# SUGGESTION.

## When, How and to What Degree Suggestion Becomes an Adjunct in Healing.

DEAR READER: It is a well known fact, that when anyone promulgates a new theory, embracing some vital question, or giving a new explanation of some old theory, it is like running up against a brick wall, however, we will try the soundness of this brick wall, it may perhaps be only a shell, which will crumble before a few well directed blows, with a logical, common sense sledge hammer, we will not only knock a hole in it, but perforate the whole structure to such an extent that we may all pass through it, and take a squint at the other side; everything has two sides and if we want to correctly understand suggestive therapeutics, we must critically examine these curative suggestions together with consciousness and subconsciousness, objective and subjective mind, and get a clear, unobstructive view of the whole thing, and not take for granted what may appear on the surface, or on one side, but get at the real true facts as they really exist.

Volumes after volumes have been written on the great and interesting subject of suggestion and hypnotism consciousness and sub-consciousness, objective and subjective mind—so it will not be supposed, that we should handle every detail, or do the subject full justice in a short article of this character—however we will start in with these statements; that there is no such thing as duality of mind, that self-hypnotism is a fallacy, that the theory of consciousness and sub-consciousness or objective and subjective mind, and a lot of other meaningless terms, is erroneous—and than endeavor to prove our possessions.

If we seek to understand what man really is, we must explore the visible and invisible parts of his being, then subdivide and analyze each part in its respective realm according to phenomena presented; classify the different forces operating in each realm according to their rapid.

ity of vibration, and we may get a clear understanding of the various phenomena taking place in the hypnotic state, said to be the result of suggestion.

When we compare man the microcosm—a universe on a small scale—with macrocosm the great universe, we find a similarity in correspondent parts, we have in both the tri-une combination of the three great fundamental factors or elements, *intelligence, force and matter—soul, spirit and body*—in using the term *body*, we mean physical and spiritual body, the constituent parts of either, being matter differing only in degree of fines, or rapidity of atomic vibration; spirit then becomes only a relative term used in designating the soul's existence upon a spiritual plane in combination with a spirit-body, just the same as we use the term *man* to designate the *soul's* existence upon a physical plane in combination with a physical body.

Now, kind readers if we have in a short way established the above to be true, let us stick a pin right here and then go on.

The student will now observe that the supreme ruler of our little universe is the *soul* which permeates every part, tissue and cell of the whole, and we call it life, *soul and life* then are synonymous, just as God and universal energy which permeates every atom in the whole universe, are synonymous. The basic principle of being is very simple, but the details in their various modes of expression is very complex.

In our researches among the human complexity we find, mind, will, intellect reason, sensation, and other avenues through which the soul by the invisible forces, operates and seeks expression, in its material combination, hence these avenues or attributes, might in reality be called the agents of the soul by and through which the human organism is created, governed and constantly recreated and kept in repair. Some want us to understand, that when they use the term subjective mind, they mean the living soul—then, why not use the proper, more comprehensive term *soul*—and by the objective mind, they mean our common everyday mind, some of these subconscious fellows want us to understand that we have one common everyday consciousness, and an other consciousness somewhat better to be used only on extra occasions,

for instance on Sunday and call it sub-consciousness—why not call it Sunday consciousness—this perhaps may explain why the average Christian attempts to be so goody-goody on Sunday when they use their Sunday go-to-meeting consciousness and may be the reason why they so often indulge in a hypnotic sleep that their subjective mind may be more readily prodded up by the ministers—suggestion to seek salvation, secured by others for their convenience, then during the balance of the week they may use their common everyday consciousness and even stretch that a little if necessary.

Gentleman, it is really and in fact too great a burden to be afflicted with these two minds. The average person has all he can do to take care of, or train one mind, and we will venture the assertion, that not one person in a hundred possesses a reasonable well trained mind, that is, a person may have his mind well trained along a certain line of activity, and be very much undeveloped along other lines of action; then again the subjective people, constantly mix themselves up, that it is hard at all times to know just where they are at sometimes they have the subjective mind to represent the higher self, and be "the product of the activity of the cells of only one part of the brain, and ordinarily not under the control of the mental efforts;" then they commence guessing about some grand controlling center, or portion of brain tissue that governs the entire system of centers." This is claimed to be the basis upon which modern suggestive therapeutics rests. Also it is claimed that clinic demonstrations along the line of healing proves, that suggestion is the basis and underlies all curative systems—reader, did you catch on to the base—we admit that we haven't yet seen a base to catch onto.

The very idea of the common everyday consciousness, impressing or dictating to sub-consciousness, how to properly take care of and preserve the physical body, looks like a person taking hold of his boot straps, and lifting himself over a fence—this is what is called self hypnotism. The law governing all phenomena taking place in the hypnotic state, proves such a proposition to be false hypnotic phenomena, can only take place under, and with the co-operation



of two individual *souls*, through their attributes, *mind* and *will*, by which the magnetic force is transmitted, and its currents reversed, hypnotism is not the direct result of a stronger mind, ruling a weaker mind as is generally supposed, but it is the result of a stronger magnetic force over a weaker one by that we understand the difference in rapidity of vibrations of the two individual forces, which constitute the positive and negative.

If you can show us an individual that can produce these conditions within himself then you may talk about self hypnotism, again, to produce hypnotic phenomena we must have an operator and a subject, and inasmuch as these processes are the direct result from the operation of the invisible forces in the invisible realm of the human being it is not necessary that the operator be clothed in the visible form, and being invisible you perhaps are not always aware of his presence, and to explain self hypnotism along scientific lines it becomes necessary to explain this invisible operator out of existence by resorting to high sounding but meaningless terms, such as unconscious cerebration, subliminal self, subjective mind and subconsciousness, with conscious and subconscious memories

We admit it would be very nice if we could have two memories, so that on Sunday when using our Sunday go-to-meeting memory, we would not be bothered with our common everyday memory, especially if we had been stealing horses, or cheated our neighbor in some little business transaction during the week when we were using our common everyday conscious memory, again it is said: "A dual consciousness with separate memories can be demonstrated, namely, the primary or working consciousness, and the secondary or subconsciousness are distinct from one another by their modes of obtaining knowledge." Here we get the cart before the horse again, by giving our common everyday consciousness a primary position; and the greater of the two, which never sleeps and possesses an almost unlimited range of potentialities is styled as secondary or subconsciousness. Now, in order to straighten up this tangledupness of dual consciousness, we will

present facts as we find them in nature, which are in harmony with the correspondence existing between the microcosm, and macrocosm that we may know by starting from a true premises, that we are at least on solid ground, upon which we find *man*, the rulers of his own little universe both physical and spiritual, this supreme ruler is often called ego, soul or life principle, or as Webster has it "that which thinks," or to quote an other lexicographer: "That substantial entity believed to be that in each person which lives, feels, thinks and wills." Let us here quote an other definition of *soul*, which is a volume in a few words, so clear in style, that it will bear reading and study. Here we give it in full.

"The soul is an eternal entity—having no place in time, no discontinuity, no fatality, but a progressive, expansive consciousness arising from its combinations with matter. To suppose the soul to have a beginning in eternity would be absurd. Soul-existence is one of the problems never to be mastered by reason. That which thinks can never comprehend itself—thinking being relative to phenomena. The consciousness of dreams is a perfect consciousness, but it is distinct from a sense of consciousness. It neither reasons nor analyzes perceptions. It is immediate knowledge and consciousness—clairvoyancy. The organism in taking the impression from this consciousness does not take it all; it is therefore, distorted imagery and broken incident. Yet in itself, as a consciousness it is perfect; it receives the impression from the spiritual sphere, made up of thought vibrations. These are immediately perceived. There is judgment without thought-co-ordination. Because this is so, dreams are sometimes prophetic, and sometimes cover lost facts in personal experience."

Now, with this understanding from the above definitions of soul, how can we use the old phrase, "has man got a soul. Such a term would certainly indicate something in man above and higher than the soul, even if Paul or anybody else should put spirit above the soul, facts will not sustain such a proposition.

## THE COR-RELATION

### Constitution of the Material and Spiritual Universe.

(Continued from our last issue.)

As we have ventured to prove by the physical, that the higher or spiritual realms must be based on, and maintained by fixed immutable principals or laws, since unity of law rules in all the Universe.

Subtle realms of nature must have subtle means of investigation, and nature has endowed mankind with senses that are wonderfully adapted to this end, in her God given, divine, and marvelous process of intuition, the sublime power of psychometry, and the all penetrating eye of clairvoyance—which senses compose the 1 3 5 chord of our spiritual being. In our observations of the ethereal realms, they, who have not been made aware of the higher senses of the unfolded human mind, and have not cultivated these most precious gifts, will be poorly able to comprehend the great truths of nature that are before us. When we rightly apply these power, with the aid of comparison and analogy, our path over truths infinite fields will become clear.

Ourscientists have assumed the existence of an all pervading ether, (but only one) failing to see that there must be more than one ether; that there are many grades of ethers, of as many different degrees of refinement; and on this one ether, popular science has loaded the underlatory or wave theory of heat, light, color and electricity. If we get their meaning correctly, then we make bold our claim that there never was a more false theory put before the minds of men. However, if this one cosmic ether is what we term as infinit spirit, then there is some remote truth in the theory, but the popular conception of waves in this ether is wrong.

If color in sun-light, etc., comes from waves or vibrations of this ether then what causes the waves, and how can one ether be made to give off a certain number of waves or vibrations to the inch, for red-light, and fourteen times as

many for violet as claimed; and this at the same time? How can the sun give off waves to give the heating power of red and at the same time, give others to cause the cooling power of blue and violet, as experience has shown. This and other forces that act upon the vibratory laws of matter and spirit will be explained.

Acoustic science, or that branch of physics, that studies the nature of sound; makes a specific declaration that sound comes from a vibration or to and fro motion of some mass of matter or substance; that this vibration is transmitted by the atmospheric gases, or some other transmitting medium, to the ear when it acts upon the ear drum, the rods of Corti, and other parts of the ear, and is thence converted into sensations, which are carried by the auditory nerve, to the sensorium of the brain, through which the mind is made conscious of said sound.

We are also told that the degree of tone depends upon the nature of the distance over its path of travel. In a cord or string, the tone is governed by its length, diameter, and tension, also the nature of its atomic construction and polarity. A large string giving less waves to the inch than a small one of the same material, length and tension or stretch, hence a lower tone.

Unity of law rules supreme, since vibration in one department of the universe depends upon the nature of the conditions, then vibrations of all departments, must depend upon the same laws.

Now, will some one tell us what kind of tubes or cords the sun uses in order to give the many colors of the solar spectrum? View it as we may, the so-called wave theory of light, heat, color, and electricity is but a vain attempt to establish a scientific philosophy of invisible forces, and we are not alone in our claims, for Tyndall, Babbitt, Crooks and others agree in saying "the wave theory explains the visible nature of light, and the radiant properties of heat; but can not give any explanation of the chemical and therapeutic action of any of these forces.

In the ethereal realms there are many grades of ethers, which may be classed into four general divisions, in the same manner as the material elements. The first division comprises chromatic ethers, which form the basic element of the coarser varieties of heat, light, color.

The 2nd is that of the *odic ethers*.



The 3rd is that of the *psychic ethers*.  
4th, we have a realm of pure spirit.

All grades up to the infinite, as the fountain of deity. The positive power behind the throne. The supreme being that has ever eluded the reach of mankind. The manifestations of which have been going on through all the ages that have past and gone, and which man in his infancy, clothed in materiality and fear, has conceived as the giver and taker of life, and which for the want of a better name, he has called God and knows no more. Thus may we stand on the threshold of matters kingdom and looking through matter, look up to matters God. Now, my friends, we will begin to unfold a more beautiful and correct philosophy of life and its laws. This observation through the material and glimpse of the spiritual, has given us a key to the secrets of the universe, whose anatomy we have practically dissected.

In this patient discussion we have endeavored to present all the leading facts of positive science, the precepts of reason and a few analogical premises, and will soon gather these pearls of wisdom and truth together, and present you an evolution of cosmic philosophy.

In presenting these views of the universal mind, I shall sustain my promises by giving brief explanations of some of the unknown problems of the infinite that is all around and about us in which we live, move and have our being.

One might as well lift a pail of water as to sling dumb-bells and to use a hoe in the garden, as to punch at a swinging bag.

The muscles of the body can be properly exercised in attending to household duties as well as in swinging on horizontal bars, if one only knows how to do it intelligently, and thus what is often considered drudgery can be made a pleasure.

Suggestion.

In hypnotic state.

—:0:—

Becomes an adjunct in healing.

—:0:—

Suggestion is not the fundamental basis of all curative systems.

—:0:—

The power of mind over matter as generally understood is not the true healing process.

—:0:—

All hypnotic phenomena have their basis on the universal law of harmony in which the positive and negative forces become polarized.

The hypnotic state is induced under a passive condition to the same degree as the operator is positive and the subject negative, both conditions being modified by sensitiveness.

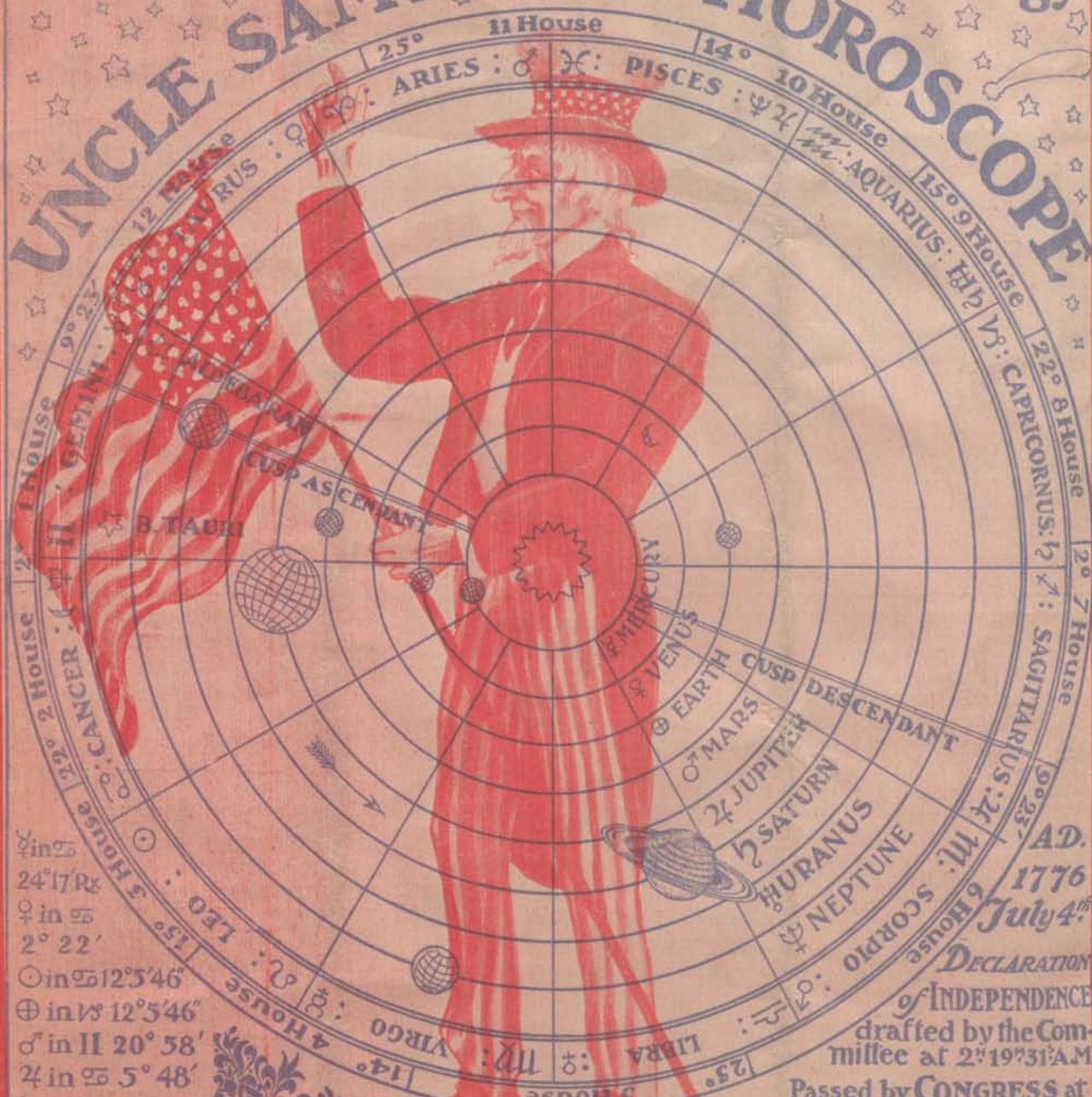
