HE IMMENSITY of what is happening in this battered old earth of ours has not yet crashed through to the daily working consciousness of Americans, and certainly not to their political leaders in Washington. ¶ Nine out of

ten Americans, and ninety out of a hundred politicians, accept in a vague and academic way that we have become embroiled with Nippon in a purely naval war in the Pacific, that to date the Nipponese have taken the lead in such fighting and scored the most gains. However, our real interest—they conceive—lies in helping England thrash Hitler's Nazis on the continent. Jewish propaganda has made this a reflex.

When we get the Hitler job done, we will collect our victorious armament and ship it westward. We will visit the same dose of conquerage on the Mikado's subjects, making them to relinquish everything they may have seized while the Hitler-thrashing was in progress.

politicians, do not see the Nipponese as becoming any major menace to the United States in the west. The Nipponese—so the assumption runs—will merely potterfuss around with their new territories in the Orient and graciously delay digging themselves into any impregnable position till Washington and London have made shambles of Berlin and Rome. Then the history of the present year will entirely reverse itself and the world go back to the same white-race ascendancy that has always maintained in both Occident and Orient.

ONE of these fine mornings, however, our complacent citizenry may awaken to the bomb-shell realization that the titanic bamboozlement of the generations has been put over on them, that the politicians of London and Washington have been asleep at an extremely dangerous switch, that history has been made during their pro-British coma that can by no means be unmade, and that the real megalomania to order the world stems not out of Berlin but out of Tokio.

They will awaken to the realization that helping battered Britain thrash their continental first cousins has been but a silly and Jewishmotivated adventure from the start. They will

see that it was connived by a clique of hateobsessed opportunists whose perspicacities are measurable with a six-inch rule.

They will suddenly perceive that Nippon has conquered, and ruthlessly supervises, practically all of Asia, and with Asia's stupendous resources at her back, is in a position to dictate conditions to the rest of the universe.

What will such a situation produce for our United States?

Awakening to Nippon's Expansions

IT MAY mean that as soon as Nippon has consolidated her gains in the Philippines, Malaya and Borneo, she will be under the military necessity of drawing the teeth of the Brit-



ish-American coalition so that her new status quo in the Orient be not upset by British and American man-power and resources concentrated against her-granted the Anglo-American alliance endures that long.

Nippon will be obliged to go into India on the southwest, and into Hawaii and Alaska on the east and north.

We have been propagandized with the notion that it was Hitler or Russia that might penetrate into India and wrest that rich province away from the British Empire. Suddenly we perceive the Mikado's troops pounding at the very doors of India-taking Borneo, pushing up the Malay peninsula to Burma, dominating Siamese Thailand and appropriating the Dutch East Indies. Britain bids fair to lose Singapore with any week that passes. That means the ejection of the white man from the Orient. Will the white man ever come back?

Not if Nippon can prevent it! And Nippon is in a decidedly strategic position to prevent it. In the face of such denouement, this squabble which the western-world Jews have with the Germans, becomes childish and silly.

But that is by no means the beginning and end of the matter for Americans . .

AWAII has already been knocked out, and can present no real menace to the Nipponese for months to come. The American Pacific fleet has suddenly and mysteriously shown itself to have no real effectiveness-perhaps because it is no longer in existence, although our wool-gathering pro-British politicos do not dare to tell us that—and the next rich prize for the Nipponese to grab and capitalize upon, is the American Territory of Alaska . . .

Alaska can be reached through the Aleutian Island chain. Kiska, the westernmost of these islands, is almost a thousand miles nearer the Mikado's capital than Pearl Harbor.

In other words, a continental invasion of the United States is very near at hand, and with it imminent just around the corner of the weeks, we see our Washington Administration brushing it all aside as though it were of no consequence merely because they had decided it so, and criminally depleting our naval resources to furnish Britain with ships, men, and guns, to shadow-box with Germans in the North Atlantic.

We do this, apparently, because our prevalent Administrative racial strain is Jewish, and the communistic Israelites care little or nothing for the Orient. They have never been able to make a living there, anyhow.

"Throw the whole Orient overboard," say they, "and concentrate on whipping Hitler because he has challenged us, and to date has been successful.'

But meanwhile the Japanese in the Orient are bringing about conditions that change the face of empires.

Our politicians are recommending to ignore all that. Nothing counts but winning the Battle of the Atlantic!

Hypothetical War Until Disillusion . .



HE AMERICAN war effort, then, is not truly a war effort. The American war effort—so-called is merely an Administrative gesture to commit the Republic to kosher designs and objectives in

such irretrievable fashion that there can be no turning back. All over the Union today, common folk are taking note of these things. The louder that the appeals for unity are sent out of Washington, the more disgruntled are the rank and file of native folk that there can be such seeming lack of integrity behind the gesture of war.

True, millions of Americans are going to camp, and thousands of "industrialists" are accepting a dollar-a-year from the Government and putting executive knees under desks in Washington, D. C.

None of it is registering overmuch with the plain masses of Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Missouri, Iowa, Nebraska, and points west.

There is something "phony" and unnatural about everything that the Administration is doing in the National Capital.

The plain Americans of the Middlewest never wanted the war in the first place, but having been served up the war, they are waiting to see what course it takes before giving it their unremitting endorsement.

To the moment, it still remains "Mr. Roosevelt's War."

He has by no means "sold" the American people on the idea that it is the vital conflict of the American Republic .

The vital conflict of the American Republic comes when the Mikado's troops land in Alaska, put it under their military rule, and start down through British Columbia to Washington, Oregon and California.

We shall probably rush troops into those areas to give them challenge. Our boys-your son and ours-shall stand against them with a paper marked "rifle" and another paper that is marked "tank."

Mr. White House Spokesman will, in that day, light up another cigarette in his eighteen-inch holder and make statements to the press that our main job is to defeat the Hitler Menace The Japanese will show him.

How we are to extricate ourselves from such political nincompoopery? That's the headache!

How Shall We Meet Them?

THESE are not remote possibilities based on racial or political propaganda. They epitomize a most realistic situation that maintains in our western ocean and on our Far



Eastern fighting front at present. We have gone to war with Nippon. Nippon has ruined Pearl Harbor and sunk the major portion of our Pacific fleet. Nippon has invaded our insular possessions, the Philippines. Nippon has thrashed our ally-Britain-in Hong Kong and Malaya. Nippon stands at this moment at the gates of the Dutch East Indies. Nippon has the Burma Road in control and pauses at the gates of India. Nippon has cut off our vital supplies of rubber and tin. Nippon is the "boss" in the Orient, and to say that we are going out there-after we have whipped one funny little man with a funny little moustache for the pleasure of the Israelites in central Europe, and drive her out of these gains and acquisitions, is to treat in absurdities.

It is Nippon we must reckon with. Hitler is an absurdity in the face of this vaster Oriental menace.

Yet instead of meeting Nippon in fair fight, we persist in following smug and provincial Britain in trying to thrash her continental enemies, and in declaring there is "nothing to" this Nipponese menace. All our concern is to eject the Fuehrer from his continental eminence. Well, we shall see!

With the Nipponese controlling our western coast, mayhap Hitler will be welcomed not as enemy but as friend! .

We have nothing to repel those Nipponese hordes, at any rate, but such "On Order" armaments as the Rooseveltians may have prescribed to the current moment.

Facts to Remember About Alaska . .



HILE Singapore is the key to the military and naval situation in the Far East, how many people know that the key to an attack on the United States is Alaska? Experts admit that if Singapore

falls, the position of the Allies in the Far East is "weak," and that following a capitulation of British and native forces, Nippon will become master of the entire Orient in a matter of days. Should such a major disaster occur in the Far East, in what direction will Japan turn?

Naturally, since war is on, they will turn toward the United States, striking again at Hawaii, but what is even more important, they will launch a large scale attack on Alaska, comparable in size and in effect to the one which has proved successful in the Philippines.

With the Hawaiian Islands and Alaska in Japanese hands, then they would attempt an invasion of the States on the West Coast, and what appalls high officers in the U.S. Army is, that so much material has been shipped to the so-called democracies that the Army would find itself in a tough spot to repel such inva-



There is an old adage that reads: "Prophets are not without honor, save in their own coun-Such a prophet was Gen. "Billy" Mitch-

ell, belatedly honored by the Congress on January 12th. In 1934 he made a prediction as follows-

"An air offensive against Japan from Alaska could be decisive. They know this full well and they know that we are preparing for it in no way whatsoever. They are misleading us with naval preparation which really will be quite secondary to air power that ultimately will decide the contest between East and West, while with the greatest secrecy they are developing long-range bombers for an attack on the United States.

What Dimond Tells Dunderheads . .



N THE same connection, General Mitchell termed Alaska the most central place in the world for aircraft, said Anthony J. Dimond, the delegate from Alaska, in the House of Representatives, Jan-

uary 12th. Mr. Dimond further stated-"It is no exaggeration that if on the fateful seventh of December last, we had in the Aleutians a power comparable to that which the late General William Mitchell so strongly urged for the region, the Japanese might never have dared to commence the conflict. And if they had dared the attack upon Pearl Harbor in any case, we could have blasted the enemy to bits" to

Just how serious-minded is the present Government in regard to the war with Japan, was revealed January 12 in a statement made by Secretary of the Navy Frank Knox who said the major efforts of the U.S. Navy are directed toward keeping sea lanes open and fighting Axis naval units in the Atlantic. He said—as have Messrs. Churchill and Roosevelt-that

Germany is the main enemy, the strategy being evidently to let Japan take over everything in the Pacific, and after the Allies have succeeded in whipping Germany, then turn around and try to wrest it back.

Japanese statesmen and military men are not fooling around with "social gains." They are out to win a war. They are playing marbles for keeps, and if the gentlemen in Washington think Pearl Harbor, the Philippines, Singapore, Burma and the Dutch East Indies constitute something of a headache, in the words of one of their kind from Tin Pan Alley, "They ain't

seen nuthin' yet!'

The Alaskan delegate, Mr. Dimond, stated that while the Congress has appropriated 140 million dollars in the last three years for air and submarine bases, and other military facilities in the Territory, none know how near they are to completion, for that is a military secret. It is, however, no military secret that warplanes -fighter planes and bombers needed for attack and defense—are being diverted to the other theaters of war, which might be used if and when Japan attacks Alaska.

BASES without warplanes are a warm invitation to any enemy to move in and take over-then use them against us. That is the Alaskan situation today, and according to Messrs. Roosevelt, Churchill and Knox, the Pacific phase of this world conflict is to be played in a minor key so that Messrs, Churchill, Roosevelt and Knox can concentrate upon blocking Hitler in Europe, Africa and the Near East. Britain seems interested only in smashing Germany on the Continent. United States can shift for herself with Japan. Alaska, then, is apparently wide open to attack by Japan, and a recent prophecy has it that Japan will seize Alaska. If General William Mitchell was right in his other predictions, then the one he made about Alaska's being the most central place in the world for basing aircraft is doubtless correct. Japan has taken cognizance of the fact, because she has astute, determined and realistic leadership

ELEGATE Dimond of Alaska pointed out that the Aleutian Islands form bases that can be used as stepping-stones in attack upon Japan, and that knowing that, the Nipponese are not going to await a Nazi defeat in Europe -which Churchill said could not come till 1943 or 1944-but will step in and seize those island stepping-stone threats, because they are fighting this war in 1942, and are very businesslike about it.

Consider those islands. Cape Prince of Wales, on the Alaskan mainland, is only 54 miles from the mainland of Siberia. The Aleutian Islands stretch out toward Japan. Attu Island, in the Aleutian group, is only 200 miles from the heavily fortified Beering Island, owned by Soviet Russia, and is only 635 miles from the most northerly island of Japan, and is approximately 1,130 miles from Tokio and its great seaport, Yokohama. From Attu Island, the other islands of the group are strung along for 720 miles to Dutch Harbor, where air and submarine bases are being constructed at the present time.

Remember, the debacle in the Far East, the appearance of Churchill before the Congress, the suggesting of Lord Beaverbrook's name for a high Government position, and the emphasis upon the protection of the British Isles, Libya, the Near East and the Mediterranean, have the most significant implications, all indicating that under the guise of international defense the program of the internationalists goes forward with gusto and enthusiasm. That program is Union Now, which is being implemented with concrete action, thereby subordinating our formerly independent Nation to the humiliating position of a colony in the British Empire

Soon the time will come when the people will awaken to the fact that it is OUR Nation which must be defended, not only against warring aggressors but from those who bore from within

Are These Britishers Honest With Us?



RE THESE British-Israelites honest with us, in getting us to go into international conflict to save their disintegrating empire? Are they even people of our own caste and breed? Back in 1931

a distinguished American—George Henry Payne—brought out a book, "England, Her Treatment of America," which laid bare the traditional British attitude toward Americans. None other than George Bernard Shaw wrote this bit of insult to Americans, as quoted by Mr. Payne from the New York Times of December 19, 1930. Little Lessons in Aquarian S



GREAT army general said to me recently: "When you get around the treaty table with other nations, only three items count. First, how big is your army? Second, how big is your navy? Third, how big is your bank

account?" He added: "The power of these is doubled as you are called to deal with Orientals." He was not trying to be cynical. He was considering international negotiations from the angle of realism and an experience that dated back to our Philippine War of '99.

The reason why that army general was talking sense lay in the fact that States are not individuals.

Any State is a hypothetical entity, precisely like a commercial corporation. It is not in existence to develop the moral or ethical attributes but to accomplish two entirely material designs: Defend the public domain from assault by rival nations, and operate a civic machinery that gets the public business done at home.

The State has no reason for existence otherwise.

THERE are groups of sentimentalists who envision the State as organized paternalism for mass humanity, doing everything from legislating against earthquakes to removing the ashes out of its cellars. When the State goes into international negotiations, they contend, it should conduct its parleypours with the transcendent moralities of the Twelve Apostles.

That would be excellent if the State were humanity's Sunday School teacher. But the State is by no means the teacher of a Sunday School.

The State is humanity's engineer and accountant. The State knows only force and expediency in treating with fellow States because they are tackling engineering and accounting problems in common. If a group of engineers came together to consider construction of the St. Lawrence Waterway, it might be a moral enhancement to the young to learn that they had opened their consultations with prayer or the reading of Lincoln's Second Inaugural. But after all, what would it have to do with the digging of a momentous ditch? Those engineers would be treating with the forces of water, the stresses of strata, the headaches of finance.

As engineers, we concede that such men should be sufficiently developed spiritually not to shoot one another if they found they could not agree on a brand of steam shovels, but their big job would be to get the canal opened and ships sailing through it.

NOW there can be such a thing as a "Christian" Commonwealth, certainly, and it can treat with other nations on a basis of probity—just as those engineers must be honest with one another if they



hope to work in concert over any length of time. But let us never lose sight of the fact that even the installation of any such system as the Christian Commonwealth is still a proposition in stern engineering. A Christian Commonwealth would not say, "I will

do all the work that needs to be done on a basis of the fifth chapter of Matthew." It would say, "I will see to it that the evolved spiritual leaders of the nation have the chance to lead. I will not suppress and distract the individual. I will not loot his bank account nor confiscate his assets. I will not permit one caste or clique in the body politic to gain an ascendancy over the majority and call the result Democracy. I will not encourage usury but will work to abolish it utterly, that no man may procure gains for which he has not labored. I will protect and secure the citizens of the Republic, insofar as I am able, from all predatory practices instigated in the name of Federal paternalism. But I will do this as fundamental in good engineering, because I recognize that that country is governed best that is governed least. In other words, I consider it my function to defend the public domain from assaults by rival nations and operate a civic machinery that gets the public business done at home. But the morality of a country is determined by the evolution and advancement of a cross-section of the whole citizenry, and that is a matter of individual attain-My function is to protect the individual in

achieving his spiritual goals by permitting him to enjoy the liberties that make such achievement possible. In my engineering capacity, I must accredit the maxim that 'the world runs itself' insofar as it is permitted to do so. All I need to do is to see that interference with the accomplishments of the individual is held to a minimum. When I have done that, I have fulfilled my mission. The individual will do the rest."

NO STATE has ever yet succeeded in legislating men and women into being "good." What we must recognize in the present predicament of America is, that the mass mind is not being allowed to express itself, the mass conscience is not being permitted to decree the Republic's destiny, the mass opinion is not being followed by those who have been made delegates to our Federal legislative bodies

In other words, the spiritual status of America is not only being ignored; it is being torpedoed, in the interest of Luciferian cliques and blocs that want to work their crackpot caprices on the whole body politic

To put it in still another fashion, the mass-mind of evolved America is not being allowed to express itself and declare what it desires for itself in the way of international enhancement. Designing blocs and cliques intrude, and by propaganda or censorship prevail upon the electorate to endorse their own vagaries. People today only petition to be themselves, to have their legislative bodies reflect their mass-opinion.

There is nothing wrong with the great majorityopinion of America; the wrong as we see it demonstrating, is the manner in which the Luciferians have found ways to put forth false claims, to make spurious representations, to employ propaganda to defeat the exercise of the great public morality

THE STATE, therefore, is executive and not philanthropic, and the fact should never be lost sight of, for a moment. If those diplomats who have the biggest navies, armies or bank accounts behind them, would seem to be most influential at the council table, it is the same thing as saying that



the firm that has the greatest aggregation of steamshovels will doubtless be the dominant firm in digging the mammoth St. Lawrence ditch.

The State is merely a machine—like a motorcar. A given automobile may transport a group of thugs, fleeing from a bank robbery, with the same precision that it carries a doctor to the bedside of a suffering baby. What has the machine to do with one or the other—as a machine? Its function is to furnish transportation to whosoever sits behind the steering-wheel. So it is the function to which we of an Aquarian Order would put this machinery of State, that counts. be encouraged in the Civil War, in order that the American Republic should be disrupted.' England has held us up to ridicule and contempt. The Rubber Bottleneck...



STUDY of strategic materials of war was made by the House Military Affairs Committee and findings embodied in House Report 982 on July 21, 1941.

There were 15 strategic materials "essential to national defense" and heading

the list was Rubber . .

Since the talk of the Nation centers around rubber, perhaps this is a good time to concentrate upon what Report No. 982 has to say

about rubber, as follows:

"Rubber is a strategic material presenting one of our most serious problems. More than 95 percent of the crude rubber used in this country comes from British Malaya, the Netherlands East Indies, and nearby islands. Military uses, mainly for tires and tubes, are requiring vastly increased amounts of this material. Since rubber most necessarily comes from the Far East, the problem of shipping is extremely The testimony before the comimportant. mittee reveals that our present shortage is primarily a result of lack of ships and in some instances refusal to carry this commodity. This cannot be too strongly stressed. It has been claimed that shipping interests prefer carrying other commodities, and do not consider rubber the most desirable cargo; but this is not the whole story. There is evidence in the record that there has been rubber available in foreign warehouses and on docks at times that independent shipping was available, but these ships could not be used because their owners did not belong to the shipping conference. There is no evidence in the record that the Maritime Commission had ever taken any steps to correct such a situation. There is further evidence that the tight situation in regard to shipping was in some way linked with the increase of shipping rates which was to take

effect in April of this year. It is entirely plausible to assume that certain shipping interests were waiting until these higher rates should

go into effect.
"The price of rubber is regulated by the international rubber cartel, composed nearly 100 percent of British and Dutch interests. There have been times during the late spring that the Rubber Reserves Company had withdrawn from the market because of the price situation and in at least one of the months consumption of rubber was considerably above importation. This may have been due to speculation, or to heavy buying by private industry. The Rubber Reserves Company has had under advisement for some time, the purchase of all rubber coming into this country under its auspices, and recently put such a plan into effect. The Rubber Reserves Company, under this order, is now the purchasing agent for all crude rubber entering this country, and under the regulations as promulgated by the Office of Production Management will soon be rationing this

commodity to private industry.



Up in Michigan many automobile workers were making wages ranging from forty dollars a week up to as high as 200 dollars for the skilled workman. Consider the plight of those workers when the first payment of their 1941 income tax comes due on March 15, 1942. Most of them have lived right up to their income, which is an old American custom Some motor car factories have been turning over partially to national defense work, but those factories which were making automobiles cannot be re-tooled for national defense work for many months, for the very reason that all the Nation's tool makers are now being pushed to their utmost to deliver tools needed in national defense industries. Reports from workers in tool rooms tell a story that raises the hair on one's head. They report they are being driven to the breaking point.
