THE MONSTER TELEVISION is, unfortunately, one of the obvious reflections of our intellectual temperament. I, for one, learn more about what we, as Americans, think from this continuous window than from anywhere else, and lately I have seen on television a whole rash of concern about what is known as the mysterious East.

Parents worry because their college children read Zen Buddhism with enjoyment; other parents fret because their high school offspring prepare karate, jujitsu, hand-to-hand combat, and secret throws as if our national enemy might be the abominable snowman instead of an invading Russia.

The center of the storm about the East, however, is Eastern mysticism and Eastern psychics. True psychics devote their lives to God through contemplation and prayer, thus preparing the ego, or self, for the "ultimate" state by mortification and dissociation. The ultimate occurs as ecstasy, the realization that the separate experiences of life, observed by the conscious mind, are inconsequential and hence subjugated to the unity of God's world. The little perceptions are relegated to the grandness of the ultimate, unifying mind of God. This realization, or feeling, of the nearness of God's plan, is derived from the operation of the subconscious mind, and its operation demands the mortification of the ruling power of the conscious mind.

Our very education, here in the West, from the time we enter the world, emphasizes dependence upon SEPTEMBER 1964 CHIMES (W ho cannot boast of at least one experience with his Psychic Presence? Nearly everyone, and still more of us admit to ourselves, when no one is looking, that there is, even yet, new knowledge and power deep within us if we but encourage it at the appropriate times. Here Rev. Brown unfolds his own Psychic Presence techniques, developed through years of pastoral psychic counseling and research with the great unknown happenings of life.)

the conscious, empirical world, the world we learn of by dependence upon our senses. In turn, we control this conscious world through the use of language. Thus mysticism for us is quite rare. But it need not be.

The entire process of reactivating the subconscious and putting it to use, in spite of the demands of conscious, cognitive reasoning, requires time, and diligence. The continued training of the inner-self brings forth psychic powers in tiny microscopic insights. Time stands still. Call it auto-hypnosis, even insanity, or whatever, it simply brings impressive results.

We of the Western world are not so much fascinated by this process as by the obvious insight of those who have succeeded. For instance, in our heritage, the earliest and most natural examples of Psychic Presence were the torecasting of events in Biblical dreams. The Old Testament is riddled with dream sequences, particularly in the Torah or ancient Pentateuch. By the same law of nature, dreams are one of the first places that psychiatrists today look for explanations of our subconscious workings.

These workings are uncovered in a

way to discover an entire complex of working forces, desires, motivations, and forgotten detail which actually forms a control personality, ruling our lives from behind a wall, in secret, as it were. It is in the subconscious, or control personality, that we record everything that ever happens to us, as if on a huge tape recorder. Mysticism is basically the attempt to define this hidden personality, to utilize the energy there, to develop the Psychic Presence that integrates all life's personal experience.

Our dreams and innermost desires originate in this subconscious area, and it is for mastery of these desires and motivations that the ancient psychics turned their attention. During moments of ecstasy, complete knowledge of reality became overwhelmingly meaningful. St. Dionysius of the early Christian Church brought about his self-realization by a three-fold mental concentration plan. He studied psychic experience by abandoning intellectuality or verbal conditioning and ignoring perceptions conveyed by his senses to the logical intellectual centers of conscious interpretation. Thus he strained emotionally to feel or know God. He did not talk about God, he knew Him, felt Him, and touched Him through his Psychic Presence. It was his impressive emotional knowledge of God, through the spark of Divine Psychic Presence, which made the difference.

All ancient seers, including Aristotle and even St. Paul, began their quest for the Psychic Presence with emotionally charged, non-verbal symbols from their sub-conscious, subjective personality. Their logical, almost mathematical analysis of life, came (concluded on page 26)

Try These Exercises . . .

B REATH IS the underlying principle of life. The rhythm of one's inspiration and expiration, with the intervening retentment and arrestment. determines the development of the body and mind. For the immediate arrest of pain and physical discomfort, try this "Yima Exercise."

First of all, relax every part of your body, whether standing, sitting, or lying down. Keep your chest out; hold muscles

YOUR DIVINE BREATH

in check. Exhale slowly; do not move the chest. Empty the lungs to the utmost. As soon as it seems that you cannot empty the lungs any more, arrest all further action. Do not move; keep your mind on the state of inaction, and either count mentally to eighteen or more, or think a prayer.

Now inhale through the nostrils fully, but with ease, and immediately empty the lungs as before, arresting all action for eighteen or more seconds, and proceed as before for two or more times. Four times in all will suffice, although after a few hours the exercise may have to be repeated, depending on the néed.

To the extent one's mind suffers or lacks power to utilize its latent forces, or control one's talents for good, it is because the inspiration is too low, and the dynamics lack the power required to keep the mind in tune with Harmonic Laws governing the individual. When depressed, down-hearted, disappointed, irritable or void of thought, when mentally overtaxed, the "Airyama Exercise" below will prove to be a means of setting the heart and mind at ease:

Relax all muscles and throw out your chest. Inhale through the nostrils slowly, but fully; always attempt to inhale a little more after you think you have filled your lungs completely. Now, retain the breath, arresting all action, and

count mentally to eighteen or more, or think a prayer; then exhale slowly but completely, and immediately inhale as before, taking caution not to move the once expanded muscles of the chest; retain the breath again for eighteen or more seconds, and thereafter exhale. This Exercise should be taken three to five times just before sitting down to study or taking up mental work. *Do not* take this exercise immediately after a meal.

It is also suggested that the person manually employed should make it a habit to breathe out a prayer or aphorism about the length of the Lord's Prayer upon one single exhalation, three times in succession, every three hours during the time of activity, or whenever showing signs of fatigue.

SHE LIVED in Rio Verde, a tiny village at the foot of the mountain ridge. Her house, like most of the others there, was but a tiny palm thatched hut with floor of hard black dirt. She lived very primitively indeed!

Everyone called her Abuelita (dear little Grandma). She had no idea how old she was. All she could remember, in clear moments, was that Diaz was President when she took her first communion. Her friends figured she must be seventy years old, or older. Seventy is very old for anyone in the tropics, and the little old woman was ready to die. Now she was very ill, and dozed through the long days and the hard never-ending nights—or so they seemed to her. She hardly ate anything, but she never missed her strong, sweet coffee early in the morning.

Finally they called on her and suggested she send for the Padre. He would give her the last Holy Sacraments, and THEN she would die peacefully.

The good Padre came all the way from San Pedro and gave the little old woman the last rites, assuring her that now she would have the peace for which she had so long, hoped. She would not have to linger longer, but could go on to her rest. When the young Padre bent through the door of the low hut to leave, then straightened up, his eyes beheld rows of friends assembled and waiting outside. They were ready to start wailing the moment she was dead. They would honor the dear soul in this native

Great revelations in the field of mediumship. may be waiting to be made known unto us . . . which are more likely to be of a mental nature."

• KEEP A PSYCHIC DIARY?

May Wright states in an article appearing in the English magazine, Prediction, that keeping a diary of her psychic experiences helped to promote the development of her latent spiritual gifts, besides providing much interesting reading. Entries of her experiences of clairaudience, astral projection, clairvoyance, cosmic teachings received, etc. helped her to understand better what was being received. Even recording precognitive dreams helped her to check them out later when they occurred in life. "If you have hunches, intuitions or psychic experiences, why not keep a diary?" she says. "Even if of no great importance, it will prove



interesting reading. Once the habit is started, incidents seem to multiply and improve in quality. There are psychic gifts latent in all of us, and they should be cultivated." Might be a good idea.

• UNIQUE BOOK REVIEWS

Rather than to read a book, then review it for readers, Editor Max Freedom Long of Huna Vistas, Bulletin of the Huna Research Associates, gets out his pendulum to get a reading on the literary worth and spiritual evolution of the author first. He can also do this by taking a reading on the photograph of an author where his identity and works are not revealed. He gives an instance of such an application when he was requested by one of the Research Associates to give a reading on a photograph of Nicola Tesla, then unknown to him. It was a good reading, one reporting that he was a man obsessed, but whose obsessing spirit seemed to be good instead of bad, and who had a far higher degree reading than the man of the photograph, the latter being in the heart of the degree range where the best mediums and psychics are found. He learned later that Tesla was trained as an electrical engineer and apparently was used by a spirit genius to give the world very valuable information leading to the famous inventions, such as the use of alternating current electricity to make it possible to carry power for long distances with little loss. He has also found in his readings on authors that obsessing spirits often are of less intelligence than the medium through whom they work. Also most interesting are his findings on authors of the books of the Bible and the early Church Fathers. A novel approach to another useful application of pendling.

• "ELECTRONIC" TELEPATHIC TESTER

Newsletter of the Parapsychology Foundation reports from an article in the Russian Youth paper of Azerbaijan by Eduard Konstantinovich Naumov, "engineers have constructed a special set of electronic mechanisms for telepathic tests; it consists of an electronic hypnotist, a unit for automatic testing and for the computation of results, and mechanisms stimulating a positive telepathic effect and 'penalizing' the subject for a failure." Mr. Naumov states in his article that he is sure that "future scientists will find means not only to use man's telepathic faculties, but also to bring out, train and develop these faculties. For the human system is a unit provided by nature with an extraordinary reserve supply of unlimited possibilities which one only has to know how to exploit." Nothing was included of the great spiritual implications of this development, of course. Perhaps that day will come even in our time.

Science of Mind Magazine, in bringing to the public its message of how all things are one, how we have not even begun to learn about the nature. and relatedness of things, that we do not yet realize how we communicate and control the objects of our environment through our thinking, in a recent issue tells of a letter to the editor of a science fiction magazine in which the writer describes his experience with his TV set, probably resembling experiences many have had with their automobiles, shavers, washing machines, tools, office equipment, ad infinitum. The writer long had been mentally supporting the set with the idea that it was functioning properly in every respect, then decided to experiment and see what would happen if he let the set operate itself. Whatever you want to call it, coincidence, mind power, or anything else that might have been involved, the fact still remains that that evening the set went dead, and on examination revealed that nine major components had ceased to function! Unexplained, maybe, but not unexplainable.

Spiritual Healing in

N THIS particular historical age, it is a significant feature of spiritual healing to know that this divinely inspired therapy continues unabated in the land where apartheid and human conflict has manifested its ugly features. It may be that the process of social evolution is gradually giving moral strength to those who have suffered for so many generations. It may be that a growing spiritual development, unseen by the eyes of those materialistically inclined, ultimately will bloom forth in a volume of moral righteousness, unheard of amongst other races of people. Evolution is slow moving, but it is relentless in its progression.

In relation to its territorial vastness, the spiritual healing endeavors of this people are insignificant. In relation to the position of its social evolution, however, it ranks comparable with many countries which claim to have embraced civilization. Healing in Africa has taken many forms in long past generations, and it is worthy of note that the organized medical associations of many countries have during recent years attempted to fathom the depths of its practice, which, although of a mythical character, did produce healing results which could not be comprehended by medical science. Could it be that Spirit guidance was directed even to the spiritually uninitiated? We may never know.

Spiritual healing in Africa, as it is understood today, is comparatively new and has only commenced its for-



ward movement during the last two or three decades. The African national movement which propagates the principles and philosophy of spiritual healing is efficiently directed by a railway official, who is himself a spiritual healer. Mr. Noel Griffin is the worthy President of the only national organization which elucidates spiritual healing in its true perspective . . . a divine therapy for all races of people.

The best known and most famous healer in Africa during past years was a Mrs. Vogl. She was an English woman who married an African. Two well known books have been written around her remarkable psychic powers.

Two exceptional cases of healing in Africa during recent years are concerned with Edmund F. Bentley. He was an English schoolmaster for twenty-two years who retired at the age of 47 upon inheriting a small family estate in Africa. He developed his healing gift during 1952.

In 1953 Edmund Bentley lived in a small hotel in Pietermaritzburg and used to spend his days in a rather dreary slum area in which the Indian population then lived. His clinic was at a building called The Aryan Benevolent Home, where he was given a couple of rooms to which the local population gradually came in fairly large numbers. One day an elderly Indian woman, who had been totally deaf for eleven years, came for treatment. He placed his hands on her ears, said a silent prayer, and waited for the divine power to flow through him. After about ten seconds, his patient suddenly leaped from her chair and darted into the ante-room where other patients were waiting; she was hysterical with joy, claiming that the sounds of the everyday world about her were now penetrating herconsciousness. She could hear perfectly and, subsequently, responded to every test successfully. From time to time during the rest of that year he contacted her, and found that her happy condition was maintained. She described a small popping sound in the drum of each ear that had taken place when he touched her ears. This was the only indication that the healing had broken through the thick veil of her auditory isolation.

The second case occurred in May, 1961. A young English boy named Graham May, a garage mechanic by trade, had been stricken in January of (continued on page 25) SEA FOOD is the coming thing. • If Spiritualism is the true religion, why is it not the leading church in today's world, instead of being one of the lesser known?

"Spiritualism," as it is called today, the organization, is comparatively new. It dates from the time of the Fox sisters, about a hundred years ago. Prior to that it was called by all kinds of names.

Spiritualism could not possibly be the leading religion today for a number of reasons. Catholicism, and other major religions, for almost two thousand years have preached that it is wrong to disturb or to call back the "dead," and have asked everyone to refrain from so doing. The phenomena of the Bible are not looked upon as Spirit manifestations, but as miracles performed by God or by Jesus. Therefore Spiritualism could not now take its rightful place in the field of religion because people have not been so trained. They have been taught to avoid the raps and the taps and the various antics that go' in seances rather than to give any importance to what is called "mediumship." Many people consider Spiritualism to be the work of the devil, and therefore shun it through ignorance and lack of understanding.

• Do people in the Spirit world see at all times the activities of earth people?

No. Spirit people are not here all the time to see all the things you do. But if they happen to be in your immediate atmosphere and your "vibration," they can pretty clearly see what you are doing. They look upon it quite a little differently, however, than if it were presented to their eyes while they

were still in the physical. ' • What is meant by a "new soul?" Where and in what consciousness was this soul before incarnating?

Well, there is no such thing as a new soul in this particular generation, for you cannot say that a soul who had been reborn many times is a new soul. An "old soul" is a learned soul. A new soul is not new to this world, but the expression "new soul" means that it has not yet learned very much. This is just a figure of speech.

• Why is it that some people who attend seances are unable to contact those whom they love very much? Why is it that my sister, who has been in Spirit for fifty-eight years, has never been able to come through to me?

It is much easier in many cases for a person who has been gone for two or three years or even for a week to come back in a seance than for a person to appear who has been gone for fifty-eight years. However, it is possible to come back for many, many years.) Much longer than fifty-eight.()

In all probability the sister who is not present to communicate with the other sister on the earth plane has gone into a plane of consciousness where she is not desirous of returning to the physical plane. Then there may be a number of reasons why she cannot communicate.

It is possible to communicate with one who has been in the Spirit world seventy-five years, or who has been gone twenty-four hours. It all depends upon the affinity, the relationship between the two, the desire to communicate, or whether the entity in the Spirit world is more interested in things there and is not desirous of coming back to communicate.

• How do spirits appear to each other? Do you appear rather shadowy to one another, or can you see right through each other on your plane?

Be it known unto all people of the earth plane that when you are in the astral, in the particular region to which you gravitate, when you are talking to John Jones, John Jones is just as solid to your senses in all respects as he was while he was still on the physical earth plane and you spoke to him there. You do not see through Spirit when you exist in the Spirit world.

To explain this properly I would have to become technical and explain that in the Spirit world you are dealing with sublimated material ... material composed of the "anim," which in the world of Spirit is equivalent to, in your gross world, the atom. Therefore in the Spirit world in which we exist we are fully garbed. We walk normally. We talk. Our senses are just as keen, much keener sometimes, than when we were on the earth plane, and we do not "see through" each other.

The reason people have the impression that spirits are transparent is that when they come to the earth and pass through to your dense side of the Candic Ray, they must appear ethereal to you because they are appearing through that which is solid to you, and they can go through that which is solid to you. They, too, are of a solid dimension, but are of a higher rate of vibration, therefore the appearance is different.

CELESTIAL ICEBERGS?

S CIENCE HAS a satisfactory explanation for hailstones—but what about huge chunks of ice, weighing up to fifty pounds that have sometimes plunged to the earth? Compounding the mystery is the fact that many of these strange ice falls came from clear, surny skies.

On the morning of July 3, 1960 in Portage, Pa., Mrs. Dixie Lewis was hanging her wash to dry in the backyard. She heard a loud whoosh, looked up, saw some bright object plunging toward her and barely managed to leap aside.

The mass of ice thudded to earth, dug a hole about the size of a twogallon bucket and shattered itself to pieces. Oddly, the fragments seemed to break along lines which indicated the ice had formed in layers. The town's police chief estimated the chunk must have weighed about 25 pounds.

In Toccoa, Ga., in 1959 a thirty pound chunk of ice smashed to earth ... No one could explain it. London newspapers reported two ice falls there during December, 1959. One chunk ripped through the roof of a house, smashed through the ceiling and demolished a substantial table.

A few days later, another basketball-size lump of ice came whistling down through the roof of a house, doing considerable damage. Officials collected the fragments that remained and offered no explanation.

On a clear, sunny afternoon-Sept.

11, 1949—three doctors went dovehunting on a ranch in Stephens County, Texas. Dr. Robert Botts was sitting beside a huge earthen storage basin when he heard a shrill, whistling sound.

He glanced up in time to see a glistening object which seemed to be headed directly toward him. Actually, it was a chunk of ice which weighed an estimated 40 pounds. It struck the earth about fifteen feet from the startled doctor, digging a hole several inches deep and shattering itself to fragments.

Dr. Botts called his companions and the three of them examined the evidence. They agreed that it was ice and that it was milky white and had an unpleasant astringent taste.

Two boys in Buffalo, N.Y. were riding their bicycle on Sept. 11, 1950. They heard a "ripping sound" and a slab of ice five inches wide, three inches thick and a foot long thudded to earth alongside one of the boys, barely missing him.

His mother called authorities, who promptly called the Weather Bureau. The weather "experts" said the slab of ice had fallen from the wing of a plane . . . But airport records showed no plane had flown over the area for several hours.

In Aitkin, Minn. on April 2, 1889, sudden darkness engulfed the city and both sand and chunks of ice fell in great quantities.

In the Orkney Islands, north of

Scotland, July 24, 1818 was a day to plague the scientists. Jagged pieces of ice, some of it a foot long, rained upon the islands. When it melted the residue had a distinct sulphurous odor.

William Wiley, of Mount Vernon, Ohio, was driving along the highway on May 18, 1961. Suddenly, he saw a white object dropping toward him in a sweeping arc. At first, he thought it was a piece of paper, or a small bird.

There was not time to duck, just a splintering crash as the object smashed into his windshield and through it, sprinkling the driver and his 12-yearold son, David, with a shower of fragments.

Wiley stopped the car to take inventory. He brushed the tiny particles from his son's face and together they searched the inside of the car for the missile. He discovered that many of the fragments, that appeared to be glass, were actually ice. They were already melting on the floor and seat of the car.

Again, no planes in the air, and no explanation for the origin of the mysterious visitor.

At least three theories have been advanced for possible explanation of the strange ice falls. Your own theory, if different, may be just as good.

Donald Robey, scientist with General Dynamics, advanced the belief that the chunks of ice are fragments of gigantic glacier-size masses that sweep through the heavens in the form of comets or, as he puts it, "cometoids."

Dr. Fred Whipple of Harvard Observatory, in seeking to explain the behavior of comets, contends that the nucleus is a mass of gases frozen into a solid. The terrestial passage of the earth through the "tail" of such a comet might produce-such ice falls.

Prof. J. H. Ort of the Leyden Observatory in Holland supposes that somewhere in space there is a vast sea of celestial icebergs, the debris of some titanic heavenly catastrophe. "From time to time," says Professor Ort, "masses of this ice may be thrown off into space." What is your theory?

F I WERE something other than me, I would like best to be a tree. A tree knows no bad; regardless of circumstances is one hundred per cent good. Its roots are deep. It lifts its arms high. LESSONS FOR STUDENTS . .

WHAT IS MATERIALIZATION?

MATERIALIZATION is the process of rendering solid, or material, for a longer or shorter time, bodies through which disembodied spirits may function and communicate. Materialization usually occurs at seances in which a group of people are gathered together, and rarely when the medium is alone. The reason for this is probably that the necessary conditions are lacking . . . chiefly the lack of sufficient vital energy drawn from a group of people by a medium and utilized for the purposes of materialization.

MARVELS OF MATERIALIZATION

Many factors play a part in this socalled mysterious phenomenon. Considered from the physical or material point of view, there is the reality of what would be termed the phantom, and from the psychological or mental point of view, there is the materialized entity to account for. If we were always sure that the materialized figure were really the person it claimed to be, this latter difficulty would be overcome, but there are many objections to this simple view of the case in many instances.

From the purely physical point of view, the phenomena of materialization are among the most baffling and the most mysterious. A few minutes before, nothing existed in the cabinet (where the manifestation usually takes place), save the entranced medium. Now there is solid, tangible . form possessing all the properties and appearances of matter, often having solid flesh and bones just as any human being would . . . the flesh being warm and life-like, the hand possessing nails, hair, etc., like any ordinary hand, and apparently composed of the cells and tissues of which any material body would be composed. How does one account for

this? It is surely one of the most bewildering and incredible facts in Nature.

FACTORS NECESSARY TO SUCCESS

First of all, we have the physical body of the medium; secondly, his vital magnetism; thirdly, the magnetism of the sitters forming the circle; fourthly; magnetism from disembodied spirits which mingle together and help to create the forms that appear at seances. The vital energy which seems to be drawn from the circle, and chiefly from the medium, during the seances is utilized or manipulated by the disembodied spirits who build up by its aid the materialized form we see before us. This is a very difficult and complicated process and not all spirits are competent to do his. For this purpose what are known as "spirit chemists" often are employed . . . those who possess the knowledge of how to build up these forms. In the deepest stages of trance when the medium is unconscious, communication through materialized figures becomes clearer and clearer, and the forms become more dense and material. This is true of much psychic phenomena: the deeper the trance, the better the results obtained.

ETHEREALIZATION AND TRANSFIGURATION

In the lighter stages of trance, only portions of the figure may develop,

such as hands, faces, etc., or very shadowy and vaguely defined outlines of human forms. These latter are not, strictly speaking, materialized, but are known as "etherealized" forms. They are less solid than the materialized figures, and often it is possible to pass the hand and arm through one of these figures without disturbing it. In the case of the materialized figure, however, it is just as solid and tangible as any human form, and it would be impossible to make any other solid object pass through any part of it. In many cases the physical body of the medium is more or less altered by the spirits without any other phantom being created. Such cases are known as "transfiguration." When the figure created at the seance is not dense and fully formed, it does not possess either a complete or matured intelligence. It is not "all there," so to speak, mentally or physically.

HOW SOME FORMS ARE CREATED

There is evidence to show that many of these forms are created by the will of the medium, or by discarnate spirits, and that they are more truly thought-forms than they are materialized spirits. Again, many of these figures are "doubles" or "astral bodies" belonging to living people, who happen to appear at the seance, or that are projections from discarnate spirits. In such a case, the intelligence manipulating the phantom is not that of a mature spirit, but is a creation, so to speak, elaborated by the subconscious thoughts of the medium or by the mentality of the sitters forming the circle. The psychic atmosphere created by the minds in the circle has, in other words, produced the mind of the phantom in the same way that the combined vital magnetism of the sitters has produced the material body of the apparition.

Using The Sample Pendulum

PART II.

L AST MONTH I described the construction of a simple pendulum and gave directions for standardizing the instrument. The next stage is to test the reaction of the instrument and the operator.

Simply stated, when the pendulum is used to discover a chemical or mineral it will give a "positive" reaction when held above the substance.

By "positive" we mean a reaction which is clearly distinguishable from the standard reaction.

If you found your standard reaction to be a clockwise circular movement of the bob, then a positive reaction would be an anti-clockwise movement.

To check this, fill one of your small plastic containers with water, another with vinegar and a third with ink. Place these in a row on your table or workspace.

Now, taking the pendulum, fix your mind firmly on the idea of water, and hold the pendulum over each vessel in turn.

Over the vinegar and the ink you should get the standard (or negative) reaction, but when the pendulum is held above the water you will see the positive reaction.

This is obviously the principle of water-divining.

An elaboration to convince yourself would be to use three liquids identical in appearance—say, water, surgical spirit, and a salt solution—which could be distinguished only by smell or taste, but not visually.

After your first experiment, repeat it, but this time concentrate your mind on one of the other liquids. This time the water will give a negative reaction while the liquid sought will give the positive one.

Another simple but effective test uses twenty blank visiting cards. These are available from any good stationer. SEPTEMBER 1964 CHIMES By Christopher C. Somerville London, England

Lightly mark a plus (+) sign on ten of these and a minus (-) sign on the others. Now turn all the marks face down and shuffle the cards thoroughly.

Take one card at a time and place under the pendulum, noting whether it gives a positive or negative reaction. All the cards giving the same reaction are placed in a pile.

At the completion of the experiment you will be pleasantly surprised to find that you have successfully separated the cards into two piles, one all plus signs, the others all minus signs.

"Hide-and-seek" experiments are very effective and very interesting. They are a further elaboration of the early experiment with liquids.

Obtain some small envelopes, and in six of them seal a small amount of some ordinary chemicals: salt, boracic crystals, powdered chalk, pepper, copper sulphate crystals, baking powder, sugar.

Do not put any distinguishing mark on the envelopes. Shuffle them and place them in front of-you in a row. Fix your mind firmly on salt, and hold the pendulum over each envelope in turn. You should have no difficulty in distinguishing the one containing the substance thought of by the positive reaction.

You may find that you fail to discover some of the chemicals, especially. if you try with too wide a variety, or with very similar substances. This is understandable and is to be expected. It was for this eventuality that we constructed the "sample" pendulum.

This has a cavity in which we placed a small quantity of the substance for which we are seeking. With solid substances this is simple, but with liquids I use a small vial which just fits inside the body of the pendulum. Another way is to soak a small wad of cotton wool in the required liquid, and insert this as your sample.

Using a sample pendulum, expert dowsers can discover the location of water, oil or metal deposits working only from a map. If this claim sounds preposterous, I invite you to try the following experiment, which is surely one of the most amazing in the whole field of radiesthesia.

Select any five crystalline chemicals and seal them in identical envelopes. Mix these envelopes thoroughly, and then number them on the outside, 1 to 5. Lay these out in a different room from that in which you are working. Returning to your work-space, lay out another five envelopes similarly numbered, but empty. Take your pendulum containing a sample of one of the chemicals and proceed to "sense" each of the empty envelopes. Over one of these you will get a positive reaction.

Noting the number of this envelope, open the same envelope of those containing the chemicals. You will find the same substance as the sample.

Incredible? Try it!

I am not going to attempt to explain how this works; I only know that it does ... not only for me ... but for countless other radiesthesists.

By the same means water mains can be traced from a street plan, or uranium deposits from a map.

The sample pendulum also is used in modern medical radiesthesia. Traditionally the sample is a bloodspot of the patient (on a slip of blotting paper), but in my experience a nail clipping or a lock of hair is equally effective in establishing contact.

A separate study of medical radiesthesia, called radionics, uses neither pendulum nor dowsing rod, but a more complicated diagnostic apparatus based on the so-called "black box." The construction of this is complicated, but in theory it works on exactly the same principle as does the pendulum.

A method which by-passes the diagnostic stage and concentrates on treatment is based on the bio-chemic treatment. No attempt is made to diagnose the illness, but the various biochemic remedies are investigated with the pendulum equipped with the patient's sample. When a beneficial combination is indicated, the pendulum reacts.

Obviously the above description is only a broad outline. Successful work with medical radiesthesia requires long training, concentrated study, and a sound medical knowledge.

As with most things in radiesthesia, there is a dearth of acceptable theory, but a wealth of positive evidence. This must be accepted . . . and understood when more knowledge is available.

"THE SEEING EYE"

IN A NUTSHELL, conditions of the eye depend on the way one looks at things specifically, and his mental viewpoint generally. Few people have perfect mental perspective; hence they experience interference with physical vision. The expression "I see" is so generally used as equivalent to "I comprehend" that it emphasizes the fact that nearly everybody is a metaphysician, whether he classifies himself as such or not. Any unnaturalness of eyesight inevitably is associated with individual perversions of comprehension of life in its manifold ramifications.

Viewpoint, considered either from a physical or mental angle, is essential to vision or seeing things correctly. Anyone who has seen a person in delirium tremens recognizes that the "pink elephants" and "snakes," from which the victim cringes, are purely indigenous to his state of mind. In hypnotic suggestion, we see a subject caused to visualize whatever the manipulator decrees, and to act accordingly. This recalls the Biblical expression, "Having eyes, ye see not. neither do ye understand."

Simple astigmatism results from slight distortion of the perfect curvature of the eyeball, and this flattening or bulging suggests personal opinions, right or wrong, which maintain the privilege of not seeing eye to eye with the majority. Crossed eyes or squint in children represent cross purposes prenatally between parents. Conjunctivitis, when not venereal, represents a more inflamed degree of opposing viewpoints, usually between those closely associated. Corneal laceration represents a festering disagreement which blinds consciousness to enlightening truth, even as the cornea resents the infiltration of sunlight. Iritis suggests mentally inflammatory reaction to insult or injury, which causes the injured consciousness to "see red." Cataract is mental opacity to some influence attempting to "pull the wool over the eyes." Glaucoma represents stony resistance to all attempts to change the point of view, especially among women with inflexible convictions as to human behavior. This could be also due to prenatal influence wherein the expectant mother's thoughts were steeled to childbirth itself, or an addition to her family much against her will because of hard relations with her husband or others from whom she felt stony resistance, or because she married against the will of her parents.

Other phases of "eye trouble" are in differing degrees representative of the difference arising between those whose viewpoints mentally are at variance, or are the constantly changing point of view of an unstable nature. Hermits and others who live to themselves are seldom afflicted with eye trouble, except through old age or other generally accepted physical causes of failing eyesight. In general, eye difficulties represent some phase of "I-trouble" which needs correction.

TREATMENT

It is written: "The seeing eye and the hearing ear, the Lord hath made even both of them." I claim this "seeing eye" as the natural component of my body, the temple of God, and I refuse to believe that my eyes can become dim because of any false law of optics. Whatever physical impairment seems to develop is only a warning for me to analyze more closely how I am looking mentally at my various experiences, the people I contact, or my general viewpoint with regard to daily life. Correcting errors spiritually in the way I see such things will restore perfect vision to my eyes. Attaining clear metaphysical perspective will establish my perfect eyesight.

I deny the beliefs of predisposition towards eye trouble through heredity, prenatalism, or early environment, for I know God never made such laws to govern His ideas. The way He sees all things is the way I see them, since I am really God-in-the-act-of-seeing. He is "of purer eyes than to behold evil," but He requires me to discern between good and evil, even as my eyesight depends upon the distinguishing of light from dark. He "saw all that He had made, and behold! it was very good," and as a part of that which He made I can see spiritually only good in all circumstances and conditions. Evil is only the absence of light, and the ability to discern this distinction at all times entitles me to the blessing that is written: "He that bath eyes to see, let him see."

But the eldest son was unwilling! "That is a woman's work," he said. After thinking awhile, he said he would earn the money and give it to her daughter that she might make the trip. The necessity of marrying, in a legal sense as on the earth plane, does not apply to the entities in the astral world. A husband who rejoins his wife in the astral world is just as much married there as he was on the earth plane. This is because of the affinity each has for the other, and because of their great attraction that had been in evidence upon the earth plane. If a person has been married more than one time, or several times, and all happen to be in the ethereal world, which one awaits? Do they allwait for the spouse to come over? They do not. If there be no affinity, there is no guarantee that a wife will go to any of her husbands in the astral world. However, it is possible that she will be attracted to one out of the group and will, with him, set up a kingdom that could be said to be somewhat comparable to the kingdom upon the earth plane. On the other hand, it may be that they will be very good friends, be they the third or fourth husband. One sees things very differently in the astral world than when upon the earth.

But there is no promise, however, that husband and wife will come together for any appreciable period of time. The only thing that can be promised is that when you first enter the astral, you will be with your mother and father and sisters and brothers for a time. There is no promise, however, that this is going to be for any long period of time, any more than the other. that year with almost total polioparalysis. One leg and arm were 100% paralyzed and the right leg had 75% immobility. He remained in the orthopaedic ward of Wentworth Hospital and Addington Hospital, Durban, South Africa for about four months, the doctors saying that he would be in a hospital for at least three years, and that he would never walk again. By an heroic effort, he got two friends to carry him out of the hospital and take him by car to his own home; this was his own responsibility, and not on the advice of Edmund Bentley. In May, Edmund Bentley was asked to give him spiritual healing. After four treatments he was able to walk on crutches. After six months he was using only one stick. Today, Graham May is working in his mother's garage in Himeville, Natal, doing the full duties of a motor mechanic, which often means getting under cars, etc. Both his legs are back to normal, likewise the arms and hands, and there is only a very slight area where some muscles have withered around the left shoulder which prevents him from lifting that arm from a horizontal position to a vertical one above his head.

Edmund Bentley is slightly averse to the publication of his spiritual cures, and believes that there is a subtle cosmic law of effectiveness which demands the principle of "let not your left hand know what your right hand doeth."

 At the extreme southerly tip of this vast continent is Cape Town. There we find a group of healers who are fearlessly proclaiming the brotherhood of man, disregarding racial differences in the fulfillment of the divine plan. The Temple of Spiritual Fellowship has eight very fine European (White) healers and seven equally gifted non-European (Colored) healers. Leadership is in the hands of Mrs. Mona Van der Watt, and she is enthusiastically aided by her husband, Dr. Van der Watt, who is an African. Their Temple and two Sanctuaries have an unobstructed view of Table Bay, Cape Town, South Africa. Mona has other mediumistic gifts,

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and during her visit to my home in the early part of 1962, I was able literally to hear the voice which speaks within her and intercept a message of love which was intended for my wife and afterwards repeated by Mona herself.

Spiritual healing is considered to be one of the Cape Town Fellowship's important fields of moral endeavor. One of their Sanctuary healers was originally a patient. She suffered from a serious growth which was very noticeable. Her doctor wanted her to have an operation. She asked the Spiritual Fellowship for healing. It was given for a few weeks without any visible results.

"I was a bit concerned when she did not appear to improve," Mona informed me. "Then one day the growth appeared to get a little smaller. The healing continued, and the growth diminished slowly day by day until it completely disappeared." Today this patient is working as a healer to help others as she was helped.

Another patient, who was about to undergo an operation for a very badly slipped disc, was restored to complete normality. She informed 'the surgeon that she had been cured by a spiritual healer. "Well," said he "it will not last, and in a few weeks you will be as bad as ever." This African patient returned to her home and, although it has been over seven years, the ill condition has not returned. That is long enough for a reasonable test of the power of Spirit:

It is worth while to record that both the Griffins and the Van der Watts are members of the National Federation of Spiritual Healers of Great Britain; as also are over thirty other healers in Africa. To our friends who carry out their healing duties in a land which is rent with discord and human strife, we, in the comfort of our comparatively peaceful surroundings, can send out our own healing thought emissions, and it may be that the volume of our love for them will help to bring a greater understanding between men of different color.

The blessing of divine healing is not confined to geographical considerations. It is universal in its application, and its corrective power can span time.

after the subjective psychic experience. Modern existentialists would call this the "blind leap" of faith.

This blind leap, this sudden jumping over the frightening abyss into the arms of Blessedness itself, actually triggers the release of meaning drawn from what Professor Jung calls the "collective subconscious." Thus our subconscious is in touch with the Infinite Wisdom of the whole history of mankind, and is related to the Powers and Radiance of all Love.

The best examples of spontaneous cases of psychic communication through the Psychic Presence is that link formed between persons in love. One dreams of the accident of the

other, or has a significant vision, and so forth. It is a common waking experience for one to guess what the other is thinking, even to answer, in some cases, a statement that was not really formed and spoken in words.

Of course, mastery of psychic mind power also provides the channels through which our very physiology and health may be controlled by this Psychic Presence. Yoga, which uses mastery of one's body as a key to revelation, simply decentralizes one's physiology in order to submit the mind to harmony with all of nature. Masters of this art can inflict wounds upon themselves, start and stop bleeding at will, and supply their own anesthetic immunity to pain through auto-suggestions. Gandhi underwent an internal operation without an anesthetic of any kind, talking to his followers while his doctor worked. In Indonesia a whole village communicates by telepathy, without words, or mail, or anything else, and most often these telepathic communications are received when members are in sickness

or need. What a wonderful human skill, indeed.

The East, the mysterious East, has had more advanced experience in the development and training of inner thought. Possibly the innate psychic mechanisms we are all born with are able to develop there because cognitive language, as we know it, is not used in a way as to make people oblivious to the subconscious powers.

Language gives us the impression that we control reality, when in fact this is not the case. Language is a delusion, our true controlling power comes from deeper within ourselves. This deeper power is what we hope to use more carefully through the Psychic Presence.

The truth, as we shall reveal it, shows that we can control our life and destiny through the proper education and use of our total personality, including our meaningful Psychic Presence, and subconscious control personality.
