THE INSIDE STORY OF CHRISTMAS

IT'S CHRISTMAS TIME again...and the entire Christian Church the world over bears witness to the celebration of the birth of the child who, according to the story, born in Bethlehem, was called Jesus, later to be known as Jesus of Nazareth, and Jesus the Christ.

The celebration of this event has been in practice one thousand nine hundred and sixty five years...a short span of time considered in terms of eternity, but a very long time considered from the standpoint of the manner in which ignorance persists in holding its own. Christmas after Christmas so many still think of it only as some-

thing of a gay, outward celebration.

What has happened to its real meaning, and the place it should have in our lives? Ignorance is still hugged by the many, but there are a few who cry out for Truth, and in their hearts ask—"How long, oh Lord, how long?" In looking about the world they see it in the throes of calamity and despair, and Christmas seems such a sad time for countless millions of people. . . all

for want of knowing the Truth.

Even though we regard them as allegories, if we deal with the elements of the Biblical story of Christmas from an inward viewpoint, we see they are fraught with deep meaning. They are spiritually illustrative of the Christ principle operative and applicable in our lives, and with right understanding, give meaning and purpose as to why we are here on earth.

For its inner meaning, the allusion to the STABLE is that here is the place where the spiritual nature of our life and thinking puts up for rest and refreshment mid the animalistic tendencies of our nature. This is where we are to be instructed.

The INN is our mind where spiritual food or instruction is to be supplied for the birth and nourishment of soul growth.

The MANGER is the place where food is provided, or instruction, and is to be given more specifically by reason of the humble and lowly state of our mind to receive the Truth, and, when accepted, the Divine Principle becomes assimilated in our being, so we grow to and finally come to the realization of the infant child.

The INFANT CHILD corresponds to our consciousness opening to the light within us and, in innocence, or a childlike manner, accepting it, permitting the Christ Child to be born of the love

of God as Truth unfolding within us.

ARE YOU PSYCHIC?

CAN YOU UNCOVER hidden facts, find lost articles, read minds, predict the future? Perhaps you can, and are not aware of it. There are ways you can find this out and enjoy doing it.

Last month two types of testing, simple procedures you can try yourself, were described: Calling All Floors and The Restaurant Game. Such simple tests, and often psychic games, reveal potentialities that otherwise might never be suspected, and cannot yet be measured by any aptitude test.

OUT OF THIN AIR

When out driving a car by yourself, often you will find yourself in the right mood for a game of psychic solitaire. This is one pastime in which you can safely indulge while still keeping a sharp eye on the road. The best type of impression to go after is one involving your sense of hearing. Your car radio provides the perfect medium for this. Raise your ESP antenna and see what you can pick up. You might start by concentrating on some popular song, then turn on the radio to pick up the music from some local station. If you are really attuned, you will pick the station playing the tune in your mind at that time. People musically inclined who practice this often call two or three tunes in sequence correctly. The fun you will find in this game lies in picking a tune from thin air and having the radio confirm it. Each time this happens, it stands out as more than a slight achievement. You demonstrate to yourself that it can be done; it fortifies your self confidence, and you will do better.

WHAT COLOR?

Children adore games and make up many of their own. Loving candy as they do, sometimes they try to anticipate what color, shape, or number will come up next in a package. You can do it too. . . try it with lifesavers, gum, magazine covers. . . anything that lends itself such tests. Simple as they are, they serve to focus your attention on unfolding your ESP ability.

TRY YOUR PHONE

The telephone offers many opportunities to test your psychic abilities. One you might start 6 with involves someone else's cooperation...

although for some purposes it is better this not be known. Some tests won't work if the other person knows about it.

Concentrate upon a friend, or even a family member, who is likely to call you, but from whom you are not expecting an immediate call. Mentally keep asking that person to phone you within the next hour so that the thought emanates repeatedly from your mind as if you were broadcasting a message by means of brain waves. The purpose of this experiment is to see if the person you are calling picks up the message and phones you.

Results from this may prove remarkable, and sometimes fairly frequent, but you must allow for some lapses in between. Sometimes the other person is too busy with other things to receive your mental message, or perhaps may be in an automobile or some inaccessible place where no phone is available. In this case, the thought received might be dismissed as a fleeting impression and forgotten altogether. On the other hand, the person you tried to reach may phone you hours later saying there was something in his mind he wanted to tell you, but couldn't quite remember what it was, or perhaps was just calling to see how things were going.

Often "flash" impressions that keep recurring to the receiver will finally grow into a definite idea and you will be called. If you will visualize the receiver and his surroundings, it could help to get your message through better. Mentally picture making a call to the other person's home or office, even visualizing yourself right there with the person saying that you expected to hear from him. You may receive a call almost as an automatic response. This frequently happens between husbands and wives, particularly if both are consciously in the habit of communicating with each other in this fashion.

When the other person does call in reply to your mental broadcast, you might even be surprised to learn of his intention to call you on some unexpected matter you knew nothing about.

While talking on the telephone, you can also practice your color game. See if you can pick the color of some piece of wearing apparel the other person is wearing. It might not even surprise you before long, as you continue to apply

COMING EVENTS

... A peek into the unknown, a glimpse of the future, a ray of light on the mysteries of time ... this search has fascinated mankind throughout the ages. Call it by whatever name you will, a glimpse of something better ahead often has given men fresh courage and strength to overcome life's trials. Here are tidings of some of those events to come.

... SAILING AMONG THE STARS

In the past sixty years we have increased the maximum speed at which we can travel about 500 times...from about 36 miles per hour to more than 18,000. If we continue to increase our speed of travel at the same rate for another sixty years...we will probably approach the 'light barrier.' Since this is a mathematical and philosophical barrier rather than a natural one, we will probably find a way through it with little more effort than was required to penetrate the sonic barrier...once such a bogey man to early aeronautical engineers. When this has been accomplished, then earth man — surpassing his orbital flights of rising only a few miles above the surface of his planet—can dream of leaving this galaxy and, as a frue Astronaut, "sail among the stars" in the space between galaxies in what astronomy terms outer space. ... HOW SHALL MAN AWAKEN?

Earthquakes are produced by forces of the seventh strata working outward until they burst forth from the surface of the earth. The movement of faults in the solid crust is the secondary effect of the primary forces originating in the seventh strata, the earth currents being intensified to the point of breaking through the surface, that earth current energy being shot off into space from the inner parts of the earth, and accompanying the earthquake disturbance. ... THE HEART OF THE RUBY

In a condensed version of Atlantis, Fact or Fiction,* Edgar Cayce foretold that the ruby, known in those early days as the "fire stone," once again would come into its own as a vast source of power and healing. When the sun's rays are focused upon it, its radiations will provide the motivating force for all forms of transportation, as well as generate power that radiates across an entire continent requiring no wires. Concentration of the sun's rays on this stone, also described as a crystal, would rejuvenate the physical body again and again, prolonging life beyond one hundred years, and will provide the answer to disease, not in animal In use now on a research basis, known as the "lazer beam," within ten years its accelerated use is expected to revolutionize all forms of planetary and interplanetary communication and transportation.

THE POWER OF THE SUBCONSCIOUS MIND TO HEAL

PART VI

AMONG THE TECHNIQUES which have been found practical for use in mental healing are those which have intelligent application because the truth and meaning behind them is understood. Affirmations or prayers used in vain repetition avail little, but those which carry the weight of positive conviction avail much.

THE AFFIRMATIVE METHOD

When you realize the truth of your being, you accept only health, harmony, and peace for yourself and for others. As you do this, you rearrange any negative patterns that may have been in the subconscious mind. To affirm is to state that it is so, and as you maintain this attitude of mind, regardless of all evidence to the contrary, you will receive an answer to your prayer. Strange as it may seem, your thought can only affirm, for even if you deny something, you are actually affirming the presence of that which you deny. Therefore, when you repeatedly make a statement of positive affirmation – knowing what you are saying and why you are saying it - this leads the mind to the state of consciousness where it accepts that which you have been stating to be true. You can see, therefore, how in continuously reaffirming the truths of life, eventually you will achieve a subconscious reaction which satisfies and changes all conditions in your life for the better.

How this type of positive thinking. . . affirming the truth of life. . . can be applied to any condition of ill health with remarkable healing results may be seen in its application to my sister's case, one that might be helpful to others in time of need.

The usual hospital tests and X-ray procedures had established that my sister, Catherine, then living in England, should undergo an operation for the removal of gallstones. She had asked me to pray for her, and, although we were separated geographically by 6,500 miles, there is no time and space in the Mind principle, for it is present simultaneously in its entirety at every point in God's creation.

I withdrew all thought from the contemplation of symptoms and from any physical personality. I affirmed as follows:

"This prayer is for my sister Catherine. She

is relaxed and at peace, poised, balanced, serene, and calm. The healing intelligence of her subconscious mind which created her body is now transforming every cell, nerve, tissue, muscle, and bone of her being according to the perfect pattern of all organs lodged in her subconscious Silently, quietly, all distorted thought patterns in her subconscious mind are removed and dissolved, and the vitality, wholeness and beauty of the life principle are made manifest in every atom of her being. She is now open and receptive to the healing currents which are flowing through her like a river, restoring her to perfect health, harmony, and peace. All distortions and ugly images are now washed away by the infinite ocean of love and peace flowing through her, and it is so."

Several times a day I affirmed the above prayer. At the end of two weeks my sister had an examination, again including hospital tests and X-rays, the results of which showed evidence of remarkable healing.

Another method utilizing the active exercise of positive beliefs and convictions stems from a procedure of Dr. Phineas Parkhurst Quimby of Maine, pioneer mental and spiritual healer.

THE ARGUMENTATIVE METHOD

In a book called The Quimby Manuscripts, edited by Horatio Dresser, newspaper accounts are given of this man's remarkable results in prayer treatment of the sick, duplicating many of the healing miracles recorded in the Bible. According to Quimby, the treatment employed consisted of spiritual reasoning, wherein the patient and himself were convinced that his sickness was due to his false belief, groundless fears, and negative patterns lodged in his subconscious mind. A distorted, twisted pattern of thought had taken form in the body, externalized as sickness, therefore changing the thought pattern could eliminate the sickness. In this process, it is pointed out that the subconscious mind creates the body and all its organs, therefore knows how to heal it, can heal it, and is doing so now. You continue to build up evidence in the courtroom of your mind on behalf of the healing

ADVENTURE IN FRIENDSHIP

In response to a letter from an inmate at the Indiana State Prison interested in studying psychic phenomena, Betty Spickler reports in the Parastudy Review how, in acquiring her first " pal from the pen," extensive correspondence resulted with seventeen other prisoners, then subsequent study group sessions at the prison. Reflecting upon her experience, she recalled a statement of truth that was brought home to her:

"God is never divorced from our relationship God is in all humanity and to each other. therefore includes not only the perfect speciman, but the blind, the deaf, the dumb, the mentally deficient, the drunkard, the prostitute, the beggar. In all of us is this light of truth—it need only Therefore, good have its exterior removed. cannot exist in its own little circles. It has to enormously expand to include all who need compassion and help... He who has seen this light has seen the Father...and even in mortal imbalance this light is there."

GETTING THE IDEA ACROSS

Understanding is not entirely dependent upon the written or spoken word, and communication getting the thought across-often goes deeper than words. At times, the unuftered thought can be more powerful than any expressed words, and sometimes those we even dare not speak get through to others. Pearl E. Gerow, writing in the Rosicrucian Digest, tells of a woman who, ill during the depression, wrote her sister in another state asking if she could visit her. Several days later, for one split second she saw her sister; in that instant she knew what her answer would 10 be. Though later she received a letter verifying

this knowledge, no words could express as completely as that instantaneous thought transference the sorrow her sister had felt at the necessity of refusing her request. Thoughts also seem to hang in space, as it were, to be picked up at a later day or hour. Another instance is given of a woman who became seriously ill and had to be taken to the hospital immediately. She wanted to tell her dearest friend, but no one answered the phone. When her friend returned home, she was as aware of the message as though it were a waiting telegram.

Some ultrasensitive to thoughts can pick them up almost word for word from another who does not even speak his language. Inebriates are especially receptive to thought, their inhibitions being anesthesized by alcohol, they respond read-Most of us receive thoughts we know not from whom they came, or why, and wonder happened to arise in our minds. Thoughts being so potent and powerful then, we should be more careful, it would seem, of what we diffuse-though unspoken-to others, and what we ourselves accept.

SHORT WAY NOT ALWAYS THE BEST

Noting the increased attention psychedelic drugs have been receiving, rather ironic was the advertising salvo received from a group promoting psychedelic sessions across the country... their aim being "to produce a psychedelic or ecstatic experience without using drugs. In some twenty hours of experimental sessions, the methods used for inducing consciousness-expansion revolved around meditation, breathing exercises, visualization techniques, trance induction, telepathic experiments, etc. — all methods long successfully used before drugs became a recent short-cut fad. Now that they have been found to have many dangerous ramifications, and have been banned, not only for public, but medical use, now the tried-and-true so-called longer spiritual paths suddenly are the latest, more fashionable approach to attaining what is termed "an ego-shattering, ecstatic peak." Speed seems to be such an all-important factor in this age in which we live...could it be the speed of desperation, perhaps?



HEALING SAINTS

ST. DOMINIC

DURING RECENT YEARS I have witnessed the successful healing of many children. I have also personal knowledge of many such healings in all parts of the world. There is no doubt that, as a rule, children respond promptly to the power of Spirit to heal. It may be that they are less subject to the influence of doubt; it may be also they are less likely to retard their attunement.

"Twelve months ago this child could neither walk nor speak. She was completely paralyzed."

The above statement was made to me a few years ago by the father of a seven year old girl. Observing the child sitting on a chair, she did not appear to be particularly interested in her surroundings.

"Can she walk now?" I inquired. "Ask her to come to you," said the mother, keenly interested in making known the cure of her child. Doing as she suggested, the little girl promptly jumped up from her chair and crossed the room towards us. I tried to enter into a conversation with the youngster, but soon realized that she wished to do all the talking. Her mother commented that she often wondered if she would ever stop talking.

It seems that from the time of her birth the child had suffered from a form of paralysis. Her speech had been limited to a mumbling sound, although she had not been affected mentally in any way. Then, spiritual healing was administered to her by one of a group of healers that reaches large numbers of people through the Spiritualist Association of Great Britain, and thereafter she has been as normal as any child of her age. Such healings as this often go unnoticed, however, apart from those who visit the premises of the Association regularly and who accept them as a natural course of events in their lives.

St. Dominic, a saint of the 12th century, had many such healings to his credit. There are also records of successful healings of this kind long before the birth of Jesus, as well as those being recorded daily in our own time. Healings of children, particularly, are being reported to me currently from all parts of America, Canada, Brazil, Japan, and Germany.

St. Dominic, whom we mentioned briefly above, was born in 1170 at Calavoga, Castille, Spain. He came from one of the most noble DECEMBER 1965 CHIMES

families in Spain, his father being Felix of Guzman, and his mother, Jane of Asa, both descendents of Dukes and Marquises. The details of his personal and spiritual life, and as a saint, are not the object of this article, however, rather our main concern is to show that he was a great spiritual healer.

One account of St. Dominic's healing power describes how a woman of gentle birth named Gutadona, having found her child seriously ill. and then declared "dead," carried him to a place called St. Sixtus' place and, believing in St. Dominic's healing power, placed the child without comment at the feet of the saint. After just a few minutes of his prayerful intercession, the child was healed completely. A stone mason, severely crushed by the fall of some masonry from building construction, was dramatically healed when St. Dominic administered healing to him in the presence of large numbers of civil and religious dignitaries. It is interesting and worthy of note that many of St. Dominic's adult patients were unconscious at the time of receiving This gives added emphasis to the claim of spiritual healers that faith, as generally understood, is not essential to spiritual healing. We learn rather that unconscious patients, children, and animals respond promptly, and with greater receptivity, to the prayerful intercession of healers who have great love and compassion for all living things.

Actually, the healing of Gutadona's child by St. Dominic in the 12th century was no more spectacular or unusual than that of the paralytic child who was healed by one of a group of healers in our own time. Both healings were proof of the great power of Spirit forever being bestowed upon us.

Although he passed to spirit August 6, 1221, at that time being fifty-one years of age, he was canonized in 1234, but St. Dominic did not end his healing ministrations. Reliable records show that since that time intercession to him has produced some truly remarkable healings. The general character of these healings has not changed, having followed the same pattern as those performed during his physical life on earth. Indeed, he can be considered as one of those

THOSE OF US who have undergone the heartrending experience of having a loved one pass away in what seems to be great pain may be comforted by these words from Margie.

She tells us that in many instances, although the one passing seems to be suffering greatly, on the astral plane there are present at the time kind, wise beings who often help such souls by taking the pain away. If the loved one could talk, he or she would tell you there was no suffering, and that there were present at the bedside loved ones, as well as Spirit helpers, who were of much comfort and assistance.

Unfortunately, we have no real assurance on the earth plane that this is the case. Each soul's passing is also different, according to what has been merited, and arrival in the world of Spirit is in accordance with the law of sowing and reaping. of cause and effect. Sometimes this turns out to be quite a rude awakening, indeed. More often, though, it is not the case.

That the person passing is squirming, moaning involuntarily, or giving outward indications of agony, is not proof positive of his suffering. Some have returned from the Spirit world and assured those who were at their bedside that they were not really in pain at the last. Such physical manifestations often are involuntary and cannot be controlled by the one passing.

There is much interest in the subject of faith healing or magnetic healing. In answer to one, of many questions received on this subject, all in the same direction, Margie gives this reply:

O What constitutes a magnetic healer? Do I have to be advanced spiritually to bring about the restoration of good health in others in order to be a healer?

If you are extremely magnetic, you can heal. You do not have to be a highly spiritual individual to do this. I understand that the common belief is that faith or magnetic healing requires a high degree of spiritual development, but this is not true. If one person is run-down and deficient magnetically, while another has a surplus of magnetic vibrations, pain can be alleviated and the afflicted one can be restored physically through the vibrations of the stronger of the two. Magnetism itself, according to its potency, automatically can build up a person low in

magnetism. . . the process being one like charging a battery. Often this process of recharging brings about healing because magnetism destroys bacteria which could be afflicting the person low in vitality.

As far as the medical profession is concerned, I grant you that I am talking nonsense, for it does not concede the importance of magnetism in healing. However, many physicians and nurses, as well as others connected with the healing arts, do possess the quality of magnetism, and the ability to transmit it to others, without even being aware of it.

You may be around a magnetic person, yet not be greatly impressed by what he or she says, or by their appearance, yet you will sense that you feel good in that person's presence. This is because of the strong magnetism emanating from that person's body. Usually if you are noticeably helped — magnetically — it is because you are greatly in need of magnetism, that you need to be recharged, so to speak. If, however, negative magnetism is given off by someone you are around, it won't make you feel good or help you, rather you will feel drained of energy. Thoughts, being somewhat like radio waves, must have something to carry them from one person They cannot flow of themselves. to another. Magnetic waves act as the "carrier" of these thought forces between human beings. experience most people have had of thinking of someone, then having that person phone, write, or appear immediately thereafter is known as thought transference. The magnetism that flowed between the two persons carried the thought with it. This is the way in which communication takes place in the astral world. The question may arise here as to why some are not as receptive to transmitted thoughts. Without being consciously aware of it, everyone receives thoughts transmitted from others. However, when a specific thought has been transmitted to someone in particular who failed to receive it, that person is immune to receiving it. could be for the reason that too much in his own make-up is working against being receptive, or that in his immediate environment a "cross current" is nullifying or detracting from

THE PAINTING THAT BAFFLES SCIENCE

GEORGE BUTLER COMMENTS

ONE OF THE STRANGEST paintings in the world baffled the artist who painted it... and has mystified thousands who have viewed it. Seen in the *light*, it is a painting of Jesus standing on a rock beside some water. His right hand is held over His heart, His left hand at His side.

In the near-darkness, however, the painting changes completely. The background glows with a strange light and the figure of Christ becomes a black shadow. Over his head is a visible halo, and over His shoulder is the shadow of a cross. Yet the artist, Henri Ault, did not paint the cross or the halo...a phenomenon that has baffled artists, clergymen, and scientists for many years.

A French-Canadian, Heni Ault painted this picture of Jesus in 1896. It remained in his studio for several weeks after it had been completed. Then one night, while getting a book he needed from his studio, his glance was attracted to the painting. What he saw there in the darkness sent him racing down the road to the nearest neighbors. him racing down the road to the nearest neighbors. They scarcely believed his story, but hurried back to the studio with him to see for themselves. There, in the unlighted room, all could see the strange sight quite clearly. . . the dark figure, the cross, the halo, and the glowing light. . . something Ault swore he had not painted.

In 1904 the painting was exhibited at the World's Fair held at St. Louis, Missouri. Later it was shown at the Dore Galleries in London, England, then was taken on a tour of the European continent. In 1948 it was presented to the Mission of St. Francis of Assisi in Ranchos de Taos, one of the earliest Spanish missions in the nation, by Mrs. Herbert S. Griffin of Wichita Falls, Texas, who had acquired it in the belief that, because of being in the nature of a religious

work, it properly belonged in a church.

From the narrow wooden benches of this old church, in a setting of Spanish statues and magnificent beams, one views this famous painting as it hangs in an alcove to the left of the main altar. A parish priest, appearing in the pulpit of the brightly lighted church, extends a welcome to all visitors, speaks briefly about the history of the painting, and emphasizes the fact that there never has been an explanation for the strange transformation which takes place in the picture in the darkness. Soon the lights are turned off, and

the church is plunged into almost complete darkness, with only small flickers of red lights from the votive candles...then, in the silence and the darkness, one can see the painting begin to glow. Suddenly, but unmistakably, its striking background becomes clearly visible. The figure of Christ becomes a black shadow with a luminous circle sharply outlined above His head, and the dark shadow of the cross looms heavy over His shoulder. An involuntary gasp escapes from the viewers, then a feeling of tremendous awe fills the tiny church. Sitting there in the dark, all eyes become riveted on that patient figure bearing the cross, which, before — in the light — was not present. Without the contrast of darkness and light produced by the phenomenon of this painting, it might not otherwise make such a deep impact upon the consciousness. It is in this contrast one can perceive the truth that man carries his greatest burdens, bears his heaviest cross, when he is in darkness... yet in the light, dissolve as though they had never been. contrasts of life, as in the painting, are filled with drama and pathos, yet in the light we see the beauty of the artist's original creation.

For many years Henri Ault tried to duplicate this painting, but was never able to achieve quite the same effect. When it was thought that some type of phosphorous might have been present in the paint, various chemical tests were run. . . even tests with a Geiger counter. . . but

all proved to be negative.

After nearly seventy years, science still is unable to explain how such a phenomenon takes place. TYPES OF TELEPATHY

OUR INTEREST in what telepathy is, how it works, its forms, and who can use it is being encouraged these days by the attention being devoted to it by researches in various branches of the physical, social, as well as mental sciences. It is something within the realm of experience and understanding of everyone, yet not much has been "tied down" on the how, when, and why of its functions. Urgent demands of our life and times, however, are pushing us into doing something about this.

We have learned a few things...that telepathic messages take many forms. They may be visual, taking the form of pictures, figures, written or printed words or symbols. They may be auditory, most likely via spoken words. They may be emotional, with the feeling of a peculiar depression or excitement. They may also be volitional, arousing an imperative desire to perform a certain action. There are probably many

more forms than are now recognized.

Origination of telepathic messages may be from those living or in the realm of Spirit. As they are known to be transmitted to and from the subconscious mind (sometimes under the supervision and direction of the conscious mind), their most effectual time is during sleep, trance or hypnosis, under the influence of a drug, anesthesia, or alcohol, in delirium, while unconscious, or at the moment of death. It is while the conscious mind is asleep, or in abeyance and unable to interfere, that the message is able to reach the subconscious mind. This is also when "visions of the dying," states of ecstasy, trance-speaking, and revelations occur.

Those in Spirit tell us that telepathic communication is the method they use between one another, enabling them to understand fully another's thoughts as though full sentences of words had been spoken. If at times we who are spirit in the flesh can converse with one another by this means, and those who are disembodied can do so also, it only stands to reason that the embodied and disembodied spirit should be able to communicate in this way. All trance mediums, of course, attest this to be a fact.



PSYCHIC EXPERIENCES

EGGS THAT TALKED BACK

SINCE 1948 I have raised a great number of different types of canaries, as well as Chihuahua dogs, and have boiled hundreds of eggs to feed

to the birds and dogs for extra protein.

Last August my husband, Charley, and I drove over to Grant, Nebraska to see his family visiting from the West Coast. Wishing to take some cooked eggs along with us, I took eighteen eggs that had been laid during the past three to four days, put them in a kettle, drew hot water over them, and placed them on the stove to cook. As I started to leave the stove, a pecping noise started. I turned to look behind me, but saw only the cocker dog sleeping that was boarding with us for a week. I turned back to the stove, and the peeping sound grew louder and louder. I checked the kettle. It was hot, but made no sound whatever. The peeping sound grew still louder, definitely that of a disturbed, uncomfortable baby chick and was now coming from the kettle. A baby chick in distress in the kettle? Impossible! The eggs were not even fertile, and, besides, were only about two to four days old. I grabbed up the kettle, took it to the sink,

scooped out several eggs, and listened. peeps still came from the kettle, so I took out more eggs and listened to them. While I held these last eggs in my hand and listened to them, the peeping stopped. I put them back into the hot water, and the sound started again. Alarmed, I had no desire to boil a helpless chick. I was actually afraid to cook the eggs for fear of killing a live chick. I argued with myself for a moment...these are infertile eggs—therecannot be chickens in them — and even so, it takes twentyone days to hatch out chickens, and no mother hen ever sat on these. So I put the kettle back on the red hot burner. Again the noise started . . . the peep, peep, peep sounding as much in distress as ever. The water got hotter and hotter, then suddenly the peeping stopped, leaving me feeling downright guilty that I had boiled that dozen and a half eggs.

I was much puzzled by this strange experience of having non-fertile fresh eggs talk back to me. However, knowing that there are no baby chicks anywhere in our neighborhood, I realized afterwards that it was a psychic manifestation of some sort. If any Chimes readers could explain it or have had a similar experience, it might be helpful

to know about it.



® RHINE LOOKS AT ESP TODAY

Summarizing his outlook on the status and prospect of parapsychology today, Dr. J. B. Rhine, formerly of Duke University, now head of the new Foundation for Research on the Nature of Man, states in the Foundation's first published proceedings, Parapsychology: From Duke to FRNM, that "the most impressive fact about parapsychology today is the really enormous amount of public interest in the field" and the remarkable growth of this interest year after year over several decades. Less gratifying, however, is the slow pace at which research is moving, its lag behind other sciences in acceptance, the few full-time trained research workers, and the large turnover of trained personnel. He seemed encouraged, though, that research findings increasingly "make sense," even those factors still a mystery comprising the unknown of human personality, and that psi phenomena can be investigated by the same basic approach used throughout the whole of natural science. Dr. Rhine sees the greatest difficulty parapsychology offers to test a researcher's capability is in the demand it makes upon his entire scientific orientation...that no field of inquiry ever was dominated by such a great variety of inquirers with such assorted assumptions, backgrounds, philosophies, and special interests...with few of them able to give up their limited approaches for the good of an objective research program, becoming a humble searcher for whatever the truth of nature is.

Ending on an optimistic note, Dr. Rhine sees present parapsychologists as less sensitive to critical attack, more confident, and willing to stand on their own feet. . . to "let the chips fall where they may"...although there will still be those who must continue to speak with restraint, whether to meet the requirements of a party line or of an academic line. Dr. Rhinefeels it is high time we push research into the hidden part of man's nature with all the best methods scholarship can offer, for a more important inquiry to submit to science, no one has thought of yet.



SPIRITUAL GUIDES AND THEIR MISSION - PART VI

THE MODUS OPERANDI used mainly by those who have become adept at the skill of leaving the body at will is called Direct Projection. It is an ability to be in any world, at any place, at any time, and to be, know and see what we wish at a moment's notice. This is a highly developed skill, but not as impossible as so many believe.

In Direct Projection one can hop out of the body and fulfill whatever desire is necessary at the moment. The body is usually left behind to run on a mechanical basis, but if the danger is too great will remove itself by some yet unexplainable means.

To do Direct Projection one needs strict discipline, for it means making instant withdrawal from the perimeter of consciousnes and blanking out everything of the physical world. To do this at once is done by postulate. The postulate is made up mainly of three words: BE — DESTINATION—NOW. By its use the Soul, or Self, suddenly is out gathering needed knowledge, then returns when the task is finished.

This is actually an advancement on the trance state, often while the physical body is in action. It is an instant, but brief, trance, one not harmful to the person using it, nor to anyone concerned. If the physical body is active, the period of being out of the body may be brief. However, this depends on the mission the Soul is to accomplish.

Brown Landone in his writings tells of a time when, during the rush hour in the Chicago Loop, he was caught between two trucks going in opposite directions. Thinking he was to becrushed, he closed his eyes, used a similar postulate, then upon opening his eyes again, found himself on the opposite side of the street moving with the evening crowd along the sidewalk.

The technique is simple: the postulate is made, the image is flicked to the Soul of what is desired, and the rest is left to that inner sense to make the necessary motion. In the twinkling of an eye, the attention is switched from the outer senses to the inner, for where thought is sent in strong force, the inner body will follow.

The question often arises as to the difference between bi-location and intuition. The intuitive sense is a knowing obtained without recourse or reasoning whereby the psychic faculty opens and innate knowledge is received without effort. This faculty works in all of us, but it is lost when we are troubled and cannot fully trust such knowledge, or possibly the physical senses refuse to obey the impulses sent through this channel.

Direct Projection, however, enables one to get outside the body, get a sharp, clear picture of the situation at hand, then act accordingly. Often it is only a clear picture, but it meets the need for the moment. This may last only for four-fifths of a second, or for as long as one desires.


The spiritual guides are interested in the welfare of every Soul. It is their duty to see that each one of us eventually reaches the highest world where dwells the Supreme Being. The reason for our returning to the ultimate spiritual plane is that God has a need for us. Ultimately we are all to become one of those spiritual travelers whose duties it is to lift the less fortunate, and in turn teach them how to reach the God world.

There are ways in which true spiritual travelers or guides may be distinguished from those who merely pose as such. First, and among the most noticeable, is that those in physical form never make a personal charge for their services. Second, they never boast of their abilities and attainments. Third, they never complain of their treatment at the hands of others, nor find fault, or blame others. They exalt the positive virtues and never lecture others about their shortcomings, nor do they punish anyone—though they may have the power to do so. Fourth, they are never given to ascetic practices, always give instead of receive, and never perform miracles for public exhibition. Finally, the genuine spiritual traveler will practice as well as teach the Word . . . the sound of God .

HOW WE GAIN WITH EVERY SACRIFICE

IT IS IN the nature of mortal man that he finds objects of admiration and devotion... those he regards highly, shows affection for, idolizes or loves deeply. A time may come, however, when he will have to break his ties with those for whom he shows special regard, and go on in life without them.

It is in the destiny of things that union with these especially loved people is not always a permanent one, and man many times has to face renunciation and sacrifice in the form of yielding to inevitable changes in relationships, accepting the inescapable growth of others, and

releasing them to their new experiences.

Sacrifices involving the renunciation of loved ones seem to be among the most painful of man's experiences for those who touch his heart are not quickly renounced by him. That he will meet again in future lives those whom he has lost does not always comfort him, if he still lives with the belief that he has only one life in which to give and receive this love. The soul, on the other hand, can relinquish those loved with less feeling of sacrifice, for it understands the ties which bind man to others in every life.

Such a time of sacrificial experience may mark the peak soul experience. In some men the soul force takes over and exerts a tremendous power over the human self, and is able to throw its weight in the direction of its ideal.

It is at this time of sacrificial crisis that the soul can aid its tortured human self. The qualities of character are then man's only strength upon which he can rely...and these qualities force the personality to yield to a higher law. The relinquishment of possessions, the conquering of the compulsion to possess another's love, the surrendering of selfishness—all are accomplished only with the assistance of the soul.

If man is unable to make a wise choice, renounce a desire, sacrifice his human ego... and his soul is unable to force him to do so... he loses an opportunity for his soul to achieve another victory for itself. The crest of the experiences passes, and nothing of exceptional value has been accomplished in that cycle of living.

Under the drama of such renunciatory sacrifice, the breakdown of man's selfishness gradually is accomplished...he begins to change his nature...and is subtly lifted to a higher level within himself, for only in his soul nature will he find the understanding and comfort the de-

mands growth have made on him.

Among the most advanced souls are those who stake their lives on their ideals and principles and suffer martyrdom for their ingrained beliefs. THE BODY TELLS THE STORY THE METAPHYSICS OF ANATOMY PART III

By Dr. Cushing Smith, Detroit, Michigan

Resuming discussion of what the various parts of the body signify metaphysically, we see how our physical senses relate to corresponding mental attributes.

THE FACULTIES of sight, hearing, feeling, tasting and smelling are recognized as more mental in nature than the organs of the viscera. Everyone remembers times when he has walked down the street with his mind so centered on a particular idea that he has been completely unaware of his surroundings, passing friends without noticing them. Perhaps he has concentrated on something he has been doing to the point where he has not even heard someone calling his name. Under similar preoccupation he might not be able to tell another what he was eating, what a pungent odor smelled like, or whether someone jostled him in passing. For that reason, few aspects of the body lend themselves more readily than the senses to metaphysical analysis.

Eves perform the primary function of capturing light and darkness in varying degrees. You cannot see black furniture in a darkened room, nor discover a polar bear on a snowscape. Metaphysically interpreted, sight represents the capacity for discernment. A person who is able to see all angles of a proposition quickly, without the need for deep study, should rejoice in excellent eyesight. True spiritual insight is the most dependable guarantee of normal eyesight. other words, the way one looks at life mentally and philosophically determines in large measure the way he will look out from his eyes.

Ears represent the recognition of external phenomena on a subjective basis, as contrasted with eyes on a more objective basis. By this is meant that, while in both cases there is interpretation of that which comes via theether waves, the matter of distance makes it appear that we project thought in seeing, and have to wait for something to strike the eardrum in hearing. Since it is written: "Having eyes, ye see not; and having ears, ye hear not, neither do ye understand," the key to ears is represented by understanding. The familiar expression, "falling on deaf ears," is purely metaphysical since it 22 refers to mental receptivity rather than hearing.

Animals have keen hearing not subject to deterioration to the same degree as in mortals, largely because animals do not become confused by a flow of words which they are unable to comprehend; they merely ignore the situation, whereas man, in trying to understand, may find his mental ears to be "dull of hearing," devoid of proper comprehension.

Smelling is considered a lesser sense only because its diminution is less hazardous to man than weakening of sight and hearing. It is the sense of smell that indicates intuition, rather than a physical sense of keenness, like that of a hound's ability to follow a scent. When intuition is blunted, the sense of smell easily becomes impaired. On the other hand, one who is able to "smell a rat" in a situation may thereby develop his physical sense of smell, even when his skepticism later may prove to have been unfounded.

Taste is a matter of discrimination . . . different from discernment in that it is more likely to relate to finite phenomena than to "the things of the spirit." As physical taste requires contact, so discrimination relates to tangible rather than intangible things. The development of this sense by wine-tasters and others is amazing evidence of its mental significance, enabling an expert to tell almost the identical vineyard which produced the grapes made into the wine samples. "woman of good taste" may likewise develop the physical sense of taste, often without being aware of the connection. A discriminating buyer seldom is visited with deliciency either in tasting or smelling, usually enjoying his food more than others, but a person who habitually is gullible may lose both these senses.
