Job Thought He Knew It All.

WHEN the three friends had done their work on Job, and Job had answered back all of the secret thoughts of his heart, then came Elihu and converted Job to New Thought. (See Job 32 to 37)

Elihu turned the thoughts of Job to God after which (Job 38-1) "the Lord answered Job out of the whirlwind." Job then prayed to God and asked His Wisdom, God spoke to him and said in effect: "Gird up thy loins now like a man! Quit declaring that your wisdom is right and that my power is unjust to you! Deck thyself now with majesty and excellency: and array thyself with glory and beauty. Cast abroad the rage of thy wrath: and behold everyone that is proud, and abase him—stand up to him and answer back in my name, not in your own! Then will I confess unto thee that thine own hand can save thee."

Of course, Job had not been able to stand up against his friends who were accusing him, and he was not able to do any of the things that God was able to do. And as soon as he thought about it he remembered that God must be right, while he, Job, must have been wrong. So he becomes humble before God and before his three friends, he declares to them the righteousness of God and

that he holds no grudge against the accusing friends. And the Lord softened the hearts of his friends when Job became humble before God and themselves. And God bade the three friends to change their viewpoint about Job, to recognize that Job had not been sinning in secret, that he had been doing the best he knew how under the circumstances—even as you and I. And God moved on the hearts of the three friends to beg the pardon of Job, and to "offer sacrifice" to Job: i. e., to give Job sheep and cattle, etc., with which to relieve the abject poverty into which he had fallen.

Then the three friends went away over the desert and told everybody what a transformation had come to Job: how he had got down off his high horse and become a real human being again, admitting his own mistakes and forgiving the three friends who had for days been accusing him. Nothing in the world is so hard for a self righteous man to forgive, than to have his friends stand up and accuse him. But God moved on the heart of Job to forgive, and he did it!

"And the Lord turned the captivity of Job, when he prayed for his friends." In other words, when Job began to feel kindly toward his friends, to forgive them for their accusations, to realize that their point of view was just as right as his own, that all of them were transgressors against the truth of God Himself, which they had not been able to recognize heretofore: when Job began to UNDER-STAND his friends, he could not hold a grudge against them because of their misunderstanding of himself.

Then came the great Surprise Party: the three friends rejoicing in Job's conversion to New Thought and humanity, and his for-

giveness of them, went away and told the tale to all of the people who used to admire and bow down to Job, but who never quite loved Job because of his self righteousness!-and then they came together, a great multitude of them, and visited Job to condole with him over his suffering, to rejoice that his captivity was turned and that he was getting well and was not quite so abjectly poverty stricken as before. And they proved their own genuineness and understanding when "each one gave to Job an earring of gold and a piece of money." There being a great multitude of them, and such willing co-operation, the result was a lot of money and a lot of gold earrings—besides the contributions that Job had already received from his three friends-all of this fortune with which to begin his new success in life. So Job's appreciation began to flow out to everybody in his world! From thinking of himself as the only "perfect and upright man," he began to see that everybody else was perfect and upright too when it came to the real pinch. And he saw that God moved on the hearts of all of them to CO-OPERATE for the good of anybody who needed extra help.

The Book of Job records that Job also had a new crop of children, seven sons and three daughters, and "in all the land were no women found so fair as the daughters of Job: and their father gave them inheritance

among their brethren."

"Also the Lord gave Job twice as much as he had before. So the Lord blessed the latter end of Job more than his beginning."

Job's Complex and His Healing Through New Thought.

JOB had arrived at the place where he had a "mental cancer" as defined by psychoanalysis. A "mental cancer" is a "complex" established in the subconsciousness, and Brill, one of the great American authorities, defines a "complex" as: "A series of emotionally accentuated ideas in a repressed state." This is the best definition I know of, of a "complex," which when it has gone far enough becomes a "mental cancer," hard, repressed, and then it explodes and begins to show on the outside as a real cancer, tumor, etc., boils in Job's case.

Every disease that appears to come from within the body is originally set up by some kind of HARD THOUGHTS which create tension, etc., strictures in the nerves, and are the seeds of every disease that arises in the system of man. Of course outer conditions can help along the disease, or one can be transplanted into better conditions which will tend to reduce the HARDNESS and eventually dissolve the "complex." Thus does modern psycho-analysis point to the infinite wisdom of Jesus Christ when he said, "Forgive those who despitefully use you and persecute you," "LOVE your enemies." And he showed us how to (1) dramatize ourselves to ourselves as loving our enemies instead of hating them, and then (2) act out the drama of truth, by "doing unto others as we would have them do unto us."

And so Job was converted to New Thought, a new understanding of life. He waked up to a realization of God's infinite goodness and wisdom working for His righteousness in and through all individuals, saving them from sin, sickness and death just as fast as the individuals can turn to him, instead of basing their judgments on the outer world conceptions of life. God's life is one life, harmonious, ever unfolding. But outer life looks to be conflict, good and evil, with some folks more righteous than others. (Our job is to see and love life as God sees it and loves it.)

Job came through his troubles to realize the equality of God's divinity in all human creatures, and the liability of all human beings to err in an infinite number of different ways, any and all of which can be healed only by returning to the source within, the Infinite One Spirit of God—who is not diverse as human beings seem to be, but is ONE LIFE AND INTELLIGENCE within them all. Ready to heal our troubles when we put them up to Him.

Jesus said, "When ye pray, believe that ye receive (directly from God at that moment—from God's Spirit into the individual mind) and you shall have it."

Translated into terms of the new psychology, it means this: Whatever thing you picture to God and ask Him to give it to you; also picture Him giving it to you, you receiving it from His Spirit into your mind, receiving it and thanking Him for it. You have the

word of Jesus the Christ that if you believe that you receive it from Him you "shall have it." Note that the "receiving" is present tense, and the "having" is for the future. You "receive" a fortune when it is placed in the bank to your credit, but you "have" it only as you use it. You receive in Spirit from God when you believe that you receive; and in due time the desired thing appears in terms of sense.

"As a man thinks in his heart, so is he." David said that thousands of years ago. Note that it is as a man thinks, not in his conscious mind but in his subconscious mind, his heart or habit-mind.

#### Are Married Women Wilder Than Youth?

E LINOR GLYNN is credited with saying that "married women are wilder than youth when they 'cut loose'". Or should I say that she is accused of so stating?

If married women when they cut loose are wilder than youth, it is because the older women are doing by imitation what youth does by nature. The older women who are wilder than youth are merely aping youth and cutting unnatural monkeyshines.

Just as infants begin to get acquainted with themselves by playing with their toes and chewing their fingers, so the adolescent youth, male and female, has to dramatize itself showing off itself before youth of the opposite sex. Just as the baby is wholly absorbed with its toes and its fingers, so the adolescent is wholly absorbed in its feelings of sex attraction. This is natural, normal, and perfectly all right.

But if an older woman continues to ape youth and cut its monkeyshines, she or he is a case of arrested development. And arrested development means that such a woman clings to her adolescent interests, refusing to let go of them and permit herself to go on to the new life interests which come next in point of growth. Such a woman is in love with herself and her past sensations.

Next after the adolescent phase of individual growth, come the parenthood interests. In the normal woman who grows healthily mother-interests come next and immediately upon the heels of that adolescent age in which

human beings disport themselvs wildly in order to attract the interest of the desirable ones of the opposite sex. The "normal matron" loves babies and enjoys motherhood and finds it still more absorbing than she found the mating interests. She continues to grow with her children.

When a woman has grown up with her children, keeping with them in all of their pursuits, until the children begin to spread out over the world carrying into new fields the fruits of their childhood and adolescent association with her, then the mother finds herself faced again with a transition in her own life. with a need for letting go of that which is past and looking forward to the next phase of her own growth. At this time the woman passes through "the dangerous age"-equally as dangerous an age as she passed through shortly after marriage, when she had to make her choice between staying tied to the mating interests of life, or going forward with the parenthood interests.

After the children have been brought up and are "out of the way," the new interests to which the normal woman turns for further growth, are the interests expressed in women's club life, including the newest phases of that life as expressed in the League of Women Voters, which concentrates upon the study of government and politics. If she continues to grow with these natural new interests she takes more and more part in the municipal and political life of her community and of the nation. In other words, having grown as far as she can grow with the home interests, she now begins to grow with the municipal and state interests, which afford her a new and almost unlimited opportunity for development in service to her community, municipality and state.

## Thirty Miles Separated Us and Telepathy was the Only Means of Saving the Day

For Five Months My Wife Never Failed to Receive My Daily Telepathic Message, Upon Which So Much Depended

Interest in telepathy drew my wife and me together. Her father's library contained some books written by Swedenborg and we spent our courtship and honeymoon reading them.

We were, at one time, particularly interested in the author's description of transportation in Heaven. You will recall he explained that mode of travel as nothing more than visualization. The travel-wishing spirit simply visualized the place he wanted to go, and io, he was there.

Visualization, too, was used by spirits (according to Swedenborg) when they wanted to converse with others, widely separated. The spirit visualized its friend, then started to talk. The second spirit heard everything said. There seems to be a deep significance to VIS-UALIZATION in all of Swedenborg's works.

My wife and I spent much time and thought upon the idea of visualization, and tried to apply it to every desire of our lives, particularly in our experiments with telepathy.

#### I Kept Myself Awake By Trying To Telepath My Sleeping Wife.

I was then working as a night telegrapher in a junction office of a big railroad. During the early hours of the morning, when business was slow, I kept myself awake by attempting to convey ideas to my sleeping wife. At first she did not respond.

One night I held to my temples the terminals from a local galvanic battery that furnished electricity to work the sounder of the telegraph instrument, at the same time visualizing as intensely as I could, that I was kissing her.

The next morning when I went home, she told me of a dream that woke her up. It took her nearly five minutes to convince herself that I was not in the bedroom with her.

Each day our experiments in telepathy by way of visualization became more successful. The use of the galvanic battery was soon abandoned. I think it was only good to assist in concentrating the attention, but useless in the way of assisting thought-transference. I found that I could wake my wife up at any time of the night I wished. This I did by kissing the back of my own hand, at the same time picturing that member as her face and lips. But though I could wake her up, I had not yet succeeded in transmitting my thoughts with any degree of precision.

About six months after we were married, my wife got a job as manager of a rooming house near the telegraph office. Transients arriving from a branch line train would go to bed and ask her to call them fifteen or twenty minutes before the arrival of the morning limited for New York City. That through train was nearly always late, at that time, so my wife depended upon me to tell her the exact arriving time, so that she could give her roomers twenty-five minutes to get up and dress and catch the train. Sometimes it would be five hours late. At such times our patrons would have plenty of sleep in good comfortable beds while patrons of other hotels would come to the depot and have to sit up waiting for the train. Our contented patrons were our best advertisement.

Then one day I was ordered to transfer to a better station thirty miles south of the junction. I tried to make arrangements with the incoming night telegrapher to notify my wife each night of the arriving time of the Limited, as I had done. But he would not do it because a rival rooming house had agreed to give him his room rent free in return for his advising them, as I had done my wife, of the arriving time of the train. It looked pretty black for our rooming house. I was sure that we would lose all our trade.

#### We Agreed To Try Telepathy As A Last Resort.

"Let's try telepathy," my wife remarked as I kissed her to go to my new position. "Wake me up twenty-five minutes before the train is to get here; I'll understand that I am to call the roomers as soon as I am awake."

"We can try it," I replied dubiously, "but don't blame me if your roomers get left." She laughed but said nothing. Evidently she firmly believed that I would wake her up.

The first night in a new job is always a busy one. I worked with unfamiliar things all around me and forgot about my wife until nearly four A. M. Then, as a little respite edged itself in between my sleepy moments, I realized that I was to call her twenty-five minutes before the train was to arrive at the old junction point. A burning shame came over me that I had completely forgotten her in her difficulty.

I began clicking furiously at the telegraph key, asking the dispatcher where the Limited was then. I thought, of course, that it had passed the junction long before that time. Imagine my relief when he told me that it would reach the junction point within the next twenty-five minutes.

## How I Sent The Message That Meant So Much To Us.

Thanking the dispatcher, I lay back in my chair and relaxed. The early morning silence was restful. I closed my eyes for a moment, then slowly raised the back of my hand to my lips while vividly visualizing my wife's black wavy tresses, her white forehead, her dark eyebrows and lashes. Then I kissed her nose and her lips, which I visualized as being slightly parted. It seemed that the strange telegraph office faded from my senses and that I was actually standing beside my wife's bed and bending over her, so deep was my concentration.

Then I visualized her turning away from me, raising one arm above her head, opening her eyes and peering sleepily at me, somewhat startled, and then smiling.

At that moment the telegraph instruments in the office began to click again, the lights grew suddenly bright and my will could hold the scene of my wife's awakening no longer. Nor could I seem to repeat the picture that early morning and when my relief appeared at seven A. M. I hurriedly got into my little car and hurried homeward. I wanted to be at my wife's side when the irate roomers woke up and began to scold her for letting them miss their train.

But my worry was just so much energy wasted. My wife evidently expected me to reach home about eight o'clock and when I opened the back door the odor of the fresh ham and eggs tickled my nostrils. BOYS! but it smelled good! But the pleasure I got from my nose was no more than what spread over me as I noted the happy smile on my wife's cheery face as she turned from the hot kitchen stove to greet me.

#### "It Worked! It Worked!"

"It worked," she was so delighted, "and oh, dear, you were so real to me. I seemed to see you seated, relaxed, in your new office." As she kissed and hugged me she continued, "Isn't it wonderful that we can transmit our thoughts by visualization so surely? Some day, probably when we know more about telepathic wave-lengths, we can talk upon any subject we may wish. Just now, we are using only the wave lengths of love, and on it we are passing the message that a train will reach a certain place in twenty-five minutes. Isn't it a wonderful combination or code we have worked up?"

The steamy coffee burnt my tongue as I gulped it down so hurriedly in my exultation. My knife felt like precious gold as I spread the butter over a hot biscuit.

"It is wonderful," I managed to say between bites; "and we must remember that the first step in telepathy is visualization. From that we can build up a method of transmitting all our thoughts, and possibly transporting the image of our bodies, as Swedenborg describes in his Spirit Heaven."

For five months my telepathic message to wake her up never failed; and we discontinued it only when she gave up the rooming house and moved down the line to where I was working.

(EDITOR'S NOTE: As a simple example of the importance of visualization in connection with thought transference, the following incident related by Edward B. Warman, LL.D. in Psychic Science Made Plain, Volume I, may prove interesting: "Some years ago, in Chicago, I would occasionally dine with one of my publishers at one of the popular

restaurants. In a playful mood he would toss a coin to ascertain who should pay for the dinner. As often as he looked at the coin after tossing, and then said, 'Head, or tail?' so often he was elected to pay. Why? Because I, being in a passive mood, received from him by thought-transference, the knowledge of the result as soon as his mind had centered upon it. This occurred scores of times, and he marvelled at my accuracy, until one day he said: 'I have made a discovery. I used to credit you with being a good guesser, but I am now convinced that you did not guess, you knew. Yes, you knew the result as soon as I did. Today I shall not look at the coin after I toss it.' He tossed it. I paid for the dinner. Ever after that it was a matter of guesswork. This was not mental telegraphy, because he did not by an act of his will send me the thought; it was thought transference without intent on his part.")

POOR little fellow—he was weak, nervous, irritable! Life had just begun with him, really; for at thirty, which he was, a man just begins to live. But he had every symptom of death—mental and spiritual dissolution.

One day he came to the Wall. There was no going beyond it. He sat down to think. And out of his cogitations he wove a new scheme of life.

He was going to change all things which had been as habits before. They were like these:

He had given a large per cent of his energies to Worry. He had worried, especially, over money matters. His salary was small, and sometimes irregular in coming. (It should be said that he was a minister in a small church.) Bills piled up and looked like mountains which it would be pretty hard to level with his little toy shovel which was his salary.

He worried, again, over the things which were going on in his church and in his community. He had tried so hard to convert sinners! Of what value had his efforts been? Folks went on and did as they pleased, no matter how eloquently he lifted his voice against their ways. Particularly was this true in his church. There were three or four who were ever creating dissension. One of them belonged to the War Department of the church—that is, the choir. She was a temperamental

singer. Her voice could warble in harmony in an anthem, but outside of that it warbled in discord. And he worried about that—as if he could help it!

There were other worries, but there were also other things besides worries which were annihilating him. One of these was Repression.

One form of repression was the holding down of his natural ebullient self for fear folks would misunderstand him. He did not laugh overmuch. He had finally come to a droop-mouth state—as unnatural to him as gloom to the sun.

Then, perhaps the worst condition of all, he had tucked away in his heart a great disappointment. Do you know what I mean? He had married the wrong woman. The memory of the Other One kept coming up ever and anon to bother him.

Even though he was a minister he was human. The Other One could have done so much for him—as a human. There were urges in him which could be expressed only in Her presence.

He wanted someone to love with all his natural being. He had no such one. He was always in danger, therefore, of picking out some little princess with lovely face and soft hands over whom to sigh. He had to watch himself, for the desire was deep—deep as any instinct in human life.

There were other things the matter with

this poor irritable fellow, but he was psychologist enough to study himself at last, and seek a remedy.

## The Basis of Spiritual Healing

By Horatio W. Dresser, Ph. D.

HEALING is a progressive term, covering a wide range of remedial processes, bodily, mental, moral. Although primarily it involves restoration, it has come to include permanent benefits in disposition, character, attitude towards life, and to imply a philosophy. In this sense it is spiritual, and calls for the use of spiritual power.

So, too, the means employed are progressive, from a balm or salve applied on the surface and left to do its work to an interior activity enlisting the faith, wisdom, and persistent concentration of the individual. Much more depends upon healer and patient than on the illness or other trouble for which healing is sought. For it becomes a question of intelligence and daring; intelligence in discerning causes and seeking power to remove them, and courage in making a venture where, externally speaking, there seems to be no hope. I shall assume that one who seeks spiritual healing for himself has persistence enough to make utmost effort if need be.

#### The Author's Experience In France.

I may be permitted to illustrate by personal experience, for it is when we come face to face with conditions that we learn these prin-While in France in wartime as a Y. M. C. A. secretary, I was quartered at night in dead of winter in an empty brick house that had been partly shot up. The cold was penetrating, the comforts few, the opportunity to catch my last "cold" close at hand; and I had just arrived from well-heated quarters in America. All night on the decisive occasion I had to fight, literally to fight, to keep from succumbing to a condition which would bring me helpless into the hands of physicians. Why was it so important to win the victory? Because every occurrence is an opportunity for realizing the presence and supremacy of the Spirit, and one must not in any event yield to circumstance. To be swept under by circumstance may be to fall a prey to disease amidst which it will be difficult to help one's self at all. Spiritual healing is preventive. Meet the situation as it arises, before any one knows about it, and you may be able to turn the tide and have no illness at all. As a result you are likely to emerge from the experience with more inner control than before. Spiritual healing should leave us stronger.

The implied philosophy may be suggested by the fact that there are two views concerning circumstances ordinarily prevalent. We may regard circumstances as decisive, for instance, the locality into which we were born. our physical habitat, social relationships, heredity, the amount of money we chance to possess, our vocation in life; or, with an outlook towards the ideal world, we may take each of these conditions to be an incentive toward progress and say, with Emerson, "the soul makes circumstance." Submission or resignation readily follows in the one case, the victorious attitude becomes dominant in the other. One not only takes the current when it serves but plunges forward when everything seems adverse.

#### The Victorious Attitude.

It is important to know that in the victorious attitude the spirit is open to higher forces. As in ordinary life we pass from fear to faith, from hate to love, in swift inner changes; so in spiritual healing we make the transition in greater fullness, with the realization that the instant's inner change means another center of equilibrium, with its resulting consequences. To know that we are reinforced is to realize that external changes in conditions will be followed by outward results. Or, when spiritual healing is prevented, untoward circumstances will be forestalled. This is possible because power is sought at the vital moment when inner conditions are threatening. Where all would seem ruin from below, all seems promising from above. the sunlight breaks through a mist and dispels it, so this higher power accomplishes a work which seems impossible while we grope our way along in the darkness of ignorance.

We may illustrate the educative phase of spiritual healing by any adverse trait or handicap, such as a defect in speech, lack of confidence, or a tendency to impulsiveness. Such a handicap may seem a misfortune which fate has bestowed upon us, or it may be regarded as an opportunity to awaken us to victory, to make effort from within, learn the causes, overcome the obstructions, and move forward to complete success. Most of us require such an obstacle.

## Obstacles Are Directly Related To The Soul's Needs.

If the soul makes circumstance, every obstacle whatever may be said to bear creative relation to the soul's needs. If I am impulsive, for example, I reap results accordingly in manifold directions in daily affairs, even in my illnesses. Obviously, I lack self-knowledge; I need moderation, inner control, poise; I need to consider wisely before I act. With me, spiritual healing will be chiefly a preventive process. Convinced that no one can instill moderation into me, I wisely decide to grow in inner peace and poise. To put myself into a state which invites such repose is to open my spirit to the higher or victorious forces. Thus my spiritual healing begins with the realization that I have the power to lift my spirit to a higher level.

Healing in the lesser sense, as the mere overcoming of disease, for example, a nervous disorder, is best understood in the light of this, its more enduring benefit. If I am suffering from a form of nervousness, this is but one instance of my typical attitude toward life. Very likely I am not only nervous but hypersensitive. Perhaps I take myself too seriously, am too intimately aware of my sensations, too greatly centered on my own moods, fears, general emotions. In so far as I am able to reduce these, my various reactions or responses to life, to a typical approach to circumstances, and this to an inner disturbance which appears to be my most central. handicap, I should be able to strike at the root of many troubles at once.

To master a handicap, such as a defect in speech, is to advance to a greater degree of inner control. Thus a famous Greek orator won his fame and power in the first place by patiently and persistently overcoming a speech-defect which would otherwise have left him in obscurity. It is said that Phillips Brooks acquired his very rapid and eloquent utterance in the successful effort to overcome his defect. If we agree with Emerson that every man should be grateful for his faults. we see that a fault is a partial expression of

power which might be put forth constructively. To be nervous and sensitive in type is to be a candidate for life-long misery, or to find some way in which this extreme sensitivity is the clue to something great and beautiful.

It is not creditable to us that we must acquire methods of healing, in the conventional sense of the term. Disease is in one way of looking at it a disgrace. For we might have lived without it. We might have retained our openness to higher power, might have been free and spontaneous in heart and mind. It is in a sense a disappointing necessity that we must spend so much time merely in regenerating the mind, purifying the body, and cleansing the life. All this may be regarded as essentially negative work.

#### How To Turn Troubles Into Blessings.

To be positive is to meet life, meet circumstances as they arise in such a way that experiences which would otherwise breed trouble will produce blessings. Instead then of studying spiritual healing as a mere process of recovery, bring together the various clues mentioned above and consider how far you have progressed in meeting handicaps or tribulations so that it has ceased to be a question of disease but has become a problem of life.

By life's problem I mean in the first place discovering what we can do best and how most wisely to do it. If my talents point to the fact that I should become an artist, an architect, playwright, executive leader, novelist, it seems plausible that I should be troubled by a persistent restlessness until I am engaged at last in my true vocation. When I put my sensitiveness, for example, to work it will not be nervousness or tension. Power confined, like an inferiority complex, is, negatively speaking, an urge toward trouble. For it is natural for me to produce, to contribute my share to the world's work.

Illustrate by elderly people of ability who have retired from active work long before their time. What is more pathetic than a widowed mother without enough to do? Scarcely less pathetic are the idle and wealthy people who are always flitting about trying to overcome ennui. For it is natural for each of us to work and to keep on working till the end. Expression is life, repression misery, if not death. As soon as you find out that you are restless, sensitive, nervous, repressed, shut in, set about finding what you should do, what you might have been doing for years to use

your powers constructively. Do not dwell on this negative state. Transfer your interest and activity to the power behind, and begin to use it by doing just your work in the world.

Overcoming Disabilities Once For All.

I am assuming that every one interested in spiritual healing, in contrast with merely mental healing or bodily restoration, is seriously in earnest, and wishes to overcome his disabilities once for all. Life is so constituted that it will urge and urge till we penetrate behind to see what is urging and why. Thus in an instance which I have mentioned elsewhere a young man of ability was, negatively speaking, beset by headaches which no

physician could cure. But, positively speaking, he was potentially or temperamentally a scholar. It seemed absurd on the face of it that his chronic headaches were a sign of power. The obvious thing to do was to try one kind of medicine after another, as people nowadays take aspirin to stave off a cold. Yet as some of us today are trying to learn why we have colds and to avoid them altogether, so as to arrive somewhere; so this young man looked back of appearances to reality. In reality he was a spiritual being, living in the natural world, with a work to do which he was not doing. The moment he transferred his attention from his imprisoning state to the powerseeking expression he began to utilize what today is called spiritual healing.

### Truth is Silent

Lesson V on "How Truth Heals"

E VERY student, approaching the subject of metaphysics, comes with these questions: What is Truth? Have you got the Truth? How much will it cost me to get it? How long will it take me to get it?

He wants truth in a definite statement that he can write, parse, analyse and dissect.

I hate to disappoint him but, to be truthful myself, I will have to inform him that there can be no answer to his question, What is truth? any more than there is a definition for love or a formula for the creation of life.

Should you go to Mr. Edison and ask him what—just exactly what—is electricity, he would have to shrug his shoulders and throw out his hands and demand that you ask him something easy.

Should you, however, ask him what he can do with electricity, that is entirely a different matter. Here he is on definite, familiar ground. His replies would be both practical and honest. He knows much he can do with electricity.

If you ask him what he assumes electricity to be, I am quite sure that he could give you an honest reply. In his own mind, he had to assume it to have certain unchanging qualities before he could venture on a new experiment and so discover another application of that power.

When Pilot asked the Master, "What is Truth," the great Teacher was silent. Truth is silent. We can't define it, for to define it would be to limit it. We can't liken it to anything we know, for it embraces the whole world and infinitely more. It is an undiscovered continent, it is a whole universe into which we are advancing day by day, reclaiming more and more of it, just as the pioneers carried civilization step by step into lands where silence had only been previously disturbed by the calls and songs of nature's zoo and the music of murmuring brooks and sighing zephyrs.

We must, however, have, like the inventor, an assumed statement of truth before we can begin our employment of mental creation. Where shall we find one? If we can ascertain the assumption of those men and women who have proved their mastery over life, then

we may feel certain we are as near the truth as we can come at present. This is the best rule we have; "By their fruits shall ye judge them." If one assumption gives only failure and disaster to the people who hold it, then we want none of that. If another has brought more success, health and happiness into a person's life because of their belief in the statement, then that is the foundation on which we may expect to build with some satisfaction and efficiency.

This is the statement that is as old as thought and as fresh as the morning, a formula that the ancient seer gave his disciples and the modern thinker finds pregnant with ideas: "All is mind and mind is nothing."

You will readily see traces of this assumption all through the sacred writings, for the devotional mystic held the teaching, not that the world was divine, but that the world was nothing and God was all.

There is a psychological application of this statement that we today cannot overlook. When this device is practised on the mind, it gives the individual more control over his affairs, it frees him from strain and thereby liberates intelligence. We practice it because it is advantageous to our success. We hold it because it conduces to happiness.

After the San Francisco fire, I knew two men who had passed through that disaster. One dwelt upon the tragedy-he could not banish the sight of the monster flames from his mind nor the smell of smoke from the corridors of his memory. He went around for months a man stunned and paralyzed. He might talk to you but he was not present. He would listen to you but his mind dwelt in the past. The other man who, in a material way, really suffered more than the first, said, "It may sound most unreasonable and illogical but, as far as I'm concerned, the fire did not occur." He walked abroad in the city that was picking itself up from its accident and secured leases on property that his judgment told him would be valuable situations. Today, the first man is living a precarious existence, explaining his limited means by rehearsing a story that we of the west have almost forgotten. The second man, keeping a lead in the progressive development of a forward pressing metropolis, has really forgotten, in his success and vision, that the fire took place.

Out of mind, out of body. We put things easily out of mind when we practice the policy that all is mind and mind is nothing.

People walk into my office, telling how their youths were ruined by false direction, how their past treads on their heels with prophetic disaster, how a domineering father or a spoiling mother has created in their mentalities the much-used "inferiority complex" or "mother fixation." There is one cure for them. If they can think of a happy past then they will be delivered. It's all very easy. It requires only a little will-power, a little exercising of the visioning faculty and a bit of faith even as small as a mustard seed.

Another benefit of this statement is the fact that it creates in the individual the mood of unself-consciousness.

Have you never sat down at a game of bridge, playing just for fun, and doing your most skillful work? The game meant just pleasure, relaxation, skill and ingenuity to you. You had the courage to try any scheme that came to your mind. You were spontaneous and therefore intelligent. But play with a partner who is regarded as a crank, who watches your playing for mistakes that he can use for post-mortem material and your ingenuity at cards flies out of the window even though you had determined to do your best and most skillful playing. The game meant so much to you that you ruined it.

There is an old saying that care killed the cat. The owner of the kitty didn't practice the precept that all is mind and mind is nothing.

There is a hint of this policy in several directions of the Master. When he demanded of his followers that they hate their fathers and mothers, he was simply seeking to relieve them of the danger of injuring their parents through the excess of their affection.

I noticed that in one of her novels, May Sinclair goes so far as to say that a man should hate his business. Business should be kept in its place as a possession. He who is so devoted to his profession that he lives it night and day, is owned so much by it that he can give it only dull, uninterested service instead of spirited, intelligent supervision.

The individual, practicing the principle we have just explained, is able to develop another characteristic of those who live the metaphysical life and that is: Trust those things that give you pleasure and avoid what pains you.

In our reaction to pleasure or pain, there is very much more involved than appears on the surface.

This is illustrated in the story of the boy,

Jesus, visiting the temple at Jerusalem. was the first time the lad had been in a large town. There were many strange sights to meet his gaze and very colorful, very magical, very intriguing, indeed, they must have been to him. But the place that fascinated him the most was the temple. We can readily understand the reason. The temple, to him, was the symbol of theology and the Master was a theologian. It signified to him what music meant to Chopin or painting to Corot. When rebuked for his indifference to the worry of his parents, his reply was, "I must be about my Father's business." He had trusted that sense in him that gave him pleasureexquisite, indescribable, mystical, gratifying pleasure. To him that sense of pleasure was the pillar of fire leading to the promised land. It was the Holy Ghost directing him into truth.

They are there, intelligent, alive and powerful as are all ideas, pressing with an irresistible power towards their liberation and expression. When you come to a subject, a person or a place

that gives you a great sense of inner fascination, you say you enjoy it. What really is taking place is that these ideas in you are acting like a magnet, drawing to themselves the subject, person or place like a piece of steel.

You must think I'm a genius, I hear a reader say. I'm only a poor, ordinary individual who profits from the criticism of my friends, who learns from the experience of mistakes and who needs the discipline of hard knocks.

### In Line WITH God

#### By Brown Landone

#### How I was Saved from a Great Loss by Getting in Line with a World Movement

RUTH can be used to move heaven and earth for you, if it is in line with a world movement, because "with God all things are possible." But, no one has ever promised that all things are possible, contrary to God. So, if an affirmation is not in accord with a world movement, it will not manifest in reality.

A world movement is of God, because God made every one of the billion and a half people in the world. So, whenever they move in a certain line of action, there is something doing—first, because there are so many hundred millions of them, and second because God manifests in the soul of every one of them. Every affirmation in line with a world movement, brings results because it works with God, and "with God, all things are possible."

The law is absolute in results—whether in healing George's eye, in winning Dorothy's love, in providing a little home for Charles and Caroline, or in piling up riches in The Home Trust Company.

#### How My Friend's Eyes Were Healed.

Take the healing of an eye for example. It worked for my friend. He had been growing short sighted, and for six months he had affirmed, "I am not short sighted. God's perfect sight is my sight. I have a right to long sight and perfect sight. God will manifest perfect long sight for me."

Yet, he became more and more short sighted. Since Truth is Truth, he wanted to know why he continued to grow more short sighted while he was using Truth and affirming long sightedness.

My friend was working many hours a day, reading books and writing. In each eye there are at least 4,000,000,000 little individuals—little cells. Every time he used his eyes to read a page a few inches away, he compelled 4,000,000,000 individuals in each eye, to move in such a way that they shortened his sight in order to focus his eyes on the printed page at a distance of 18 or 20 inches. Every

word he read compelled a "world movement" of little cells in one direction—that of short sightedness. So, since all his affirmations were contrary to that world movement they had no effect.

When he came to talk to me about it, I said: "Unless you change the 'world movement' of the billions of cells in your eye, and unless you affirm in line with that changed movement, your sight will continue to get worse. But, if you use your eyes so that you compel a 'world movement' of billions of cells, looking far out of your window to that mountain away over there, or in viewing the beauty of the trees as they stand up—like sentinels—on that hilltop, or the clouds hanging over the ridges to the northwest—then, the world movement of the billions of cells in your eye will be in line for long sightedness, and the Truth of long sight will manifest."

So, he began to use the 4,000,000,000 little cells in his eye to look at things far away and to take joy in the beauty he perceived at a distance. Thus, he compelled a new world movement—and was healed of short sightedness.

With conditions in your body, you can compel world movements of billions of cells, because you are their god; but, since you are not the god of the universe, you have no right to compel world movements of other people; and so, it is you who must get in line with them, and work with God instead of trying to work contrary to God's movements when He moves people. In all problems outside of yourself get in line with the world movement, and affirm your right to your share of it.

#### Getting In Line With a World Movement Saved Me From Great Loss.

This Truth is what saved me from losing money in the South a few years ago and led me to acquire valuable land near where I live. I then had a few pennies saved, and was looking for land in which to invest. I was inclined to the South and was especially attract-

ed to Florida. But about that time people outside of Florida started a "talk movement" which led a multitude of outsiders to grasp greedily for something beyond reality. There was talk and more talk and thus others who were not graspers were misled.

I confess I was tempted. Florida was right in itself and its people were right. So I was tempted by the "talk." Others were tempted also—and some grabbed, and missed. But a still small voice within me said, "Wait! Florida is a land of immense opportunities; they will not disappear; wait and invest later! If you invest now 60 per cent of your money will be invested in 'outsider's talk,' and only 40 per cent in land. The talk movement is not permanent, and outside graspers are not a permanent population. They will soon 'clean up,' move away, and leave Florida to meet the ill results of their 'talk'."

I listened to that still, small voice, and recognized for the first time that "world talk" may move in one direction while "world movement" moves in another, and that that it's always wise to follow the "movement" instead of the "talk." The insight led me to realize that—all around me—a world movement was taking place—perhaps the greatest world movement of its kind in the history of the world.

#### "The Most Significant Change In 600 Years."

Then another illumination came, and I saw that the movement was in a direction different from any I had ever known—the most significant change in 600 years. It was from the city to the country, for the first time since the fall of the Feudal System in 1280 A.D. Prior to that time peasants lived around one or another baronial castle, protected by the guards of the Baron, while they slaved to provide his wealth.

After the fall of the Feudal System, each group of peasants was left to the mercy of roving bands of marauders, who often descended upon them, stole their grain and sometimes their wives and daughters. Consequently, the peasants began to move together so that they could protect themselves. Thus towns and cities gained impetus for great growth. This kept up even after the advent of nationalities, because it was easier to provide police protection in cities, than to spread out a police force throughout a country. Centuries later came the railroads, and they again aided the world movement to the cities.

This continued until some economists feared that all people of the world would become city dwellers. *BUT*, the economists forgot God, who always provides new means to meet new conditions. God's creative mind working in man created automobiles.

#### How The Automobile Turned The Tide.

Now, after twenty-five years, the auto has turned the tide! The proof is most evident in the largest city on earth—the City of New York. New York is composed of a central city, New York City Proper, and four other boroughs which form the legal city. Outside this, there is the Great City District, now recognized as *The City* by the U. S. Census Bureau. Strange as it may seem to you, *most* of this City District of New York does not lie in New York, but in Jersey.

The tide has turned. The country is coming into its own. This new world movement from city to country is so great that New York City Proper LOST 21.9 per cent of its population in twelve months! And the population of the Jersey Section of New York City District is now only one-tenth less than the population of the entire city of Chicago. It astounded me to learn also that the Jersey Section of the New York City District had a population 42 per cent more than New York City Proper.

I have had many heartaches trying to help those who have written me, asking me "to hold a thought" to help them to "get back" money they have unwisely invested in the 'wrong' real estate; hence, I am giving absolute laws of such investment, so that no more unprofitable investments need be made here, there, and everywhere.

#### How To Determine Values In Real Estate.

FIRST, permanent values exist only where there is a permanent population.

SECOND, great land values will continue only where there is a great permanent population.

THIRD, greatly increasing values are safe only in lands toward which there is a great and increasing movement of people who will settle permanently.

Have you not heard of Nauvoo?

That is strange, because when Lincoln was running for Congress, only 15 years before the Civil War, the vote of Nauvoo was an important factor—for Nauvoo was then METROPOLIS of ALL the eastern MIS-

SISSIPPI VALLEY—a city LARGER than Chicago! Moreover, it had been built substantially—shops, homes, banks, university. Yet, since its population was not permanent, its values vanished and it is almost forgotten!

Where there is no permanent population, values are never sale. Recognizing this and led by Spirit, I put my pennies in line with the greatest "world movement" of people—the most significant in the last 600 years—and I have nothing to regret.

Remember: if the movement is within your-

self, line it up with your ideal.

Remember: if the movement is outside yourself, get in line with it, and affirm your right to a *share* of its good.

#### This Can Be Applied To Any Business.

And, here's another case: a young man, with a little radio business in a small town found himself so over-stocked with receiving sets, that he was not able to sell rapidly enough to make a profit on his overhead. He was a student of Truth, and when he found that he was overstocked, he began affirming, "I shall sell more sets every day; God wants me to get rid of these sets in time to meet my obligations."

But, instead of things getting better they got worse, and he came to me for advice. I had seen him about town before, and as he talked, I saw little lines in his forehead—up and down lines—which I had not previously seen; his smile was not so responsive and carefree as it had been; and he did not carry himself with quite the same happy consciousness of all things going well.

So, I said: "Of course, your affirmation for sales will not succeed so long as you crawl forward with your *mind*, and race backward with your *body*."

"What do you mean?" he said.

"Just this, the way you carry your shoulders now, your forced smile, the lack of joy in your eye, those lines in your forehead—all

make up your world. They are slipping backwards, and slipping rapidly. Your affirmations point forward, but every expression of your body is pointing backward. You are a house divided against itself. You are a god and king of the cells of your body, but there are some 23,000,000,000,000,000,000 of your cell subjects who are in rebellion against you. As a king bring all your subjects in line, so that you'll know that all of those billions of billions of cells are helping you. Then your affirmations will bring success.

"Change the entire world movement of the EXPRESSION of all the cells of your body—whistle when on the street; smile real smiles; every time a person goes by your shop, every time a person comes into the store, whistle the airs which are being broadcast at that time by your receiving set; let your face shine forth the joy of the music you whistle; let others feel your JOY at being able to listen to broadcast music. Then, others will want your joy and they will want it so much that they will want the means (radio) which helps you to get it. Stop trying to sell radio sets; and instead sell your joy!"

And his business moved forward apace!

Be at peace: either the world is good because God made it; or else God is evil for having made something so wrong. So take your choice. If you choose mistakenly, it will not hurt the world or damage God; but it may not work well for you! If you choose rightly, you will be at peace with the world and in love with God, and all will be possible for you.

In your own world, change the world movement to agree with your ideal and affirm success in it.

In the world about you, get in line with the world movement of others, and affirm your right to a share of its good.

Then, you'll work with God and all things will be possible!

EMOTIONS AND IDEAS.

NE speaker at the recent national convention of psychologists emphasized the important part which emotion plays in human life—quite as important as the part played by ideas.

Ideas give the direction to energy, but it is emotion that gives to ideas effectiveness. That is why love is such a powerful—even all important—factor in the daily affairs of life. If you do not love your work, it will lack in effectiveness. The business which is built to a great success has back of it some one's intense interest and love. Love is creative. To love your business is to cause it to grow and expand, under anything like reasonable conditions. Love inspires one to find ways and means to bring about the result desired.

Many great thinkers and philosophers have acknowledged the power of emotion. In a recent issue of the Independent is the following by Geoffrey Parsons: "To feel the right emotions is fully as important as to hold the right ideas, and the great service of religion is the development of the right emotions." And Ferrero, the Italian philosopher, wrote: "It is not ideas but passions that move and transform the world; and an absurd passion is a thousand times more potent than a wise idea."

Science alone is cold and impersonal. It cannot inspire great masses of people to unity of action. But certain religious beliefs—even some which science regards as being based upon pure superstition—still have the power to inspire and move millions.

But even science itself is indebted to that emotion which impels men to patiently work year after year in an effort to penetrate the unknown or to follow out ideas which are based largely upon faith rather than upon demonstrated facts. And frequently such work leads to some great new scientific discovery.

The world needs faith and hope just as much as it does science. In a recent article upon the Prince of Wales, published in Re-

view of Reviews, the writer shows how the Prince helps to key the whole British Empire through his remarkable personal qualities, and his consequent appeal to the emotions of his people. I quote one paragraph from the article: "The Prince of Wales, young, cheerful, persistent, has incarnated the future. When the Wembley Exhibition was failing, his words whipped it into success. When the advertisers congregate in London, he advertises Britain. He is not a policy, not a thought, not a religion, but a mood and a faith. The Prince of Wales is an antidote for pessimism." (The italics are mine.)

Very significant testimony as to the value of a balanced emotional life is contained in a recent article published in the Outlook which deals with the comparative success of children who come from large and small families. The writer gives the result of an analysis made of students at Yale and Harvard. In both cases the results showed (1) that in the class room and in all college activities the students who came from families of five or more children uniformly and positively excelled. Furthermore, the percentage of success was in direct ratio to the number of children in the family from which the student came. Only children invariably showed the lowest degree of success. The analysis took into consideration classroom work, extracurricular activities, athletics, college earnings and the standing of the student among his associates.

A further interesting analysis was made of the Yale classes of 1893, 1896 and 1898 with the result that men who had remained unmarried ranked lowest in the matter of success since leaving college. The next highest were the men who had married but had no children while the most successful were those who had married and had six or more children. 95 per cent in the most successful group were married, and 80 per cent of that group had children. Of the most unsuccessful group only 66 per cent were married and only 40 per cent of them had children.

No doubt the majority of those who made a low showing in this analysis were intellectually equal to the successful group, but because they were spoiled only children they were so self-centered and lacking in selfdirection and poise that they could not lead a normal life emotionally, and as a result were seriously handicapped.

So we come back to the words of Geoffrey Parsons that "to feel the right emotions is fully as important as to hold the right ideas."

#### SELECTING YOUR RHYTHMS.

L IFE is made up of desire and the satisfaction of desire, each succeeding the other in a sort of rhythm.

Civilization has been built, not without considerable blundering and friction, by selecting in the main the most constructive desires and then educating man to choose these in establishing his rhythms, or subconscious habits.

Desires are, to some extent, interchangeable. That is, one desire may be substituted for another, within limits. And this furnishes the basis for culture.

Health and happiness depend largely upon the judicious use of stimuli; upon the judicious selection of the rhythms to be established through desire and its satisfaction.

In this the mental attitude, the direction of thought, and especially the direction of one's power of *choice*, becomes all-important in its effect upon the life of the individual.

The mental attitude should first of all be steady. The attention should not drift from the aim which is, for the time-being, occupying the field of consciousness. The mind should not be divided or distracted by opposing desires.

Emotional conflicts lower the energy and discourage effort. The mental attitude should be so directed as to discourage such conflicts. The choice should be centered where the activity is in process.

For instance, many a woman is living with one man, raising his children, keeping his house, cooking his meals, while her choice and her attention dwell constantly with another man. So she lives in a state of continual mental conflict. Worry and unhappiness are her daily and hourly companions, because she is not united WITHIN HERSELF. Her energy is flowing in two opposing directions. The rhythm of her life, without which no one can be happy or efficient, is destroyed.

Such a situation is perhaps the most difficult with which the individual has to deal. It can only be remedied by the direction of choice and attention, by focusing these faculties upon ONE course, by UNITING the mind until rhythm is established.


First, the situation should be faced and a definite CHOICE made, as to the future course of action. Then the mental attitude must be brought into harmony with that choice. Perhaps a woman, in such a life situation has children. Her love for her children can be used as a substitute for the outside attraction. She can visualize their future happiness, the pleasure of guiding them through the years of childhood, the satisfaction she is sure to feel in the future in the thought of having given them loving care (even if this last is a self-righteous expedient) and emphasize these satisfactions in her own mental attitude and through the magnifying power of her imagination, until the other desire dims and the rhythm of her present life is established in greater harmony and power.

The feelings of discouragement and fatigue that are sure to arise in such circumstances should be ignored, and mental and physical activity occupy every waking moment.

But the greatest relief in such circumstances will be found in a daily short period of meditation, during which the mind is stretched to take in the Truth that the individual is a part of God, or the One Life, and that the Universal forces of Love, Health, Harmony, are waiting to flow into expression through the individual as soon as the consciousness is opened to receive them. The imagination and affirmation or prayer are the means by which the channel is opened for the inflow of love, peace and joy from the Infinite. The vision is thus opened to perceive the underlying spiritual Reality of all life, which is health, harmony, joy—the eternal Kingdom within.

CONCERNING this parable, the Rev. Charles R. Brown says: "In the enlargement and enrichment of personality, with its ever-widening capacity for service, I find something more amazing than anything in the story of the loaves and fishes."

The loaves and fish are the emblems of that vision of power which comes to all who live in a world of human beings. Even in play, the child displays something of his innate executiveness and early in youth come the first indications of the Father's business.

The adult who feels that he is of no service in the world is simply the individual who has turned

his back on his own vision.

The test of the vision is its nourishing quality. It has been well termed by the Master as food and drink. Putting it in plain language, it is efficient, progressive and constructive.

We have been prone to classify certain departments of life as professions or jobs, as arts or trades, as sacred or profane callings. This division is artificial. A man who designs a washingmachine may be giving a higher quality of spiritual service than he who writes a book.

We cannot all be poets or preachers or philanthropists and our visions do not all run in that direction. Our visions are always most practical. He who sees in his acreage an opportunity to make that land produce three times what it has been doing, by his example and experimentation, adds to the prosperity and power of his fellowmen.

Our vision is our efficiency and our efficiency is our vision. By letting it, through us, feed humanity, we find it growing constantly, for its source is in the infinite Cosmos itself.

These latter are the hypocrites because they do not subject teaching to the tests of truth

The great deceivers of mankind are they who themselves are deceived.

The great lights of humanity are they who themselves have tested out the precepts of men and sorted the wheat from the chaff.

One of the great truths that you will find all successful men subscribing to is this old adage: Providence only helps them who help themselves.

He was looking for a "treater" who by the magic of telepathy would make that owner change

P OR this review, the three parts of the gospel of the Master may be profitably held in mind.

The first is man's state. He taught that the Self is not a creature of flesh and blood, but a spiritual entity, living, moving and having its being in the great ocean of God.

All that is, is not the changing of the external world but in its final analysis, is simply the expression of some design lying living in the Self just as the song reposes in the threads of the phonograph record.

The second platform of the Master is that man, like a dusty masterpiece, is apparently in a false state that denies his worth, that limits his power, that flaunts his authority and that ridicules

his immortal status.

How did this false state come about? In the words of the Master, he who is believing himself to be in this condition of material slavery is "bound by Satan." What is Satan? A reality? No. He defines Satan as a clever liar and the father of lies. The subtle race delusion. The false belief in matter.

The third technique of the Master is that if the image of a better condition is held before the spirit, in intelligence and faith, that very conception will work for the individual his own salva-

tion.

Whatever the individual can conceive, his mind can create. That is the power of the unconscious. If we see an action in its perfection, even for a fraction of a second, we have started that idea working in the fertile soil of the soul and the result will be that the "ways and means committee" of the spirit sends in its report.

T OWARD the end of the summer of 1925, I changed my place of employment and entered the service of a mother as nurse to her two girls. the service of a mother as nurse to her two girls. Training and experience over many years had no value in this position. The girls put more trouble into one day than I was accustomed to handle in a month. Explanations were laughed at and fun made out of them. Correction simply called up a disgusting exhibition of temper. Everything I did or said was wrong, especially in the eyes of the household help.

Desperately I struggled to retain my ich and

Desperately I struggled to retain my job and make good. Weeks went by and apparently we had not progressed one fraction. The girls had been sick a great deal and the family lived in fear of further illness. In their play, all dolls and toys had some disease, and I sometimes wondered

if my charges were mentally all they should be.
In desperation I took the subject up with a fellow New Thought student and then I started mental treatment for health and goodness again. Every night before retiring I would read Nautilus until I was calm and rested. Then, lying flat on my back, I would wrap each child in turn in a blanket of love, and affirm Elizabeth Towne's statement: "You are good, you are, you are."

One person living in the house had continually

Slight faults go by with only an explanation. Any really bad deed is five or ten marks subtracted from the one hundred good ones. Always I say: "Well, it's a hundred we'll have tomorrow."

I forgot to say I wear eyeglasses and I explained they were "magic lens." "Anyone wear-

ing my glasses can see the good inside everybody." Oh, my friends, results have been wonderful.

### MRS. CARTER'S ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS.

M. J.—I am very sure that your prayers will be answered for your "wayward" son if you will pray aright and not in a sentimental manner. But first, let us never again call him "wayward," but "God's son." And all of your Nautilus friends will be most happy to join us in affirming for him the following: "As God's son, you are never wayward. His gentle hand is guiding and directing you. INQUIRING MOTHER.—You are very wise not to give up all hope for that son. Go into the silence with your thoughts dwelling upon the great Universal Mind. In it is All memory and ALL judgment. Then, when you are filled with wonder for the vastness of that mind, realize that your son is in that same consciousness, a living part of that Universal Mind. Quietly deny all those qualities in which he appears to be deficient, and positively affirm the dominant Christ mind ever ACTIVE within him.

MRS. G. C.—Let me first ask you to be patient and believe that those granulated eyelids will be healed. Before you take the baby up, say to yourself: "I AM cleansed by the Holy Spirit." Then, take the attitude that this is the Christ Child, for Jesus said, "Of such is the kingdom of heaven." Now for arithmetic: Use objects and small change. Cut up fruits into halves, quarters, etc., and make the lesson a real, living thing. Buy and sell. Let him do some shopping for you. Count the change. "Do the thing, and ye shall have the power," applies to arithmetic as well as metaphysics. Affirm for the boy: "THE MIND THAT ORIGINATED GEOGRAPHY AND ARITHMETIC IS IN YOU, LONGING FOR EXPRESSION. YOU NOW CHOOSE TO EXPRESS QUICKLY AND PERFECTLY THROUGH THAT UNIVERSAL MIND."

I FEEL LIKE I DID WHEN I WAS 16. FREE FROM WORRY, HEALTHY. SELF-CONFIDENT.

JUST eleven years ago I married an upright, religiously brought up young man, one year my senior. I myself come from a religiously inclined family. Both my parents were dead and I was left alone. To me religion meant the inclusion of everything good. This influenced my choice of a man. Ten and a half months later, our little daughter was born. Her expected arrival was not too gladly received by my husband. But the pretty sight of the smiling child at last won him. Towenty-one months later our con was born. him. Twenty-one months later our son was born. His father looked upon him as upon a not needed True, with rents climbing higher and higher as they had been, and only \$18 per week, (his salary), and the bank balance of \$2,000 which my father left me at his death growing smaller and smaller, it was hard to bear; but I thought we were acquiring an ideal family.

In his single days he was taught to turn in all his earnings to his mother. However, he had given me the impression that he had as much as I before we married. Soon I was disillusioned! Never will he speak of it. Feels there is no need for any explanation. To keep peace I let it go as it was. I'd have to forget, that's all there was to that! But my heart closed up also. I was as a dead person trying to keep on living a dead person trying to keep on living.

He worked steadily, however, returning every check to me, so it was up to me to make things move along. Everything was upon my shoulders! The cross seemed to be getting heavier and heavier. I had given my heart into the keeping of this man, in return I was receiving his pay-check and would have to keep on bearing his children. I no longer yearned to feel the tender baby hands around my neck, when I know their father wished them not All the mother love within me rebelled, yearned for an expression. I had to smother it, however. Then life to me was just plain punishment, drudgery. Unbearable headaches weekly poisoned my health, and I grew hard and weary. Only for my children's calculated and the second state of the second se my children's sake I kept existing.

For ten long years have I lived this life of discord with myself and others, avoiding church and religion. 




