

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

• I am attaching a letter to you, friends, that I sent to a client of mine who sent you an atricle HE THOUGHT would get published immediately. He was in an uproar because he had not heard from you, and it is now three months since material was sent to you.

I took it upon myself to answer him, along with his other questions, if you don't mind, I didn't know if your thinking would be along these lines or not, but I just had to explain something to this fellow. He is under the impression that he is a messenger of the Gods, and I had to set him straight. I suggested further that he take a writing course if he feels this is his goal. He made some very derogatory state-ments (some justifiable) about Spiritualists and publishers of this type of publication. So I thought I would put the shoe where it belongs . . on his own feet. I sure hope you don't mind. I have to do this ever so often with some clients and, much to my surprise, they thank me for it. This is most interesting work--assisting people-and I am very grateful and deeply humble for the opportunities for being of service. Here, in part, was my reply. My very best to you folks.

(It is probably best not to receal the name of the above writer, one of Chimes' loyal adjestivers, or the person to whom the wrote, at the feel it would be violating a confidential relationship between counselor and client to do so. But such an unsolicited rush to our defense certainly was deeply touching, and made us realize how many Angels watch over us on this plane, as well as on countless others. She was right in what she said substantially, and said it so much more to the point, yet with firmness and kindness, that we couldn't -bave sought and found a better champion. We hope that any others to whom her answer applies will give it some thought and grant us their understanding.)

"Dear Friend: Before I go into your chart and check your questions, there is a matter I would like to clarify for you with regard to your letter and the article you sent to Chimes. Three months is not long to learn whether your material is acceptable for publishing or not. It is to be remembered that publishers receive close to 1000 articles, if not more, per month from would-be writers. These must be read and as-similated to see if the majority of the readers would find the article interesting, YOU may think it is excellent, others may not, and this is something only the publishers can determine from past experience. Then there is the question of "spacing." This is a matter that has to be discussed with their printers, because advertising is necessary to keep a publication going. The subscription fees frequently do not cover the cost of postage, etc. Advertisers must be considered first, and placement of their ads, then other material aligned to this.

In your letter to me you stated that you felt this would have reader interest as it was given to you by "spirit guidance" and should be of in-terest to all Spiritualists. From your previous letter, and your current one in which you dcscribe your disappointment in Camp, ------- It is possible that your article may have contained such information, and this, of course. could not be published as it is derogatory to Spiritualists, the bulk of the advertisers. If your material contained such information, then, of

course, you cannot expect it to be accepted. You don't offend advertisers.

Physically it is impossible to answer all mail received. Chimes' entire time could be consumed with this. Most publishers clearly state in their publication that no manuscript can be returned (which Chimes does) or commented on. They do not run a "writing school" and the material has to be correct, timely, and interesting. There are millions of would-be writers, and if pub-lishers answered them all, they would get nothing else done. You should always keep a carbon copy of your material no matter where you send it.

So, give this some thought and perhaps you will understand why you have not heard from Chimes. They are limited in their endeavors too. * * *

WPPOSE THAT twenty-five years ago, before the beginning of World War II, someone had described the amazing atomic age in which we are now living. Suppose you were told then that Mussolini and Hitler would die shameful deaths at the hands of their captors; that the United States had much to fear from the insidiousness of foreign countries, especially the Japanese; that millions of Jews would lose their lives; that the German people, in spite of their very great advancement in science and industry, would suffer very adverse conditions, not to be released from these conditions until 1965; that after World War II there would be additional threats of war in outlying territories and uprises here and there? Amazing, perhaps. But suppose all these prophecies and more had been made a matter of record and were subject to being verified by anyone who wished. Would not this continuous chronicle of verified prophecy constitute as amazing a record as history has ever produced?

Yet the above is by no means the whole record, and is in all respects in accordance with established fact. These things had all been foreseen by a spirit entity, Agasha, speaking through trance intermediary Rev. Richard Zenor of Los Angeles. Rev. Zenor is not known to the public for the amazing things heis capable of producing, simply because he never sought publicity, even in the days of his public appearance tours. He does not do so now in that he devotes his entire time to the work of the spirit entities which compose the band led and directed by the master teacher and prophet, Agasha, the entity amassing such an astounding record of successfully foreseeing the future.

Agasha's many prophecies have, indeed, been almost incredible. Some of them, taken at random, from the past records are the death of Albert Einstein, the illness of President Eisenhower, the death of Pope John, and a threat to the life or person of Queen Elizabeth, the latter either having been averted or yet to happen.

The Anchorage, Alaska earthquake also was foreseen and its occurrence predicted, as was the exploration of the moon by a photograph-taking satellite. In connection with the latter, it has been forecast that science is to learn soon of some limitations that exist as to space travel, limitations that have not yet been made known.

An interesting curiosity that Agasha predicted was a chemical to fall from outer space. He first spoke of it in August, 1955. He said that it would fall from the sky, that it would be wispy, and that it would defy analysis as to its origin. In 1963 and 1964, falls of this substance were reported in several areas causing the congenitally rabblerousing Castro to blame the United States and to say that it was some sort of germ warfare.

In the realm of curiosities also, the reappearance of the so-called "abominable snowman" in the Himalayas was forecast accurately, a forecast well borne out by stories in LIFE and other magazines.

Several forecasts by Agasha are interesting in that they are current trends and have partly come to pass, but at this time are still in the process of complete materialization. Such a forecast is the series of outbreaks fostered by an "undercurrent" of hatred in the United States which has come perilously close to costing us our freedom and has been more ominous than we realize.

On the happy side of the ledger, Agasha forecast years ago, before such a thing was thought possible, that tremendous speeds would be reached in passenger flight, and that this would result in travel becoming cheaper, with many people traveling to and from the United States all over the world. He forecast, too, the unemployment resulting, from automation, but says that in the long run it will not be a problem for there will be measures and systems brought forth that will result in more individual well-being. This is not to be a dole, but a system whereby one can earn a living.

President Kennedy's assassination was clearly foreseen and described months prior to its actual happening. In fact it was lightly touched upon in the published prophecies for both 1963 and 1964. Agasha also described the attempted assassination of others high in political office, but said that it was hoped that these could be avoided. He has often spoken of a sudden change in the Russian leadership which could take place and would strip Kruschev of his power, and of a change in the ruling party in England. He has, to be as brief as possible, spoken of the Viet-Nam trouble, of progressive changes in the Catholic Church, and of the crisis between Red China and Russia.

Predicting the future, Agasha tells us, has been a hobby he has pursued over the years, but a hobby with a purpose. By this means he hopes to prepare his students to meet inevitable changes ahead with equilibrium and to make them more receptive to his teachings. Since his greatest prophecies over the years are in regard to the coming of

I N ONE WAY or another a man should, when considering his eventual passing away, do something in order to secure for himself the best possible conditions in the land of the unavoidable beyond. There is no doubt that the best preparation for death is none other than a well and wisely spent life here on earth, but the problem of how to do this is not at all easy to solve practically. How many of us are able to become saints?

Nevertheless, there is a technique of preparation that is so useful for the not-too-well-prepared person that it is worthy of attentive consideration. In the *Tarot* philosophy we find a strange statement: "You must die every day if you want to live." Its meaning is that one has to be prepared to leave the physical life *at any moment*. Christ mentioned much the same idea when He advised us to be ready and watchful for we know neither the day nor the hour when our time will come.

Effort is necessary to achieve this readiness, of course. . . for we cannot get something for nothing, even in regions much higher than this earthly plane. But, after having read the technique presented here, everyone should be in a position to choose and to create his last thought for himself. . for which he will be richly repaid when the time comes. As you work with it, gradually it will pass into a habit and become impressed on the subconscious part of your mind. It would be especially useful for you to use this exercise as your last thought before falling asleep every night.

1. In the beginning, during each day (the best times being morning and evening) one must quietly *imagine one-self leaving the present physical body* . . that is, dying. A good, mentally visualized symbolic conception would be that of a bird leaving its nest, and flying into free space.

2. Become acquainted with the idea of abandoning your body, seeing it from above, creating the feeling of *nonattachment to it*. Such simple but effective exercises gradually will become deeply rooted in your subconscious.

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Have you ever given any thought to what it should be? Did you know there are specific techniques that will prepare you for it? . . .




3. When operating with mental theories of separation from the body and survival after its death, omissions are possible and very probable, especially when death comes suddenly and unexpectedly. . an accident on the street or elsewhere, drowning, a heart attack, or some other catastrophe. . thus the need for thorough advance preparation.

4. When the effort made to do this reaches the realm of man's unmanifested consciousness, this *subconscious element at death will take over* the duties of its conscious brother, which is then in difficulties or is oblivious under the impact of death's shock. It is therefore essential to have a clear and firm grasp of this fact if you want to take full advantage of your *last thought* when the fateful moment comes for you.

5. How can you obtain the desired cresult? Only by adequate exercises. Every day when you have an opportunity of being alone, or in a quiet and undisturbed position for a few minutes, as realistically as possible imagine yourself dying in an accident, for



example, or being taken from this plane in some sudden manner. Then try to remember your *last thought*, just as you had decided to do in such a case. Do not think about anything c else.

6. What kind of thought should be chosen? It should be something that uplifts you, gives you inner peace and hope, and quietens the disorderly thinking of your mind. This is something that should be chosen by each person after careful deliberation about the whole matter.

7. Some suggestions can be offered that would be helpful, such as:

a) A very short prayer or uplifting sentence may be more suitable for those who have difficulty creating vivid mental images. For this type of *last thought*, one's choice of the heart should be considered.

b) The image of an Ideal Being whom you revere and adore would be a good choice. This should never be a member of your family, a friend, acquaintance, or other average human being either on this plane or the one beyond. In either case, it could bring a shock to the person, or bring on feelings of depression or fear. Rather, if you are a believer in Christ, Buddha, or any of the great saints of whom you know, or if you have had the rare priv-

SELF-IMPROVEMENT IN PSYCHIC PRESENCE

DAILY PLAN of Psychic Presence exercises has been recommended for students seeking self-unfoldment. Measures to take or observe at the waking or breakfast period and during the working part of one's day so far have been suggested. Proper diet and exercise, however, are also imperative in good psychic conditioning, thus it would be well to consider this in such a program.

3. Exercise

Regular routine exercise in keeping with one's age and condition of health is essential. Such exercise should be strenuous enough to absorb our mental activities. It is the only way we have of moving our concentration from Psychic Presence long enough for a natural equilibrium to take place. This equilibrium between Psychic Presence and work-a-day conscious activity gives our insight an opportunity to catch up, to integrate new experience. new gifts. This is also why we cannot remove ourselves completely from the world, and why exercise brings us back to conscious reality. It also makes us realize that our gifts are to be used for the benefit of the world, not for selfish ends, that they are given to mankind for elevation, and we are but the instruments of the higher powers that all may see God and know Him.

4. Prayer Life

Our whole life is a prayer. . a thanksgiving to God for His blessings. As we realize this, as we walk with God more consciously, we become aware that we are always in prayer with Him. Thus we find that prayer is natural to us.

5. Your Meditation Period

This is the apex of the day, and probably should occur just before sleep. It is best to pick a restful, quiet locale, and a specific time each day. Your dream pad from the morning, and the projection diary, provide the basic material for the contemplation period, at least as a starter. Develop a series of questions to which you hope

to have the answers by the time you awake the next morning. Include any distorted signals you may have received from people during the working day, then try to sum up by setting a resolution for yourself.

Gradually, you may be able to try automatic writing, or receiving telepathic thoughts from others in need, projecting to them new energy, love, power and greatness, psychic gifts, and personal truth.

Advanced students, of course, enter trance after contemplation. But this is not recommended for the novice.

There may be some days when you are "dry," that is, when meditation seems very difficult. At other times, it will be easy. That is to be expected. So do not be surprised if you have to experiment a little with your projections at first. The idea is to develop the habit of contemplation so you can use it as a preparation for advanced power. Remember to conclude every contemplation with a harsh spiritual stocktaking and to set a self-improvement resolution for the next day. Make sure not to be too sweeping with your resolutions; they should be easily performed, and for the next day only.

Let me leave you with one final and conclusive thought. Do not at any time "fight" with yourself or your abilities. A pleasant, bouyant frame of mind can free your energy. This is not a suffering thing. Let yourself go, for

A passive state is the necessary ingredient on your part. Don't try to mix a helter-skelter, rusharound existence with psychic development. It simply won't work. To do so is to ruin your health. Knowledge happens, in a sense, to you. Enjoy yourself, let worry depart, especially during contemplation. Relax all over. Your state of mind will improve right away. Your powers will take a little time.

Words are symbols, and in meditation the object is to use less and less from the meaningful set of verbal abstractions and substitute more pure tender flowing thought without immediate verbalization. It is, in a sense, what happens between meditations and the inventiveness of new, bold creative experimentation that causes a progression to higher level abstractions and greater unfoldment. Many who are gifted with mediumship, and communicate regularly with other planes. experience almost daily, hourly, the kind of sensitive perception we have described in this chapter. It is second nature to them. They specialize in spirit communication, but they are not exempt from other understandings. They have simply developed along very distinct lines, just as eastern mystics do, or Christian medieval monks did. Sooner or later the psychic experience of each person formulates, takes specific shape, and the follower of a certain set of spiritual disciplines becomes easily recognizable. Who cannot notice the characteristics of Christian Scientists, Rosicrucians, or members of the "I AM" movement? They all deal with the immortal, inner mind, and its various powers, but they each take a road of their own, and a character, flavor, distinctive to each group, is finally evident.

In a later chapter we will discuss the special mark, or aura, which seems to emerge among those studying Psychic Presence. They have a distinct personality of their own, and it is brought about by a very special art of meditation. That art we will discuss next.

WHATEVER YOU THINK it is, first of all, it isn't. Whatever you think it may be like, when it comes, it won't be that.

It is the most natural thing in the world, so much so that afterwards all the endeavors and aspirations of man and all of his greatest attainments and dreams seem, in this new perspective, more than laughable. Even the momentous struggle we make of realizing the Self, becoming absorbed in God, seems silly, since now you know in every pore that you have never been less than or separate from that which you were seeking through these many eons. Before you might have grasped it at times, but put a little pressure on the mind and that which we thought we had has eluded us when most needed.

That is because Realization or Illumination, or whatever you wish to call it, is not something you have or get. It is something you *become*. Afterwards, when the pressures of mind become heavy, you become it more, not less.

It comes to each according to his nature, for it is nothing in itself. It is the reaction of mind, or man to having become totally absorbed in that which is the essence of all Life. If you ignite a coal, it will glow. If you ignite phosphorous, it will flash. If you ignite an explosive, the energy will not contain itself. When he at last attains, his conscious mind will not at first register the attainment; he will only sense the inward change with time.

Perhaps it is a little like two men watching a tennis match. One sits in the stadium all day watching the ball pass back and forth over the net. The second man rushes into the stadium late in the day just in time to see the server "ace" his opponent. "He made the point" immediately registers on the second man's brain, but not to the first man, who has seen so much like action during the day that he does not at first distinguish between the winning shot and the other which led up to it.

Some mystics attain illumination quietly, the culmination of a life of prayer, meditation, or service. Others, following an act of extreme will or some extraordinary circumstances, are jolted, moved a long distance from the materialistic consciousness to their ecstasy. Some propel themselves too quickly from darkness into light, balking at the necessary preparations of character. They are "lost in the abyss." as described in "Light on the Path."

The most natural path is to follow a Guru or Master Teacher. It is not easy to offer up the ego to slaughter, particularly when it has held itself in supremacy for so long. But there is nothing, really, of value to be lost in the struggle, and there is Eternity to gain.

"Darkness is blanketing the earth in these latter days. Destruction will be



NO LONGER ON THE DEFENSIVE

At the Parapsychological Association annual convention held at Oxford, England in September, the Parapsychology Foundation Newsletter quotes banquet speaker, Prof. John Beloff of Edinburgh University as saying that the researchers in this field are too much concerned about placating scientific opinion, which can lead to premature defeatism. Dr. Beloff gave an illustration of this from the history of "eveless vision." He concluded by expressing the hope that the time may not be far off when we shall have gained such a degree of control of the phenomena we study that we shall no longer be on the defensive with regard to the rest of the scientific community. Mr. William G. Roll of the Psychical Research Foundation in his presidential address on "The Psy Field" stated that the facts of ESP strongly indicate the existence of a new field which is analogous to the electromagnetic and gravitational ones of physics and interacts with them to produce ESP and related phenomena. Thus it may indeed be that we are closer than we realize to "being in control."

O AMERICAN MYSTIC PASSES

Joel Sol Goldsmith, renowned not . only as an author of innumerable books, international lecturer, spiritual healer, and spiritual leader for thousands of people the world over, passed to the life beyond in June, 1964, according to the report carried in The Voice Universal of England. Hislatest work, just published, "Man Was Not Born to Cry," is a brilliant exposition of the truth that individual man has an inherent capacity to transcent apparent limitation, and that he was not born to cry over his status in this world. His work will be carried on under the supervision of his wife, Emma, thus though his journey into eternity has commenced, the harvest of his work has still to be reaped from what has been accomplished thus far, as well as from posthumous books that are. said to be in preparation.



ESP CONVERT SPEAKS HIS MIND

Dr. F. Regis Riesenman, psychiatrist of Arlington, Virginia told members of the Virginia Polygraph Association in a lecture recently that the public is not yet ready for ESP, that there was a mass of evidence showing that it did occur, though not how, but that within fifteen years it will be established scientifically by the great scientists, physicists and mathematicians. He further stated, according to the report of his appearance by The Virginian-Pilot, that "everyone who went out to prove ESP wrong was converted." He stated that there are ninety known parapyschological phenomena, that not everyone has the same amount of ESP, although everyone has at least three to seven per cent ESP potential (dogs, cats, and horses have even more). He stated that the Old Testament was written by psychic experience, and that in the New Testament there is clear evidence of parapsychology being accounted for. "The fact is, "he announced, "the after-life is ESP in its fullest."

The Searchlight, A.R.E. monthly, in a discussion of how to work with attitudes and emotions for the elimination of accident, disease and unhappiness tells of how long before World War II, Carl Jung, famed Swiss psychologist, said that Germany would soon be at war because it was in the minds of thousands of his patients. This is a striking example of the power of attitudes. We cannot blame wars, sun spots, even the weather, communications, diseases, and accidents on someone else...not even Kruschev, or the guy next door. -WE are the cause and the result of our own attitudes. Pays to watch them.

O A JOLTING PROD

Basil Wilby, Editor of New Dimensions, English magazine, really "laid it on the line" to Occultists, Spiritualists, etc. in a recent editorial. He asks: "Are we occult-minded people all we crack outselves up to be?". . . then answers with the statement that "talk of occultists being in the vanguard of humanity is just an over-worked sick joke"... that "those who qualify as occultists are as scarce as diamonds on the shore. . not to be confused with the vast number who usurp the term on the strength of giving lip service. . having learned a few psychic parlor tricks." He noted that "the usual life history of any occult group starts with one person's vision, determination, courage and capacity to inspire others. There then follows a fruitful phase of growth, which continues into another generation, though more usually does not. Then the group either sinks into obscurity or else crystallizes into an organization which is often more of a publishing company of specialized interests than a center of inspiration with expanding viewpoints. It may still do a valuable job, but it is orientated to past glories rather than to future goals, the creative builders having been replaced by the routine administrators and commentators He sees a field ripe for harvest, but too many who will do nothing to spread the word. All too often their good intentions dissipate into nothing, hefeels, because of hidden cowardice, usually called "lack of time," "lack of money," "lack of opportunity." "Make time! make money! Make opportunity!" he urges, for "otherwise such are as puppets. . a curse, a drag, a disgrace to occultism. . a living example of life denying ineffectuality." We couldn't agree with him more than when he said: "Occultism (and Spiritualism) can help no one, and no one will help Occultism, until occultists learn to help themselves."

SPIRITUAL HEALING IN

JHE MORAL PROBLEMS which arise from human conflict weigh heavily upon those who possess the gift of healing.

They are equally of paramount importance to those who sponsor this divinely acquired therapy. For the last two years our Cuban healers have been faced with far reaching decisions concerning the immoralities of social life. Let us pray that the decisions they have taken will lead to the establishment of true brotherhood within that country, and will enhance the prospects of a universal system of love towards all mankind. We of the Western hemisphere should "not cast the first stone,"

Spiritual healers in Cuba are not welded together into Federations or Associations as they are in Great Britain and in America. Healing is encouraged, however, by a national organization which is known as the Confederacion. It has its headquarters in La Habana, its courageous leader being Senor Rodolfo Rigal. The general policy of the Confederacion was outlined for me in a summary of their aims and Rodolfo especially requested that their momentous decisions be make more widely known.

The population of Cuba is only a few million, but, as long as can be remembered, that country in the South of America has been much noted for its sensational spirit manifestations which have taken many forms. Spiritual healers have been comparatively small in numbers, but their healing gift often has been of an apparently miraculous character. In the very earty days of healing in Cuba, there JANUARY 1965 CHIMES

was a total absence of organizational influence by a body of moral opinion. In consequence, the gift was abused by the commercial exploitation of what could have been of great curative value to the people of Cuba. The authorities were obliged to act and, with the formation, of the Confederacion National Espiritista De Cuba, healing was placed on a sound basis. The internal changes in Cuba during the last two years have not altered the Confederacion's legal position, and healers are permitted to practice freely, providing that there is no breach of surgical and medical law.

For a few years following 1930, the most westerly province of Pinar Del Rio, was favored by a group of healers who achieved astonishing results. It was a part of their technique first to dip their fingers in clean cold water, this being a symbol of purity and cleanliness. Amongst them was a healer named, "Nica." He was noted for his almost instantaneous cures.

"Nica" was a healer who, by virtue of his simple approach, gave proof of the universality of Spirit power. One of his most outstanding cases was that of a patient who from birth had suffered from epilepsy. By only O By Major T. E. Patterson

one healing he was given permanent freedom from physical and mental illness.

During 1958, I witnessed the healing of a seventeen year old London girl who from birth had suffered from epilepsy. She was on a visit to Kent and received one healing only. Not until September 1962 did I learn that this single healing intercession had produced a permanent cure. She is now married, has a small child, and her uncle has informed me that "she enjoys perfect health." The entire family are Roman Catholics.


"Nica's" healing wonders were, unfortunately, short lived. After only two or three years of practice, he was attacked by the medical organizations of Cuba. Although he was a perfectly normal man, he was finally declared insane and confined to an official asylum. Others also of Pinar Del Rio, on performing spectacular cures, some instantaneous, were similarly treated or imprisoned for the "illegal practice of medicine."

In September, 1959 a man by the name of Listoriel Moro Perez of E2 Manaju had a serious illness. This

illness deprived him of speech, and for a period of weeks it appeared that he would not recover. Perez did recover, and immediately informed his family that he was to become a healer and be used as an instrument of Spirit.

After Perez's complete recovery, his healing wonders commenced. He had been a country woolshearer for years, but he now became a person of great importance to thousands of, Cubans who saw him a dispenser of Divine grace. He gave healing for every known physical and mental ill condition.

Perez's fame grew so rapidly that by 1960 it was quite common for nearly a hundred vehicles to be assembled around his home, while he and his assistants performed cures which the patients "proclaimed loudly and widely." Hundreds of patients who camped out in the open fields had to walt three, four and often five days for their turn to be treated by the healer.



STRANGE TRANCE FEATS

*C*AN PERSONS in deep religious fervor and semi-trance handle deadly rattlesnakes without being bitten? Can they place their hands in flaming torches without being burned? Can they drink lethal doses of poison with no harmful effect?

Dr. B. E. Schwarz, a New Jersey doctor, says he has seen more than two-hundred instances of venomous snake-handling in Pentecostal religious meetings in sections of eastern Kentucky, Tennessee, and some outposts of Virginia and North Carolina, and that he has yet to witness a bite. He also has seen the "ordeal by fire" thirteen times.

On one of his trips he observed two instances of an ordeal that is far rarer than the snake-handling or the fire ritual-the ordeal of drinking the terrible poison, strychnine. The congregations of these religious faiths have complete faith in the words of Jesus as reported in Mark: "And these signs shall follow them that believe. . . They shall take up scrpents; and if they drink any deadly thing it shall not hurt them." Strychninesolution, sprinkled on meat for a dog, will convulse him shortly afterwards. The two "saints" that Dr. Schwarz saw swallow strychnine returned immediately to their preaching, however, and at no time went into convulsions... They did not even twitch.

Most of the people that Dr. Schwarz witnessed attending these meetings were mostly farmers plus a few coal miners, 14 descendants of early English and Scotch-Irish colonists with straightlaced Calvinist backgrounds, who do not attend movies, and abstain from alcohol, coffee, tea, tobacco, drugs, even soda pop. After fervent singing, accompanied by guitars, cymbals and tambourines, with loud prayers and testimonies, some speaking in strange tongues. Dr. Schwarz observed they then went into deep trances "when the Lord moved them." From screened. flat, wooden boxes rattlesnakes and copperheads that had been caught in the surrounding mountains and fields were taken out to be used in the ceremonies that followed. One to four poisonous snakes were held in the hands, around the neck, or close to the lips of the worshippers. Sometimes women handled serpents, but usually this ordeal was performed only by men. During such ceremonies, rattlesnakes seldom rattle when being handled, but do make a collective racket when their cages are disturbed. When it is all over, however, usually no one has been bitten. Sometimes the snakes do strike and bite, but one minister alone claims to have handled serpents more than two thousand times in his career without being bitten once. He did admit, however, that he was in deadly terror of seeing or handling even small, harmless snakes when not in trance.

The members of such groups usually

LESSONS FOR STUDENTS.

MORE ON ECTOPLASM

FINCE ECTOPLASM plays a major role in the phenomenon of materialization, a little closer look at what is known of it so far is at least a beginning.

What has been described up to this point really is not ectoplasm, but materialized "ectoplasm," in other words, "matter." It is a gaseous type of material, but does not necessarily condense when brought in contact with the air. It may be several feet from the medium's body before it is noticeably so as an ectoplasmic arm, for example, levitating some objects at a distance. Yet the space between the medium and the ectoplasmic form is not filled with gas, or with any material we can identify, but is filled with something far more attenuated than any gas of which we know, and it is invisible. What do we know of this "apparently" empty space where ectoplasmic forces are at work? We know energy is present in some form. We know that it is a conductor of electricity; that is opaque to 70% of the infra-red rays; that it casts a shadow on a luminescent Barium Platinocyanide screen; that metals are transparent to it, and that insulating materials are not.

The biological concepts we have of it actually are more helpful than the physical and/or chemical. In materialization, what we are witnessing is really a "birth" process. The medium apparently "gives birth" to these forms in a biological sense. The materializing process recapitulates the history of the organism. The form appears first as, a foetus, then as an embryo. The darkened seance room corresponds to the mother's womb. All life starts in darkness, just as the seed must be planted in dark soil. In the early stages of the medium's development, the phenomenon is presaged often by

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a cold breeze, indicating an exchange of energy somewhere. Partly materialized forms frequently are quite cold, 4 degrees C., showing that in the process of organization, energy is absorbed. Just as with all new life, these forms are connected to the medium by an umbilical cord, visible or invisible. They are never ideoplastic, for fanciful or imaginative structures are unknown. Mermaids, centaurs, and unicorns do not appear. Materialization is NOT creation; it is re-creation. . . a reproduction of something that is or once There is no invention. Even was. thumb-prints have been obtained of thumb-prints that once were, or are now, on this plane; indicating that these materialized forms are molded in or around pre-existing structures. Discarnate intelligences, or spirit entities, must come back in the mold they left behind while on the earth plane, although they do grow and progress in many ways on "the other side." No physical laws are violated in the seance room.

If the materialized form weighs fifty pounds, for example, the medium has lost fifty pounds. In the case of a small medium, if seen beside the materialized form, the medium may seem to resemble a bundle of rags. It is also true that anything levitated must be supported from below, so to speak, or hung from above. In this case, if a table weighing thirty pounds be levitated, the medium shall have gained thirty pounds. (*To be continued*)

DSYCHIC PHENOMENA are God's revelations to modern mankind. We have receivers inside of us which pick up information sent by a kind of shortwave. Psychic phenomena are proofs or reassurance to aid us in a troubled world; they are the obvious parts of a beautiful, complex, and fragile Divine Plan built into each and every one of But why should mortal man be us. singled out for a Divine Plan?

The answer has to be that each person is important to His Plan, which in turn, is important to us. Let us examine this great Plan to better understand Psi..... The divinity of the plan is beautifully manifest in so many ways: in the setting and scenery which we inhabit, the crisp, ice-blue of the sky, the white fluff of clouds, the dazzling vermillion sunset, the dashing whitecaps of ocean and lake. We see beauty in a baby's smile and in the faces of happy people. These sights are needed to uplift and inspire man when little hope seems open to him.

We are reminded by these elusive, *natural* phenomena that there is a way up and out of our daily problems. They tell us that troubles and dark clouds and perishable beauty are not permanent in our lives. We know all this from the beauty which greets our senses through the Plan.

Complications also intrude into this Plan of life. It is amazingly complex for mere humans to fathom how there can be injury, pain, sickness, unhappiness, misery and death which rips and tears at our beings until, reeling and whirling, we think we shall collapse and not be able to go on. How can we, with memory so short, understand the complex reasoning behind the physical "loss" of a child, the "too early" death of a husband, wife, parent, brother or sister? How can we endure the cruelties delivered on mankind by God-less men and still believe in anything? These are the parts of the Plan which are complicated for man, and

for which Divine Intelligence has not yet provided *all* of the answers.

However complex the Divine Planis on these points, we need not despair for all of the answers. One law, for example, the law of Cause and Effect, provides an answer which students of Metaphysics know to be true. Many effects manifest themselves long after the causes are forgotten.

In addition to the *beauty* and *complexity* of the Divine Plan, there is a third quality which touches us more directly than the others. This quality is expressed in the term FRAGILE.

Like a great masterpiece which is both beautiful and complex, the Divine Plan in each of us is fragile. It can be preserved, enlightened, enlarged and

improved with diligent care by each of us. The spirit life may be unfinished at birth, yet after a period of bodily occupation, it may take on the appearance of a finely cut gem polished to perfection. But our spirit-masterpieces, though almost indestructible, may also be misused, shattered or broken.

Our Free Will can determine whether we reach closer to God or further from Him. Bad use of our lives can-mean a set-back in reaching and uniting again with Divine Intelligence, which is the Ultimate goal of immortal men. You can be sure that you are reaching closer to God when you use the help He has made available to mankind, namely, ESP and psychic phenomena. Perhaps this seems like the long way around to our discussion of psychic phenomena, but this writer confesses to borrowing from the philosopher, Aristotle, the technique of moving from the general to the specific. We all have them and we all can develop them and use them, though it may be difficult to control them. There is nothing mysterious about them, but they may seem strange because we have not yet taken them for granted.

Is there anything strange about the young woman's dream that her fiance's hair had turned white at age twentytwo, later to hear by mail that it had turned white while soldiering in the Normandy invasion in World War II? And what about Peter Hurkos' ability to find a criminal, unknown to authorities, by meditating at the scene of the crime? What of the many people who accurately can detect colors by touch? And what of falling objects connected at the instant of "death" with a person who dies? What of direct and material communication with those who have passed on?

All of these phenomena have convinced even the most skeptical people. It is strange, indeed, that many of the greatest scientific discoveries occurred through psychics. Edison, Bell, Westinghouse and Kettering, all were notably psychic. Edgar Cayce of Virginia Beach, an unschooled man, gave thousands of accurate medical diagnoses while in trance. Treatments recommended through his mediumship resulted in many cures.

Repeatedly, history and recent events prove the point that ESP is simply God's Revelation to modern man, yet it is really no different than that given to ancient man. It is clearly

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
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FROM THE INVISIBLES


ALL IS ONE and shall always be, for ONE IS ONE and IS everywhere and is forever in the NOW.

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

THE SIGNIFICANCE OF OPERATIONS

ANY ADHERENTS of metaphysical methods of healing (and this is particularly true of Christian Scientists) eschew entirely any use of drugs, surgery, or other so-called material methods when one is under the ministrations of a practitioner; in fact, there are those practitioners who refuse to take a case in a hospital or to stay with a patient who feels the necessity of making use of hospital facilities. The argument is that to divide one's faith between "God and Mammon" is to neutralize the efficacy of the treatment.

So, let us examine the true nature of healing. Merely to cast out by any means the manifestation on the body of a disease or other deficiency is not true healing. Witness what the greatest healer of all time said to the man whom he had required to take up his bed andwalk at the Pool of Bethesda. Seeing him later in the temple he warned him, "Go, and sin no more, lest a worse thing come unto thee." In other words, it is as if He has declared: I have cast the disease out of your body, but that is only to put you on probation until you have eradicated the cause, the mental roots which I have not pulled up in _my ministrations. Whether the man was obedient or not is not recorded, but if he was unwilling to stop siming (and he knew Jesus knew just what the nature was of this sin), he would have suffered what moderns call relapse. It is possible then that some might have said that the work of the Master Metaphysician was not conclusive.

In a recent case of cancer of the breasts, treatment was carried on for an extensive period. While pain was completely mastered, there was a continuance of loss of blood in such quantities as to undermine the strength and resistance of the patient. Therefore it seemed wise to resort to surgery for the removal of the malignant growth, but not to permit amputation of the breasts, as would have seemed justifiable and necessary according to the evidence on the body. A surgeon was found who would go along with this arrangement, and the cancer came off like a scab over an ordinary wound. The patient returned to work the second week, no one suspecting that she had been to a hospital, assuming that her explanation of being on vacation was unquestionable. The skin of the breasts returned practically to normal and their formation was almost perfect.

This resort to surgery was not conclusive, however, for the malignant thought from outside her own consciousness (indicated by the growth on the outside of the body rather than internal) had to be destroyed metaphysically to complete the healing. It had been uncovered that this woman for many years had played Santa Claus to a group of relatives who were interested in her only for what they could get. Some months before the first evidence of cancer appeared, this situation had been pointed out to the woman, and she had written the parasites that there would be no further largesse on her part. Instead of being grateful for what had been done for them over many years, these people turned on her, even as Jesus warned about casting pearls before swine, saying that "they will turn again and

rend you." This then was the mental cause of the physical manifestation, malignant disease. The patient was counseled not to cease pouring outlove towards these ingrates in obedience to the demand, "Pray for them that despitefully use you." When she feels there is no longer any evidence of the resentment coming from this source, she then can claim her complete healing. No relapse can occur, regardless of doctors' expressed fears that the growth might have spread to other parts of the body.

This evidence of rendering "unto Caesar the things that are Caesar's and unto God the things that are God's" would seem to justify the assumption that to eschew entirely any method other than strict metaphysics in healing is short-sighted, to say the least. The world of today is too steeped in material methods to follow the example of Jesus completely in his eschewal of any apparently material adjuncts to His healing Processes. Yet, while in His ministry. He relied completely on the power of God to heal through His Christ. He gave us His parable of the Good Samaritan who poured oil and wine into the wounds inflicted on the wayfarer's body by the brigands who robbed him and threw him into a deep ditch. He pointed out the greater love of this unaccepted Samaritan as compared to the professed representatives of God, who "passed by on the other side." Jesus was an absolute, as was required in His day, but He was not a fanatic!

climax their ceremonies by taking to the fire. They have been seen to put a rag wick in a milk bottle or tomato juice jar full of kerosene, ignite it, then slowly move their outstretched hands and fingers over the midpoint of the flames, or put their toes and the soles of their feet directly in the flames for up to lifteen seconds, some even putting their elbows, forearms and upper arms in the flames for several seconds. Some of those in a calmer mood will pick up flaming stone coals the size of hen's eggs and hold them in their hands for over a minute while walking amongst the congregation. Dr. Schwarz acted as a control on one suchoccasion and found he could not touch a piece of burning charcoal for a fraction of a second without developing a painful blister. The members of such groups believe that "sinners." when intoxicated with alcohol or disbelieving what they saw, suffered bad burns of the skin, hair or clothes when they attempted to duplicate these feats. Many strange things are being accomplished through the mind once thought impossible. We are just beginning to find out how little we have scratched the surface. . . or how much we have limited our infinite potential.

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

ita, and God bless all of you good friends."



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
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
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
