Indeed, Conversation is the health of the soul and the life of the heart.

But beware, too, lest conversation be the undoing of mental power, the viper of hate.

Too often gifted men and women become the dread of society, the confusion of minds and the worry of friends, because of a dangerous sarcasm or unwitted indiscretion of tongue.

A good converser avoids all topics, of state, creed, ism, nationality and everything liable to embarrass or anger, or add hurt to any one, in the membership of any general gathering or company of persons.

John T. Dale once said: "There are brilliant talkers of whom we are always in dread, lest they sting us by some careless sarcasm or witty rejoinder." "Better an eternal silence than to scatter firebrands and cause heartaches; such conversers bring upon themselves the well merited contempt and condemnation of mankind."

It has been said, "The most necessary talent in conversation is good judgment"; "the secret of success lies not in the knowing of what to say, as in the knowing what to avoid saying."

Sir William Hamilton, profound scholar and philosopher, said: "Man, in fact, only attains the use of his faculties in obtaining the use of speech, for language is the indispensable means of the development of his natural powers, whether intellectual or moral."

Madame de Stael, it has been said, "Could talk with the most astute diplomat on political affairs in Europe, or meet the most subtle philosopher on his own ground in the realm of Metaphysics;" she was a most brilliant listener as well as converser, and seldom failed to become the center of attractiveness, in the personnel of any gathering.

The ground work for all good conversation is a thorough knowledge on topics in general, and, above all, knowledge of temperaments and persons in general. It is only the newly graduated high school or college student who violates the rules of conversation by eternally referring to books as authority.

Dale, in his worthy work, entitled, "The Way to Win," says, "Curran was a convivial deity,—soaring into every region, and at home in all;" of Leigh Hunt, "that he was like a pleasant stream in conversation;" that "Car-

lyle, doubted, objected and demurred;" that Buckle, author of the "History of Civilization," that for inexhaustibility, versatility, memory and self-confidence never was there an equal."

We have brought before our readers these few excerpts on the Art of Conversation, simply for the purpose of attracting attention to this much neglected phase of culture; there is no accomplishment more worthy attention and cultivation, yet none so neglected; a thorough converser, ready and apt upon timely topics and of the nicety of judgment requisite to elegance in entertaining others, is a rarety oftener than a presence in most social gatherings. Most men are too hurried, while women are too gossipy to be classed good conversationalists.

Where the Light shineth there will be no wrong or error permitted to possess the man or misdirect his will energy.

From the election returns, the spirit of Justice out-ran the spirit of discrimination, as to the "Wets" and the "DRYS."

Justice, as our name and shield, may seem strange to all unjust and disappointed, disproportioned ones; but such is our Revealment and Truth.

The man of the hour remains above the mix-up of earth's people; speaks his mind with discretion; awakens men to thought and action and passes on to new endeavors and new fields to conquer. coming principle.

We find religion void of spirit; we cannot become whole unless there is Spirit at work within our religion, as the Psychosis; we, per the process, termed, Ratiocination, may proceed to swallow, take in the form, the word, the symbol of this religion and remoulding it, permitting Spirit to quicken it, utter it as our own judgment, as of the Ego, and, then, per Reason, accept it and make of it, a Healing, a Psychic Process, as Spirit expressive as Light, polarizing and equilibrating all things, in, of and about us, to our uplift, spiritualization, healing and overcoming of disease, poverty, ill conditions or lack of inspiration. Without Spirit, as Light, we have not the Psychosis, neither have we the quickening and awakening, as well as Healing Powers or Energies, as LIFE-PRINCIPLE, possible, or work. Religion void the Spirit is a dead form, unable to perform its mission, the awakening of Soul, or the quickening and healing of the flesh; the word cannot become HEALTH FLESH, void the LIFE-PRINCIPLE, as made,

manifest, alone, by Divine Spirit; Will is useless without Life of Love as creative, unfolding and fulfilling Process, and Spirit is that LIGHT of WILL and LOVE which permits the EGO to recreate and utter its own GOOD, whether of Health, Happiness, or new environmental conditions.

We reach all GOOD to self and other selves, per Ratiocination; the Ego is thus permitted to re-establish us, and for us, that which is not in natural circumstances, fitted to our uplift. health or GOOD. Accept nothing ill, then, but what you take it and let the Ego turn it to thy good. This latter process, may, too, reflect the law of Transmutation.

Upon this law depends the efficacy of all Psychic Process; within the Ego of the Psychic, Occult, Healer, Oracle, Seer, Prophet or ordinary genius, lies that power which, through Ratiocination, may become, even, the Gift of "the Philosopher's Transmutation, Stone," which makes possible all things that make for health, success, unity, love, peace, or wealth and attainment. It is this knowing, this transmuting and transforming and uttering power of the Ego, which makes Amulets, and Sacred Images, Pins, or other articles, blessed as made by the Gifted Psychic, Occult, Master or Guru, a power to others, for their might and Good. bration is the finality of effect, as to the judgment uttered by one Ego for others Good, and articles become the rate of vibration instilled into them, per the Process of Ratiocination, as idealizing them, as new Symbols, Emblems, or Articles, endowed with the Spirit and the Life-Principle, which is the very thing necessitated by the one to whom the article is given.

It is this same Process that causes this Magazine to Heal its reader, or a letter from its editor, to change conditions from ills of life and environmentals, or of form to that which is success, health and wealth.

This was the secret source of perfection in the wonderful Healing Work carried unto perfection by Slatter, in Denver, some years ago. It is the secret of success, in our Psychic Process; we swallow our patients, take them into our own Ego, and there, alter and spiritualize them and send them forth with the Life-Principle at work and, ever after, keep it at work, per the Psychosis, the Divine Light of the Soul of us; this accounts for the intensity and the danger in our Healing Process.
