## The Nervous System.

It has been sald that "Modern man has developed into a bundle of nerves." This may in a certain sense be true, however we find this to be a fact: The higher we go up the scale of being, the more intricate and complex do we find the nervous system to be.

Our common telephone very closely resembles and is an almost perfect imitation of the human nervous system, so we may very appropriately use it as an illustration, when elucidating on this subject, and call this wonderful network of nerves the human telephone system, on which messages are flashed, from the central office at the base of the brain, on the efferent nerves to any point or part of the human organism, and back again, on the afferent nerves from the remotest station on the circuit to the cerebellum, where we find the human mind doing duty as a telephone girl, operating the switchboard, on the medulla oblongata; and at the same time tending the dynamo, the larger brain, where nerve energy is generated, and held on tap, for the vitalization process, all under the supersuperintendent (soul.) of the which is everywhere throughout the whole system looking after its working, and manifesting as life. Soul, ego, consciousness and life are synonimous: mind, the telephone girl, executes the command of the soul through the will, and makes the proper connection on the switchboard, when a message is to be sent to any particular point on the system, and receives all incoming messages, and retransmits them to conscience, the soul, after which they are acted upon by the mental faculties, and decission is rendered, and if approved by the higher tribunal, formulated into action at the base of the brain, if occasion should so demand. For instance: If repair is at any time needed along the line; or at any of the numberless outlaying stations, a message in the way of pain is at once automatically transmitted to the superintendent who sends an order for the required amount of material, to be sent to that particular point at once; quality and quantity of course depends upon the condition of labratory or workshop in which the material is extracted from the general resources, the nutritive system through the process of absorbtion delivers

this material to the red blood corpuscle, which at once transports it to the desired point, accompanied by the white blood corpuscle, who carries the necessary vital force and motive power, and the result is, a new living cell or cells have been created in place of the old worn-out ones which had to be discarded, and hauled away, and the new cells are put in proper connection with the nervous system, that they may recieve their pro rata amount of vitality or life principle.

At the present time we have no exact data as to how long a cell will live and perform its duty. It may be six months, more or less, but we do know that this process of tearing down and rebuilding is constantly going on, especially during sleep, when the greater portion of the machinery is at rest, giving nature a better chance to do repairs and new work (growth).

It is a deplorable fact that the line men (vital organs) and sometimes the workers throughout the whole system will go on a strike, which may at times even spread to the telephone girl; this strike business is often the result of an unsatirfactory dinner pail, both as to quantity and quality, and all work stops except what is absolutely necessary for self-preservation, no expansion, even the safety of imperialism, becomes a paramount question- It is under such condition when the superintendent finds himself head over heels or rather heels over head in a bedlam of discord (disease) that a mediator in the way of a powerful healer is needed, using his good office and in a diplomatic way to reestablish harmony and formulate a treaty of peace, bringing his allied forces to bear upon the strikers and revolters, supplying their present need of dynamic power until the necessary fuel for the power house can be refurnished; the healer of course never neglects the dinner pail question or hygienic home comfort, and confidence is restored, the strike is called off, all the workers return to their respective duties, machinery oiled and readjusted. Harmony, peace, prosperity and contentment (health) again reigns supreme; the incident is closed with perhaps a good lesson on life economy, which if thoroughly understood, will prevent a similar occurrence in the future. Harmony, the keynote of the whole system, should at all times be kept in evidence. Equilibrium and perfect balance in all the working departments prevent explosions, unequal distribution and consequently

discontent, strikes and disorder.

The human telephone system can be very beautifully demonstrated by an operator taking charge of one of the outermost stations, for instance the end of first finger of right hand and from there send a message to the telephone girl at the base of the brain, asking her to connect you with any station that you may desire to communicate with, which you can then successfully ring up, providing the lines are in perfect working order, and properly insulated, but if an obstruction should be present anywhere along the line, impeding the passage of the nerve forces, you may have to wait a few seconds until the nerve duct is cleared out, then you can ring up the station indicated; if you have a good subject, with a nervous system in perfect order, you may designate 100 stations and ring them all up as fast as you can count from one to 100, showing how quick the mind can do the switch ing and connect you with any part of the whole organism. This is an experiment we want the healers to study carefully, that they may be able to treat successfully any part of a duplex organ, a certain muscle or a particular number of cells or glands, by transmitting the healing force in a concentrated form, to the parts to be treated, in place of sending it throughout the whole system when the parts in question would only receive its pro rata amount of vital force, hence would take longer to obtain the same result.

We stated in a former number that we would explain how a pain is or becomes a means to a cure, and right here is just the place to do it-A pain, as we have stated, is a message sent on the afferent nerves to the mind at the lase of the brain, which the mind understands to indicate that there is semething wrong in the immediate neighborhood from whence the message came. In severe cases this message is flashed to the brain continuously all the time, and of course the brain is continuously kept in connection with this part by the mind, thinking and recognizing this pair, which wise proivsions of nature makes it possible for the mind to send immediate relief, through the vaso-moter nerves in the way of additional life force, and the necessary material in a greater flow of blood to that point, that the repair work may be done as quickly as possible. In a case of this kind a healer will find that nature has proved the

necessary conditions, hence pain is a good thing. It not only gives timely warning of approaching danger, but also gives a healer direct connection with parts to be treated, and the healer is called to treat a duplex organ when no pain is connected with it, the healer should establish the same psychological conditions as when pain is present, and thereby have direct connection with the organ or part of organ to be treated in order to have a reasonably quick result.

Right here we will take up the question of suggestion, and see how it operates, and becomes a necessary adjunct in healing. There are two methods by which a pain may be removed; one is to remove the cause which produces the pain, and the pain will stop; another method is for the healer to take control of the patient's nervous system and send a message in the shape of a suggestion of no pain from the parts affected to the brain, which a passive minp under right conditions is bound to accept as true, consequently there is no more pain, although there may because for pain. The modus operandi is simply this: The suggestion of "no pain" is transmitted in the form of sound vibrations, from the healer's to patient's care, where they are taken up by the auditor nerves and landed at the nerve centers, which are all connected by the sympathetic nerve, which brings. the suggestion to the nerve center, governing the part to which the suggestion is directed; when it reaches that point, the suggestion of "no poin" is automatically reflected back to the brain, where the mind recognizes it to be a fact, and there is no more pain, while at the same time this has been done the healing process has commenced to take place; when completed precludes the necessity of pain and the case is cured, or in other words we relieve the external effect, and at the same time remove the cause producing that effect.

This healing process, which is inevitable, and takes place unconsciously of the suggestioner, will be explained and dealt with in a future number. Now to prove that we are right in our proposition, we do by a "suggestion of pain," produce all kinds of pain anywhere in the whole system, where in fact there is no cause for a pain and is simply a false alarm but accepted by the passive mind to be true, just as a fire department will recognize a false fire alarm sent

from an outlaying alarm box, and preced the same as if a fire really existed.

The sum and substance of your suggestion in such cases is simply this: A false alarm is sent into the brain where a passive and willing mind under right conditions is ready to accept it as true. It is said if a falsehood is reported often enough it will finally be believed to be true. We may now readily see and understand that the suggestion does not really do the healing act, and all theories connected therewith fall to the ground when fully understood: we should like to explain the workings of "suggestion" in all the different cases, but space will not permit this time. #### WHO IS THE TRUE PHYSICIAN?

In order that we arrive at a more perfect understanding of "Who Is the True Physician," it will be necessary to review briefly, the various methods of curing disease.

First, we will consider the drug system.

There are a great many people who are so materialistic in their thought and belief that they will not recognize anything that does not come within the scope of the five senses.

These people must see, measure and weigh everything, or they are not inclined to admit of their existence. These are believers in the drug system of therapeutics.

There are many readers who can recall to mind the time when the old-fashioned doctor went about with saddle-bags well filled with quantities of pills, powders and liquids; or perchance he rode in a vehicle of some sort, well filled with jugs containing, as he supposed, infallible remedies, the basic principles of which was calomel, antimony and the lancet.

And the first thing in the order of his practice was to bleed the patient; and the second were a dose of calomel. If the patient had too much blood, he must bleed him; if too little, he bled him. If it was a case of smallpox or a fit of the blues, typhoid fever, the stomach ache or a bad cold, the bleeding process was strictly adhered to. What was the result? Visit the old grave yards and you will know.

Finally Homeopathy came on the stage with most radical views. You old people can remember the terrible commotion it caused in the medical camp. Oh, how they did ridicule it. One of their stock stories was that "The Homeopaths took a small vial, corked it air tight, tied it to the tail of a muskrat, caused the rat to swim across a pond, caught it again and secured the vial, and what was caught in the vial was Homeopathic medicine."

But notwithstanding all their antagonism the result has been the elevation of medical practice, until today, the progressive M. D. is not satisfied with one school of medicine, but has diplomas from three or four, perhaps, and instead of calling himself after the name of some particular school, he says, "I am a Physician." And while many of the M. Ds. have clubbed together and caused the enactment of monopoly laws, in an effort to drive out all other methods. and their advocates, the progressive physician is not in favor of such laws, but is eager for new light, new truths, in fact, any method of cure, which will relieve him from administering drugs, in which he has no faith, and from following a system of therapeutics, called a science, but which he knows is all guess-work.

Take the Journal of Suggestive Therapeutics,

published by the Psychic Research Co. of Chicago, and the various other journals of like character, and you will find that a large number of the contributors are M. Ds. who are using Magnetism, Hypnotism and Suggestion in their regular practice, and with much better success, than with drugs. There is an abundance of evidence, from these gentlemen alone, to establish the fact that Suggestion is far more potent than drugs, and has effected a cure in many cases where the drug system has been thoroughly tried and failed.

The so-called medical science has been continually making new discoveries to account for the cause of disease; and of new and (said to be) infallible remedies for its cure. But the great infallible remedy of today is discarded tomorrow. That great humbug, vaccination for smallpox, which has poisoned the blood of so many thousands with a disease far worse than the smallpox, is proven conclusively by an abundance of statistics from the most reliable sources, to be of no value as a preventative of smallpox, and that where there has been the most thorough vaccination, there has been the greatest death rate. And yet many of the M. Ds. advise it as a sure preventative, undoubtedly because a smallpox scare is very remunerative, and they love to vaccinate the dear people, at so much per head.

How do you account for the fact, that the same medicine that, taken when siek, makes you well, if taken when well would make you sick? Rather peculiar, aîn't it? But a fact nevertheless.

In spite of all the wonderful discoveries, all the advancement made by the so-called, medical science, people keep right on dying just the same. The wonderful "Elixer of Life" is yet undiscovered by them. People do just like the little girl said her kitty did, "Dest kicked up its feet and died."

Therefore I think we may cease looking for "The True Physician" here.

Next we will consider the Christian Science, or Faith cure method. The first obstruction in our path of investigation is a very serious one, fatal to the majority of investigators. And it is the declaration, "that all is mind, or spirit." Suppose you were suffering with a most violent toth ache, one of the jumping kind, when it seemed that every throb would burst your jaw!

the tears streaming down your face, and your nerves strung up to the highest tension, and a Christian Science demonstrator should tell you that it was all in your mind; you had no toothache, you only thought you had.

What sort of a thing would you look for to throw at her? Do you think your tooth would hurt you any less after being informed that it was only imagination?

I read a story, not long ago, said to be the experience of a gentleman in connection with a Christian Science demonstrator, which ran as follows: "Said the gentleman, I had a laughable experience on the train today; there were four of us in that end of the car, two ladies, a gentleman from a neighboring city, and myself. Being all middle-aged people, of a social nature, we soon drifted into conversation, when one of the ladies informed us that she was a Christian Science demonstrator. The other gentleman, who had said but little up to this time, remarked that he had an ankle which gave him considerable trouble and asked the lady if she thought she could help it any. She replied that she could undoubtedly effect a cure, but as the trouble was only in his mind, it would take sometime to eradicate the idea, and as she could not commence too soon, 'suppose I give you a treatment right now?' 'By all means,' said the gentleman. So the lady apparently went to sleep and all was quiet for perhaps ten minutes when she opened her eyes and said: 'There your ankle is better now; the trouble is going away, fast going away; in fact it is gone.' 'I am sorry to contradict you,' said the gentleman, but the truth is it is just as bad as before; it even squeaks. Just listen.' And he moved his foot, when it gave a terrible squeak, and the lady jumped to her feet, exclaiming: 'Great heavens! What ails the thing?' - The gentleman replied, 'I think it needs oiling; I forgot to mention that that limb is an artificial one. The lady straigntened herself up with all the dignity possessed by perhaps 200 pounds averdupois, and with the remark, 'Sir, I am forced to conclude that you are no gentleman,' they passed into another car. The gentleman and I laughed for an hour by the watch."

There is no question but what there are many cur, which are the result of faith, where there is no knowledge of the means used, such as by prayer; the patient is visited by friends, and prayer is suggested; the concentration of thought upon the result desired, by both patient and visitors, produces a powerful suggestion, which acts upon the mind of the patient, causing them to believe in accordance with the desire to be well, and therefore they are benefitted, perhaps cured, especially would this be the result if the patient had strong faith in prayer. Christian Science methods have benefitted thousands, and cured a great many entirely. But now and then its advocates meet with cases like or similar to the above, which subjects them to ridicule.

The one great drawback in this method of treatment is lack of a practical, tangible system, capable of demonstration. Their statements are too ambiguous for practical humanity to have faith in them; and no faith, no cure.

Osteopathy is another method demanding consideration. I have met with several graduates of this school, and conversed with their patients, and I find that some of them are quite successful in certain diseases, but cause no relief in others. This I believe to be rated according to the magnetic force possessed by the operator, and that the cures are to be credited to magnetism, massage and suggestion.

However, the percentage of cures is not sufficient to entitle them to be called "The True Physician."

Magnetic treatment is another method. This is practised by many spiritulist mediums, and by some not spiritulists. Many thousands have been cured by this treatment, after the medicine doctors had tried and failed, leaving them to die. I myself have used this method of taeatment with most wonderful success, and therefore consider it an eminently valuable system of therapeutics; but it has its disadvantages, and does not meet the requirements in all cases. Many magnetic healers possess no knowledge of the system of treatment, or of anatomy, and treat all cases alike, and are unable to tell how or why it benefits, or cures the patient.

Again, many healers take on the disease of the patient, and a serious illness follows. Others are so terribly exhausted in giving treatment that they are not able to give more than from one to three treatments a day, with good results. Others neglect their own personal health, even ordinary cleanliness, and are thus offensive to many patients, to say nothing of the impure magnetism which emanate from such a filthy source. The true magnetic healer, who by proper diet, bathing, personal habits, pure thoughts, and a moral, chaste life, fits and keeps himself or herself in a proper condition for their work, can do more good than all the others before mentioned.

Then you may ask, are these not the "True Physicians?" No. Why? Because the system does not meet all requirements.


