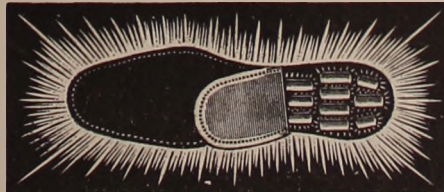

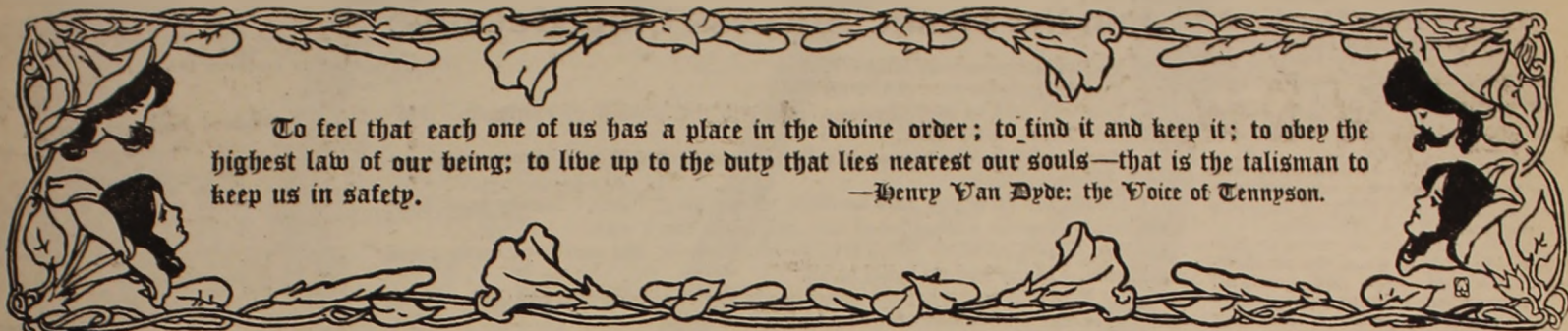

These words, coming from the prime minister of England, meant a great deal. Balfour, one of Gladstone's successors, has been actively engaged in the investigations ancient psychical phenomena.

He Was Australian.—John F. S. The quotation you ask about is from a poem, "Afar in the Desert," by A. Lindsay Gordon, the Australian poet. By a curious coincidence, in one of my notebooks I have some unpublished lines of his, written and signed A. Lindsay Gordon. Here they are, with the English spelling:

"Question not but, live and labour, Till the goal be won; Helping every feeble neighbour, Asking help from none; Life is mostly froth and bubble, Two things stand like stone; Kindness in another's trouble, Courage in our own."

MISS EVANGELINE S. ADAMS, an astrologer, who is given credit for having forecasted the burning of the Windsor Hotel, cast the horoscope of the new King of England. She sees nothing but unrest and trouble for England, and nothing of kingliness in its King. He is the dangerous combination of a narrow and stubborn man.

"If I were to sum up the character of King George in a sentence," said Miss Adams, "I would say that he is a Grant without Grant's breadth and strength. He was born under Taurus, the least princely of all the signs of the Zodiac, and his strongest characteristic is the blind stubbornness of the bull. He is colorless, but when opposition arouses his stubbornness he will stick to his plans, though it be manifest to a child that he is wrong. This is the mark of a mediocre man, and that is what the new king is.

WILL FEAR REPUBLIC

"There will be in him what has but seldom occurred to his predecessors," continued Miss Adams, "the constant fear of a Republic. And this fear will be well grounded. As soon as his reign begins to be felt in the world of English politics there will be born, and rise rapidly, a strong Republican party. It is more than likely that a Republic will be established before his death."

Miss Adams then went on to compare him with his father, and the son suffered in the comparison.

"He has not his father's gift of winning the affection of his people," she said, "and this is natural, because he is not at heart a ruler or a public servant. He is naturally domestic. If he could be left alone with his wife and family he would be perfectly contented.

"Neither has he his father's financial ability. If he meddles in the stock market or any speculative investment he is doomed to lose. He has not the foresight to be a good financier or a good king.

"His queen has more initiative and more force, and will be a prominent factor in his reign. In this connection there will be in 1913, or early in the following year, a scandal that will shake the royal family to its foundation. FORETOLD KING'S DEATH.

"Before Lady Paget went back to England we were talking about the king's health, and she asked me to cast his horoscope," said Miss Adams. "But she told me it there was anything gloomy in it not to include that, as she wanted to show it to the king to cheer him. I went to work and presently wrote to Lady Paget and told her it was impossible to give her the kind of horoscope she wanted. I told her that if His Majesty were alive six weeks from the date of the letter I would try again. He was dead before the end of the six weeks."

"I am sorry that I cannot see more cheerful times ahead of King George and his people, but there is no hope. I do not care to specify further, but what I have said may be relied upon as certain to take place."

The bull typifies power, tenacity and endurance. It is also the symbol of pro-

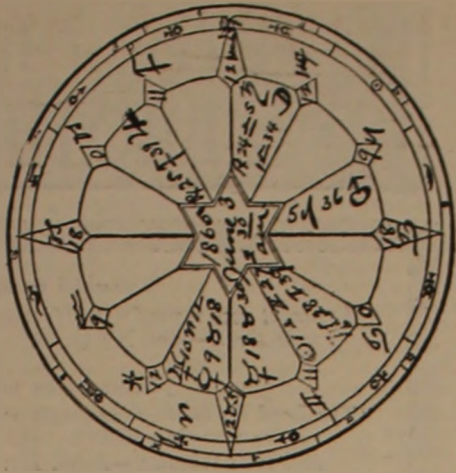


Chart of the King's Horoscope

SLOW OF DEVELOPMENT

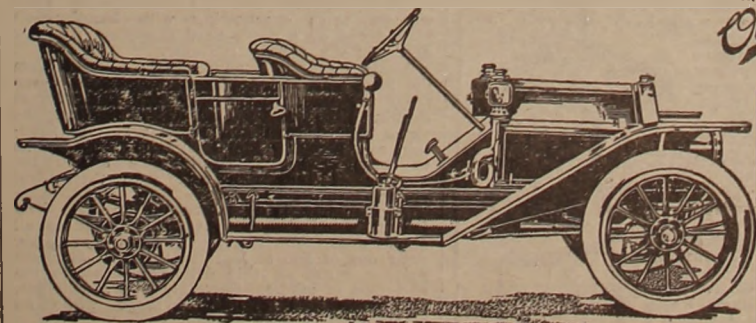

Swedenborg

By Servator

SEVERAL have asked me about Swedenborg. This remarkable genius was, for the first fifty years of his life, a most prolific and versatile scientist, inventor, philosopher and statesman.

As a man of the world he loved the good things of life, and particularly the pleasures of the table. Being at an inn in London one time, he ordered an elaborate dinner served in his private room.

Before the dinner was quite finished, a peculiar lassitude overcame him and objects around him became misty and mysterious.

The darkness that enshrouded him suddenly cleared and he beheld a man in a corner of the room eyeing him reproachfully. Swedenborg tried to rise and to speak, but his physical frame had lost its power.

Then the visitor spoke the words—"Cease Over-Eating." Then the darkness came again, with the swarming reptiles and finally the light and normal conditions.

That night came a second vision. This time there were no reptiles or unpleasant conditions. The Presence appeared in the midst of great white light that brilliantly illuminated the bed chamber.

He found that in this intermediate state of existence, certain cosmic laws still prevailed; the evil minded gravitated toward their kind; the pure and the righteous sought out kindred spirits ere they passed on to higher planes.

The next day Swedenborg realized that he had not slept, but had been abnormally conscious. He also remembered that he had previously received symbolic dreams from time to time—a tongue of flame, a golden key, and voices.

On returning to Sweden he arrived at Gottenburg to spend a few days with some friends there. Within three hours after his arrival he suddenly exclaimed that a dangerous fire had just broken out at Stockholm, 300 miles away and was spreading rapidly.

Great excitement prevailed in Gottenburg as the news spread of Swedenborg's statements, but many ridiculed him. There being no railroads nor telegraphs in those days the people of Gottenburg had to wait some 48 hours before any news came.

Swedenborg's home at Stockholm soon became a visiting place for the inquisitive. People wanted to communicate with the other world for all sorts of reasons, but Swedenborg refused to gratify the idle curiosity of most of the callers.

When visitors satisfied him, however, that their cause was just and something more than mere curiosity, he acceded to their desires and with astonishing results. Some time later, while at Amsterdam, he told the people he was with that just then Peter III, in far-away Russia was being murdered.

Soon spread all over Europe. Royalty and the great and learned eagerly sought him, but he devoted most of his remaining years to transcribing his impressions and psychical experiences.

At the age of 84 he predicted that on the 29th of March he would pass over to the world of spirits and upon the day predicted his physical life ended.

The investigations of Janet, Sidis, Prince, Myers, Gurney and others throw a good deal of light upon the transformation such as occurred to Swedenborg.

His frequent dissociation from the physical self cannot be considered in the sense of mediumship or trance conditions. He retained the command of his own personality, his individuality and many of his experiences he avowedly attributed to what we now call telepathy.

This man of gigantic intellect was unquestionably inspired, combining normal and abnormal powers to a most unusual degree. He expressed many noble truths, though his fantastic pictures of heaven and hell frequently border upon the hallucinatory.

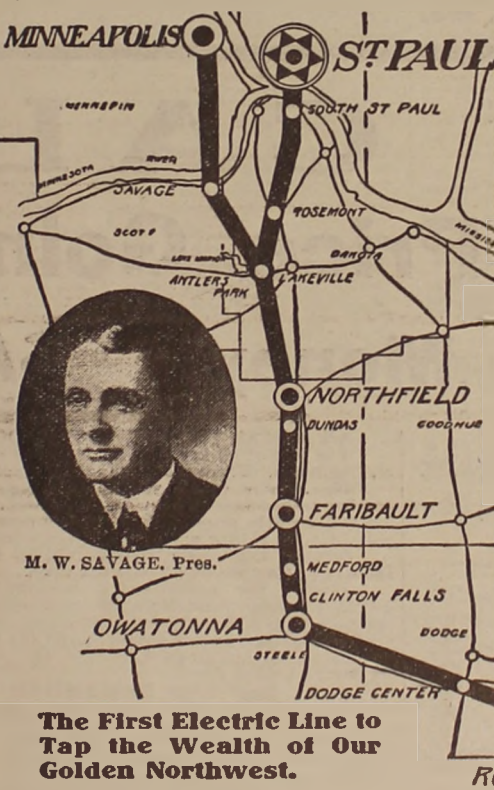

Walking It Off

By Graham Hood

WESTON, who recently completed his marvelous walk from the Pacific to the Atlantic, is quite as much the philosopher as he is the pedestrian, and during his tramp—tramps that would put many a younger man to bed under the arm of a physician, he has evolved some theories that deserve to be distributed widely that all the world may know of them.

Practically speaking, every one of us enjoys life and wants to make it as long as possible. In a word, the lust of living is in every heart. Even those who seem the most dissatisfied with things as they are—the misanthrope—the pessimist—the critic—all fight hard for life if by any chance it is threatened. Schopenhauer taught principles that life was a burden, in bearing which we were never repaid and never could be repaid; it would have been better for us had we never been born. In spite of this Schopenhauer clung to life with all the avidity that he could possibly have shown had he been one of earth's most genial optimists. He simply helped to prove what many of us know, that intellectual theory and a practical philosophy are two entirely different things.

There may be some who, temporarily, deem life not worth the living, but they are in number, and the sentiments which now possess them will eventually be discarded for a more cheerful character. For most of us, on the other hand, life is a most enjoyable one and we would do almost anything within reason if we felt that we might prolong our stay on earth.

It is here that Mr. Weston's philosophy becomes of practical value, for he teaches us of health that will lengthen the days of any man or woman who will adopt it and follow conscientiously.

To do this, however, it is necessary that we should get out of our present sluggish habit. He does not advocate a new method of diet that can be pursued at home without troubling anybody. To many persons this may seem like a serious matter, and, under present conditions, is; yet there is not the slightest question that were we to pursue this course of treatment, ills that are now bothering us would quickly disappear. The trouble with most of us is that we do not exercise enough. Transportation is so easy and economical that we are wise to save a few minutes wherever possible by taking a street car or the subway. It is but a nickel to do this, and the time it saves may be worth many times the value of the nickel to us.

Logical as this argument may seem at present, we must rid ourselves of such ideas and are to take advantage of Mr. Weston's gospel of exercise. At first thought, six, eight or ten miles seems a long distance to walk, but if we were to take advantage of every opportunity that we have to walk, instead of riding, comparatively few miles would be left uncovered at the end of the day. By adding a mile or two in the evening, when we have plenty of time to spend in walking, we should find that we had covered the ten miles almost without knowing it.

As a cure for rheumatism, there is nothing better than walking. It may be a treatment, but it is the best and cheapest remedy known to man. There are other ills, too, that may be walked off just as easily. Disease brought about by indigestion—the ailments caused by eating too much, or the wrong kinds of food—all these things give way to the improvement that walking alone can give us.

And then, as Mr. Weston says, these are not the only ills that can be walked off. "Walking isn't only a cure for the body," he insists. "It is a cure for the brain. If you have a sore head, walk it off! If you have mental worries, walk them off! A good appetite, sound sleep, the perfect composure of mind that comes after these blessings will solve many problems."

It is "Weston the Pedestrian" who is speaking, but if it was "Weston the Philosopher" he could not utter truer words. For sorrow, for worry, for every kind of mental ills, there is no quicker or surer cure than long walks. If you don't believe this, try it for yourself. Sit in the house moping over your troubles. Get out into God's fresh air. You will be astonished to see how thoroughly you can walk them off.

that he will meet with a great deal of opposition.

The Moon, a beneficent planet, which stands for the masses and the poor people, was in that portion of the heavens ruling the health of the individual as well as that of the nation. Now, as I remarked before, in my long experience with the spiritualists, I have picked up a whole lot of information, and am willing that the world should know it; although I know the ministerial part of it would say I was a fit subject for the madhouse; but still I claim the right to acknowledge what I have seen with my own eyes, rather than merely believe what a lot of other people have said I must believe. 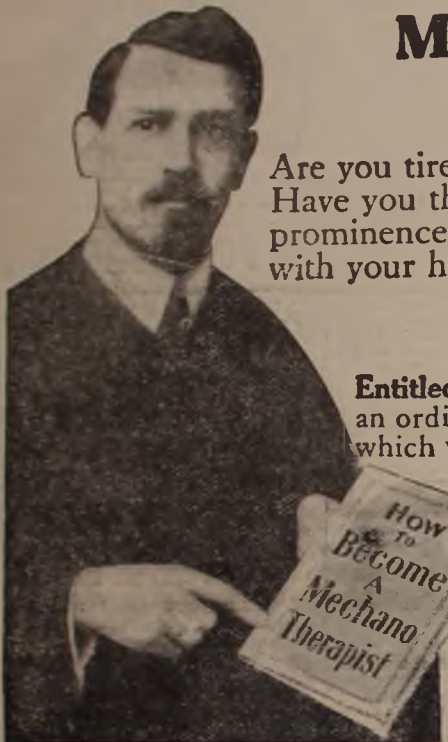
