We were church folk and our home held quite a collection of Bibles and religious literature. Yet day by day we learned to know God by a greater faith, one we were taught to live.


The idea of Word Association was for me to give the meaning in a (as the children put it,) "true story". They chose, "What's Love?"

Part II

ME LEARNED in Part I of this article of the preceding issue that healing power resides within each one of us in our subconscious mind, and that only a change in our attitude is necessary to release its power. What you believe about yourself is reflected in all experiences, events, and circumstances of your life. Prayer prayer therapy - is also a force that can bring into being a harmonious union of the conscious and subconscious mind. Let us see also how great an influence our faith has in releasing healing power from the subconscious mind.

FAITH HEALING

What is popularly termed faith healing is not the faith mentioned in the Bible. This means a knowledge of the interaction of the conscious and subconscious mind. A faith healer is one who heals without any real scientific understanding of the powers and forces involved. He may claim that he has a special gift of healing, and the sick person's blind belief in him or his powers may bring results.

To illustrate how blind faith works: You will recall the Swiss AUGUST 1965 CHIMES

physician, Franz Anton Mesmer, who, in 1776 claimed many cures when he stroked diseased bodies with artificial magnets, then later threw the magnets away and evolved the theory of animal magnetism. This he held to be a fluid which pervades the universe, claiming this fluid went forth from him to his patients, healing them. People flocked to him, and many wonderful cures were effected. After Mesmer moved to Paris, the Government appointed a commission composed of physicians and members of the Academy of Science to investigate his cures, from which came a report that there was no evidence to prove the correctness of his magnetic fluid theory, and that the effects were due to the imagination of the patients. He was soon driven into exile and died in 1815. Shortly afterwards, a Dr. Braid of Manchester discovered that magnetic fluid had nothing to do with the production of the healings, but that patients could be thrown into hypnotic sleep by suggestion, during which much of Mesmer's well-known phenomena could be produced. Thus all his cures undoubtedly were brought about by the active imagination of the patients, together with a powerful suggestion of health to their subconscious minds, all of which

could be termed blind faith since there was no understanding in those days as to how the cures were brought about.

SUBJECTIVE FAITH

Whatever may be your objective belief, if you will assume to have faith actively or passively, your subconscious mind will be controlled by the suggestion, and your desire will be fulfilled. The faith required in mental healings is purely subjective faith, attainable upon the cessation of active opposition on the part of the objective or conscious mind.

In the healing of the body it is, of course, desirable to secure the concurrent faith of both the conscious and subconscious mind. However, it is not always essential if you will enter into a state of passivity and receptivity by relaxing the mind and the body and getting into a sleepy state. In this drowsy state your passivity becomes receptive to subjective impression.

Recently, I was asked by a man, "How is it that I got a healing through a minister? I did not believe what he said when he told me that there is no such thing as disease and that matter does not exist."

This man at first thought his intelligence was being insulted, and he protested against such a palpable absurdity. The explanation is simple. He was quieted by soothing words and told to get into a perfectly passive condition, to say nothing, and think of nothing for the time being. His minister also became passive, and affirmed quietly, peacefully, and constantly for about one half hour that this man would have perfect health, peace, harmony, and wholeness. He felt immense relief and was re-

OUR HIDDEN LINKAGE

In speaking of her views on ESP, colored by her own experiences as a psychic, Rosalind Heywood, in ESP: A Personal Memoir. states that she is of the conviction that there exists permanent subconscious communication between people, in proportion to their affection for each other, or the desire for help one can give to the other . . . the closeness of the hidden linkage varying according to temperament. "But to be linked means to affect and to be affected." she contends, and "beneath the surface. then, we may all be directly affecting each other all the time."

OUR PROGRESS IS REGULATED

Speaking of the ESP (extrasensory perception) studies at various colleges and the attempts to develop systems for measurement of phenomena, Walter D. Voelker, writing in Gate Way, Spiritual Frontiers Fellowship Journal, states "it is important to recognize that most of the factors influencing a particular incident are unmeasurable. It is possible also that there are other important factors of whose existence we do not know or even suspect." He further speculates that "if paranormal phenemena are in fact controlled or even influenced by spirit forces, researchers here probably cannot progress faster or further than allowed by those 'on the other side'."

HOW FEAR RULES

Even though gradually we are being prepared for the shock of knowing for certain that intelligent life does exist in other parts of this universe, and that we may soon be 10



in communication, prominent scientists, government heads, and fiction writers long have instilled much fear in earthlings. *Little Listening Post* of Washington D.C. writes that "in a world abundant with beauty, and amid a universe exhibiting law, order and grandeur, is it any wonder that, with *so much expectancy of evil*, man's progress on earth is so agonizingly S-L-O-W!"

OPSYCHIC TOUR OF EUROPE

Living proof that healing is the "gift of Spirit"

ST. TERESA OF AVILA

SPIRITUAL HEALER of my acquaintance frequently intercedes directly to St. Teresa and the Mother of Jesus. From my close association with this healer over a number of years, I am able to say that her healing has, on several occasions, produced spectacular results. Through her intercession I have witnessed the unlocking of joints, the almost instant removal of pain, and, above all, the restoration of normal mental balance in cases of great distress.

During 1960, this healer, for the purpose of absent healing with patients in Japan, decided to send her own Healing Minute Badge to a Mrs. T. O. of Tokyo. It was received with "grateful thanks to be worn always."

Twelve months after this I received a letter from Mrs. T. O. in which she stated: "As a result of my husband being an exhibitor at the International Trade Fair, I have been overburdened with work. It has been a tiresome task, being occupied with meetings and receiving many guests and foreign buyers mostly. I developed a very severe pain in my left shoulder, which I think resulted from fatigue. badge on my shoulder and prayed for Spirit help. After a short time I realized that there was no longer any pain, and it has not returned."

It is necessary to point out that the healer referred to had been giving absent healing to this patient throughout the period. That this was an act of spiritual healing, there does not appear to be any doubt. Pains of this kind do not disappear without cause or treatment of any kind. We are intitled to ask if the healer's intercession to St. Teresa did in fact meet with prompt response. Knowing the healing record of this healer, I am prepared to say that it most certainly did. If healing did not take place through intercession to St. Teresa, then it must have taken place through the intercession of some other discarnate spirit to whom the healer and patient were attuned. St. Teresa was a healer during her lifetime, and we have ample evidence that she has continued to heal since her passing to Spirit.

A small child was crushed by a wall which fell upon him. He showed no sign of life, and there is no doubt that he was seriously injured. He was carried to one who had the gift of spiritual healing. The healer took the child in her arms and, after prayerful intercession to Spirit, returned him to his mother. The child was perfectly sound in health; he was completely healed. It was a healing which today would make headlines in our press. The printing press had not been invented during the period of this healing, but the records were carefully preserved so that the healer today is known as St. Teresa, foundress of "The Formation of the Barefooted Carmelites," better known as St. Teresa of Avila.

The life of this Saint was written by herself and is indeed a story of mediumship in many of the known forms. . . clairvoyance, spiritual vision, levitation and spiritual healing. All these forms of mediumship are known to have been highly developed within her.

Teresa was born March 28, 1515 at Avila, in old Castille. She came from a good family, her father being Alphonsus Sanchery of Cepeda. He had married twice, and there were twelve children of the two marriages. Teresa was the daughter of the second wife,. Beatrice Ohumada.

Of Teresa's father it is said that "he delighted much in reading good books; he was also very generous to the poor in need, kindly and considerate to the sick and an ideal master of his servants." Her mother also was a woman of great piety, but died very young when Teresa was only twelve years of age. History has paid great tribute to the parents of Teresa, and there is no doubt that her early pious instructions were derived largely from them.

It is claimed of this Saint that in her excited spiritual and pious endeavors frequently she was levitated to above ground level. Testi-

• Margie (writes E. L. of Erie, Pa.), I have been searching for the truth about God and life for years. I despair in ever finding it. Can you help me to find what I seek?



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THE BROOKLYN ENIGMA

, MONG THE MYSTICS and clairvoyants of our age, few had such a strange life as Mollie Fancher of Brooklyn, New York. She died in 1903 after having been hopelessly bedridden for forty-eight For thirty years of this vears. time, Mollie scarcely was ever free from pain. For nine years she astonished doctors by taking no food or drink.

Mollie's mother was psychic, and early sensed there would be a deep shadow over her daughter's life, thus arranged for Mollie to live with a sister. Mollie broke two ribs after being thrown from a horse, then later suffered a worse accident when returning home on a street car from a visit to her physician. She was stepping off the rear 'platform, her arms full of bundles, when the conductor started up the car, throwing her to the ground. Her skirt caught in an iron hook at the rear of the car, twisted around as a rope, and dragged her rapidly over the rough stone pavement. As a result, she developed inflammation of the lungs, paralysis, blindness, deafness for a time, loss of speech, then spasms, followed by the trance condition. Except for the region of the heart, her body became entirely cold, all natural bodily functions ceased, and often no pulse

was felt. Many times physicians pronounced her dead - only to reverse their ruling later. During the nine years she was in trance, her right arm was so rigidly bent that the hand was fixed over the back of her head.

Despite all these afflictions, however, Mollie was able to make the most beautiful minute patterns of embroidery, monograms on silk, and fine wax work, cutting flowers and leaves in an ingenious manner. Even in her blindness, she could match colors to perfection, and would make friends return colors of thread to stores because they were not the exact shades she She was able even to needed. distinguish delicate shades of colors someone carried in a pocket or purse. All the money she earned from her handiwork she gave to charity, and on the many occasions when her work had been exhibited. she won top prizes.

During the nine year period of her trance, Mollie's aunt urged her to eat to maintain life. Her reply, however, was, "I receive nourishment from a source (spiritual) of which you are all ignorant." Her physicians thought a person would die without food in two weeks. They were a long time trying to prove that Mollie ate and drank nothing. Her throat was contracted, so she could not swallow, and her stomach had collapsed. Trying to force food and water upon her, when she could not swallow. only added to the misery of her spasms and convulsions.

Spirit entities are said to have controlled Mollie's body after her accidents and performed the work she could not have done herself. During that nine year trance period she performed intricate embroidery and wrote more than 6500 letters to help, comfort and inspire persons in many walks of life. When the trance was over, she knew it was not Mollie Fancher who had performed all that work and written all those letters, for she had great difficulty even in holding a pen or pencil and the handwriting certainly was not her own.

Mollie was able to read books under the bedclothes and unopened letters placed under her pillow or on her forehead. From her bedroom upstairs, she was able to identify anyone who entered the front door downstairs, as well as callers who were yet several blocks away. Often she told what people. were doing on certain days as far away as Bermuda and Hawaii, and hours before they occurred, she predicted thunderstorms and fire alarms about to sound.

In all her long years of martyrdom, Mollie did all she could to serve handicapped children, to lessen the burdens of the aged, and to inspire others to higher spiritual living. Truly she was a selfless instrument of Spirit, one who, because of her many afflications, succeeded in astounding and confounding the psychic and medical worlds. What could have been considered a tragic and cursed life became a blessed one as the unlimited power of Spirit manifested through her to bring good to every life she touched.

LESSONS FOR STUDENTS . .

• WHAT SYMBOLISM MEANS •

Symbolism is one of the most important and least understood subjects in the whole realm of the psychic field. It is therefore necessary that one understand exactly what symbolism means.

A "symbol" is a sign for something else expressed in a more or less partial and incomplete manner, usually appealing to one of the five senses. It does not denote a sensual thing, but the thought lying behind it. Thus the printed word is the symbol of an author's thought. A poem, for example, is the expression of the poet's mind and spirit set forth in the words and meter of the poem. Thus, symbols are only partial and incomplete, representing but a small fraction of the thing they stand for.

SYMBOLIZED OBJECTS

We only perceive or realize through our five senses various aspects or qualities of an object. If you are looking at an orange, for example, your sense of sight gives you the impression of a reddish-yellow sphere, rather irregular on its surface. Your sense of touch tells you that this thing is round, that it is somewhat rough and cool. Your sense of smell supplies you with the information that it has a pleasant odor unlike anything else. This is confirmed by your taste. In this particular instance the sense of hearing would not enter into the identification as in many other instances.

All these things which appeal to our senses...color, odor, texture...are"qualities" of the orange, 16 and are not the orange itself. The orange is more inclusive than any of these qualities and symbols. Suppose you took away one of those symbols—its color, for instance. The orange immediately would become invisible to you, yet it would continue to exist even though you might never know of its existence.

This shows how symbols are inadequate and imperfect representations of a vaster "something" lying behind them, and that they represent only a small fraction of the totality of the thing as it really exists.

SYMBOLIZED SPIRIT

As applied to the spirit of man, we must begin by admitting that no man has seen it. All he has ever seen are the outward features, the form and the facial expressions of another. When by spirit we hold communication with one another, we do so by written symbols, by motions of the hands or head, or by means of air-waves passing from the throat of one to the ear of another. All of these are but expressions or symbols which are interpreted by us according to a certain prearranged code. If we did not have this prearranged code, it would be impossible for two intelligent beings to converse with one another. . . as may be seen when someone from America and someone from China meet for the first time, neither speaking the language of the other. They try the best they can to make each other understand what their thoughts are, but they succeed imperfectly, or not at all. The symbols they are

using are too inadequate to express their thoughts.

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

mony of her physical mediumship was given by no less a church dignitary than a theologian of great fame who stated: "She was raised in the air in the choir." Levitation was common to this Saint, so also were other forms of mediumship. That Teresa frequently went into a trance condition is made quite clear by the assertion that "when she returned to herself, her powers continued in some degrees, absorbed sometimes for two or three days."

It is reported that this Saint received apported objects in the form of four "great stones" of which "a diamond is but a counterfeit in comparison to these." She was holding the cross at the end of her beads when these "four stones appeared." At a later period, and after her death, this cross, as a relic of the Saint, has been credited with healing power. We. know that this relic in itself could have no healing power; we know that it could only represent a point of concentration by which attunement could be obtained. There is no reason why the Healing Minute badge, such as the one sent to Mrs. T. O., should not answer the same purpose. Perhaps, after all, St. Teresa still heals. Why not. . . if the power of Spirit is unlimited.

A minute more and you would have been cooked alive." He didn't know that I had been inside working on the boiler, and I didn't know he was about to turn on the steam to blow out the boiler scales.

Both of us had been called by our first names. Neither of us knew who did the calling. However, because of it, my life had been saved. An experience like ¹ this certainly can cause one to investigate the unseen forces in life even if previously much we had heard was not believed.

Death, the great leveler, has crushed man's pride. reduced his ambitions to nothing, and quenched the flame of his surging passions. If only man would remember death, he would do no evil action. stored to health. It is easy to see that his subjective faith had been made manifest by his passivity under treatment, and the suggestions of perfect healthfulness by the minister were conveyed to his subconscious mind. 

EINSTEIN WAS INTRIGUED

One of the greatest physicists of his day, and the man really most responsible for the discovery of atomic energy, from J. H. Pollack we learn in his book about Croiset, the Dutch Clairvovant, that Einstein was intrigued by psychic phenomena. At one time he is said to have demanded a scientific hearing for the telepathic powers of Upton Sinclair and his wife. Another example given of Einstein's interest in the psychic was when he traveled from Princeton University one evening in May, 1954 to Edgewater, New Jersey to attend a psychometry session conducted by Florence Sternfels (recently passed to Spirit). She was a psychic who became famous, like Croiset and Hurkos, assisting various police departments to solve the fate of missing persons and locate lost objects.

PARAPSYCHOLOGY IN THE RUSSIAN PRESS

The November 26, 1964 issue of the Literary Gazette of Moscow, mass-circulated newspaper on culture and the arts, in an article by A. Kitaygorodsky attacks parapsychology as a pseudoscience, an open door to acceptance of the 'supernatural,' and as being responsible for the wide dissemination of superstitions. In another article, A. Roshchin, a psychiatrist, objects to such a dogmatic approach to facts which exist that cannot be ignored. Speaking of the advances of science, he states: "During the last decade the history of science in general has abounded in examples of showing how the most unthinkable of facts, contradictory to all formerly established scientific standards, became actual



reality. They not only achieved an ample scientific explanation, but were also widely applied in practical life. Remember how, at the beginning of this century, Einstein himself stirred up distrust with his theory of relativity which showed that such fundamental matters as time, mass, and space were And what a storm in relative. the field of science the 'strange' theories of quantum mechanics aroused. The invention of lasers upset the theory that parallel beams of rays could never be obtained, to say nothing of the truly fantastic discovery of the distance over which these beams are effective. The infrared optics made it possible to see things in darkness. Electronography showed us atoms and molecules, which was considered absolutely impossible at a time not very far back." Speaking of recent experiments in the recognition of colors by finger-touch in the Soviet Union and the United States, he reminds us that few people know that experimenters soon found out that the subjects being tested could recognize colors in a pitch-dark room . . . that color samples could be recognized even if enclosed in metal film holders. He states that the results from the tests showed "the level of correct AUGUST 1965 CHIMES

responses is very high." With regard to the role of parapsychology and religion, he concludes: "...if science discards some facts and does not explain them, this doubtless will be the open door through which religious faith rushes in."

PSYCHOMETRY ANGLES

Charles Richet, famous scientist who has contributed much information on psychic research, gives his explanation of the word "Psychometry" as: "On any object being given to a sensitive, many curious details are furnished concerning the persons to whom it belonged." However, many sensitives feel it is questionable as to whether the presence of the object is required, for to many doing this work, an object is merely a focus for concentration; successful psychometry frequently has been carried out with objects inside boxes or sealed envelopes, or at a great distance from the sensitive. We are finding out that it does little good to try to define the unknown.

RESEARCH IN INDIA

From Jaipur comes word that

the Government of Rajasthan has asked all heads of departments to provide research facilities to the Parapsychology Department of Rajasthan University. The department, only one of its kind in that country, has undertaken research projects which may have a farreaching impact on the theory and practice of education, as well as throw more light on understanding the total nature of man.

PHYSIOLOGICAL RESPONSE TO TELEPATHY

"When an emotionally-loaded telepathic message is subconsciously registered, its impact can be electronically recorded because it is accompanied by minute bloodvolume changes," according to an American Society for Psychical Research pamphlet. A method of recording these impacts on a continuous graph with an instrument known as a plethysmograph, has been developed by Douglas Dean and Robert Taetzsch of the Newark, New Jersey College of Engineering Research Foundation. Mr. Dean spoke at the First Space Congress in Cape Kennedy about his work with telepathy and communication.

NEW SPIRITUALIST MOVIE

George Cukor, producer of this year's Academy Award Winning motion picture, "My Fair Lady," is set to produce a motion picture based on the book, "*The Spiritualists*," by Trevor H. Hall dealing with the alleged relationship between Sir William Crooks and the young English medium, Florence Cook, according to the *Parapsychology Foundation Newsletter*.

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



YOUR SLANG TALKS

JHE CASUAL observer of all the gadgets, gauges, instruments and indicators on the panel of an airplane would find himself merely bewildered; but to the pilot, every one of these devices is of vital importance in flying the plane. This casual observer would not feel himself in very safe hands if the pilots were to ignore the message transmitted by the "jiggling" of an instrument, and was interested only in not being disturbed by its agitation. Unless he knows what the instrument is saying to him, and knows what to do to correct the error being reported, he is a menace to every passenger who has placed faith in his ability to handle the plane.

So it is with the body. Every organ, every function, every formation tells its story to the understanding professional whose aim is to bring his patient to a safe landing on the runway of health. The condition of a part or function of the body tells the doctor what sort of ailment or maladjustment 22 is present, and the probable remedy. Unless he has a working knowledge of psychology, however, he is unlikely to be deeply concerned with the patient's mental background, since he is convinced that it is the *body* that needs his attention.

Ancient diagnosticians believed the organs and other parts of the body were supposed to originate certain mental traits and tendencies. The heart was said to be the source of the affections; the liver and gallbladder were thought to produce various emotional manifestations; the kidneys were said to be the origin of various unlovely characteristics of disposition. The only mistakes by these old diagnosticians was in regarding the body as the cause of mental conditions, rather than the reverse. Let us reason a little over this. Do you say that a man has a pleasant disposition because he has a good face, or is the facial expression the result of his disposition? If we were interested in changing a child's facial expression, would we start with his disposition or would we employ a face lifter? Are not most parents familiar with the fact that if John's mouth turns down he must be told to get a more joyful outlook on life? In associating mental traits with organs and secretions of the body, the ancients were wrong only with respect to which was cause and which was effect.

One of the most common and interesting applications of mental etiology lies in the use of slang expressions. This most refreshing use of language often is one of the finest clues to the mental causation of bodily manifestations. We are all familiar with such expressions as "getting it in the neck" ..."belly aching"..."elbowing somebody out of the way"..."going on behind my back"..."the girl is turning his head". . . "shouldering too much responsibility" "watch your step"...and dozens of other expressions which are a direct clue to the cause of a physical condition. In conversation with the writer, a patient continually used the word "stomach" as a verb. . . "I just can't stomach a fellow like that." Is it surprising that his complaint was stomach ulcers? Another patient stoutly complained to me, "I think I've got a kick coming." Is it any wonder that he had trouble with his feet and legs?

The skeptic might say, "Isn't that a little farfetched? Aren't you allowing your imagination to overshadow your common sense?" If mental diagnosis was confined exclusively to slang expressions, the skeptic's doubts would be well founded. However, these few illustrations are not supposed to substantiate the case for the mental causation of disease, but they do enable one to draw on something he knows about and which may lead to many things very few people know about mental etiology. It is an interesting pursuit to try to associate familiar slang phrases with the physical symptoms of friends whose ailments and mental characteristics are both well known. Try it yourself and see what you learn. We will relate these expressions and symbolisms to their inner significance in our next discussion.


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
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
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ANY PEOPLE have become inerested in the phenomenon of bilocation for it represents survival of the Self, and, along with this, to a certain degree much of the present attainment and progress in this physical life. Those who are able to exteriorize on their own and learn to control the light body, or what we call the Self, will have a sharp increase in awareness and ability.

These are latent aptitudes within every man awaiting development. In at least ninety percent of the cases of those engaged in bilocation, they will develop rapidly, and keep at a high state as long as they are engaged in it. However, when the individual ceases to practice bilocation, these gifts will atrophy and lie dormant until resumed.

The person who uses bilocation soon learns that it has many beneficial uses; he finds that while out of the body he is much more at ease and creates his own pattern of life. TECHNIOUES OF BILOCATION PART II

which Soul or Self leaves in bilocation. Those who have little knowledge of bilocation generally leave at the solar plexus; other points are the spiritual eye, or pineal gland; the medulla oblongata; the thousand petal lotus, or pituitary gland, and the heart center, known to the Hindus as the Anahata.


There are, of course, five main techniques in bilocation. These are the imaginative, dream, meditation, trance, and direct projection techniques. None of these are difficult to use, for thousands of people today know at least one of them.

The imaginative technique is hardly related to its own name, although many may think so. The reason for this lies in the fact that nothing you can think about on this physical plane is more than a reflection of its original in the astral.

All inventions, art, literature and laws in our world have comedown from the astral. Most of man's destiny is worked out and any human problems are solved in this upper world. There is a great museum in the astral capital city of Sahasra-dal-Kanwal that has the archetypes of every possible thing which has been on this earth. It is said that every great inventor, e.g., Edison, Marconi, Alexander AUGUST 1965 CHIMES

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The late Dr. Reginald Mills

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Graham Bell, and the Wright Brothers, visited this great museum at some time in their astral bodies, either in dreams, or one of the other methods of bilocation methods mentioned here. Leaders in every possible walk of life have visited this museum, or other places in the astral world, where they received directions for working out their destinies. This was supposedly true of Washington when, at his lowest state in Valley Forge, he was put into a trance by a higher entity, and was projected into the astral. There he saw the future map of the United States stretching from coast to coast. This gave him the hope and courage he needed to continue the war.

The imaginative technique follows out the old spiritual law: "As above, so below!" Whatever is above reflects itself below. Thus if one wishes to be out of the body by this method, he simply puts himself at a certain place, at a certain time, and he will be there. However, this technique is only good upon the first three planes, physical, causal and mental. It doesn't work in the worlds above. for beyond the third world the Soul drops all bodies and enters into the pure planes of God. It has no need of tools or faculties for traveling within the far regions of pure spirituality.

For this technique, one sits back in a chair, relaxes and closes the eyes. Then he looks directly into what is called the Spiritual Eye, that place between the eyebrows, at what might be a blank screen. Put the place to be visited on this screen; let it stay there. Get interested in this place, and register the preceptions received: the feelings, atmosphere, color, actions and odors.

All of a sudden this becomes reality to the one participating in 28 this exercise. He is standing in the center of the scene he was looking at within the spiritual eye. The old law of physics says that wherever the thought body is placed, the rest of he who is doing this must follow, whether it be in the physical or astral body. Here one is working with thought, an element of Self greater than has been given credit. It is thought to be the power action of the light rays in the three upper worlds.

This is the beginning of bilocation for those new to the subject. It is within these moments that creative power is exercised — Bilocation can operate as well with creative power as with any other the Soul will use in other worlds.

During the periods one uses this technique of bilocation to get out of the body, the state in which he has been is so real that it is a shock to return to the physical senses. One sees something so vivid that it becomes questionable whether the evidence of the outer senses can be believed.

This shock actually reverses the sense of time. No longer is the individual participating every moment on the time track of his life in this physical world. This time track consisting of the past, present and future is very important to anyone interested in bilocation. It is here that all must work out their karma – Hindu term for cause and effect. One could battle his way through a series of a million incarnations, but it would do little good. For long as man is involved with the problems of this lower world, he will live on the time Once he projects himself track. above this time track, however, he is in a much better position to manage his life Once he comes to an understanding of this timetrack and can comprehend the present, or what we call the moment, that

part of the track we are living in this instant, he can understand karma and eternity.

This is where we are living individually, if we are fully aware of . all things going on within our own universe. We need not dwell in the past, for all things have been

¹en care of, and the future is not needed, for we live in eternity here and now. We are living in the reality of God at this moment, not in the past nor in the future, but here and now. This reality is what we know as the Is-ness of God. God IS, because God is always in the present. That is where we are when living out of the body—in bilocation.

One must project himself into the heavenly worlds in order to get off this time track. Once one is able to handle bilocation, he can go backwards on the time track and correct any problems bothering him in the present.

There is a second phase of the imaginative technique. . . its use outside of the body. The participant can put himself outside the body in the thought form, then, use the imaginative faculty of the astral body to create an event for the physical self. My wife did this to bring about a sea voyage which occurred in a very natural way without passenger cost for either of us.

For this technique one first must have a strong desire to be out of the body. Secondly, he must have complete physical immobility, like lying on a couch or in an easy chair. Third, he must assume that he is already in the state he so desires, whether it is in some astral locale, in any of the planes above the astral, or somewhere on this physical planet. It makes little difference where one wants to be, but the attention must be fixed

there, without using the imagination to look at it.

Another aspect of the imaginative technique of bilocation is that one can leave the body and go back on the time track to look at any scene of yesterday in his life. Often he can get into the time track of a person whose biography he might be reading, or those around him, by mocking up what appears to have been events in their lives. All of sudden he finds reality pouring in on him from the scenes he views with this technique while outside the body.

Bilocation is not hard to do, but it means one must practice it continually. By doing so, one has control of his life in the past, in the present, and in the future, and, of course, beyond the senses in the next worlds. Anyone doing bilocation, however, must be fully aware that one of the first things in his training is the cultivation of discipline. This will be taken up next, along with some of the other techniques of getting-out-of-thebody.
