

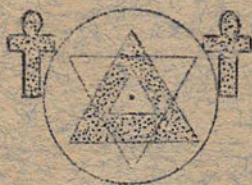

# PSYCHOLOGY & METAPHYSICS

(Part two)

The nervous system supplies means by which the mind can reach all parts or organs of the body. Certain organs are so constructed as to collect or focalize vibratory impressions from the surface of the human body. These sensations are conveyed to the mind by nervous impulses travelling along connected nerve-paths. Others are so made as to respond to motor impulses from the brain and spinal cord activating, or motivating various muscles and glands toward the physical adaptation of the organism to its environment.

If the co-ordination of the various parts of the nervous system is defective, an abnormal situation arises wherein the sensory sensations received by the brain and the motor impulses sent out therefrom are both liable to be incomplete, if not entirely false. Lack of adaptation of the physical body results. The body is liable any moment to plunge itself into destruction because of this disruption of its nerve habits. On the other hand, a situation wherein all stimuli are correctly received, and all motor impulses are quickly and exactly transmitted, is indicative of normalcy and the mental and nervous health so essential to the con-

structive, progressive adaptation of the organism to its environment.

A simple but clear example of the necessity of sharp perception and quick reaction is the following: a man has taken a hot iron in his hand; if his reaction is slow or otherwise at fault, a serious burn will result. The proper attunement of the sensory, associative, and motor nerves is the primary requisite of a normal being. The man, also, learned by the above behavior that hot irons are not to be picked up with impunity. Suppose that his right hand was thus burned; he has acquired the knowledge to protect it henceforth, and the left hand as well. Thus knowledge of the material world increases. The mind learns; it seeks ever to preserve and protect the instrument by means of which it lives.

In Metaphysics we learn that the Cosmic Mind operates in a similar manner. Just as the nervous system with all its parts and divisions makes up the objective mind, so do the human minds of the Universe make up the Cosmic Mind. Your minds, great and small, are all parts, sensitive to stimuli and open to commands, of the Great Mind we call the Cosmic Mind. The totality of all minds in the Cosmos forms one large mind. This mind of the Cosmos receives our experiences and sends forth impulses to all its member minds in the same manner that our minds receive sensory stimuli and send out motor impulses to



the various parts of the body. Because of this and since we are parts of the Cosmos, we can receive all the knowledge which the Cosmic Mind has gained from the experience of its other individual units, after we have properly co-ordinated ourselves with, or attuned ourselves to, this Greater Mind.

The functions of the objective mind, as psychology observes them, are true as far as they go. But phenomena of subjective origin are forced to Metaphysics for explanation and clarification. The Metaphysician is qualified to penetrate into the mysteries of the subjective mind, because it is by subjective means that Cosmic experiences are construed. Only through subjective penetration can the fundamental purpose of man as a unit of Cosmic Consciousness be understood. Metaphysics, the scope of which is as vast as the universe, unveils the mysteries. First, it has the student study the objective, the subjective, and the Cosmic minds in their relationship to each other and in terms of their meaning, application and purpose. Only by first comprehending their intimate inter-relationship is one prepared to approach the study of the Secret Life - the inner, glowing mystery that is the end and goal of all seekers for Mystic Truth. It is no more than natural that without an intelligent concept of the master mind, the functions of the lesser minds are mysterious and little understood. The door to Cosmic comprehension is within

us, waiting to be opened when we have found the key, and that door is none other than our subjective mind.

This is truly a wondrous study; the reason we delve so deeply into Metaphysics is to learn more and more about the Cosmic Mind, so that we may better understand the part we are to play in the life we are living.

Also, we wish to learn how to attain the Greater Life, the Perpetual Life of Cosmic Harmony. Our first understanding is our realization of our unity with everything. We must know that we are creator and created. We must realize the comprehensiveness and wisdom of the Cosmos. In this way only can we realize the power we have within us.

As I have said, psychologists limit the field of study to the world around them. They do not recognize life in all its phases and in all its extensions. Metaphysics extends the vision of all students to all parts of life, regardless of the distance that these parts may be from home. Life, even in the most remote regions of the universe is of interest to the Metaphysicians, for they know that each bit of knowledge they can discover, enhances their wisdom and can be used to further their development.
