EDITORIAL.

THE AMERICAN NATION-MUST ENFORCE LAW.

In the annals of history there have been many magnificent manifestations of the power of man as made apparent to the world's populace, in the shape of great Empires and the Institutional, in the shape of Government. The steady move out from the despotic forms of Empire up towards that of the Democratic administration of the Institutional as a governing organization, has consumed almost three great Cycles of time and caused the overthrow of hundreds of, at the time, seeming imperishable and unconquerable Governmental Fabrics. The Ancient Dynasties of the Medes and Persians, the magnificent Assyrian Power, the mighty Egyptian control of more than Thirty-two Centuries, the Classic Rule of the Greek, the All-Conquering Thirteen Centuries of Roman Cæsarship, all, all have proved the powers of man to rise, to glory, that the ever-destroying Canker of time may bring these same powers, as 'twere a man's career, back to earth again, there to become, once more, the ashes from which all glory and greatness, originally, sprang. The Modern world looks back through all these demonstrations of man's inability to govern himself and wonders if it, too, must rise but to sink, once again, into final nothingness, the result of man's foolishness, selfishness and incapability to glean from the lessons of the past, that which shall prove his saving plank when the tempest's fierce winds shall blow, and the floods descend and the billows froth

with the anger of demondom turned loose, as, if it were, to wreck our ships of state.

The Dynasties of the far East, we fear, are about to arise, and, casting off the chains of long Centuries of slumbering inertness, spring into the ranks of contending forces for the world's substance; yet, why should we, of this great . free Institutional Government of the United States, dread, or stop to fear, rising Intelligence or any people's awakening spirit of Independent exertion in, and for, their own behalf? Is it not one of the Signs of an awakening to greater industrial worth and thrift at home and, thereby, the possible relieving of the world's apparent congestion in the overproduction of marketable material, the measured resourcefulness of given communities of interest, as well as the measure of greatness in the conquest of the Intelligence, rightly underworld? stood, begets freedom, which, in turn, increases usefulness and also consuming power; it also creates additional avenues of useful exchange, thereby increasing the world's marts of trade; it casts off the uselessness of poverty and despotism; thereby decreasing pauperism and inability to enjoy, or even purchase, that which begets enjoyment of earth's productions; it reveals individual ambitions without which no people or combination of peoples can, possibly, long continue to thrive; it springs into action the genius of the Soul; begets independence, in the mental realms; necessitates superior creative faculties and their active employment, and makes of

the world, as it should be, one great busy commercial house on the one hand and a hive of industrial superiority on the other.; it makes peoples more equal of mind, impulse and producing and consuming ability, hence, of greater worth to all mankind under the great lawthat of mutual interests depending upon the marts of the world as a means of exchange. If, in the awakening, wars will at first spring up thick and fast, that, too, can be but for the final triumph of genius, the turning of earth's kingdoms into more congenial hospitalities and the cleansing of the streams of the Institutional, political, economic and ethical, in order that, for a season, rising generations may the better promulgate the aspirations of industry, thrift and peace. War is one of the eternal necessities of Creation; Institutions, like Nature, must have their Earthquakes; their fierce raging storms; their roaring, alldestroying waters, that later the atmosphere and earth surface may the better suit the needs and requirements of that which, the upheaval and storms, have left to enjoy the peace and good of the after-calm. War has been and will continue to be, the only safety valve of the world; for man shall, we fear, never learn that over-congestion will force the stays of patience, endurance and good humor, until the bursting of the bands thereof endangers the state. War with a foreign people saves revolution, oh so often, among ourselves. The American Nation stands, today, the best type of the Institutional, in so far as governmental control of ourselves as the free wills making the governing will supreme, is concerned; it embodies all that any Centralized all-powerful will dare to permit, in the shape of the free action of the individual wills, which, as differentiated wills, assent to, as the sum total of their individual wills, made manifest for the greatest good to the greatest number, under the powers of the Institutional, in the shape of the Government. Too great a license in so-called liberty in the individual often means de-

struction of the safety of himself and all members of the Institutional of which he is a factor; liberty can not. and MUST NOT, mean LICENSE TO DO THAT WHICH UNDOES THE GOOD OF THE WHOLE. A Government, like a Universe, is made up of mutual alliances and interests, and the human factors thereof, MUST OBEY the decrees, as made clear, by the Supreme Will of the Institution, regardless of personal or individual ideals, isms, or aspirations. Anarchy IS never JUST-ICE NOR RIGHTEOUSNESS, in anything nor anywhere; neither is the throttling of the avenues of industry, of trade, or the means of a people's exchange JUST OR RIGHT. The greatest GOOD to the greatest NUMBER, means the promulgation of ALL that UPLIFTS the masses as against the classes, and it means, too, the rightful enjoyment of Governmental privilege to that extent necessary to man's higher good in all that preserves his manhood. These United States form the most perfected system of Government, as yet devised by the minds of men; yet, with all our blessed privileges; our freedom and liberty; our power to go forth and DO and BE what every man should be, worth and thrift, we find the mistakes of other great powers are striving to gain possession of our resources and bring to bear the same serpentine tactics-luxury and decay-that has caused countless Empires to sink into lasting decay; not this alone, but a set of minds, individualized ideals, are springing up, like weeds in a thrifty garden spot, as discontents where discontent with things that be, is silly and inopportune and absolutely uncalled for, as well as ungenerous and unjust; the American people must preserve, at all cost, the fabric of Government, as it now stands, or else run the risk of sinking from Freedom's lofty heights back into Depotism's iron The Trusts have already met hands. their Body Blow, at the hands of a brave Executive; but there is still a monster stalking abroad, of another stripe and kind; a venomous thing which neither spins nor labors, lest it be to destructive ends and means; this, too, must receive its Body Blow, ere safety is assured at home and all Conquering Victory over foes abroad; this latter monster is of the type that sees neither good nor stability in any form of Government; has no home under any flag; lives upon the ill it can do and fattens upon the blood of patriots; its doom must be sounded, be it now or in after generations, for to the thrifty, the patient, the long-suffering, the laborers for the right, belong the spoils; the drones, be they rich men's sons violating our laws by murder and debauchery, or the Anarchistic followers of the dictum: no law, no Government, no nothing but sloth; all is the same, no matter from which source comes the violation of our only guarantee of safety-the law of our American Nation.

Murder of a Ruler is of no greater damage than murder of an individual by a fool, who, in his cowardice, sneaks up and shoots his victim. Insanity should have no bearing in either case; a violation of the law is a VIOLATION of SOCIETY'S DECREED RIGHT TO PROTECT ITSELF AND ITS INSTITUTIONS, and MURDER, under any kind of CIRCUM-STANCES, is a form of ANARCHY which MUST BE STOPPED by PUN-ISHMENT, regardless of the provocation and regardless of MONEY, or IG-NORANCE, or TEMPER, OR ANY HATCHED-OUT PLEA OF INSAN-ITY; we can all get INSANE if there is to be such an excuse permitted; NO, SPIRIT AND CARRY OUT THE THE LETTER \mathbf{OF} THE LAW; AWAY WITH YOUR SICKENING SYMPATHY. Law has been outraged, let the PENALTY be EXACTED; stamp out Anarchy in all its phases NOW, and forever live to thank God the law was made to be respected.

The American Nation's future demands this, and its destiny hinges much upon the absolute refusal to permit any one to violate its Laws. We are Free, yet crime is rampant. We are just, then

let us have justice. The murdered dead are mute, but their Spirits live to curse.

ORIGINAL UNDERLYING CAUSE.

Many able writers are ignoring the importance of Original, Underlying Cause; they seem to teach that the mere Objective Mind must order the Subjective Mind to produce anything we may desire, regardless of whether it is to our good, or whether the Spirit that illumines the Subconscious sees fit to permit it or not; they seem to forget that this leaves man as weak and as bad off as ever, in that it's the short-sightedness and narrow view of things, from a physical standpoint, that causes us to fall into error, and of necessity, it must be the Consciousness of the Superior, made manifest by the Omnipresence of the Divine Spirit, as backed by Superior Intelligence and Divine Mind and Will, and Love, that enables us, per unfoldment and Soul Attainment, to correct the crrors of the Objective; according to these theorists, we are to attract everything we desire to us from our own choice, mentally, from without, instead of looking within ourselves and permitting the Higher Spiritual to render unto us what is best, regardless of our own outer and, necessarily, limited view of things; according to this there can be no reason in Soul Unfoldment nor any excuse for seeking after that Wisdom from within which guarantees perfection in the without; we, in our experiences, have discovered that it's our duty to seek first, Wisdom from within, in order that knowledge, that which belongs to the Objective Mind and is of the Physical, alone, may be properly illumined from within, so as to permit of the exercise of Genius, in the shape of creative thought, the real power of the Higher Selfhood and, thereby, expect Spiritual Forces to back up Objective Knowledge with that which, being revealed direct from the Great First Cause through the Spirit of Truth, shall make of man a creative Being and bring to bear, for his benefit, the mighty forces of the Universe to aid him in the accomplishing of desired and desirable,

Love of power and lust for control, politically, is their sole ambition; elect no man not a proved and well-known, full-fledged, dyed-in-the-wool Patriot; we can afford no possibilities; we must have men at the head of this great Government, especially during the perilous times threatening the entire world, during the coming years, up to and including 1917. There are too many people who do not understand Freedom's grave DUTIES; who seem to think LIBERTY is NEVER broad enough: who FEEL as if GOVERNMENT should be so regulated as to MAKE THEM OR UN-MAKE THEM as INDIVIDUALS. who erv down everything and everybody who happens to represent LAW and and SOCIETY'S ORDER PEC-TECTIVE CREW, and it is this large and GROWING dangerous Element in our Country that threatens its welfare. The Slums of our CITIES are getting to be a most DANGEROUS element in AMERICAN POLITICS: not because they are so bad innately, nor that they have not elements of good in them, but because they flock together-a band of discontents-either against all LAW and its Energetic Forces, as administered, or else because they are for sale to the highest bidder, regardless of the character of the Bidder.

OUR OBJECT.

THE SUPERIOR MAN.

"To quaff the inner life is to see the outer life. To live in defiance of time is to live in the whole." He who discovers the Spirit of ALL LIFE as in, and of himself, vivifies the body and quickens the senses; for there is that passing within and expressing of the Soul superior to all that constitutes the fullness in expression of the powers of Nature, through which man succeeds in surpassing and overcoming the systems and powers of the elementaries producing chaos in Nature.

All true Psychic Healers, while Healing the Body, must Heal, too, the Soul; the process involves both, and there can be no other true Healing, hence such Healers are termed sacred Revealers of Spiritual Health in the ALL GOOD.

In cases of Nasal Catarrh, empty the Lungs by exhaling, then inhale till well filled; placing the tips of thumb and first finger in Nostrils so as to close them nicely, exhale slowly, but forcibly enough to cause the warm, moist air to force itself out around the thumb and finger, as placed in the Nostrils; this causes the air to be forced back up into the Nerve Cavities at the root of the nose; continue this once or twice daily, say for five minutes at each attempt and the first thing you know your head will be cleared up and a cure of this disagreeable complaint is under way; after

you have continued this 'till head is clear, place the fore finger in the right nostril, then inhale, slowly, easily, till you can count eight or nine, then remove the finger and place in the left nostril and exhale, slowly; then leaving the finger in left nostril, as placed while exhaling, inhale, as formerly, and removing finger and placing again in the right nostril, exhale; continue this process for three to five minutes, once daily, after the first exercise has first cleared the head, and you need not fear Catarrh; it will finally leave you for all time. We paid \$5 for the above and healed our own case-a very stubborn one-in les than three months.

Do not forget to think while eating so your food produces effects. Eat, thinking of the food being eaten as for Body Building; eat, then, to a purpose. It will soon pay a big dividend on the time given to correct thinking habits at the table.

OUR METHOD.

SIXTH LESSON-IN CHARACTER, AM I DEAD, OR ELSE IMMORTAL?

The Forty-two Faculties referred to are as follows, to-wit: Amativeness. Conjugality, Parental Love, Friendship, Inhabitiveness, Continuity, Vitativeness, Destructiveness, Combativeness, Acquisitiveness, Alimentiveness, Secretiveness, Cautious-Approbativeness, Self-Esteem. ness. Firmness, Conscientiousness, Hope, Spirituality, Veneration, Benevolence, Constructiveness, Ideality, Sublimity, Imitation, Mirthfulness, Individuality, Form, Size, Weight, Color, Order, Number, Locality, Eventuality, Time, Language, Tune, Casuality, Comparison, Human Nature, and Suavity.

According to Mr. Vaught, these Facnities may be Positive, Neutral or Negative in expression, and as we group them they may be Large, Medium and Small in expressive manifestation or be entirely inexpressive under certain conditions of abnormal development of some at the expense of others, or through Circumstances forcing them into negative or neutral expression.




