There is not a heart that ever beat but what in some way or by some process, has worked some measure of good to some striving, suffering one; even the bandit has his fullness of heart and his kindliness in action, that causes some one's burdens to lighten beneath his spirit's favor.

There is no spot, no being, no portion of the great family of earth's children but what there is some life working out the good necessary to the final triumph of Spirit of Christ over the spirit of destruction; no life is possible without some kindly act and none are so evil but contain some spark of the Spirit of the All Good; the world, at large. may not see it or ever hear of it; but the soul of a Universe contains, within its mighty folds, the very souls of all its possible factors and the Great Spirit indwelling the Great Soul must, to some extent, leaven even the most sordid of its individualized factors.

Down in the depths of every being is a still, silent temple fitted for the entrance of Divinity: the doors may be hung on rusted and creaking hinges; the locks may be keyless, the doors themselves of material bordering on decay; but even there, the Light of Spirit penetrates, at times, and God's Great Over Love, breaking the gloom, brings to the outer man a moment's reflection of the All Good; judge not too harshly; we little know what that poorly expressive human heart or tabernacle of the soul, may bear beneath the rough exterior; there may be an Angel slumbering there. Not sanctimoniousness but goodness: not moral thou shalts and thou shalt nots, but fullness of rippling, laughing, healing Spirit marks the Godly and full life. No man leaves a greater legacy to mankind than work well done, life well lived, love and kindness well scattered and honesty and honor in fullness of conception, and expression and nobleness, in acceptance of the Divine Spirit in action.

#### A CONJECTURE.

We are living; we are striving for heights hitherto unattained; we are the same restless beings seeking place and power that the generations before us were. Times may change the aspect of aspirations and ambition's goads and spurs; but the human mind and spirit still relishes conquest. If it be not a conquest in view with some earth power then man turns to the clouds, the sun and planets and stars, the air in order to find vent for his thirst for that which remains yet unconquered. But the problem of the Ego in all its inner and outer manifestations, assumes a far more stupendous roll and we conjecture that this man's final grand conquest, that of the Self, will complete the Circle of present racial Cycles and then, poor man, with nothing more left to fight over and to conquer, with nothing new to grapple with, will silently slink away, become partially extinct, and leaving but the merest pair or two of his kind to begin it all over again, will have completed human destiny.

This is but a conjecture, while it has, too, the feasibility and plausibility of analogy. Nature produces species, but to replenish them with others or continue them in cycles, as to years, or their better, per cultivation, as to varieties and textures and kind. Continents rise from the bowels of the earth, hold back the ocean and the encroachments of air. fire and water, as to elementaries and, finally, submit to being submerged, or cast under, while other continents rise to take their place; even the planetary conditions admit of and submit to, changing polarity and atmospheric variations, so much so as to make of the surfaces thereof very uncertain conditions as to tropical or frigid zones, some times for hundreds of years at a stretch as to time; this is evidenced by the revelations of the fossil and rocks of the earth, and most especially, as revealed by the geology of the earth. It is scarcely probable that man can set aside Nature or overcome the swinging fore and back of the great pendulum of eternal action, counteraction and interaction. There is somewhere and always, a final height or destination for and to, everything and all progress; where or when is the conjecture. We have certainly, now and here, entered a most rapid and progressive age in our present racial development and unfoldment which shall reveal either a possibility of final fulfillment of our racial destiny, as to earth conquests, or the setting back, per some mighty revolutionary reactionary principle of ourselves, in this onward, forward and upward progress of human genius.
