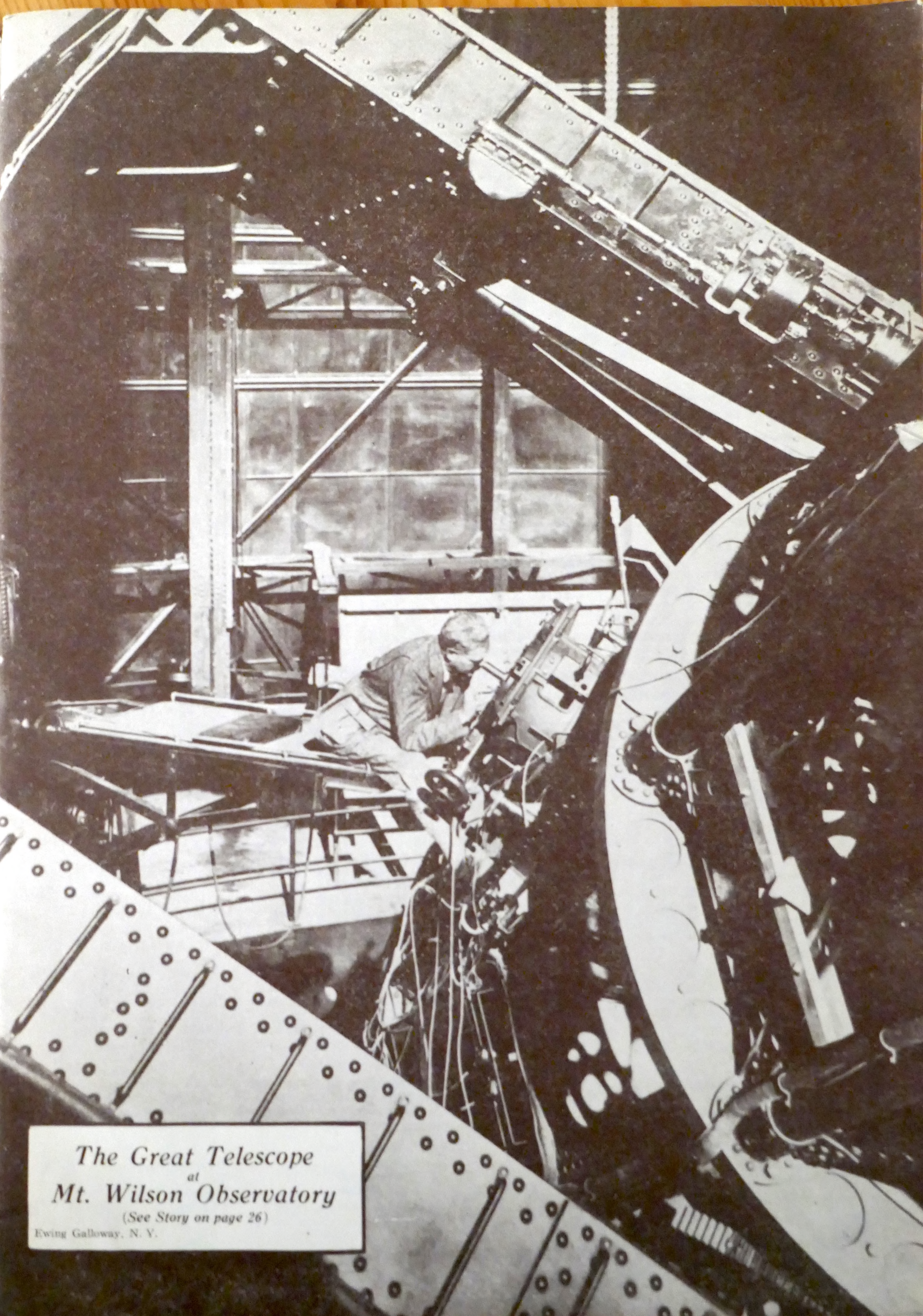

THE LUNATION falling in a fixed sign with fixed signs on the angles of the horoscope mark a month of great obstacles, which are initiated by destructive force, encased by a powerful will in order to withstand outer protecting influences. These forces refuse to yield to the implorings of man and so continually submit one imposition after another.

Uranus being dominant represents a pressure with equally tremendous energy, driving power and purpose, an opponent which man must combat.

The planetary battle is on. A great battle between man and Nature. The latter heaps ruin upon ruin and man attempts to rule and overcome, even staking his life in the attempt.

Dramatic are the occurrences of the month, to be enacted with the Leo tempo rising and ascending to one high grand note and then suddenly crashing as its notes fail and weaken, yet in a most graceful and ceremonious Scorpio manner despite the now pitiful situation and the weakness of theme.

Pluto nearing the ascendant centralizes and makes sensational the coming events. The Water-Earth element holding firmly inherent and deep-rooted emotions now finds an outlet in swift currents.

The month opens on a grand scheme, enhanced by glamour, so ably connected with the movies and theater. Sports, speculation and young people join in. The masses swing into a fast pace, with government affairs and superiors, and politics are in the lead. All seek to get there first, to beat the other fellow, whether it be in game or contest.

The chip-off-the-old-block now runs into the chip-on-the-shoulder with a "you dare and cross me" look. Deep resentments leave way for bitter hatreds that seethe in the breasts of man. The slightest friction sets the dynamite cap off into blazing unknowns. The world at large is under a nervous tension and powerful angular afflictions will not allow these overrushing energies to be suppressed.

Grating the ruffled edges is the return opposition of Saturn and Neptune, which harassed our footsteps during all of 1936 until April, 1937. Our readers will remember the great destruction it wrought in the form of disastrous floods in the stricken Ohio Valley region and the numerous sit-down strikes or the war between Capital (Saturn) and Labor (Neptune).

These now return and in even greater intensity. The retrograde motion for a third time repeats over now tender routes. A retrograde

planet takes on the influence of an outer planet and Uranus (the outer in this case) opposes the four angles, marking November as a drastic month.

Mere casualties of the past do not compare with these. More great floods and Uranus opposing a fourth house Lunation involving Taurus-Scorpio afflictions brings earthquakes and volcanic eruptions. There will be great destruction of crops and property. Man again builds up what Nature repeatedly tears down, so typical of Uranus which destroys the old to make way for the new. November is a month to be reckoned with and long remembered.

The Lunation occurring in the fourth house directs the released planetary energy into matters of land, buildings, farmers, miners, and weather conditions. The Lunation conjunction Mercury, square Pluto, opposition Uranus and sesqui-quadrature Saturn is decidedly adverse for these matters. Severe weather conditions result. Mercury showing strong winds, gales; Uranus lightning, and Pluto causes freak unheard of weather leaning to extremes that are unseasonable.

There is danger of mines, or buildings collapsing or suffering from fire and explosions. Note above when the transiting Mars (ruler of the fourth house) opposes Pluto November 11th, squares Lunation November 25th, squares Uranus November 26th and Mercury November 28th. Venus moves into Scorpio and the fourth house on November 12th and moves forward to a T Square of Mars and Uranus which is exact above November 21st. Between these two latter dates the above matters are in full swing.

The Full Moon period ushers in a partial eclipse of the Moon on November 18th in 25 degrees Taurus. This decanate is associated with snakes and creeping insects which will perish by the millions. This eclipse is visible at Washington and occurs in the eighth house there. In Taurus its effects are lasting. There will be the death of a prominent woman. Much

sickness, epidemics, and many deaths occur, also earthquakes and mining disasters. There is evidence of great agricultural depression and scarcity of corn and earth products due to drought. Watch the middle western states, especially St. Louis, Mo., which is ruled by Taurus.

While the Eclipse in itself is not afflicted, Venus, the ruler of the eclipse sign, opposes Uranus on the eighth cusp and these two square a fourth house Mars. This points to heavy financial loss through property damage. Questions arise over the nation's finances. Also commercial affairs, banks and women suffer from the effects of this eclipse.

The Lunation horoscope closely corroborating that of the Eclipse warns Mr. John Q. Public be he in private residences, schools, amusement places, or business houses, to check all steam pipes for leaks, go over all oil and gas burners, for great fires and explosions may take a heavy toll, among young people especially.

Travel is under adverse rays. Railways considering the prominent Uranus and aviation with the rising Neptune in opposition to Saturn. Accidents are liable in water (Saturn in Pisces), and also collisions in mid-air due to atmospheric conditions. Airplanes catch on fire and explode close to earth.

Ships share in tragic mishaps. Storms and collisions cause loss of life off the coast. There is evidence of sickness being prevalent during travel. Saturn in the ninth house causes trouble in the religious and legal world, shipping and foreign trade. Elderly members of church, law and state pass away.

The Saturn opposition Neptune this winter will bring unusually cold weather and persons may suffer asphyxiation in close rooms, huddling up to keep warm and so neglect careful observation of the heating system. Damage done under this aspect will leave bad drinking water and plumbing will tend to get out of order. A siege of intestinal flu clamps down on the nation.

Pluto in orb of the ascendant indicates the hardships facing the people through suffering and want. They feel the effects in poor housing and lack of proper nourishment. Great mass action stirs and violence follows.

Uranus in the M. C. disturbs and throws into an upheaval the government powers of Washington. Sudden and unexpected troubles face them. Great and adverse changes evoke unpopular reforms. Parties split and bills fail as difficulties continually arise.

While authority now holds the upper hand and has the say as to the run and order of matters, the little fellow remains tightly under their thumb. But superhuman effort gives the latter the necessary strength to break loose and added with a vanity of calm self-assurance brings them out and up to the top.

Especially the more unfortunate (Moon ruling the twelfth house) who have gone through rigid denials and strenuous tasks unbelievable in stark reality feel this influence. They make

definite demands, with the prospects of a barren path stretching ahead, covered only by a blanket of snow in the bleak winter months. Placing their cards on the table they are heeded only by tangible promises of future consideration.

But their patience is outworn and they proceed to fight for their demands. That they gain marked results is indicated by the big changes in government affairs. Many higher-ups are ousted. Scandals are brought to light, for a retrograde Uranus in the Tenth house exerts much ill and adds emphasis to the unpleasantness of government affairs. The higher powers continue to instill contempt in the minds of others. It is an open month of confusion, disorder and hostility. The people bitterly defy and oppose the President and his order.

Examining other charts we can well understand the intensity with which Uranus will operate this month.

First in the U. S. horoscope the progressed Mercury opposing the progressed Uranus from the seventh and first angles respectively tends to stir the people of this mighty nation, upsetting their minds and causing them to move at a high rate of nervous tension or speed. Extreme and radical ideas constantly break forth. Personal betterment and future safety are feared for.

Transiting Neptune is square the U. S. Mars on November 26th. This inclines to mob action, riots, and a disordered state of mind. The birth square touched off brings out scandalous love affairs. Illicit pleasures end in tragedy. Travel for pleasure is adverse.

Uranus rules the Lunation seventh house and so highlights foreign affairs, scandals, divorces, and lawsuits. Chaotic destruction in foreign countries is at the back of our country's fears.

The Lunation opposing the Solar Ingress Uranus heralds more news in its most exciting pathos from foreign lands.

The Lunation falling in the President's third house and square his Sun and Neptune, involving a T cross, takes him on the crossroads, where decisions weigh heavily upon his shoulders. He finds little peace of mind with neighboring cities clamoring, while foreign affairs hold his attention. His mental anxiety is deep and our sympathies are with him at this trying time. The Lunation Uranus stirs his personality, which is indicated by his own prominent Uranus.

The Mars conjunction Jupiter aspect in Capricorn upsets government regulations in the western part of the U. S. Pluto opposing these planets, and signifying graft, indicates that police are involved and they suffer discredit.

Thus in three most important horoscopes we find Uranus prominent and ready for action.

Uranus rules aviation, railways, radio, telegraphing, telephoning, machines, electricity, and science. These are now under very adverse rays. Public companies, municipalities and po-

The ingress takes place in your ninth house and as Mercury is also posited in this house it is apparent that long journeys, voyages, publications, law, religion or philosophy and higher educational interests are to the fore. THE ingress horoscope for Scorpio is calculated as usual for the 90th degree West Longitude and the 35th parallel of latitude. Thus the ingress chart is applicable to a greater proportion of people than would otherwise be the case. The ingress chart embodies a new method in solar forecasting that is unique. Judging from the number of letters complimenting us on this system it would also appear to reach a high degree of accuracy. Naturally the major planet transit influences are also considered in relation with the ingress horoscope. An ingress is simply the exact beginning of a planetary transit of any particular zodiacal sign. In this case it is the ingress of the Sun into your birthsign.

The first degree of the zodiacal sign Aquarius is rising in your solar ingress horoscope this year. This makes the radical, disruptive, progressive and occult planet Uranus your planetary ruler for the year ahead. We find Uranus posited in your third ingress house in the sign Taurus. Uranus has been a disturbing influence in your life for some time. Especially does he affect those whose birthdates fall between November 2nd to the 10th of any year.

The third house position of Uranus may incline you to a somewhat radical or progressive interest, perhaps of a financial nature, in literature, lecturing, and advertising. You may now take advantage of radical innovations or make sudden departures into new fields. You may tend to be a little more restless than is usual to a person born under a fixed sign. This restlessness may manifest as nervousness, irritability, sudden moves, changes, unexpected events, travel, and unusual letters. bility are possible. It is a good period in which to consider all important interests regarding real estate, agriculture or mines. Begin slow developing enterprises under this influence or make such plans. It is a period of stability.

Neptune remains in favorable aspect to your sign this year. It especially affects those whose birthdays fall between November 11th to the 15th any year. It has a somewhat subtle influence that is favorable for those engaged in metaphysical or mystical studies. Intuitions should be noted or hunches followed. With the Ingress falling in the ninth house this aspect favors the study of mystical philosophy, art and religion, as well as voyages overseas. Neptune is in harmonious aspect with both Mars and Jupiter, a position which is indicative of benefit as outlined. Also Uranus is slowly approaching a trine or friendly aspect to Neptune. This future aspect favors increased interest in occult and astrological subjects. In fact it is quite possible that a wider interest in spiritual and astral science will mark the next few years as unique in this twentieth century.

Jupiter opens the year in conjunction with Mars and urges that you practice economy somewhat in 1938. Jupiter remains from October 23rd to December 19th in friendly aspect with your birthsign. This affects those especially who have their birthdays between November 13th to the 22nd any year. Also the second decan or those born November 3rd to the 12th any year from February 1st until March 16th. The third decan of Scorpio comes under this influence from March 17th to May 13th and again from July 30th to December 30th. This affects you especially if your birthdate falls between November 13th and the 22nd of any year.

DAYS TO COME!

APPROACHING the Christmastide of another year we still find the spirit of *peace on earth, good will to men* remote in this troubled world. The age is a cycle of unrest and social insecurity which has added considerably to the fears and worries of mankind. Man is more than just a physical body—he is one with Nature, the Great Mother, and so it is in line with ancient astro-occultism that present unusual moods of destruction and unrest evidenced in Nature are to be considered as but the reflection of man's disturbed psychic and mental condition.

There appear indications of startling developments in the future of this country that should command the attention of the occult or astrological student, for even now the shadow of things to come falls ominously over our civilization.

Few people understand that there is an astrological cycle of 84 years which is of tremendous importance to these United States. This is the cycle of the planet Uranus through the Zodiac. Uranus spends seven years in transit through each sign of the Zodiac, thus making a total of 84 years for the cycle of the twelve signs.

A cycle is but a ring or a turning—that is, it represents the return of an impulse to a similar position in regard to its starting point. Human life is a cycle of which we only know the slight arc of this physical earth life. The period between the successive births of the ego complete the human cycle of rebirth. All life manifests in waves or cycles, such as the seasons of the year and the minor cycle of day and night. This periodical return of impulses is the one most important universal law.

A cycle such as the Uranian cycle which we are studying is of little importance unless there exists behind it an original impulse or force which is stimulated into activity during the culminating point of the cycle. In this respect let us study the basic astrological nature of the planet Uranus in order to understand better its influence over the United States at the culmination of its cycle in 1943.

THE SPIRITUAL INFLUENCE OF URANUS. Uranus is the perceiver, the spiritual consciousness, the inner "awakener" and the seat of intuition and altruism.

THE CIRCUMSTANCES PRODUCED BY URANUS. The planet tends to produce "sudden changes, estrangements, exiles, blind impulses, catastrophes, romantic tragedies, inexplicable changes of fortune; accidents; secret enemies and plotting, sudden elevation," when prominent in one's personal horoscope.

THE MUNDANE DOMINION OF URANUS. It tends to produce strikes, national disturbances, and unusual happenings as determined by Mundane Astrology. It rules the powerful magnetic currents or vibrations of the Earth, electricity and radio-activity.

THE PHYSIOLOGICAL FUNCTIONS OF URANUS. Uranus governs the human aura, the nervous

system, bodily electricity and the mental processes along with the planet Mercury.

THE DISEASES CAUSED BY URANUS WHEN AFFLICTED IN THE HOROSCOPE. Tends to ruptures, spasmodic disorders of all kinds, stricture, shock, cramps, spasms, acute nervous conditions, disorders having a psychic origin.

THE HOROSCOPICAL INFLUENCE OF URANUS. It produces an intensely sharp, sudden, unexpected, and in the main adverse or unfortunate, uncertain and erratic effect, tends to strange developments and, as Carter states, is "unexpected and drastic, and as a rule inevitable."

THE TEMPERAMENT PRODUCED BY URANUS. Tends to develop an impulsive, quite original, unconventional, intuitional, and independent character. One born under this planet is usually fond of curious studies, astrology, metaphysics, antiquities and progressive ideas in politics. The nature is often inventive, freedom-loving, idealistic, pioneering, altruistic; and so, interested in the practical application of humanitarian principles in social and political life. The true Uranian when highly evolved or developed is a most progressive individual often generations ahead of his fellows in regard to mental and spiritual conceptions. The undeveloped Uranian is often a crank, querulous and eccentric, finding great pleasure in just "being different."

It should be apparent from the study of the above known astrological facts that the influence of Uranus over a people at the time of a culmination of a cycle can be quite drastic, leading to tremendous reforms in political and social life. Now let us study the effect of Uranus over the United States.

The horoscope of the Declaration of Independence calculated for Philadelphia, July 4th, 1776, at 2:17 A.M., finds Uranus in 8.51 degrees (approximately nine degrees) of Gemini, the ruling sign of the United States. This nine degree point of Gemini is the culmination of the 84-year cycle of Uranus so far as this country is concerned. It has been noticed that each transit of Uranus over this degree has precipitated the entire effects of Uranus in Gemini and so is attended by drastic conditions. In fact the really great crises faced by this nation have come during this Uranian transit. There are of course several different horoscope charts given as the natal chart of this country. One gives Virgo on the ascendant; another Libra; however, the most authentic chart is the one used here which shows the natal sign of America on the ascendant—Gemini. By this horoscope the great astrologer Sibley predicted the rise of the United States to world power and commercial importance. An impartial study of the American people in the mass well reveals the psychological tendencies imparted by the sign Gemini.

THE CYCLES OF URANUS OVER AMERICAN HISTORY

The years 1607 to 1614 are memorable as they constitute the first known cycle of this strange

planet through Gemini so far as the colonization of this continent is concerned. At this time the country was but sparsely populated. The British were just making their first permanent attempt as colonization. So unsettled was the period between 1607 to 1614 that most of the colonizers decided to go elsewhere. Fortunately, in the nick of time other immigrants and supplies arrived from England. The period was one of suffering, sickness, anarchy, civil strife, war with the Indians, starvation and want. Nor was there to be any appreciable improvement in the condition of the colony until Uranus had, in 1614, left Gemini.

Eighty-four years later we come to the period 1691 to 1698. Again Uranus enters Gemini and produces another important period in the history of the country. To give an illustration of how eccentric or how far from the norm this planetary influence can swing the American people is to be found in the horrible Salem witchcraft insanity that swept the country. Uranus entered Gemini in the spring of 1691 and at Salem the first development in witchcraft occurred in February 1692 and in June of that year the first trial took place. It seemed as if everyone was bewitched, so powerful was the public conviction or delusion. Throughout the period on the frontiers the Indians did everything in their power to make things miserable. It was only when Uranus was on its way out of Gemini in 1697 that peace returned to this troubled land.

The return of the cycle brings us to the most important page of American history. The years from 1775 to 1782 brought into being a period that was to try the souls of men—the American Revolution. In all the Uranian cycles through Gemini it will be noticed that the ninth degree, or to be more accurate, 8 degrees and 51 minutes of Gemini, is a very sensitive spot. The transit of Uranus is always preparatory up to this point for the coming conditions. It seems that the tremendous electro-magnetic or psycho-magnetic energy released by this transit then descends with great power. Up to this point, a period of two years, the people feel the restless and stirring influence of Uranus. There appears to be a condition of nervousness, of awareness that something drastic is to happen, and so note blends with note until the culminating point is reached in a wild crescendo of

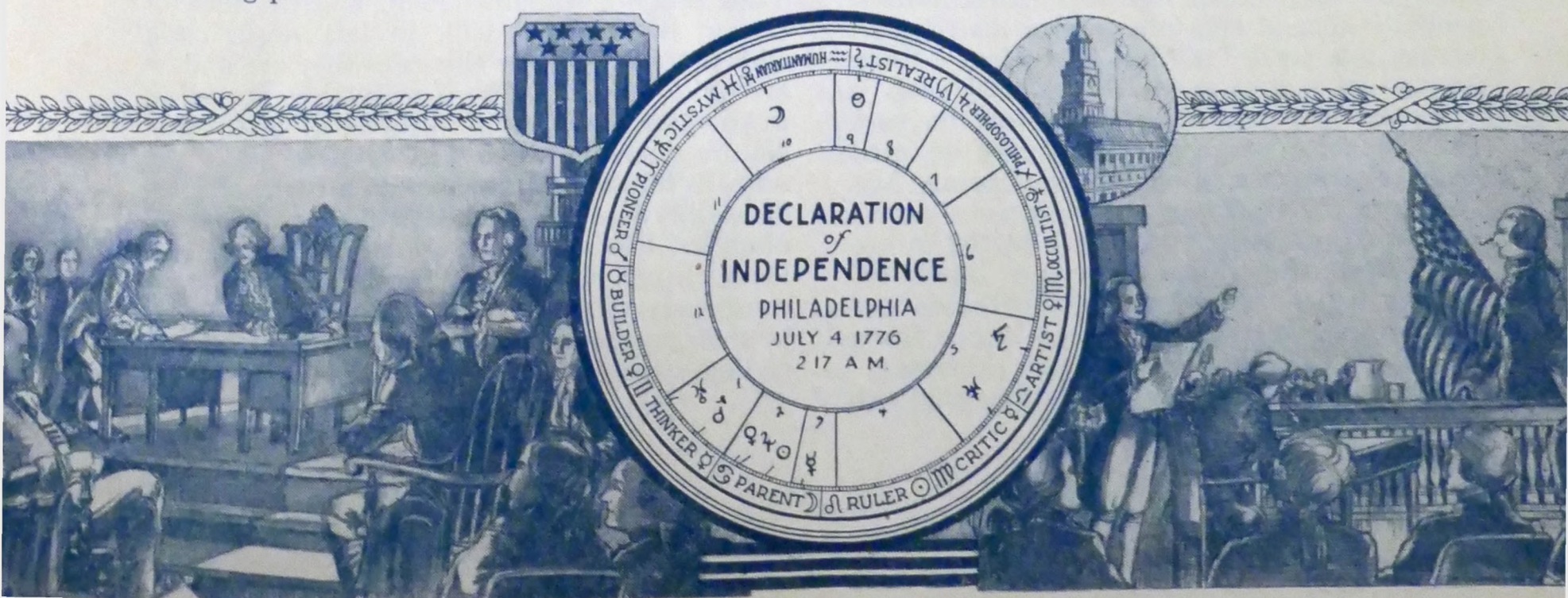
passion. Need we speak of the events leading to the signing of the Declaration of Independence? The Declaration was signed when Uranus had reached this culminating point of his cycle. Thus born in the storm and restless passion of a transit of the Great Awakener Uranus, the United States of America came into being. It was not until Uranus had left Gemini in 1782 that peace arrived.

The first great test or initiation of the country was to come with the next transit of Uranus through Gemini. The period from 1859 to 1866 will be long remembered, for then occurred the Civil War between the States. It matters little what the argument was, for Uranian action stimulates human desire for freedom, independence, progress, enlightenment, altruism and change. It was not until Uranus was leaving Gemini that fighting ceased with the surrender of General Robert E. Lee to General Grant on April 9th, 1865. However, Uranus still had power for damage and before it had left Gemini a fanatic had assassinated Abraham Lincoln.

In all these historic transit cycles of Gemini by Uranus the nation has witnessed changes of great importance in government, legislature, the character of the people and in social conditions. Uranus as the Great Awakener serves its purpose in arousing men from slumber to the call of a new day. Uranian procedure is not always pleasant, resembling as it does the birth pangs of a new era.

Today we are drawing close to the beginning of a new cycle of Uranus which will take place from 1942 to 1949. In the light of what has happened in previous cyclic periods of this planet and in view of the present unsettled conditions of labor and capital, social life, religion and the ever-increasing tempo of machine production, it is apparent that the great crisis so long expected may face us during the fateful years of this coming cycle.

In considering the probable effects of Uranus in 1942-1949 we find a different world today than that of the Civil War, or the Revolution. Today we stand upon the eve of world changes. As yet America remains with the British Empire, France and smaller nations, among the rapidly diminishing democracies. We witness a world gone mad, so neurotic that stark fear is the only restraining force holding back the ruthless hands of dictators. We see a world



blessed with the gift of Science—the power of mind or reason that can make the desert bloom as the rose and satisfy the needs of all men. Yet rather than cooperate for mutual benefit the nations of the world are drifting into a state of individualistic barbarism wherein the principles of international law will soon be forgotten. This fact is evidenced by the subsidized piracy arising in the Mediterranean.

Yet, regardless of the instability of modern life, the last few years have witnessed the most momentous social legislation ever accomplished in all the Christian centuries. We are now in the closing cycle of the Piscean Age of world evolution. That is, when we apply the astrological principles of cyclic law to humanity and the development of civilizations we find great periods of 2160 years in length wherein a definite tendency is manifested in human culture. The Sun slowly moves backward in the Zodiac in a vast cycle of 25,920 years which is termed the cycle of precession. The Equinoxes slowly vary at the rate of 50 seconds per year, one degree in seventy years, thirty degrees or one Zodiacal sign in 2160 years and the entire twelve signs in 25,920 years. This great cycle was linked by the ancient astrologers with the periodic rise and fall of human culture, civilization, religion, and races.

Through all the ages one can trace the influence of the celestial rays over humanity. Mankind ever follows the zodiacal expression of these cycles. That is, the dominant influence of the sign then in power, colors the thought, desires, ambitions and hopes of the race. Six thousand years ago during the great Taurean Age man worshipped the Celestial Bull, Apis, and in line with the characteristics of Taurus turned their efforts to the construction of mighty monuments. Then following the Taurean Age came the cycle of Aries and the worship of the Celestial Ram (the lamb slain from the foundation of the world, that is the Celestial Lamb in whose sign the equinoxes took place) which was under the rulership of Mars, the grim God of War.

During this Aryan Age we find conquest and war keynotes of the cycle, for by fire and sword the doctrine of Might was taught. The great Roman hegemony nurtured in this religion of might, then rose to world power. Following this cycle the Piscean Age began. Its zodiacal symbol is that of two fishes and so its religious teacher was termed a "fisher of Man." Being the end of a greater cycle of 25,920 years it represented the stored-up karma of the past. That is, the consequences of the entire cycle found violent expression in this Piscean Age. Therefore the Piscean cycle has been a period of sorrow, oppression of the weak by the strong, of bondage; for Pisces represents limitation. Actually it has been an age of retribution and of transition, wherein the human race is being prepared for a new cycle of human progress.

The gradual precession of the Sun into orb

of the airy, electrical, and humanitarian sign Aquarius has brought into being the modern scientific age with all its marvels in the development of steam, oil, electricity, radio, and aviation. The first great step of science has been without the wisdom of astro-religion and so the task of spiritualizing civilization and turning science to the conquest of peace rather than the domination of peoples must now begin. As the influence of Uranus as ruler of Aquarius begins to filter into human psychology we will witness in the centuries to come the inclination of science to investigate the superphysical. What was once the absolute domain of the Holy Man, the Yogi, the Occultist or the Astrologer will then be included in the universal field of applied science.

The Astral World or the etheric aura of the Earth will give up its secrets, and sources of power now undreamed of will operate countless automatic machines to do the necessary labour of mankind. Thus, what we face in the Aquarian Age is actually a Cosmic Age of Science. The cooperation of peoples will then produce a friendly confederation of nations pledged to supplant present financial aristocracy and the hell of universal want.

Great cities such as we have never dreamed will be constructed. Glass and metal cities built geometrically, which will know no slums, discordant noises, extreme heat or cold, dust or traffic dangers, where air and sunshine, beauty and peace alone endure—in the heart of a great metropolis.

Even as man conquered the seas during this reign of the present watery sign Pisces and so linked the continents with shipping lanes, so in the Aquarian Age will man master the upper reaches of the stratosphere and link the outermost bounds of the earth by air-lanes.

War will finally be outlawed by the international government of the World Confederation of Nations and universal education and freedom could be called the visible and outward symbols of inward peace and beauty—thus expressing a humanity that has at last matured.

Even now we witness the gradual and unconscious tendencies toward an ever-increasing factionism in which the progressively minded people (the Uranians) will oppose the conservative or reactionary types (the people under Saturn). Thus progress, enlightenment, and the idea of human brotherhood will, in fact must, clash with those who prefer things as they are and so are quite satisfied. The conservatives are blind to the fact that a new world is in birth—that Nature does not stand still or look back. Always, as humanity presses on to a higher degree of civilization, must the path be cleared of obstacles, hindering or antiquated policies and ideas. Every new idea is howled down by the conservatives of one generation to be praised by their successors in the next. Life is a never-ending struggle between the divine powers of

Lessons in

Astrology

Lesson Five

LAST MONTH we chose an example horoscope to work on. This was calculated for Wheeling, West Virginia, which is 81 degrees of west longitude and 40 degrees of north latitude. The time was 2 A. M. on August 14th, 1937. By first finding the time zone Wheeling is in we calculated its true local time for 2 A. M. as 1:36 A. M.

This was done as follows:

Distance *west* of time meridian—6 degrees.
As one degree equals four minutes of time, six degrees equals 24 minutes, being west of the meridian we *deduct* 24 minutes from the standard time. Thus the true local time for Wheeling, West Va., is exactly 1:36 A.M. and the next step is—

THE SIDEREAL TIME

Looking in the ephemeris for August 14th (page 16) we find under the sidereal time column the following notation of the sidereal time for noon 9:29:58, or 9 hours, 29 minutes, and 58 seconds. This is for noon, however, and we want to find the sidereal time for the true local time of birth. Now the simplest way to calculate the sidereal time is to *deduct* the difference in time from the noon sidereal time *if the birth hour be before noon* or in the morning hours. If, however, the time be in the afternoon we would add to the sidereal time for noon.

As our first example we will try the easiest system of working out the sidereal time. Look in the ephemeris for the noon sidereal time for *August 13th*. Set this down as follows:

Sidereal time Noon Aug. 13th	9:26:01
From Noon to Midnight equals	12:00:00
From Midnight to birth hour	1:36:00
Total equals	23:02:01

By deducting the difference in time from the noon sidereal of the birthday or August 14th we would have had to add the circle of 24 hours, as follows:

Noon sidereal time	9:29:58
Adding 24 hours	24:00:00
Equals	33:29:58
Deducting the difference in time from noon to the birth hour	10:24:00
Total	23:05:58

By this method we get approximately the same time, with only a difference of 3 minutes and 57 seconds. Now, when you get down to the more exact methods you will find there is no real difference which way you figure the sidereal time as there is a slight increment of correction to be added to all calculations that are made from *the previous noon* to the local time of birth. This increment of correction is as follows:

Ten seconds for each 15 degrees the birth place is west of Greenwich. This equals approximately 55 seconds for Wheeling. Then also another increment of correction equaling ten seconds for each hour of interval from the previous noon to the hour of birth. In the present case we have 13 hours 36 minutes of interval. Thus we have about 135 seconds or two minutes and fifteen seconds. Adding the two corrections together we get 3 minutes and 10 seconds. Adding this correction to the sidereal time we find it to be 23:5:11, or twenty-three hours, five minutes, and eleven seconds. Thus the two systems are close enough to be fairly accurate to the second. For simple and easy calculation it is best to deduct the time difference for morning births and add the difference for afternoon births.

And now having found the sidereal time of birth our next step is to find the

GREENWICH MERIDIAN TIME

We know that each degree of longitude equals four minutes in time. As our horoscope time falls into the eastern standard time zone we know that the difference in time between Wheeling and Greenwich, England, will be 5

hours and 24 minutes as Wheeling is 81 degrees west longitude. Multiply 81 by 4 and you have 324 minutes, or 5 hours and 24 minutes. Having discovered this difference between Wheeling and Greenwich in time we find the true Greenwich time as follows:

The true local time of birth.....1 hr. 36 min.
Difference between Wheeling
and Greenwich.....5 hr. 24 min.

Greenwich Mean Time equals 7 hr. 00 min.
Therefore the Greenwich Mean Time, by which we must learn to calculate the positions of the planets, is 7 A. M.

We have now found all the time equivalents by which the calculations of our horoscope is accomplished. We set down the time factors as follows:

TRUE LOCAL TIME—1:36 A. M.
SIDEREAL TIME—23:5:11
GREENWICH MEAN TIME—7:00 A. M.

Now our next step is to take one of the new type scientific horoscope blanks as featured in my magazine and draw in what are termed the cusps of the twelve houses.

I recommend this new type horoscope chart, which is becoming increasingly popular throughout the world, to all students. It shows the twelve zodiacal signs and each degree of the zodiac, *and it shows them exactly as they are.* Unlike the old wheel-type horoscope chart the new type shows the exact size of each house and gives the beginner an even break when it comes to putting the planets in the houses and the degree positions.

There are twelve houses to a horoscope. They are as follows:

First House—Rules the personality, early environment and instinctive mental traits.

Second House—Rules your possessions, finances, ability to accumulate possessions.

Third House—Shows your relatives, brothers and sisters, your mental abilities in regard to education, short journeys, writings and correspondence.

Fourth House—Reveals your home life, the end of your life, whether happy or otherwise, and your abilities in respect to gain through farms, mines, or property.

Fifth House—Indicates your love affairs, your contact with art, the theatre, amusements, your children and your speculations or investments.

Sixth House—This house has to do with your health, your aunts and uncles, your association with fellow employees, your servants and your occupation or the work you must do in life.

Seventh House—The seventh house has to do with marriage, your partner in love, in business, or your opponents in life, and also with contracts, legal moves, and public matters.

Eighth House—This house governs the manner of your death, your insurance gains, or monies accruing from legacies, estates, partners, etc., and the goods of the dead.

Ninth House—The ninth governs your long journies or voyages. Your experiences in foreign lands, if any, your inclinations in religion, science and philosophy.

Tenth House—This house rules your profession in life, and shows your reputation or your standing in the community, your public successes, etc.

Eleventh House—The eleventh governs your friends, their tendencies, whether you will have many or just a few, your latent hopes and your wishes as well as your social contacts.

Twelfth House—This is the "House of Destiny," that is, it shows the particular problems you have brought into life, your "karma" or the debts you must pay in this present existence, your limitations, experiences in hospitals or institutions.

And so we have learned what the houses represent—now to place the houses into the chart form. To do this we must consult a "Table of Houses." Now one of the reasons why I recommended Raphael's Ephemeris as the best of its kind is that it also carries several tables of houses that are adapted to the principal cities of the world.

All a table of houses represents is the zodiacal positions of the fixed stars for any given time. That is, we find by consulting a table of houses for a particular latitude the particular degrees of the Zodiac on the cusps of the twelve houses. The tables will show the degrees of the signs of the Zodiac on the cusps of the houses for the latitude it is calculated for. That is you cannot use a table of houses calculated for 25 degrees north latitude for the latitude of London, England, or Washington, D. C. You must use the proper table. Now you can purchase prepared tables of houses from most booksellers that deal in astrological books. So if your birthplace is not in the latitudes covered by the copy of Raphael's Ephemeris that you have in order to follow this course of lessons—then get a table for the proper latitude. These tables will come usually complete for latitudes from about 25 degrees north to about 60 degrees. It is a good investment as once you have your tables they will serve you for a life-time. The positions of the fixed stars change but little in the life of a person so that these tables are almost permanent. Raphael's complete Tables of Houses is about the best that you can purchase, for quick work, though there are several such publications.

Now, if you will turn to the back of your Raphael's Ephemeris for 1937 you will find a table of houses for New York, which is exactly 40 degrees and 43 minutes north of the equator. Now, merely because the table is calculated for New York does not mean it is no good elsewhere. It is good for all places on or near that parallel of latitude. You can even use this table, by a calculation that is out of place at this period of your studies, for southern latitudes.

Then, in sheer frustration (love *will* out), she soared to the opposite extreme of fairy-tale idealism—obviously attracting a flighty super-idealistic youth. Of course, neither could live up to in real life the impossible ideals of the other, so they broke up. Again and again, as though on a spiritual see-saw, Ann went from the deeps of pessimism to the delusions of optimism, until with disgust for “all” men confirming the emotionally immature idea implanted in childhood by her mother, developed a lesbian attraction to Dot. Desires are like magnets. Dot, very much a healthy girl, broke away from what threatened to become a degeneracy, and married.

Ann, broken-hearted, bought a bottle of poison, and while this was not on the label direction—*before* taking, wrote the writer. Relational therapy for her showed up on the birth-environmental horoscope explained in previous articles as to method. a religious creative urge, and the universal laws lived consciously or unconsciously—preferably consciously, since then we all *know where we are going when we leave our good earth and enjoy life on the way*. Which brings us to the subject of . . .

MAGIC IN LOVE

The right magic in love is the one that learns about and uses the creative rhythms of The Creative Intelligence in nature or the "Spiritual Sun," which by the way is *not* sun-worship, in the sense of the one wee Sun of our solar system. Men and women, even what some would say, "common" people, have powers within them that their most wonderful dreams never picture! But more, especially persons who are chronically troubled, must learn to directively control what they permit themselves to "spiritualize" of desire, and do the right thing to bring "the better spirit" into outward "materiality." THIS has been an unusual month from the standpoint of the novelties we have heard about, so I pass them on to you in this—our gossip column.

First of all, did you ever hear of Rose Jelly? I'll wager that some of you good housewives have, but I'm also sure that a great many of you, like me, have never heard of it—let alone actually experienced the novelty of tasting it. And, strange as it might sound, it's delicious!

A friend of mine has a jewel of a chef, who concocted this unusual spread by using three bushels of rose leaves, to make one pint of jelly, and I am informed that the white rose leaves get the best results. Of course, Rose Jelly must be used sparingly—it cannot be used as you would use grape jelly. A very small amount perfumes the breath for hours and as we experienced this new sensation, the thought went through our mind that it is a wonder some manufacturer hasn't thought of this as an idea for erring husbands whose desire it is to cover up the fact that they have made too many stops on the way home to dinner.

HERE is the recipe for the jelly experimenters. It's fun to offer your guests a bit of this delicacy and watch their expressions as they taste it.

George H. Carter, famous chef for Dr. John R. Brinkley's family, gives us this recipe in his own words:

"In the making of Rose Jelly, I find the easiest way is to pick the petals off the roses, not taking the roses off the bush. These petals are put in a wash tub or a sink, allowing cold water to run over them in order to remove whatever insects might be present. You then put the rose petals into a large stone jar and beat with a potato masher or a whip until reduced to a pulp. This is strained through a coarse cloth and after straining all you can through the cloth, you twist and squeeze as much more as you can from the pulp mass. The remainder of the pulp is then put through a meat grinder. Once again, you strain through a cloth as you did before, only this time a finer cloth is used. This will give you about one pint from three bushels of rose petals. You then take the liquid and put it into a glass jar, which in turn is put into a double boiler, where the liquid is allowed to boil for five or six hours. The glass jar is then removed and put in the sun where it sits for about two days. Every hour the jelly maker must go out and move the glass jar around—in other words, turn it so that the liquid goes clear to the top. You do this because the jar is hot and it helps to evaporate the liquid more rapidly. Just keep moving it around in this manner until it forms a thick syrup—after which it is put into the refrigerator to jell."

That's all there is to it. No sugar is added. This may sound like an unusual recipe, but the result is DIFFERENT.

WAS HE BORN IN SCORPIO?

Well mated, he is active physically and mentally, ambitious, talented, highly creative, but may have to develop planning ability to get what he rightly wants with less lost motion. The laws of life are not the laws of reason as we usually think of reason. "Destiny shapes our ends, rough hew them as we will," as Shakespeare put it. *But we are fated only by what we do not know!* That is, Scorpio does well to seek foreknowledge by the heavens. Then, intuition (desire-thinking-doing clicking in more at-one-ment) grows. Keep any knowledge of the heavens simple in everyday life. Real life astrology is no more complicated than the principle of compatible mating, and plenty of coal in the furnace for when the heavens are going to snow. (The seven years between 1942-1949 can be a World Harvest of happier home life or a madhouse of murderous wars—it's all up to the people.)

In the less evolved type, the Scorpio male turns to sexual conquest, whereupon the desire for intoxicants usually completes ruin—*unless any emotional immaturity like this is first conquered by your own creative expression as to what's right about him*, and you two keep your spirits on what you rightly want next in real life together and work toward it. Flattery is false or venal praise, sooner or later it does not work. Creative love expression is simply the hopeful sincere attitude. (Some persons, however, have a sort of cry-baby in them needing much assurance and petting, until they become surer of themselves.) We should realize that immature men and women always feel sex conscious in a childish way, until both realize that "Life is real . . . Life is earnest . . . The grave is not its goal" and that after the thrill of intimacy is thoroughly explored, there are other missions in life to be fulfilled here and hereafter. But it may take another war to bring the entire world to its senses about this, what with all the free (in the sense of chaos) love propaganda. Real love is meant to be taken seriously!

Your Scorpio man likes a girl who is poised, fond of activity, a red-blooded rather than an ethereal creature, who knows how to make home life congenial—whether you live in an attic, a trailer, or a palace. He wants *complete loyalty or nothing!* Be wary of winking at another man, or any jokes and alleged wit that belittles another. The world already has more Smart Alecks and Slick Susies than it knows what to do with; such persons diffuse hope and *spirit . . . centralizing of desire to create order out of chaos*. Emotional balance intuitively knows when to draw the line between humor and seriousness. If there is any curse on America, it is the gossip wise-crack that panders to moron

popularity. Scorpio knows that, and while he (she) can be full of fun at the right time, it will take more than the Marx Brothers to give Scorpions happier home life and the defense of it.

The shame is that so many Scorpio children are mis-educated. With powerful desires, the common psychological racket is to tell them: "You can't have everything," and then when the heart is taken out of them: "Oh, so you can't take it any more, eh?" The voice of the devil always finds lips to express thoughtless cruelties. No person wants everything, most all of us have been "taking" too much; *all that most of us really like here below is a little love, a little money, and a little knowledge of—What's life all about, anyhow? together with a bit of real life proof that what we are doing is all a constructive part of The Great Work of The Creator of order out of chaos. But how can we know that we are on the right track unless we let each other know by expressing appreciation for what is right about each other, and defend it against the natural enemies of better living?*

If Scorpio is very changeable, this is proof of a wavering spirit, i.e., urges from pessimism to optimism. (See case of Ann, starting this article.) Pessimism says, "The bottle is half empty." Optimism says, "The bottle is half full." *Emotional balance is neither and simply keeps right on slowly filling up the bottle of right living for self, loved ones and all.* Others then learn by example. If Scorpio is not perfect, look in the mirror and ask: "Are you?" The only perfect being is neither you nor I, who are relative parts of Him. We are all on the way to perfection.

Important: The word for God, "Elohim" was mistranslated in most Bibles to mean He, i. e., masculine gender. All real students of the occult know "Elohim" combines *both* the feminine and masculine genders! *Divinity is the universal male-female or plus-minus principle going onward together, by living universal laws of the Creative Intelligence.* If you both choose to believe this in love life, and never permit yourself to cynicize your right motives, you will find powerful sources of spiritual intuition. Astral, i.e., intra-atomic, purgatories are very real, and tolerating filthy mouths about the home is proof that the person needs—not punishment so much—as understanding of what their creative powers are meant to be used for. As sex urge develops it is *brain and spiritual power to create order out of chaos.*

In love relations, never by hint or fact repulse your Scorpio lover. If he is clumsy, as every child can be taught manners in how to enjoy the best of life, he can learn to be more considerate. litical bodies are also adversely affected. Unusual explosions connected with the above organizations and in research laboratories occur. Some amazing discoveries in the realm of science now come to the fore. There is much talk of a new gas.

The U. S. must exercise its fullest power to keep from becoming involved in foreign troubles. Saturn opposing Neptune from the ninth marks a grave turn in foreign affairs. good and evil, positive and negative, right and wrong, radical and progressive principles and the conservative or reactionary ideas.

Astrologically, Saturn is the planet of tradition and well symbolizes the forces of reaction, solidity, crystallization or the *status quo*. An institution becomes Saturnian when behind it lies the enormous weight of tradition, pride, procedure or ceremony, unchanged through the centuries. Our modern civilization is a cross between the past and the future. We have entered a scientific age without changing greatly our social structure. We have gained political democracy but have failed to extend democracy into the other great areas of human life. In this respect Uranus the Awakener or the Iconoclast represents the forces of progress. Uranus is the smasher or destroyer of the forms built by Saturn. However he is not "evil" but rather a necessary power; for without Uranus we would drift smugly on without real progress or change. It is necessary that man put aside the old in order to know the new.

With the orb of influence of Aquarius ever narrowing it is little wonder that old and outworn policies, ideas of government, society and philosophy are constantly changing. This being a transitional cycle, however, we find this change cannot take place without opposition. Everywhere we see the struggle of progress against reaction, of Left against Right, the rumblings of unrest that has thrown people against people, brother against brother, labor against capital, education against ignorance—which will continue until the question is settled once and for all. No more than the new born child can be forced back into the womb can humanity turn about-face on the Aquarian Age. Nature will aid in this great work and all obstacles will gradually be eliminated.

What has all this to do with the cycle of Uranus as it affects the United States? It was not mere chance that the great American democracies, stretching almost from pole to pole, came into being. Two great nations especially can face the future with confidence upon this continent, no matter how drastic the period of transition may be. A tradition of peace and fraternity have persisted through the years between the English-speaking American democracies that could well be studied by other nations.

It is said that coming events cast their shadows before—in which respect we have studied the previous influence of Uranus in transit through the ruling sign of this nation thus appreciating its possible influence during the years 1942 to 1949. Uranus will enter Gemini on May 15th, 1942, but it will not be until September, 1943, that he will transit the fateful ninth degree. During that month we find two other planets of significance in Gemini. Saturn the planet of conservatism and tradition enters Gemini May 9th, 1942, and continues therein until June,

1944. Mars is also in Gemini entering this sign August 14th, 1943, thus indicating feverish activity.

Saturn transits of a nation's ruling sign often bring on industrial depressions, crop failures, and popular discontent brought on by want, which prepare the way for action. The presence of Mars in Gemini stimulates the belligerency of Uranus. There may be war-like conditions, adverse or unfriendly feelings and disagreements between the various states and a reckless devil-may-care attitude among the people.

Uranus begins to retrograde in September, 1943, and so will pass over the fateful nine degree position it held at the signing of the Declaration of Independence. Another position of great importance to the astrological student is the gradual movement of Aldebaran, a fixed star of the first magnitude, now approximately in 8.48 Gemini (Latitude 5.28 South and declination 16.19 North) will in 1942 have exactly reached the important position Uranus held in the U. S. A. horoscope. Due to its astrological influence Aldebaran is termed the "Dictator," and the "Subduer," and it tends to be martial, powerful, violent and seditious. We thus have horoscopolical forces of tremendous power focused over this country during this next Uranian cycle.

Another curious cycle of interest in respect to coming conditions is one which has to do with the death or assassination of a U. S. president every twenty years. From the first inauguration in 1789 until Abraham Lincoln, the presidential chair had been filled without harm. However, at regular intervals from Lincoln's death presidents have died in office. This cycle marks the years 1861, 1881, 1901, 1921 and points to 1941 as the next possible occurrence. It is easy to understand how such an event would affect the general trend of events in the disturbed years following.

In the horoscope of the United States we find the Utopian sign Aquarius on the Midheaven and the Moon posited therein. This is a strong indication of HOPE that the people of this democracy will pass through the coming unsettled conditions and emerge well able to enter the new era. This position of the Moon holds the promise of sweeping and progressive developments in the days to come.

The planets Uranus and Neptune in the next five years will throw favorable aspects to each other (Trine). The first begins July 7th, 1939, and the ninth or last falls on March 12th, 1943. This strong planetary aspect is but another indication that the "angels" that led man of old are again guiding him toward a better day. This period outlined above may well witness new and unusual conditions prevalent in the world, especially shall new ideas be taught and experimented with in the realms of politics, social life and finance. The old order is gradually passing and ever-increasing interest in the new era will intrigue the minds of men. It is only once in

sixty years that Uranus, the planet of the new order and Neptune the ruler of the masses come into such an aspect. Thus this period foreshadows the practical interest of the masses in the new trends of government, religion and education. It is a time of awakening.

Let us profit before it is too late. The value of Astrology is its charting of the trends of the future. The application of Astrology to daily life and education can enable us to prepare for the days to come and avoid the mistakes of our forebears. Let it not be written in the histories of later centuries that the XXth was an age in which the Gods wishing to destroy mankind first made them mad. The present is ours and out of its intelligent use the future is born—let us not fail in this common duty.

Now study this table. See how the cusps of the 10th, 11th, 12th, 1st or ascendant, 2nd and 3rd houses are given at the top, and below them columns of figures showing the zodiacal positions on that particular cusp. See how the table

begins at 0:0:0 Sidereal Time and continues until it reaches 24:0:0 hours. A notation of the cusps of the houses is put down for each four minutes of time. Therefore, in looking for any particular sidereal time you will find it within a few minutes of accuracy.

Next month we will show you just how to find by the sidereal time, the proper house cusps for our example horoscope. In the meantime, go over your lesson carefully and thoroughly learn each step we have taken. Then also study the table of houses.

PERHAPS the study of the stars is the most romantic science that has intrigued the minds of men. The study of the stars lifted man from the sordid and dusty valleys of passion and personal interests to the calm and peace of the mountain-peaks of abstract thought. This reflecting telescope is the largest in use pending the completion of the new great 200-inch reflector. Mt. Wilson is 5,700 feet above sea-level and is near Pasadena, California.

It is known that within historic times the Ancients had no telescopes. Yet without the modern wealth of technical apparatus they became highly versed in astronomical knowledge. It is only comparatively recently that man has *rediscovered* part of what the Ancients knew in respect to the Heavens.

Such scientific facts as the distance of the Sun from the earth, the precession of the equinoxes, the shape of the earth, the number of planets, and many more highly intricate and mathematical facts were fully understood by the learned Ancients. It is the conceit of our age to believe this is the first scientific age, the falsity of which belief is easily apparent to the impartial student.

The ancient Chinese of 5,000 years ago were able to predict with amazing accuracy eclipses of the Sun and Moon. Even today some of the old Chinese observatories still exist. 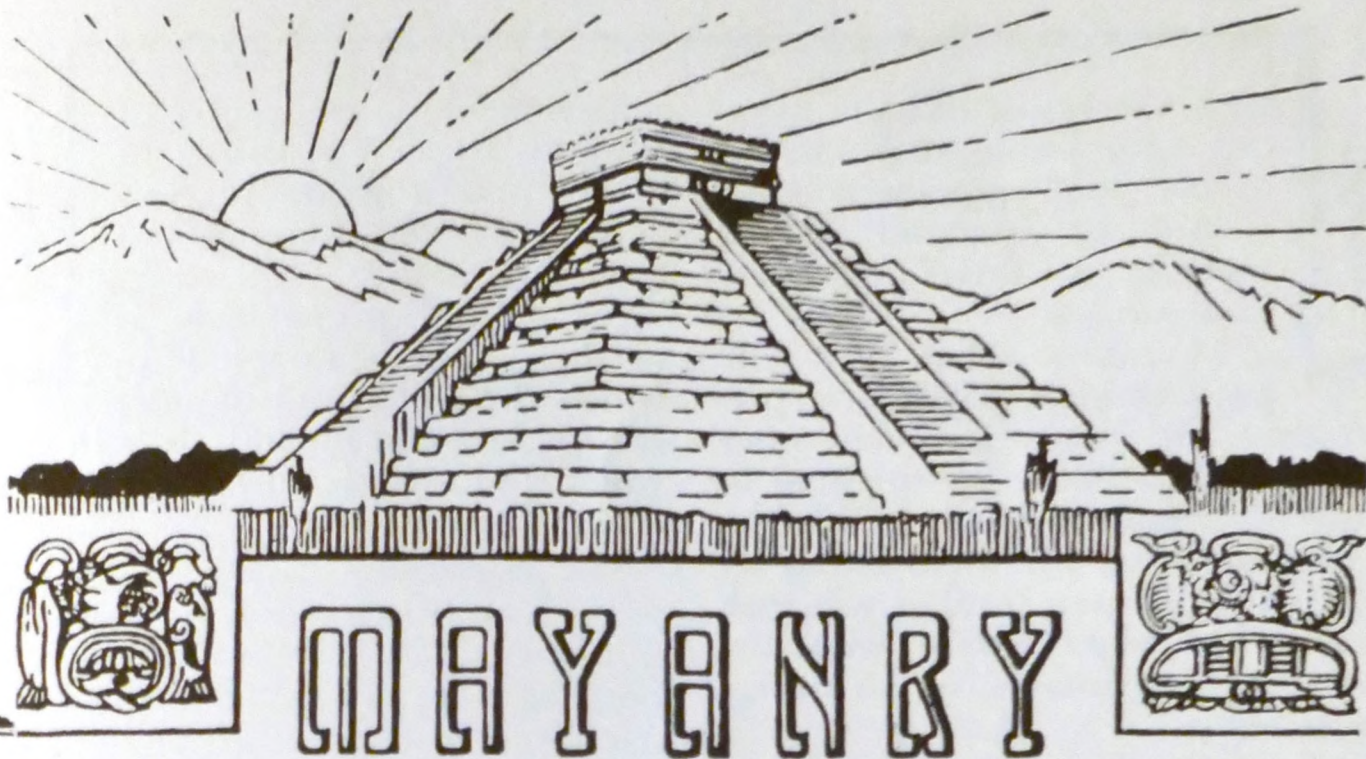
