


As This Editor Found The Convention Wednesday Eve., June 22nd, to Friday Eve., the 24th, at Kansas City, Mo.

THE TEMPLE OF LIGHT

To Be Erected in Kansas City by the Society for Scientific Revelation.

The Temple of Light will be of the Grecian-Roman Ionian school of architecture, adhering to the beautiful lines of the ancient temples that were erected in the Old World, and which have withstood the ravages of time for hundreds of years. The Temple will be built in the form of a cross, with four fronts, each 210 feet long, and a dome of magnificent proportions will surmount the center. The building will be four stories in height, and marble will be the principal material of construction. Immense columns of granite four feet in height and nearly six feet in thickness will be placed at the entrance in each of the four sides. Broad marble steps will lead to great bronze doors. which in themselves will be beautiful works of art, reproductions of the doors of one of

the ancient Grecian temples.

The main auditorium will be a room of immense size, with a seating capacity of sevreal hundred, and will occupy the west wing of the Temple. It will be beautifully decorated in colors that blend harmoniously and will be pleasing to the eye.

The Hall of Healing, the Shrine Room and the Art Gallery will be places of special interest to those who are privileged to enter therein. The immense reception hall, the Hall of Healing and the Doctor's private offices will be on the first floor, occupying the greater part of the entire three wings.

Close of Session.

The President then announced that the sessions of the Society of Scientific Revelation were completed and that the present convention would adjourn. You have seen the beautiful face and form of Rose the Sunlight, Emma the Starbeam, and Grace Celestia, the heavenly messengers who come here to meet and greet the ones they love.

These divine revelations bring heaven down to earth. The drawings for the Great Temple of Light were made in the same way. You have no doubt viewed this beautiful and wonderful art production that represents a building 210 feet long, with four fronts, built in the form of a cross, four stories high, with dome and cupola 166 feet in height.
