# AS WE HAVE BEEN APPROACHED, HERE IS OUR VERSION, CONCISELY STATED.

Numerous cases of criminal diabolism, such as the Harry Thaw, the Haines, and the Mrs. Read cases, cause us to pause and grow strong in an inquiry as to how far imagination nurtured for ill may be responsible in most crimes? Jealousy, hate and passion, backed by imagination, followed by an all persevering auto-suggestion, is the only answer to the two murder cases referred to here. Drugs, an aptitude for the gathering of money, a too powerfully vivid imagination permitted to evolve a process for gratification, per auto-suggestion, answers the possible "Maniacal Exaltation, with Hallucination, Moral Disturbances, with Irresistible Impulse" to commit any act to gain MONEY, in the case of Mrs. Read. The "Evil Spirit," so-called, results as an effect of long continued self indulgence in an imaginary concept, leading through powerful autosuggestion up to "Hallucination of Hearing," or seeing of a presence, as a guide or control, leading often, even to delirium of a nature which, after the act, may result, as in this noted case of Mrs. Read, in mental and nervous collapse: a voice may speak, a shadow presence may attend this voice, a common effect of criminal imagination trending to auto-suggestion which, as a final effect, resulted in the hallucination so much in evidence in this case and in most all such cases, as the three mentioned. Auto-suggestion, long continued in any one of these cases, drove to the final "Irresistible impulse" that caused the criminal act. In each case similar results have been the outcome, a collapse, or else a pretension to such collapse of the brain and nervous system; this proves our premises. Now as to Hypnosis; cast out the "devil," co-called, let reason return and if hypnotized and especially instructed as to what to do and say, in case of success or of failure, the parties will ever after stick to the original instruc-

tions; this is a safe, sure and sound test as to whether any one did instigate or help the parties to the crime, or its commission under process of Hypnosis; if not specially so instructed by the Hypnotizer, the parties acting under Hypnosis, after the commission of the act and recovery from the Hypnotic Control. will have no memory, whatever, of what act has been performed, unless, again placed under Hypnotic Control, when they will remember every detail and reveal all concerning the matter, but not otherwise; this is a certain proof of Hypnotic Control, either as to instructions as to what to say, after the act, provided performed or not, and, also, as to the case of an act to be performed while under such control and without instructions as to statement, etc., after the act.

In all three cases under discussion, we are led to believe imagination coupled with jealousy, hate, envy and drugs, permitted, through auto-suggestion, of the "Irresistible Impulse" and neither Hypnosis nor any other control was at work.

## BEWARE OF WRONGFUL CULTIVATION OF IDEAS AND IDEALS.

The despised imagination ever working, never ceasing, has brought the muchinations of man to their wits end. Imagination, usually looked upon as a thing to be despised, has more resourcefulness of spirit and greater power in making or unmaking human kind than all other human thought agencies combined. Many cases of imagination are just pure and simple imagination, have we known, which later on have brought on the most provoking conditions; maniacal exaltation with hallucination; moral disturbances with almost astonishing and irresistible desire or impulses to do certain things, perform certain acts, often criminal and evil: hearing of voices, whether result of hallucination or that of long repeated self hypnotic or autosuggestive experiences; delirium attended with presences, spirit forms, shadowy and filmy some things; all these conditions may result as an effect of too brilliant or too strenuously and long continued operation of imagination.

We have witnessed and attended many cases, in our work as a Psychic, where ill results were only too apparent as an after effect of a line of imaginative thought; wherein false concepts resulted as the outcome; these false concepts being strengthened and still further materialized by constant inworking auto-suggestion; imagination leading to auto-suggestion is one of the most stupendous powers with which humankind have to deal. Imagination, rightly trained and subject to right reason is a powerful agency for good and when rightly operative brings to bear the mighty energies of soul, spirit and mind in such manner as to heal, uplift and forward man's every good; and when rightly employed, through its setting at work of a right auto-suggestion, can become the greatest of human agencies for man's continued health, success and good.

Man's imagination has peopled empires; built all civilization; carried into all the nooks and corners of earth useful invention; laid the plans which have become great cities and mighty undertakings and made possible the carpeting of earth with the fruits of the husbandman; this same imagination has, too, built engines of war; filled the earth with forces and demon forms, and spirit shadows of woe; it has formed concepts of crime; made criminals of men and women; filled our penitentiaries, insane asylums, and hurried countless hosts into the maelstrom of human agony, sickness and murder, suicide, thievery and skulduggery; it is a question then, of tremendous import, as to the right method of training and final unfoldment of all that evolves in man, that WILL, Spirit and Mind energy, as well as Character, which shall cause imagination to become the powerful agency of the true, the beautiful, the artistic, the healthful, and the all The ill advised imagine all the world against them, or else all the world a skin game or a rendezvous for thieves, thugs and violators of law; the well advised see the world in all its beauty, as a field, a garden of industry and thrift; peopled by human brothers working out the Divine plan of salvation and as an abode of God's children, placed here for the gathering of such experiences as shall immortalize, through individualizing, a Soul. Imagination then, is not a thing to be underestimated as to its power for good, or as an engine of tremendous resourcefulness and power for evil. We have many evils the outcome of pure, simple, wrongly trained imagination, and we could have no good were it not for this same faculty creation or adjunct of the human being's inspiration.

The Thaw case, the Haines case, and the Read case are fine examples of imagination, leading through auto-suggestion, to irresistible impulse to commit crime; not insanity, but effects of imagination

and auto-suggestion.

## A COSTLY BLUNDER; CLIPS AMBITION RUN. RIOT.

Without the Spirit of Justice our words are of none avail.

Harpocrates, the god of Silence, has swept the borders of our fair State clean from the machinations of the devil, false ambition, with results politically, so apparent to all, "that chickens will come home to roost," as astonish the most unwary. Like thunderbolt from a clear sky was the tremendous impact of that indignation, which, rooting itself deep down in the black, material subsoil, contents itself in rumblings and groans, until the right moment for liberation permits the breaking forth of its long pent-up energies. An outraged liberty, the result of a conceit, which raised the constitutional Confidence of trusted Leaders and Members of a party into an arrogance and assumption of authority, that changed all their claims for ADMIRATION into an avalanche of tremendous popular PREJUDICE, is answerable and accountable for the landslide from the Party naturally in popular favor in Colorado to the opposite party's candidate's election, and marks such a revolutionary spirit as to probably forestall any such future freak undertakings on the part of partisan leaders or others interested in political matters in this commonwealth.

Napoleon-Bonaparte desired to conquer all the world, per his own method, that, by so doing, he should unite all nations under one Empire and Napoleon the Emperor; no compromise or quarter, to any power, or anyone, was his slogan; results could be none different than his final overthrow by that spirit of true liberty which he would violate; but what matters it? Or do you merely desire to obtain great knowledge so that your curiosity may be gratified and that you may be proud of your science, and believe yourself to be superior to the rest of mankind? Consider that the depths of Divinity can only be scarched by the Divine Spirit Itself, which is active within you. Real knowledge must come from our own interior, not merely from externals; and they who seek for the essence of things merely in externals may find the artificial color of a thing, but not the true thing itself."

There is no power aside from the Divine, working in and through man, and that power cannot be acquired in thirty days nor in thirty months; any other kind of power belongs to Mesmerism, Hypnotism, and WILL go round its Circuit, if used wrongfully, to return in triple measure the ill sent forth to others, back to the sender thereof. Let it alone or else lay all else down and devote a life to it as a Divine Art for the good only of yourself and mankind; it's a dangerous step unless continued throughout eternity. A little knowledge is a most provoking weakness and dangerous thing in this Profession or Art; beware of false premises and wrong ideals, coupled with dangerous undertakings; your mind is at stake.

Anyone should learn concentration and affirmative creative process, but aside from that be sure before you leap where you are leaping.

Better leave Healing and Occult work to the GIFTED ONES and be safe in the outcome. Every man to his work, not all to the same work, is the law.

Please understand Prof. Hines and his work; do not ask him to decide whether you shall take Silent Treatment, or continue it; he is at your service; you are the one to receive and the Silent Voice of the Soul is a hard Master; He does not permit of us doing more than

Letting ALL men know of our Gifts, and there we must remain Silent. God forces no one into Success, Health, Love, or any other GOOD; man must ask, seek and give.

Strange as it may seem, during the past four years we have had on our healing lists some two hundred houses and business places which were not paying propositions, and out of all this list, all became successful, or a sale for price asked was brought to bear. All people suffering from tuberculosis should follow the example of a man who came to Colorado some years ago from New York; arriving at Evergreen in the autumn, he could scarcely walk two hundred feet without having to sit down for breath and rest; he was persevering, however, and after a while began to daily pick an axe and chop away at wood; finally he was able to cut quite a nice pile of wood each day; he went from the wood-pile into the hay field; after spending the first summer in this manner, he was enabled to do the ordinary work of a regular farm hand and hired out to a ranchman for the coming year, at the rate of \$25 per month; he got well; he rose from 130 pounds, his first weight upon arrival here, to 210 pounds, his normal weight-as he was a six-footer. The last we heard of him he was a wellto-do Cattle King in Montana; grit and vim and labor, coupled with perseverance, good will and humor saved the life of that man: nothing on earth could have done it; if he had adopted the method of sitting around, day in and day out, as most consumptives do, he would have died the first spring he was here. Work is what most sick people need, and that, too, in the out-door, open-air positions; hothouse office positions will never heal Tent life without work a consumptive. is a failure.

We have, in our work among all classes and types of people, endeavored to be out and out with the truth as nearly as God might permit in us its positive expression; yet we find we have lost many so-called friends through our adherence to the truth, as we have been permitted to see it.

It seems all are seeking truth, yet none like it in its everyday austerity and severeness of discipline. Truth energies are absolutely yea and nay and intensify the austerity of man, and often, to state the truth is to be so misunderstood as to almost win the dislike of people in general. But the Christ said. "Lest ye lose your life ye cannot gain it," meaning, in truth, we must sacrifice the personal to the Spiritual and let no whimsical like or dislike turn us from the high purpose of doing good. To heal, nothing but straight, Spiritual Power is of the slightest avail; often we are compelled, for the sake of a patient's own best good, to stand firm against his every whim and feeling, not daring to give vent to one single impulse less than that; you are Health and can be nothing, in Truth, less than Health, and thus do we, seemingly, outrage the most ardent thoughts or feelings. Spirit knows, and knowing persists, and persisting turns never back, nor to the right nor to the left, and who heals must follow Spirit, and to do less defeats all Spirit undertakes, in and through him, as the instrumentality of Healing Power.

If you expect to receive petting or sympathy from a true Healer, that is, such sympathy as will encourage and foster your DEVIL, the DEVIL your case requires REMOVED, then, do not ASK your Healer to ACCOMPLISH, nor expect DISEASE to be CAST OUT, for you expect what will defeat the realization of any Psychic's Process. A true PSYCHIC is TRUE to YOU

and if TRUE to YOU he must not strive for anything beneath YOUR HEALTH. You may LOVE a DOCTOR, or a LAWYER for his PERSONAL AT-TENTIONS, but you cannot LOVE a HEALER who is a PSYCHIC or TRUE OCCULT and be HEALED: this is LAW, is TRUTH and it places the poor unfortunate PSYCHIC and OCCULT, as the most powerful manifestation of ALL TRUTH, at a tremendous disadvantage; hence we say he loses his life (personal), that he may gain it through DUTY to himself, his profession and others. He is Positive Health.

"We cannot use Occultism in politics." Let us see why not. Some four years ago occasion caused the question to arise regarding whether Occultism could be of use in politics; a noted politician, who had utilized similar gifts, whether aware of it or not, exclaimed, "We cannot use Occultism in politics;" this man undoubtedly misunderstood the term and also the mystery of his own success; he was the very embodiment and actualized expressiveness of the "hidden," and never spent one single hour in his political work that was free from the silent, subtle forces at work, in and through him, if not admittedly consciously, then unconsciously; but perhaps not recognizing the potency within his own Soul at work may account for his recent overestimate of his proper place and the failure to keep his former splendid equilibrium; his present mistake is not his, but that of his leader, through ambition having overcome the usual good sense and safe mapping out of political fights. cians, never for a minute undeceiving themselves by a search within, for that which is the real potency and energy at work, in and through them, for their own advancement; man looks everywhere but to the real source for his excellencies; "Man proposes, God disposes," is a truism when we understand man as he is, the expression of a Universal Force, or energy, as guaranteed by Spirit, as the means of Wisdom illumining knowledge, and, as the mode of expressing, in the one favored, the all that's in all others, as a Consciousness of at-one-ment; this begets mutual interests in spite of any self-knowing to the contrary, and makes of the Occult the means of establishing this at-one-ment, and is, therefore, power Divine at work as a subtle, hidden force, bringing about a perfected agreement of unity in the given community of inter-

No man may understand divine law lest he understand man; the divine Nature in man contains all the attributes essential to the understanding of the law governing our inner and outer natures; without this Divine Nature expressive no man can know himself rightly or act safely as to compliance with law; obedience to law is guaranteed right action, and hence health, success and good results in material matters; no man can be assured of acting rightly from any source lower than that of the Divine Nature; the most startling crimes have been enacted through objective conception of right; even in the name of Christ millions of murders have befouled the earth sphere, during past epochs of history; a belief is not Knowledge, but a Spiritual, Divine Nature is light of Knowledge, and through this light of Knowledge no murder ever was or ever can be permitted; because absolute right is known only of the Soul and Spirit through Wisdom, the Light of Knowledge. Belief leads but to fanaticism, the highest outcome of ignorance and bigotry. Now, in the same manner, man may be, as the child, a sceptic as to what kind of a character, whether Spiritual or Material, may be the outcome of the germ or seed, said to be the beginning, or source, of a given type of manifestation, of life and its expression, as to Soul or form. The germinating seed of man will produce its kind, as to the physical, without one single exception; this is acknowledged as an immutable law; this has been demonstrated to the satisfaction of all men, everywhere; but when it comes the Soul of things and, more especially, the seed, that per regenerative process, termed the PSYCHOSIS, brings into expression the full and completed Immortal Selfhood, the real Self in man, the demonstration is, practically, impossible of satisfactory production, aside from each

individual proving it for himself, by actual effort in the directing of the Objective to assume the possibility of Soul Unfoldment, or, rather, the acceptance of the Spirit of The Creator as a necessary requirement to his own individual regeneration. No thing exists without a cause; the seed of all things does and must exist somewhere in some manner or shape or form, or without form, as the case may be, material or Spiritual, as to form, expression of, or from Original Will and Life.

Each seed, no matter whether of plant, or vegetable, or animal life, must contain within itself the persistency of WILL, LOVE AND LIFE, as from First Cause; without this persistency there can be no continuity of Life, form or purpose, whether of Original ES-SENCE and SUBSTANCE, in BE-ING, or of Form, and final Expression, and Power, or attainment and unfoldment; this is the reason and reasonableness of things. Nothing grows, in any kingdom, where life is the indwelling factor, except from within out and from a germinal or seed center; there is no growth by accretion from without; a child is formed, from male and female element, the tiniest germinal combination is nurtured and maintained within the womb of the mother parent, but, even there, its growth is from the central orb, or original seed, up and out, from within out, and, after birth, this same growth process must continue, whether life be short, or whether it extend to the ripe manhood only completed in old age. As it is with the Physical, so is it with the Spiritual man; there is that which is Soul, but Soul, like the womb in the physical process, contains within it that which is the seed of a Nature, a New Creature, to be Spiritualized, quickened, awakened, set under new process of growth, per growth process, permitted to unfold and continue a growth from within out and without this PSYCHOSIS, as a process, there

is incompletion, as to the inner manifestation, and the Christ Nature fails to materialize, and Individual Immortality is defeated; the process is essential to Soul attainment, or Subconscious knowing and the building of an Immortal Selfhood as a completed Ego. WILL predetermines the type, the species, or the kind, and then determines and sets in motion the process of growth along fixed or idealized lines; WILL is the beginning and end of action, growth, or generation, or regeneration; WILL fixes purpose, determines process and persists in growth, action or expression. Divine WILL is the Supreme Power back of all that is, persists or continues in manifest expression, hence, man, to partake of Continuity and Immortal existence must needs be at-one-ment with Divine WILL. This Divine Will indwelling the word is Creative Power in Action, without which Creative Thought is of no consequence. Divine WILL is the energy of the Divine Word, and the same in all manner of seed.

The business man of the future will employ less mental and physical mesmeric force and far more Spiritual and Suggestive power. Under such methods disease vanishes under the Master's stroke and health becomes an assured reality. Nurses, too, should be likewise endowed, in fact everything having to do with the invalid or the sick, should be governed by the principles of Suggestion. The Bed, the room, the building, the every surrounding influence, must be Suggestive of VITALITY, SUNSHINE, GOOD CHEER, and hence of HEALTH.

Materialistic man, poor fool, how he covers himself with his shell and thinks there is something grand in his self-imposed selfishness!

Impervious, he believes himself to be to the upheavals, changes and mutations of time, yet what is he but an emblem, in

passing, of time itself?

How soon, "slow, regular, perpetual, time" shall bring that inexorable change, which is true of all mutable forms and things? "We are but the stuff of which dreams are made."
