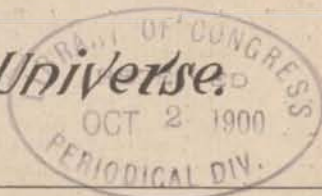

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UNIVERSAL WIRELESS TELEGRAPHY!

Pearson's New System of Communication in the Morse
Alphabet, Which Is Unlimited as to Distance.

It requires nerve to come out, and in public
print discuss a question of such great magnitude
and almost unlimited possibilities, as the caption
of this article would indicate.

To be able to elucidate on a topic of such
immense and sweeping proportion, we must be
conscious of "where we are at," and stand upon
solid ground of demonstrated facts. We would
not dare, neither could we afford to present to an
intelligent class of readers theories that could be
knocked down as flat as pancakes. We will
therefore endeavor to present to our readers facts
only, and we are happy to say, there will be no
recantation.

We may also consider ourselves lucky not to
have been born three hundred years ago, for then

we would certainly have been taken up before a
tribunal of some kind of justice (?) and charged
with usurping powers belonging to the domain of
omnipotence, and perhaps roughly asked to
choose between the gallows or recantation, and
of course we would have done like Galillio did,
for we, like the Irishman, would rather be a liv-
ing coward than a dead hero; but still we might
have whispered to ourself: "We do it all the
same."

How fortunate it is to live in this glorious
age just lapping over into the twentieth century,
which will be crowned with still greater achieve-
ments and progress of freedom; when we can,
unhampered, experiment and peep into the most
hidden recesses of nature, and bring out and pro-
claim these wonderful discoveries, right in the
face of ignorance and superstition, and not even
being asked to recant, but to show our hand that
all may see if it contains anything of value to
mankind.

There is hardly a thinking man today but
will concede to almost any kind of proposition in
the way of new discoveries as long as it is inside
the boundries of intelligence and reason, for we
have grown so used to all these new things com-
ing in such rapid succession during the last half
century that we do not dare to deny anything.
We have a right to doubt and doubt hard but we
have no right to deny. Don't deny anything un-
less you can prove by actual demonstration that
the other fellow is wrong. Theories and beliefs
have no standing with a scientific mind hence we
must base our postulate upon well established
facts, proven to be so by demonstrations con-
ducted under scientifically directed experiments.
But our readers will remember and concede this
to be true: That what the experimenter demon-
strator knows to be facts are to you only theories
until you come in possession of the same knowl-
edge that the experimenter possesses.

To tell you that we may stand at any point
on our planet and intelligently communicate with
another human being without wires and regardless
of distance, we admit, will seem to you to be of
such tremendous scope and unheard of proposition
that you no doubt will at first glance feel like you

would want to relegate such an idea to the categories of crankology to keep company with all other fanciful and visionary ideas that some time or other evolved from some human mind.

But nevertheless let us keep on with our studies and the student who is able to read between the lines and absorbs (to the uninitiated, hidden truths) that which is the spirit of the letter, the very soul emanations, manifested in the spiritual aura of this communication, will certainly be the most fortunate.

It perhaps would be well right here to relieve the mind of some of the wise ones who may have jumped at the conclusion that our new system of wireless telegraphy is telepathy, which is admitted to be a proven fact. We will, by the way, also admit that telepathy is a phenomenon in the same field of vibrations, but so far has not proven to be of practical value, for if you should be requested by this method of communication, "to go and buy an opera ticket, you would perhaps go and buy some dishes." How would this work in a commercial transaction evolving perhaps millions of dollars?

In the study of wireless telegraphy (we wish some linguist would give us a better name) and the common everyday telegraph and telephone, we have to consult the law of vibration in order to get the correct knowledge of what we are dealing with. When we understand this law and divide our studies in divisions corresponding to the divisions of the fields of vibration according to their respective phenomena, we may be able to get a clearer conception of the workings of this law by comparing the higher with the lower, and realizing that analogous and sympathetic condition existing between them all, for we have the same phenomena that we witnessed in the lower occur in the higher but in different form under different conditions, hence how true the old saying: "As it is below, so it is above."

Now that the student may more fully grasp the situation, we will use as an illustration, a piano with eighth octaves. Each one of these octaves will represent a field of vibration and each note in the octave of what we would call the microcosmic scale of vibration will represent an

octave in what we will call the macrocosmic scale of vibration.

Now in our experiments we may play a tune on any of the eighth octaves of the piano, and it is all the same only a change in form occurs as a result of change of vibration but always in correspondence with vibration of the respective octave.

Now when we take up the study of the electrical and sound vibrations in our common telegraph and telephone system, we find that we are playing in the third, fourth and fifth fields on the macrocosmic scale and when we have the appliances or conditions regulated into a harmonious chord on the 1-3-5 principle, we obtain the common ordinary result of telegraph and telephone. Now if we are bold enough to venture into the sixth, seventh and eighth field on the macrocosmic scale, we will have exactly the same result but different in form under different conditions, but in perfect harmony and correspondence with the rapidity of vibrations on these fields, and the completeness of the result will depend upon the harmonious conditions of appliances and environments by which and under which the experiments have been conducted. Sometimes the change will be so great that it almost seems to be a reversal of natural order of things, like water for instance is a fluid in one octave and a vapor in another, but the atomic elements are the same in the vapor and water drop or ocean—only a change in vibration corresponding to the octave upon which we find it has taken place. Please notice the sympathetic and perfect harmony and blending of the chords on the different octaves and fields in nature, and you will find everything in perfect harmony from the lowest up to the very highest.

When we make the statement that the higher vibration controls the lower, we mean simply what is exemplified in our everyday telephone system whenever the appliances and conditions are based upon the true principle of the harmonious chord of 1-3-5. There is a perfect blending of octaves and fields just like minerals and other substances are held in solution in the air and carried along, just like a log swimming in a stream

of water, so it does not really matter in what octave or field you are experimenting. As long as you play in the right key you will have a responsive phenomena in harmony with the dominant chord belonging to the key in which you desire to conduct your experiments.

Nicola Tesla no doubt is right when he claims that electrical energies may be transmitted to a (as yet unknown) distance by the agency of the upper stratas of the atmosphere, but to get the conducting wire up there would be the next problem to solve. A balloon would necessarily have to come to a stop at a certain point and the distance he would be able to reach would depend upon the altitude of the balloon, besides it would be impracticable, hence such a system would not solve the problem of "Universal Wireless Telegraphy," unlimited as to distance, and if we want to solve this problem, we must reverse ourselves and stay close to mother earth and revise the heretofore accepted theories, and in place of going up in a balloon or a 150-foot high pole, just go up in the sixth, seventh and eighth field of vibration, and we can play our little piece just as well as the other fellows now playing in the third, fourth and fifth fields.

So you see the principle of our system is not new. We do not claim to have discovered a new principle or force, but simply happened to stumble onto a new method by which we are able to apply or rather turn these mighty and potent forces in nature in the direction or for the purpose of transmission of intelligent messages in the Morse alphabet without wires to any distance. In accordance with the law governing in these fields, we recognize no distance. We are in touch with the utmost limit of our solar system, and as human beings, are master over force, time and space.

Now, dear readers, you may say this cannot be done, it is impossible and lies beyond the domain of human achievements, etc., etc. But, my friends, your beliefs and your conclusions do not alter the case or change facts, neither does it in the least affect eternal principles or laws governing the universe. We not only do it, but we have even improved our system to that extent that we can send a message now in less than five

minutes which heretofore required over twenty minutes, and expect to be able to shorten this time still more when our operator on the other end of this at present twelve hundred miles invisible line gets to be expert enough to read by sound. At present writing our operator does not even understand the Morse alphabet but sends the message to us to translate but is doing most uncommonly well for a new beginner. Our system is very simple, easily learned, but it takes a long time to become an expert.

What are all our late new inventions but imitations of what we find in nature? We imitate the fish when we build our steamboats, especially the submarine. What is the piston on our engines but an imitation of the human arm with the hand on the crank, the telephone instrument patterned after and applying the principles of the human ear, and so on all through the catalogue? And now our scientific people are even trying to imitate the birds in the air, and no doubt will succeed, and then how nicely our new system of communication will come in play and fit in, for how would you go about digging post-holes in the air along an aerial line of transportation necessary for an expedient way of transacting business in this new field of vibrations? We will admit that if you could successfully dig the post-holes in the air you might put up the poles and wires.

Let us imagine an airship coming from the south, a hundred miles away yet and perhaps a hundred miles up in the air. Click, click, click! A message comes to our operator like this: "Will arrive at Ponca City, O. T., 10:15 a. m. Any passengers for Chicago?" Answer goes back: "Two passengers for Kansas City. Please stop." Then passengers are notified in their homes by the same system and they stand ready to catch on when the airship comes along and scoops them in. All our new inventions go hand in hand with one another. Some of them could not exist if it wasn't for this fact.

In these last few sentences our readers will please understand that we only speculated on the future possibilities and utilities of our new system of communication, and by your permission will go still farther up the ladder of progress during

the first quarter of the twentieth century and witness the operation of the "wireless telephone," unlimited as to distance, when we will be able to stand in Ponca City, O. T., and converse in an audible tone of voice with a brother in Europe, or a friend aboard a ship in the middle of the Pacific ocean, and we have no doubt of still greater possibilities in the near future, but will follow Paul's advice when he stated that "some things are unlawful to mention."

In regard to these possibilities we base our theories upon what knowledge we may have of the laws governing on these higher fields of vibration, just like you would do if you were to build a boat. You would know without trying that your boat would float on the water when finished. You would know how many tons of freight it would carry. You would even know the speed your boat would be able to travel. Yes, you would know all this even before you commenced to build your boat, and you gained this knowledge by or through the knowledge you had of the law of gravitation.

Now in closing this treatise, we hope that our readers will understand the hints given in this simple but honest presentation of its concerning these things and that at least some of our readers will between the lines catch on to those things "unlawful to mention" and profit by superior ability. "He that hath shall be given," etc.

MARRIAGE A LA ASTROLOGICAL ART.

Science versus Guess Work.

In the oriental lands of ye poor and despised "heathen Chinese," the student of sociology is brought face to face with the startling and marvelous success of their marriage relationship. Seldom are the better classes found to live unhappy married lives, and still less are divorcees to be found among them. In conversation with a member of their middle classes, I ventured to ask why this good condition prevailed, and to my surprise he answered in these ideas:

When a child is born in China, great care is taken to observe the local mean time when the navel cord is cut, and this data is given to one or more competent astrologers who draw up the horoscope of the child's birth. Friends and relatives then see if there is evidence of success in marriage; this found, they next go about among the people until they find a person of the other sex that is somewhere near the same age, and if by careful comparison an astrologer decides that there is harmony and adaptation in the horoscopes, the friends of both then determine that at a given age, near puberty, that the two will be united as man and wife. They have thus laid a foundation and ere the structure is complete, the astrologer is called upon to make the "Election Figure" or

map of the heavens for the best time to marry, and this is no small task.

My friend then began to give me my first ideas of the "astrologer's grim science." A few years lapsed and I took up the active study of the same, and my researches lead me even to higher and more skillful methods. Phrenology and its allies were combined. Prof. J. B. Harris, of the Fowler and Wells school of phrenology, gave me some valuable points, but more than this, he made it possible for myself and companion to first meet. Time and again he told me I "ought to marry her." After getting the birth date accurately and comparing our horoscopes, I found the opinions of my phrenological friend were reinforced by astrological art. And I did so. My own birth date is 6 a. m. Local Mean time, of October 2, 1876, at Evanston, Wyoming. At that time Libra was in the eastern horizon and Lun in Aries in the western, with Venus in Taurus. That of Mrs. Tisdale is 2:45 a. m. Local Mean Time of January 23, 1879, not far from Wichita, Kan., at which time Sagittarius was rising in the eastern heavens, with Gemini in the west and Jupiter in Taurus, according to Heliocentric measurement. The signs of the heavens are divided into four varieties, called Earthly, Airy, Watery and Fiery. Libra, the ruling sign of your humble friend, is of the airy nature, while Sagittarius is of the fiery order. Now, as air is essential to fire, we may learn that persons of airy signs are of vast importance to those of the fiery, whereas fiery people warm up those of the airy order, a fact well proven by our acquaintance, for when we met, she was sickly and puny, now she is far on the road to health; and I was cold and not very social, now I am getting more social each day.

Astrologers are welcome to these dates if they want them.

Venus and Jupiter, our ruling planets, were close to a conjunction when we first met, and we have been in touch every since, with scarcely a discord. Seeing this natural harmony as a basis, let me now call your attention to the places of the planets at the time I chose for our marriage, and what the heavens have given as the result.

The local mean time at Joplin, Mo., was 12 o'clock (noon) sharp, or 12:16 central standard time of April 9, 1900. The mean time for Greenwich for this hour is 6:16 p. m. of same day.

As this day was on Monday, it was the moon's day, and the hour of the day was ruled by Lun and Venus. The cusps of the mundane houses were as follows:

 Libra 19 deg., 4th.
 Scorpio 25 deg., 5th.
 Sagittarius (intercepted in 5th.)

 Aquaries 23 deg., 8th.
 Pisces 18 deg., 9th.
 Aries 19 deg., 10th.
 Taurus 25 deg., 11th.
 Gemini (intercepted in 11th)
 Cancer 1 deg., 12th.

The heliocentric places of the planets, calculated by myself, were:

Lun in Aries, Mars in Pisces, Mercury in Scorpio, Jupiter, Saturn and Uranes in Sagittarius Moon and Venus in Leo, "The rising sign," the Sun its lord, are the chief significators of the groom, and the seventh house, with Aquaries setting, Uranus, its lord, are the significant colors of the bride. The sign aries in the tenth house, Mars, its lord, and the Luni therein, have signification of the conjugal state. The sign Libra, in the 4th, Venus, its lady, show the event and aim of marriage. The fixed signs, Leo and Aquairus, in the first and seventh, indicate that chances are for a permanent and life-long companionship, and as Leo is a fiery sign, and of a positive electric temperament and Aquaries an airy sign of the same temperament, we see that as air is essential to fire,

that there is a mutual life force to operate between them for each other's good. Venus, lady of the tenth, in Leo, is the term of Jupiter and force of Mars, is in the first and free from the evil aspects of evil planets, and as Leo rules the heart and its sympathies, we knew that marriage at this time would find its end and aim in a warm, honorable, friendly and enduring love. As Venus is the God of love and Marriage, and as the moon is always a co-significator and is well placed, and in conjunction with Venus, and applying to the time of Lun we find much active expression of such conditions, whereas the Lun in the tenth, and free from affection, shows great honor to the couple, as a result of an active, warm, and humane religion that will exist between them. A more agreeable or fortunate time could never be found. Mercury, Jupiter and Uranus, with Saturn in the fifth house, indicate chances for children are good; of which Mercury says they will be of an intellectual and active nature; Jupiter promises them honor and glory; Saturn says they will be cool and of an even temper, peaceful and laborious in all they do, and Uranus speaks in a loud voice that they will be of an extraordinary and rare nature, and this from the manner in which they will be brought into life, not results of accidents and passion, as the masses are, but the result of years of careful thought and scientific culture.

All these conditions are confirmed by the personal horoscopes of both parties. Friends will be made among students of the occult, artists and scientific people in general. There will be no enemies to this couple, that are of importance.

A MYSTERY SOLVED

By Hoary Astrology.

On the 27th of February we received the following delineation of a "Hoary Figure" from Prof. Carl Lourenze, an astrologer of national reputation, of Melrose Highlands, Mass.:

"On the evening of February 14, about 7 p. m., I noticed in the evening paper the following startling headlines:

WINNIE ALDEN MURDERED?

PARENTS OF MISSING MALDEN GIRL
FEAR THAT SHE HAS MET
FOUL PLAY, ETC.

"On reading the article I noticed that she left her home at 7:45 p. m. (approximately) February 6. By making the correction necessary from standard time to mean solar time, this would be about 8 p. m.; at which time 24 degrees, 49 minutes of Argo ascended and 24 degrees of Gemini were culminating. Mercury, the ruler of the ascendant (and) signifying the person enquired about, * * * was in the fifth house, showing her to have started on a pleasure trip; but as Mars, the lord of the eighth house (house of death), was so near and her signification was applying to the sun (and he was), ruler of the house of sorrow, I judged she would have occasion to regret leaving on that trip. The moon, lady of the eleventh (being) in the ninth house, and as Venus ruled that house, I would judge that there is no fear for her life, but Neptune exactly on the meridian would lead me to judge, as he is the ruler of the seventh house, the house of associations and opposition (and marriages) and as he is an evil planet in many ways, that she would meet with disgrace. But we will look also at the time we first heard of the disappearance, viz., February 14, at 7 p. m. We then find Neptune in the tenth house and Venus in the seventh and Mercury past the conjunction of the rulers of the eighth and twelfth houses but in opposition to moon, signifying her friends, and sun and Nep-

tune in a triune aspect with Venus and moon, a quincunx, and Mercury her significator in good aspect to Venus, and Venus applies to a triune of Jupiter. I would further judge that she had a Venus (i. e. marriage and love) affair, and as Neptune is significator of the other party and Mercury, her significator, is in mutual reception by house with Neptune. I would judge that her marriage was strongly indicated to a person older than herself, and a man who was connected with navigation or some such watery business because Pisces is a watery sign and Neptune is the god of the ocean (anciently known by the Greeks as Poseidon). The direction indicated is westerly and as Neptune is significator of the partner, I would say southerly, also. Judging from the figure for the time of leaving home, I would be inclined to believe that as Neptune exactly squared Venus and her ascendant, she was at first unwilling to take the step and that she was coerced, especially as Mercury, who is her significator, is besieged between the lords of the eighth and twelfth, a very strong argument of restraint and imprisonment.

"I could tell better if I had the young lady's time of birth to work from, but this hoary figure is sufficiently strong in appearance for me to advise looking for her in a place near the ocean and where many people congregate, but on rather hilly ground. From the direction indicated, I would suggest the vicinity of New York.

OHIO OSTEOPATHY VICTORY.

The supreme court has rendered a decision which has the effect of legalizing the practice of osteopathy in Ohio, without the formality of securing a license from the state medical board.

The decision was rendered in a case carried up from Lucas county, the supreme court holding that the manipulations which form the mode of treatment in osteopathy do not come under the law.

MAGNETIC HEALERS BARRED.

Magnetic healing concerns hereafter, it is likely, will not be permitted to operate under the sanction of the Kansas laws. Within the past few weeks a half dozen of these enterprises have made application for charters. They have all been held up. The board is investigating their operations. Up to date nothing has been found in their plan of work that entitles them to a charter under the new law. Unless a discovery is made that requires the board to issue them charters, which is unlikely, their applications will be denied. Some time ago the board issued charters to two concerns of this kind. At that time it was in doubt but thought no damage could be done by doing so. Later it concluded that possibly no good could be accomplished and held up other applications of that sort. In case it is finally determined that such concerns have no legal right to have a charter the two charters already issued will be called in.

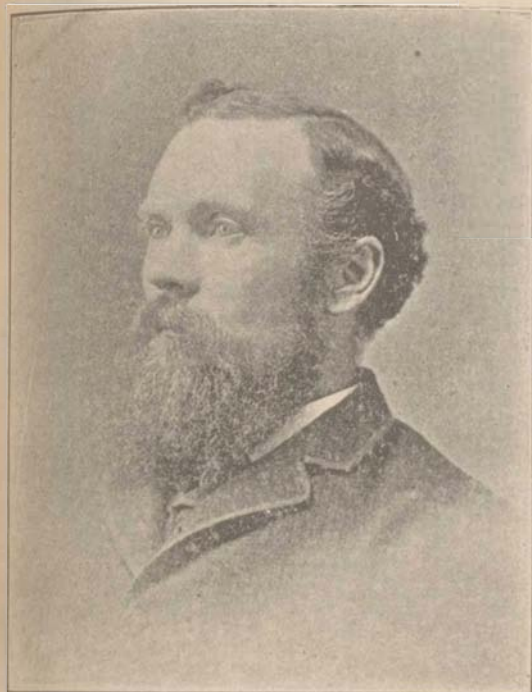
