You must walk in the narrow way between the two worlds; hold your balance between the objective and subjective thought, don't neglect this world because you happen to have a view of another world. It is well enough to be exalted to the ecstatic vibrations of immortality, but don't

neglect to wind the clock, put out the cat and see if the house is closed up before you retire. Don't pump so much blood into your brain that your stomach is left without the proper propulsion for good digestion. This is the reason why myself and wife, June and May, are well mated. When June soars up into the air, May says "did you hear the dinner bell?"

*** Somebody says "Proverbs are potted wisdom." So I got a book of Proverbs because I wanted to be wise; and I found a lot of things that are antagonistic to Mental Science, and to the Bible as well; for there is nothing in all the world that agrees with the Bible so well as Mental Science. You will notice the statement made in the quotation above, that no prophecy is of private interpretation, I was not permitted to mention the wonderful prophecies concerning Mrs. Eddy and Mrs. Wilmans, in private letters. The Word received from God must be proclaimed in the columns of Christian and left to work out its own unfoldment. No prophecy is ever a private one or for private interpretation. The human women mentioned in my prophecy are no more in the sight of God than other women. We say, why was General Grant put in command of the armies of the United States to close up the Civil War? We ask why Bismarck held the position he did in uniting the German Empire? Why should Leo, Pope of Rome, linger in his present place? These questions are coming up before us all the time. Why should Mary Baker and Helen Wilmans be selected as the mothers of this great movement? I don't know. When I found I was the chosen prophet of the Lord God, I wondered why He didn't select someone else. I asked the Spirit why He selected me. The answer was, "Because you are the biggest fool on earth." At first, this shocked my vanity. The light came to me afterwards, when I found that the fool in the eyes of the Spirit was one who was willing to learn. In the language of St. Paul: "If any man among you seemeth to be wise in this world, let him become a fool, that he may be wise. For the wisdom of this world is foolishness with God." I confess I have always been fool enough to try to learn the truth. It was not my modesty which caused me to wonder why God did not select some one else; but, at that time I did not know what he wanted me to do. When Moses was called, he asked God why He did not select his brother Aaron. Aaron was older than Moses and a good speaker. Moses thought that Pharoah, king of Egypt, was to be impressed by oratory. was not called. After ten years of schooling, I found out God does the work, and all I have to do is to hear and obey.

I have always had the gift of prophecy. It is a natural gift cultivated and educated by the Spirit. For instance, I have named every president of the United States before his nomination, from General Grant's first term to William McKinley's second term. The man and his inauguration always flashed before my mind several months and sometimes years before his nomination. When I was speaking before the United States Court, twenty years of prophecy flashed before my mind. I gave it to the Court in these words: "President McKinley will serve out his present term. Theodore Roosevelt will serve two full terms. His immediate successor will also be a Republican and serve one term. By this time, the Union Labor Party will elect a president. All this will be done peaceably. There will be no more war. Capital and labor will be united for the good of the people. What appears to be division and strife is but God's way of bringing about unity. When all the capital is united in one great trust and all of the labor is united in one great union it is but a step for the two divisions to become one. But a mightier than man is behind all these movements.

I could give you a whole list of prophecies made by me that have been literally fulfilled. I have told you in CHRISTIAN how I saw the face of my wife eight years before I saw her in the flesh. The whole of that prophecy is being fulfilled every hour, in "She Whom My Soul Loves." The reason why it was made public, is because no prophecy is of private interpretation. THE THREEFOLD NATURE OF MAN.

The earth.
The moon.
And the sun.
This is the Trinity of Being.
The physical man is of the earth.
The mental man is of the moon.
The spiritual man is of the sun.

These things are taught in the sacred writings of the Hebrews, called the Old Testament, and in the scriptures called the New Testament. "That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is Spriit." In other words, the earth brings forth after its kind. The mortal body of man is produced by the earth. It is born of dust and unto dust it will return. There is not any such thing as physical immortality, because, the earth body is subject to change. It is under the law of dissolution. It comes forth as the grass and is cut down by the scythe of Time and returns once more to the place from whence it came. Why men should have been encased in such a frail house of clay, is more than I can say. He hardly has time to look around and think about his situation, before the grave-digger comes around and puts him into a hole in the ground. He may die of old age, just the wearing out of his organs, or he may be an athlete and step on a rusty nail and die of lockjaw. He may be suffocated for want of air. Or it may be he is drowned in the waters. There is a chance of his being wrecked on the railroad. He may breathe some infectious disease from the atmosphere and lie down and die. There is a chance for him to touch the live wire on the streets and die instantly. You see this earth man never knows just when his house of dirt will be dissolved. The only thing that keeps him from becoming a lunatic is hope. He is always hopeful. He knows that death stalks abroad in the land, but each individual hopes he may escape. Therefore this man of flesh is not afraid to risk his life on fast trains. In fact, he rather prefers to travel fifty miles an hour, rather than go in a safer train at a slower rate of speed. He takes his chances on board ship, amid the storms of the mighty deep. He will enlist in the army and go to war, not because he expects to be killed, but because he expects to return with laurels. The other fellow

may be killed, drowned, smashed in a wreck, but each one thinks he is to be made the exception to the rule. The element of hope is all that lifts the mortal man out of absolute lunacy. If there is no immortality for the man of flesh, for the body of earth, what am I talking about? I am talking about breaking the earth connection and putting man's soul in conjunction with the sun. An electrical body would not be subject to accidents, disease or death.

The mind of man is moon. Our boasted

thought is nothing more than moonshine. It is the mortal mind in the mortal body. The one corresponds to the other. The first glimmering ray of intelligence which comes to the earth man is from his mortal mind. He begins to learn by having objects and ideas impressed on his brain which corresponds to the moon. His brain is the moon of his spirit. Therefore, its light is reflected light. This mortal mind never goes out of the environment of the mortal body. It can not see one day ahead, and it can not see backward except by reading the records made in books and otherwise by mortal man. He has to learn every thing he knows by the sole process of impressions on the brain. He can not think without words. He can not have an idea without words to express it. So all of his boasted knowledge is simply a collection of words. This moon man walks by faith and not by sight. He can only see a few feet in front of his nose. St. Paul speaks of that scientifically when he says: "For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then, face to face: now I know in part; but then shall I know as even also I am known." The original reads: "Now we see in a mirror, darkly." It is moon light. You must remember that St. Paul and all the apostles were in the psychic where they could only see in a mirror. It is the second plane of being. In one place St. Paul speaks of this mirror in this way: "But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord." The whole unfoldment was revealed by the Spirit to the apostles of Jesus Christ in prophecy. They saw even the change that would take place in the bodies of those still living on the earth at the time of the resurrection. The resurrection period dated a thousand years. It is sometimes called the millennium. But all the scriptures and all the theological writings and all the church organizations are on the second or psychic plane of being. In other words, they are in the moonlight.

There are many so-called scientists who are groping in the moonlight. An editor of a New Thought paper, criticised me the other day for printing the lessons of R. C. Douglass because he reasoned from the Bible. This editor spoke of the Bible as a dead book and as belonging to the past. It shows how thin is his thinking. The Bible belongs to the present just as much as it does to the past. The Bible has the greatest current circulation of any book on earth. The Bible runs more printing presses than

any other book that was ever printed. There are more people reading, teaching and talking about the Bible than any book that ever came forth from the printers. It is not only a modern book, but it is in every man's mouth. There never could have been a Shakespeare without the Bible, for his writings are honey-combed with passages from the Scriptures. The man who speaks of the Bible as a dead book is talking foolishness. But as I have said, the Bible was written in the psychic or prophetic period of man's unfoldment. "Heaven and Earth may pass away, but my words shall not pass away." As sure as the sun shines, all the prophetic writings will be fulfilled. The time is at hand for the Bible to get on its feet and walk. It is not only a live book, but it contains in its pages the highest spiritual potency. The man who does not know the Scriptures is an uneducated man. It is the foundation of all true education.

The spirit of man is sun. That which is born of sun is sun, and that which is born of earth is earth. In spiritual illumination, we come into the knowledge of the truth. We walk on the earth and we touch the sun. What man has been he will always be. Therefore, the body will always partake of the elements of the earth, the mind of the moon, and the spirit of the sun. The majesty of the Spirit man will control the earth and the moon. He will be master of matter. Therefore, his earthly body will be changed into a finer substance with a more rapid vibration and still it will be earth. His mind will be moon and his spirit will so illuminate the brain that he will see things as they are, and know as he is known. Therefore, you see we do not get away from what we have been, in the sense of losing identity or personality. St. Paul puts it in this way, speaking of the Lord Christ: "Who shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto His Glorious Body, according to the working whereby he is able to subdue all things unto Himself." A better translation is: "The body of our humiliation." St. Paul does not call this a vile body, but an humble body. It is to be changed into a glorious body, an electrical body, a body that will vibrate in unison with the sun. This is what is meant by putting off the old man and putting on the new man. It is created in righteousness. It is taking the same material and refining it. "The fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is." This fire is the electrical current and when it is turned on the earth the very elements will melt with fervent heat. The God-man and the God-woman will be able to walk through this fire unharmed. "I will not mislead you, gentlemen, in saying of His intelligence, that in character and sign, it possesses that which we call the sublime. The sublime is elevation, profundity, and simplicity, blended together in a single trait."—Lacordaire.

This is a splendid definition of the sublime. Men reach the sublime in their writings when they are inspired of God. In reading, we touch the sublime and it acts on us like a live wire. We read page after page of common things and then suddenly touch the sublime and are lifted out of the common place. Inspiration is sublime because God is sublimity. Therefore, all sublime writings are inspired writings, for only God can speak the Word of God. This is the reason why only God can give you the Secret Word and the New Name for the Secret Word and the New Name is the name of God. And only God can pronounce the Name of God.

I have said that men occasionally reach the sublime in their utterance. Julius Cæsar, in the midst of a storm, said to the frightened boatman: "What fearest thou? Thou carriest Cæsar?" This is the sublimity of personal courage. At the close of the civil war, when the North and the South were torn by strife and bitterness of soul, General Grant said: "Let us have peace." These words of sublimity touched every heart. But note the simplicity. Every word is a word of one syllable. Such is the sublime. It is, as Lacordaire says, elevation, profundity, and simplicity blended together in a single trait. All words of prophecy are spoken in the sublime. Nearly the whole Bible from Genesis to Revelation is prophecy. After thousands and thousands of years of faultfinding, the Bible still stands as the compendium of sublime sayings.

In Jesus Christ the sublime was natural. It was his native element. He never said anything that was not sublime. His mind was characterized by continuous sublimity. He said of his own words: "The heavens and the earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away." On another occasion he said: "The words I speak unto you are Spirit and they are Life." His words were living words because they were sublime. It is said in the last book of the New Testament: "The testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy." All the prophets found expression in Jesus Christ. He was the fulfillment of all who came before him. But Jesus was also a prophet and his own prophecies are being fulfilled now. He was in himself, by his testimony, the Spirit of Prophecy. Then he projected his own word into the future and it is now being fulfilled in the truth.

You must bear in mind that in Jesus the sublime was always present. What would be called the common in other men are sublime when spoken by Jesus Christ. For instance, this expression: "Gather up the fragments, that nothing be lost." This was an ordinary remark after the feast, and yet it was not ordinary when spoken by the mouth of Jesus Christ. It has been taken as the text for sermons, songs, poems and even volumes. Take that other expression: "Blessed are the poor in spirit." It has been a benediction all down the ages to those who have been struggling with poverty of mind and spirit. There is no need for me to give you quotations from Jesus Christ. He is the Divine Word and this Word is always sublime.

The whole Bible is filled with sublime sayings, because it was spoken by the Logos, the Spirit, the Word of God. Take up the common version, it is good enough for anybody, and read the majestic words in the first chapter of Genesis:

"In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

"And the earth was without form and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.

"And God said, 'Let there be Light,' and there was light.

"And God saw the light, that it was good; and God divided the light from the dark-

"And God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And the evening and the morning were the first day."

There is not anything more sublime in the literature of the ages. In all of our advancement in physical science, we can not find any better words to express the unfoldment of creation. Read right along through the whole book till you come to the Ten Commandments. In these Ten Commandments you will find the foundation of all our English law. They not only contain the foundation of all law, but the fundamental principles of human society. Then go on down until you come to the Book of Job. In this great poem you will find the scientific statement of the Truth concerning man's spiritual and mortal mind. It is one of the grandest poems that has ever been written. Then turn over and begin to read the Psalms of David and you will find such poetry as was never known even to the Greeks. The Psalms are full of Mental Science. The "Lord God" of these Psalms is the Word of Truth. I will quote for you a part of the 139th Psalm:

"O Lord, thou hast searched me and known me.

"Thou knowest my downsitting and mine uprising; thou understandest my thought

"Thou compassest my path and my lying down, and art acquainted with all my ways. "For there is not a word in my tongue,

but, lo. O Lord, thou knowest it altogether. "Thou hast beset me behind and before, and lain thy hand upon me.

"Such knowledge is too wonderful for me;

it is high; I can not attain unto it.
"Whither shall I go from thy Spirit? or
whither shall I flee from thy Presence? "If I ascend up into Heaven, thou art there; if I make my bed in hell, behold,

thou art there. 'If I take the wings of the morning, and

dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea; "Even there shall thy hand lead me, and thy right hand shall hold me. 'If I say, 'Surely the darkness shall cover

even the night shall be light about me. "Yea the darkness hideth not from thee; but the night shineth as the day; the darkness and the light are both alike to thee.

"For thou hast possessed my reins; thou hast covered me in my mother's womb.

"I will praise thee, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; marvelous are thy marvelous are works; and that my soul knoweth right

Then turn to the major and minor prophets for the lines of inspiration and the promises of the Messiah. The New Testament is full of sublime sayings. It is an up-to-date text book on Mental Science. All the Bible needs is to be interpreted according to Science instead of sects. You will find all your New Thought in this so-called old Book. It is there and you need no Revised Version, Our old, terse, Anglo-Saxon has been preserved in the Bible. Shakespeare drew both his language and his inspiration from the Bi-

The ideas from the Bible have been translated in all the languages and nearly all the dialects on earth. This has prepared the way for Christian Science. You must have a vehicle for the transmission of Thought. This vehicle is the Bible. It has been more closely and scientifically studied during the past century than ever before. The International Sunday School Lessons have given a systematic study of the Scriptures.

Therefore, if you want to be a true Christian Mental Scientist, study the Bible. Don't undertake to read it through from beginning to end. This would tire even the patience of Job. LESSON V.
Thought and Expression.

"And God said, Let the waters bring forth abundantly the moving Creature that hath life, and fowl that may fly above the earth in the open firmament of heaven."—Gen. 1:20

This Lesson deals with the Creative power of Thought. For since Infinite Mind is the Great First Cause, all Causation is in Mind, and there is no such thing as material causation. Back of all material forms, back of all forces of every description lies the Great Eternal WILL, the source of all forces and all activities. From this Unerring Wisdom-Will proceeds the Thought-Logos with inherent infinite possibilities of expression. Form is an inherent attribute of thought. In this allegory the "Great Deep" is a symbol of formless Mind. But thought, being definite, is a thing of Form; though Form does not always mean Shape. Primarily it is mode or state of being, which is ultitimately manifested in Shape, its full expression. Thus Thought by the Power of the Will is formative and creative. "Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the Word of God." Heb. 11:3.

The Divine Idea is the Spiritual Germ, the living "Monad" of Leibnitz, the Creative "Logos" of Philo and St. John,—the biological Entity, forever seeking its etheric protoplasm, that it may find expression in visible Form after its own likeness. The biological nature and Creative power is not peculiar to God's Thought alone; but is a characteristic of all thought. It is the nature and prerogative of thought to express itself. It receives its energy and creative vibration from the Will, which sends it forth. This vibrative energy moulds the Ether-Substance, and visible Form is the inevitable ultimate result.

The True Self or Ego is always working with God. In fact, in a very true sense its working is God working. The human needs to find its at-one-ment with the Divine; then will its creations be as perfect as are those of the True Ego. Then they will be the Ego's creations. Then "It is God working in you both to will and to do"; then you will make no mistakes. Whatever the Father is, that is the Son also. If we ascribe Omnipotence, Omniscience and Omnipresence to God, we must also to Man, the Son of God. Man is finite in his conceptions, and therefore in unfoldment and realization. Yet as a Son of God all possibilities are inherent in him, even to Omniscience, Omnipresence and Omnipotence. Like the "waters" of this allegory, man's mind is a free expanse omnipre-This free-flowing mind-expanse of man is not confined to the narrow limits of the body; it is no more within the body than For wherever your thought is, whether here or in China, there you are

functioning,-there you are, in the Omnipresence. As a Son of God you belong to the Universe. The Universe is your home and field of activity. You are here to unfold your possibilities of Omnipresence, Omniscience and Omnipotence. In all ages there have been men, whom we call Prophets and Seers, who have been able to go to distant countries consciously, and report what was actually taking place there. borg repeatedly did this; he even went into the Heavens and held converse with the angels there: St. Paul was "caught up into the third heaven, and heard things unutter-So real was this migration to his consciousness, that he said of the experience, "whether in the body or out of the body I can not tell."

Emerson said, "There is One Mind common to all men; and each man is an inlet to the same, and to all the same."

As we rid ourselves of the limitations which we have surrounded ourselves with, and open ourselves receptively to our infinite possibilities, we shall begin to be conscious of being in touch with Omniscience, and the whole fountain will be open to us; we shall be "an inlet to the same, and to all the same" consciously. Even the fullness of infinity is not withheld. "All that I have is thine," is the language of the parable. There is no limit, except what my own mind has prescribed. God has not circumscribed his own Son with limits. Walt Whitman, seeing this, exclaimed "From this hour I decree myself loosed of limits and imaginary lines, my own master total and absolute."

"Let the waters bring forth the moving creature that hath life." This is the law of action of Creative Mind. This active, living mind generates active, living thoughts. Therefore thoughts are living entities, "moving creatures that have life," which the mind "brings forth." Thoughts do not per-Mind's creations are not dead. Mind must express itself. Its creations must be living, like itself. Man is the containment, the compendium of all God's creation. the Microcosm. In him All has been infolded,-all the Divine thoughts, the whole creation,—the whole of Divinity even. All these are in man potentially, in-folded. To these are in man potentially, in-folded. un-fold these is man's work through Eter-

Mind would not be mind if it could not think or bring forth its thoughts into ex-Therefore Man, the Idea of Dipression. vine Mind, must have always existed. Man is therefore God's necessity; because he is the expression of God's Idea. Bishop Warren said, "Creation is a necessity of mind, even Divine Mind." Then creation must have always existed. Thought is a necessity of mind, and creation is a necessity of If God is Love, he could not be Love without man to love. God could not exist without his creation, any more than mind could exist without thought, or thought without expression. It is an equal necessity of man, that he think, and that his thought be outpictured in expression. In my Microcosmic world my thoughts are expressed in my body. "In thy book all my members are written."—all my thoughts are expressed. For it is a universal law of thought, that, "without the Word was not anything made." And it is equally true, that "the Word is made flesh." That is, Thought is made concrete in body, "after its own image and likeness." Wherefore Wherefore Jesus said, "Every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment." Every word you utter Every word you utter is faithfully recorded in the register of your body; and you are therefore receiving judgment accordingly. For the judgment day is already come; the judgment is set; and the books are open. Every word (or thought) you send forth goes on its mission of blessing or cursing, according to the quality of the thought sent out,-the true word to bless, and the evil word to curse-whom but yourself?—only yourself—. It could not hurt your neighbor, unless he open his door admitting the fugitive. It is the law (or judgment) of thought, that it be "I flesh," in conditions "after its kind." sow thoughts, and we reap corresponding conditions. "By thy words (thoughts) thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned." Exact Law is both Judge and Jury, and your words are the witnesses against you in this Judgment. Righteous judgment, the relation between cause and effect with our thoughts, has been going on all our lives. We have been reaping the fruit of our "idle words," until "the whole head is sick and the whole heart faint"; and weary with the burdens we have imposed upon ourselves, we seek relief from sin and surcease from sorrow." So bitter is the fruit, we are tired and sick of error and sin. In hope of harmony and peace we turn from these illusions to Truth, as the remedy for error's sad outpicturing.

But notwithstanding the accuracy of the law of cause and effect in the expression of thought, yet so great is the dynamic power words of Truth, when uttered in the full realization of their power, that inharmonious conditions, effects of error thoughts, may be utterly overcome by the speaking of true words. For error is a coward in Truth's presence, because it is emptiness, falsity, illusion; and because Truth is True -Omnipotent Reality. Therefore you may speak your word with the assurance of its power and success. "So shall my word be that goeth out of my mouth; it shall accomplish that which I please, and prosper in the thing whereunto I send it." This is the power of your word,—not God's alone; but every Son of God has the same power. trouble with us has been, we have not half understood the irresistible power of the Word of Truth, when backed up by Faith and Realization.

For man wields Omnipotent power, when he knows it, when Faith gives him the consciousness of it. With this great Faith, that knows, your word becomes a decree;—then, "thou shalt decree a thing, and it shall be established unto thee."—Job 22:38.

The ancients understood this power of the Word. They said, If you desire agreeable experiences, you have only to put a good word into the ether, and leave it to take care of itself. It will bring comfort by and by, by something agreeable coming to pass. So in silence they sought the right word, which they spoke with, the vehemence of faith. Are your circumstances uncomfortable? Is your environment intolerable? Then you may go to work and change it. You have had much to do with forming it. It is exactly adapted to your mentality. But if it is becoming intolerable, you may be about to throw it off, and come into a better one. You are like the Dragon-fly. For a time he is content with his environment, as he crawls, an uncouth grub, on the bottom of the pond. After a time he tires of it, and aspires to higher things; so he climbs upward on a reed, and the sun splits open his environing shell, and he leaps forth free, the beautiful dragon-fly, with a new and better environment, which he has sought and found. "Ask, and ye shall receive; seek, and ye shall find." What you desire you can have, if you know your power, and don't get "rattled" by fear or doubt. No matter if the whole world seem to be against you, and would destroy your law. By steadfastly adhering to Principle, abiding in the "secret place of the Most High," holding on as did Jacob, as he wrestled with the angel,—some-time it will transpire, that "while they are speaking I will hear"; while steadfastly claiming with the "persistency of faith" your heart's desire, the transformation will come. You must be free.

"For though wrong grind thee small, And all depart; Yet shall thy world grow polar to thee, Slowly taught,—
And crystal out a New World,

Like thy thought.'

By training the mind in steadfast purpose, and with fidelity to Truth, you may bring into manifestation the desirable and beautiful things, which are already yours in the invisible omnipresence, only awaiting your demonstration to come into conscious ex-

pression.
"Let the waters bring forth the moving creatures that have life, and fowl that may fly above the earth."

It will be noted, that it is the "waters" that bring forth both "moving creatures," and "fowl." This is the language of both the Authorized Version and Douay Version, and is doubtless correct; because this allegory relates to thoughts and the creations of mind. For thoughts ("waters") create everything. Indeed if the Darwinian theory, that the "fowl" is a differention of the fish, be true, then this statement is all right, even in its literal sense. The revisers had no need to change it.

In the correspondence of this allegory, "Beasts and creeping things" are the Passions, Sensations and Feelings of the flesh; and the "fowl that fly above the earth in the open firmament of heaven," are thoughts that soar above the sense plane, in the unlimited free expanse;—the greatest and most powerful of which are high Aspirations and Spiritual Ideals. These have greatest power in unfolding our Highest and Divinest faculties. These carry us into Heaven, where we discover the Higher Self vinest faculties. -our Divinity. These lift us up to God. In the silence we form our high Ideals.

The story of Moses, as given in Ex. 2 and 3, is my experience in meditation. For he was forty years in the wilderness tending sheep. And he "led them to the back side of the desert," where he found himself "in the mount of God." Here God revealed himself to him by the Great Name, "I AM." When Spiritually understood, this is my experience—your experience. For, if we will go into the silence ("desert")—into the depths of silence ("desert")—into the depths of silence ("to the back side of the desert"), and there shepherd our pure, in-nocent thoughts; and stay there through the perfected experience, indicated by the term, 'forty years," without regard to time, (4 denotes, perfection—a square—; 10 denotes, All; 4x10 denotes a full or perfected experience),-we shall suddenly find ourselves in a very exalted Spiritual state ("in the mount of God"), where highest revealings come to us, where we "meet God face to face," as it were. It is the revelation of my True Self to myself. I find my own True Being, whose name is, "I AM." The Hebrew word for this is JHVH, pronounced Yaveh or Jehovah.
Translated it means, "I AM," and is the name of my Higher Self, my Divine Self— Divinity within—the Son of God—Immanuel. This is the "Lord God"—the Christ within, who rules my world.

When at the "Burning Bush" Moses received this revelation of God within (3rd chapter) has been allowed with power suf-

chapter) he became clothed with power sufficient to overcome the bondage of the whole nation of Israel. Just so our Israelites (Spiritual forces) have been long in Egyptian bondage; and we cry to God by reason of the oppression. By finding God within we may awake and arise,—awake to the con-sciousness of our Divine, Omnipotent powers, and overthrow these Egyptians (carnalmind thoughts). When we know that we are Sons of God, we shall be sure of our right to freedom,—we shall be sure of our right to freedom,—we shall be free. It is always the "Son," who makes us free. "Whom the Son makes free is free indeed." "Lo, I Am with you always,"—the Son of God—the Christ. Only within can we find him. His name is, "I Am." The highest

thought we can have is our highest concept And this Great Thought has its of God. greatest power over us, when we find this God within. For then we awake to the consciousness of who and what we are. We become Omnipotent to the degree of our realization of our Divinity,—exactly as Moses did. For he is our type.

Elijah's power, well nigh omnipotent in its notency in the application of the 450

potency, in the annihilation of the 450 prophets of Baal and the 400 prophets of Astarte, by one herculean effort, is only a symbolic portrayal of my own power to destroy sensuality from my heart, when it seems to have gotten uppermost in my consciousness. Baal and Astarte are the Sex Gods. When these dominate me, I am worshipping them, and in a hopeless case, until Elijah arises within me. For "Elijah" (EL-JH-U) means, My God is "I Am." Therefore when I awake to the consciousness that "I Am is my God," then I am Elijah, and can bring about the test, who has the supreme right and power, these miserable gods of sensuality or the Divine Man, "I AM." So I am able to demonstrate my So I am able to demonstrate my power, and by one fell swoop "clean out the Augean stables"—purify my heart of sensuality, through the understanding—shall I say it?—that I am God ("My God is I AM"). Oh, yes! if we could only get rid of that old inconsistent, childish idea of a limited, personal God; and find the Omnipotent One within, we would have no trouble in demonstrating Holiness, Wholeness, Health. But knowing this, we are "Elijah" and can thwart the foul designs of "Jezebel that wicked woman"—the Carnal Consciousness. For the Kingdom of Israel is my king-I am always the King, ruling righteously or unrighteously, and taking the consequences.

Shall we say that all of God is within? Not by any means. For back of my own "I Am" is the Great, Eternal "I AM that I AM." These are not identical. As the words indicate, there is a marked difference between For the Hebrew word for "I Am" them. For the Hebrew word for "I Am" is "JHVH," and the word for "I Am that I Am" is "AHJH," a different word, the rootword, from which "JHVH" is derived. Thus it appears, that back of my "I Am" is the Great, Original, Underived, "I AM that I AM,"—the Being of my Being,—the Being of All Beings,—the ALL-BEING, from whom I am derived, by whom I am All "I Am's" I am derived, by whom I am. All "I Am's" exist by reason of "I AM that I AM," the All-Embracing ONE. One is the Father, the other the Son. Only through the Son (Am") can I know the Father ("I Am that I Am"). "He that hath seen Me, hath seen the Father also." He that knows God in the Father also." He that knows God in "I Am," knows "I AM that I AM." The way to the Father is always through the Mediator, the Son. "I AM the Way."

Thus the God whom I know is the Christ, the Mediator; yet knowing him, I touch and know the All-Conquering ONE. "I and the Father are ONE." O but man needs to awaken to the consciousness of who and what he is! When he knows that the om-nipotent ONE is within, and that he is inseparable from that ONE, he will begin to awake and arise, glad in the consciousness

of his holiness and power.

The great lesson to be learned by the "Burning Bush" and the "Elijah" allegories the actual Omnipotence of Man, when

is the actual Omnipotence of Man, when thinking and speaking from the consciousness of "I Am,"—when recognizing, and identifying himself with, Divinity within. Finding this "I AM," you find the CHRIST, the "Only Begotten of the Father."

"I Am" is the local; "I Am that I Am" is the Universal. Yet "I Am" is at-one with the Universal—identifies himself with the Universal. "I Am" is able to draw on the whole fountain of the Universal. He "takes of the water freely." The Great Fountain is not local; it is Universal. Thus at will, and through the exercise of my will, when and through the exercise of my will, when

realizing Divinity within, I may freely draw on the inexhaustible supplies of All Good, Life, Love, Truth and Power. If it is possible for me to come into the consciousness of "I Am"—the Christ Consciousness,—then I shall be able to say, "All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth." But, not until I reach that Consciousness. Note the dynamic power of this great word, when spoken with the full realization of its mean-When the officers came to ing and power. ing and power. When the officers came to arrest Jesus in Gethsemane, he asked them, "Whom seek ye?" They answered, "Jesus of Nazareth." Then "Jesus said unto them, I AM." And "they fell backward to the ground," discomfited and powerless before that mighty Word, "I AM."—Jn. 18:5.

Manifestly the way to overcome imperfections of vision or of hearing is to realize your own Divinity. The way to overcome your own Divinity. The way to overcome any imperfection or limitation is to realize

who you are.

These are Spiritual thoughts we are now uttering,-putting into intellectual formula our Spiritual conceptions. The same Law which has brought your error thoughts into undesirable expression will be now available to bring into harmonious expression these Spiritual thoughts. If you know yourself to be a Son of God, you will find, that "The Law of the Lord is perfect, converting the soul"-that is, restoring your consciousness from its low estate of sin, corruption, disease and death, to that of Holiness, Purity, Health and Life.

Through the courtesy of one of our best loved friends, we have before us a copy of the May number of Christian, a monthly journal of religious science, published by Thos. J. Shelton, 1657 Clarkson street, Denver, Colorado. We have read the paper with a great deal of interest, and, we must add, with not a little curiosity. Some of Mr. Shelton's teachings are strange to us, possibly because we do not understand them, but he asserts a strong belief in individuality, and ranks among the most original of writers.
