### THE RELIGION OF THE SOUL; OR THE SUPERSENUOUS FACTOR OR NATURE.

After Notes on a Lecture by Prof. F. D. Hines at Upper Howe Hall, Sunday, March 1, 1908, 3 p. m.

All Altruists and Mystics, including Plotinus, Plato, Schilling, Boehme, even down through Emerson to our own day. have found in man a Supersenuous Factor, or Nature, through which-per the Law of Like alone being able to discern Like-we, through the Divine Nature, Faculties and Attributes indwelling us, know God. It is that something deeper and beyond Science; that Intuition or Insight which beholds and knows God through His Nature in us, discerning itself through Spirit Divine, interpreting Spiritual Essence in Being. alone can discern and know Spirit or Spiritual Wisdom, Schilling says: "There is a capacity of knowledge above or behind Consciousness and higher than the understanding, and that this knowledge is competent to human Reason, because this Reason itself is identical with the Absolute. In this act of knowledge. which he calls Intellectual Intuition (as distinguished from the Intuitions of Sense), there exists no distinction of Subject and Object, no contrast of knowledge with existence; all difference is lost in mere indifference, all plurality in simple Unity. The Absolute is identical with the Reason that apprehends it. Because man is himself a manifestation of the Absolute he can know the source and essence of his Being only by falling back behind the limits and conditions of his phenomenal existence, and knowing himself as he really is,"-as of God, His Essence, in Mind, Soul and Spirit a manifestation, here and now, in this Sphere. He further asserts, "All things are God; in Him we live, move and have our Being." Of course the act is ineffable, it is the Vision and Faculty Divine. He who is incapable of it is incompetent for Philosophy. This is what Cousin means by his dostrine of the Impersonality of Reason. "That by which

I apprehend the Truth," he says, "is not MY REASON, nor YOUR REASON, but REASON itself, as such, or in abstract; also the TRUTH ITSELF THUS KNOWN, IS NOT MY TRUTH, YOUR TRUTH. ORBUT TRUTH AS SUCH. ABSOLUTE, THE IDENTICAL WITH THE FACULTY WHICH APPREHENDS IT." By this Process we do not do our own thinking. Thought is from the very depths of the Supersensuous, springs into expression from our very Soul Center of Being, is a Creative Self-Emanating Processabove, over, beyond, in and through that which is greater than our own Mental Objectivity. All our thinking becomes at-one-ment then, with All Knowledge and Wisdom; is of the Soul, over which we have little or no control. It is Revelation; it is Abstract Truth; it is Reality expressed and apprehended as of the Absolute.

Once we have evolved so as to attain to the Wisdom that is from this Supersenuous realm of the Soul, our thoughts partake of the nature from which they spring—that of God, or the Absolute; they partake of spontaneity, of Intuitiveness or Insight. We are the children of an Heavenly Wisdom; we need no longer attempt to direct our Mentality per Objective Process of Reason to determine our Spiritual or Natural Correspondences; there is an influx of verv Being-continuous righteousness descending from the very Promogenial Body, as of His Essense permeating, illumining and clarifying, as well as reinstating per continuous process, our entire inner and outer Being; the perceiving, knowing and realizing, as well as the revealing of Truth and hence the interpretation of Truth, and, as Emerson relates: "We must not tamper with the organic motion of the Soul." But we must use, utilize and obey the Truth would we derive constant benefit and accept the fruitions of the thoughts, revelations and creations as received per the Supersensitive Nature through the Motions of the Soul. Thought is motive proceeding as Motion, Design or Cause shaping into forms, things, or ends, to meet the exigencies of our existence and the necessities of Immortality. The Religion of the Soul, recognizes the necessity of our Intuitions rising as thoughts uttered that action may express in character our Spiritual Nature, not for private good alone, but for the good of all.

We must so attain as to listen, become able to be still and hear the Silent Voice of the Divine Spirit within each of our own Souls, as of ourselves a distinct intuitive revelation, for to worship God. He being Spirit "we must worship Him Spirit and in Truth," meaning through the processes guaranteed of His own Nature as of and within our own Being. "For so to be is the sole inlet of so to know." All Mystics practice sitting alone and listening that they may hear His Voice as if from within the precincts of the Soul, not for the purpose of forcing revelation, but for the most high moral good that they-wemay become beneficiaries of as an elevating ethercalizing, healing and uplifting, as well as Spiritualizing, process; the after benefits of which may be not to the sitter alone, but to all mankind as factors of the One Great Over-Soul. The Spanish Mystic, St. Theresa, says: "We ought to sit alone and wait for God to come to us, in no wise dictating the method of His coming." In the same Spirit, Eckhart declares that "He that is at all times alone is worthy of God." We must not assume an egotistical or allknowing or superior air; we must judge of what we receive and test our Intuitions; action, character and results alone determine the source of our Intuitive knowledge and from whence springs our Inspirations; we can interpose no selfish motives, science nor interpretations; we must ask no questions for personal aggrandizement or gain; we must prepare to obey and carry into action the decrees

as given per the Silent Voice of the Soul; we can hear the speaker but can never behold His Face; for Truth comes as it listeth, to whom it listeth and when and where it listeth, from whence, no man may ask or definitely presume to say, beyond the fact of the indwelling of the Spirit of the Absolute, as of God, permitted, to make Him and His Attributes manifest to, in and through our Soul Selves as Essence, in Being a Factor of Him. Eckhart says "that God has the substance of all creatures in Himself;" "that He is a Being who has all Being in Himself," thus making a fundamental postulate for all transcendentalism and Mysticism, "that all things are in God and all things are God," we add, in manifestation and expressiveness only, in so far as partaking of His Indwelling Spiritual Attributes as the Illumination of the Inner, or Soul Self, as we do not accept the postulate that "all things are God," believing facts contradict such a view of the perfection of forms, things and human Beings, would be highly presumptuous and very misleading.

The Soul Religion holds that God is the life, the Cause of all that is; that His Spirit indwells and makes manifest His Nature, in the shape of a saving Nature, the Christ Consciousness; but we must be regenerated of His Spirit, made alive, born again into a Spiritual Kingdom, through a Spiritual awakening of the Soul and until that rebirth has taken place we are not in touch with the Nature which is of Him and hence cannot partake of all that the Supersensuous reveals as Truth in and through us; for Truth, Abstract Truth, is of the One Source of Being and is not otherwise possible of expression, lest it be through its own Source, Essence or Nature.

#### OUR METHOD.

#### SEVENTH LESSON.

Spiritual Creative qualities and Mental Faculties, rightly in universal at-onement and at unity with each other in the completed Man, constitute the rightful expression of the Divine, in and through the Human.

In last Month's Lesson we named the Forty-two Faculties which made expressive the general trend and tone of human character and laid the foundation for their grouping so as to the better clear the method of their final development for the expression of innate Genius, creative thought, purpose and power. As WILL constitutes the MO-TIVE POWER OF MIND, we shall prefer to give it our first consideration. Without Will to do or to undertake, or to pursue, or to continue any given course or in any undertaking, the Mind is utterly listless and void of all motive power; the Will of the Creator, alone, made possible a Universe and its after-continuous perfection, in growth, harmony and continuity; God WILLED and it WAS, IS, and shall continue to BE as WILLED. The FIAT was the result THOUGHT, the creation of Supreme Mind, but until WILL came forth, power to make manifest the Creative Thought could not and did not exist. So with man, he, too, has within him a Superior Mind, continuous in the outer form, as Objective Mind, yet of the ONE SU-PREME MIND A FACTOR; but unless this Being, Man, too, in conformity to, and with, the Divine, has a cultivated, continuous, undeviating Force, an emanation, and as power of Mind made effective in all undertakings, desires, words, thoughts or deeds, as WILL, in the shape of WILL EN-ERGY, he accomplishes little or nothing. The WILL, then, becomes of first importance in the teaching of that which embraces the intricacies of Superior Manhood or Womanhood. stubborn relentlessness of Will is not at all what Will Energy signifies; we may have an iron Will, an unbending, set, determined Will, yet fail, because of pure stubbornness. Mulishness is not proper nor best in anything nor on any line of thought or action. There is a vital difference, then, between Stubborn Will and WILL ENERGY: between stand still or dead Power and Vitalized, Active, Propelling Force as Life of Power; don't fail to grasp this important difference, for one phase is nothingness while the other is a continuous process of growth, through Will Energy, rightly channeled and at work, always so and at all times. The WILL of man, to be as it should be, must be in conformity to and with THE DIVINE WILL. This is the real secret of the continuity of Purpose as in exact conformity to, and with the ALL-GOOD of the One Eternal Whole, and constitutes the final triumph of the Superior Man over the weaker, as well as over all circumstances or environment. #### NOTES.

We blame everything to law, but it's not law that fails; it's lack of understanding and opportunity. The Laws of Life, Love, all Biological and Natural Laws, as well, are continuous, but to gain fullest advantage of their modes of operation we, as the operators, must get in position to enjoy that which is within the province of law.

The Law of Continuity involves the One GREAT LAW—that of LOVE—without which the Universe would be a nonentity; LOVE comprehends and involves Continuity, hence the Law of Continuity is the Law of LOVE. Man forgetting, or rather refusing, to be subject to the action of the Law of Love, sinks into disrespect for all Law, because without Love no man grows or thrives lest it be for SELF and SELF-ISH ENDS.

St. Paul put it this way, "it is no use to kick against the pricks;" he meant it's useless to place ourselves without the pale of law or natural consequential results, as from, or of, law. Growth is the law of Life, Love and Health; expeet to grow; expect to grow unto perfection; expect healthy growth. It's your natural right, you need not refuse to place yourself in shape to receive all that law sets in regular motion for your best good. Worry is not growth, neither is fear, fretting, jealousy, envy or hate; the law is growth, hence in order to gain your highest estate and keep it, cast out all that contraries the laws of your welldoing or well-being.

Have you ever read the child's book entitled "The Chance World?" It describes a world in which everything happened by chance. "The sun might rise, or it might not; or it might appear at any hour, or the moon might come up instead; when children were born they might have a dozen heads or one, and those heads might not be on their shoulders—there might be no shoulders—but arranged about the limbs. If one jumped up in the air it was impossible to predict whether he would ever come down again. That he came down yesterday was no guarantee that he would

come down next time. For every day antecedent and consequent varied, and gravitation and everything else changed from hour to hour. Today a child's body might be so light it was impossible for it to descend from its chair to the floor; but tomorrow, in attempting the experiment again, the impetus might drive it through a three-story house and dash it to pieces somewhere near the center of the earth." In the chance world cause and effect were abolished. Law was annihilated. In such a world reason would be impossible, it would be a lunatic world.

What is a pin-headed fanatic? Ask Job's spirit; he had full experience in that line, with those endeavoring to console his misfortunes and run his Soul's salvation.

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


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
