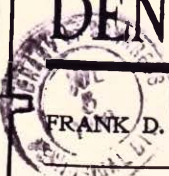

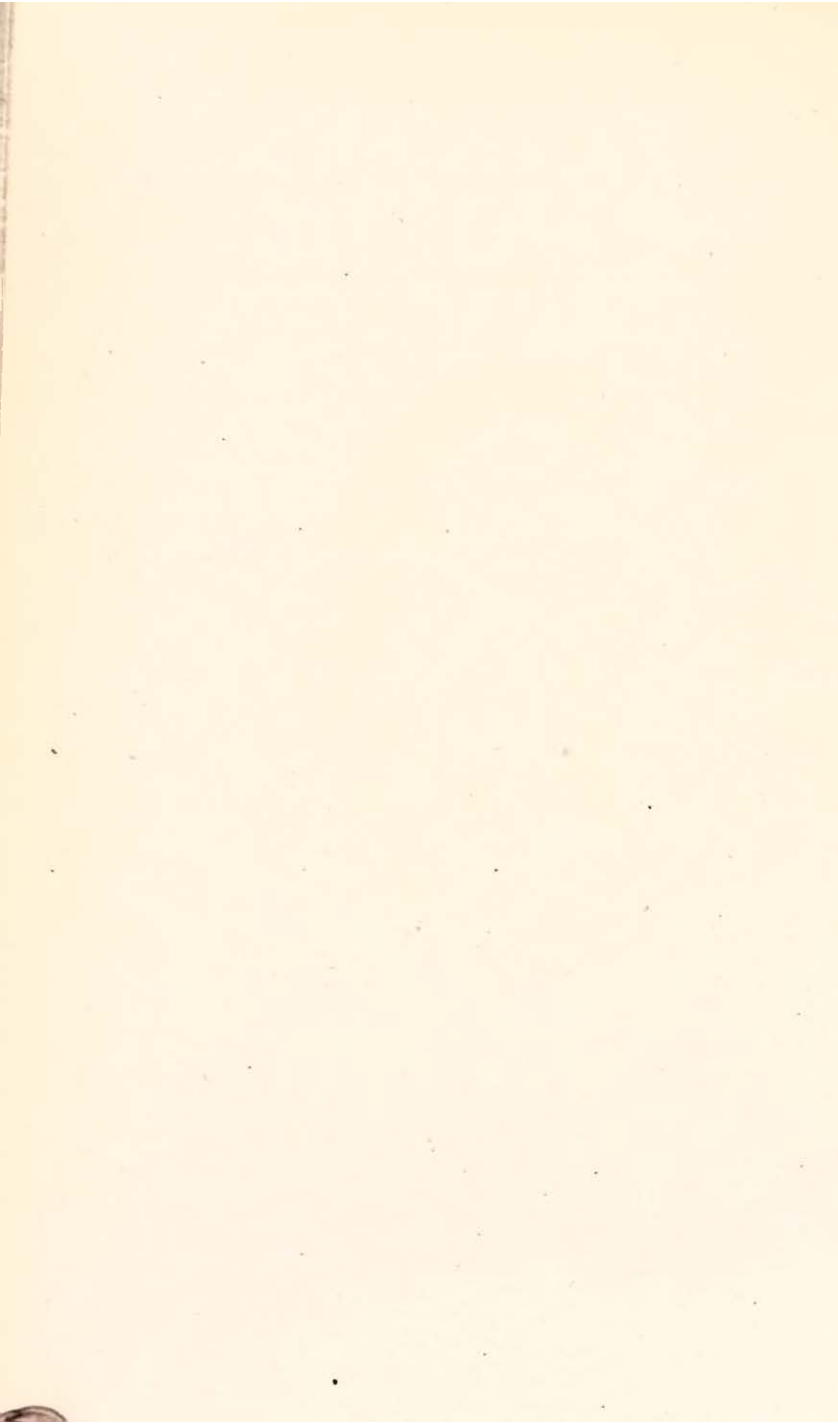

Get up and Do is it.

The Taurus Nativities are the "conservators of Knowledge," Libra, the "conservators of the Life Principle" and "Law and Order," yet a Libra may be very poorly educated and Shine in everything and everywhere, while a Taurus fails and remains in secondary position, even with the most elegant equipment as to educational advantages; the difference lies in the spirit of power to BE, and to DARE to DO; Taurus wants and prefers the Art of Perfection, the nicety of the Ideal, ere venturing, while Libra works to make the Art, the Ideal, a fact of Conquest and WADES IN to WIN it from all opposing factors, with results that, usually, bring Success. We give this illustration to show the WHY persons FAIL or WIN. It's not egotism or its lack; its spirit to Be, to Dare, to Do and Win, and stop at no adverse criticism.

It makes us fairly boil from within, when angry parents beat and whip inhumanly their own offspring; we wish we could, by our Process, overcome this most excusable freak of human kind. It's so strange that parents do not understand that the child is themselves over again, just as formed in character, during prenatal period. The spirit of the Mother forms every child's character and her spirit and the environmental conditions, also, makes its form, its Brain and its entire physical Being. Why then try to inhumanly pound, and beat out of your own child and offspring your own meanness? The Attributes of Divinity are ours, but we refuse them and to refuse is but to fail in attainment of that which is LOVE, in Health, the only LOVE worth while.

We speak of ascending to the heights; we speak of dwelling on the heights; we should not forget we must ascend, view from an advantaged point the fields beneath and before us, only to descend, again, that we may carry into effect the beneficial results of having gained the expanded and clearer view of things necessitates, works and ways. You never can imprison Genius, neither can you shut behind prison doors the Spirit of the real Super-man; nay, more, even death does not inhibit or estop Super-man's after reflections back to earth of that which belongs to OCCULT GIFTS and RESOURCEFULNESS; this is REAL FREEDOM and for this REASON this writer fears NOTHING anywhere or in any place.

Time and Space with Spirit as Equilibrating POWER and LIGHT is ALL, and who IS OF THE HOLY GHOST has ALL, provided he OBEYS that most POTENT LIGHT. The REAL is EGO, not EGOTISM, and is POWER not SELF SUFFICIENCY.

The REAL works constantly, eternally, without NOISE or HINDRANCE; it is GROWTH, in FULFILLING PSYCHIC PROCESS. Why FEAR, DOUBT or LACK FAITH, when once you become the LAW manifest?

The boy or girl who can be saucy to father or mother and fight and quarrel at the childhood home, will seldom be a fit subject for matrimonial happiness in after years. The spirit is the moulder of character and the kind of spirit determines all character as to manifestation of disposition, happiness, health or ill conditions.

AN INSPIRATIONAL DESCRIPTION OF COMETS.

Halley's comet belongs to a class which serves the Universe as a cleaning-out agency. The attraction is neutral, compared with that of Planets and Suns. They are composed, formed or created and maintained by excretions from Planets and Suns, which they, in the form of poisonous gases, throw off into the ether and thus cause these comets to float in space in search for food. This also indicates that not only is the attraction different from that of Suns and Planets but the one kind is a vigorous

repulsion to the other and therefore collisions with planets, Suns and that class of comets are impossible.

WHAT IS A COMET?

Its nucleus is jellylike formations, which in the main are clearer than glass. The largest one is about twice the size of the Earth with numerous others of various sizes from about the size of the Moon down to the smallest imaginable in the state of gas formations.

Each of these strives to maintain its own existence independent of the others, but all of them form an organization with much similarity to organizations of Sun systems. The smaller ones have the first chance at the nutrition attained and they again give nutriment to the largest one, and it performs a function similar to the function of Suns in Sun systems.

THE COMET'S TAIL.

This is gaseous and vaporous substances, which is the atmosphere of the comet and would enwrap the nucleus similarly as the Earth is enwrapped in its atmosphere, but the repulsion of these atmospheric substances for the magnetic current, sent out by the Sun, force them to seek shelter, as it were, back of the nucleus, which causes it to spread out over an enormous space, and it again serves a great and double purpose. As a cleaning-out agency it covers much more space, consequently gathers up greater amount of poisonous gases, which again give it more nutriment or more to subsist on.

What effect will the comet have upon the Earth when passing?

The poisonous gases in the Earth's atmosphere and also excrement in the Earth itself, which has not yet been thrown off, are attracted and make their way to the comet through a similar process as the attraction or the electric exchange between the Sun and the Earth. It will be possible for men to observe these poisonous gases when they leave the Earth as they will result in more or less pestilence, and are inclined to influence men with irritable and ill temperament. Such has been observed before when comets have been close to the

Earth and as this comet at this time comes closer to the Earth than any previous, it is reasonable that it will have a greater influence in that direction; but when it has passed, and the Earth again has come into its normal stage, it will be possible to notice that we have had a general cleaning-out, mentally as well as physically.

**THE IMPRACTICABLE LEADS TO CHAOS
FOSTER'S DESTRUCTION.****The Spirit of a Philosopher is the Spirit of
Equilibrium.**

It is true that so-called riches, possessed by so-called rulers of the Money Markets and the Industrials, seems to be trending to a luxuriousness, fatal to civilization; but the pendulum will swing to and fro until it regulates itself. There is a Law which being of the Universal will equilibrate matters, in spite of seeming surface indications; this law is Philosophically and Scientifically always at work, on and along, absolute lines of correct principle; the fundamental law is a safe reactionary one; in the fundamental alone lies all safety. Man has never yet been able to rule himself, and shall fail, so to do, until that time comes when selfishness ceases to be a Virtue, cultivated as much by the Socialist, the Idealist, as by the most powerful Financial gormorant.

It's useless to preach to what is incapacitated or incapable of just understanding underlying fundamental principles. A mess will be made of everything so long as principles are sacrificed to mere selfish aspirational desires or designs. Men are the tools of themselves; society or government is a facsimile of what the people, en masse, best represent, as to general character; water can not rise above its fountain head, neither can a government and its Industrial welfare, as to distribution of values, rise above the characteristic indulgence and qualities of its factors, as to its citizenship. Evolve a race of men capacitated to be self-ruling and you have, then, a Nation capacitated to be self-ruling. Equilibrated conditions can not come by making all men serve a process, which makes all virtually beggars; all bees' work, but the Queen bee is essential to the centralizing of effort for the commonwealth of the hive without a strongly organized, concentered and concentered head, leaves nothing but chaos and poverty as the result of petty selfish-

ness and factional destructiveness. Men will be trifling and selfishly lazy, even if supposed to be under brotherly Love, bound to do each an equal service for the whole as well as each for each. It may be possible for Heaven to run with equal rights and privileges and communistic enjoyment, but Heaven is so daringly opposite to the Utopian theory, planned for earth, as to make its modes and methods a matter of study to sensible earth-bound creatures, here and now. It's strange how men, while in poverty, rise to dreams of social communism, only to remain so, so long as it's necessary to do so, in order to gain a foothold, or an advantage over the other fellows to the deal, and then, suddenly, to drop out of the community of interests. It's all right to dream, but let your dreams be tested and proved by practical demonstration, ere you trifle with the possibilities of a Nation of dreamers. We have spent eight years in our present Altruistic work and Mystic and Occult endeavors; we have found, at no time, a MAN who wanted a Communistic Brotherhood scheme, who was not, at heart, a schemer for after selfish gain, out of his Brotherhood scheme, or else, someone well to do playing a fiddle to catch the Votes of some certain class of men.

We have met some fine, capable, intellectual giants who advocated some plausible looking schemes, but they, too, were past the pale of further necessity and safe in Money for Life. We oppose nothing that is sincerity and honesty, in its inception or presentation; but we cannot be a party to false and surely undoing principles, nor afflict after generations by advocating what is, only too apparent, a failure, in practical demonstration. We belong to the service of mankind; we wish all to grow and unfold and prosper; we advocate the Altruism that makes men of the type that may sustain a world as well as themselves in prosperity. The rich and foolish will consume themselves.

THE TREND OF ETHICS AND POLITICS.

It is with no small concern we watch the unfolding of the false Concept in recent Ethical and Political Movements. It astonishes us to behold modern civil communities drifting back to the period, formerly known just immediately preceding the dark ages. It would seem the concern of demagogues and political connivers to utilize the high attainment of Spiritual Illumination to cultivate a paternalism, or quasi sentimentalism, so ridiculously selfish, as to make hideous its facial expression, even to the most dull student of Sociological and Political-economic questions.

Anything, Oh God, to get my click into power; the after ruin of a Nation and its system of finances and economics, is inconsequential. The forcing of a Panic upon a people is a Crime, the measurement of which enormity is scarcely possible. To make valueless Billions of Dollars' worth of Securities at one fell blow; to totally and radically alter the ethical relationships of a people, in its general characteristic make up, may seem doing something for the dear people; but, on its very face it appears to the sensible, as an illusion and a monstrosity. Demagogues and demigods are of the same type; both work for the meal at the expense of the people, through a system, which is a lie. The spirit, now possessing the world, is one soon to prove most frightfully reactive, and the outcome of which reaction, promises most terrible suffering, poverty, famine and possible war and bloodshed; it is the spirit of greed working for gain, through self-interests, buried beneath a cloak of pretense to uplift and save the common people. Capital is an essential to progress in any community; all can not be Capitalists; few are able to stand prosperity to the extent of holding large Money Interests; this is Mundane History and the world still clings to history repeating itself as a sacred fact.

Paternalism is as fatal as is its sister Sumptuary Law; too much liberty leads

to laziness and license; too many bosses, like too many head cooks, spoil the pie; an incentive to save and to prosper one's self is the factor in sociology that makes for greatness, in the individual and personnel and the same holds true, as to the Nation, nay even the City. We have no sympathy with City ownership of all public utilities, because City Politics are already Machine enough without adding interests so as to make all we are a Political Machine, once organized, so powerful as to subjugate all citizens to ignominy and helplessness. Get your Water Works, your Telephones, your Tramways, your Subways, your Parks, your Sewerage, your Gas and Electric Lights and your Railways all under one stupendous organization, political, and watch for the strings that will hang you. The spirit of competition may go to extremes, but it can be regulated and stopped; but not the community ownership scheme. We have known of Water Works, where, when you violated a rule, instead of, as in private ownership, your water being turned off and it costing you Five Dollars to get it on again, you were subject to the most discriminating and unjust political chicanery and abuse, besides, being arrested and fined for negligence; this is City ownership brought to its finality. We have too much City Interference already; cut it down; add not to it. License Boards, Health Boards, Inspection Boards, Election Boards, all kinds of boards galore, until it costs a fortune to stand in with the Machine, or get a public write-up that ruins. We are skilled in politics, know the ropes, the tricks, the methods; we are afraid of further power.

Instead of freeing men the modern spirit but adds to their burdens.

If present rampant methods are indulged, look out for 1914 to 1917, for the most terrible revolutionary and awful times of history. It's coming through falsely presented and alluringly false ideals; let us look before we leap.
