

Everything grows in might and strength even as it is fostered, eared for and nurtured; as it is with all Nature's herbage and fruitage; with strength and might of health of mind and body and soul, even so is it with the evil of life; encourage anger, scolding, fretting,

You will get what you expect when von come to our Circles; your knows; we are simply enabled to interpret its symbols and intelligences, and an interpreter is your need and usually your most essential requisite: Spirit is our Gift and Spirit reveals, and our Circles are a SUCCESS to people who really come expecting to get what they If you go come after-information. to a bank with a check, what do you go for? Suppose you expected nothing and by chance you got more than you expected? Would you give credit to the bank or the Agency through which the bank blessed you? You never think to thank the Spirit which Reveals to your good, and usually you sneak off and lie about the way you get your information that saves you.

There is but one Law, Sumptuary, if it might be so termed, that we heartily favor; it is a law making Marriage impossible under the age of twenty to any one on earth; some may question this, but every grown woman of ripe years with whom we have conversed, with but very few happy exceptions, bemoans having lost her girlhood and withered her life by too early maternal cares having been assumed. Any sensible man would not ask a girl of Fifteen or even up to Eighteen, to grow old for his mere pleasure and gratification; such marriages are rarely anything but merest false ideas of real Life and its higher duties. The Spiritual Union is impossible, lest in very rare instances under Twenty-six years of age. The place to cut out bad marriages is right where we mark it in this little statement. Girls and boys should not assume the responsibilities of fatherhood and motherhood; we grow old too rapidly as it is.

The recent agitation in Denver in regard to Speeding by Autoists and Motor Cyclists, did a world of good in one direction, but it also brought to light some of the smallest, most contemptible specimens of human kind the world can possibly afford: we were out on three different occasions with one of the most careful, genteel and gentlemanly Auto manipulators any city might wish to see; not a trip was taken but what some specimen of the genuine FOOL deliberately, maliciously, purposely, cut away from the regular street crossing and, like a cur and coward, walked leisurely across the path of the automobile, seemingly striving to deliberately get in the way; we grew disgusted and. at last, told the GENTLEMAN in charge of the machine just to graze one of those Hyenas and if they wanted to carry it to the Courts we would stand pat until H-l froze over. Injustice is one of the despisable traits of a fair share of the low, vulgar type of so-called human beings.

A Medium means a person standing between two spheres of action; able to receive, transmit and give forth from one sphere of activity or condition on through to another. Mediums may be of a high or a low order; the same process involves divers methods and modes; no one person can be the sum total of all manifestation or the infinite variety of intelligences desiring to express through Mediumship their wishes, desires and influences for good or for ill; thus some may express as of the ill, others of the mixed type of good and ill, while others bring to pass the ideal, the best and highest from Celestial Spheres; all depends upon the Wisdom, Integrity and Purpose of the Means of Communication. To condemn Truth and ALL Mediumship, indiscriminately, because many are seemingly Fakes or the victims of earth bound evil conditions, is like condemning the ALL GOOD because much evil exists in the same sphere of expression. There are good and there are bad Mediums; and there are good and there are very bad Psychics. All that is good has its imitators and imposters. It's so of Religion, of Government Service, in fact, of every vocation, calling or profession; none can claim exemption from this law.

We sat in a court of justice some time ago; by some hook or crook what purported to be three questions, touching upon one of the parties to the case, as asked of us in writing and answered in writing, was part of the testimony offered; the judge rather sneeringly said: "Oh, I don't believe we will go into this clairvoyance; it's all a sham;" he knew not what he was doing. As it happened we were friends of both parties in the matter and had done work for both and had saved both as no other Power could have protected them; there was clairvoyance in it either. mighty strange that every case we have had to do with comes out right and just right, in the end, for the best good of all concerned. When Thaw was being tried we held for seven jurors to decide against him; we said if freed he would kill his wife; we said time would prove this by her own statement; it has so proved. When Cradlebaugh was in jail, shortly after the tragedy, before the trial more than five weeks, we wrote a poem, in which we said he would win out through pity and go free at the hands of the jury, but the ghost of his victim would refuse to down; that poem was published in the February magazine and he was freed the last of March; he is reported dying of remorse; this was not clairvoyance; it was TRUTH revealed as prophecy.

In the famous Captain Haines case we were strictly prophetic in every detail, even to the fact of the brother's final collapse and refusal of publishers to take his work. Occultism is a fact, and Truth and Revealed Knowing is also a fact, while Clairvoyance has nothing to do with this ALL POWERFUL PHASE OF DIVINITY INDWELLING THE SOULS OF MEN.

Prove my metal and then I am somewhat prepared for what may yet beset my way; the Spirit tries the hearts and minds and souls of men in order to prove their metal and prepare each one for the triumph that assures the fulfillment of highest aspiration and keenest enjoyment. Put not thyself to bed upon the first approach of sickness, and thrice blessed are the chances for your early recovery; who succumbs to the first ill seldom lives to tackle a greater one. The real warrior is the fearless one, while, too, unflinching to pain, he faces the enemy's ranks; through shine or storm, up hill or down hill he pursues the foe, a better warrior for having the troubles along the way. Fortitude has won many a life success, where fear, impatience and succumbing to storm or shadow, has filled a fresh made grave with the remains of a failure. "Jesus Wept" and seldom smiled, yet he knew all was but as it must be, ere he parted the way and turned from trial to heavenly consolation. Many a good cause is injured or defeated by rash and hot headed methods: agitation should conform to brotherly unity and peace begetting Vibrations more and to combative and destructive principles less. Progress is a growth Process, a healing and overcoming of adverse and unreal conditions. Mystic Way is the Right way in all true accomplishment and right attainment. Reason should sit always at the helm of everything we undertake and sound judgment should be the monitor. while Justice and Equity should temporize and harmonize all proceedings involving public or private good. good of the whole should be of far greater importance than the temporary benefit of the class or the mere personal, for on the good of the whole depends, in the end, the final success of the individual. just as the good of the individual aids to bring about the good of the whole. THE TEMPLE OF LIGHT


To Be Erected in Kansas City by the Society for Scientific Revelation.

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

THE CONVENTION.

Casino hall, at Eleventh and Broadway, was beautifully decorated to receive the delegates of the society, which had gathered from all parts of the country. Hon. L. B. Leach of Wamego, one of the

the following address:

"I am not in the habit of speaking in public, and, of course, can not be expected to say very much. There were two things mentioned here that I feel very strongly, and one is that, having been in my younger life associated with the Methodists, and even meeting in their class meetings, I learned to talk quite ably, and to get up and say: 'I feel that I am on the side of the Lord.' (Applause.) And another thing I feel very strongly this afternoon is my ability to rise up and say these things this afternoon and be looked at.

"Now, speaking of spiritualism. I suppose it would be fair to say that I am not what might be denominated as an old-minded spirualist. For a great many years, quite a number, at least twenty, we followed up the investigation of spiritualism by attending seances, when convenient, and reading books on the philosophy of spiritualism. I read the works of the best men in their lines. I didn't adopt any particular or special belief, but when anything was proved to me, no matter where it came from, I called it true, that is, if it appealed to me as such.

'Well, after I had all I wanted of that kind of investigation, I settled back into the belief that there was such a thing, and it was for everyone. I went even farther than that; I believe that there is a life after death and that belief has not been shaken.


"Dr. Carson has spoken to you of his wife that he lived with so many years. I lived with my wife fourteen years, and she was certainly a wonderful person. She had a way of knowing things; was well read and informed, educated, well read in everything; could give thirty-two concise sets of talks on Plato. She understood a great many things that I never could come to any conclusion as to how she knew them. She always had a store of knowledge ready. She was the sort of person that never forgot anything in her life; but she died, and after her death she never appeared to me any more than she appeared in life. She was there then, and always will be. I know she is alive yet, and I believe I will live after this.

"Speaking as to 'where are the dead,' it came into my mind, this little matter. When we were traveling in Constantinople we saw a great many things. It is a great city. It is made up of eight different large cities, and when you get there they are just as separate as can be. When you go from one city to another, you always pass a grave yard. There are a great many more in the grave yards than in this city of Constantinople. Some of Constantinople is in Europe and a part of it is in Asia, and there is a mass of people living miles and miles in every direction, but there are so many more dead ones than living ones. Well, my belief is that none of them are dead. Their spirits are somewhere, and they are alive.

"Speaking about the Temple of Light, I was very much interested in it from the time I heard of it, and I thought I would go and offer my services to the doctor to help

ing. Mr. Settle told of how his paralysis and rheumatism had been banished, and expressed deep gratitude for what had been done for him. Mrs. Bruer spoke on the "New Scientific Revelation." Her address drew the closest attention, and was filled with much instruction

for all present.

Mrs. Wingett of Sterling, Kan., gave a beautiful poem of her own, entitled, "An Ode to Flowers."

Prof. F. D. Hines, the distinguished editor, teacher and healer, of Denver, Colo., who had planned to attend the convention, found he could not be present, and sent the following beautiful greeting, which was read to the convention:
