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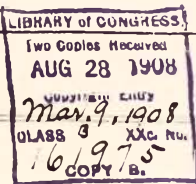

EDITORIAL.

AMERICAN LABOR AND SAFETY AT HOME OF FIRST IMPORTANCE.

Unfortunately for the good of the movement known as the Altruistic, too many of our magazines devoted to New Thought are advocating a Universal Brotherhood Alliance along lines absolutely impolitic and directly impossible of consummation.

Universal Brotherhood as an ethical proposition, under the spiritual process as a unifying general proposition, is very good; but to be good at all we must leave to Asia its own people, and to the United States its own homogeneity. I have no right, if unable to do so, to invite all the unfortunate and poor to my board and bed and bounty; such a move would be suicidal, not alone to myself but to all concerned in such a foolish misapplication of Higher Truth principles. Charity begins at home; if you are unable to maintain yourself while fostering others, you are then in violation of the first of laws, that of continuity, or love, i. e., self-preservation. If I so love self as to elevate self, then must I also so love my other selves about me, as to also elevate and raise them; if I cannot divide present opportunities or modes of income, this prohibits such sharing as would cripple myself, and in no wise aid the other selves whom I invite to share my bounties, and I am falsely performing my own highest duty as regards obedience to the law of continuity. Now to admit hordes of foreign-born poor, laboring classes to American bounty in the field of labor is self-destructive, suicidal and cannot elevate American labor nor those who come

here; it simply lowers one set at the expense of dethroning our own good labor. We have no sympathy with such a monstrous doctrine; we have no sympathy with any man, or set of men, who would lower the rate of labor's wage scale nor fasten upon us a yellow, or a brown, or any other kind of foreign element to the unsettling of American wage affairs.

If the poor of other lands need our help, far better is it for American labor to set aside a few cents of each individual's daily wages and send it abroad to feed and clothe such needy ones; if room and business is needed to employ Asia's hordes, far better is it for American capital to enter upon the home field and retaining such labor at home, under its own institutional environments, remove from American institutions a leprosy so far reaching and undoing in its real nature as to necessitate heroic measures, here and now, ere it becomes a fact in our midst, to head it off.

We believe it our duty to aid all earth's people to the gaining of knowledge and wisdom unto a higher and freer individual and universal life; we would that all people everywhere could so live as to enjoy all life's comforts and emoluments; but we must never undo home and home welfare, attempting that which will destroy instead of uplift humanity in its material as well as spiritual progress. Races of men foreign to our institutions, political, ethical and religious, can never affiliate with us on mutual grounds of understanding, and it's most dangerous to our governmental institutions to invite an element, abso-

lutely ignorant of our economics, into the midst of our competitive labor field; such latter move engenders ill will, hatred, a riotous spirit and great aptness to internal strife and blood-shed, resulting, later, in internal dispute with war, and sacrifice of life and money the outcome. Altruism does not comprehend, in its teachings, any such a mistaken ideal, nor will it presume upon the mixing of the races of men, heterogeneous, with any hope of an after homogeneousness. Altruism means the widest divergence of spiritual liberty consistent with the good of each of the individual national factors of society, thus bringing about unity amidst separateness, each race best served and of best service, in its own environment. Altruism does not, and can never mean, intermixing of races of men; innate spiritual unity in separateness, is the fundamental principle of Altruistic Philosophy.

ALTRUISM AND POLITICS.

Some few Altruists are very apt, under the influences of a universal brotherhood ideal, to become socialistic; some are the more firmly rooted in the idea of a strongly centralized government, as in conformity with the truth of centralized power of the great first cause of the universe; some are inclined to the widest possible interpretation of individual liberty; while the great majority are disposed to drift with the tide while paying the strictest attention to private uplift and individual and personal unfoldment for present and future self-attainment and good.

There is a trite and true saying: "Every man to his trade," which should have very much to do with all matters political; a politician is a man born to the manor or else an adept at the helm in the fort of organization, concentration and management of the masses, as well as an expert equalizer of the energies and mental attributes of men useful for the promulgation of political ends and aims; the political boss is of so many and varied types of human kind

as to preclude any accurate description; he is of the Altruistic in a sense partaking of the keenly intellectual, while, too, highly manifesting all the attributes of the selfish and animal; he can have but a single purpose, but one motive, that of victory for himself and his party; he can harbor no friendship not absolutely of his own actualized good and immediate benefit; he must cast out and away, even father or brother if, in any wise, inimical to his victorious progress; he will mercilessly trample under foot the ambitions, the aspirations and hopes of all who desire to step aside from his own immediate mandate or command; he, like Cæsar, knows no man greater than himself, no ends mightier than his party and personal success, no use for men aside from the place they must, of necessity, assume as essentials to final victory; he is ruthless, while bland and sedate; he raises up but to dethrone; he aspires to nothing but immediate unquestionable results and stoops to anything to gather his forces. The Altruist, if of the right spirit, cannot, possibly, affiliate with the thoroughbred politician; his field is that of uplifting the masses through the culture, education, unfoldment and uplift of the individual, he is the expressed embodiment of the Spirit of Love; he must cast out but the evil that defeats man in his upward and onward progress; his work is for eternity and deals with that which is of the eternal, the soul of man; he can never stoop beneath that which the Great Spirit inculcates within and makes manifest, in and through, him as an agency of the ALL GOOD; he is the quintessence of all that is power, consciousness in the Absolute; he, therefore, can be neither Socialist, Republican, Democrat nor Prohibitionist; he may vote any one of the party tickets and advocate the same, but he can never be limited by the dictates of a boss nor submit to undoing tyranny; he must uphold the patriotic, the Altruistic in government as well as in ethics or religion; he rises above the scum of society, soars aloft but to reach down into and among the flesh pots of

Egypt in order that he may thrill all men and women with the Love Light of the eternal spirit; his is the work of leavening the whole regardless of the petty divisions; he can enter nothing that limits man's freedom to express, to the fullest, breadth of intellect, liberty in choice, as to occupation, religious views or mode of expression, provided, alone, it be in conformity with a process involving eternal unfoldment, including growth unto perfection, in health, success and wealth; for what enriches character and builds for thrift and health in the individual, but raises the masses and improves the rank and file of the whole fabric of human society; he is a patriot in the land of his adoption, or birth, also a patriot in all lands; he respects correct methods of life and procedure, as well as obeys all just laws; the mixing of Altruism and politics is but the rendering of duty to country in a manner free from class legislation or class differentiation, beyond the necessity of choice for the consummation of government. Altruism is not communism, is not radicalism, is not extremes in anything lest it be that of a righteous conservatism essential to the general good of the whole of the institutional. Altruism means correction of evil through spiritual unfoldment, the building of a character from eternal fundamental principles, by and through a process, corrective and hence, per growth, unto perfection and can never ally itself with sumptuary laws or sumptuary methods. We are lawed to death; we are already suffering too frequent coercion; let it cease.

WHERE HE LEADS.

Ever since a child we have sung and heard sung, "Where He Leads I Will Follow," but not until recently have we understood who He referred to, and whom we should follow. We had pictured it as the man Jesus of Nazareth, but God cannot be worshiped except it be "IN SPIRIT AND IN TRUTH," which forever disbars worship of a form, a thing, whether it be a

man of fleshly form or a form of wood, of iron, or stone, or of mere earth. Jesus was flesh, expressing and making manifest something not flesh nor form; He was then the selected embodiment of the worshiping and worshipful essence, spirit and intelligence innate, of being, and hence, indwelling His form of flesh was that which, alone, could comprehend, understand and knowingly worship "In Spirit and in Truth," for that which understandingly so worships must be in very part, in essence and fact of being, of that worshiped; spirit alone comprehends spirit, hence, spirit alone can worship or instruct as to manner of understandingly worshiping that from which, or of which spirit is a part or a fact. "Faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen," but without spirit, the Illumining Light and Life of substance, there is no real, actualized faith possible and spirit alone is the life essence, the Christ nature, real being, in the soul of things and spirit, alone, makes known all things within soul as mind and will back of it, manifest; until the Divine Spirit has quickened and awakened, resurrected the Christ, the Word, the Truth in each soul, worship unto saving grace, health and salvation is an unaccomplished fact and faith is not possible, neither is realization of substance "hoped for and things not seen," feasible as an actualized sequence. In Christ we accomplish all things, because in Christ we are of the New Creature, creative, within our own soul self; in Christ we heal and uplift, see and prophesy, express innate wisdom and partake of a pre-science precluding error, because, the Spirit of the Father speaks in and through this Christ as the Word of Truth, saving Grace within our own innate being, our soul, or subconscious self. "All to Him I Owe," yea, all to the indwelling perfection made possible by the Holy Ghost as indwelling, guiding, illumining, controlling, speaking Divine Spirit, making manifest the Father's will on earth, as in and of, the New Creature, the Christ Na-

ture within my immortal soul self; so we say in Christ, believing Him actually Omnipresent Spiritual Power, the Healer Divine, a Saviour within ourselves, right here and now. The prototype may be essential and will undoubtedly long remain necessary to many in order to the better see and know the manifest expression of overruling mind, soul and spirit; men and women are so constituted that the form is essential to understanding; yet the worship of the form can never be as "worship in Spirit and Truth," which is in, and back of, all form and not possible of human vision; the unseen is the Spiritual; is the Spiritually discerning; is real and actualized knowing because we know and the only correct understanding in Truth, that Truth which sets us free and makes us partakers of opulence in all that goes for Success, Health and Wealth, as of Faith, the actual and real possession.

We accept Jesus as the prototype of whose excellence we may partake as the antitype. We, like Him, are crucified to the old, that we may take on the new, and partake of the resurrection in the New Creature—the Christ.

WE ARE INDEPENDENT.

In national affairs it's best to have a party ticket and stand by it, otherwise be FREE and VOTE for the BEST AND MOST LIBERAL-MINDED CANDIDATE. We determined eighteen years ago to see the day when we could enter as a wedge in the politics of our native State; we are arriving slowly but surely at the determined goal. We were born in Colorado and propose yet to be an uplifting and regenerating power in its councils; the same Great Spirit that has helped us thus far, shall elevate us to the next position. We have no spleen, but we propose to vindicate some matters of bygone days and shall never lay down our pen until we have WON.

IN SPIRIT AND IN TRUTH, OR THE CHRIST MANIFEST.

To us Christ has ever been, shall ever be and was never not in existence from the foundation, or all beginning of Creation; to us Christ has been made manifest millions of ways, through countless

processes of evolvement; to us many forms are necessitated to make Him, as the Way, the Life, the Truth apparent and actualized Essence in eternal and everlasting touch with all that manifests in any manner Creative Power, fulfilling Life and the all expansive Grace and growth unto final perfection. To us the Man Jesus was but the accepted perfection of the Christ Nature made manifest in perfection of outer form as fleshly vehicle, or body, for the fulfillment of the expected in the final triumphant at-one-ment of the Spiritual within, with the Material without; a perfected form, as a Corporeal Body, could not, the sooner, meet the requirements of time and place and suited environments, hence it was for the Lowly Nazarene as the chosen vehicle, as the perfected Corporeal Body, to embody and make manifest THE WORD which was from the beginning, as the final expression of the Will of the Father in making manifest the saving Grace and Power of the Word of Truth; we believe, for this reason, Jesus became the accepted, as the Word spiritualized, made manifest in the flesh and should be accepted without dispute as the highest and best prototype of Earth Man, as well as God manifest in and through the flesh; He the type we the antitype, in that we can never excel His excellence, even though we may come up to His manifest perfection of all that implies Mortal and Immortal Being, Soul, Spirit and Body, in a perfected Unity. As the most perfected instrumentality of the expression of God with and in man, we feel that Jesus should be accepted: others shall express the like; others have the indwelling saving grace of the Christ, the Word, as made manifest by the indwelling, quickening Spirit of the Father, but the one accepted man shall remain forever the prototype, in spite of any after perfection of the same God-given graces or spiritual attributes, as well as phenomenally perfect outer faculties, expressive of manly perfectness, as to the Physical.

The prototype affords the antitype an opportunity of simulation, yet the one suffices for all after demonstration and in the acceptance of the One Jesus we have all sufficient revelation of what man may become, in expression, may do as to Spiritual Gifts or accomplish as Superman. Virgo responds to Aries, the keenly active and gainful aspects of the intellect and Sagittarius, the energetic, active desire for wealth and emolument, and is forever stickling for technicalities in most every direction possible for mind to bring them to use; lovers of family and family life; great patriots because, too, lovers and defenders of home and native land, in preference to all others; great chemists, naturally born so, are of the tribe of Benjamin, the most beloved of the twelve sons of Jacob; represent the period of time in the year which results in the separation of the grain from the stock and the chaff, and are, in character, naturally prone to separate the flaws from everything and preserve the real grain for future use; love to know and see and feel that there is no possibility of lack; must see wealth or at least sufficiency ahead for the future; desire to pile up substance and wealth for themselves and their children after them; are seldom content with a mere sufficiency, and will worry over trifles regarding the measure of belongings; are extremely exacting, both as to mental ideals and as to personal settlements in matters of commerce or money; must have everything to the last penny or farthing that is their due, sometimes extremely careless about the other fellow getting his final penny, which makes some people dislike to deal with the Virgo personnel, yet this is rather an exception than the general rule; are selfish regarding own children; when step-mothers or step-fathers, will slight the step-child to favor the child of their own flesh and blood; this nativity persists in the continuance of mental activity and power; in the furtherance and continuance of the race must see security as a realizable fact or

else cannot be content; never can feel assured or rest easy if the slightest doubt exists as to future welfare or well-being; are natural scientists rather than Altruists, as the solid, secure, material manifest presence of things are preferred before anything favoring faith and confidence; yet when Mystics or Occults are usually great in inspirational and prescience or foreseeing or prophetic as well as healing powers, and make adepts in the higher sciences; are artistic, very precise, quick to see and quick to act; make fine heads of schools, medical institutions, government offices or mints, postoffices, or in departmental service; are great in newspaper work, rapid and exact; good stenographers; fine with pen or in mathematics; good book-keepers; the women are the finest needle workers and seamstresses to be found, and among the neatest and most exacting housekeepers; the nature is to enjoy life while at the sametime keeping everything together and under absolute thrifty movement for the gathering of greater abundance; this nature loves to tease and tantalize and often is vindictive when angered, while at other times easily appeased and forgiving; it's a good, all-around, stiff-backed peculiar type of people, yet vigilant, energetic, saving, ambitious and hard working, no matter where employed, how engaged or what engaged in.

The sign is in the bowels, and gives a tendency to liver, stomach and bowel diseases and their effects; often suffers with rheumatism and neuralgia as well as head-aches and troubles of a very distressing nature; need plenty of air and sunshine and above all, neat, tidy, comfortable and cheerful surroundings and apartments. William H. Taft, candidate on the Republican ticket for President of the United States, is a very able and representative type of the Virgo stamp of people, and sways, with Virgo characteristic exactness and efficiency, a power over human kind, and has proved the identity of this mentality with Government and National life and the natural tendency to thrift and economy, a marked characteristic of the Virgo nativity.

Among noted men and women of the past born in this sign were the following characters: Count Tolstoi, Oliver Wendell Holmes, Queen Elizabeth of English fame; St. Augustine, James Watts, John Locke, General Lafayette, Alexander the Great, Fenimore Cooper, Baron Von Humboldt, Louis Kossuth, M. Faraday, and Dr. John Dalton.

Virgo is ruled mostly by Mercury, and is an earth, variable, feminine, barren, maternal and cold and melancholy

sign; rules love, courtship and family, unity or marriage; should marry their direct opposites in nature, and usually do best in marrying those born in one of the water signs, and being inclined to get discouraged, should travel or move about in order to bring about changes of scene and places of dwelling, and must have as a mate some one who can be cheery, bright and never dare to find fault or a flaw; should never marry a Libra, for the reason that Libra is a ruling sign, and is exacting and apt to pick Virgo natures to pieces and is, too, absolutely a detriment for the reason that Virgo, too, must rule or die of discouragement, and discords are very bad for either Virgo or Libra, both being tremendously sensitive and set in ideals and methods.

I wish every one of them had to rise at seven each morning and hustle out to milk a cow or two, feed some chickens and then get their own breakfast and wash the dishes each day for a year; they might, by that means, possibly, become fit subjects for Sex Mates; as it is they are fit for nothing but dime novels, drawing-room silliness and doctor bills and tribulation and disappointment to themselves and the man unfortunate enough to marry them. The whole machinery of society is wrong for the promulgation of vim, worth, vital energy and social good or health.

Luxury is the curse of the young and the right of the old, provided the old know enough to rightly enjoy and util-

ize it. Luxury should never make of the young spungers upon civilization or breed the insanity that precludes all usefulness to mankind by permitting its use for ill and undoing habits; parents so using wealth are sinners, such as the world otherwise fails to furnish, and are twice cursed, in that they misapply an intended blessing and ruin the chances of those intrusted to their care.

Duty to one's self implies duty to society; duty to society necessitates right example, and right example implies right motive and correct and inspiring health habits; it's a duty, an all around duty to self, and to society, at large, to be health. Moral Codes and straight jacket principles do not make for right actions nor improve those for whom they are intended; use but do not abuse all the gifts of Soul, Body and Mind, and you will usually find moral codes superfluous. the final consummation of the fullest and completest unfoldment. Salvation is of the Soul; salvation implies and necessitates a process; salvation is here and now possible or it can never be attained; Soul unfoldment must begin here in this realm of the physical, the season of the seed, the human shell; it cannot begin over there nor under there, nor in "the sweet bye and bye." The Soul is the fount of Love, Life and Will; in your and my Soul is the "all in all" of all that is; but as there is a generative process, so,

too, is there a regenerative process; the generative is essential to the regenerative, and the one but completes the other.

After all, we are builders, either for immortality, or else underminers of all that is real and true; we are Love, the great Healing, uplifting and expanding fire of the all-good, or else we are the children of a darkness so dense as to rot, forever, the seed of real being; all is but a Healing and overcoming growth process, or else all tends but to disintegration and decay. The breath of Spirit alone, Heals, regenerates, uplifts, and blessed are those Psychics who understanding the use of this blessed Spirit breath, utilize it for the Healing of Souls that Bodies may become Health, Strength and Beauty, the tabernacles of the unfolding, Creative, Immortal Self. A true Psychic thus becomes a Healer Divine.

When you have reached the first heights, stop but for a moment and earnestly and lovingly survey the path behind you; stop but for a moment lest you forget the inspiration of your mood and tarrying lose the splendor of the ideal goal you have set before your mind's eye; there are many more stations along the way; stop but a moment at each; but forget not the goal; pass on and on to still greater heights and nobler achievement while yet the day is yours, for the night of transition is coming on with swift and steady surety, and you must press on. •

The Occidental Mystic and Occult, Denver, Colorado.

To the Editor:

I have attended many seances during the past twenty years; I have seen tables dance and chairs move about the room; I have seen flowers materialized and flowers taken from vases and placed in the lap of a person in an opposite part of the room; I have felt touches and cold breezes of air pass over me; in fact all manner of phenomena. Can you tell me in what way these phenomena are produced, or through what agency?

Your question involves so much as to make it an almost impossible task to answer it as you would require. We have the law of physics as the basic one; another law of dynamics, and that of personal electrocism, sometimes termed magnetism; we have, too, the philosophy of magic, material magic, as well as the influences of demoniac, or earth-bound spirits to contemplate.

Another important feature is the contact with first-class prestidigitation, or legerdemain, which will come nearer answering eight-tenths of the phenomena productions you have been able to witness.

As a Psychic with a reputation for strictest verity and trusted as an Occult of the White Magic School, I, as this editor, would not care to go beyond my own verifications in any statement regarding such phenomena as you have referred to in your question. It has perplexed the best psychic research, while we of the experienced stamp have our own fixed opinion as to the real means of production of, at least, the greater proportion of it, and would far rather go and see the reality of legerdemain as performed by such noted performers as Herman the Great. We can state, however, that evil characters having once inhabited a house, a room or other premises, are enabled to create chaotic conditions and raise havoc with such apartments, long after they have departed this life, as we have personally proved by our own experience in our work as mystic, psychic or occult. In these latter cases the disturbances come without any warning or

previous invitation or preparation; and are dismissed only by a power superior lying with a skilled and gifted occult; they must be driven out, overcome in the same manner as we would drive out disease or any physical chaotic condition. We deem it strange that darkened apartments should always be required for the production of most of the strange phenomena your question brings up, and we cannot understand why any spirit should require darkness any more than any person would require it to perform an honorable and righteous act; spirits of darkness, however, seek darkness, the same as a born thief prefers the night season for his magical operations. There is a vital difference between spiritual manifestations and spirit phenomena, and you must learn to distinguish between spiritualism and spiritism; prestidigitators and true psychics, or high class spiritual mediums; in Denver are a hundred, perhaps, of practitioners, of which fifteen may sum up the good, while the other eighty-five represent the spiritists and prestidigitators.

As to table-tipping, that is common electrical or magnetic force, or energy, as set at work by the persons sitting about the table. You can easily prove this. Take a good, sound, medium-weight table; sit down and place your hands upon it; if too heavy, you fail to phase it; get another to sit with you, placing fingers and thumbs together so as to make a circuit; still it refuses to move; get two or three more, and again form the circuit by the above method, and the table begins to operate and becomes capable of tipping in accordance with the will of any one sitter at a time. You say, "Tip towards Jack;" it does so; "Tip towards John;" it obeys; no spirit is present beyond the spirits in the bodies of those sitting. But a rap comes, suddenly, while you are sitting near a table; there you have entirely another type of phenomena; or something brushes by you, when you are thinking nothing of such a possibility; this latter, usually, indicates the presence of some far-distant or near-distant person, just passing out of earth life, and at that moment casting a last thought to you, presents the thought, per a thought, or astral body, per a psychic process, to you and there you come under the higher law, that of spiritual and mental as well as soul manifestation; again you enter a room; a something like a presence, tangible yet not tangible, seems near you; this, too, involves the genuine spiritual; you visit a true psychic, illumined of the Holy Spirit; you sit for advice; per his spiritual illumination he reveals your future correct moves as read from the tablet of your own soul, for the soul knows; this latter is psychic power, that of Soul Sight, or Spirit Illumination.

The true Psychic reads the SOUL by the LIGHT OF SPIRIT UNIVERSAL, and needs no other. Hears by the voice of the same spirit and knows.

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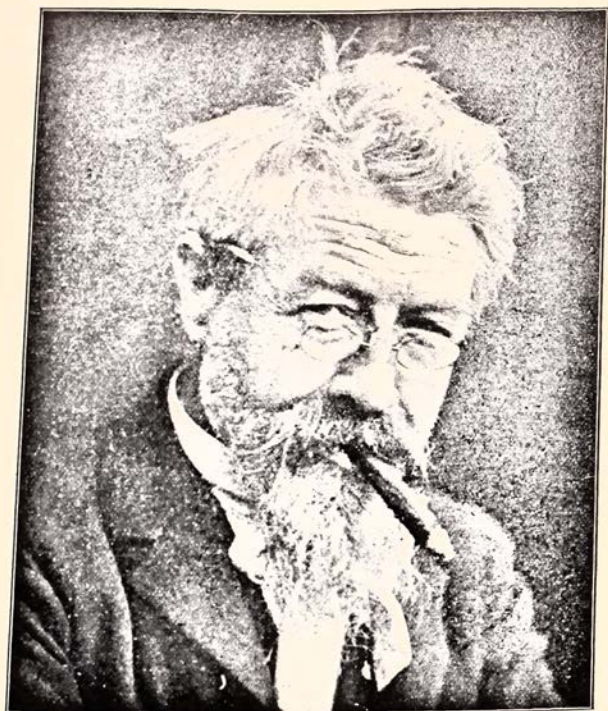
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
