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

The Seven Shangri-las

CHANGRI-LA again holds public attention, for it is something so real and appeals so strongly to the longings of man's soul for a world of peace and ever youthful life, that the revival of the motion picture, Lost Horizon, again is filling the theatres.

Some, of course, doubt the actual reality of there being any Shangri-las on earth today. . but there are at least seven such known horizons.

First, there is a Shangri-la in Venezuela. One lost traveler, an explorer, first saw it seventeen years He had wandered for months ago. among savage tribes, and, seemingly by accident, reached the secret city high up in the mountains, surrounded on all sides by deep chasms. He stayed there seven months. On his return, no one believed his story of that marvelous city, and of the white men there different from the dark skinned natives inhabiting all the surrounding regions. He told of how the men in that Shangrila knew what was taking place in our civilization, although there had been no ordinary means of communication with the outside world since the year the Pilgrims landed at Plymouth Rock. They described our automobiles, drew diagrams of our principal railway lines, etc., but no one believed him.

Then, a few years ago, that same Shangri-la was sighted again from an airplane that had lost its way, driven by a tropical storm. Its two fliers were young men who had never heard the story told by the explorer, could find no place to land, but did get a view of the secret city. Driven by the storm, they soon lost sight of it, however, and could not find it again. With the clouds clearing and fuel running low, they flew due east and found lowlands for a land-They told of templed walls and luxuriant green vegetation in a bowl high up in regions of intense cold. Since their descriptions were like those of the first explorer, others began to believe, and hunted for this hidden city for two years. When they could not find it again, the previous reports were doubted again. Those of the mystic Caetenic orders know the place, how-

tains covered with ice and snow, this city also is in a valley of tropical vegetation. It was first seen in 1869. Two men reached it; one returned. Dr. Livingston passed near it in 1866 when exploring the Rovuma Valley. Then in 1891 Dr. Schulmann, exploring the 18,000 foot heights near Ruwenzari, probably discovered it, for when he returned and made his report to German scientific societies, he stubbornly refused to give any report covering a period of nineteen days. Later he confided to a friend that in those days he had discovered something so phenomenal that, if he had told of it, he

would have been discredited by men of all geographic societies on earth.

However, the man who had visited that Shangri-la in 1869 told of happy, joyous white men, with white-golden hair, of beautiful palaces in "God's Valley of Peace," and of some of the people living to be as much as 219 years old.

Mystics know of this Shangri-la in mid-Africa, and some have visited it. One told Sir Henry Rider Haggard of it, and he wrote the books She and Ayesha, making them sound fantastic to cover up what he had promised not to reveal. Haggard did, however, tell truly of their their miraculous knowledge, of what we had developed in science although out of touch by ordinary means of communication for more than two thousand years.

The third Shangri-la of earth is in northwest *Tibet*. It is real and does exist. You can envision its peace and calm, it is not so different from what you see depicted in the purely imaginary film, *Lost Horizon*. Originally the higher mystics of this Shangri-la joined the group of the true thirteenth Dalai Lama who left Lhasa in 1922 to return to the ancient holy center in the eastern Andes.

The fourth Shangri-la is in northeast Spain . . a hidden bowl circled by high mountain rims . . not far from Esterri and west of holy Montserrat. It is like a titanic crater high among the snows, yet in this bowl there is vegetation as green as that of Ireland. Its great temples are built into the mountain so that only the fascades are seen. Here, more than a thousand people . . possess. ing the wisdom of the ages, and luxuries surpassing what we have today . . live in joy, peace, and youthfulness working with other mystic groups of earth to bring about a New Age of peace and brotherhood.

The fifth great Shangri-la is in Guatamala. It has existed for four thousand years. High in the mountains about a hundred fifty miles southwest of Peten Itza, in its center is a lake. far deeper than the Sacred Well at Chichzen Itza. Protected by the mountain rims, its waters are forever calm, a perfect mirror reflecting the stars at night. This Shangri-la is also a gigantic bowl of stars.

Rumors of a tribe of white Indians on nearby isles off its Pacific Shore

were current even thirty years ago. Now explorers have found white Indians near the Pacific Shore, and also in the the unexplored inland, but these are the degenerated remnants of that ancient race of whites. In contrast, up in the bowl of stars, the mystics of these ancient whites still live in luxury, peace, love and power.

The sixth very ancient Shangri-la is in the Caucasus. Its men have the lightest skin on earth, hair as light as platinum. They live in a region of eternal snows and avalanches . . in a valley as green as the downs of England. This is not far from Mount Ararat, 16,900 feet high, and Elbruz of 18,300 These heights are more than a mile above the perpetual snowline, yet hidden high up here - - where even modern mountain climbers dare not go - is a city with gardens of verdant beauty. From its environs, glaciers flow and great masses of snow slide like mountains down to the lower valleys. This is not far from Krestavoya Gora . . the Mountain of the Cross . . and is known as the Bowl of the Silver Cross.

The mountain passes by which it is reached have walls of almost vertical rock and ice, one of which extends straight up more than a mile high -- almost inconceivable. It was to this Shangri-la that Christ once made a pilgrimage before he went to southern Arabia, then to Ruwenzari in mid-Africa.

It is not the wealth and luxuries of these Shangri-las which are important to these mystic men. It is the quiet calm, the joy and love of their fellow men surpassing anything we have ever dreamed possible on earth, and their love of life without striving that holds the greatest value for them.

The seventh Shangri-la . . now the greatest on earth . . is over the Andes to the east, up above sheer precipices which rise from mountain bases almost two miles below. Modern man never visits this holy center, except when mystically invited, and then actually is taken there. Although there is no possibility of landing there, modern explorers have flown their planes nearby and have seen the ancient temples high up on the mountain sides. Engineers have wondered how these mystic men could have built such temples, two miles up sheer rock, with no possibility of roads reaching them. Yet when you learn that they built the great road of ancient Andean times on a great wall so massive that the Great Wall of China looks like a plaything built of children's blocks, then you realize that they also could have known how to build secret inner passage tunnels, mile on mile, to enter underground from a far distant point.

Much more valuable than their building, however, is the sweetness and

peace of their life, the lack of striving, while they enjoy luxuries we do not yet know, and a joy of which we but dream. They are not mere dreamers, however, and are far wiser and more practical than any men of any nation today. They are ready now . . after twelve hundred years of outer inactivity . . to initiate a new consciousness of man on earth. They are doing this now.

Some things I cannot tell you, just as there are things one cannot tell if a member of a Masonic Lodge, or a priest of a church, or an official in our military services. But this much is true I can tell you. The men of the Shangrilas are waiting until 97,000,000 souls on earth shall have suffered so that they will awaken . unified and powerful . to rise in actual power to bring to pass the new age of which man has dreamed for ages.

Every month or year, some one thing or another is revealed as evidential proof of what I write. example, the experience of a healthy, vigorous, vital young American army flier in France in the last world war who was not even religiously inclined, a youth who 'came from Missouri' in all things, after the war was in China selling airplanes. When one war lord captured another war lord, confiscating the planes this young American had for sale, he cabled America for another shipment, then partly to save his skin while the war lords quarreled, and partly to see unknown western China, took his one remaining plane and flew west. He landed just as you see the airplane land in the film, Lost Horizon.

This young man was a doubter of doubters, but when I met him after he first returned to America and heard him talk to a small private group, he was telling them things that were seemingly incredible. For example, he told of walking alone one day in those high Tibetan mountains, and unexpectedly coming upon a man sitting nude where the snow all around was many feet deep and the temperature was forty degrees below freezing. Yet there was a circle of bare earth around the man, and the snow was melted for at least thirty feet away by a mysterious radiation of energy from the mystic's body.

Scores of other wonders which this doubter of doubters actually saw and experienced could be related and . . perhaps you have guessed it, for when it was known that he was back in America, he was called to Hollywood to advise in filming the scenes of Lost Horizon.

MANY YEARS AGO at an informal

MANY YEARS AGO at an informal discussion during a Church Conference, I was asked what, in my opinion, was most needed in the Spiritualist movement. Promptly I answered . . "education." My opinion has not changed. People coming into Spiri-

tualism today need education and, unfortunately, the need is not limited to newcomers.

During the past fifteen years when it has been my privilege and pleasure to have served

as a Staff Medium at Camp Chesterfield, Indiana and as a Faculty Member of the Chesterfield Seminary, I have been confronted constantly with sheer ignorance on the part of people who claim to be Spiritualists. I regret to say that many mediums and teachers of Spiritualism also are ignorant of the basic principles of our beautiful philosophy. Perhaps ignorant is too harsh a word, for no doubt the mediums know the philosophy, but perhaps find it difficult to teach.

Just last summer at one of our Master Philosophy classes, a gentleman and his wife . . apparently educated, cultured and refined . . when asked to greet their Master Teacher, apologized by saying they had no Master Teacher, although they had been sitting in a class for two years. I asked them to call on their other teachers and guides, but so far as they knew they had none. These people were not trying to be smart; they were honest, sincere seekers. Further questioning brought out the fact that they had been sitting with the only available teacher in their vicinity, and this teacher (I asked them not to mention the name) had told them they had no guides or teachers of their own, but in an emergency they could call on hers! It seems that a few months after joining this class they had visited a Spiritualist Camp and, being anxious to know their guides, had asked for them They were given the in a seance. names of two of their teachers, but when they returned home and told their physical teacher, this teacher refused to recognize any Spirit teacher who had not come to them through her mediumship - - yet none had ever come through her!

What was the trouble here? Lack of confidence on the part of the medium?.. jealousy?.. what? We know, or at least should know, that everyone interested in matters psychic have Spirit teachers and guides attracted to them to help in their personal, spiritual, physical and mental development. We

have been promised Guardian Angels.. the Comforter.. and we know that the "Angels came and ministered unto Jesus." Will they not do the same for us?

Education in relation to Spiritualism, or Psychic Science, is a big word and covers many of its facets. Perhaps the question could be put . "Where should one start this educational process?"

Let us begin at the beginning: First, there must be a sincere desire to do as

HOW CAN WE EVER HOPE TO PROGRESS WITHOUT IT?

Jesus directed . . "Seek ye first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness . ." In other words, one must have a spiritual desire to know more about the religion and philosophy of Spiritualism in order to make one's own life and the lives of others "richer, fuller and deeper."

Those who are unable to attend a Seminary, such as the one held at Camp Chesterfield and many other fine Camps, should find some other source of knowledge. Nothing is better than an organized class with an educated, developed medium. Unfortunately this is not always available, in which case there are always many wonderful books. Write to Chimes for their Book Catalog and reading guide for beginning students, or contact one of the various teachers whose courses are advertised, attend Spiritualist churches, have clair-

voyant readings. . do all you can to get an understanding of the basic philosophy

and tenets of Spiritualism.

To those of you who are teachers I make an especial appeal - - get knowledge yourself before you attempt to give it out. Remember, if you don't know your philosophy, it will only backfire on you. Sooner or later your students are going to realize this fact, and they will lose respect for you. We are being told constantly that the Spirit teachers will use the tools we furnish them. Let us give them educated tools.

Just before her death, the late Mable Riffle told me she realized more and more how the Spirit teachers had progressed in their teaching, and in many ways taught differently than they did even a few years ago. She felt, and I am sure most people will agree, that the mediums have changed too - that they have progressed in understanding, and so are better instruments of the Spirit teachers.

A public school teacher, if he or she wishes to progress, must take summer

school classes in order to keep up-todate on the particular subject being taught. Unfortunately, many of our

Spiritualist teachers feel that once they can contact Spirit, they do not have to study any more.

At most of the better Camps during the season, public classes are held by well qualified and outstanding teachers, Those of you who plan to spend some time at a Camp next summer, please. I beg of you. make it a "must" to attend classes. Schedule your private readings, seances, etc., for other hours during the day. You will even find that the latest advance thought in science dovetails closely with Spiritualist teachings.

Another point: Don't aspire to be a medium until you know the basic fundamental principles. At times it seems as though every one interested in Spiritualism wants to develop into a medium, and quickly! Remember, however, that if every Spiritualist became a medium, it would be a case of "all Chiefs and no

Indians."

So before you attempt to develop mediumship, friends, learn something about mediumship... who your guides and teachers are and how they cooperate with you. Learn to relax so that you may meditate. Learn how mediumship is related to your physical organs.

In other words, take the advice of the Apostle Paul when he said in his letter to the Romans (12:2) . . "Be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind."

RESEARCH IN "SURVIVAL"

Theta, bulletin published by the Psychical Research Foundation of Duke University (a Foundation devoted wholly to the promotion of scientific research on the problem of the survival of the personality after death), explains its function and perspective, from which the following excerpts are quoted: "The Foundation and its bulletin represent no position regarding survival except the belief that scientific observation and experimentation may lead to a solution. The bulletin is not intended as a substitute for other publications in psychical research and parapsychology. On the contrary, one of its functions will be to direct readers to papers and books by abstracts or reviews. It will also discuss current researches and activities that touch on the survival question." It also recognizes, as psychologists and modern religionists do, that "the importance to man of his attitude to death can serve as an important organizing principle in determining how he conducts himself in life."

ARE YOU LISTENING?

The faculty of inner listening . . which everyone may exercise at times . . can be cultivated until it becomes a a perpetual process, and its scope can be extended so that it will become a veritable state of being, says Helen A. Kamm in an Orion Magazine article "Develop Your Hearing." All of the perceptive faculties will have a wider range when the field of perception has been expanded to respond to wider gradations of vibration, she tells us, and all the senses then will work more closely with each other and will extend over into the psychic and intuitional areas. And as we develop our subtle listening faculty and begin to hear on a multi-level basis, we shall also find that our understanding and interpretation of that which we hear is commensurately increased.

INTERCHANGEABILITY OF SENSES

Reporting on an article carried in Time Magazine relating to a 22 year old girl, an epileptic patient at Russia's Sverdlov Clinic for Nervous Disorders, Rosa Kuleshove, in demonstrating her ability to see with her fingertips and practically interchange her senses of touch and sight, Theosophy Magazine explains the phenomenon by the writings of H. P. Blavatsky when she wrote long ago "that all the senses are astral, distinct from the physical organs, and are interchangeable; also that they are as subject to mental impression as to physical."



TUNING IN ON THOUGHT WAVES

Except for your modern inventions, such as television, radio, and radar, we of the Spirit side of life could not fully explain the power and nature of thought, for only by comparison with modern methods of communication could you understand the operation of thought. Thoughts are picture forms. We know what you are thinking, what your hopes and desires are, and as your thoughts coincide with ours, we try to work to obtain what is desirable mutually. Although you are frequently told that a new guide must learn the language of the sitters - and does - as his realm of influence broadens, this becomes impractical. Then his work with you is effected purely through thought power introduced into your aura. To the extent that you are developed you are able to tune in to these thought waves, much like a modern radio set tunes in to the air waves . . so writes R. B. Mc Eathron for the International Spiritual-Review.

liberally from Arthur Ford's Do It Yourself instructions for meditation and development, The King's Business magazine in their feature, "Cults Critique," usually quite lambastic of such activities, judges them with a Scriptural quotation, Isaiah 8:19-20, which - to a Spiritualist - vindicates rather than condemns, illustrating how the Bible can be used to prove anything. Must also have given someone some food for thought because of the stir it created in strictly orthodox circles.

WHERE IS THE EVIDENCE?

In resigning after many years as President of the International Spiritualist Federation, due to ill health, Dr. Karl E. Muller wrote in Yours Fraternally, the ISF Quarterly Journal, in his farewell remarks: "I believe it was very detrimental to our movement that most Spiritualist Societies disregarded the scientific aspect as soon as societies for psychical research were founded, forgetting that scientists are not always scientific. Thus the evidential, truly Spiritist or Spiritualist case histories are at present not even recognized as such, are not properly established by testimonies and nowhere recorded. . . Every society should nominate its own research officer, or several for different districts, whose task would be to investigate and collect case histories covering the whole field of psychic science necessary scientifically to prove survival. . . . I appeal to all societies to get busy with the scientific aspect!"

SEEING PAST SELVES?

One often reads or hears of people with psychic sight saying, "Oh yes, it was quite distinct. As I looked at you your face changed and became that of an Indian (or a Chinese, whatever the case may be). Most Spiritualists put this down to the overshadowing of spirit guides, when in most cases, says Mark Western in his article, "History of the Soul," in the Occult Gazette, it is not this at all. The psychic is merely seeing the personality behind the present one. Both could be right, of course.

FULL MOON HECKLERS

Minutescope, a new Astrology magazine, reports that when Billy Graham appeared on the NBC program, "The World of Billy Graham," in August, he stated that they could always predict when there were going to be hecklers at his meetings. The famous evangelist said that the word 'lunatic' is derived from 'lunar,' in recognition of the effect the Moon has on human behavior. Dr. Graham said that when the Moon is Full there are always more hecklers present.

FOUR STONES known to have had properties for healing since the dawn of civilization are: Lapis Linguis (Azurite), Lapis Lazuli (Lazurite), Lapis Lingurius (Malachite), and Lapis Lingua (Chrysocolla).

Among the ancients who made wide use of their physical and occult properties were the Egyptians, Assyrians,

created around the substance, which makes this stone a fascinating research challenge both to gemologist and occultist.

Lapis Lazuli (Lazurite), an aluminum silicate, symbolizes tranquility and harmony, soothing angry vibrations and making the heart tender and susceptible.

This stone was famous in antiquity

stones, is referred to as a very brittle substance. This brittleness is advanced as one of the reasons why it has been neglected as a medium for ornaments, and may also be the reason why it is not found in sacred or semi-sacred vessels or used in talismans. The question arises as to whether the physical reason is the only one for its apparent

Stones of Hidden Healing

Babylonians, and Atlanteans. found that these four stones especially were to be worn by all seeking attunement with psychic forces, and by those desiring to pierce the veil of this matetial universe and enter the sphere of the spiritual.

All four stones are linked physically by their common origin in copper, the prefix 'Lapis,' their bluish-green color, their reputation for occult and mystical healing powers. In the very fall of the syllables of their names there is a harmony, a hint of mystery, of knowledge withheld but there for the

seeking.

Lapis Linguis (Azurite) probably had many secret influences as its use is so shrouded in mystery. The Greeks seem to have known it, however, naming Caeruleum, using it in practical and and mystical healing. Nowadays it is mined chiefly in the states of Arizona and New Mexico, though veins of it certainly existed in Europe, Africa, and the Mediterranean lands. It forms in crystalline masses as the result of water dropping upon copper compounds in limestone. It is blue in color, and nearly always found with or near Lapis Lingurius (Malachite). Although it still remains very much a stone of mystery, it must exert therapeutic influences because of the mineral exudations present. In the psychic field, it has a curious reputation amongst seers and healers who have studied it. When worn on the person by one whose own psychic emanations are in tune with it, it puts the individual in touch with vibrations and forces beyond the plane of matter. Some writers of antiquity said it aided meditation and psychic development, and counseled that it be worn upon the body so that it touched the flesh.

There is a strange lack of information, in the occult sense, about this substance that has been known and worked from the earth since the dawn of civilization. This is why so many seers think it must have been used on Atlantis and in ancient Egypt. If it had no secret or occult powers, it would have been widely described as a common mineral having some ornamental and perhaps physically therapeutic powers . . instead, there is a barrier of silence

for its healing powers, though there was never any secret about it. been some confusion, however, regarding this stone and the Sapphire, as it is often referred to in error as the Lapis Lazuli. The Tables of Law in the Bible are stated to have been of Sapphire, as well as the Magic Breastplate . . but in both cases, the gem was, undoubtedly, the Lapis Lazuli. A fine opaque stone, it is often flecked with gold owing to the presence of iron pyrites . . iron, being another healing element, according to the ancients. They called it the Stone of Heaven, perhaps because its hue resembled that of the firmament. The ancient Egyptians had a peculiar veneration for it, and many talismans were carved from it . . especially the Eye and Heart talismans. The beautiful color of this Lapis always has attracted those interested in healing vibrations and emanations from material substances. The Greeks and Romans employed it in the treatment of circulatory diseases, epilepsy, and skin troubles. It was believed to be especially potent where the mentality was disturbed or sick, being able to lift depression and dispel melancholy. Probably because of its fine blue color, it was also employed in the alleviation of many eye conditions.

Lapis Lingurius (Malachite) seems to be shrouded in less mystery than any of these four stones as there are more facts about it in the ancient writings. The Egyptians mined Malachite from copper ore very early in their civilization, used it for ornamentation and most extensively in the treatment of some infectious ailments and circulatory di --The substance is green, its name coming from the Greek word, 'Malaku,' meaning Mallow Plant, one which is a beautiful shade of deep green, of itself containing many therapeutic essences and elements. In days of antiquity it was worn as a talisman to ensure sleep, constancy in love and friendship, and as a protection against cholera and disaster by lightning.

Lapis Lingua (Chrysocolla) has certain similarities to Lapis Linguis (Azurite) as it has to Lapis Ligurius (Malachite). Chrysocolla, when so named in scientific treatises on gemneglect by healers and mystics on the material plane. We know that much occult lore is still secret, in the same way that the ancient teachings of the alchemists stay secret . . even in this

revealing atomic age.

Chrysocolla occurs in blue or greenish hard masses, with a texture like enamel. Its name is derived from the Greek meaning 'Gold Solder.' It is interesting that it contains the compound borax . . which may have been used in medicine in antiquity and in medieval times. Today, of course, the therapeutic and beneficial effects of borax are well recognized, so there does seem to be a physical link between ancient and modern methods of healing.

A stone of itself, of course, may not open the door to psychic truths. Yet it has emanations which make it a focusing point, or center, where occult forces may be trapped and utilized to channel the mind on to the mental or spiritual wave-lengths where these truths may be found. Psychically, man is a body of tiny particles existing outside his body of matter. These gems are also atoms, humming with activity, alive with force . . perhaps the Lodestones which will yet put him in touch with those dimensions and planes beyond present time which hold the secrets and the truths of eternity.

Edgar Cayce, the Virginia Beach seer and healer, positively suggests that the properties of these stones have been a closely guarded secret since times of antiquity . . that perhaps they are destined to remain so, since those finding and recognizing them are reluctant to reveal them except to those who share the revelation with them in the dominion of the Spirit.

Capturing The Light Sensation

WHAT IS a "Lighter Than Air" feeling? It is the sensation of lightness that fills the upper part of our body with a buoyant, elated feeling.

The light feeling is that exuberant, happy, confident power many seek, but too few attain. So often we wish to rise above a sensation of heaviness, but find ourselves unable to do much about it. However, fortified by a sound, secure and positive frame of mind, we can help ourselves to make our dreams come true by recognizing a negative, heavy feeling for just what it is, then proceeding to put into effect a full, workable understanding of the "Lighter Than Air" feeling.

Let us put the imagination to work for a few minutes. Let us conceive the idea of the upper part of our body filled with twenty times the amount of air we use normally. Such a lightness of feeling brings a 'lightness' to our facial expression . . relaxes the facial muscles and tends to discourage the approach of age. ity can be traced to the lightness of attitude (positive attitude).



I must be developing into a journalist. I have just been faced with my first controversy and called to account, for the first time, by a reader. He writes: ► In the September issue of Chimes Margie made this remark: "One is no more psychic in the astral plane than on earth, in all probability. Nor is he able to foretell the future any more than he could on earth." My more than thirty years of experience in communicating with dear ones on the etheric plane have proven incontrovertibly that they have been able to foretell the future events to happen on the earth plane. Her statements contradict the medium's anprophecies from his spirit teachers. So, please ask Margie to amplify her above statement.

In the over-all picture, my remarks that you're no more psychic in the astral world than you were on the earth plane were correct. Why should I be anything greater in the astral world than I am here on the earth plane, just because I am out of the physical body. I am the same identical individual. This makes sense.

The question was, however, a logical one. The writer is in evidence of those who had foretold some future event. He is aware that these people were not prognosticators on the earth plane. But he has communicated with them in the astral and learned that they were psychic, or assumed that they were.

Let us say that a woman asks her mother in spirit: "Mother, am I going to sell the house? Mother, am I going to marry Jim?" Mother would be in a better position to find out if she is going to marry Jim, for she may have a sympathetic relationship with her daughter, and probably would pass an opinion more readily than if she were on the earth plane and were asked the same question. For mother's powers of perception are cleared, and she sees in a different manner than she had seen upon the earth plane.

So there is evidence that people in the astral world can see the future insofar as they take the initiative to unfold, precisely the same as those who unfold

turn psychic for numerous reasons. It is make up his deficiencies academically possible, for example, to be shocked into a condition that would enable one to have psychic powers. This is possible when you come into the astral world, but it is not very probable.

So I go along with the question. I am aware that loved ones have predicted successfully. For the most part, however, it is because they have obtained the information from other sources that conveyed the message to them to the people on the earth plane.

And now the question probably asked more often than any other single question, in one form or another, in my letters so far:

> Do people who have had a husband in this world with whom they were not in love live together in spirit?

You could have been married six times on the earth plane, and each of your husbands precede you to the spirit world, yet you might not live with any one of them although you may have had a number of years on earth with each.

In the event, however, that there is one out of the six with whom there is a strong affinity or a stronger tie, then there is the possibility that you would be in his presence, continue to learn with him, enjoy his company, and share his feelings. There is no guarantee, however, that you will be with any of your husbands when you leave the physical body. Most certainly you are not all going to be together, for they are entities the same as you are. They also have their interests, and will go their respective way with other companions.

Usually, however, when one has been devoted to someone, he will join his spouse and the rest of his relatives and friends if he wants to see them in the next life.

> I was never satisfied with my education on this earth. Will I have a better one in the spirit world?

Yes. If one is not particularly satisfied with his academic training on the earth plane, it is to his advantage to know that in the next phase of his exis-

on the earth plane. Or it is possible to tence he will have an opportunity to - if he wishes to take the initiative.

> Since the only thing you take with you when you pass out of the physical body is the knowledge you acquire, your identity, and your personality, you can well appreciate that we never cease to learn. There is never anyone who can say that he has reached the ultimate in this respect. So if you have been denied academic, formal training in this life, certainly you can make it up. You can continue your development in the astral world, for death is a continuation of life.

> ▶ If a person partakes of meat while unfolding for mediumship, can it be said that this has retarded his progress?

No. Some of our best known mediums in the past have been known to partake of meat. In fact, some have stated that if they did not eat meat,, their seances often were very weak and that very little "came through."
Mediums who have experimented in the field have found that their guides "Don't eat a heavy have told them: meal before a seance."

Some feel that eating a heavy meal can impair the manifestations. Others say that if they haven't eaten a heavy meal, they don't get anything at all, or if they do it is very weak. So it all depends on the constitution of the particular physical medium. He must find out - through experience - the type of regime he must develop with reference to eating habits. Eating meat, however, does not necessarily impair one, or slow down his rate of growth.

▶ Do you think I will accomplish my spiritual work by sitting fifteen minutes each day in the silence?

Sitting fifteen minutes in the silence certainly is conducive to unfoldment, and can be said - for the most part - to be very helpful. However, there are times when one finds that he cannot sit at that exact time for fifteen minutes, or for any special time. Let your loved ones know on the other side - whoever they may be - or their guides, that you are going to operate in this way. They


A former official of one of the largest Spiritualist organizations in America - after a number of years of conflict - resigned from all affiliation with Spiritualism and wrote to a friend as follows:

"I am convinced that Spiritualism is definitely not the path to soul evolvement. I found that the majority of its activities are of a negative nature, and that ultimately it destroys its adherents. With true soul evolvement, you will find yourself more and more pulling away from the precepts and practices of modern Spiritualism."

In my forty years of experience with spirit phenomena, I have found both high and low among Spiritualists; the percentage of those with negative qualities is not more than that found in any religious or philosophic affiliation . . unless it be the Salvation Army which ranks so very high in human kindness and service. Therefore, I feel that soul evolvement is still an individual thing, and can be found in any sincere religious or philosophic affiliation that seeks truth through righteous spirit development.


Spiritualism, in principle, not judged by the lowest in it but by the higher, is a true path to God and soul evolvement. Those who stray into the byways/ and swamps (and they may be numerous), do not carry the banner. Those who stay on the solid highway with high spirit guides, however - just as Christ demonstrated with Moses and Elijah represent soul evolvement to the greatest extent, for they have found the Spirit Comforter which the Master Spiritualist promised all those who are for righteous spirit truth . . not against it . . and who live by it.

PROPHETESS MOTHER SHIPTON

DROPHECY, THE ABILITY to peer [into the future, always has intrigued Although there have been many "false prophets" during this century whose prognostications just didn't pan out, there also have been some giants in the field of prophecy, such as: the Old Testament prophets, Nostradamus, and - in our own generation -Edgar Cavce.

The most reliable prophecy being heard today comes from the churches, those who believe in and practise the Biblical "gifts of the Spirit." Prophetic words applicable to our day and time are given by those who - among other gifts - have the spiritual gift of speaking in tongues . . sometimes called unknown tongues.

True, they are often "unknown" to the person speaking them, but they are known to some nations or tribes on The language spoken may be Yiddish, Sanskrit, Latin, Chinese, the seldom heard tongue of an African tribe, the Aramaic language of Jesus. With this often goes the gift of "interpretation." This is important, of course, hundreds of years before they were inotherwise the spiritual message would have no meaning for the audience. Thus we have combined here three of the nine spiritual gifts mentioned by Paul in the New Testament . . speaking in divers tongues, interpretation of tongues, and prophecy.

Mother Shipton is one of the most famous prophets in history . . and one of the least known. Ursula Southill (her maiden name) is reported to have been so shockingly ugly that, during her girlhood she was known as "The Devil's Child." She lived in the 15th Her parents were country people who lived near Dropping Well, a Yorkshire village. Her mother, Agatha Southill, was reputed to be a witch because of her psychic powers, and was held in superstitious fear by the coun-

In her early twenties, Ursula tryside. was married to a man of York, Tobias Shipton. Shortly after she began to issue her astounding prophecies which became famous throughout England, and her reputation soon became established as an infallible seeress. She died at the age of 75, and was buried at Clifton, Yorkshire in 1561.

Mother Shipton is supposed to have made the prophecy that: "The world to an end shall come in eighteen hundred and eighty-one." It spread terror throughout the country in that year. People fled from their homes into the fields, and prayed in the churches. Some gave away all their possessions awaiting the day of doom.

However, it has been established now that Mother Shipton made no such prophecy. It was a forgery, the invention of Charles Hindley, a well known publisher of London, who included the forgery in a cheap version of Richard Head's "Life and Death of Mother Shipton" which he published in 1862.

Mother Shipton foresaw automobiles vented. "A carriage without horse shall go, disaster fill the world with woe." She predicted the submarine: "Beneath the water men shall walk, shall ride. shall sleep and even talk." And the airplane: "And in the air man shall be seen, in white, in black, as well as green." Long before ocean liners were built she foresaw: "In water, iron shall float as easy as a wooden boat." She predicted the gold rush days in America. "Gold shall be found in stream or stone, in land that is as yet unknown." And the Civil War: "The states will lock in fiercest strife and seek to take each other's life . . . When North shall thus divide the South, the eagle builds in lion's mouth."

Was Mother Shipton talking about current fashions when she said: "For SPIRITUAL STORIES BEHIND STAMPS

in those wondrous far-off days, the women shall adopt a craze to dress like men, and trousers wear, and cut off all their locks of hair." The picture she paints is not flattering. "They'll ride astride (horses) with brazen brow, as witches do on broomsticks now. Then love shall die and marriage cease, and nations wane as babes decrease. The wives shall fondle cats and dogs and men live much the same as hogs."

We are living in the latter part of the century about which Mother Shipton's outlook was far from encouraging, as she says: "But those who live the century through, in fear and trembling this will do; flee to the mountains and the dens, to the bog and forest and wild fens, for storms will rage and oceans roar when Gabriel stands on sea and shore; and as he blows his wondrous horn, old world shall die and new be

This would seem to tie in with prophecies of many modern writers, Great Pyramid prophecies, and other sources that an old age is passing away, and that the world is entering, or has already entered, a new age which many call the Aquarian Age. The prophecies, we are told, do not refer to the end of the world but to the end of an age.

Life is glorious when we make it so





Richard Zenor, internationally known trance intermediary of The Agasha Temple of Wisdom in Los Angeles, California. His lecture topics have ranged through a broad field of knowledge, frequently interspersed with prophecies concerning major events of the future, natural disasters, developments in science, and important political and economic changes.

His purpose in giving these prophecies from time to time has been a simple one. He uses prophecy as a teaching tool to stimulate the mortal mind of the student to have faith and to know that the future can be foreseen. By this means he breaks down some of the barriers surrounding one who first approaches the study of the occult, thus making it easier to accept the teachings and to advance in one's development.

They had been told something that was false . . not so much deliberately, but because of lack of understanding and misinterpretation of the original teachings that had been

given to the people.

DISASTERS

The subject of natural catastrophies is one that, however unpleasant it may be, is always exciting. Cities from Los Angeles to San Diego on down would not escape, and much rebuilding would have to be done. If it does happen once, it will repeat itself.

On the other hand, there are happier prophecies for that area. There will be water available where no water is now in evidence, resulting in the creation of entire new communities where none presently exist. The time is coming when a workable large scale system for purifying sea water . . to the extent that it can be used for agriculture . . will be put into general use. Eventually much of the water of Southern California will come from the sea.

Large scale fires will be more easily controlled. A new material is to be used that will put out fires in a

very short time.

With regard to coming disasters elsewhere, a large earthquake is in the making in the Pacific Islands, bringing in its wake a large tidal wave that could do damage to the islands.

There are also probable earthquakes in Lower California, and possibly in Mexico and South America. As mentioned before, the main damage seen for the Los Angeles area is the rendering of one of the freeways impassable. In addition to severe earthquakes that may take many lives in Central and South America, there is great danger in the upper part of Russia where a fault line runs through Siberia and the Arc-We want to prevent an earthquake there, for it would mean an entirely different picture for the people of Alaska, changing their whole way of life for generations to come. If it occurs, it can be the worst climatic catastrophe in history. An earthquake in India could also occur opening up the earth and destroying the lives of many. Keep an eye on Japan also for trouble that could set it back considerably.

During the past two or three years epidemic disease is in the making, one that - if it were to get out of hand would take the lives of hundreds of

thousands of people.

SCIENTIFIC DEVELOPMENTS

It is in the field of science that the most wonderful and interest-inspiring developments will be made in the immediate future. Developments which many think far in the future are "just around the corner." In the next few years we will know things that are regarded now as unsolvable mysteries.

There will come into future use for locomotion which - for want of a better name - we might call "automobiles" but which have no wheels. They are not on the market yet, but have been on the drawing boards for some time.

Radar, as we know it, is to become obsolete and will be replaced by automatic control of aircraft in flight. The use of atomic power will permit cheap, rapid, accessible flights anywhere in the world in just about "the twinkling of an eye." This will do much to eliminate the differences among men and advance the period of universal

peace and understanding.

Some of the weapons and implements now designed for destruction are to be modified for good. A weapon is being developed long since mentioned in these predictions that will eliminate worry. about an atomic bomb. It will utilize rays as its operating principle, and will bring about a cure for cancer, tuberculosis, and other diseases. If employed as a weapon, no structure would be able to withstand it, but if used properly in treating disease can bring about a great deal of good.

Atomic power will be adapted so that it can reach to the bottom of the sea as easily as a needle going through cloth. 



THE CASE OF THE ELBERFELD HORSES



Among these visitors was the famous writer, Maeterlinck. In the manger, in front of the horse selected, were placed cards, each bearing a letter of the alphabet. The answer to the question put by the visitor and repeated aloud by Herr Krall was spelled out by the horse, who lifted the letter with his mouth from the manger in front of him, thus spelling out the word. For instance: "What do I hold in my hand?" . . . "'R-O-S-E" was spelled out by the "What is its color?" horse. . . . "P-I-N-K." But more wonderful still. Herr Krall asked his guest to ask the cube root of some large number. This he did, but got no response from the horse, much to the chagrin of the owner who, on working it out, found that it was a number of which there was no cube root, so he suggested that Maeterlinck should try again. This time the right number was rapped out at once by the stamping of the horse's hoof. Several similar tests were submitted, and



the answers showed complete intelligence on the part of the horse.

What is the solution of the mystery? Mentioning a desire to secure infornation on the subject to friends in Spirit, the answer came at the next sitting that it was a case of pure Spiritualism. Wherever love exists, an atmosphere is created into which Spirits, once human souls living on Earth, in tune with the mental state provided, can enter.

The owners and trainers, Van Osten and Karl Krall, were deeply attached to their horses, and to this love the animals responded. The atmosphere resulting was one into which a certain Spirit could enter, and the horses being clair-voyant, as most of the nobler animals are, obeyed their Spirit Master, as they did their earthly ones. The answers to the questions put by the latter were given in obedience to indications by the former, thus the phenomenon!

The same explanation holds in regard to all other animals on behalf of which kindred phenomena are claimed. It is unreasonable to assume that an animal's mentality could express itself in human language, appreciating the value and meaning of words.. in the case of the Elberfeld horses these were of the German language.. nor could its intelligence possibly work out so difficult a mental problem as to give correctly the cube root of given numbers.

Mediumship is far more general, and has many more methods of expression than most of us are prepared to admit.


"And these soul attributes become a body beautiful.

KARMIC LAW OR DIVINE GRACE . . WHICH ?

Into my office one day stepped a man who recounted one of the weirdest tales I had ever heard in my many decades of practice as a metaphysician. He told of the physical condition of his only sister, confined to a wheelchair because she had lost completely the use of her legs, which had been perfectly normal until the phenomenal experience occurred of which I am writ-

He and his sister had lived together for many years, neither having married. Then one day he met the woman whom he was later to marry. When he told his sister of his intentions, which - of course - would involve the breaking up of their home and the necessity for her to live by herself, her reactions were nothing short of violent at his apparent selfishness and neglect of her. However, the marriage and separation were consummated in due time. When the sister learned that a child was expected, she went into hysterics over this further intrusion into the formerly happy relationship between the two.

Then came the denouement. When the child was born, she was completely without the use of her little legs. As the father described the condition, it. was similar to what one might experience if grasping a rag doll around the midriff and shook the flopping extremi-

When it appeared that no form of surgery or manipulation could remedy the situation, the father consulted a "healer" who followed one of the esoteric methods of therapy. In reply to the father's query as to the possibility of the child being healed, the healer told him, "Yes, she can be healed, and you can be sure that one day whoever it was that wished this condition on the child will live to see it manifested in

his or her own body." Within a week the child began to show evidences of voluntary movement of the legs . . . and the sister, or the child's aunt, overnight was afflicted with the complete inaction of her pedal extremities. At the time of our interview, the father said that the child was running around as normally as other children, and that his sister was confined hopelessly to a wheelchair, her legs having shriveled to complete inutility.

This example of the law of Karma in action, also sometimes described as "an eye for an eye, a tooth for a tooth . . . and whosoever sheddeth man's blood by man shall his blood be shed" . . . while satisfying the cause of justice or revenge, could not serve to institute a new way of life. On the contrary, it served to alert the writer to the incontrovertible fact that one must choose between the law of God and the law of Karma, which eventually will operate even when no mental manipulation is exercised. Sooner or later, in this stage of consciousness or the next, one's offenses must catch up with him.

In the experience of the greatest exponent of the laws of God, Jesus the Christ, occurred an incident which has baffled most students of the Bible. One day this infallible healer visited the country of the Gadarenes and "there met him out of the tombs a man with unclean spirits" who was so tremendously strong that no man could "tame him," even with chains and fetters. The dialogue which followed was terminated with the demand of him that the "unclean spirits" be permitted to enter a herd of swine grazing nearby. To this request the Master acquiesced, and the herd "ran down a steep place into the sea and were choked" . . or drowned.

This phenomenon illustrates a philosophy similar to that of the esoteric healer in the case cited previously here. Apparently the assumption was locally that the swine had somehow produced the insanity of the strong man, and therefore must perish in order to restore him to normalcy. But, while such a manifestation of Karma might have satisfied the healer under similar circumstances, it could never account for the salvation of the man on the part of the greatest healer the world has ever known. His spiritual insight perceived the mental nature of the cause. This, however, was only incidental to the operation of the law of God which freed the man on the basis of his sovereign right to harmony and dominion because of his eternally perfect relation to God.

The great Hebrew lawgiver, Moses, admonished his followers: "I call heaven and earth to record this day against you that I have set before you life and death - blessing and cursing; therefore, choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live." This fundamental exhortation posits the choice of every man to enjoy life and the blessings of God - - or accept the reverse, the curse of Adamic postulates terminat-

ing in spiritual death.

There seems to be no alternative . . either one understands and obeys the law of God's perfection and that of His creation, including man . . or he comes automatically and inevitably under the laws of Karma with all the curses they placed upon Adam for his disobedience. Intelligent comprehension of right choice would seem to indicate that there is only one way to true health, prosperity and freedom, namely: "the straight and narrow way of spiritual understanding."

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WHAT ABOUT PHYSICAL PHENOMENA?

The physical phenomena of Spiritualism, as distinct from the mental or psychical phenomena, are those which relate to the physical world, and in which some mechanical or physical movement of matter takes place. In clairvoyance, for example, no such physical phenomena is apparent; but if a table be lifted into the air by supernormal means, then we do come into contact with mechanical and physical forces.

PHYSICAL CONTACT

Doubtless you have seen performances of so-called mind-readers who found lost articles which were hidden in' various parts of the room or hall, when one who knew their hiding place held the psychic's hand or placed it to his forehead, etc. In most of these performances it is not mind-reading at all, strictly speaking, but what is technically known as "muscle reading," the faint unconscious twitchings of the muscles of the person holding the psychic's hand are felt and interpreted by him, consciously or unconsciously, and these guide him to the spot where the article is hidden.

If one concentrates on the faint pushings and pullings given, in nine cases out of ten the article will be located. Some performers who have had years of experience grow so proficient they are enabled to open safes whose combinations they do not know merely by holding the hand of one who does, or even drive a cab along the streets of a crowded city while blindfolded, avoiding other vehicles by just holding the hand of one who can see them.

INDEPENDENT FORCE AND POWER

Planchette writing is another means whereby the hand moves at first as the result of unconscious muscular action. After a time, however, some psychic force seems to be developed and the board often continues to move about even after the hands of the operator are removed from it.

Beyond this we have also those cases of so-called "dowsing" where the forked twig (or other material) bends to and fro in the hands of the water finder when he walks over water and metals. The simple movements felt at first are probably due to muscular twitchings, but as the force develops it seems to become more independent, and the twig is bent in spite of the efforts to

hold it.

TABLE-TIPPING

Another type of physical phenomena are those with the table. A group sits around an ordinary table and can tilt it or tip it. The first simple movements are probably due to the unconscious muscular pressures of those having their hands on the table. Later on, as the psychic force develops and charges the table, it seems to assume an independent character and the table often continues to move when all hands are withdrawn from it. In fact . . in many instances and especially under unfavorable conditions, the phenomena do not rise above the initial stage (of simple non-intelligent movements), leaving the impression on the minds of the investigators that the force exhibited is, if at present unknown and unaccounted for, nevertheless, a natural and a mechanical one, and that the action of independent intelligence in connection with it cannot be conceived. This has been the experience and verdict of even scientific inquirers who have not hesitated to give that verdict to the world.

HOW THE POWER INCREASES

Such a conclusion is based upon inaccurate knowledge and upon imperfect and superficial observation. experienced psychic students are aware that it is often only after repeated and prolonged sittings that the full development of the psychic force is obtained and that independent intelligence is exhibited in connection with it, and that in by far the larger number of instances that stage of the experiment is never reached at all. It is fully admitted the mysterious force thus called into operation in some unknown way issues from the physical organism of the sensitive and the sitters, and is in itself an unintelligent force; but it is with equal confidence asserted that when available in sufficient quantity and wholly detached from the physical organism, it can be, and beyond all doubt is, frequently manipulated by intelligences, independent of and other than that of the psychic and the investigators assisting in such an experiment.

HOW PHYSICAL PHENOMENA

The principle upon which many physical phenomena are based is this: There is a vital or nervous force existing in many of us usually limited to the surface of our own bodies, so that unless we touch the object in question, we cannot move it. Under certain conditions, however, this vital energy, or fluid, is capable of being projected outward beyond the normal bodily limits into space, and, when powerful enough, is capable of moving physical objects with which it comes into contact; or if it be a rapid outward projection of this force, it produces percussive sounds or raps well known to Spiritualists. This psychic force often is uncontrolled, then objects are moved without the knowledge of and even against the wish of the medium. We then have the socalled Poltergeist phenomena. other times this force may be guided and manipulated by the conscious or unconscious mind of the medium. Beyond this stage is one in which the medium is unconscious of what is occurring, having passed into trance . . and it is then that many of the most striking physical phenomena occur. At such times complicated and intelligent physical manifestations are produced which are not due either to the mind of the medium or to any person present.


EXTERNALIZED VITAL ENERGY

Here we enter the realm of genuine physical phenomena produced by spirit intelligences. Most of the communications are obtained through raps, following a code. Playing upon musical instruments, for example, is due to this source. In other words, after a certain point has been reached, the externalized vital energy or psychic power of the medium is manipulated by an external intelligence, even creating forms by utilizing it.

CONTROLLING THE PHENOMENA

Very interesting experiments have been conducted in controlling physical phenomena, but not much success as yet has been attained in this direction. An experiment was conducted where a medium who had the power of producing raps was hypnotized, and it was suggested that raps be produced at will, according to the suggestion of the hypnotist. This was completely successful. It was also suggested that raps be obtained on any article of furniture which the hypnotist would suggest. This also succeeded. The range and variety of physical phenomena are great, such as: table levitations, movements of objects without contact, playing upon musical instruments without apparent cause, spirit and thought photography, materialization, slate writing, apports, trumpet phenomena, raps, etc.

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Absent Healing

VER SINCE MAN has been interested in the healing of his ailing fellowman he has searched for ways of sending healing across time and space to those in need who were not able to come to the healer.

In ancient times, when I fulfilled an earth cycle as a physician and teacher in the beautiful city of Alexandria in the Nile Delta, distance could not be bridged by trains, motor cars or airplanes winging swiftly across the sky. Physicians had to depend on swift runners for short distances, or on horses and camels for great distances. That was the reason why we turned eagerly to those eminently successful forms of spiritual distance healing.

Various methods of what is called absent healing were tested and used by my pupils and me at that time. As the pupils used them, it established proof of their success in their own minds, and gave them confidence in having chosen the healing arts as their chosen profession.

Amongst my handful of pupils were four who had the promise of becoming excellent healers. They were: Kerekai of Persia, Luriti from upper Egypt, Soma Tarando from India, and a young Greek by the name of Galen. I gave each of these students a different method of distance healing to use, each according to his or her preference. Thus Kerekai chose Color; Luriti, with her lovely voice, used the Prayer Chant; Soma Tarando preferred the vibration of Sound and Music; and young Galen used a combination of the healing hand held over a symbol representing the patient. He called this form of distance healing Harmonizing Through Projected Light.

I should like to tell you about each of these methods and illustrate when and why each one is most effective.

KEREKAI'S PROJECTED COLOR

Kerekai, having an artistic nature, chose color as his means of distance healing. He trained himself first to feel, and then to see the colors with which he experimented. He used children as willing receiving stations for the sending of his colors, for children, if not spoiled by ignorant parents or teachers, make use of their imagination in a natural fashion and thus can be trained into becoming good receiving stations.

First he showed the children the color he was going to send to them until they became accustomed to the warmth of Red, the soothing tenderness of Green, and the cooling gentleness of Then he would tell his little helpers, "Close your eyes. I am going to send you a beautiful color. You will feel it and tell me which color it is." In the beginning the children stand only a couple of paces away from him, but as they became better receiving stations, he increased the distance to ten, twenty and thirty paces. He even had them hide behind a wall, then finally sent them up on to the roof of a dwelling at the other end of our beautiful city of Alexandria where these experiments took place.

The final tests were made with three children suffering from various ailments: one had lung fever (pneumonia); one suffered from the falling disease (epilepsy); and one merely suffered from pollen irritation (plant allergy). These ailments were healed at a distance by Kerekai, not only through the choice of the right color combinations, but also through the right rhythm in sending the colors. One little patient needed color sent to him only once every day, another . . three times daily, and one . . every three hours for

the first three days.

When Kerekai had proven the efficacy of color for healing at a distance, all of my students were instructed in the use of this form of distance healing . . with varied results. The outstanding color healers were, of course, Kerekai – – because he had become an unobstructed channel through its use and belief - - then Soma Tarando - because sound and color are closely related, and he understood their vibratory relationship, and finally young Galen - - because he was willing to accept the findings of Kerekai, and therefore also became an unobstructed channel for color healing at a distance. The other students suffered from such obstructions as disbelief, doubt, pride and inharmony.

Those who did not believe that color could heal, or be sent through time and space, had no results whatever. Those who doubted Kerekai's method also had no results. Those whose own inharmony and pride in their own form of healing made them look down at color healing as an inferior form had very meager results.

What was true at the time of Kerekai's experiments is still true today: disbelief, doubt, pride and inharmony obstruct a healing channel and discourage the would-be healer with meager or no results. One must be willing to accept this basic truth: All forms of healing come from the great Creator of all life and beingness; therefore all are good, but in order to be effective, one must first become an unobstructed channel.

once every day, another.. three times Faith, in the form of healing you daily, and one.. every three hours for have chosen as your own, and prac-

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tice - daily practice - are needed to channel. make you an unobstructed But more than this: you must be willing to test your own efficiency as a distance healer. For this, time is needed, and complete dedication. Chose wisely the form of healing that seems the most natural to you, and do not let pride confuse your judgment.

Let me ennumerate for you the steps Kerekai found necessary in his self-training to send color to his patients at a distance. He found that:

1st - he had to feel a color.

2nd - he had to feel the chosen color surrounding his patient, or receiving station.

3rd - he had to learn to distinguish the effect of each of the seven basic colors on himself.

4th - he had to learn the effect of a chosen color on a receiving station, or patient.

5th - he had to learn to diagnose, not only which color assembly should be used for the healing of a chosen patient, but how much time each color was needed for the best effect, and in which rhythm the color had to be sent.

6th - he had to train himself to see color behind closed eyelids.

7th - he had to see, with closed eyes, a projected color surround his chosen receiving station or patient.

8th - he had to be willing to test his ability extensively.

9th - he had to remain humble and give the Creator of all life both thanks and credit for the results.

10th - he had to learn to accept all other forms of distance healing, both for himself and others . . the last being the most difficult of all to learn.

LURITI'S PRAYER CHANT

Chanting has been used in the temples of Atlantis, as well as in Egypt, India, Persia and Greece. It is used to step up a sluggish or sleeping polarity, and thus bring it into harmony again with its counterpart.

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For each individual the mixture of these polarities varies. Where one may need an equal fifty percent from both, the negative and the positive current, another may need sixty percent from one and only forty of the other. Your God-

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

given Spirit tries always to maintain this individual balance, and tries to influence both your conscious mind to a sensible diet and sensible exercise, and your subterranean, or subconscious mind to keep harmful thoughts and feelings festering in its cellar region. However, sometimes one, then sometimes the other, and often both facets of your mind forget to fulfill their tasks, then imbalance is the inevitable result. Imbalance always creates dis-ease. Therefore, as you can see, an accurate and daily balancing of these two polarities is necessary. This can be achieved in several ways: (a) By the conscious mind training itself to think only good and health producing thoughts. (Out of this grew the science of positive affirmations.) (b) By training your subconscious mind to eliminate all harm-bringing feelings, such as fear, anger, doubt, jealousy and their ilk. (c) By the individual cleansing himself, or herself, in daily prayer and meditation. (d) By using the Soul Melody for this daily balance-attunement. (e) By having another send your Soul Melody to you in a Prayer Chant.

For this the healer must be extremely sensitive and able to attune himself completely to the need of the patient. Only those will have good results who previously had conditioned themselves to this delicate form of vibratory balancing of the two polarities.

(Further discussion of the Prayer Chant, as well as the other two forms of absent healing mentioned by Antonius, will be contained in next month's conclusion.)

HE TIBETAN TEACHER says that the beginning stage of discipleship is the most difficult in the whole cycle of evolution. "Here the self is sometimes walking in the shadow, at other times in full sunlight. Sometimes it knows the joys of full communion, and at other times all seems dull and sterile. Service at times seems fruitful and satisfying, then one seems to have nothing to offer. At one time the neophyte knows himself as Son of God, and again is sure of nothing. Those who enter upon this training need not count the cost. The reward is great, but the path is rough."
