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

WHERE TIME HAD NO YEARS

AUTHOR'S FOREWORD

I am interested in mental telepathy, and often experiment with the subject. On one particular day I was sitting quietly trying via thought waves to communicate with those no longer on this plane. Suddenly a story was being told to me by a girl who had lived in the ancient world of Ur before the time of the flood. The story has a message that seemed particularly applicable to our time.

AM ARGRET of ancient Ur... names that would mean little to anyone after nearly five thousand years. I was dark of skin and hair, my eyes were black. I was tall, very slender, and lived in the ancient world before all was washed away by a terrible storm.

My home was in the city of Ur, in the land of Cane, a city more beautiful than words can describe. Nothing would compare with it now in your world. It contained towers of solid gold, studded with precious stones which flashed in the sun. There were great palaces with sunken gardens, flowers and trees everywhere, and a multitude of birds with brilliant plumage thrived. We had great highways, and our cars, as you call them now, ran on an electric rail in the center of the highway whereby they could not collide as your cars do now for they had an electronic emergency brake which would stop them if they came too close to one another. We also had small chair-o-planes which we used for short trips around the city. These were easily landed on the roof tops of stores

or apartment buildings. Our space ships long had visited other planets, as they had ours.

We had no democratic form of government, as we had done away with that years before. There were a few who ruled, and the rest were merely slaves...slaves to the state. If they disobeyed or offended, they were given to the rulers to be their slaves and often were beaten to death.

All worship of God had been done away with, but as man will worship something, His place was taken by a man-made God named Henge, whose image was in every home, except one: my mother's Uncle, old Uncle Noah, who worshipped the ancient God whom he called "the only true God". He was calling constantly on us to repent—to turn from our God, Henge, and worship what he called the God of Heaven, and that if we refused, a great ocean would cover us and we would all perish. Sometimes he would become terribly agitated about it.

My father was a lesser ruler, very rich, and a man of great renown. It was said his father had been the great-grandson of an angel who had taken a wife from the daughters of men. When I was a child I used to dream of how very fair this woman must have been. However, I knew Uncle Noah did not approve of this idea. But Father used to say of him: "Poor old Uncle Noah—He is so old that he is imagining things. This world will go on forever. He could have been a great man, had he been sensible. The poor man is even building a boat on dry land!"

Life was very pleasant at our palace,

and our slaves cared for all our wants. My mother was kind to the slaves, who all loved her. She cared for them herself when they were ill, and I have known her to stay up all night to usher a new baby into the world.

But into our world had come something to mar our happiness. One of our scientists had invented a "deathray" gun which had the power to destroy all that came in its path. The nations began living in fear of one another, each waiting for the other to touch off the holocaust. This weapon also could be used as a bomb and could lay waste thousands of square miles. However, it poisoned the atmosphere, due to the many tests made of it, and many died of a lung disease for which there was no known cure. However, we had giants in those days who lived in caves in the earth, so we did not venture out into the lonely countryside without a small death-ray gun. They were ugly and mean creatures - more animal than man-who were covered with hair and practiced cannibalism for they killed and ate everyone they could capture. Some were eight to ten feet tall.

Our home stood next to that of the Lord Governor of Ur who had one son my age, Jed, who was my sweetheart: handsome, tall and blond. We used to strap ourselves into our small planes and race over the tree tops of the University of Ur, laughing and shouting to each other all the way. Jed and I often sat in my father's garden at night and talked of the unrest in the world at that time. At the far end of the garden there was an image of the God, Henge, to whom we worshipped and sacrificed. As I often saw him look at it defiantly, I wondered if he was an unbeliever. Henge was a demanding God, and every spring a young woman's name was drawn from the golden pot by his high priest and was sacrificed on the altar before him to become his bride.

I heard Jed sigh and say: "Argret, tomorrow is the annual drawing for the bride of Henge, and if your name is drawn, I will kill the high priest with my death-ray gun, for you are

going to be my bride — never the bride of Henge."

His words terrified me. "You CAN NOT defy Henge," I told him. "This is the first time my name has been placed in the drawing, and there is very little chance it will be drawn. Even so, it would be an everlasting honor to be the bride of Henge."

Ir seemed to me that the very eyes of the statue were angry. I was terribly afraid, and I ran and threw myself at Henge's feet. "Great Henge, I am willing to be your bride. If it is to be, give me strength to go through the ordeal that I may pass with honor into thy eternal court."

Jed leaped forward and pulled me to my feet, as he exclaimed bitterly: "Oh, if only we had not forsaken your Uncle Noah's God we would all have been better off, and this slaughter of our maidens would never have been allowed."

"No, no," I cried in fear. "How can you say that? How can you insult our great god? He heard you... he will curse you! Go away, Jed!" I ran across the courtyard into a small room my mother loved, one where she spent much time. She was there alone. I saw tears in her eyes.

"Mother, dear..." but I did not finish my sentence, for Father entered the room hurriedly.

"Sarah, Uncle Noah has his big boat finished. It has wire cages filled with animals of all kinds, male and female, as well as many birds. He said that he only had to catch two doves tomorrow, then all would be complete. I have been visiting him this afternoon and he tells me the great rush of water will come soon, and that he and all on the ark will be saved. He says all the rest of us will perish. Poor old Uncle Noah. He has really gone mad!"

Mother lifted her head and sadly said, "I wish our ancestors had never forsaken Uncle Noah's God, for then the fairest of our maidens would not be killed every year."

"Silence, Sarah!" roared my Father.

"Do not speak so of our God, Henge.

If it is to be our daughter, if it is his

will, I command you never to speak this way again."

Mother bowed her head, and the tears streamed down her cheeks. Then Father said in a more subdued tone: "Forgive me, dear, but I guess my visit to Uncle Noah upset me. . . that stubborn, crazy old man!" Then he turned to me and said, "Go to your room, Argret, and rest."

Slowly I mounted the steps into my beautiful apartments with their golden hangings, velvet upholstery, and heavy rugs. I struck a bell and a slave girl came running. "Prepare my bath with lots of perfume and oil," I commanded her, for I was tired and unhappy and felt the hot scented water would relax me.

After I had taken my bath, and wrapped myself in a silken robe, I walked to the window and looked out. How strange and heavy the air was. I had never seen such a night. I called to the slave girl. "Come here and look at yonder sky. The mists must be very heavy tonight, for even the moon is hidden from view at times."

"Mistress," she answered in tones of fear, "I have never seen such a heavy mist."

I dismissed the slave, went to my jewel-studded bed, and laid down, pulling the curtains around me. But I could not sleep for I knew that early, just as the sun came over the horizon, the name of Henge's bride would be drawn. Finally, however, I fell asleep. I was awakened later by my Father, who was accompanied by Jared, a lesser priest of Henge to receive the news that my name had been drawn. Father's face was white and drawn as the priest came to my side and fell on his knees. I sat up in bed fully awake, realizing what had happened. My name had been drawn!

"O, gracious Queen," spoke the priest, "I have come to escort you to the temple where your bridal robes are waiting, for today you are to become the bride of Henge. O, fortunate girl, you are blessed."

Just then the door was flung open and my mother came screaming into the room. "You murderers...you and your grinning idol! May the God of Uncle Noah strike your high priest dead when he raises his knife, and may your God, Henge, melt to nothing!"

My mother crumpled to the floor. My father cried, "Pay no attention to her, child - she is ill and over-wrought, and does not know what she is saying." He lifted her gently and laid her on the bed, and turning to me he said: "Make haste - go at once." He pressed me to his heart, then taking my hand, helaid it in the hand of the priest, who led me to a waiting electric car. We were driven swiftly to the temple where I was dressed in jeweled bridal robes of finest satin. In a daze, I let a slave girl help me dress, then she left me to inform the high priest I was ready. I could hear the crowds chanting and praying to the God in the temple grounds. I was not afraid for my mind seemed to be asleep. It was like a dream.

ADVANCED MEDITATION AND TRANCE TECHNIQUES

(Continued)

HE EFFORTS serious students make for self-development may be undertaken in many ways. In addition to those already described, there are those which may be accomplished successfully in concerted effort with others, such as those which follow here.

Group Meditations.

If you are sæking unfoldment with others, you can perform group exercises and prepare meditations together. Members of the group, each in turn, may state items from the dream pad, and the group analyzes the information much in the same way one interprets in tongues. The members let their minds glide inward for the telepathic signals of insight.

The same is done with texts, and spontaneous prayers. In this way, the group advances to Psychic Presence unfoldment together.

Care should be taken in organizing in advance the items to be used and the persons to be called upon so that once the group meditation begins, it can proceed of its own volition without a leader indicating which way it should go. The principle to follow is spontaneous experience. Discussion should follow the psychic events, not interrupt them.

All the gifts of the Holy Spirit, Healing, Prophesy, Automatic Writing, Spirit Communication, Mental Telepathy, and so forth, can be developed as a group endeavor. In fact psychic projection works best when a group can augment individual development. Trance.

Trance is induced by concentration on something so insignificant that, for all practical purposes, you think of nothing at all. This allows the conscious mind to relinquish its active

control over the organism and the subconscious takes over. It is a second cousin to sleep, and when the trance is complete, you will either clairvoyantly talk, or write, or bring manifestations of insight to those present. The key to this kind of wisdom is that when the conscious mind recedes, the subconscious mind, which is in touch with the collective unconscious of all mankind, is guided by the influence of the Psychic Presence and the infinite intelligence of God.

In experimenting with this process, one might secure hypnotic conditions ahead of time so that the trance state can be brought about through self or auto-suggestion. There are a number of ways of inducing this state independently, however.

One method is the "sight object method" whereby you concentrate on a shiny object, a crystal, a ring, a candle, etc. Close and open your eyes to the count of one, two, three, etc. Gradually the trance ensues as the numbers fade, the eyes stay shut, and the clairvoyant writing or talking begins.

Another method is the one which concentrates on "each part of the body separately," relaxing the entire mechanism gradually, until the sleep-like state follows, and the manifestations of communication then begin.

The third method is that in which you simply concentrate on "going into the trance," think of your mind receding out, and the control of the subconscious taking over. Concentrate on the indwelling of the Psychic Presence itself, as you have come to know it, and feel the Presence.

Many students ask how they will awake from self-induced trance. As Andrew Salter indicates in his book, "What Is Hypnosis," there is little difficulty in coming back to consciousness. When the manifestations are over, the organism either sæks its own equilibrium immediately, or natural sleep takes over, and the waking is in the usual manner. My experience has been that students return to wakefulness almost as soon as the sequence is over.

Fortunately, results are what we are looking for, and the methods change to meet the needs of each Psychic personality.

There are many manifestations of Psychic Presence, so if you are not comfortable with a technique, it is not at all an admission of failure to try another. There is a way for everyone. Experimentation will find it. When it is found, you will become a new person, with a new life, guided by new insights, new knowledge, and new power.

Free your subconscious roadblocks. Learn to know your Psychic Presence. Let it grow, wander across your mental landscape, and glide where it chooses, and how it operates within you before you consciously discipline it in the kinship of other students that have preceded you along the same path.

Gold was the God of such souls, and they existed inmisery to see it gradually getting away from them when they could no longer hold onto it, and became powerless to help themselves when they no longer had those earthly possessions. Such souls live in one eternal nightmare, sometimes thousands of years, before seeking salvation or getting help from on High through Temples of Learning. Another large per cent of Earth Bound Spirits is those who are really good, but who deliberately bind themselves to earth conditions, such as a mother who died leaving little children behind, particularly a baby. Her whole life on earth may have been wrapped up in those children and their welfare. She therefore still clings to her children when going to the Spirit side of life, constantly trying to protect them from harm and guide them rightly. Spirits of this type often suffer from their apparent inability to be recognized by their loved ones on earth. Many times it is possible to bring Earth Bound Spirits who are willing to seek salvation and accept help to some well organized circle. There intelligent mortal souls often are able to enlighten them on their "life after death" and put them in touch with enlightened souls in the Spirit World who are able to help them in their new life and duties.

Because many souls entering the next existence have acquired the habit of seeking knowledge from man instead of the source of higher Spiritual Intelligence, they resent the counsel of Spirit, and still look to man for guidance. This is the reason lost and confused souls are brought to circles of those still in the body of flesh that they may be informed of their transition, and that they may learn where they may receive help. Many do not realize that they have "died" because they never understood that they merely discard their cloak of flesh to take on one of spiritual elements, and that they continue right on living and developing in their new environment.

One very helpful bit of advice mortal man can give any lost or confused soul is to give directions to the Spiritual Temples of Learning in the Spirit World, of which there are many, that they may receive understanding of their condition and be freed from their confusion.

A lost soul is not nesessarily an evil one, and may be lost in the first place because of confusion in not being able to find the Heaven and Hell and the God they had been taught existed after "death". They refuse to listen to the emissaries of God who offer help, and continue to look for advice from the religious teachers on earth who were themselves responsible for the Earth Bound condition in which they later found themselves. It behooves those of us who know better to help these Earth Bound souls whenever we are able and not to condemn them to further suffering. As we help to dispell ignorance and alleviate the misery that exists in the unseen astral planes surrounding this earth plane, we bring about more harmonious conditions in both planes of life.



MHE IDEA that Brazilian spiritual healers are able to practice their spiritual calling unrestricted by legal formalities is an erroneous conception of things which has arisen from the great volume of publicity which has been given to the Brazilian hospitals, where for thirty-five years the medical profession and spiritual healers have worked together without the slightest discord. Spiritual healing is illegal in Brazil, but is generally tolerated providing that its practice is conducted in strict conformity with a legally defined technique. Strictly speaking, the laying-on-of-hands is not legally recognized, and can be interpreted as the "making of passes" which is forbidden by law.

The movement which sponsors the spiritual healing endeavor in Brazil is the Federaedo Espirita Brasileira, but the real founder of the principle of spiritual healing, as it is understood by the National Federation of Spiritual Healers in Great Britain, was Jose Bonifacio de Andrade e Silva, the Patriarch of Independence, in 1818. The story of the Brazilian Hospitals, churches, schools, orphanages, and homes for minors and the aged, is well known to CHIMES readers. It is only necessary to relate the story of Jose Pedro de Freitas and the mighty campaign which is being waged to establish the realism of his healing from Spirit.

The narrator of this story to me was Professor Conrado Ferrari, President of the Board of Directors at the Hospital Espirita, Porto Alegre, Brazil, and Ed-



itor of "Desobsessao", the official organ of the Hospital. Not too long ago, Professor Ferrari wrote me that he desired to have the story of this famous Brazilian healer more widely known in other countries.

Congonhas do Campo is a small town in the state of Minas Gerais, Brazil, and is located a little distance from Belo Horizonte, the state's capital. This small town had no modern comforts, was noted for its lack of accommodation for tourists, and was little known to those outside its boundaries. Yet in a few months it became the mecca of medical science. Hundreds of people now visit the small town each day, and often it must house over a thousand visitors daily who are lodged in small uncomfortable hotels, and who camp in the streets and open spaces. All this is because one of the town's inhabitants, Jose Pedro de Freitas (nicknamed Jose Arigo), approximately thirteen years ago, and almost overnight, developed an extraordinary gift of Spiritual healing. He is a subordinate officer in the State Administration, married, the father of six small

children, and a Roman Catholic.


It is necessary to define Arigo's extraordinary Spirit gift in a manner which will leave no doubt as to its authenticity. Arigo does not touch his patient. He is in a condition of unconsciousness throughout, and makes no pretentious movements of his hands which would indicate that Spirit surgical methods were being used, or that a Spirit operation was taking place. Yet, in the presence of famous surgeons from many countries, what appears to be a surgical achievement has taken place without anesthetic, with no feeling of pain, and without any trace of scars, the usual hallmark of earthly surgical science.

In exactly the same manner that Harry Edwards of England is influenced in diagnosis by Lister, Pasteur and others in Spirit, so the healer Jose Arigo of Brazil, is used as an instrument by the Spirit, Dr. Fritz, who was a German physician. In the same way that the British Medical Association has attempted to discredit the healing of Edwards, so has the Medical Association of the state of Minas Gerais brought Court charges of illegal practice against Arigo on two occasions. Once he was convicted, but was exonerated by the President of the Republic, Mr. Juscelino Kubitschek de Oliveira.

The second charge was still pending at the time I received Professor Ferrari's report, and it is because of this that a vigorious campaign is being waged on



HUMAN DYNAMOS

EDICAL SCIENCE has not yet found a satisfactory explanation for those strange people who seem to be charged with high voltage electricity. Many could simply touch persons of this nature and the electrical shocks emanating from them would throw their victims to the ground.

Jennie Morgan who lived near Sedalia, Missouri in 1895 was such a person. Frail and nervous by nature, at fourteen, for no apparent reason Jennie suddenly started to behave like a powerful storage battery. Sparks flew from her finger tips when she reached for the pump handle. She was like a human dynamo. A certain Dr. Ashcraft doubted the stories he had been hearing about the young girl's electrical output and took her by the A few moments later when hand. he opened his eyes, the amazed doctor found himself flat on his back. He had been tossed several feet by the impact of the shock.

Jennie had few close friends, and she regarded the phenomenon as a curse. She loved the family cat, but it would have nothing to do with her after it had received a few shocks. However, her strange electrical "gift" faded by the time she reached maturity and, to her delight, she became another normal low-voltage young woman.

Another human storage battery was Caroline Clare of London, Ontario. In 1877, when she was seventeen years old, Caroline was a strapping one hundred thirty pounder who lived with her parents and six brothers and sisters. Caroline became ill, lost her appetite, and began to waste away. Doctors could find nothing seriously wrong with her, but she continued to dwindle away until her weight was about ninety pounds. Then she underwent a mental change and began suffering from seizures or convulsions. While in this state, she would mumble of far-away places and scenes, describing them vividly. It made little sense to her family and friends, for they knew she had hardly been outside of her native town. For eighteen months Caroline remained in this condition before taking a turn for the better. She soon discovered that she had acquired an unwanted power to shock people who merely touched her. Oddly enough, Caroline not only gave off considerable voltage, but seemed to be magnetized as well. When she picked up any metal article that could be attracted by a magnet she could not let go of it. Someone had to pull the article from her open hand forcibly.

In a somewhat different category are those who can set combustible things on fire simply by breathing on them. Dr. L. C. Woodman of Paw Paw, Michigan at first dismissed as ridiculous exaggeration the possibility of such an occurrence until A. W. Underwood, a twenty-four year old negro, walked into his office asking for help. Dr. Woodman wrote in the "Michigan Medical News" what happened in the presence of himself

and some colleagues: "Underwood will take anybody's cotton handkerchief and hold it tightly against his mouth while breathing through it. After a few seconds, it bursts into flames. The flames continue until the handkerchief is consumed. He will undress completely, rinse out his mouth thoroughly with various solutions, wear surgeon's rubber gloves, and submit to the most rigorous examination to preclude the possibility of any humbug." Still the human blowtorch went on setting fires with his breath.

Such phenomena as those described have an explanation, of course, but perhaps until the coming of the Psychic Age people have not been ready for it. Their manifestation at certain times, or in certain areas, serves to awaken people to the realization that there is more to man and the world in which he lives than appears on the surface. Some day we will come to appreciate and understand the basis on which these phenomena occur.



ECTOPLASM PHENOMENA

(concluded)

Having described the solid forms of materialization, three other forms remain to be touched upon.

Transfiguration is one in which a semi-materialization substance, not unlike dough, oozes from the facial orifices of the medium. At first it looks as if the medium's face had been plastered with clay. The material is then transformed into the characteristics of the invading spirit. The medium with this so-called "false face" then resembles a Hallowe'en mask, being entranced, may then walk out of the cabinet resembling some recognizable spirit who is returning to the seance.

Simulacra can be described as the invading spirit shaping the semi-materialized substance from within, as an overcoat assumes shape when we slip it on. It is a "biological" fitting, of course, but when the spirit cannot achieve this, occasionally the control will make additions and changes from without. Forms thus produced look as though they had been sculped or molded from clay, and sometimes by a not too good craftsman, as they are representations in two dimensions only.

Etherealizations are forms produced that can be seen through, as can the conventional ghost, and are comparatively rare. They are subject to fewer limitations than the other three forms, however. American Indians appear in full regalia in these forms and there is no suggestion that the garments have been copied from available costumes or materials from within reach. Orientals may appear in their bejeweled turbans and flowing robes in a variety not found in other kinds of materiali-These forms rarely speak, zations. however, or if they do, their voices are almost inaudible. This is what we should expect from the absence of solid vocal membranes.

Observation, experiment, and in-

ference relating to previous descriptions given here of materialization usually bring forth little help from the Spirit side of life. Why is this? In the first place, the picture we have drawn is from our side of life, and we see effects only, assuming causes. From their side of life, the causal, what they do may be inexplicable to them. There is evidence they do not know the "inwardness" of what they are doing in many cases anymore than we do when we raise our arm. How do we explain that act to anyone? We do not even know how we digest our food, how we see or hear. Therefore the mind-matter relationship probably is as obscure to them, or nearly so, as it is to us. They may realize what our science denies, that mind has an organizing power over matter, but their knowledge may end there.

In these discussions of materializations, however, we find that the crux of almost all that is yet known about them is that mysterious substance, ecto-We have found that it is a living substance, acted upon and molded by thought and memory. It has been suggested that the term "Psychoplasm" be used for this substance rather than ectoplasm as it denotes a quality of mind behind such manifestations. Harry Boddington, one of England's great writers on psychic subjects, says: "Nature around us is a condensation into palpable forms of previous aerial and inscrutable forces. Man, an organized being, is composed of thesethings. He holds them in suspension in his We are all matenervous system. The solid food we rialized spirits. eat is used to maintain the structure of the body, supply if with force, and the mind with feeling, thought, and expression. This fluid within man's body is called "Psychoplasm" because it is so highly vitalized that the soul

can mold it into organic form. This then means invisible elements can be condensed and molded and thus become visible and tangible by reason of the directive mind behind the manifestation.

This gives us quite a new slant on the study of physical matter, physical bodies, and materialization. If we are all materialized spirits, so to speak, then it is quite rational to suppose that the materialized human body, when properly organized and chemicalized, can "give birth" to other forms. . . materialized spirits. This then brings the whole scope of our study on this subject into the realm of natural law, acting under its eternal compulsion of infallible action and reaction, cause and effect, in endless streams of varied manifestations. It relieves us of the feeling that such manifestations are of supernatural origin, and brings all such phenomena into the field of rational, understandable, and thus acceptable happenings.



CHRONIC APPETITES

T ABOUT THE TIME of the outbreak of World War I, I decided that it was time for me once and for all to break the habit of smoking cigarettes, to which I had been addicted all through high school and college. Never a chain smoker was I, but I felt as lost without a pack of "fags" in my pocket as without a dollar bill. I tried unsuccessfully many times to free myself from this appetite, so I decided I must find a better solution than mere human will. This came when I ran across a statement in a religious book, claiming that "Desire is prayer". I began to ponder the import of this pronouncement, trying to analyze what was the true significance of false desire as opposed to good.

I was with a broker's office at the time, the firm which now occupies the highest spot on the New York Stock Exchange, and I began to watch what impulse caused me to reach for a cigarette when Mr. Gottrocks called to inquire as to the market on steel. I decided that I was reaching for inspiration beyond and above my normal astuteness that I might render the greatest service to the inquirer. There was

nothing wrong in this desire, I reasoned, but by what delusion was I beguiled into thinking an inanimate cigarette could give it to me? Then the significance of the quotation dawned upon my consciousness. I was giving tobacco the intelligence and power that belonged to God! My desire was false in that I was praying to a god of my own making. It came very forcibly to me that I was like the Chinese who burn incense to a deity built up of false convictions. import of this awakening was to cause me to break no more the First Commandment, "Thou shalt have no other gods before Me." From that time on there has never been a time when cigarettes have ever appealed to me, even in the slightest degree. However, if I felt like smoking occasionally I would not look upon myself as a sinner, because I would know that tobacco has its right uses, just the same as other products of the soil.

This revelation as to the nature of desire set me to examining other phases of appetite, and I found the significance of practically every one of them. With respect to drinking of alcoholic liquors, I analyzed the motives as: (1) the desire to enhance happiness and friendship, (2) the urge to drown one's sorrows, (3) the need for stimulation or strength, (4) discouragement to the point of "what'sthe-useness, (5) the automatic habit of routine suggestion carried out. Now, the desire for happiness is a prayer to God, Who alone can give it; oblivion to sorrow or disappointment is based on the fact that He can experience nothing that "defileth or maketh a lie"; inspiration or energy has its source only in Infinite Spirit, divine Life; courage and hopefulness, can come only because God is "Of purer eyes than to behold evil and cannot look upon iniquity"; it is the "still, small voice", not suggestion, that continually urges toward good, not evil.

Sex appetite is based on failure to recognize the fact that male and female are qualitative in nature, not corporeal.

The man who feels the sex urge must learn that the female of God's creating is the inherent quality in each of His ideas that proceeds from the Motherhood of the Creator, and is not to be found under skirts or a bikini. The woman who looks to man for satisfaction must realize that spiritual manhood is within herself by virtue of her relation to God's Fatherhood. Therefore, it is within consciousness, not the "lo, here or lo, there" of sensuality that satisfaction must be sought. Both men and women must learn that ecstacy is divine, not physical, and is based on the fact that God is always satisfied with all that He creates. An application of this principle applies also to homosexualism.

So it is all down the line of human appetites. Strength is to be gained from Divine Omnipotence, not from a "coffeebreak". Obliviousness to unhappiness can be had only as one recognizes that God is completely oblivious to any form of error, not from accepting the suggestion that a drug or the distillation of a poppy can supply it. Overeating in the form of gourmandizing shows one's ignorance of the fact that his real desire is for the food of spiritual living, the experiences which he can masticate (analyze) metaphysically, digest with the truth of being, assimilate with love for the body, not as a thing of flesh and blood, but "the temple of God, which is holy."


Approach to any false appetite along these lines is an enlightened concept of what desires actually is and eventually must supercede all attempts to meet the problem through medication, alcoholics anonymous, or psychological experimentation, all of which miss the point of actuality.

MY SLEEP WRITING

ECENTLY, I sold an article on how cemeteries could curb vandalism and desecration of their premises. Considering that I have sold over six hundred articles during the past few years, this sale was not in itself very unusual. What was unusual is that this article was written, or actually drafted, while I was in a state of sleep.

My full time occupation is that of Certified Public Accountant. To ease the tensions of wrestling with figures and tax laws, I took to writing articles on taxation, insurance, finance and office management.

After some moderate success I branched out and wrote articles of general interest—health, hobbies, travel, political science, etc. However, during all of my writing career I had never thought of writing an article on cemetery vandalism, nor did I have any research material on the subject in the packed files I maintain for reference material. How then did this article on a subject foreign to my interests and knowledge come to be written?

Sleep is still something of a mystery to medical science. We know that it is a state of repose in which the activity of the senses and brain appears to be suspended temporarily. This state is akin to complete unconsciousness, accompanied by a relaxed condition of the body and a general diminution of vital functions. We must sleep so that the parts of the body actively engaged in the discharge of important functions can rest from toil and be "repaired."

The night I wrote the article in

question was no different than most others. As usual, I watched the 11 p.m. TV news, spent a half-hour or more of restlessness, then fell off to sleep. In my sleep I must have been dreaming of doing an article on the curbing of cemetery vandalism. First came the opening paragraph with the narrative "hook," then followed a few brief paragraphs to lead the reader to pointers on the steps to be taken to curb vandalism. I will never quite know where the pointers came from - it seemed as if an unseen off-stage voice furnished me with the "meat" of the article. In my dream I wrote furiously, pleased with the rough draft of the article.


Sometime after 2 a.m. I awoke, the dream still fresh in my mind. I grabbed a writing tablet and pencil and went into the kitchen so as not to disturb the rest of the family. The words poured from my pencil onto the paper. All I had missing was a wrap-up paragraph and the article would be complete.

I returned to sleep—not disturbed by dreams.

In the morning I awoke and called a local cemetery to ask if they had any extensive problem with vandalism, and if so, asked what they were doing about The information elicited enabled me to put the finishing touches to the draft of the manuscript and to compose an ending. A little hesitant, I typed and mailed the manuscript. I didn't know quite what to expect. Could I tackle a vexing business problem and, without any research on the subject, come up with enough correct answers to warrant sales of the article? Did my off-stage helper speak with the voice of authority?

The article which "fell into place" and was composed while I was asleep appears under the title, "Sixteen Steps which Cemeterians can take in Curbing Cemetery Vandalism," in the September 1964 issue of AMERICAN CEMETERY.

This has not happened to me since then, but I am prepared for more interesting things to come via this phenomenon with paper and pencil at my bedside. (The September, 1964 Chimes carried a thought-provoking article by George Butler, entitled, "Celestial Icebergs," having to do with such mysterious objects falling from the sky in many parts of the world, still largely unexplained. AN LIVES at the bottom of what we could call a "sea of atmosphere." The heat of the matter caused condensation, and the condensation of moisture was frozen into horizontal layers, due to the nature of air movement in this layer of the The ice thus formed stratosphere. would still contain the odor and taste of its former relationships.

A rent in the ionosphere by a volcanic eruption, many hundreds of times MARCH 1965 CHIMES more powerful than the most powerful atomic explosion set off thus far (and many such eruptions have occurred in the history of our earth), causes a rush of "cold air" down into the lowest atmosphere "flash-freezing" the inhabitants. This is what happened to the dinosaurs and explains their sudden extinction. Evidence that prehistoric animals were rapidly frozen has been uncovered in Siberia. The quality of meat of these animals was edible and was put to just this purpose by the peasants who discovered the carcasses in the ice and snow.

In recent history we have exploded atomic bombs into the atmosphere, creating radioactive debris which now circles the earth and which one day will descend. We have penetrated the stratosphere by missiles piercing layers which normally protect man, causing rents which enable currents to swoop down into the lower atmosphere. The result is that there are frequent reports of stones and ice slabs falling from the sky. There is within the earth's atmosphere, in its highest reaches, a tide of debris collected from past volcanic eruptions, which now includes atomic debris orbiting the earth, and is working its way down eventually to the lowest level, where man stands and wonders how stones or ice can fall from a clear sky.

Arigo's behalfthroughout Brazil and in other South American countries. The amazing healing cures effected through Jose Arigo have been front page news in Brazil, Mexico and Argentina, and a number of reports of them have appeared in European countries.

mask" the healer, Jose Arigo. "The healer," Prof. Ferrari informed me, "spoke with complete correctness." This fact was communicated to certain doctors in Berlin, who then decided to visit Brazil and invite the healer, Arigo, to demonstrate his healing powers for them. Doctors from Japan who had witnessed his healing successes, also invited him to Japan. However, he was unable to accept this invitation because of the large number of Brazilian patients who visit him daily.

"I would be pleased," Prof. Conrado Ferrari wrote me, "to know that your many readers are informed of the realism of Arigo's extraordinary healing capacity."

(Editorial Note: It has been learned from other news sources that in October, 1964 Arigo was convicted in Brazil of malpractice, and that his transfer to the federal penitentiary almost caused an uprising among the people. While out on bail, before he had been sentenced, it is reported that he successfully removed cancer from the uterus of a famous newspaper woman. Upon learning that she was well, she "lit the torch" and cried out for the people to save him. Several thousand strong, they stormed the jail at Congonhas do Campo, escaped with him to Rio de Janeiro, and lodged him in a military prison where attempts are now being made to arrange for his release. Another illustration which demonstrates that no area of this world is exempt from the discrimination produced by fear, ignorance, and selfinterest, regardless of how great the blessings the world of Spirit would bestow on suffering humanity.)
