The coming of Spring is always a miracle—even in California, where some people say we have no change of season! To discover the new shoots coming out of the ground, and the tender little green buds appearing on the erstwhile bare branches of bushes and trees, is to become aware of a divine pageant annually performed before our eyes, revealing the wonder of the renewing principle of Life. THE PRAYER THAT NEVER FAILS

There is a kind of prayer that never fails. Any one can use it. If you are unhappy or disappointed, or oppressed or aggrieved. If you are bothered with illness or failure or discouragement, you can find relief by using THE PRAYER THAT NEVER FAILS.

There is no reason on earth why any one's life should contain dreary things. Success and happiness are the natural condition of mankind.

You say you lost your job, your sweetheart, your health? Well, what of it! Lots of people have, and they found happiness. Of course you feel awful. But you don't have to continue that way.

It isn't what happens to you that matters so much. It is how you react to the external pressures that counts.

Don't waste time trying to make things unhappy. Thousands attempt it and fail. It can not be done.

THE PRAYER THAT NEVER FAILS operates upon a law or principle that says, "If you would change your environment, your conditions, your expression of health, you must first change your habits of thinking."

All changes begin within the mind of man and, until you have tried THE PRAYER THAT NEVER

FAILS, until you have tested it out, you have no right to say it will not do the work.

I know hundreds of people, literally hundreds of them, who have changed almost everything about their lives within a year, by using THE PRAYER THAT NEVER FAILS.

What is this prayer? It was given by Jesus to His disciples when He was teaching them about the Power of Faith. In one sentence the Master gave them the whole principle of scientific prayer.

Here is what He said:

"Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them and ye shall have them."

This is THE PRAYER THAT NEVER FAILS. Let's analyze it. It contains four distinct steps, viz:

1. "What things soever ye desire," began Jesus in this talk about prayer, that is, Jesus puts **desire** as the first step in prayer,—**active desire**, not just wish-thinking and not the kind of weak complaint that wishes it were free from unpleasant conditions.

2. "When ye pray," when you turn your desires over to God to be fulfilled.

3. "Believe that ye receive them." This step is absolutely essential to answered prayer. Believe that you are even now receiving what you have asked for, even though you can see no signs of its coming. Paul spoke of this step in THE PRAYER THAT NEVER FAILS in his Epistle to

the Hebrews, 11:1, "Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen." This is Faith, **the feeling that your desired conditions are already present.**

4. "Ye shall have them." In the fourth step you walk right out in this complete faith, which you are feeling, and you act "as if" the things you desire are already yours. If you have kept complete faith toward the object of your prayer, you are now ready for fulfillment of the promise "ye shall have them" with which Jesus closed His lesson on prayer.

If it is health you want, start right now acting as if all health were yours. This is hard to do sometimes, but something happens when you do it. If it is love, start giving more love to everyone you meet. If it is a job, start preparing for it.

When you pray let your desire be so intense that it brings to the focal point of your thought an image of the ideal condition.

We all think too much about what we do not want. How much time do any of us devote toward thinking creatively about what we do want?

So begin to think now of the things you do want to instate in your life. Take my word for it, positive things will soon begin to happen.

God does not favor one man over another. He is absolutely impartial. We receive our favors from this universe in accordance to our choosing.

If you were calling upon Principle to operate the law of growing seeds, baking biscuits, of electricity, or even arithmetic, and you were not getting satisfactory results, what would you do? You would check over the rules, the recipe or the formulæ, and then carefully try again.

You know that if you forget to water certain seeds they will not grow. You know that if you leave the baking powder or yeast out of biscuits they will be hard. An amateur soon learns that he cannot "fool" with electricity. You could stand in front of the blackboard and pray from now until doomsday for two and two be five, but they never will.

And so it is with THE PRAYER THAT NEVER FAILS. If you are not getting results, check over the four rules again and try it once more. Go into each day's work with the idea that something good is coming, say to yourself:

"I know this perfect condition is on the way to me. I'm opening up every channel for it. I am doing everything I can to bring it about.

"I am expecting it for I know that Life will not fail me. I know that my mind is a part of the One Creative Mind. Universal Love is within me and Universal Power is around me. I know that nothing which I deeply desire can fail to materialize."

When you have completely changed your thought about, and expectancy of, what Life will

deliver to you, you will find that you yourself are changed as well as your environment.

I have seen this happen hundreds of times and I know that you will find this Law of which I have been telling you so inevitable in its action that, once having tried it, you will never again doubt what it will do for you.

This is THE PRAYER THAT NEVER FAILS. Try it, it works!
