SOUL, SPIRIT, BODY.

Or the Triune Combination of Man.

(Continued from March Number.)

This triune combination as far as we know,
is Eternal.

Intelligence, force and matter always have
existed, and always will. We can not think of a
special creation, for to create is to make some-
thing out of nothing, and if this triune combina-
tion always existed, it necessarily follows that
it will always exist, for we can not think of any
of these factors or elements of this Universal
Trinity—the all in all—being lost or destroyed.
But in the endless chain of the evolutionary pro-
cess in nature, we find numberless variations of
expressions, which as a phenomena in nature is
the result of different ratio of vibration of this
triune combination. When this combination is

of a harmonious condition, we have the chord of
one, three, five, or rather five, three, one, for five
is the greatest; then nature is ready for the next
step on the scale of vibration, where new environ-
ment and consequently discords are again met
with, but it is through discord that harmony is ob-
tained, hence this continued effort of the ego or
aim of nature or self-acting energy as we term it,
is always striving to maintain equilibrium by
changing the vibration of atom and molecule it
comes in contact with, and the harmonious chord
of five, three, one, is again restored. A continu-
ous warfare between harmony and discord is en-
countered, in all the different fields of vibration
and their octaves.

We may reasonably take for granted, that it
was by this law of the evolutionary process that
planets and earth came into existence in the solar
system, and finally at the proper time, by the same
law man appeared on earth, after ages and cycles
of ages of evolutionary steps of progress through
the scale of being, bringing into harmony all dis-
cord encountered along the line, and as "a sur-
vival of the fittest," emerged into a self-conscious
individualized being.

Man is a universe on a small scale possessing
in a degree all the elements, powers and possi-
bilities contained in the whole, hence the same
triune combination of intelligence, force and mat-
ter, soul, spirit and body. Soul, the supreme
ruler of this little universe, through spirit force
builds its body in its own image, so to speak, not
only the physical, but also the spiritual body for
its own manifestation, so that it (the soul) may
be able to come in contact with all things on that
particular plane of existence.

As a healer we must understand what mind
is and its office. How the soul, through the mind
as its agent operates and controls the physical
body, and how it through the spirit operates and
controls the spiritual body, by the invisible forces.
When we understand that nearly all diseases
originate in the invisible realm of the human
being, that an organic disease is only the external
effect of a cause in the invisible realm that came
about by an inharmonious condition of the invis-
ible forces. Therefore it follows, if we are going to

heal a disease, we must treat the first original cause of this disease, and if that lies in the spiritual realm, we should be able by spiritual powers to locate the same, and then be able to remove that cause by restoring natural, harmonious conditions in that realm where the most potent forces have their sway. By relieving the external effect and removing the internal cause, we heal the patient. Now some healers say it is not necessary to know the nature or cause of a disease, that their patients get well anyway—only trust in a higher power. But we hold, that in order to always be successful, we must know what is wanted and then treat the case accordingly, for if we go at it in a haphazard, hit or miss plan, we are apt to meet with many failures. The successful physician is the one who can correctly diagnose an ailment, for then he knows how and where to treat, and obtains the desired result. When a healer by his psychic powers diagnoses a case he knows the exact condition of his patient without asking for symptoms which are often misleading. Then when a healer possesses this knowledge, he has no need of experimenting, for the result is already known, it is only a question of time. This question of time depends largely upon the patient, whether he is negative or positive to the healer, and the healer's relation to the patient, besides the nature of the disease, whether chronic or acute, determines the length of time that is necessary for a permanent cure, it may be three minutes, two weeks or two months. Numberless cases are of record not only of our own experience, but of eminent healers in Paris and London that permanent cures result sometimes in one or two months after one or two treatments, even at times when treatment had little or no effect when given. To understand this our readers will please study our front cover page. Right here it becomes necessary to deal with another question, which the healer and patient must fully understand, for it is an exception to the rule given above. This pertains nearly to all chronic diseases, especially in chronic sciatic rheumatism, and its varied manifestation in every part of the human body.

A healer may successfully remove the cause

of chronic sciatic rheumatism in one or three treatments, but still, after awhile the same excruciating pains may be felt by the patient, who will naturally think that the treatment does him no good, that the healer is unable to cure him, but this, in most cases great mistake, we shall endeavor to explain away.

When a healer arrives at that point where the cause of sciatic rheumatism is removed, which can only be known through his or her psychic powers of perception, then the healer has a new phase to deal with, which in some cases is worse than the first, and requires new tactics in order to be reasonably successful, for we now have to deal with the patients' mind and automatic action of the sympathetic nerve. This action of the sympathetic nerve, where the trouble existed, has, during its long standing become automatic, and will continue to send the same accustomed to messages to the brain, of pain long after the trouble has been removed that caused that pain, and although it is only a false alarm, produced by the reflex action of the sympathetic nerve, it feels to the patient just like the genuine article in every respect. This, we know to be a fact, for we demonstrate it by producing the same condition in a well person, (not in the Hypnotic sleep). The method we use and the actual process that takes place will be explained in a future number of HARMONY.

At this point certain factors came in, which must be recognized so that we may know whether the patient after only three treatments will get permanently cured or not for it depends largely upon patients' own condition of mind and his negative or positive nature, and to what extent patient, through the mind, is capable of controlling his own physical condition, for those reflex actions of the sympathetic nerve will eventually if unrestrained reproduce the same original first cause that caused the first attacks and patient is back in the same old condition, and will only get well under a continued treatment of mind and body.

Now beginners should therefore not be discouraged if results should not follow as quick as expected, for good may come from his or her ef-

forts in the near future, but it is true the patient then don't know what cured him; he may attribute his cure to medicine if he used any, but should remember that he had been taking medicine for perhaps 10 years until he got tired of it and it never then had any effect, but this time it surely cured him and not the healer, so he thinks, which is deplorable from a healer's standpoint, but then the desired result has been obtained, and it don't really make any difference who gets the credit, for you know a healer must not be selfish or grasping for this or that, only try to help his fellow being, and all other things will come in due time, the credit side of his ledger is not in his patient's nor anybody else's keeping.

Our readers will now please remember, that whenever we use the term, spirit or mind, we do not mean the soul, no more than you would call my arm my physical body, although it is a part of it, and when we speak of the soul, we mean that conscious part of man, which we believe is an emanation from that central source of all life and being, that which Herbert Spencer calls, "The infinite energy pervading the Universe being incomprehensible and unknowable." Being individualized in man it is sometimes called Ego. Soul and ego we take to be synonymous.

Who is foolish enough to try to fathom the divine scheme of the Universe, the divine plan of existence. Some writers of note claim that life or soul essence works in a circle, that the human soul will sometime reach an ultimate limit in evolution, and then involution takes place, that is being absorbed into that form which it once emanated. Here it is where they put the cart before the horse. Before we can unfold or evolute, we must have something to unfold, hence involution must take place before evolution, besides what would have been gained by this millions of years circle if we should finally be destined to fall back into this Universal center from which all things proceed and in nirvana loose our individuality which nature had spent so many millions of years in producing.

Let us rather hope for an eternity of progress in which the human soul, by continued efforts, may be able to develop that inborn God principle—become like Gods, not only knowing good and

evil, but having power over good and evil, occupying the realms of arch-angels with power to mould new constilations and worlds yet to be born.

Life in the spirit sphere affords better opportunities to study mind than on earth sphere. Patient investigation has given no manifestation except from personal organisms. Recall the time when I, in earth life, as your instructor, gave you an opportunity, by the aid of a large magnifying glass, to see the blood coursing through the thin membrane of a frog's foot; how the corpuscles, driven by the tiny atoms of which each was composed, rushed along at a lively gait. With that same whirl of excitement, the brain tissue receives, the atoms from the blood and passes them on to the spirit organism which, although invisible to the natural eye is visible clairvoyantly and fills the interstices between the brain cells, which reacting upon the brain gives out thought. The brain tissue which can be seen is the machinery by which the spirit organism, by the aid of language, transmits thought to other persons. Those born with a slow rate of vibration, unless the rate be increased by observation and reflection, will not understand the messages sent out on the higher vibratory chords.

"All mothers and others who have charge of the training of children should understand how to assist the child to develop the power to think. The first exhibit of mentality in the dormant brain of a healthy infant is caused by the waves of

light upon the eye, and vibration of air upon the ear. Physical vision depends largely upon the subtle relations of the elements. All will see nearly alike, but in hearing, the sound waves coming from a more condensed condition of elements, will be more conflicting and confusing.

The brain develops through in response to the force in planetary and radiant states, the nearer the elements in the organism can come in harmony with the radiant condition, the higher the quality of brain tissue. The brain and muscular tissues are formed on the same principle, but the brain being nearest in nature to the radiant condition of the elements forms the front brain in correspondence with the forces that prevail in that state, and thus becomes the organ of thought, and are more sensitive to the forces existing in the radiant condition of matter than those existing in earth realm. As the vibratory rates increase in force, a department is formed in the cerebrum corresponding to that force, each 1-3-5 having its fold or convolution. The growing brain pushes outward the osseous tissue, making room for the cerebrum and the cerebellum; these forcing the expansion of the skull.

The first voice sounds, denoting pain or pleasure of infants, are nearly alike from each; the growth of the spirit organization, corresponding with abstract ideas and their expression in audible sounds, is developed by an artificial manipulation of natural processes. As the child grows, it is taught expression in language. First, the names of objects with which it comes in contact, the properties of these objects, then the names telling the actions of things.

In time, as the child developes, a new series of sensations, not belonging to the physical senses, brought out by the reactionary effect of language, is developed, forming the basis of imaginary faculties, which balanced by experience develops inventive faculties, first used to increase the production of food, shelter and clothing. The mental faculties thus exercised, enlarges the brain, giving it increased mental vigor and material, helping the spirit to reach out in many directions to aid in

improving the condition of existence in earth-sphere.

CO-RELATION.

(Continued from June number).

It is not the purpose of this discourse to consider either shape or size of the universe, so much as it is to give our attention to the manner in which its various elements and forces blend and work, one with another, for the glory of the whole, and in this we shall bring to our, both inductive and deductive methods of reasoning and at the same time draw our principles from chemical science.

In this consideration of the chemistry of our universe, one needs to study its constituents, of which there are many varieties. At the first step on our way we are confronted by a seemingly immutable law, which for lack of a better name, we will term the Law of Polarity; by the operation of which everything in the universe is polarized, divided or arranged into double, or dual conditions on the plan of contrasts; one set of conditions we know as positive, the other as negative; for instance, magnetism and electricity are said to have positive and negative poles. This duality is also seen in hot and cold, light and darkness, male and female, red and blue, black and white, brown and gray. The absolute and divine unity of all things teaches that there is a unity of law in all things, and that this law of polarity must be and is universal; and therefore we declare that nature speaks from everything in her realms, and says

in clear and distinct tones: "The universe is polarized into its dual conditions," giving us on the one hand, a realm of apparently imponderable, seemingly intangible, spiritual and ethereal substances; and this is a positive pole of life and power, and it is within this realm that the secrets of occult phenomena are to be found, and this realm of rapidly vibrating substances, we will call the kingdom of spiritual being, or spiritual realm. On the other hand we have the ponderable, crude, tangible, material substances as a negative pole of life and power; thus we have two kinds of substance, the one a fine and elastic kind, the other coarse and crude, and by these facts do we proclaim the law of polarity to be established in harmony with observation experience, and we will see that in these principles and no where else, we will be able to find the keys to the mysteries of the universe, and the secrets to untold relations in biology and all other sciences, arts, and philosophies. Here the mighty mysteries and heirophants of the occult can find grand secrets of power, and unknown pearls of truth, such as shall delight the mind's eye, and the heart's ear. Ere we go farther, we desire to consider something about the terms tangible and ponderable, as applied to substances. When a substance has weight it is said to be ponderable, and when this weight can be measured by mortal sense, it is then tangible weight to mortal senses. A thing that is tangible can be perceived by our senses, but there are things our senses can not perceive and these are termed intangible, but they are only intangible to our senses, and are as tangible to the senses of disembodied souls, as rocks are to us; hence both terms are only relative. All things have weight and tangibility, but this varies in degree according to the sphere of its position, and that of the observers.

We now come to an investigation of the negative pole of the universe, or that realm that we termed material, and which gives the receptive, feminine qualities of universal being.

In this realm, the chemists have found some sixty-five or seventy varieties, or differentiated conditions of matter; i.e., matter is a unitary substance that has been diversified into numerous

kinds of conditions, and to these varieties of matter the name of elements has been given. Working hand in hand, and shoulder to shoulder, the physicist has aided the chemist to classify these elements, and as a result we have our observation pointed to four great general divisions of the material realms, which are known as solids, semi-solids, liquids and gasses.

So far as science has gone, each element has certain traits of character and disposition that distinguishes it from all the others, and each class certain features that are common to all. Come now, beloved of truth, get into our car and travel with us, as we march onward and upward, from lower to higher degrees, for the time being your pilot is able to shake the molecules by the hand, and give them our orders.

All aboard for higher plains! Please review the article, "Degree," in the February number, and demonstrated. Commencing at the crudest and coarsest of the solids, for there are degrees in solid things as in all other things, we ascend in a gradual progression by degrees, each degree being more refined and attenuated than the one below it, until we have passed through an innumerable number of degrees in the solids, till we pass from solids to semi-solids, one of whose most important members is the mysterious bioplasm, more commonly called protoplasm, a jelly-like substance, somewhat like the white of an egg, in which we find the starting point of all organic animal and vegetable life in the material realms.

In time we pass the realm of semi-solids and enter that of the liquids, and thence pass into the realm of the gasses, and in this realm we shall pause, for here we find the connecting link between the material and the spiritual realms.

The study of these elements in all of their details, must be had in works on chemistry and physics, and we make no pretence at it in these pages, neither do we say that there is any fixed and definite division between these realms, for they are more or less intermixed. Solids and semi-solids blending with liquids, and these being permeated by gasses, but we do not wish it understood that there is gradual progression by gradation, step by step, and degree by degree, from

the most solid of solids, through semi-solids, liquids and gasses, and on through the spiritual realms, until the highest, most refined, subtle and elastic of all substances is reached spirit, pure, simple and divine. This progression from the coarse to the fine, constitutes a most perfect medium for the transmission of forces of all kinds, as we will soon learn.

So far, we have followed the teaching and principles of chemistry, physics and the common observation of every day life, and if we are not in error, the disciples of nearly every school of thought, will agree with what we have said concerning the material elements.

When we commence our investigation in the realm of gasses, our friends, the physicists and chemists, have been able to go a little way with us, but not until recent years could they grapple with the more refined and subtle gasses, although clairvoyance and psychometry had called attention to them, chemists found obstacles in their way. Their method of observation became too crude to deal with the higher and more rarified gasses.

The life long, careful researches of Sir William Crooks, the eminent chemist of London, England, lead him to give a positive demonstration of these higher gasses, and thus pave the way to higher progress in the arts of chemistry, by means of his ingenious radiometer, the vacuum tube that bears his name, and other devices. He has shown that there is a gas that was so highly rarified and refined, as to escape all former means of observation, and this gas he termed radiant matter, and it is by means of sending the interrupted galvano-magnetic current of the electrical induction coil, or from one of the static machines, through an atmosphere of this gas, which may be had by exhausting the air from a glass bulb, and seal the bulb up, without letting the air back, that the far famed and wonderful "X-Rays" are produced, as was discovered and made known to the world by William Conard Roentgen, of Barvaria, in the winter of 1895. Scientists have been forced to accept Prof. Crook's demonstrations as a proof of the existence of a higher condition of matter than was before known to chemistry and physics, and we affirm that this rarified gas forms the negative pole of the connecting link between the material and spiritual realms of the universe.




