the great uncharted region, the subconscious, our Psychic Presence lives, breathes, and rules. We learn to heed its warnings, admonitions, sudden revelations of what we should do. We encourage this Psychic Presence development by dethroning the ordinary knowledge conveyed by our senses — knowledge that has been



verbalized inadequately, then constantly rearranged like so much old furniture by our conscious, empirically trained mind.

First Level Unfoldment

The first level of unfoldment is really the activation of the truth that there is more than one source of insight.

We ask that God give us the Grace to heed our Psychic Presence. We are not bold enough to develop it fully yet on this level. We simply prove its aliveness, prove to ourselves that it is there, watching and aiding, if we call upon it.

First Level Meditation

"God, reveal my Psychic Presence, show my inner sensitivity and unity with all divine forces, activate the vibratory patterns of psychic unfoldment, drive out all evil and disharmony, show prophecy and wisdom, knowledge of the peace and harmony of all things. Help me to sharpen and control my perception of the world, that I may see the truth from the false, that understanding of the smallest particles of my life may combine with the greater reaches of Psychic Presence so that the final self-realization of my complete soul and destiny is the mystery to me revealed."

We free ourselves from our faulty observations, from limited, objectively verifiable knowledge, from ignorance of our Psychic Presence. Our spark of divinity, the likeness which we have incommon with God, is best explored when the Psychic Presence is free to perform on its own, while the conscious mind rests.

Second Level Unfoldment

Trained self-suggestion puts our conscious mind at rest. We develop a trance state so that our Psychic Presence can emerge from the recessed, subconscious storeroom. We begin to cross the barriers separating our spiritual and physical selves. Our trance frees our Psychic Presence, allows it to project itself clair-voyantly back and forth across the limitations of time and space.

Second Level Meditation

"As I enter trance, reach soul knowledge, personal understanding, and true psychic mystery, I aid the integration of conscious and subconscious energy. I leave behind the textures of wonderment surrounding life's turning points. I break time and space. Walk forth Great Psychic Presence!"

Time and space contain enclosed particles of faith and reason as separate orbiting love beings, but the Psychic Presence shows all tiny particles of love and meaning revolving upon the smallest necessity of the other.

During the process, time stands still, that is, it appears suspended, as our Psychic Presence overcomes consciously fixed time and the limitations of space. During trance, the suspended moments, separate from all other moments, but still speaking for all that was, and is yet to come, becomes your Psychic Presence, your subconscious control personality, speaking to you clairvoyantly.

Our Psychic Presence shares in the collective experience of all mankind, collects all subconscious material and energy, is the channel from God's Infinite Intelligence.

"I want" you all to know that "i" am blessed that "i" have in me the Father.


"I want" illumination through His grace.


IT WAS SUCH a long time ago. So many centuries have passed ... yet I can recall it as though it were vesterday. I had begun a long journey across the burning sands of my country: my destination was a great distance away, across the lonely desert, and I had no way to get there except to walk - and to walk I had to have sandals. I had to have food. I had to have water I had none of these to drink. things. My few worldly resources had long since been used up, so I had neither food, nor any way to purchase food. Worse yet, I had only the merest of garments, and these were badly worn and patched. I had repaired my sandals so often that at last they were absolutely beyond repair and were useless to me. I knew this was going to happen, and now the time I had foreseen was upon me.

How well I remember the day when this came to pass. It was not because I had been negligent in any way. It was because I did not have the material. Nor did I have anything with which to purchase it, nor to barter for it. we ate in those days, and what, in your language, might be termed a canteen of water! There it was, I looked at him: and as I looked at him there before me, I knew that he had come from nowhere on this For, indeed, there was nowhere for him to have concealed himself. Nothing but barren sands could be seen as far as the eye could reach, and anyone who had not a supply of food and water soon would have perished; yet I saw him not until he appeared there before me, with his soulful eyes and fine, expressive face. I found that as I looked upon him I had ceased hopping from one foot to another, almost without knowing it, and that somehow the fears of losing my life had gone away.

I reached out, thinking, of course, that he was going to give me the water. He was not unkind or forbidding, but neither did he offer it. Then with my left hand I reached out for the black bread; but somehow, although he did not move, I was not able to reach it. I tried to sieze some of the cloth from the ample robe that he wore, but as I did this I realized that it was not real to my touch, and that I could not grasp it. Then I began to think I was losing my mind.

Gradually I came to the realization that he was not real — but a symbol in a sense. He was a master teacher who had appeared before me when I was in great distress, and in the last stages of physical suffering.

I tell you this story for I know that such a tale can come to mean a great deal to you in your everyday life.

As his voice had spoken to me before, it spoke again: "The black bread take not, nor drink from the water. If I saved your life, then you would be very grateful that I had appeared to you. You would think it very strange that I appeared to you as I do." Of course he was speaking in the language of that day, which I am translating into your tongue, but it means the same.

• CREATURE FROM OUTER SPACE?

A snapshot taken by Jim Templeton of his 5-year-old daughter, Elizabeth, on a lonely stretch of marsh near the Solway Firth in Westmorland, England gave everyone a surprise when instead of there being just grass and blue sky in the background, a 7 to 8 foot tall stranger appeared on the film just behind Elizabeth's head. From the angle of the picture, he had the appearance of a spaceman wearing some kind of protective headgear. Templeton and several experts had the film checked with the photographic firm, as well as the processor, but could find no explanation in the way of technical faults, and, in fact, were amazed at how clear the photograph appeared. According to the National Enquirer, the police are quite concerned about finding an explanation to the identity of this unexpected visitor as the occurrence took place near an atomic works and a NATO radio-tracking base for a rocket testing station.

ESP STUDY URGED FOR SPACE TRAVEL

Everett F. Dagle, chief of Data Sciences for the Air Force Cambridge Research Laboratories, stated recently, according to the Los Angeles Times, that scientists must explore extrasensory perception or other mental processes as a means of communicating with astronauts who voyage millions of miles from earth. "Not only do we have a scientific responsibility for doing this research," he stated, "we also have a moral responsibility for doing so, even in the face of strong ultraconservative opposition," Dagle said further that neither the United States or the Soviet Union has put a man in true space. "While it is true that impressive orbital flights have been made by American and Soviet astronauts," he said, "it must be realized that as they went spinning around they still had visual re-



ference to Mother Earth below them and they were still tied to her gravitational apron strings." Dagle said that experimental psychology has shown that when a subject is placed in an environment foreign to his normal one, he often undergoes striking personality changes, with accompanying changes in his perceptual capabilities. To minimize any sense of disorientation, space travelers should be provided with a swift, effective means of communication with earth. He said if an astronaut 100 million miles from earth sent a radio transmission to his ground station, it should take approximately eighteen minutes for the return trip message. "To the lonely adventurer in space, an eighteen minute delay could be intolerable," Dagle said, "and a disembodied robot-like voice from a loudspeaker might not satisfy his deep personal need for human contact." How wonderful to know that the means of communication already lies within each one of us!

DO YOU DAYDREAM?



THE SEVENTEENTH CENTURY was a turbulent period for those with colored skins in the Spanish South Americas. By the usual process of brutal conquest, the Spaniards had colonized this fabulously territory and "commandeered" the material wealth of its Indian people,

It was a period of Christian injustice when cross and sword were used to convert the heathen, and at the same time rob and enslave him, to the pompand glory of the King of Spain.

In the wake of imperialism came the offsprings of varied intermarriage. Spanish and native Indian, Spanish and imported negro slaves, each swelled the tide of rapidly increasing population. Of the forty to fifty thousant residents in Lima, only some seven to eight thousand were white.

The imported negroes were the slave population, but for considerations which were not always worthy, they were able to purchase their way to freedom. To be a colored child and born "of a father unknown" became the lot of many,

So it was that Anna Velazquez, a freed colored woman, gave birth to a boy child, who on the 9th December 1579, at the Church of St. Sebastian, Lima, Peru, was baptized Martin and registered by the parish priest as of a "father unknown." It was common knowledge that the colored boy, Martin, was the child of a Spanish nobleman, Juan de Porres.

Juan de Porres became Governor of Panama and undertook the responsibility for the education of Martin and his sister. Martin became apprenticed to a surgeon, and, even at the age of twelve years, was noted for his care and devotion to the sick, During youthful skirmishes between two Spanish boys, one received an injury to his eye from a knife. We are told that the eye "jumped out of its socket and hung," It was given prayerful treatment by a colored youth, and within a few days it was healed.

The colored boy was Martin de Porres. He became a Brother in the Order of St. Dominic, and a healer whose fame spread to many lands. He became Blessed Martin de Porres, and on May 7, 1962, the half-caste Dominican lay-brother was canonized in St. Peters, Rome.

It is claimed that during his life there were healing "miracles after miracles" and that "they did not cease even at his death,"

Martin de Porres had many pious qualities, but the most outstanding was his love for all men, be they Spaniard, Indian, or Negro slave. He was a friend to them all, and as a healer realized the absence of racial barriers in the realm of Spirit.

It is recorded that when he died there were mourners from many lands, and amongst these were to be found the Viceroy of Peru and the Archbishop of Mexico. From both Peru and Mexico I have received confirmation of the healing miracles, which have taken place during recent years in consequence of intercession to him in Spirit.

When the colored Martin was Canonized during 1962, great publicity was given to this event by the English press. He was declared to be the first colored Saint. This, of course, is not true; it is more correct to say that he was the first Negro Saint and the second native-born Saint of the Americas.

Martin's medical knowledge and

They went something like: "What is the subconscious mind?" "What is its importance to us on the earth plane?" "What causes dreams and nightmares?" "Why do we have dreams and nightmares we cannot control, or is it possible to gain control over them?" "What causes hallucinations?" and many others of a similar vein. going to receive your share. Your ego is hurt, and you fall victim to it. Your ideas are being challenged and you cannot endure this. So you keep yourselves in a dilemma, wondering what is going to take place.

As you deal with the people in your life, and you have unpleasant experiences, you begin to build something that is contrary to the laws of God. You nurture your hurts along for a period of time, then you "forget it," and only occasionally does that unpleasant experience come to mind. It is the culmination of a great many experiences that were unpleasant that made such a deep impression on your subjective consciousness, and which has created this "something" that is there. They have That is the become imbedded. reason why it becomes necessary to cleanse the subjective portion of the brain.

We cannot sit and mull over the things that have transpired in our lives. We have to expect that if we do so, this is recorded in the subjective and it will cause us a lot of trouble when it comes into play. The subjective can and does become overactive. It produces inharmonious relations with others. It produces hallucinations. It produces many ideas that are conjured up in your mind that are not really true, but which become a reality to you, so that you become a victim to them.



HAT IS HEAVEN really like? This is a question that has puzzled much of mankind throughout all history. Have some persons been given a "preview" of Heaven through dreams, visions, astral trips or other means?

A Bradenton, Florida woman had a vivid dream recently and she wrote to me as follows:

"Last night I had a dream. My husband and I were living in a nice town. How we got there — who knows? Anyway, we had a pleasant home as did everyone else.

"Everyone was friendly, clean and neat, honest and kind. But it was a strange place, too.

"No one cleaned their homes. No one had a car. There was no public transportation. No one cooked meals. We had all we could use, or do, or eat anytime. No stores were there for shopping. Yet everyone was happy and gay and had everything they wanted. They could go anywhere — anytime.

"I told this to my husband today at breakfast and he said I must have got pushed into Heaven for a spell... If it's like that, I'm all for it."

Strangely enough, this woman's dream corresponds closely to what many occulists claim Heaven, or the spirit world, is like.

There are many books on the subject, describing the spirit world. The information purportedly came through dreams, visions, astral trips (flights by the spirit while the body is asleep) or automatic writing — the dictation by a spirit or messages to a mortal on earth.

Nearly all of these books say that the spirit world is a place of homes, gardens, trees, flowers, rivers, etc. They say the homes never get dirty, never need painting, never wear out and the climate is perfect. The flowers, we are told, never fade.

need. No one gets hungry... Food,
except for a type of "Manna," is
not needed by the spiritual body.

Transportation is no problem. One desires to be someplace else and — presto — he is there. The type of souls, of course, who would earn such a Heaven would be "friendly, honest and kind."

This woman's dream sent us scurrying to some old books on the subject — — among which was *Intra Muros*, from which we also learned:

"Homes may be built by spiritstemples, or any sort of struc-

ture desired — by each worker putting the best that is in himself, as well as drawing the fine and subtle forces and elements of the universe into his work.

"Will power or personal concentration has a great deal to do with the completeness and utility of the workmanship. There are other methods besides that of manipulating the atmosphere and drawing from it and from humans the material for the formation of 'stone' or other substance, to put in place in the building of a structure, or the fashioning of any object desired."

One paragraph also reads:
"We are told that before this century is closed, mortals in many instances will have grown so sensitive, so attuned to the higher vibrations, as to be able to receive and comprehend much knowledge from Beyond, which at present can not be comprehended."


HOW DO YOU RATE?



PROJECT THE PICTURE OF ENRICHMENT

No matter how poor your fortune may be now, at this moment, resolutely determine your thinking, "I am at the threshold of wealth." Do not look upon phenomena (the material world). Phenomena is a shadow of past thoughts.

LESSONS FOR STUDENTS . .

DEVELOPMENT FOR MATERIALIZATION

ONE OF ENGLAND'S great writers on psychic subjects, Harry Boddington, says:

"Nature around us is a condensation into palpable forms of previous aerial and inscrutable forces. Man as an organized being is composed of these things. He holds them in suspension in his nervous system. We are all materialized spirits. The solid food we eat is used to maintain the structure of the body, supply it with force, and the mind with feeling, thought, and expression. This fluid within man's body is called "psychoplasm" because it is so highly vitalized that the soul can mold it into organic form. The term then means invisible elements can be condensed and molded and thus become visible and tangible by reason of the directive mind behind the manifestation."

This gives us quite a new slant on the study of physical matter, physical bodies, and materialization. If we are all materialized spirits so to speak, it is quite rational then to suppose the materialized human body, when properly organized and chemicalized, can "give birth" to other forms ... materialized spirits! This brings the whole scope of our study on () this subject into the realm of natural law, acting under its eternal compulsion of infallible action and reaction...cause and effect. .. in endless streams of varied manifestations. It relieves us of the feeling that such manifestations are of supernatural origin, and brings all such phenomena into the field of rational, understandable, and thus acceptable happenings.

PREPARATIONS

When sitting for materialization development, the medium with

whom one usually begins sits inside a cabinet, one not too large, in order to focus or concentrate the energy obtained from the members of the circle. The light should be almost totally extinguished. Infra-red lights being so low on the scale of visible vibration, they are the most commonly used during such a seance. However, photographs may be taken by both the infra-red and ultraviolet lights. Light has a very disintegrating effect on these subtle forms, thus must be kept to the barest minimum or it would serve to disintegrate many of the materialized forms upon their initial appearance. It is also important that the medium hold his mind as blank as possible, other than mentally to call on Spirit to assist with the production of this phenomenon.

EARLY SIGNS

Among the initial signs the medium will experience in producing this phenomenon of materialization probably will be flashes of heat and cold, blackness before the eyes (in which there may be specks of light dancing), and a "cobwebby" sensation over the hands and face which occurs almost invariably and is most noticeable. One famous medium described it as follows: "If a few persons have gathered together in a half-darkened room, the emanations from their bodies can be seen by many...not necessarily clairvoyants. It appears as a slightly luminous haze about the

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
head, shoulders, and sometimes the knees and feet. Frequently it gathers slowly at the fingers, increasing in density until it resembles a slight transparent film of slightly luminous cotton-wool. This often is perceptible to the eyes of all, but it offers no resistance to the touch. By some force of attraction, either inherent or exerted upon it by some outside agency, this mass appears to mingle and draw together, to become more dense, and at this stage has been found to be decidedly perceptible to the touch. It resembles as nearly as can be described the gossamer web seen on trees and bushes on an early summer morning."

WHAT THE COBWEBS MEAN

"Many persons in a materialization seance are sensible of a feeling as of cobwebs being on their faces and hands ... Often the fine filaments of the gossamer cling to the fingers... This impalpably fine substance, however, vanishes as soon as the light is brought near to it. This emanation from the sitters is usually accompanied by a sensation of chill or draft...the head will be hot, there will be a heavy throbbing in the temples, and the hands and feet and other parts of the body will be cold to the touch. By the exercise of will, the medium, can, at any time, however, prevent manifestations. If there is opposition from any person sitting in the circle, this will act as a hindrance the work of the unseen operators."

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(Next month will commence a study of the element, ectoplasm, which plays a major role in the phenomena of materialization. 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


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The Body Tells The Story

A FREEZING THOUGHT INTENSIFIED

NE OF THE STRANGEST CASES in all my experience was that of a man who suffered from perpetual cold sensations all over his body, particularly the abdomen. In winter he piled on sweater after sweater in the attempt to restore any feeling of warmth to his body. summer, even when the temperature was in the eighties, he had to turn on the furnace of his home to feel any sense of comfort. What made the situation all the more severe was the fact that his work involved a great deal of walking winter and summer. In severe weather he had the sensation of freezing to death.

What a practising physician might have named this ailment, or how he might have treated it, was not in my province to find of interest as a metaphysician. The mental explanation was so obvious that physical diagnosis would have been redundant. The man was chilled perpetually by thoughts from outside his own conscious-It took few questions to determine that this source of adverse thinking was his own mother, who had turned against him because of his marriage to a woman whose religion was different from that in which he had been brought up as a child. Further investigation showed that even in childhood he had been very susceptible to cold weather, so the indication was that even prenatally the false sense of motherhood had marked him with her frigid mental attitude toward his father, thus causing the sense of coldness to lodge in subconsciousness and become aggravated throughout the years.

To add to the problem as presented to me was the fact that the mother had become unbalanced mentally to the point where she insisted that the daughter-in-law was some sort of a witch that sprinkled poison over the front steps of the two-family apartment in which they all lived. It turned out that the explanation lay in the residue of salt sprinkled on the icy stairway during the winter; the old lady, however, would not accept this explanation, and, in fact, went about the neighborhood stirring up animosity against her son and his wife, thereby intensifying the cold thoughts directed toward him.

To heal such a condition was not difficult, remembering the words of the greatest healer the world has ever known, "The Kingdom of God is within you." This Kingdom is the environment of Divine Love, not of frigidity. When the patient became fully aware of this fact, the illusion of perpetual

coldness in his body yielded to normalcy of thought and bodily temperature.

However, this did not end the episode, for the mental roots must always be dug up lest recurrence in some form take-place. This is one of the most distinguishing aspects of metaphysics as compared to medical practices. Usually when the error is eliminated from the body, the case is considered closed, but this assumption was nullified by the Mastermetaphysician, who on several occasions réminded one whom He had healed that unless he cleaned house of the mental cause, a worse thing might come to him. A weed may be cut down to the ground, so that it no longer is visible, but if the roots are left in the soil, there will be a further manifestation - usually with several stalks instead of just one.

So, the patient was required to forgive his mother and those whom she had stirred up against him. This forgiveness transcends the usual human discharge of the debt; there must be complete nullification of it on the basis that there is between God's children nothing to forgive, that the apparent aggressor is not so known to Divine Mind, that schisms between the beloved sons of Infinite Love are an impossibility, that apparent causation in the mind of one person cannot affect another, either mentally or physically, that evil has no place in the divine order of things - either as cause or effect. By this means, the patient is made "every whit whole" as the Bible requires, and the apparently evil person is benefited in proportion to the intensity of his antagonism. "Bless your enemies" is the edict of the man who, above all others, knew the true science of healing.

Such occurrences cannot but arrest the attention of any thinking person. On what basis other than the mental could such a state of perpetual coldness in the body be accounted for? Shooting serums into the blood would have been useless, unless the patient had great faith that anything done to

his body would be effective. Like all other manifestations on the physical stratum of the carnal mind, the condition was mesmeric, induced prenatally and developed over the period of the patient's life until it became self-hypnosis on his part, (I Can Heal Myself, and I Will by Dr. Cushing Smith is a veritable gold mine for information revealing the co-relation of physical conditions of dis-ease to our thinking and our emotions. "But I have not come for that reason. I have appeared to teach you," he went on. "First of all, you must know that you are as much a part of the Universal Spirit God as I am."

I listened to what he was saying, but I asked no questions as to who he was. He had the bread that I wanted. He had the water. I was past caring whether he was spirit or flesh. The food looked tangible to me and I wanted it, because I wanted to survive.

Then I looked down at my feet, and I noticed I was no longer hopping from one foot to another. The sand was just as hot as it had been before, but the pain had gone. Then he went on to tell me: "The bread I hold is here within you. The water I have has already quenched your thirst. But you do not realize that this has happened. You gaze upon my sandals as though you wonder if they are the right size, and as if you want to take them."

I asked then, "May I touch those that I see?" He answered. "You may touch what you see, and you may come close, but know that that which you touch is within you."

I did not understand these remarks. On the surface they did not make sense. He went on to say: "As soon as you come to the divine realization within yourself that you have the food and the

water and the other things you need, and as soon as you become peaceful and right within yourself, and you follow me as though you are going to permit me to tell you that there is a village a short distance away where you can obtain everything that you need, then I will lead you."

I wondered again. Where we were, there was no place anyone could hide. Where had he come from? He was very real, standing there before me, yet there seemed to be something different about him. As I talked to him I sensed, without knowing how I knew, that not very far away there was a community. It seemed to appear out of nowhere. It had been hidden from me before. All I could see was what I wanted, and all I wanted was comfort and to be relieved from the pain. I followed him faithfully because of the food and the water which he carried in his hands. I wanted it. It was true he had told me it was within myself, and that I did not need it in the manner I thought I needed it. Nevertheless, I followed him and he led me for what seemed to be several miles, until we reached the little community. Then when I was not looking, and did not expect it, he disappeared, taking with him the sandals and the bread and the water I had so desired. But although he had taken these material things away with him, he had left me on the path that leads to understanding.

I quenched my thirst at the well in the center of the village. I drank pure cool water from the gourd. I will never forget how good it tasted. It seemed as I drank that my very life was being restored to me. When I had slaked my thirst, I met a stranger, then other strangers came and went all day long, quenching their thirst by the city well.

I lived for a time in the village, and I became acquainted with the wonderful people who lived there. After a while I told them of the man who had appeared to me in the middle of the desert, and who had saved my life by leading me to them.

It was many years later in that particular lifetime that I was told by the master teacher himself that this had been a test for me, that I had actually seen what I wanted, that he had produced it. He had appeared to me at that time because all I was thinking of was my comfort and how to save myself, and because he wanted me to search within my inner self and begin learning the laws of life. He wanted me not to give in to my whims or my passing woes, but to have implicit faith. He had known the city was only a little way from me, although I did not. He had known that I did not see it, and that I did not know it was there.

This, then, was for me, and can be for you, the beginning of the greater understanding..to have faith..to have courage..to believe..to know that if you are right within yourself, you will have the bread to eat and the water to drink and that you will have what is rightfully yours. If you complain continually while trying to attain what you need, however, you cannot succeed in the way you are supposed to succeed or to learn the lessons you are supposed to learn.

So, my friends, I leave you, but I leave you with this thought. I want you to know and to understand that it is not that your soul wants to punish you, or that it wants to place you in a predicament so that you will not have bread to eat or water to drink. If you are ever in such a predicament, it may happen that you will not have a teacher to appear before you as he did to me. But you must understand that, as you become right within yourself, everything will right itself so that you will have the things that you need, and that it will not be too long until it does this. (Continued from page 11) skill were greatly improved by the time he reached the age of sixteen years. During his early period as a Dominican lay-brother. a plague had spread through the city of Peru. Nearly one hundred of the University students had become victims, and the death rate was so high that none were expected to recover. Martin gave them treatment, and if records be correct, "ali were healed."

His healing successes soon spread through the Monastery, and it even came to the attention of the Prior that students had witnessed the levitation of the young halfcaste. It was also reported that Martin had appeared in distant places to give healing, while, in fact, it was known with certainty that he had not left the precincts of the Monastery.

Martin de Porres healed by the laying on of hands, and when the Archbishop of Mexico was taken ill on one of his visits to the Monastery, Martin suggested that a more experienced physician should be obtained. "Place your hand on my side," said the Archbishop. Martin did so, and a cure took place instantly.

Martin's healings included the cure of many diseases which, even today, are beyond the skill of our most experienced physicians. They included many of the incurable diseases which today respond to spiritual healing after the medical profession has reached the limit of its knowledge and skill.

When one of the friars of the Monastery was awaiting the amputation of his gangrenous leg. Martin de Porres gave him treatment. He promptly recovered and amputation became unnecessary. When during 1958, Antonio Cabrera, a boy from Santa Cruz de Teneriffe in the Canary Islands was badly injured, the doctors were ready to amputate. Healing intercession was directed to the Blessed Martin in Spirit. The boy's leg was cured. In the early part of 1962, a London healer was responsible for the complete recovery of a patient who was awaiting an operation to remove part of her vertebrae. She had been paralyzed and unable to walk for nearly thirteen years.

Martin de Porres passed to Spirit over three hundred years ago in 1639, before he had reached the age of 60. Records prove that healing is not the prerogative of one nation of people, and that it is a gift of Spirit available to all races, whether colored or white.

As in many countries, the orthodox church in Peru has decried the gift of Spirit for hundreds of years. Painful persecutions have retarded the continuance and progress of the healing gift which was so clearly manifested through the mediumship of one of its most pious sons, Since 1939 Martin has been patron of social justice in Peru, and this by official decree through their President. However, the logical conclusion has not been drawn that the unstinted power of Spirit is still available for those who are sick in body, mind or

In spite of orthodoxy, however, there is still in Peru today a small band of devoted healer aspirants. The number is very small and they are spread over a vast territory. It may be that the canonization of Martin will give them encouragement, and that they will draw strength from the sure knowledge that, like many who passed before and after him, he is still able to heal from Spirit...a half-caste colored boy, who has given proof of the universality of healing.

The Third Level


