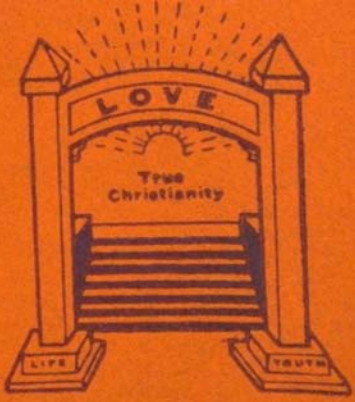

LIFE OF ELIZABETH DELVINE KING AND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE UNIVERSAL CHURCH OF THE NEW AGE

The life of Elizabeth Delvine King from the year 1907 to the time of her passing, August 5, 1932, was filled with events of so great importance to the establishment of the Message of the New Age, and the "Kingdom of God" by the Living Messiah, Jesus Christ, that there would not be space nor benefit from the review of her early life except to mention that as a child she showed signs of a spiritual trend and leaning toward Truth, which fore-shadowed somewhat the depth of her Spiritual Illumination and Enlightenment.

Elizabeth Delvine King was born in Flemingsburg, Fleming County, Kentucky, October 22, 1858, the daughter of Stephen P. Biddle and Evaline Ross Biddle. Her mother passed away when she was quite young, and her father, shortly thereafter, moved to Illinois, where Mrs. King spent her childhood.

Mrs. King is survived by her son, Orice Holman King, who has co-operated with, and assisted her, in the giving forth of this Message of the New Age, the publication of her writings, and the establishment of Church Truth Universal—Aum.

Before receiving the Baptism of the Holy Ghost in Los Angeles, in 1907, Mrs. King had for some years been a teacher of Truth. She studied Christian Science, and for a time was a Practitioner. It was not for her, however, to remain fixed in any one of the more advanced teachings; but her call was to move forward on the Path, and to this call she responded at each mile-post, or turn in the road, on her spiritual journey.

Prior to 1907, and during the course of her studies of Absolute Truth, Mrs. King took a course of instruction from George Edwin Burnell, whose teachings she always appreciated and respected.

In 1907, the great change of her life came, when, in response to an inner leading, she became interested in the nature and significance of healing, and other spiritual work of those who were reported to have received the Baptism of the Holy Ghost. Her interest lead her to attend certain Pentecostal

meetings and services, wherein prayers were voiced for this Baptism of the Spirit. Her investigations convinced her that these sincere people were endued with a touch and power from the Divine Source, and this inspired her to have prayers voiced for her own Spiritual Baptism. For this purpose, she attended meetings at what was known then as the Azusa Mission, on Azusa Street, Los Angeles, California; and prayers were voiced for her by those who had already been baptized and infilled with the Holy Ghost. These prayers were voiced there; and she also prayed at home. She continued earnestly; and, after receiving a deep lesson by Aum-Jehovah himself that this is a gift from Him in answer to prayer, she conformed to the simple childlike Prayer, as shown her by the Father in this Revelation, in response to which she was given a deep anointing of the Holy Ghost.

With the door to the Spirit thus opened, Mrs. King began to receive, by direct Revelation, Spiritual teaching from the Father Aum-Jehovah, and from Jesus Christ, who revealed to her that it was her call and privilege, because of her service to humanity in past births (and more particularly her birth in Jerusalem in which she was a close worker with Jesus of Nazareth) to take up the thread of Spiritual work in this birth, to become a true Prophet of God, and be of great service to the Messiah in laying the foundation for the presentation to the world of the Spiritual Message of the New Age.

Mrs. King responded to the call, as presented to her in these Revelations, and since that time has labored under the directions of Jesus Christ, the Messiah, and the God-conscious Masters in the Great White Brotherhood, with whom Jesus Christ, the Messiah, later brought her in contact, as a necessary step in traveling the Spiritual Path as a high Initiate, which Jesus Christ pointed out was before her.

Through these Revelations, Mrs. King became aware that the Message she was called to bring forth was a very exalted one, and that much preparation as an Initiate in the Spiritual Brotherhood of God-Conscious Masters would be necessary to qualify her for her task. Early in these deep Spiritual teachings, she learned that severe tests, and great Renunciation, were before her. As she was alone on this difficult Path, it was not traveled without mistakes; but with the Light of

Absolute Truth and her high calling ever before her, she did not fail Aum-Jehovah, the Father, nor Jesus Christ, the Messiah, nor the Masters, who, under the direction of Jesus Christ, labored with her for many years, giving her deep instruction, assisting her in her Renunciation; and who have guided her continually in the establishment of this Church and Message.

Mrs. King received the Baptism of the Holy Ghost, May 15, 1907. In that year, and after Aum-Jehovah by direct Revelation had begun to lead, guide, and direct her, she was called into semi-retirement to prepare for the Spiritual work before her, and become attuned for the writing of the manuscripts for the books which she later published. For seven years she was in this semi-retirement. The first four years were spent in her residence in a bungalow at 1267 West 39th Street, Los Angeles, California. In 1910, from January to October, nine months were spent by Mrs. King and her son at La Crescenta, during which time she was in charge of the La Crescenta Hotel. From December, 1911, to June, 1913, Mrs. King and her son lived in a cottage at 912 Strand, Manhattan Beach, California; and the last year of her semi-retirement was spent at 927 West 36th Place, her home, which is now the Church Home of Church Truth Universal—Aum.

In 1906 Mrs. King became a student of Baba Bharati of India, then teaching in Los Angeles. He was a great devotee of the "Lord of Love," Krishna, who lived in India about five thousand years ago. The "Baba," as he was called, was a high cast Hindu of a wealthy family, but he had renounced all, and studied under an "Illumined Guru." After years of life as a strict devotee on the Bhakti Path, he was called by his "Krishna" to come to America. He had no money, but his Lord was guiding the matter, and at the time of his call to bring a new spirit of Devotion to America, a wealthy Hindu in another part of India was inspired to take him a large sum of gold. With this he made the trip.

By a divine leading the "Baba" took a plate of hammered gold and brass to Krishna's Juggernaut Temple in India, where it rested on the altar for three days. He was then directed as he said, by revelation from Krishna to take the plate with him to America, and he would then be shown the person in this country to whom he was to give it. After Mrs. King had become his student, he was lead to give her

the plate and tell her its history. She did not then know for what it was to be used, but it is now used in the Holy Communion Service of Church Truth Universal—Aum, under instructions from one of the Masters relative to the manner of conducting the Communion Service in the New Age, written down by Mrs. King on January 2, 1925, from which we quote:

"The plate of hammered gold and brass which has rested on the Shrine of the Juggernaut Temple, which is on the bank of the sacred river Ganges in India, is to be placed upon the Altar with the Chalice. The Chalice is the sacred vessel for the Communion Water; and the plate is to be used for the Holy Bread, (to be unleavened, which means that by the Power Divine, which responds to Prayer, the leaven of carnality is consumed, leaving the symbol of Spirit in the vibration of Spirit)."

This great Hindu teacher, radiating the Krishna Love, had a great influence on the Spiritual Life and work of Mrs. King, and while much of his teaching was not clear to her at the time she received it, she came more and more, in the course of her Devotional Work under the Masters, to appreciate and often mention the depth and universality of his great love.

In the year 1909, it was revealed to Mrs. King that the La Crescenta Valley was a sacred valley; and it was the desire of the Messiah that she purchase the hotel there known as The La Crescenta Hotel. A number of revelations were given to her as to the desirability of acquiring this property and living in the valley. Efforts were made by her but the purchase could not be arranged. However, arrangements were made whereby she leased the hotel and was there from January to October, 1910, about nine months. She first heard of the valley through Revelations from Jesus Christ, and, after investigation and location of the valley, she visited the place, spending the night at The La Crescenta Hotel of which she afterwards had charge. That night the Messiah again revealed his Presence and advised her that He desired her to establish a residence in the valley because later on a Spiritual work, under his direction, and with which she would be connected, would be established there. Either at that time or later, it was shown her by these Revelations that this valley had been made Holy, Mystic, and Sacred by there

having been established there by an ancient civilization, temples and monasteries, and that the very ground was Holy. Also, that it was in this valley that work would be done under the Messiah and by Him, which would bring about the spreading of the Light of Truth in this New Day, and that much of the Messiah's work would be done there in the establishment of the Kingdom of Heaven, as prophesied by many prophets.

It was in response to these Divine leadings that Mrs. King and her son made arrangements to take charge of this hotel in the year 1910. At that time there was no transportation except a stage, conducted under her supervision. Conditions in the conduct of the hotel became adverse, and in October 1910, Mrs. King and Orice H. King returned to Los Angeles and lived at 1267 West 39th Street, their former home, until they moved to the cottage at Manhattan Beach in December 1911.

After the return from La Crescenta, and in the month of April 1911, Mrs. King was stopping at the San Diego Hotel in San Diego, at which time deep Revelations came to her in accordance with which the group meetings were started. She was called to set apart one evening a week for deep "Inner Work." This call came April 18th. At the same place, Mrs. King was called by Jesus Christ, through the Holy Ghost, to keep a record of events relative to the establishment of this work, and to preserve the manuscripts containing the instructions. She was then advised that this record would later be published, widely read, and much sought after; also, that some of the books she would write would be printed in other languages. On that date she was called by Jesus Christ to start a Truth Center at Santa Monica, California. She did this in the fall of 1911, the Center was at 1223 Second Street, Santa Monica, and was known as "Practical Christianity Center."

On April 24, 1911, at San Diego, Jesus revealed that a group of "Ancient Ones" had been chosen to assist her in her Spiritual Ministry, and that she would now begin to gather those who would work with her in that Ministry.

On Tuesday evening, April 25, 1911, at San Diego Mrs. King received a Revelation, coming from one of the Great Spiritual Lights of this Planetary System, who later

inspired the complete text of the Flashlights of Truth, by Revelation, that on the next Tuesday evening, May 2, 1911, at the cottage at 1267 West 39th Street, Los Angeles, the third member would be initiated into the Inner Group (the second being her son). This same Great Intelligence at that time revealed that He had been sent by Jesus Christ to inspire "this scribe" (referring to Mrs. King) and that she would write some wonderful things. The manuscripts later received from this source, during her semi-retirement, now appear in book form in the Flashlights of Truth.

At this time, Prayer over a handkerchief for healing was introduced; also instructions were given for the "anointing with oil," which had been prayed over for healing. This was used by the one later to be taken in as the third Initiate, and her serious ailment was completely healed.

In December, 1911, for the purpose of entering more deeply into the retirement to which she was called, and especially that she might become prepared for writing the deep manuscript mentioned from time to time in these Revelations, particularly on the evening of April 25, 1911, in San Diego, Mrs. King and her son moved to a cottage at 912 Strand, Manhattan Beach, California, and remained there until about June, 1913. At this cottage, much deep work took place. It was there, in 1913, that the manuscripts for the Flashlights of Truth were commenced, and they were not completed until some time in 1915, on her return to Los Angeles.

Mrs. King's first distinct call for healing work was given to her by Jesus Christ on December 30, 1913, record of which is in a manuscript bearing that date.

In the year 1916, many important events occurred marking the more definite beginnings of the "Outer Work" in the establishment of the Message.

On February 22, 1916, Mrs. King was called for the first time to give instructions concerning "Aum" as a mantram, and a manuscript bearing this date makes special mention of Mrs. King as being a recognized member of, and co-worker with, the White Brotherhood.

From July to November, 1916, Mrs. King was given three deep Inner Initiations following certain outer Initia-

tions in the Brotherhood, one on November 23, 1915, and the next on April 8, 1916.

On April 21, 1916, at 927 West 36th Place, Los Angeles, to which home Mrs. King and her son had moved in June or July, 1913, she became, by the appointment of one of the Masters in the White Brotherhood, an independent worker, teacher, and healer under the White Brotherhood. A record of these dates is preserved in a manuscript which is a Revelation from Jesus Christ, written down by Mrs. King, and bearing the date of May 9, 1916, at which time she was first called to announce openly her connection with the White Brotherhood. At that time the home in which she was living at 927 West 36th Place, and the present Church Home, was stated in the manuscript to be a "Home of the Brotherhood." In this manuscript, the "Flashlights of Truth" is referred to as a very important book to be published.

In about the month of January, 1917, the manuscripts for "The Lotus Path" were written, under and in the vibration of one of the Masters in the White Brotherhood, who was specially appointed by Jesus Christ to work with, and bring about the integration of, the Group which then was, and now is, known to the Brotherhood as the "Jerusalem Group." This Master and Mrs. King were specially appointed by Jesus Christ (probably in the year 1916) to work together (she on this plane and he from the plane of the Fourth Dimension) to prepare a Group through and with which the Messiah and the Brotherhood might work to lay a substantial foundation for this Universal Church, and the giving forth of the Message of the New Age, as the Absolute Truth which will set man Free. Through their joint labors, this Divine Message of Wisdom and Devotion has been brought into outer expression.

"The Lotus Path" was published March 31, 1917, and copyrighted April 9, 1917.

On February 26, 1918, "The Higher Metaphysics" was published, and it was copyrighted April 6, 1918. This book consisting of sixteen lessons (the same Master giving it who gave "The Lotus Path") was presented to enable the student to pass from the mental or intellectual perception and practice of the working hypothesis of the Reality into the Spiritual or Esoteric practice.

In May, 1918, the little booklet "Aum, the Cosmic Silence" was published and copyrighted. This was a direct Revelation, through the Holy Ghost, from the Cosmic Spirit, Aum, and it was dedicated to all Divine Mystics; for, to understand its contents and source, one must be a Mystic.

In June, 1918, the booklet, "Sayings of Jehovah," also written down by Mrs. King a short time before publication, was published and copyrighted. In the preface it is stated that the book came through from Jehovah, speaking through the Holy Ghost within Mrs. King, who had received the New Birth about ten years before. This message from Aum-Jehovah to the children of earth and the chosen instrument to bring it forth, is a vital one to every individual living on this planet in this New Age. It will give Spiritual Light, comfort, and Peace to many who are awakening during these changing conditions from the old order to the new.

The manuscripts received by Mrs. King at the Manhattan Beach Cottage, and in her last home in Los Angeles, referred to in *The Lotus Path*, and by the Masters, from time to time, as the "Greater Book," were edited and published under the title "The Flashlights of Truth." Referring to the two books, this and *The Lotus Path*, it is stated in the introduction to *The Lotus Path*: "This book covers the main points of the Message of Truth Absolute; therefore is a text book to be used in connection with the Greater Book, which is to be published. This message is to assist those who are at the place upon the Path where they can hear the deep Truth."

Faithful to the Divine Call, and after considerable difficulty in arranging the necessary funds, on December 12, 1918, this "Greater Book" or "The Flashlights of Truth" was published by Mrs. King as a book of 564 pages. It contains the "Inspired" writings which, as early as April 25, 1911, it was revealed to her she would receive. It was given wholly from the Divine Source, or, Scientifically, from the Fourth Dimension. In the introduction we read: "We, the Spirit of Aum, and this writer, Yotis (the inner name of Mrs. King's Atman or Divine Self), invite all brothers of all races, colors, and nationalities to glean these Flashlights, given at the beginning of this New Age, and walk in that Light, guided by the Light into the Reconstruction period of these days."

observed by the Church. The next year, 1928, this Sacred Day was established for the Sunday between Christmas Day and New Year's Day, and occurred December 30, 1928, and became known as Christ Sunday, or Christ Day; and since that time has been observed by the Church as one of the most sacred days of the year.

In January, 1928, the Church School, held on Sundays, was established as one of the branches of the Church work.

In December, 1928, there was inaugurated at the call of the Masters, a Sunday Evening Healing Service, at 7:30, Prayers being voiced in answer to calls for healing from those present, or those absent and confined to their home. These first Healing Services were conducted by Mrs. King.

Christ Day was observed Sunday, December 29, 1929, by morning and evening services, at 927 West 36th Place, Los Angeles. At 6:00 p. m., Mrs. King was given a deep initiation.

On December 17, 1929, Mrs. King received the call from Aum-Jehovah, through the Holy Ghost, for the La Crescenta Unit of the Church. She took steps to secure the right place for this unit, and on May 19, 1930, the first donation to a fund for the purpose was made by an Initiate.

On Sunday, May 25, 1930, several of the Ministers of the Church accompanied Mrs. King to La Crescenta to look over, and consider, a lot facing Foothill Boulevard at Highway Highlands, owned by Mrs. King and her son; and on Wednesday, May 28, 1930, one of the Masters in the White Brotherhood revealed in a manuscript, now preserved, that this was the site desired by the Brotherhood, and that, when established, this Unit or Branch would be used much by the Initiates for the deep Inner Work.

Arrangements were, therefor, made; and the construction of the building (now the two story Aum Center building at 3612 Foothill Boulevard) was supervised by Mrs. King under the guidance of the Masters. About October 1, 1930, the building was completed, and early in the same month, it was dedicated as the "Aum Center," the first branch Unit of Church Truth Universal—Aum. Since that time, regular public Sunday afternoon Services have been held there, and most of them were presided over by Mrs. King.

The Christ Day Services on Sunday, December 28, 1930

were held for the first time at the Aum Center in La Crescenta Valley.

In March, 1931, at the call of the Masters in the White Brotherhood, the outer teaching, which before this had generally been termed, "Esoteric Christianity," was given the name "True Christianity"; and signs bearing this name were placed in front of the Church Home in Los Angeles, and the Aum Center in La Crescenta Valley. This name was used much by Mrs. King in her presentation of the teachings of Jesus, and will be similarly used in designating the nature of the Message of the New Age.

Mrs. King was taken very ill and removed to the hospital on April 29, 1931, but was brought back to her home a few days thereafter, and on May 6, 1931, had in part resumed her work in the Church and for the Brotherhood. Her healing was most remarkable, and she always gave credit for this healing to Aum-Jehovah in response to the prayers of the Initiates.

As a part of the work of giving forth the Message, two different studios were at times maintained in the down-town district of Los Angeles, commencing April, 1928. The last location, in which considerable work was done by Mrs. King in the down-town district was at the Hall in the Phillips Building, conducted by Edna M. Phillips, and for several months Mrs. King there conducted regular Thursday afternoon meetings; and these were continued for some time after this serious illness. Mrs. King devotedly took charge of these later meetings. Miss Phillips caused a beautiful banner, with the letters AUM in gold against a dark blue background to be hung in the Hall during the continuance of these services.

In September, 1931, The Greeting Messenger—Aum, edited by Mrs. King, theretofore multigraphed, appeared in print and thereafter was published as a copyrighted first class magazine, containing articles by Mrs. King and the other Ministers, the New Age songs used in the Church Services, and portions of manuscripts from the Masters, written down by Mrs. King, through the Holy Ghost.

The Sunday between Christmas Day and New Year's Day, December 27, 1931, was observed as usual as Christ Day at the La Crescenta Aum Center with Mrs. King in charge.

The next important day, and the first special holy Easter day, to be observed by the Church was Easter Sunday, March 27, 1932, called by the Church, "Ascension Day." This was the first time this Sacred Day was observed as one of the sacred and vital days of the year. These services were held at the La Crescenta Unit, commencing with a Sunrise Devotional Service, with Mrs. King in charge; and through her lips, by Revelation, deep and vital instruction was given to the Initiates.

The day will hereafter be observed as "Ascension Day."

In May, 1932, the call came from the White Brotherhood for the building of an additional story at the Aum Center for the deep Inner Work of the Initiates, and this was by the Brotherhood, given the name of "Christian Ashrama."

Mrs. King took charge of the work of construction, which was commenced June 11th and completed August 3, 1932. She took part in the dedication service held about July 31, 1932. She looked after the moving of the furnishings for the Ashrama on August 3rd, and it was then ready for occupancy.

Although taken seriously ill, on the morning of October 4th, she recovered sufficiently to accompany a few of the Initiates to the La Crescenta Aum Center, where it was her custom to spend Thursdays in deep Inner Work. After arriving, however, she again became very ill, declined rapidly and, although returned to her home in Los Angeles that she might be better cared for, passed away, peacefully, at 12:30 o'clock a. m., August 5, 1932.

Elizabeth Delvine King was called by the Messiah, Jesus Christ, to stand positive in her Ministry against all opposition and persecution. Much persecution came because she stood firmly for "Aum" as the Great Foundation-stone of this Message. She filled a most difficult place, loyally and well. Many times, as all the Initiates know, Jesus Christ and the Masters in the White Brotherhood expressed to her, and to them, their Gratitude and Appreciation for her unwavering devotion and consecration to the Message, the Church of the New Age and her Healing and Teaching Ministry. Even during the last years, when her condition of health made the work most difficult and trying, she continued with unbroken Spirit to carry on the Ministry and

meet every requirement of a most active and busy Spiritual Life, thus earning the deep and lasting Appreciation of Jesus Christ and the Masters, who have proclaimed in gratitude, "Well Done, thou good and faithful servant." Each of the loyal Initiates, remaining to carry on this Ministry, also in Gratitude to her for her great service to them, joins in heartfelt expression of similar Appreciation and Praise.

May the Peace and Blessings of Aum-Kali, The Divine Mother, Aum-Jehovah, The Elohim, Jesus Christ, the Messiah, The Holy Ghost, and the Masters in White Brotherhood ever abide with our Brother Yotis, known in this birth as Elizabeth Delvine King. Aum tat sat, Aum.

CHURCH TRUTH UNIVERSAL—AUM

Instruction and Ministry

Church Truth Universal—Aum is a spiritual institution, established according to Divine Revelation through the Holy Ghost, under the directions of the Masters in the Great White Brotherhood, of which Jesus Christ is active head. The Spiritual Instruction, carried on by Reverend Elizabeth Delvine King from the time of the establishment of the church, and long prior thereto, is now being given by Dr. E. W. Miller, one of the Ordained Ministers of the Church, and whose ordination, by and under the directions of the Masters in the White Brotherhood, took place December 19, 1926.

Spiritual Instruction is open to those who sincerely seek the Light concerning "The Message of the New Age," Absolute Truth—Aum, as the foundation of this Spiritual Message, Spiritual Healing, and Immortality, full and complete, or Redemption in body, mind, soul and spirit.

THE LORD'S UNIVERSAL PRAYER

AUM—*Delivered Us From Evil*

In Aum and Aum's expressions (Paradise or the Perfect World—The Kingdom) there is no evil, for they are of the Higher or Fourth Dimension, while evil exists only in the third dimension or relativity.
