## EXPANDING AND CONTRACTING

Magnetism and Electricity are both motions; are positive and negative, and either one can be destroyed by an excess of the other, which proves that either may be said to exist only because of a lack of the other, and that they are mutually attracting each other or equalizing. Now it seems that this everlasting current of equalizing motion can be traced in every thing, even to the opposite ends of a magnetic needle, as you may demonstrate by sprinkling iron filings on a sheet of paper, holding a magnetic needle under it and watching the arranging of the filings.

The human or any other animal is a bundle of circles of motions, positive and negative, equalizing or expanding and contracting by heating and cooling. We might say a little solar system within itself, and must itself go back into the reservoir of matter and force when worked out. It is but the temporary center of an organization or system of matter where these forces are equalizing. The heart which the text books would teach us is a great engine which pumps tons of blood every twenty-four hours, is not a muscular organ at all, any more than the liver is, and is but a set of valves which open and shut by the positive and negative charges of electricity or heating and cooling, which causes expansion and contraction alternately. The blood circulates thru a system of tubes with valves so it can only flow away from the heart continually branching and dividing to smaller streams until at last it finishes its outward journey in millions of ramifications, where it is cooled and taken up by veins which are ramified in the same manner, each tributary vein swelling the current as it proceeds back or completes the circle to the heart and lungs, where it is again broken into ramifications into every part of the lungs, where the oxygen may have access to chemically heat it, and again collected and returned to the heart warm, or positive, or in an expanded state, and when we come to analyze the whole circuit and the positive and negative action of the heart and lungs we find that the whole body and the motion of circulation is an electric machine or temporary center of motion of heating and cooling, where these two forces are equalizing. The rotation of the earth upon its axis may also be caused by positive and negative electricity the same way by heating and cooling, i. e., by the cool or night side which would be negative con-

stantly being attracted by the sun which is positive, and the warm or day side, being continually repelled by the sun, because they are both positive. I can take a piece of quartz crystal, heat it white hot, dissolve it, immerse it in muriatic acid (to make sure there are no life germs in it,) and then by introducing a positive and negative pole of a galvanic battery, so as to pass a current of force thru it, develop a living being in it, thus absolutely proving that this force organizes the dead matter into life. At least anyone but a christian would accept the positive proof.

 Or a bald-head fool, or both.

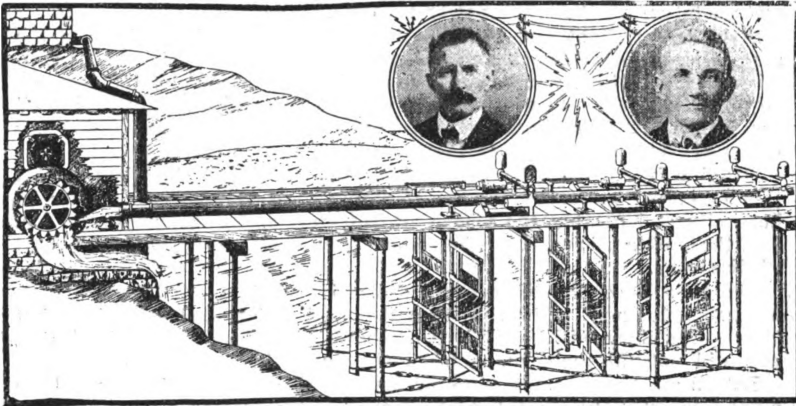
## USE YOUR REASON
