

# GAS OF EXPANDED MATTER

Law XI of the motion of matter as taught by this magazine, says as my students will remember:

XI. As expanded gas is swelled up from the sun into greater orbits, the same amounts of space are filled with gas in the same times. This is correct except for the fact that as this gas is swelled.

This is correct except for the fact that as this gas is swelled and pushed up by gas below, its weight is upon the gas below and therefore is constantly becoming lighter as it goes farther up, inasmuch as the gas next to the sun is more condensed, by holding the weight of all above it, the same as air is more condensed at sea level, than on the mountain top, or as water is more condensed as you go down in it. The pressure under water, increases so fast, that an ordinary man will be killed at a depth of forty feet. The following cut will illustrate what I mean by the same gas filling the same space (and more as it gets lighter) in larger orbits.



You will perceive that it leaves the sun less and less rapidly, because it has a larger circle to fill, therefore the body of gas will occupy more space because it is so much larger in circumference. Half the distance to the nearest sun center is twelve million million miles and we can understand that up at that point the gas must be pretty thin and light. We must not forget either that motion (which is light, heat, electricity, etc.) will certainly travel at greater speed thru gas that is light, than thru gas that is heavy. The reason why we have light at the earth, is because the air is so dense that it makes a resistance to the expanding motion from the sun that the friction is the cause of light, and heat.

There is also another objection to this law which is that at some times there is more returning solid matter going into the sun, than at other times, evinced by more sun spots, resulting in more heat, electric display, etc., which are all results of returning matter. Consequently it is not dependent on time as the law states, but upon the amount of matter returning to the sun; therefore law XI should read:

As expanded matter is swelled up from the sun into greater orbits, more space is filled with the same gas, because it is less dense, having less weight of gas above it.

# A REPELLING MOTION

There are motions in nature that attract and repel, which we partially recognize but fail to explain and even deny, in many cases, which science must now recognize and explain. These motions are most manifest in the magnetic needle and the common magnet. They are considered very mysterious and "past finding out." In the first place there is no force in nature which cannot be found out and understood, when we drop the idea of mystery, inasmuch as force in nature, is a part of nature and nature be made either by expanding by heat, or contracting by cooling as I have often shown you and no motion can be made any other way.

These forces are directly related to the forces of attraction and repulsion which we see in the magnet and may therefore be explained easily provided we find what causes the forces in the magnet. Let us then examine the magnet for evidence of what its forces consist.

First, we subject it to great heat and we find that it has lost all of its so-called magic power. For a time it has lost its mystery and if we will follow this clew, it will lose its mystery for all time. If heat destroys magnetism, what does that fact indicate? Simply that magnetism is not force of heat expansion and as there is but one other cause of motion, *i. e.*, contraction by cooling, therefore it is a motion of contraction or cooling.

February 18th, showed us that when he was a young man sixty years ago, he recognized these magnetic forces in nature and that man may personally control them to attract or repel, but to me, he seems to have misapplied the evidence of their force in attempting to prove the existence of the human consciousness after death.

The late Dr. B. A. Wright who was one of our most honored members and a sound atheist was once in his younger days, a great magnetic medium and could attract and repel articles without knowing how he did it. Pioneer members of the Liberal Club will remember his lecture giving his own experience along that line in 1902.

About the same time birds were seen thru a telescope at night, at immense heights far above where it was supposed birds or any other life could possibly exist. The question arises how could they reach such immense heights unless by power of repulsion from the earth and how could they make a flight of thousands of miles in a single night but by repelling themselves to this great height and then dropping at lightning speed towards the south? All these things point directly to the fact that there is not only an attracting but also a repelling force in nature which we should not overlook.

The "pressure of sunlight" as they call it, is known to be a fact and can be and has been measured by Professor Lebedeu of Moscow, Russia. What this pressure is, is not known to science, but instead of sunlight it is the pressure of expanding gas from the sun. It is, however, the force of heat and is therefore the opposite to the force in a magnet.

## SOUND AND LIGHT

Gopel Chaundra, Bahawanipur, Culcutta, East India, asks a number of questions regarding the vibrations of light and especially the seven colors of the rainbow, with regard to their entering into the retina of the eye, with so many different speeds of vibration, as to cause confusion or mixing of them in the vision. Now we must remember that all sensation of touch, is simply a measurement of vibration and that sound is only the jarring of

vibrations coming from a vibrating object in the air, or other medium of transmission which we are in. The rapidity of the object's vibration regulates its tone. The slower the vibration the lower the tone and vice versa. For example: we may send as many telegraph messages over a single wire, as we can make distinct tones. They do not mix at all, unless the tones are so near alike as to be undistinguishable. Some people can distinguish more tones than others can and would make better musicians. So also, some eyes do not measure close enough to distinguish colors and are color blind. I once visited a friend at Atchison, Kansas, who was an expert telegraph operator. He had in his office seven different telegraph instruments clicking their messages over the same wire. Any one of these would attract his attention instantly when it called him because it was on a different tone or octave, from A to G, and his ear was so delicately attuned that these tones did not mix on his feeling of sound vibrations.

We know that the beautiful combination of harmonious sound is made by vibrating from A to G thru seven octaves. These are divided into smaller parts and these again into fractional parts, by many experts in music. Light of a rainbow might be explained in much the same way. There are seven cardinal colors corresponding with the seven octaves of music; that is to say, the ordinary retina can only measure seven until they blend, the same as in musical blending of tones. There are many other shades, if our retina could measure them, the same as there are many tones between the octaves of musical vibrations. Their mixing occurs only on a consciousness which is too coarse to measure them. It is not only possible but a logical conclusion that an instrument can be made to throw colors upon a screen in an artistic manner, similar to the artistic manner of music production, which would give exquisite delight to persons having artistic taste, the degree of delight depending upon the degree of capacity, to distinguish the finer blends of color, just as the degrees of delight, possible to a listener to fine music, depends upon the degree of listener's capacity, to distinguish the finer blends of tone. Perhaps this would make a soundless "light music" and possibly it could be played with the same keys used to play music with or at least simultaneously with music, changes being made with keys as in music. It is possible that if the colors were set in the order they occur in the rainbow. on the scale from A to G and then set to a beautiful tune of music. the effect on an artistic brain would be most astonishing.

There is a growing tendency on the sage it seems to me, to enjoy the colored lights thrown on the dancing girls and dark screens. Often these colors follow each other with grand effect, but often they will grate harshly on the artistic eye and mind, just as bad music, or an instrument out of tune, will grate harshly on an artistic ear and mind of a good musician.

The state of California is yet exempt from the curse of Sunday legislation; but if we Liberals relax into a state of indifference and fancied security the politico-religious element will score a similar triumph in regard to Sunday legislation that they did, when they carried the state in favor of "church exemption from taxation;" simply, through the indifference and lack of organization among Liberals.

The present censorship of the press would never have been tolerated in Lincoln's time; but the American people through their mad race after the "almighty dollar" have allowed the word "liberty" to become an outcast in the land of its birth. Liberalism is essentially an organized movement in defense of human liberty. It is a declaration of human rights. It's purpose is to secure to mankind the full enjoyment of their right to "life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness." No organization on earth ever enlisted in so noble a cause ever set out to achieve so glorious a consummation. # THE ZODIACAL LIGHT

The zodiacal light now appears in all its glory and will continue to be seen until May. This time of the year, you will find it in the west after the sunlight has disappeared, reaching from the horizon in a pyramid, to an apex almost to the zenith, where the constellation of the Pliades is now located. This beautiful Southern Climate, makes it more noticable here, than perhaps in any other part of the world. Be sure and study it when the moon is dark. This curious phenomena is undoubtedly caused by the sunlight shining upon untold billions of meteors, scattered comets, asteroids and disintegrated planets, which have gone to pieces when they have reached a point on their way falling to the sun, where their speed is so great that their centrifugal force almost balances the gravity of the sun, taking away their own center of gravity. The heat expansion (repulsion) from the sun also gives a comet-like light, to the whole and helps check their approach to the sun. By noticing this light carefully you will be able to locate the plane of the sun's equator thru space, upon which every planet. moon, asteroid, etc., revolves; and which you will notice is at right angles to the Milkey Way and is surrounded by the nebulæ, or clouds of crystals which came from the sun as gas, and are the material out of which these big, light, new wrolds are gathered.


