# Mystic Methods of Mastery

The common complaint of would-be doers of the will of God is lack of power to concentrate and hold the mind to the appointed spiritual task until results are attained. The difficulty lies in the fact that the brain centers of spiritual activity have not had the years of exercise and training that have been given to the brain centers which use the body for physical duties. When a student begins to use the higher centers of spirituality and veneration, compassion and will, which are the bright crown of the soul's divine activities, there is a tendency to drowsiness. These centers are not yet awakened to act positively in the ethereal atmosphere of spiritual forces, hence abstraction or mind wandering or sleep ensues. But let a physical fact or act call the attention from the abstract to the concrete and immediately the attention and the whole mind is alert and positive. The problem then is, how to give the spiritual faculties the benefit of the many years of training that the physical faculties have attained.

Experience has convinced me that this may be accomplished by uniting spiritual and physical activities. Associate each spiritual state of mind with some appropriate physical attitude or act. Notice how in the act of prayer the ancient Hebrews let the attitude of the body concentrate the energies of the mind.

"The ordinary attitude of prayer was standing, with the arms stretched forward, the hands extended with the palms upward, and the face raised toward heaven. It was in this posture that Moses was sustained all day by Aaron and Hur during the battle at Rephidim. The next one was one of adoration, or 'worship,' the head bent forward, the body stooping. Penitential prayer was made kneeling, with the body inclined forward or prostrate, the forehead and hands resting on the ground."

The dervishes of the East work themselves into an ecstasy of spiritual devotion by daneing and whirling. All the negative and passive states of mind are worked into a positive frenzy of devotion until all feelings are blended into one feeling of supreme joy. The Indian medicine man, by his incantations and noise, strove to awaken all his spiritual force and by this intensity of effort to focus it all to one end, whether it was to produce rain, heal the sick, or drive away demons. Of course, results depended in a great degree upon the quality of the nature of the "whirling dervish" or "medicine man." If he were very aspiring and noble, his nature, when polarized into a single flame of concentrated effort, would unite with and receive benefits from a much finer and higher degree of spiritual life than if he were crude and selfish.

All occult or spiritual accomplishments depend upon the mediumistic, the mental or the soul power of the instrument. In Jesus we see a mighty soul using a positive and consecrated mind and mediumistic aura to express

the wisdom and power of God.

When all the powers of mind and soul and body blend into one flame of consecrated purpose mighty works are done.

"Physical unction" plays an important part also in great spiritual accomplishments, as it gives a body of magnetic force to the spiritual intelligence, which enables it to make a greater impression on material minds. Dowie, Moody, Beecher, and all orators, are magnetic men with physical powers of persuasion. Their influence is broadening and sweeping while they have the attention of their audience; how deep and permanent such an influence will be depends on the depth of spirituality and soul unity with God of such teachers. The words of Jesus are words of life with a permanent value to the race, because they were voiced by a soul that knew and was Divinity individualized.

Another illustration and then we will see if we can apply these principles so that each student can gain a more potent grasp of spiritual forces and embody them to the attainment of all good ends.

The ancient magician, when he desired the help of spiritual intelligences, entered a room sacred to his occult work, or went into the forest at midnight. He drew a pentagram or interlaced triangle on the earth or on the floor, placed lamps at regular intervals on a circle about the pentagram, burned incense and in other ways brought all his physical and mental forces to a focus. Then he uttered and repeated occult names of the powers of the air or of the angels of light, according to his character as a black or white magician. His names and mystical formulas stirred the slumbering forces of his spirit and these in turn drew from like states of the spiritual universe qualities and powers like unto himself. He worked himself more and more into the realization of the kingship of his spirit and then let the waiting intelligences know his desire and decrees. He then spoke words made potent with all his concentrated emotion. Words which were the focal points of physical and spiritual energy, were sure to accomplish great good or much harm according to the will of the magician. If his motive was good and his aspirations high and holy, the slumbering divinity of his soul awakened and he drew the benedictions of the Holy Ones of Heaven and was glorified and made more powerful as a spiritual individual. If his ends were selfish and his thoughts destructive, his soul was clothed in deep darkness and centuries would be required for him to outgrow his evil aura.

Every student has the constructive imagination which will enable him to form pictures, to intone aspirations or to adapt graceful gestures so that the mind cannot wander from its object but will be so joyously united to the physical activity that body and spirit will be one mighty force in adoration, in prayer,

in the exercise of will and in voicing the words of creative design.

One student has solved this problem by placing a picture of the Soul Victorious on the wall on a level with his eyes when he stands before it. In a bow over the picture he has placed cards on each of which are the names of the classes of holy, immortal beings as follows: Jesus the Christ, Archangels of Power, Cherubim and Seraphim, Angels of Love and Wisdom, Gods and Goddesses, Artistic Spirits, Musical Spirits, Scientific Spirits, Ministering Spirits. Above these is the name ELOHIM. These names represent to him God and His hierarchy of celestial and spiritual beings which constitute His Divine Providence, while the picture represents his soul made powerful and victorious by absorbing the emanations from the mighty souls of Heaven and from Elohim, the Father of all. He stands before these names with his arms extended, hands open, like the ancient Hebrews, repeating the name of Elohim and invoking His Holy Spirit. He affirms the noble and strong powers of his soul. He makes motions with his arms, drawing the essences of the soul plane, the spiritual plane and the physical plane into his organism. He takes deep breaths and imagines that every cell of his physical body and every particle of his spirit is indrawing the joyous essences of life. He feels the cleansing spirit of Wisdom purifying his body and mind of all disturbing poisonous influences. He rejoices in the conscious influx of the Holy Spirit. While he is in this eestatic state he holds in his hands card after card containing the names of those he would bless and heal, caressing and magnetizing the names with the healing spirit of his soul. As the fervour of his affirmations and the devotion of his spirit increase, he hows his head in adoration and the white light of Elohim blended with the vari-tinted lights of His Sons overshadows the spirit of this devotee. and he stands quietly under the influx and recrives of the Love of the Eternal.

The heat of the electric and magnetic qualities of life is the effect of the pure, vital flame of divine Love.

Through these invisible forces material elements and human hearts are reached and made alive by the Spirit of Love.

Love divine yearns to become embedied in something distinct from itself. Love is a creative power and it constantly flows forth in acts of kindness.

#### MYSTIC AND OCCULT POWERS IN PURE FOODS

Normal man is not considered carnivorous, says Dr. Peebles, in his "Science of True Living." The formation of his teeth, say our today anatomists and pathologists, the structure of the stomach, the alimentary canal, and the entire organism prove beyond the possibility of a doubt that man is not to be the companion of lions, tigers, hyenas and ravening wolves in his daily diet. Flesh-eating is an artificial habit. It is an abnormal taste acquired through long generations, and peculiarly gratifying to the lower animal instincts of blood and aggressive war.

Meat-eating, to the highly spiritualized, attended as it is with its cruel butchery, seems a sacrilege. All animals have rights, and among them the right of life.

Flesh-eating has been time and again proven, by eminent scientists, to make men and animals restless, nervous, selfish and hard and cruel. The Janis of India say, only cruel and selfish men will kill and eat the bodies of animals. Bears fed on fruits and cereals become mild, gentle and loving in disposition.

Go into a menagerie and watch the nature of the different animals: the flesh-eating lions, tigers, leopards, hyenas, wolves, etc., have to be caged, and they restlessly pace up and down their cages in nervous apprehension, while the vegetarian elephants and camels serenely and calmly munch their vegetable foods and have a quiet and friendly nature. Flesh-eating, causes much of our nervous disorders. It is significant that the more intelligent and useful animals of the world are strict Vegetarians; while those of less intelligence and who are dangerous and useless to man, as working servants, are flesh-eaters.

That vigorous journal, Good Health, gives us the following:-

"I know a dog twenty years old that is a strict vegetarian. He eats only two meals a day. He belongs to Senator Palmer. Hunters feed their dogs on corn meal and oat meal, and that kind of foods. I asked a dog trainer, who kept a large number of dogs, why he feed them on corn meal and oat meal. He answered because it gives them sound mind. If a dog eats meat he has no mind.' Some years ago I had a fine dog that I sent to a dog trainer to be trained. I sent a line to the trainer that my dog was a vegetarian, and I did not want him to have any meat; that he was to take a term of lessons and learn what a dog ought to know. I got a note in return saying that I need not be afraid that the dog would have meat, for he never gave his dogs meat. Upon inquiring why, I was told that if he fed his dogs on meat he could not teach them much; that the meat-eating dog was dull and stupid. Sometime ago a dog trainer brought twentyfive dogs to the sanitarium, and I asked him what he fed them on. He said, corn meal, oatmeal and bread. Said I, Don't you give them any meat?' Never!' 'Why?' I further inquired. Because it makes them savage and cross.' Now is it not strange that the men who rear dogs, which are carnivorous animals, find out that meat is bad for them; while human beings, who ought certainly to keep them-

selves in the highest intellectual and spiritual condition, in the clearest-headed and best physical condition, seem determined not to realize that meat-animal food makes them cross and stupid; that they are not so well in any way when they use it? Men know this for their dogs, but they have not yet learned it for themselves. And yet they ought to have learned it, because both statistics and experience prove it."

The flesh-eating nations of the world are the war-like nations. The Buddhists of Asia, numbering hundreds of millions do not eat the bodies of their animal-brothers, and have never been known to engage in an aggressive war. Dogs fight because they are dogs, and are largely fed on meat. O, what a blessed world of peace, harmony and melody this would be if we were all gentle and kind, and not so restless, nervous and aggressive!

Spaniards who engage in cruel bull fights on Sunday afternoons, often eat on Monday, they and their immediate neighbors, the bulls they had previously killed. But the bull, a grass eating animal, would not demean himself enough to eat a dead Spaniard, or a dead, porkfed, beer-and-tobacco-pickled American.

No one can refine, purify and spiritualize the mind and body and make it the living Temple of God, if he persistently pollutes it with dead flesh foods.
