Remember, "lest ye forgive ye shall not be forgiven," was not written of yourself towards others alone, but also for self as well; lest yo forgive thine own follies, place them before thine own mind, and so placing them forgive them and, thereby, let loose of them and, dropping their evils, turn to righteousness and new and better endeavor, ye cannot be forgiven in truth; for what ye are in actual Consciousness so shall ye become in actual revealment, as to final expression, whether of form or of character.

Her chickens did well; she added to them; her Springers she peddled to well-to-do families at highest retail prices; cleaned them and delivered them healthy, clean and fresh; her business has grown until now it keeps several people busy; she IS A SUC-CESS.

The Generic (universal), and the Genetic (species), must become a judgment, an utterance of itself, in the particular, the individual, its other of itself, ere it can express its otherness, its counterpart; the Ego remains inactive, unless it can know itself and knowing itself, become a judgment, an utterance of itself in something of itself, yet differing in the particular form itself; hence to one's self is to know all otherness or counterpart of self, as particularized individuals, offspring of the Generic, first and secondly, as the creations of the Genetic.

The study of man, then, is that of man as selfhood in its dual complete-

Have a purpose in Life; Will, Do, Dare; and be patient and content in patience; millions of cycles have been required to perfect what we see and know of the Material realms; around the central orb of the Eternal Ego swings and whirls and moves and has life and being and existence all that is; around each cne of the central orbs of being in each of the factors, individualized Egos of the Generic, radiates, swings into expression and actualized existence that which we, as such an individualized Ego, create, propel and will into manifestation; we are masters of our own particularized, little kingdom or sphere of activity, provided we so will to be. As with the greater, so must it follow with the lesser, to will is to be and to will is to set in motion; but like the creative Ego, we must let loose and leave our willed condition to evolve, develop

and grow unto its fulfilment. To doubt is to defeat our own willed desire.

I, this individualized, particularized Ego am something, or else I exist not at all in actual worth to my community of interests; I may be, in form, a mere useless thing walking around occupying space, a rock in the way of other more useful and potential forms, or I may be, as the completed manifestation of innate being, a master Ego, potential energy, wisdom, light and power for good; it all rests with myself as to which kind of an Ego I really express. Power is from the within, never from the without; the engine represents the action of that which is representative of innate, concentrated energy as power, but the outer without the innate, or inner means of volition and energy, would be a useless machine, a dead, inactive engine, occupying space without work or specialized worth or value; so is it with the Ego, without the innate energy, divine power is not in actual manifestation or complete revealment; it is void of the main essential Life and Light, as well as volition (will).

Don't FORGET YOU PASS THIS WAY BUT ONCE; for heaven's sake if you have plenty and can do so, LIVE and ENJOY some COMFORT. The most pitiable BEING that walks is that one who, having MONEY, so hoards it and worships it as to make LIFE a miserable penuriousness. Look at the features, look at the hawk-claw fingers, the greedy countenance, as shown by eye, lip, nose and chin; look at the premises of such an one; the story of living in Hades, while in the midst of plenty, is written everywhere.

He dies twenty years ahead of the usual time allotted to a reasonably happy creature, and dies to leave some one else to fight and law over his leavings; at fifty, old and gray, tattered and worn, broken of mind and wrecked in nerve; such is the end of all who, having plenty, forget that there is but one God and that there are none other before HIM, and HE is LOVE, LIFE, POWER and the ALL of the ALL that is GOOD in health, honor, longevity, real RICH-ES and noble, radiating manhood.

From the Soul to Soul communications of the Illumined Mystics man gets the intimation of that which enables him to use atmospheric vibrations, in wireless telegraphy; there is no system of communication that was ever devised or ever can be devised by man that is not already manifest and working in intricate harmony and perfection within the human organism; turn your eyes inward; let intuition guide thee; listen to the still small voice of the Spirit within thee and Wisdom is at your service; "know thy self," and thou shalt master all elementaries, all material problems and become master of all things essential to human destiny. Our Philosophy and Science is more than mere Spiritual development confined to super mundanc affairs; it is the real road to the mastery of all mundane affairs and conditions, as well. We have the key to all that can, may or shall be done, provided man chooses to look within himself for the treasury vaults to which the key applies. All that is, was or ever will be, is evolved from within and never from the without of things.

You want success; you aspire to it; you see it as it presents itself to you. Now, success, in its reality, has a face to suit each one's view point; it presents its face to you as you yourself shall idealize and expect to see it. What, then, is success? Is it not to you that which is your truest, completest, fulfilment of your ideal? Yet how often our ideal is a false concept in so far as our own best good is concerned, and, then, success as fulfilling our ideal is not SUCCESS. A success that brings content at the expense of moral uplift, good health and useful longevity is but the shadow that undoes. We once knew a man; he had wealth, a fine, richly furnished home; spent his summers in fashionable resorts; traveled and seemed ALL that earth could give as success to him. Five years later we met this man a vagabond upon the street, passing from saloon to saloon as a patron of free lunch counters; another year added and we read: "S----- W----- shot and killed in a dive at C-----, relatives unknown, body unclaimed, lies awaiting coroner's inquest and the-?" This man was formerly, while a SUCCESS, a great saloon man, taking in thousands of dollars daily; this illustration, we believe, is convincing enough.

Spirit will so illumine Soul as to place knowing of value at your command; Spirit will also instruct you through your Soul, or Subjective Mind, but you must learn to listen, obey and

do, without delay or doubt, that which is revealed, provided always, common sense and reason is kept sharpened and your wits with you. A fool will be given a fool's message; ignorance will draw ignorance; cultivation of mind, as to intellect, gives faculty-power a prime essential to benefit from Soul illumination; the Soul can only reveal what we are able to understand, discern and apply.

Do not, therefore, expect greatness to be revealed to a two-by-four Faculty de-Education, reading and velopment. culture receive more than ignorance and incapacitated mental calibre can possibly hope for. Go through a farming district; here is a farm; the house is unpainted; the shingles split and falling away from the roof; some window panes missing and old rags stuffed into the place where the glass should let in the light of day. All farm machinery out in the weather; no sheds for anything; a plow over here, a dilapidated reaper yonder, a brokendown buggy across the way, and hoes and pitchforks, shovels and picks dropped wherever last used; cows, pigs, cats, dogs running about the very doors add to the general confusion and filthy appearance of the premises. Go to the store-keeper and ask him how that man is getting on; "Oh, he owes everybody; is out of luck; his family is sick more than half the time, and his farm is mortgaged for all it's worth, he's on his last legs, poor fellow; he likely will be sold out soon." This is a true picture

drawn from actual conditions and actual realization, as witnessed, seen and noted by this editor.
