

## What Lies Behind a Declaration of War?

IT SEEMS to me that back of all war declarations there is one cause: fights between great financial interests for supremacy over the natural resources of less powerful countries.

And those interested in promoting war incite the people to consent to war, by feeding them UNTRUTHFUL PROPAGANDA about the other country or nations involved.

One little example will suffice: during the war we were told in this country, and also in Great Britain, that the Germans were "boiling the bodies of the dead to extract grease for human consumption". I sat in the House of Commons one day last November and heard the Prime Minister acknowledge in answer to a question pressed by the Labor opposition, that the "cadaver story" had no foundation in fact.

Great financial interests bring on war, and they do it by giving out only part of the facts. The only cure for one-sided propaganda is to get before the people all the facts on the other side. To this end, I propose that your Polytechnic Evening High School debate the following resolution:

Resolved that in times of threatened war, internal strikes and in political campaigns, all newspapers shall sell their reading and advertising space on equal terms and in equal space, to all governments and groups concerned, each communication to bear the names of the leading proponents, individual and group; this law to be enforced by prison sentences.

It is the truth, the WHOLE truth KNOWN to All of Us, that will do away with wars and strikes. No one ever said a truer thing than this: "To know all is to forgive all".

I believe that a law to the above effect would overcome all of our troubles that have been due to a subsidized press.

In President Wilson's time we had a government propaganda bureau headed by Mr. George Creel, but this too gave one-sided truth. Necessarily the government propaganda bureau puts out the propaganda of the party that happens to be in power. It could not be otherwise, to my mind.

But every newspaper in the country, and every magazine, should be obliged by law to sell EQUAL SPACE FOR EQUAL PRICE, to every party or organization or government which is involved in any dispute. Such an arrangement would give us a nation wide forum in which every person could read the facts from all sides.

To KNOW the truth from all sides is to see through things.

To KNOW the whole truth from all sides is to dissolve the differences upon which all wars are made.

TO "DO IT NOW" is to keep from having to do it over and over in your mind, until you finally get around to really doing it! CHOOSE what you will do, and then DO IT. DO IT PROMPTLY!—this has been my motto for thirty-five years, since I discovered that I was burdening my mind with put-off jobs, until I had no energy left with which to do anything.



# The Man Who Regained His Lost Success By Putting God Into His Work

The Strange Experience of a Free Lance Writer Out in the Middle West

W E HAPPEN to know the man in point very intimately and will vouch for the truthfulness of the story.

As he puts it, it had to do with a man who reached a point in his professional career where he believed himself a sure success for aye, and able to defy God, Man, any and every other thing he would. His success was so simon-pure certain and wide that nothing might shatter it. He could defy all obligations set down in Scripture, all moral law, except as human law held the reins through arrests.

The Ten Commandments were well enough. If you enjoyed living up to them, that was your choice. But the Bible as basic foundation-stone for present-day civilization was "bunk"—so it seemed to him.

His ethics were a negative code.

He would not pick a pocket. He might not rob a poor-box. He did not murder. He seldom swore. He was a perfect gentleman, he! You know the type. Nothing done to be sent to jail about, yet taking sharpest advantage wherever he got the chance.

How the Strange Experience Was Told.

It was at a little causerie of writers, when conversation had turned to Man's tremendous awakening of interest in the problems of religion and faith, and communion with God, since the World War, that he told us about it.

We give the story here as nearly as can be:
"I seem to have gone into a field of writingto-live which the rest of you chaps have overlooked, and it is one that has absolutely no
bounds. It consists in preparing illustrated,
informative articles for the trade, technical
and specific press,—the publications which
are devoted each to some particular field.

"This type of literature may range from a paper devoted to infant hygiene to a paper devoted to funeral procedure, or to any num-

ber of publications concerned with what may await after death.

"It was all grist that came to my mill.

"The new cook surprised us with a Welsh dish, KRITS, at breakfast. I obtained details and sold the recipe to a cooking magazine. The children on the way to school hitched Ponto to a sled, for fun. I took a snap-shot, wrote an item suggesting we use dogs as the Dutch do, sold it to a dog journal. I rewrote it and sold to half a dozen Sunday-school papers of as many faiths. Everything sold in the States I carboned and sold also in Britain, Canada, Australia. If things are interesting to you and me, they are interesting to those people. It multiplied receipts, of course.

"Editors everywhere began complimenting me on the exceptional nose for news I had developed, overnight as it were. Orders came unsolicited as publishers read what rivals used of my scripts.

"The world is so big, so full of interesting things, one simply could not exhaust the field. There are perhaps 40,000 different publications in the English language buying manuscripts today; a man could not remotely hope to give each just one article a year. Many of them buy monthly; many weekly.

"Inexhaustible fields of material, ever-expanding as human progress goes on, to draw from! Inexhaustible markets in which to sell! Joy in the work; no hazard about it at all; really just intensive sight-seeing and interviewing! All was well with the world, and the Devil to care!

Then "It" Came: A Strange Thing "Happened".

"Bit by bit it began happening.

"I found myself growing, first of all, a trifle arrogant. When I arranged to interview Smith or Jones about his late invention for some publication concerned, I was favoring

him by granting him the publicity to come. When Black or Brown gave me hours of seeing their plant, the favor was mine, I had chosen THEIR plant to come to.

"The world was my oyster, and let the oyster have its care!

"On—on—and on I passed, to new extremes!

"Constant dealing with material things made a materialist of me. I developed a code of take-what-you-can, so long as you can 'get by with it,' and a fool you are if you don't!

"And then—well then, at the very height of my powers, with orders pouring in and mounting high, with the knowledge a man gets when he KNOWS success is his,—a strange thing happened:

"The orders would come, they were filled, the manuscripts were accepted by publications good as gold. They were held until convenient for publication. That is the custom in the craft. They would be paid on publication. That is the custom, too.

"But—editors held and held and held certain manuscripts. Queries would bring the reply that they had found no openings. If pressed they would regretfully send them back! But the next editor to whom it might be sent would do the same!

"Again, an editor would accept a manuscript and soon after I would learn he had left for other fields, or was discharged. His successor did not like what the other had picked and sent it home!

But when I could show six steel drawers of filing-cards, crammed, and each card recording a manuscript somewhere—6,000, 8,000 manuscripts perhaps, for there may be two entered on a card—you'll admit it is more than a 'chance'.

"Follow-up cards were sent in their wake.

Money and time simply wasted. Letters brought the same result.

"Meanwhile rent, heat, light, stationery, other costs continued.

"The inexorable, gruelling paradox of it all,—orders galore, then returns reduced almost to the vanishing point,—finally brought me up with a jerk. In my homelife, social life, similar events transpired at every turning,—catastrophes beyond calculating, or power to prevent.

"I studied the problem. I consulted authorities. I sought advice where I might. Fellow experts urged me to bring manuscripts in and offer elsewhere. And always 'elsewhere' did the same in turn!

# Finding the Christ Within

FINDING the Christ within, is after all not so much a question of "finding", because He is always there, but often more one of being still and knowing Him, a case of seeking, and finding by putting the self out of the way.

When we take "our hands off" and let God do the work, our desires and longings almost instantly become our happy and joyous possessions.

We all of us seem to take the longest way home instead of taking glorious short cuts. We begin to think we are of such importance that a necessary part of the universe rests upon our shoulders, but in reality it is God's universe, and His burden, or rather pleasure, but we begin to look upon it as a burden, instead of as our glad, joyous opportunity of being sons and daughters of a King. Sons and daughters of an earthly king have no hard, tedious work, for the foundations of the kingdom are already established, and they need only to "carry on" in freedom and gladness. The children of our earthly kings surely enjoy

themselves. So why this terrible responsibility on our parts as children of *The King?* 

How then are we to find Him within? Why, by being still, by letting go, by having courage, by knowing His everlasting goodness, by being glad, happy, joyous; holding to our vision and desire and letting it rest in God's hands.

There are laws of health, success and happiness. If you want health, you must do the things that make for a perfect body. Get a picture of yourself mentally as you would like to be. Don't "copy-cat" someone else or envy their appearance or good looks, but set every law in operation that helps you to build your idealized self. Command every cell of your body to take up the work of making and molding you into that vision. Never for a moment see yourself as your outward manifestation now is, but visualize the perfect and see yourself only that way. Ask the Christ within to do the work, and do your part, in sane, sensible natural living. Do only those things that would make or tend to bring the perfect picture, then take your hands off and let the Father indwelling bring about the realization and demonstration.

If it is success you want. Find the work you most want to do. By being still and listening, the Christ within will tell you what you are best fitted to do. You know yourself where your greatest interest lies. Build your "asking, seeking and finding" about this interest, then think the thought, speak the word and DO THE DEEDS in accordance therewith, and then let the Christ within do His perfect work, and you will have demonstration and realization. If you do not have the patience to wait for the materialization and manifestation of your ideals, and try to force them into manifestation, then very often at the very moment when you might have enjoyed your heart's desire, you find it shattered in atoms at your feet.

It is this impatience of ours saying, "oh, what's the use"; "it doesn't work"; "there is nothing in this"; etc., that destroys all we have built. If we want realization we must know that there is a divine spark within each one of us which makes our own ideals and desires perfect, because it is, or we are, one way for God to express, and it is His desire for manifestation that gives us the urge and desire to accomplish.

We must learn not to let anyone deflect us

from our course, neither must we step on anyone else's toes to carry out what we desire,
but we must adhere strictly to our vision if
we want success to follow our efforts. If we
will get ourselves out of the way, by not
attempting to dictate the lines of transference
over which our good is to come to us, the
Indwelling Spirit will walk us, and talk us,
and think us, and act us into the thing we
most want, and if we allow no one to turn us
from the vision of our highest desire.

The same is true of love and happiness. If you want love, you must be love, act love, think love. You cannot allow fear, jealousy, hate, and envy to destroy your vision of the ideal love that is in the center of your being trying to be realized. Be your truest and best self, and you will get only true, good, fine things in return. If you do not trust, if you have fear, if you see the imperfect in someone else, they will see those thoughts and visions manifesting in you and your dreams of the realization of happiness will be in a heap at your feet. There is a slang phrase much in vogue at the present time, and that is "oh, be yourself". I have heard it used even by the boys at play on the street when one of their number has been angry, surly or mean. One of the boys will suddenly cry "AW, be yourself". Then, they will all pause and suddenly the cross one will laugh too, and the disturbance is over. You know when you have been cross, mean, unkind, and perfectly horrid, you say "oh, wasn't that horrid of me, why I wasn't myself," and even the boys on the street today understand that there is a something inside, "a still small voice" if you will, that is more perfect than our outward manifestation at times. Well then "be yourself," that is, be your best, fine, true self, poised, calm, faithful, hopeful and you will find all things in the outward to your heart's desire.

If you are not willing to pay the price of holding yourself to your vision then you can expect only imperfect results. We are in just the places, situations, and among just the people who are giving us the experiences, bitter or otherwise, that we need, to call our attention to the fact that all the help we need, all things we desire are ours by listening carefully, then acting only in accordance with that quiet, poised monitor, which ever guides all our actions, when we take the self that we have built up of false ideas and beliefs out of the

way. Life leads us into just the places and situations where we get the next lesson on the path of life and attainment. If we find in our environment that which pricks and prods us, we must stop and learn the lesson which it has to teach and that very thing which pesters and prods us we must learn to love and understand, and when we have the lesson which the pricking and prodding has for us, it will just naturally drop out of our lives. We have to be still, love and understand, and then all things are added unto us. As soon as we learn to let go of our personal beliefs, opinions, criticisms, and just love, suddenly we are expressing Christ within, and there is no further seeking. He just shines forth and radiates.

# Love As A Corrective Agent

A Drunkard Cured by His Wife. A Year Later He was Still a Sober, Industrious Man

66 T OVE is the fulfilling of the Law." Like our dear old family doctor, whose faith was pinned to aconite as a supreme remedy for all diseases, I, in the Metaphysical School of Healing, place my dependence on love, and I have had plenty of experiences in proving my theory not merely a theory but a fact. Here is one which illustrates the power of Love in overcoming:

About a year ago a young woman whom I had met a few times and who, for convenience, I will hereafter call Mrs. A-, came to me in great trouble. She said: "I wish you would advise me in a situation for which to me, at least, there appears to be no solution." And

she then told me this story:

About six years before she had married the man of her choice, a worthy young fellow who loved her, and whom she loved sincerely. They were very congenial, fond of society and of gay times, and at this period of her life the young wife knew nothing of Mental Science or Metaphysics. Mr. A- had a good. income and his business required him, or he thought it did, to "wine and dine" prospective partners in certain business deals. Mrs. A entertained these men at select little dinners and, of course, served wines and champagne. She liked the taste of wine herself; Mr. A did also, and it became the custom for them

to have it when they dined together in private. The difference between them was that Mrs. A— knew when to stop, and Mr. A either did not know or very soon lost the ability to know. Result: In a few years Mr. A-had become a confirmed drunkard. The worst of it was that Mrs. A- felt that it was her fault, or that at least she could have prevented it. The young husband's mother added to this self-condemnation on the part of Mrs. A— by telling her that Mr. A—'s father had been a heavy drinker, and that she had always been especially careful not to put temptation in her son's way.

Now, in spite of her remorseful feeling Mrs. A- still felt resentful every time her husband succumbed to the desire for drink. She had long since banished liquor in every form from their table and from the house and would not taste it herself, but the damage had been done and was, to all outward appearances, irreparable. "Of course, talking does not the slightest good," Mrs. A- went on in telling me about it, "but I just can't help feeling that he ought to brace up and just stop; just let it alone. I liked the taste of wine and champagne, but I did not have to make a beast of myself over it—I could stop and I did. Each time he promises never to taste whiskey again, but the promises mean nothing, absolutely

nothing, and I know they mean nothing when he makes them. For the last six weeks he has scarcely drawn one sober breath. I love him, of course, but I do not know myself how long love will stand the test. To see the object of your affection, the being you once looked up to and leaned upon, slowly brutalizing himself; the plaything of his grosser desires; well—!" She stopped with an expressive gesture of her pretty hands.

"You know," I began quietly, "I have one great remedy for such cases, and it is simply love. Love great enough to stand all tests, big enough to overlook, kind enough to protect and pity, wise enough to be silent; the allembracing love seeking only to bestow, asking no reward. He who achieves that love, can conquer any bad habit, disease or failing."

"Is that really true?" asked Mrs. A— wistfully, but with hope already shining in her

eyes.

"I will tell you what I wish you would do," I said. "Every morning and every evening, at a certain specified time, have your Silence. Go into this Silence with a feeling of greatest love toward your husband. Fill your heart, your whole being with it; not just the natural affection of a wife for a husband but the broader, finer, more spiritual love, the kind of love you would have for God (for it is God in him that you are endeavoring to call forth). Hold to this steadily, quietly, joyfully. Love him into strength, perfection and beauty of Soul (outwardly manifested). Praise the Free Spirit, the Christ-Self within him, the Self that is without flaw. Send this love and quiet, absolute recognition of the Spirit Perfect within to him during your Silent Treatments. At other times do not let the tiniest feeling of resentment toward him enter your heart, and never discuss the subject with him. Whenever the matter comes to your mind, consciously reach out in Spirit for this feeling of love and send it toward your husband, praising the Divinity that you know is in him, no matter how thoroughly it may seem to be The Divine Spark is there, the concealed. Divine Spark is himself and this Christ-Self is perfect. Praise it in thought, love it into manifestation on the outward plane. Know that it cares not for spirituous liquors, for enslaving habits, steadily hold the thought that IT is FREE, and that this FREE SPIRIT is the REAL SELF of your husband. Do this faithfully every day for a month, and

your love for it, your calling to it, your yearning toward it will bring it into manifestation."

My earnestness and evident belief in what I said put a feeling of conviction into Mrs. A—'s heart. She went away much happier, and promised to let me know at the end of a month how things were with them both.

I never told Mrs. A—, but as a matter of fact I, too, treated her husband twice a day, using this same method. I also treated her for confidence and strength and a boundless

ability to love.

It was about six weeks before I saw her again, and then only for a moment, as she was taking a friend to a train, but I thought she looked much happier and more at peace. The following day I received a note from her. It said, "I am so grateful to you! I gave the Silent Treatments as you told me, and it has been four weeks now since Mr. A— has touched a drop of liquor. We are so happy, and I can never thank you enough." To which I replied simply this, "Love is the fulfilling of the Law."

The story of this young couple, in its basic principles, is not an unusual one in my experience. "Love never faileth,"—there is, to my knowledge, no better way to cure anyone of an enslaving habit, whatever it may be, than to love and praise the Free Spirit of that person, at regular periods, in the Silence.

It has been over a year since this incident, and Mr. A- is a sober, earnest, industrious man. He never returned to the drink habit and never will. His wife tells me that she continues in a general way, the treatments I advised, because she says she feels that there is great spiritual development for them both in this method. Mr. A—'s transformation was a good deal of a mystery to himself, but finally, when she thought the time was ripe, Mrs. A— told him about that first six weeks and the anxious period just before, when she saw their little ship of happiness sailing straight toward the rocks. He was deeply touched and very much interested, and asked for more information. Mrs. A- brought him to see me one day, and we talked a long time; I answered his questions, which were thoughtful, practical and to the point, and I recommended a few books. He has read good metaphysical literature ever since, and has improved his business and his health and developed himself wonderfully through a practical application of the principles he has learned.

Both Mr. A— and his wife are firm believers in THE POWER OF LOVE TO FIND THE WAY.

This silent praise and love is wonderful in its effects. I can almost hear some of you who read this say, "But does not praise of ourselves or of others beget vanity?" No, because this is silent praise in the first place, and, in the second place, it is praise of the Free Spirit, which is the Divine Spark, the Higher Self, the Christ Within, which is always perfect, always well, always strong and above all petty satisfaction. Our object then, in the silent praise of the Free Spirit, is to so LOVE it, call to it, recognize its spiritual beauty, as to draw it into perfect manifestation on the outward plane. Why, then, if in every man, there is this Soul Divine, and this Soul Divine is always perfect, is it true that one man drinks, another cheats, some people affect us unpleasantly the moment we meet them, while others attract us as surely as the magnet draws the needle? It is simply this: You have probably often said and heard others say, "Mrs. B- is extremely attractive; a charming woman," or "Margaret's personality is particularly disagreeable to me." Now, "personality" comes from the Latin word "persona," which means "a mask". We have the Soul, then, or Free Spirit, and it takes on its personality or mask. As an infant develops, parents, relatives, circumstances, environment, all have their share in forming the personality. It is easy to see, once understanding this great principle, how potent a factor is the mind of the mother in beginning the personality of the unborn child, for the personality begins to form at conception. The mother's thoughts for nine months attract to this Soul the elements she naturally attracts to herself; after birth circumstances tend to carry on the same formation of the personality thus begun.

Therefore, when undesirable things show in a person the remedy is silent praise, untiring love of the Free Spirit of that person which is, for the time, behind the mask. Your silent praise of the Free Spirit, your great love for it, your knowledge of its perfection, your yearning toward it will cause it finally to manifest through the personality on the outward plane. This will take place little by little, and one should welcome with glad recognition the slightest sign.

The ideal condition, of course, is the one

in which the Free Spirit manifests itself in the personality, where the personality is the real and true expression of the Free Spirit on the outward plane and not a mask. The developed Soul has brought this about, and in these people the Free Spirit and the personality are One and manifest in truth and beauty inwardly and outwardly. You will see various degrees of this; people in which the Free Spirit manifests in some few good characteristics up to those in which the personality is but the expression of the Christ Within, and down to those in which the Soul is overlaid by concealments and hides in darkness. In the last condition it is possible by this method of silent praise and love to bring the Free Spirit into some sort of manifestation, to bring to the individual a certain degree of development, at least, and a certain amount of spiritual satisfaction, and so help the Soul on its way. In the first condition it is possible to bring the Free Spirit into full and complete expression and to cause the mask, as such, to drop away.

I think the tendency is to feel that praise is flattery, and is, therefore, a type of insincerity, and I believe that we recognize and appreciate good qualities far too little. Now, with children, you can demonstrate this for yourselves any number of times. The child of the fault-finding parent will be cross, sullen, disobedient, sneaky; the child whose efforts. to please are recognized and appreciated will try harder every day to come up to the standard of his parents' opinion of him. Words of encouragement in rewarding a child's efforts do not make him vain. They help him, they make the doing of a thing worth while. How much, do you suppose, would anyone of you care to do something which was, perhaps, a little difficult, or required some special effort on your part, when you knew perfectly well that if you did it no notice of your success would be taken, or the most you would get would be a grudging, "No more than you ought to do every day"? A child, under such conditions, gets the idea that he is a worthless little animal, and he becomes discouraged and feels that being good isn't really worth while. I once asked a small girl why she did not wash her face before going to her supper, and she replied, "Mother doesn't care, and father doesn't know." It is far too often the case that "Mother doesn't care and father doesn't know." Both are,



perhaps, too engrossed with the daily struggle, and the extra effort of praising the children seems just too much.

How different the lot of the boy or girl whose parents always expect the best of him or of her and who use expressions like these: "You have been such a helpful little girl all day," or "you are getting more orderly and quiet every day." Recognition is constructive; it builds. Recognition of a child's effort to do a thing will encourage it to make the effort again and again and will finally bring about the ability to really do the thing. If you say, "I know you tried to be quiet today," it encourages the child to try again, and he will finally succeed in being really quiet. If you do not notice his effort he will not repeat it.

The same thing is true of many little habits that children pick up, little disagreeable or unattractive habits that annoy us. The more we recognize these habits the oftener the child repeats them, and the oftener he repeats the more fixed does the habit become. To absolutely ignore outwardly a bad habit and at the same time silently praise the opposite virtue as an attribute of the child's Free Spirit is the best way possible to conquer a failing or weakness. It is an excellent plan for a mother to sit by the bedside of her sleeping child each night and silently and earnestly praise the Free Spirit, calling to it, loving it, recognizing its more perfect manifestation each day, and especially loving and praising those virtues or qualities as attributes of the Free Spirit that she most desires the child to manifest in his daily life.

I do earnestly feel that we, especially we in the New Thought, do not recognize and praise the good in everybody and everything half enough. We do not even in ourselves. We can use this method of loving and praising the Free Spirit into outward manifestation with ourselves just as successfully as with others.

And we must get away from the idea of flattery. It would be impossible to flatter God, would it not? Then remember, what we are praising is a part of God, is ONE WITH GOD. It is the perfect Christ Within, the Divine Self, and all we want to do is to so thoroughly recognize and appreciate and praise and love this Divine Self Within that the outward self cannot but be the true, perfect, complete expression of this Christ Ideal.

What we contemplate or believe to be at law is a law in so far as we are concerned,

and if we limit ourselves in thought or simply fail to recognize ALL SUFFICIENCY and UNIVERSAL SUPPLY we demonstrate limitation. We are like the little fish that lived in a well. He swam around and around in circles close to the sides of the well. One day a boy lowered a bucket into the well and caught the little fish in it and carried him to a large pond and threw him in. But the little fish began swimming around in circles the size of his well in one corner of the pond. His freedom did him no good, because he did not recognize it. So with us. Because some of us seem unable to draw from the Universal all that we need does not prove that the supply is not there, but only that we do not recognize the boundlessness of it. The pond was there. and the pond was large, but it did the fish no good because he recognized only the amount of space to which he had been accustomed. The Infinite is, and we can draw upon it boundlessly, but, like the fish, we demand or recognize only the amount to which we have been accustomed. There is no lack, there is no limitation. Abundance of health and wealth and all good things is ours NOW. Recognize Infinite Supply. Give thanks for "Ask and ye shall receive."

"According to your faith be it unto you." How great is your faith? Have you ever asked yourself that question? Look well into your soul and find out. How great is your faith? If you are God's child, is not your Father's yours? Would a child have to sue and plead and beg a kind, loving father for what he needed? Why, no; you never thought but what your father's property was yours. You looked to him in perfect confidence for all your needs. Then why doubt your Heavenly Father; He who is all-perfect, allwise, wholly divine? Is He less loving than an earthly father, less likely to hear His children's cry?

Know, then, that the Universal Mind is open always to your demands upon it, that it is boundless, unfettered and unlimited. Be conscious of supply. Consciously relate your subjective mind to the Mind of your Father, i. e., Universal Mind, consciously strive to come into harmony with It; realize that within you there is a Divine Spark which is a part of this Universal Mind, which is one with It, and that through the sympathy and harmony which you realize between this Divine Spark within you and Universal Mind

you have made a channel, established a connection, through which, and by means of which, you can draw unlimitedly upon Universal Mind which is the source of all supply. You will have to practice this in the Silence many times, perhaps, but in the end it will accomplish your object. The realization that within you there is a Divine Spark which is identical with Universal Mind and then the conscious relating of the Divine Spark with

Universal Mind for whatever conditions you wish to demonstrate is the thing to work for. Get that realization that you (the real you) can make yourself a part of the Divine Mind and then relate yourself with it for the bringing about of your desires.

# Demonstrating Prosperity Through Faith

How \$30 was Demonstrated to Pay a Bill and in the Exact Denominations Pictured— Two Tens and Two Fives

Y OU WHO read this title may wonder at it, for prosperity cannot be demonstrated except through Faith.

I was born and raised by two fond parents and being the oldest of four children my life was a sheltered one from all hardships and responsibilities. Consequently when I reached the age of twenty-one I lacked confidence in myself to carry out any kind of an undertaking because almost everything I wanted within reason was made for me. If I did wish to do something really worth while I was told that I was too young to carry out this or that plan. This is a mistake most parents make. I do not believe in keeping responsibilities away from children because it destroys confidence in themselves, which to me is the most prized trait of character anyone could have.

When I was of age'I became ambitious to get ahead in the world and determined to strike out for myself. Just about this time my attention was drawn to a very much advertised course that promised to give me self-confidence, poise and self-control with the result that I took it. As I look back upon it now I can see that it was the most important step I ever took, but at that time it did me very little real good except to teach me one thing—

"Whatsoever things ye desire,

When ye pray believe that you receive them And ye shall have them."

This was the one thing that stuck in my mind and made a very deep impression upon me.

Time went by until another year had elapsed and while I was working yet I was still at home and consequently I had very little responsibility. Things might have gone on in this way indefinitely had not fate stepped in and forced me to leave my home and room out.

Just at this period I met a friend's wife who told me of Nautilus and what wonderful results she had obtained in getting debts paid and in making friends. She told me she was picturing a home of her own and was confident it would come. She was so earnest and sincere that I became very enthusiastic and determined to try the experiment myself for if she was confident of having a home of her own in a short time (she was then living in two furnished rooms upon a very small salary of her husband's) I was confident that I could do the same.

## 1 Was \$230 in Debt and Out of Work.

This was in the fall of 1923. I didn't have any work. My room rent was two weeks overdue, I was in debt for a set of carpenter tools and owed \$200 for books and courses I had purchased on time. When I came home that night I found a letter from a friend I had borrowed money of who wanted it at once.



The sum was \$30. For a minute or two I was inclined to be beside myself with worry as my mind reviewed the situation, but I held on to my hope of New Thought and set down to enter the silence. Now I don't want anyone to think it was easy to banish those worries and fears; in fact, it wasn't until I had been trying to enter the silence for about three days that I learned how to banish them. I will tell my method in hopes that it may be of aid to others.

# The Method of Visualizing That Brought Me Success.

I seated myself and fixed my mind upon picturing the money coming to me. I did not try to figure how I would get it, I left that to God, but I merely pictured the money in my hands. Every time a worried thought came into mind that I would not have the money to pay this bill I did not try to ignore it but mentally faced it by saying to myself, "Well suppose I don't get that money what will happen?" In this way I made myself see that this so-called fear did not have any base to stand on and so by facing each fear I conquered them. I kept picturing this money coming to me in two tens and two fives. After I had a picture firmly fixed in my mind of myself holding \$30, I next saw myself going to the post office, making out a money order, placing in an envelope and mailing it to my friend. I had only been picturing this bill being paid night and morning for three days when I received the definite impression that the bill would be paid on the 18th of that month, it was then the afternoon of the 10th and I did not even have any work. There didn't seem to be any way in sight to get work either but I held firmly to my picturing every night and morning until on the 15th I suddenly had a definite impression to look at a newspaper of that evening and on looking I saw a sales position which was just what I wanted. In a short time I was steadily working and on the 18th, I mailed the \$30 which came to me exactly as I had pictured in two tens and two fives.

#### Next I Demonstrated a Home.

Now that I was working steadily I made up my mind to have a place of my own with my own furniture. Common sense told me it would have to be a rented home but even at that to undertake to buy all the furniture and pay high rent by myself would be some task for one who did not have any confidence; I was not daunted, however, by the magnitude of the task but systematically went to work night and morning picturing a house. Each time I would mentally see one particular type of house with its advantages and disadvantages. I did not try to picture or bother my head how I would obtain this house for I believed what Jesus had said about believing what you ask for as being already taken care of.

## My Subconscious Vision of the Home.

One evening as I was lying down it came to me definitely in a vision the kind of a home I would get. As soon as I had this vision I knew that my picturing had set things in motion that would soon bring about my having this particular type. From that time on I concentrated upon each piece of furniture separately until a vision came telling me what kind to choose for I had come to realize that when I received a vision at an unexpected time concerning what I was concentrating upon it meant that forces were at work to give me that very piece which I saw. Curiously enough as I kept on picturing buying articles of furniture, I always seemed to know that a woman would be with me although I didn't know anyone that would be with me.

Time passed by until it was nearing October without a single sign that my dream would come when without warning the people notified me that I would have to hunt another room as their son was coming to stay with them. Just as I was wondering how to take this my friend and his wife with another girl friend, told me they were thinking of moving. I told them my news and after talking it over decided to go with them and rent a furnished house. This was the first step I felt as we Just three now had a home to ourselves. weeks later the people decided to come back in their own home. This caused much dismay as we had counted on staying there for the winter but knowing that "all things happen for the best", we began to look for another furnished house but were unable to find any. Then one afternoon after I had almost grown worried I was impressed to go to see a certain prospect which was way out of my usual route with the result that I found the very house I had seen in my vision. That evening we decided to buy the furniture and rent the

house, so the next day my friend's wife and I purchased the very things I had seen in visions and two days later we moved into our own home.

Two years have passed by since we all made our start. We have made two moves and each time we have been shown positively that it was for the best although we didn't think so then. I now have steady employment and absolutely own furniture of my own. When I look back and think what I have gained in two years without anything to go

on I am firmly convinced Faith is the one big thing necessary to get what you want—provided you aid Faith and prove to God you are sincere by doing your part.

Can you blame me when you think I had nothing to depend upon in a material way, not even a single sign of income? But I had God to lean on and He is worth many times more than material aid. All He asks you to do is trust Him and the way will be opened.

I visioned waves of healing love flowing through and through this portion of my body. I felt the warmth of this healing love as it flooded my ankle and filled it with renewed life. I cannot begin to tell you how quickly it healed and grew well. It grew well as if by magic.

In two months' time there was nothing but the little scar to remind me of my troubles of twenty years' standing. In two months' time God did what medicine had failed to do in twenty years.

And you, dear heart, can be healed no matter how great your own troubles may be. There is that blessed healing balm of love waiting to do its perfect work in you. Do not be afraid to use your visioning power.

There is far more power in just visioning than many of us can dream, but we must put feeling into our visioning.

We must feel that the work is done now. That is the simple direction given by our dear Elder Brother. We should practice this with vim. For instance, just suppose your legs were stiff and you could not move them. Can you not image your legs moving? Can you not while imaging, actually feel them move? Now sit perfectly still and practice this; actually feel the movement of your legs as if you were walking.

You can do it and you can vision and feel yourself as accomplishing any other good thing. I believe with all my heart that there is far more power in actually visioning and feeling than in words. I know that all people

should practice visioning more and more. Just because you vision a thing once and it is not accomplished—do not give up. Remember, if you have been sick, just how you have seen yourself as suffering many times. You have seen yourself in detail, putting all the feeling into the vision that was in your power to use.

Turn right about and vision yourself or your loved one as strong and well.

Perhaps the picture is not strong and clear the first time, but the next period of visioning will be clearer, the next clearer still, etc.

So practice until your vision of the good is much stronger than of the bad, just as in the case of my own trouble. I visioned my ankle perfectly healed and it was so.

# New Confessions of Brown Landone

Article II. A Son of God vs. Be Yourself

A CHAIN is a chain and Truth is Truth. Both statements are self-evident and absolute Truth. Neither can be doubted.

Truth can be used to pull to you spiritually that which you desire and need; so can a chain, physically.

But will your chain pull if but one little link is missing? And will your absolute Truth draw if you miss the use of even one little link of its application?

We assert absolute Truth, but leave out a link here or a link there—of course, without knowing it—and then wonder why Truth does not pull to us that which we desire and need.

Principle One: Truth never fails!

Principle Two: Absolute Truth is generalized Truth—for it applies in general to all mankind—to every man and woman who has ever lived in the ages of the past and to every one who shall ever live in the eons of infinite future.

Principle Three: Whenever generalized Truth seems to fail you, the failure is due to your mind missing a link or two in the chain of its application.

Principle Four: The missing link is always

due to your failure to particularize Truth so as to meet your particular problem, and this is all important in attaining what you desire and need, for everything you want is particularized in your soul.

If you want health, you want it for someone in particular—yourself or others; if you want happiness, you want happiness particularly for yourself and for others. If you want success, you want it this day, this month, this year, this lifetime—not half a million years hence. Everything you really desire you desire particularized as to condition, or place, or time, or individual.

We are not interested in any discussion about ideas—mine, yours, or those of anyone else—BUT, since Truth IS correct thinking, it is essential to think correctly in order to attain the results of correct thinking.

I have never written that holding a general Truth is of no value whatever. Many years I depended solely upon using generalized Truth; but now I confess that I see vast differences in modes of using Truth and results attained.

Let me clarify thus: (1) a general Truth is

the ONLY Truth which meets a generalized need; (2) a particularized Truth is the ONLY Truth which meets the need of a particular problem; and (3) you cannot successfully use one for the other.

These three statements are self-evidently true—as true as the fact that (1) if you want to paint a box black, you should use black paint; (2) if you want to paint the box white, you should use white paint; and (3) that you cannot substitute one for the other—for you cannot paint a box black by using white paint, or paint it white by using black paint.

Now what is the difference between (1) the treatment "You are 'A' Son of God and all His abundance is yours," and (2) the treatment "Be yourself, for God's abundance

is within YOU?"

Both statements are absolute Truths—yet there is a difference—just a *little* difference—a very little difference—just one little link in a long, long chain and yet that link is important!

The first is absolute Truth generalized; and hence, in your use of it, your mind may miss one little link of its application to your problem, so that it will not pull for you.

The other is also absolute Truth, but particularized so that you miss no link at all, and

it brings you what you want.

Among the boys who came back from France and found no position waiting for them was one young man—an advertising copy artist—whom I had known for some years before the war, and who was in fact, a sort of a personal friend. After the armistice, he had been sent into Germany with the army of occupation, and consequently, when he came home—months after the war was really ended—there was no position open for him.

During the war, his parents had suffered reverses and every penny he had saved of his army pay had been sent home and used by them. Hence, on arriving home again, his finances were very low.

For two weeks after his return, he sought for positions in that greatest of all cities where positions are most difficult to obtain. After two weeks of fruitless searching, his feet were tired—walking from office to office; his ears were tired—hearing "Sorry, but we're letting men go, not taking them on now," and his heart also was tired!

He came to me and I quickened his spirit with the Truth that "he was a Son of God,

that God had already provided a place for him, and that God was meeting his every need." This Truth helped to sustain him—sustain him spiritually.

But he really needed a position, and in that I did not help for three months! I confess it! Although I did help him spiritually, I did not during those three months help him to get a position. Absolute Truth was Truth, but I was missing one little link in the chain of application!

Night after night, I prayerfully went over the Truth for him: "I am a Son of God. God has provided a position for me. It is mine by divine right. I have it now, because God always takes care of me," but as financial conditions were getting worse during that year of 1920 and as his own need and his parents' needs were becoming greater, he began to think that Truth was failing him.

Yes, he did become discouraged! And he doubted!

Oh, do not blame him! Have not you, yourself, had a similar experience in some line? Have you not sometimes doubted? When loved ones really hunger for food and no means of securing food materializes after three months' earnest use of Truth, doubts do creep into our consciousness—into yours, into mine!

Then one night I awoke! "Certainly, the young man was 'A' Son of God. Certainly, 'A' position awaited him." That Truth was absolute, and general! The missing link in my use of this Truth was that I had failed to particularize it in him!

I remembered his brave smile, his attempt to be cheerful, his effort to cover up the discouragement within him, whenever he went into an office to ask for a position. And particularizing the Truth in him, I saw that those men to whom he went for a position could not help but sense that the young man felt that he was down and out. In other words, although he had asserted the Truth that he was "A" child of God—yet his face and his manner told others that he was not in Truth himself.

Before dawn that morning I telephoned him and got him out of bed. When he came to my study, I said:

"In the chain of Truth, Man is a Son of God—EVERY man is a Son of God—but you are not every man, and you are not all men!

"Stop thinking of yourself as 'A' Son of God—you're not an 'as a Son of God' at all! You're 'this Son of God'—the sun—so shine and radiate!

"Stop emphasizing the 'A'—for it is so general it applies to any man. Stop thinking of yourself as an 'A' something and instead BE—be yourself!

"Stop going into offices asking for positions, but instead, go to the office in which you most want to work, and TAKE the position you want

"Emphasize your capacity, your power, your right—so that men will feel that you will be a valuable factor in any business."

Before noon, I heard from him; he had secured the position! The manager to whom he had gone had been swept off his feet by the young man's sublime daring and divine assurance of himself as HIMSELF! And that position has now led to a partnership and exceptional prosperity.

In this case, general Truth was of value. (1) General Truth sustained the young man spiritually—it helped him to be conscious of that in which he moved and had his being, but it did not secure a position for him; (2) general Truth also helped me during those three months—it led my mind to perceive, more definitely than I had ever done before, the difference between the use of generalized and particularized Truth.

The generalized Truth sustained him and awakened me, but it did NOT lead to a position for him. In fact, it kept the position away from him for three months. On the other hand, particularized Truth secured one within a few hours!

Oh, there's no need to take a stand for one and against another! Both modes of Truth are absolute and of infinite value, each to be used after its own kind: Generalized Truth is the spirit substance in which we live and move and have our being. Particularized Truth is our use—our application—to meet our particular needs.

The leader who once wrote in content—"Is it possible that holding a general statement of Truth is unavailing, alone? Does Mr. Landone mean that?"—was wrong in concluding that the WAY to attain the use of a particularized Truth is to hold to the general Truth. That is a wrong conclusion for it is equivalent to asserting that if you are walking toward the west end of a street, the

way to walk toward the east end is to continue walking toward the west.

But this leader was and is right in her use of particularized Truth as evidenced by her experience which she stated thus: (1) that for more than a year she had been in need of money—material supply; (2) that she had been holding to the general Truth of abundance for two years but that abundance had not materialized; (3) that she had been reading a certain advertisement for two years and that it had never suggested any particular opportunity to her during the time she had been holding the general 1 ruth; (4) that one day sne picked up a magazine and read this same advertisement again; (5) that suddenly the particular Truth came to her: "I can write one like that. Although I'd read them two years, it was never till I saw this one that I had this thought" (note the particularized thoughts I've italicized); (7) that immediately after her perception of this particularized 1 ruth, she wrote a copy for such an advertisement and sent it to the company, receiving in return a check and a request for more copy, and earned \$500.

All of which is proof (1) that holding to the general Truth sustained her spiritually but brought her NO particular material supply; and (2) that on the *instant* of thinking just ONE particularized Truth, she gained abundance!

Whenever you need or desire anything, not only recognize the absolute and general Truth to sustain your spirit BUT put in the particular link which will LINK UP with what you want—link the YOU and the WHAT—to meet your particular need.

Hold to the generalized Truth that you are "A" Son of God—as every soul is—to sustain you spiritually; but particularize yourself—BE the Son of God—to demonstrate abundance.

When you conceive this Truth, and when your soul is filled with the God consciousness of YOURSELF, others cannot help but recognize your value—and abundance is yours—for all abundance is within you—within YOU!

WHAT TO DO WITH YOUR TROUBLES.

WHEN primitive man felt anger, he proceeded to take it out on those about him. He did not bottle up his feelings.

But this is a crude form of solving mental conflicts. Modern conventions have lead to a general bottling up of destructive emotions. If one feels anger, he is expected to repress it. If he has complicated and unpleasant relations with other persons, at home or in business, he is expected to keep his troubles to himself.

This is undoubtedly a great advance, from a social standpoint, over primitive customs. But it is not by any means a complete solution of the problem. And this is shown by the ever increasing number of nervous disorders and nervous wrecks that are created through trying to reconcile man's primitive instincts with the demands of modern conventions.

The attempt to crowd back into the unconscious, unpleasant emotions such as resentment, anger, etc., often creates serious physical disorders. A common illustration of this is the phenomena of shell-shock which affected so many during the great war. The cause of shell-shock was mental, not physical. It resulted from an intense mental conflict—the desire to do one's duty, to carry on with the day's work which meant terrible dangers, and, on the other hand, the powerful primitive instinct of self-preservation. In order to find a way out of this seemingly irreconcilable inner conflict, the unconscious mind of the victim created the phenomena of shell-shock.

Wilfrid Lay (in "Man's Unconscious Conflict") records the case of a man who hated his wife and yet kept on living with her, for conventional reasons. He became blind, though physicians and oculists could find no physical basis for his blindness. It developed that his blindness was wholly physical, and was created by his unconscious desire and determination not to see his wife. He could

not (for conventional reasons) separate from her, but he could put her out of his life, so far as seeing her was concerned, by becoming blind.

It is obvious that neither the uncontrolled expression of one's feelings nor their repression is a satisfactory solution of the problem. There is a third way out, a way that has been emphasized by modern psychologists, and which is called sublimation. It is accomplished through a redirection of the forces engaged in a mental conflict. The emotion of anger, for instance, may be directed into some constructive physical activity, and thus find an appropriate outlet in such a way as to satisfy the conventions and benefit society.

Where the individual is torn between two courses of action that vitally affect him and that relate to a long-standing problem he may select a third course that will satisfy both of the emotional drives that are back of the conflict.

An illustration is a woman who finds her home life most unsatisfactory and desires to leave her husband. On the other hand, perhaps they have children, and she feels tied at home on that account. She may find peace of mind by absorbing herself in the work of making a suitable home environment for the children, in directing their development and in fitting them to make the most of their lives. Or she may turn to art, music, literature, society, for an outlet for her energies.

The activity should be constructive in its nature in order to prove effective. And it should contribute something of value to society, or the welfare of some one outside the individual. Sublimation always represents a compromise, an adjustment between two extremes of expression or action. It is accomplished by the selection of a substitute interest object and the complete absorption, for the time being at least, of the individual in that object. And in order that this new interest object may be effective in arousing and holding interest it must contain elements of inter-

est that are related to both sides of the mental conflict. To quote an English writer, new interests, to be most effective in absorbing the attention from the existing conflict, must be "creative, progressive and absorbing". It should be added that the newly awakened interest should lead out into action. It is the release of the opposing currents of energy into action that completes the process of sublimation and wipes out the unpleasant effects of the conflict.

#### LOVE WHAT YOU DO.

MANY New Thought people fail to succeed in their undertakings because they expect the reading of an inspiring book, or the repetition of some good affirmation, to take the place of directed ACTION.

It is necessary to work in order to get results and to get the best results it is also essential to LOVE your work. The law of Life is Love—an active love expressed in action.

"Faith without works is dead." Reading and affirming without appropriate action to accompany it is like trying to work in a vacuum. The tendency of every affirmation is to find expression in action. Unless that tendency is allowed to follow its natural course of expression, it results in futility.

Love frees energy. Unless you can love a piece of work, it falls below the standard of which you are capable. Unless you love your work, the sources of your success dry up and you stand still or go backward. Whether you love your work or not is a matter of choice and mental attitude on your part. If you welcome to your thoughts only ideas of a disagreeable nature connected with your work, if your mental pictures of your work reflect only its unpleasant features, you will naturally feel little love or attraction for it. And such energy as you put into it will be given grudgingly and with little creative impetus.

There is in every normal human being a continuous urge for life and love and activity. Some portion of this urge must be directed toward one's work to make it a suc-

cess. You should regard your work as a means for the expression of this energy—a means by which you realize many of the joys of life both directly and indirectly. First there is the joy of action, the joy of creating, the joy of overcoming difficulties. All these you can find in and through your work. Indirectly your work may be the means by which you obtain most of the things that make life worth living.

You should therefore bless your work instead of cursing it. By so doing you release more creative energy into your work and make it a means to greater and greater success, as well as multiply your usefulness to society.

Many a man becomes sick of his work because of some inner mental conflict that distracts his energy from its normal expression through work. Adjust yourself to the conditions of your environment so long as you stay in it if you would succeed in your work. If there are petty annoyances in your immediate environment, the best way to free yourself from them is to become interested in your work and forget them. It is a demonstrated fact that our attention can be directed where we choose and interest is bound to spring up where attention is directed.

The following is from Mr. Landone's "How to Turn Your Desires and Ideals Into Realities": "You must put your ideals into idealized action for ideals are the substance of things that are and idealized action is the only certain process of attainment. 'Faith without works is dead' does not stand alone; Christ and the apostles presented the truth many times: 'I must work the works of Him that sent me . . . Return to God and do works . . . What doth it profit though a man say he hath faith, and have not works . . . Can faith save him? . . . Was not Abraham, our father, justified by works? . . . By works was faith made perfect; and the very last message—last chapter of Revelation—is "Behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be."

And this: "It is not holding ideals that makes desires come true. It is using ideals.

# Class Work by Rev. GEORGE C. GOLDEN

May 16. ABRAHAM AND THE STRANGERS or ILLUMINATION. Gen. 18, 1-19.

Bible Readings: Gen. 18, Isaiah 55.

GOLDEN TEXT: All the nations of the earth shall be blessed in him. Gen. 18, 18.

NEW THOUGHT GOLDEN TEXT: Watch therefore, for ye know not what hour your Lord doth come. St. Matt. 24, 42.

T HERE is a flash of genius in every person. No soul is sent into this world without the gift of a special, individual, unique talent. While Spirit is universal, containing and creating all things, yet in the individual it pours itself out through specialized work. Man is informed of his "field" by his desires, fitted and qualified for it by Omnipotent Spirit and no joy that life can give is equal to that which he finds in creating according to the revelations of his own super-SELF.

For man to find himself is illumination. In this lesson of Abraham entertaining the angels there is recorded, in symbolic language, the technique of illumination.

The time for illumination is the rest hour. Abraham, living in a hot country, took his siesta in "the heat of the day," when the thoughts of details dropped from his mind, the worries of the management of his herds and the direction of his men no longer obsessed him. Notice that Adam, in the garden of Eden, heard the Voice in "the cool of the day" for that was his rest hour. For the most of us, the clock of illumination will strike "'twixt the dark and the daylight, when the night begins to lower"-for there is the pause in the day's occupations that gives the opportunity to our superconscious SELF to open the door for vision to walk into the conscious mind.

To be quiet, to be undisturbed, even to be passive and still is to create the condition when clearness of insight and intuitive knowledge fall from the invisible as lightly as the feather drifts down from the eagle in his flight. To force illumination, to compel insight—is to close the door of the soul and bind revelation in unde-

monstrable obscurity.

The reception of illumination is joy. The man to whom illumination comes with its insight of, say, musical talent, can drive that destiny away by shoving it from him through fear. "I am not fit." "I am not worthy." "Conditions make this career impossible." "There is no room in the world for my talent." These are the subtle arguments that mortal mind presents to him. It is only by realizing that Spirit which creates that illumination has prepared for its realization that he can drive fear from his consciousness and give himself up whole-heartedly to the joy that HIS own career, HIS own fulfillment, has been revealed to him.

I am still and quiet, letting Omniscient SELF reveal to me the good it wills to do through me.

GOLDEN TEXT: A soft answer turneth away wrath; but a grievous word stirreth up anger.

NEW THOUGHT GOLDEN TEXT: Beloved, believe not every spirit but try out the spirits, whether they are of God. 1 John 4, 1.

T HE symbol of the "well" is one that runs all through the Bible. Isaiah spoke of them who listened to the inner SELF as of people coming to drink of a fountain; and the Master in his talk with the woman at the well told of the spring that was within man, giving forth living waters.

Have you never put every last bit of energy and intelligence into something you were accomplishing until you felt as empty as a last year's bird's nest? You were drained dry. You were empty. But after a rest, after making yourself one with unconsciousness and thoughtlessness, you woke up to the fact that now you had ideas of which you had never dreamed, you possessed even more energy than you ever had had. Whence came these? From the "well," from the Spirit that is in you. You drew from your deep, mystical SELF.

But man has found that every idea that comes into his consciousness is not safe to follow—that he seems to harbor both good and bad impulses. An enemy has sown in his conscious mind tares that are growing up with the wheat that God has planted. How can he distinguish? How can he try out the spirits?

This is the drama of Isaac in this lesson. The first spirit he tried, he called Esek, that

is, contention. Man, when he is first coming into his own, is inclined to consider contention as the only possible step to self-realization.

This is the stage when the individual has not yet found himself. He is moved by ambition but has no clear idea of the particular field in which his talents can be realized. He is an imitator rather than a creator.

When man finds the first spirit leading nowhere, he will probably try another, as did Isaac, and give himself up to Sitnah, hatred. Now he no longer makes any pretense of individual work. His whole time is occupied with active, aggressive

plans against others.

"I know that is true," replied Kate thought-


fully, "because of an experience of my own.

THE CRITICISM: "I have just read your article in Nautilus about the spiritual basis of continuing abundance, and it seems very strange to me that you, who stand for the individualism of each personality more than anyone else of whom I know, should have written such ideas."

ANSWER: I do believe in the individuality of God, of every soul manifesting, of every cell. of every tree, of every blade of grass! But, I do not now stand for individualism, although I confess that years ago I did do so.

Sixty or seventy years ago, when we were

growing out of DEPENDENCE — awakening from dependence upon things, conditions, people and creeds—individualism and the consciousness of independence were then of great help!

But, NOW we need something more than we need individualism — we need INTER-DE-PENDENCE—that is, the inter-dependence of the Christ spirit—the feeling of BROTHERHOOD!

After great submissive dependence, the soul re-acts to over-egotistic independence! Neither is perfectly balanced. Each is a half-thought. What we need is loving inter-dependence! Hence for years, I have NOT emphasized individual-ism—for it is primarily personal independence. Elizabeth Towne's slogan of "Christ-in-all-of-us for the good-of-all-of-us" is the ideal of soul-IN-TER-dependence!

# PAY TO THE SOURCE OF GREATEST SPIRITUAL HELP.

QUESTION: "Why do you say that you pay to God, when you pay to churches? Aren't taxes God's, too? Are not schools and teachers God's just as much as the churches? Isn't paying really God creating the churches and schools?"

ANSWER: I am not sure that I understand all the questions in your long letter; but I realize that you object to my paying tithes to churches. In the first place, I never made the statement, for I hold that tithes should be paid to that source from which we receive the greatest spiritual help.

Second, what I did say is that that which I pay to churches is a self-imposed local tax—a tax which I impose upon myself equal in amount to that which I pay to the local schools. What I pay to the churches, I do not include in my tithes. My tithes are what I pay to that person or persons who, during the month, have given me the greatest spiritual help. I am very certain that if we pay to the churches an amount equal to our school tax in appreciation of the true value the churches render to a community there will be little need of tithing churches.

### DIVINE RIGHT TO MONEY.

WILL YOU DEMONSTRATE MONEY FOR ME? "I have been a teacher and a healer for many, many years. I have written some stories which will make me wealthy! I need money to publish them. A. J. G.—Read the article by Herbert Coolidge in June (1926) Nautilus. No one can influence you against your will UNLESS you fear that he can. There is a faculty in your own mind that stands as a watcher at the gate and protects you from the negative thoughts of others—and unless you yourself welcome such thoughts, they cannot

come into your thought field and control your actions.

MRS. M. W.—If you feel a strong enough liking for the work, and confidence in your ability to produce results, I believe you can succeed in spite of physical limitations. Several of the most successful teachers and healers have been similarly handicapped. By what is termed in psychology the law of compensation, such physical limitation often leads to unusual development in the effort to make up for it. I would try repeating about twenty times just before going to sleep at night and the first thing in the morning, a simple affirmation to the effect that THESE THINGS DO NOT TASTE GOOD TO YOU AND THAT THEREFORE YOU DO NOT DESIRE THEM. Then think as little as you can about the matter during the day. If you eat of some of the things you are trying to avoid, forget it as soon as possible. DON'T WATCH YOURSELF FROM DAY TO DAY TO SEE IF YOU ARE MAKING ANY PROGRESS. But keep up your affirmations faithfully for two or three weeks. At the end of that time you should find that you really have little desire to eat or drink to excess. As far as the Bromo is concerned-just don't allow yourself to keep any of it in the house.

MRS. C. W.—First, you probably need to assure yourself that you really WANT to get well. In many such cases as yours there is some sort of subconscious satisfaction in continuing ill. There is some advantage to be gained—the attention of the family, freedom from work, sympathy-which the subconscious self (the primitive, child-like self) eagerly grasps at any cost. Ask yourself in all seriousness what inner satisfaction you have to gain by your present course. No one can help you out of your present condition but yourself. You need to put your desire, your attention, your choice, over on the side of constructive activity. You need to work every day to the extent of your strength, and keep on doing so.
