It has been said that "more people have died from over-eating than from starvation," which may be true, one thing however, is absolutely true—that none of the vital organs are more abused than the stomach, which is treated worse than a slave; work, work, work, day and night no rest, no chance for recuperation.

The heart action has a partial cessation and rest during sleep, but the digestive organs have to toil and slave incessantly in order to keep up with an abnormal and unsatisfiable appetite, is it any wonder then that these organs from sheer exhaustion sometimes refuse to perform their duty, and even at times reject and expell ill-selected food, indeed it often lookslike the stomach was wiser than the bran, and in order to capthe climax or perhaps to show the superiority of the brain over the stomach under such conditions, a quantity of poisonous medicine is dumped into this catch-all, and then more food is forced down and at prescribed intervals more drugs, more something else, until the stomach gets too weak to raise an objection to the superior brain, and simply submits to the inevitable like a slave der the lash. It is this tired and weakened condition the catarrhal microbe is laving for, watching for an opportunity to get a foothold for extension of territory; this little imperialist is a staunch believer in expansion by invasion and conquest, and delights to have his cwn way with out the formality of asking your consent, and seldom ever lowers the flag when once raised;1 3 sticks closer than a brother and never neglects his business to conquer the whole terr tory along the alimentary canal where colonies are planted under favorable conditions, with the solo view of exacting tribut in the way of life force and vitality. It is true that a warfare is steadil going on to expell this army of invading bush hawkers, and to the same degree that the allied f rces are able to cope with this terrible foe and enemy of mankind. Will you be free from catarrh. But often the war is carried right into Jericho, and by trumpet blast and shouts of victory the walls will tumble and fall, and there you are yourself transported into a new country on the evergreen shores of eternity, to the celestial city, into which Mr. Catarrhal Microbe has no passport, but is left behind to assist nature in the transmutation of matter, and to look aftre

its own posterity—and yours. Friends, what do you think of it? Would it not be advisable to rallie your own forces, to call in additional allied powers and exterminate these boxers before it is too late, or have a treaty of peace signed and executed, or have a Chinese wall built around you, that you might live in peace and security?

Digestion is a chemical process which takes place in and by the actions of the digestive organs. If a chemist does not have the proper instruments and the proper amount and quality of material, according to exact formula, the looked for result cannot be obtained. In nature's labratory when harmony is in evidence, all the different actions and re-actions are perfect and more or less automatic, but still under supervision of the chemist-just like the action of the piano player's hand which has by a constant repetition become automatic, but yet governed by the artist. These so-called involuntary actions are not as involuntary as generally supposed, for they are amenable to the same general law that governs all action.

A chemist may in his own labratory, obtain desired results, but if he should be indisposed, unable to handle thenicely adjusted instruments, then there is no reason why another chemist, perhaps with greater knowledge of the art, could not in the same labratory, with the same instruments obtain perhaps still better results, providing, however, the other chemist would lay down and not interfere, if he was not able to cooperate in the experiments. He should step to one side and let the more active operator have at least as much freedom and liberty as possible. By the way, this is the position a Healer takes under the method of suggestion, when the patient is in a hypnotic state, but bear in mind, suggestion in itself does not cureanybody; some person might stand and suggest movements of the bowels for a million of years providing the patient lived that long and have no more effect than if he, in the same length of time, should by suggestion try to stop the moon in its orbit; suggestive moonshine. Fellow students, please don't overlook the real power behind the throne; now friends, don't be alarmed if we, in a simple way, tell you a few facts regarding your long endured chronic bowel trouble; what have you done to correct this unnatural condition? Taken medicine to regulate the bowels of course; well, did they stay regulated? No indeed, when I stoped regulating, regulation stopped also; by

this fact we discover that the patient was all the time trying to regulate the effect instead of reulating or removing the cause that produced the effect, hence the regulation was not and coal not be permanent. A Healer who does not con centrate the healing force at the right point wi have the same result, and perhaps failure when medicine was relied upon for this reason In the case in question the pancreas glandwould only receive its prorata amount of healing force which perhaps was not enough in this particular lar case to restore activity and harmony in bration, hence only a partial result, but if con tinued long enough we will admit would, inmos cases, bring about a result that might have been obtained in half the time if the Healer had know the cause of the trouble and concentrated in forces at that point, assisted by a well directed effort by the patient. We must know what w are going after and then go after it in an intell gent manner. Now listen to a story told us by a physician a few days ago: "A patient had bowel trouble and on exhibiting symptoms colic and cramps a large quantity of medicin with a high-sounding name was prepared an taken with the customary result, patient go well, but a friend got sick with the same trouble and the same medicine was given without all result whatever; the patient thought he was g ing to die; the same doctor was called in; some more of the same medicine (paragoric) with an other name was given; the patient at once has relief and fell into a sound sleep and awoke

Principles of Astrology.

NUMBER THREE.

Our second lesson in June number, explained the twelve signs of the Zodiac, all of which are now represented in their regular order on the backcover. We will now consider the twelve mundane houses. They are divisions of the apparent daily path of the sun and planets, around tye earth, and are numbered in order from one to twelve. An observer at a given place on the earth, looking to the Heavens, has three prominent sections before him; if he looks east or to the place where he first sees the sun in the morning, he sees the eastern horizon; looking west, to a point directly opposite, he sees the western horizon. The eastern horizon is the point, where, either, sun moon, planet or fixed star is first seen to rise, and the western horison, the place where they are last seen to set, and these two points mark the begining of the first house, or ascendant, and seventh house or decendant, called cusps. Directly overhead he sees the Zenith or Cusp of the midheaven, while under his feet and on the other side of the earth, is the Cusp of the fourth; were he facing south, to the right he sees the seventh, eighth, and nineth houses. To the left is the tenth, eleventh and twelveth. These houses are called Diurnal: itis light when the sun is in them, and they are always seen, for they are fixed in relation to the place of observation.

The number of degrees of the Zodiac seen in these houses, varies with the latitude of the place. The other six houses could not be seen from this place, but were we on the opposite side of the globe we would then see them. These twelve houses are shown in the outer circle of Uncle Sam's Horoscope.

While the planets move through the signs from Aries, in their order, as shows by the arrow. The signs move through the houses, in the reverse, from the Cusps of the first through the twelvth eleventh, tenth, nineth, eighth and seventh, or decendant, and thence through the sixth, fifth, fourth, third, second and first. With each revolution of the earth on its axes, so that every sign rises and sets once every twenty-four hours, rising from the Cusp of the fourth to the Cusp of the tenth or midheaven, then setting from this point till the Cusp of the fourth is again reached. This revolution of the signs, carries the plannets in them along, hence at a given time of the day, a planet is seen in a certain sign and house honses are divided into three classes, viz: Angular, Succeedent, and Cadent. The first tenth, fourth and third are Angular and are sometimes called Angles. The second, fifth, eighth and eleventh are succeedent, while the third, sixth, nineth and twelevth are Cadent. They have distinct degrees of power which vary in relative proportions. The first house is first in power, the tenth, second and eleventh, is third, seventh is fourth second is fifth, third is sixth, nineth is seventh, fourth is eighth. twelvth is ninth, fifth is tenth, sixth is fifteenth, eighth is twelvth, each house has signification of special things in the different department branches of the art. In studying the nativity of persons, the first house shows personal appearance, temperament and disposition. The second shows the wealth, property and liberty of the native. The third concerns brothers, sisters, neighbors, letters and writing and short journeys by rail, or wagon. The fourth shows the father, inheritance, or property, and natives condition at close of life. The fifth house governs children of the native, his pleasures and speculations. The sixth house rules the sickness of which the native is liable and shows their exact nature if any planet be therein afficting the sun or moon. The seventh house governs leve courtship and marriage, also all partnerships, financial or intellectual, and public opponents. The eighth house rules our relations with the dead, their wills and legacies, and has some significance of

the native's death if the Lord there of be anareta. The ninth house governs long journeys, voyages, etc., and has much influence over the native's religious and philosophical studies and opinions (similar to the third, but is more external.) The tenth, rules the honor, credit and business of the native, and is therefore the most important of all from an earthly standpoint. It also signifies the mother. The eleventh rules the natives friends and friendships, hopes and desires in life, the mothers wealth etc. The twelveth house governs the natives fortune in relation to enmity, sorrow and distress, secret foes and imprisonment.

UNCL SAM, S HYLEG AND PROSPCTS OF HEALTH AND LONG LIFE.

The planets in Uncle's horoscope form the following aspects: Moon is leaving Trine of Saturn, and applying to Trine of Mars. Mercury is leaving Semisextile of Mars, Semisquare of Uranus, and Trine of Neptune. Venus is applying to a conjunction of Jupiter. Sun is leaving a Semis extile of Uranus, a Quintile of Neptune, and applying to Square of Neptune. Jupiter is applying to Semisextile of Urans. Saturn is leaving Trine of Uranus.

In Astrology, the Sun and Moon are teh givers of life life, and are called the Hylegs. Ptolemy said "the Sun is the source of the vital power and the Moon the Natural power." In a male Horoscope the Sun is Hyleg when it is adove the horizen and if the Sun is not above the horizen and the Moon is adove the horizon, then the Moon and Sun rule the vitality, and such a life in force is termed Luni-Solar. determine the strength of the vital powers, we must consider the Hylegs, the tenth house, ascendant and its lord and whatever aspect are made to them, also whatever the prace of nativity be in the northern or southern hemisphere, as the time of greatest Solar energy varies in them. In the northern hemisphere, the solar force is greatest from the 21st of March to June 21st; the second from June, 21st to September; the third grade from Decemder, 21st to March 21st, and the fourth grade is from September 21st to same date in Decemder.

The signs of the Zodiac also have their influence; the fiery and airy signs form the

strongest in a male Horoscope. In the case of Uncle Sam, we have the second grade of Cosmic energy combined with the air, electric signsof Gemini in the first and Aquarius in the tenth. which give him the second grade of vitality. The moon a magnetic orb, is above the horizon in tenth house, and the Sun below the horizon. in canser. The sign of the Moon and in the first house, give him a Luni-Solar quality of The Sun and Mercury being in the Magnetic sign of Cancer, with Moon in Aquarius, gives a predominence of Magnetic forces thus giving him the Magnetic temperment, whose key:note is B, as Brother Pearson has stated: such a system is liable to give off its forces too freely and thus become weak.
