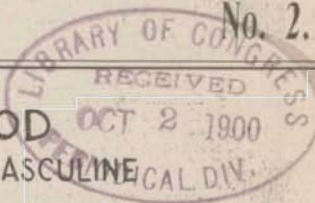

The Human Aura.

Seated on the balcony of our hotel, as the twilight fast disappearing, gave place to the shadows of a summer evening, resting from the fatigue of a long drive in an open buggy across a wide stretch of prairie where the shimmer and sheen of reflected heat, or the flow of electric and magnetic forces, had left its imprint upon our faces, and dimmed our eyesight; my friend, a gifted psychic, opened the conversation by saying, "Do you know that this visible fairy, like emanation, earth's aura, can be used to illustrate that wonderfully mysterious play of forces that surround human beings?"

"Yes," I replied, "I have often wondered, when crossing the great western plains and observing this phenomenon, if the same forces were not producing like results on our bodies and causing them to send out radiations in a similar manner."

"Well," said he, "the human Aura is a very interesting study, and now that we have the Roentgen ray to help us out, a great interest is springing up regarding this matter. The possibility of persons, gifted with the x-ray psychic sight, capable of super-normal, super-psychic vision, and penetrative perception through living bodies and many opaque substances is being accepted by the class of persons known as scientific investigators. Among some of the distinguished persons that have investigated human Aura, may be mentioned Dr. Baraduct to whom belongs the honor of first proving by photography the fact of human Aura, as well as that of the image or form of thoughts impressed upon the thinker's Aura. The great French physicist Mr. G. Sebon, has, also, proved that dark rays which appear to be related to the invisible rays of phosphorescence (x-rays) are emitted by organized beings in darkness which allow them to be photographed. Added to these are some new and interesting experiments of Colonel DeRochas, the well known

savant, director of the French Ecole Polytechnic; also, the testimony of Dr. Gates, one of America's distinguished physicians, as reported in the Medical News. The Doctor says: 'That these emanations can be tested by the chemical reactions of salts of selenisem; and that reactions are characterized by various tints of colors, according to the nature of the mental impressions of persons.' Now as to these colors," said my friend, closing his eyes, and using his psychicsight, "they take in the seven colors of the rainbow, that magical seven, the rhythmic number, and the Aura of a man whose magnet, electric and psychic development, is in perfect balance, has twenty-two bands or ribbons of colors, three octaves, the triune number. This Aura radiates out from all parts of the body, but can best be observed encircling the head and face, and is very active in vibration when a patriotic man, fired with zeal for his country, is pleading her cause and arousing her sons to action in her defense, or when a philanthropist is pleading for the rights of his fellow men."

"Now, my friend," said I, "will you kindly portray to me the arrangement of the three octaves of colors, and their signification?"

"Yes," said he, "the first division, starting at the skin, is composed of five colors—white, light blue, blue, a shade darker, yellow, and red; it is, also, interspersed with geometrical figures—the dotted circle, the simple circle, the crescent, the triangle and the square. This band of five colors and geometric figures represents the flow of the various life currents; each force giving birth to elements, is animated by a peculiar mode of vibration, producing in matter forms represented as follows: Sound, touch, light, taste, and smell. From these emanations can be traced the peculiarities of races of men, the state of health and disease of individuals. The second band is bluish-violet and rose; the third, cloudy zone, of light blue, pink, violet and orange; the fourth belt, green, bordered with yellow; fifth, indigo with silvery edge; sixth, light blue with golden rim; seventh, greyish blue violet golden silvery mist. These bands, except the first, are heaviest on the lower border, and gradually

become lighter in extension to outer rim of each. Extending from the first belt outward, penetrating through these shimmering, waving, rhythmic, vibratory colors and forms, are electric streamers, lighting up the whole Aura."

Pausing for a time, and bowing his head in meditation, my friend whose countenance was now becoming illuminated, the evening twilight having faded to darkness, continuing said: "The physical Aura of a man whose thoughts are low and animal like, are gross, thick, dense and dark in color, while that of a noble, generous, pure man is clear, luminous and bright. The trained clairvoyant or psychic can read the character of persons with whom he or she comes near to, as readily as a good reader gleams the ideas of the writer from the pages of a book. The forces that shape the destiny of individuals are heredity, environments, will power and imagination. Thoughts may be brought largely under control of the will. Clear, pure thinking aids greatly in developing good, generous, noble-hearted men. Bearing in mind the close relation of color and sound, and that space may be defined, as sounds imbued with a personal meaning, expressing modes of the speaking entity; then, while speech affects the Aura of the listener, it must also be closely connected with the Aura of the speaker. In fact it would seem only natural that, if we knew how, the character, the moral as well as the physical status of every person, could be sensed through the intonations of his voice and the various characteristics, in sound, forms and colors, given out by his speech as manifestations of his thoughts. The special vibrations of a man's speech—what might be termed his equation of speech—ought to induce on a sensitive or trained hearer impressions of the same nature as those that the auric colors, which are produced by the same thoughts, do on a psychic."

Again for a time my friend ceased to speak and sat in silent contemplation. Resuming the conversation, he said: "When people are closely massed together, the auras mingle in a curious way, and catch influences one from the other, unless they

Questions and Answers.

A. M., Ohio:—Mr. Pearson, Dear Sir. Question: Is it necessary for a person to have faith in your art of healing in order to be benefitted thereby. Ans.: No, not to be healed, but you want faith enough that you may come to the healer, who will in most cases give you confidence and knowledge in from five to ten minutes. A patient once said that he was born blind, but now he could see. He knew that; he did not say that he believed he could see.

T. O. M., Kans.:—Question: What is disease? Ans.: Not to be of ease is disease, an inference of pain. Disease, therefore, is a derangement of internal or external organs, or any other function as a whole, brought about by discord in the relation that the invisible forces—in which we live, move and have our being—hold to one another; obstruction of vital force, one of the primary means when it occurs in any of the channels leading to a vital organ, causes stagnation or slowing down in the rapidity of vibration of that organ; hence, discord, or out of harmony, out of balance, and derangement accompanied with more or less pain follows, and we call it disease.

Tobacco Smoker:—Question: By what method do you correct the habit of smoking or chewing tobacco? I have been establishing this habit for a number of years and am getting to that point where it is a great injury to my health. Ans.: If you are very negative and sensitive we put you under the magnetic influence. If of a more positive nature, in the hypnotic state, and in these conditions, proceed with suggestion for five or ten minutes, after which you will find that you have no more any desire for tobacco. This will last, perhaps, for only a few hours after first treatment, but by repeating treatment for a few days it becomes permanently ingrafted in your being and you will forget all about your former habit, which even becomes offensive to you, if such suggestions have been made. How these suggestions become so potent, that we may change a person's mode of living, change the vibrations

of the brain cells or make them inactive or literally walled in, so to speak, and the actual process that takes place between the Healer and patient, the forces that are set in operation whether consciously or unconsciously, will be explained in some future number of HARMONY when we come to deal with the phenomena of hypnotism.

G. E. O., Ohio:—P. Pearson, Dear Sir. Question: Will you kindly explain the difference, if any, between Christian Science and Magnetic Healing? Ans.: To answer this question in detail would require volumes, but for a short answer would say, there is in reality no difference. To be sure there is a difference in the method of application of those forces that do the healing act. In most cases perhaps with both methods the application is effected unconsciously. Our belief as to what power effects the cure does not alter the facts in the case. Here it is where knowledge, and not belief, must hold. This knowledge must be based upon actual demonstration to be of any value. To base your knowledge on belief or prayer will not hold with scientific thinking people. Therefore the majority of mankind, as well as nations, are drifting down the wild and rugged stream of time, carried along by numerous occult forces of the universe, whose influences they are ignorant of, as well as failing to know themselves and the real extent of their inherent capacities; and blind to the various obstacles that will arise to meet them in the future, they naturally fall into a condition of negation and weakness, and are swayed by every wind that blows. They do things at times which they ought not to do, and hence create inharmony, and fail to do the things they ought to do, and hence their suffering is the outcome of their sins of omission and commission.

"Knowledge is power," saith the adept. Are we creatures of fate? Have we no free will of our own? And is there no road by which we can be more certain of our destiny? We answer that we are creatures of fate; for we are effects of causes of which we were not the author; but we have a free will, but must have a knowledge of our proper sphere of being, ere we can exercise our free will to our good. possess occult knowledge, and by will power send out a positive electric force that repels impinging inharmony. As long as those out-flowing lines are firm and straight and the magnetic flow continues steadily at their base, or near the cuticle, the body seems almost perfectly protected from physical influences. By deep inhalation through the nostrils in the open air and slow exhalation, willing that a strong protective cloud be thrown out over the external limits of the aura, so as to cling to it tenaciously, if the thought and will power are strong enough the object will be accomplished, and the physician, healer, or psychic can enter the sick room of persons suffering from infectious diseases with impunity. A harmonious gathering of people has been aptly termed 'a happy intermingling of sympathetic auras.' The magnetic affluences of two persons who are in complete accord are interwoven or blended. A correct knowledge of human auras leads to self-protection socially, morally, and physically."

Again my friend sat in silent meditation, then resuming, said: "The psychic or soul Aura, the finest, most subtle, most grand, is not clearly discernible surrounding every person. Only the good, the noble, the generous and self-sacrificing have that radiant halo strongly developed, shining out resplendently; radiating from the head and face, when on great occasions the speaker is pleading for humanity, or contending for some fundamental principle, underlying the prosperity and happiness of the community, the state, the nation; or as seen when a great religious reformer, pleading with the people, admonishes them to forsake their evil ways and walk in the paths of righteousness; or as seen surrounding a great Healer, who for the love of mankind, cures them of their bodily ills by the touch of hand or a few passes. On such occasions, the Auras of such persons are filled with glittering golden-silvery spirals, revolving each upon its own axis, and sending out, as it were, an Aurora-borealis, healing, illuminating, enlightening all those within its reach."

Astrology Defined.

The term "astrology" is taken from two Greek words, astron (a star or constellation of stars) and logus (discourse) and means a discourse on the influences which constitute the language of the stars.

"Astronomy" comes from astron and nomos (law) and implies the knowledge or science of the laws and motions of the stars. As an art modern astrology is based upon astronomy and a great and divine law of the universe which we call the law of the occult correspondences of the universe. A law of analogies, it recognizes the absolute unity of all nature, from God, the Infinite Macrocosmic Intelligence of the universe, down to man, as the finite microcosmic, but highest expression of God's wisdom.

In former ages astrology and astronomy were twin sciences and astronomy, mathematics and geometry were studied solely for astrologers to make their predictions by. Indeed, the priest, physician and astronomer were one person, as they will be after the dawn of the year 1925. No art has a history so old and full of wonder as this chief of ancient arts. Josephus tells us that Adam was an adept in the art and taught it to Seth, and the records of the ancient Magi tell us that it was taught in a very ancient work called the Jewish Cabella of Magic and that this work was given to Seth by Adam and that it was handed down from generation to generation and compiled into its last revision by Moses, and there seems a strange analogy between much of the matter contained in the books of the old testament and more especially those that are said to be the works of

Moses and the esoteric matter of the Jewish Cabella. Plato tells the story of an ancient continent that flourished in the vicinity of the Azore islands and that it was submerged by volcanic action. Hon. Ignatius Donnelly has given an impartial investigation of the story, and in his book called Atlantis he has produced an abundance of evidence to prove the truth, and shown that Adam was a citizen of this last Kingdom of Atlantis. The Ancient Order of the Magi lived in Atlantis and if there be any virtue in tradition, Adam was an exalted master within its folds and Seth his successor.

Prof. Richard A. Proctor, the leading astronomer of the last half century, says: "Not only among all the leading races of antiquity and in all the chief civilized nations, but during periods of time such as no other faith can boast of having swayed, men held firmly to the belief that the stars in their courses foretell, nay rule, the fortunes of men. The cuneiform inscriptions of Assyria, the hieroglyphies of Egypt, the most ancient records of Persia, India and China agree in showing that of old all men believed the sun, moon, planets and stars to be as 'radiant mercuries' carrying through the astral ethers of space the perpetual bound decrees and resolutions of the gods." To trace its history in detail would fill volumes. It is enough for this time to present this cursory vision of its great age. As a philosophy it is purely inductive and deserves investigation and we invite the general reader to go with us on a tour of investigation and if he finds it to be a truth and in harmony with all truth, as we have found it to be, then shall he be the wiser.

Soul, Spirit and Body.

Or the Triune Combination of Man.

When it comes to the question of healing it is somewhat necessary for us to understand this triune combination as exemplified in man. We must know the parts singly, and the parts as a whole, and the relationship existing between soul, spirit and body, the microcosm, and what relation this has to the universal triune combination of intelligence, force and matter, the macrocosm. When we as healers understand these combinations and their relations, then we are able to know the cause of disease and locate it wherever it may exist in the human being be it in the visible or invisible realm. We know then what we are about and can have absolute knowledge. The universal combination of intelligence, force and matter has always existed and we may take it for granted that it will always exist. Now then if we are a part of this stupendous whole, we must necessarily always have existed and, of course, always will exist in this same triune combination, although changes may come for the purpose of adaptation to the changeable environments upon the different planes of the different periods or divisions of existence as microcosmical being. Now we want to remember that this combination cannot be broken up, that either part cannot exist by itself, but must remain in the trinity of its own combination, in harmony with its planes of existence. Now then, if we have this exemplified in man, consisting of soul, spirit and physical body on earth plane, we also have the same triune combination of soul, spirit and spiritual body on the spiritual plane which is in harmony with its surroundings and environments. Now the reader will understand that when we speak of the spirit we don't mean soul any more than you would call our hand our body, or vice versa; but contributors in these pages have a right to use these terms as they may understand them, although it would be desirable to understand them all alike and no confusion could arise. Others refer to the mind as synonymous with soul, when in reality it is only an attribute of the soul, so to speak. 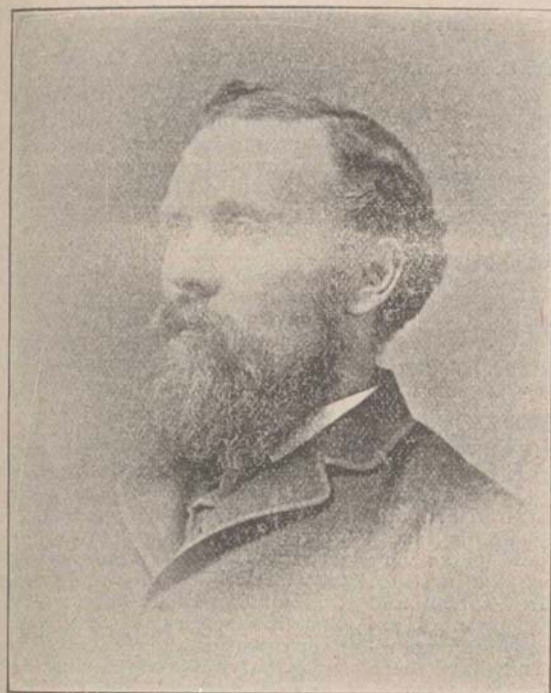
