ATTAINMENT

O ATTAIN the things your heart most desires you must make a conscious picture of the cherished wish in its entirety or completeness. If you want financial success you must eliminate all errors that stand between you and your goal. You must make, first of all, the necessary summing of cost sufficient to purchase (over and above all of your liabilities) the debt that hangs between you and that financial success. This same formula can be adapted to every other success you are seeking. You must visualize the possession of the goal for yourself. You do this by visualizing the mental and physical strength to hold that goal after all errors have been eliminated, all barriers hurdled and all obstructions and objections removed. You must place yourself in the position of the conquering hero receiving congratulations from his superior. Even in small matters, every day trifling things—things that irritate and aggravate, disturbing frailties that become such monsters when encouraged, must be eliminated, each one as it aligns itself to disturb. In the last analysis you must gain sufficient control over your stock room that nothing becomes depleted and nothing is pilfered by an excuse for weaknesses.

When the day is done and you are ready for sleep eliminate every thought of the day from your mind; retain only the memory of that thing which served you and served you well. By doing this you will have a seed of plenty to place in the structure of your memory for prospective and perfect activity to begin a new day. Place this seed so strong in your mind that if you are awakened from your slumber the guarding of this seed will flood your memory; though you be awakened several times before the time to arise, each time as you enter the sleep state be conscious of this seed reposing in your memory chamber. The Denial of Matter in the Allness of Spirit

THIS great question confronts occult students and has divided many truth seeking minds, therefore it is timely to seek out the old masters and compare their versions with modern metaphysical sciences if such there be.

Probably the greatest discussion of the age among advanced students centers around the Christian Science Scientific Statement of Being, found on page 468, of Science and Health With Key to the Scriptures, by Mary Baker Eddy.

"There is no life, truth, intelligence, nor substance in matter. All is infinite Mind and its infinite manifestation, for God is All-in-All. Spirit is immortal Truth; matter is mortal error. Spirit is the real and eternal; matter is the unreal and temporal. Spirit is God, and man is His image and likeness. Therefore man is not material; he is spiritual."

Not only among materially minded men but among advanced students of the occult science, this statement has been labeled untrue and ridiculous, but the writer feels that the theory that all is spirit, is substantiated by the most authentic writers of the old sciences.

Let us delve into the thoughts of those wise philosophers, Hermes Trismegistus and Jacob Boehme from whose writings, and others, the Allness of Spirit originated. The question really takes us to the highest realm of Divine Spirit for it is the keynote of Divine Healing.

When man affirms that he is Spiritual and learns to know and understand in Love and Humility, that there is only One Power, the barnacles of material trouble and sickness leave him and he experiences a spirit of levitation in his bodily senses. This the student can prove for himself without taking the writer's word for it, but inasmuch as it has been proved by many thousands of people, we will use it as a premise to our discussion.

Jacob Boehme, speaking of the "Power of the Glory of God" states, "Out of which Science all Things grow, blossom, flourish and yield fruit, which Power lies within the Quint Essentia, and is a CURE OF SICKNESS."

Now along comes an occult student, one of our Occult Digest writers, and states:

"Christian Science states that there is no life, substance or intelligence in matter—a fact which even laboratory scientists know to be untrue as they realize that Energy or Force, which to us occultists is Spirit, is in all things, in every atom. There is no such thing as spirit and matter, but

all are the polarities of the One Substance—Spirit in the essence form, matter in its densest form."

Now in reality, is there much difference between these two ideas? Where does matter end and Spirit begin? Is all Spirit? Is there a point of contact between the two or are they One? Is matter but a vibration or degree of Spirit?

Recent findings of physical science lead man closer each day to a metaphysical understanding. Radio waves have advanced man almost to telepathy and electricity may be but the advanced material manifestation of the great angel El. Angelic thoughts of power in love, wisdom in understanding, are discovered in electrical beneficial contacts. Neither of these essences and forces can be used without wisdom and understanding. Yes, where does matter end and Spirit begin?

Now in our occult science we are agreed that God is All-in-All. All Power, all Science. Also as Divine Substance and Essence He is our Life. There is no other Life. He is All-in-All and this All-in-All is Spirit. Then where does matter commence, or is there any such thing as matter?

Hermes Trismegistus states that "The Mind of the Great Lord is the Most Mighty and Absolute Emperor" and he further states, "Holy is God Whose Will is Performed and accomplished by His Own Powers."

Have we not learned by experience that there is only One Power, One God. Then whence comes the existence of or power of matter, if such there be?

We find in "Of Election," Chapter 1, by Jacob Boehme:

"But there being nothing before God, therefore there is nothing that can move him to any thing; for if any thing did move him, then were that before and greater than Himself, and it would be that God was at odds and divided in Himself, and then also that must be movable from a Beginning, since it did move itself.

"But we tell you, in or according to the Saying of the Only ONE, that the Being, Essence or Substance of God, so far as he is called God, is understood to be without Ground, Place and Time, dwelling in himself, and not to be considered as in any several distinct Place, with a separated dwelling apart.

"But wilt thou know where God dwells, take away Nature and Creature, and then GOD is ALL; take away the outspoken formed Word, and then thou seest the Eternal speaking Word, which the Father speaks forth in the Son, and thou seest the hidden Wisdom of God.

"But thou wilt say, I cannot take away Nature and Creature from me; for if that were done, I should be nothing, therefore I must represent the Deity by an Image or Resemblance, because I see that there is in me Evil and Good, and so also, it is to be understood in the whole Creature.

"But hearken my Brother, God says in Moses, 'Thou shalt make thee no Image of my God, neither in Heaven nor upon the Earth, nor in the Water, nor in any thing,' to signify that He is no Image, nor wants any place to dwell in, neither should man seek for Him in any Place, but only in His formed outspoken or expressed Word, viz., in the Image of God, in MAN HIMSELF.

"As it is written, 'The Word is near Thee, viz., in thy mouth and heart'."

In our seeking for the answer to our question it seems that one point stands out clearly. God is not in man, for God is without Ground, Place or Time, therefore God must be man. Man must be the manifestation of God for God is his only Life. This would indicate that man is wholly Spiritual, of the Being, Substance and Essence of God, demonstrating and manifesting God according to his development in wisdom and understanding, as the flowers of the field manifest the colors of the rays of the Sun.

Note the beloved Boehme says, "Take away Nature and Creature, and then God is ALL." And we know if we pass away this moment that God is no longer expressed; there is no Life without God. Therefore Life must be Spirit. The so-called material body remains but there is no life, truth, intelligence nor substance in it. It is not any part of us then; it belongs to nature as it is only earth and water. There is no Power in that body; no Truth, no Goodness, no Beauty. Therefore can man be anything but Spiritual?

Now it is quite clear to the practiced student that a human body is refined by "That Mighty and Absolute Emperor," the Mind, when that Mind in understanding is The Mind of the Great Lord. Under the vibratory refinement of the Mind the body becomes light, so locomotion and levitation must be Spiritual. Love and Wisdom, says Swedenborg, determine the quality and color of the blood and they are Spiritual. And of what vibration is the heart and brain? The heart has no action and the brain does not function when Life, the Manifestation of Spirit, is no more. Then what have we left? We call it matter and some assert that Life and Intelligence are in matter.

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The Ethics of Natural Foods

HERE is a tendency on the part of I most political radicals and lovers of liberty to attribute world evils to an apparently unjust economic system. I quite agree that with the establishment of a saner social order, we would destroy many seemingly permanent sources of misery and hindrances to happiness. True-the organization of society is such that it awakens all evil tendencies. A favorable environment will develop, however little, the weak social instincts of man. But we must not attribute our present social unrest to political causes only. These, of course, influence the scheme of things. Man's struggle with his environment is a negative rather than a positive issue. The defeats or triumphs of his social institutions are really the redemption and vindication of his thoughts and motives. The far deeper causes for social disease are the outcome of the false course of life followed by the people due to materialism—an absence of lofty and noble spiritual thinking and plain living, causing a resultant artificial structure of society.

High thinking—the antidote of materialism-combined with the simple life, will ultimately place us more in sympathetic relation to the laws of nature and the laws which govern our being. Thus we obviate the need for the restoration of any violated equilibrium physically, mentally and morally in the universe. A great deal of evil today is due to dislodged or usurped vital vibratory energies, rendering natural law inharmoniously operative. We are creating by our ignorance, greed, selfishness and gluttony an atmosphere that is antagonistic to the universality of the law of harmony, and hence we call into play discordant vibratory currents. A purity and sobriety of heart and mind, fortified by a nobility of character must inevitably accrue to ourselves as virtues, when we learn to direct our base animal appetites and passions subservient to the commands of our higher mind and nobler soul.

In the selection of his food and in the control of his appetite, the individual passes a test of character more severe and critically unerring than if he stood before the most august body of judges. In his power to control his appetite, face to face with the numberless opportunities that every hour of the day prompt its gratification, requires more firmness of will and strength of character than many a temptation of vastly more formidable aspect. The character of the food deliberately chosen by an individual for his diet is directly or indirectly determined by his own character. The evolution of the mind must invariably be in advance of the evolution of diet. In other words, a mind controlled by a devouring, beastly gluttony responds to foods of a corresponding grossness.

At the emergence of more refined impulses in the mind, there ensues a dietary response in the form of the more hardy vegetables such as turnips, onions, carrots, cabbage, cauliflower, peas and beans. As the mind of man continues along the upward striving of culture, we notice among the coarser tubers, the finer leafy vegetables, such as lettuce, watercress, celery, parsley, etc. Fruit is the latest expression of nature in the evolution of foods, undeniably in response to the urge in the individual for a more refined diet. The mind began to feel the need for subtler nourishment to sustain the stirring yet feeble impulses towards a higher, more sympathetic life. In the fruit we have the finest form of nourishment which ingenuity as yet has caused to be evolved. Its high manifestation of electric and magnetic energies; its readiness to enter into the vital processes of physiological chemistry; its nutritive value united with ease of digestion, and its non-irritating roughage in just the essential and balanced proportions, give to fruit a dietetic value unparalleled in the scale of other natural foods.

Furthermore, the constantly increasing demand for fruit as part of the human dietary, with a subsequent increase in the quantity and quality of its output, indicates a general ascent of human life along all the various avenues of human expression. The advent of the reign of fruit in the realm of diet is significant. It stands as an answer to a demand for higher ideals and modes of life. Dietetic purity and balance can have a basis only in direct ratio to moral purity and balance. A persistent craving for a pure wholesome diet will arise within ourselves only proportionate to a mind whose own purity demands a corresponding purity of food.

Hence the exclusive diet on leafy vegetables and fruit for a man of gross passionate mind would involve the same difficulties in the combustion and distribution of heat and energy in his system, as the explosive heat generated by some swift combustible fuel like paper in a steam engine. In either case the inadequacy of the engine to adjust itself to the rapid heat evolution would render the use of such fuel not only impractical, but dangerous. A diet on fruit, which in a refined self-composed and idealistic nature would result in the most beneficial changes, might very

probably give rise to tissue starvation and progressive emaciation in an eccentric, passionate and ungovernable subject. A gross animal-disposed and animal-fed nature, if suddenly reduced to a diet of fruit and green-leafy vegetables, would very likely come to grief in his experiments and suffer physiological disturbances, because of the failure of his digestive functions to react normally on the high-tensioned discharge of the subtle polarization of fruit yielding a quick-burning fruit sugar, ready for immediate absorption into the blood stream. A slower means of combustion is more harmonious to a nature dissipating tremendous leakages of vital force through assorted forms of mental, moral, emotional and physical misconduct; and hence it constantly makes demands upon the organism for copious quantities of fuel more tardy in ignition to replenish a continuous and even violent diminution of energy. In one of his lectures the late Professor Huxley of Oxford, England, once made the statement that "the future of the world belongs to the vegetarian," because he undeniably visualized that our moral regeneration, side by side with our physical development, would ultimately evolve digestive and assimilating powers corresponding to a higher hygienic phase of diet.

It is a mistake to regard the moral side of human nature and physical nature as entities progressing through separate air-tight compartments. Mind and matter, form and idea, spirit and substance. in every ramification of life and consciousness, follow the same principles and orders of expression, are subject to the same laws of rise and fall, of growth and decay, of evolution and involution. Nature advances only to the extent man advances. Mentally, she responds to human thought and imagination with the same necessity as she physically responds to the seeds and nuclei of growth deposited in the soil. If the seed is degenerate, the resulting growth also becomes degenerate; while with no seed, nature will yield no response at all—a fact equally applicable to conditions pertaining to the culture of the mind. For man is at once the vilifier or degrader as well as the purifier of nature, according to the character of his motives; and hence he refines or elevates, purges and perfects -or debases-all matter or life, organic or inorganic, by his thoughts and motives. While he demoralizes the whole of nature and himself through the poison of his selfish emanations or vibrations, yet the case of humanity is not hopeless, for while evil defiles, altruism serves as the purifier or antidote.

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Instinct and Intuition in the Animal Mind

R ECENTLY I have been asked to define the following terms as used in an article appearing in The Occult Digest.

1st. What is instinct?

2nd. What is instinctual memory?

3rd. How account for the homing instinct in pigeons, over entirely new terrain concerning which the pigeon could have no memory?

4th. Will the idea of group soul intelligence explain instinct?

5th. Will the theory of group soul direction explain the migratory instinct in birds, and the homing instinct in the homing pigeon?

In attempting to answer these questions it must be acknowledged that the knowledge available at the present time concerning the functioning of intelligence in the human mind is much too limited to give anything like a positive answer, and that our knowledge of the functioning of intelligence in the animal mind is even more limited.

This lack of definite knowledge is very aptly illustrated by a professor of psychology-Dr. Fuller-and an authority on the subject, who makes the very frank statement that they - the psychologists-do not know what mind is, and that to give a comprehensive definition of intelligence is impossible. It appears to me, however, that there are some factors in what we are accustomed to call mind, that have not been given the consideration they deserve. I refer to the single cell and its relation to intelligence, consciousness, memory, etc. From what I have been able to gather from the reading of various treatises on cell life, it appears to me that the single cell is not only the unit of life, but the unit of intelligence and consciousness as well. It is the lowest and simplest form of animate organism, and it has been proved by many scientific experiments to possess both intelligence and consciousness. Consequently, it would appear that whether as a single cell, in groups of simple cells like some of the lower organisms or in more complex groups of cells-like some organ of a higher organism, like the liver for example—that these cells retain a measure of their individual intelligence, consciousness and independence of action. as well as having the same qualities interdependently with the other cells of the same mass or organ. Apparently this would also be true of the cell group -like the liver or kidneys-in relation to the consciousness and intelligence of the entire organism. Apparently it is in this cell consciousness and intelligence that we will have to look for the source of what we call instinct, and that in the single cell or group of

simple cells will be found the answer to many questions that perplex the scientist today.

Anything like a comprehensive definition of what we call instinct would be long and involved so I will try to illustrate my meaning by the use of several concrete examples and at the same time try to make my meaning clear as to what I mean by cell or instinctual memory.

The hunger urge, the sex urge, the digestion and assimilation of food, is purely instinctive. So is the urge of fish, seal and other sea mammals to return to the breeding grounds as the mating season approaches. These are primal instincts as is the instinct of the young of the mammalia to suckle: they know where and how to get their dinners. There are other instincts that are acquired such as the migratory instinct in birds and animals. There are many other acquired instincts. It has been demonstrated that if eggs in an incubator are talked to by the attendant who cares for them, that when the chicks are hatched they will know the voice of this attendant but not the voice of anyone else. There is one species of spider that weaves a very beautiful and intricate web. The peculiar part of this is that if the spider is interrupted in this process, it is compelled to go back to the beginning and start all over, each operation of the weaving when completed appears to release an impulse to take the next step. This appears to be a case in which cell or instinctual memory plays an important part: each part of the web when completed releasing a memory of what the next step is to be. This instinctual memory plays an important part in all acquired instincts, rising into consciousness as an urge to perform the action, whatever it may be.

The primal cell intelligence which we call instinct appears to have much to do with the building of the various organs that compose the bodies of the higher organisms, and it seems to be certain that cell memory plays an important part in this process. Of course there is much back of this that cannot be discussed within the limits of an article: there is much, very much, that we do not know. Von Hartman's excellent work, "UNCONSCIOUS MEM-ORY" (translated by Samuel Butler) gives much light on this subject. This book can be found in any good public library.

In the migratory instinct of birds and animals and the homing instinct of pigeons and bees, it undoubtedly is instinct that furnishes the motivating principle for their actions, but the directing or guiding influence in these migrations, and the manner in which the bee or the homing pigeon find their

way to the hive or cote, appears to be something entirely different.

Anyone who has observed the excited and noisy gatherings of black birds and of some other migratory birds, would certainly conclude that group intelligence had something to do with it. They might conclude that group Memory was the principle which enabled them to find their way to some given locality, and perhaps it really does have something to do with their sense of direction in some cases. Against this theory, however, is the recorded observations of the keepers of a lighthouse on the southeast coast of England. These keepers recorded the passing of a flight of starlings that were seven hours in passing, and these birds flew in a straight line, and at night. As one of them expressed it, "They flew in a straight line as though they were attached to a string somewhere up ahead, and were being pulled by it; they would not even swerve aside when the solid bulk of the lighthouse loomed ahead of them." They recorded that hundreds of them were killed by dashing against the stone wall of the lighthouse.

The theory of group soul intelligence will not account for the ability of the homing pigeon to find its way home over unfamiliar territory, or of the bee to find its way to the hive from a point outside its habitat any more than it will account for the storks mentioned in the clipping of the Chicago Examiner, in finding their way home to Poland from Palestine, after being carried in an airplane and released in the latter country.

It seems to be very evident that if a satisfactory answer to the question of how migratory animals, birds and fish find their way to where they want to go, it must be found in some other factor besides the foregoing. It is a fact familiar to all scientists that everything gives off or emits vibrations: rocks, trees, hills, mountains and everything else. It is also a known fact that many birds, fish and animals are much more sensitive to some vibrations of a high frequency than is the average human being. Everybody now-a-days is familiar with the directional radio beam used to guide airplanes to the landing field, and with radio broadcasting stations that radiate vibrations in all directions, and can be picked up by any radio within range. It is also a known fact that these vibrations-or very few of them at least-are not dissipated into outer space. They follow the curvature of the earth, and are confined to a more or less definite atmospheric strata. Furthermore it is known that they follow a straight line -laterally-for great distances.

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HOW I BEGAN TO PAINT

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MY FIRST steps in the world of painting came to me through the medium of a dream. A PSYCHIC EXPERIENCE

WHEN I was a boy about twelve years old I was sitting by the stove one cold winter night between my brother and my uncle, not two feet from either of them. They were talking about ghosts. My uncle believed in ghosts and my brother did not. I was inclined to believe as my uncle did. After they had argued for about an hour there came a knocking on the floor right between my feet, as loud as it would be if a man was driving a nail with a big, heavy hammer. To my surprise, when I asked about it, neither of them had heard it.

At about thirteen or fourteen I had a dream. In this dream my whole life was laid out before me, the way it would be if I took the right way and the way it would be if I took the wrong way. This was all shown to me by a man without him speaking a word. He made me understand without a wave of his hands or a move of his lips; all I can say is that he just made me understand - I can't explain how. I took up the right way of living according to his idea for a time; from then on I always dreamed of things that had any importance to them before they happened. I never told anyone about my dream or of my way of living, but I listened to people talk. I knew from what they said that they did not believe the way I did, so I would often tell myself that it must be wrong for nobody else believed that way. Still my dreams always came true.

Then came the dream of all dreams, the World War. I saw dead people and could smell them. I saw holes blown in the ground, old pieces of iron broken and twisted. I saw a lot of horrible sights and I knew something horrible was coming to the world, but people said the world was too civilized to go to war. This was ten years before the war broke out. War to me was murder and still is.

About this time we moved into a house that was built right on the ground and in this house I heard pounding on the floor, the same as I heard when I was with my brother and uncle; it would come quite often, nearly always close to my feet. It would hammer about as long as it would take to drive a nail; sometimes in a few minutes it would hammer again. Nothing or no one could get under the house, so don't say someone was playing a joke on me. Some years after this my brother and I were on a camping trip away up in the high mountains. I said to my brother, "This would be a good place to build a cabin where nobody could find it, for there is going to be a war and I don't want to go to war and kill people." Then I heard the first horrible words, "You are crazy; there is going to be no war." I dropped the subject at that time, but it

did not change my mind about the war. This was in July, 1913.

War is murder in the first degree if there be such a thing as a degree in murder. No Spiritualist that is a Spiritualist wants to commit murder. Now we have our choicecarry on war and bring civilization to a close or do away with war and let civilization bound ahead like it did before. A few years after the war was over I dreamed of being in a big iron cage; about this time I bought some Spiritualist books. I had never seen anything along this line before. I had long ago dropped the way of living that I had discovered in my dream, but these new books built for me a new world; they put a foundation under my dreams that could not be shaken down. I soon began to see visions and hear voices. This new world was so real to me that I thought I had a right to express myself. I began to tell people about it.

I wanted them to learn and be happy as it had made me happy but they opened their mouths and roared, "He has gone insane" and I was soon railroaded into an asylum for the insane by my own people (my people had some of my worldly goods in their possession). My wife who was a materialist was in another town for the winter. She was just as much against Spiritualism as my own people but she came to my rescue when she found she could not get any of my belongings which were in the hands of my people until I was free. So at the end of twenty-six days I was free on parole to my wife.

As soon as she got all the money I had I was dumped back in the asylum. This time it looked like I was there for life as I could not be freed by the State without being paroled to some person for a year and there was no one left to sign the parole but outsiders. I had friends but perhaps they would believe that I was insane. (For all the cry "they can't put you in an asylum unless you are insane"-but don't be too sure about that.) Anyway, no one could sign my parole without my wife's consent. I wrote to a friend; he came to see me but I found that my wife had poisoned his mind until there was no use talking to him; so you can see from a materialist's viewpoint I was doomed for life but I was not whipped yet. I went to work mentally. One day I saw a long strip of highway and I knew I was going over that highway to freedom. I then wrote a letter to a friend whom I had contacted with my concentration and from this I got good results.

This friend got my wife's consent to sign my parole and once again after five months of imprisonment I was free, this time for good for I was

paroled to honest people. All of this was the outcome of the big cage I dreamed about. One of the places where I was held was in every way the same as the big cage I had dreamed of.

This has caused me years of grief and financial loss and also loss to those who caused all this. It has done no one any good but has caused a lot of harm. No one can profit by being the cause of someone's loss. It may happen that they are getting the best of things at the time but they will have to look back from the spirit world at the things they have done in this world. There will be much grief in some cases; for that reason one should be careful what they do. Right here I want to point out a few things that might help the materialist to see things as they are. I hope they will at least give the Spiritualist the benefit of the doubt.

In the first place I have feelings like everyone else. I never have any trouble gaining the confidence of others. I feel good in every way and am very happy at all times. Of course I cannot say that it is a pleasant thought when I think of the way they treated me; just because they did not like the way I believed does not make me any different from other people. All I can say is that if I am insane I prefer to be insane.

We know that rock is solid; quicksilver comes next; you can run your hands through it and stir it like water. It stirs a little harder than water. Glass comes next; you can see through it; it is almost invisible. Water comes next; it is very thin. You can run your hands through it and see through it. Then comes air. You can feel it when it blows-you know there is such a thing as air but it is invisible. Now think! Couldn't there be other things that are invisible? What moves your body about and what keeps it from decay while moving about. Some would say Life or Intelligence and they are right but are we going to stop at that? It seems to have shape; at least you have feelings all over the body. It is too bad that man's head had to be full of marrow; it leads him to think that the whole man is in his head. The human body is a magnet; if it has animal magnetism, then it also has electric and spiritual magnetism, for the body is a three-fold body. If there be such a thing as magnetism, and there is, for it is a proven fact scientifically, then God is also the Father of MAGNET-ISM.

NOT only does Saturn, the planet of Capricorn, rule the grave, but it is when the Sun is in this earthy sign of Capricorn that it reaches its lowest point in the annual cycle, representative of the tomb. All three decanates, therefore, quite consistently, give some teaching in reference to the condition encountered after the stone has been rolled from the entrance of the tomb at the winter solstice and the soul has left its tenement of clay and passed to more congenial realms. While, therefore, the constellation picturing the middle decanate of the sign, where the Sun may be found each year from January 1 to January 10, represents a Dolphin, it is not surprising that in various lands it is also known as a coffin. Among nations familiar with the Bible it is more commonly referred to as Job's Coffin.

The Dolphin, which is the picture of the constellation in the sky is always represented as a beneficent sea dweller which performs good deeds and rescues from death those who are persecuted, especially those who are martyrs to some just cause. It is due to these legends and to the observation that those born when the Sun is in this decanate often take up some worthy cause and work ardently for it in spite of its unpopularity, that the key-word of the constellation is Martyrdom.

There are three Greek legends which give the outstanding teachings which the Dolphin was placed in the sky to reveal. One relates to the administration of strict justice in the after life; one pertains to the reunion of loved ones in that realm; and the other to the importance of harmonious thoughts as a means of attracting those who on the other side of life will assist the one who has passed from earth life to make a quick and satisfactory adjustment to the new conditions.

It is related that the famous poet Hesiod was slain and his assassins, in order to escape retribution, threw the body into the sea. They supposed this would be the end of the matter; but the Dolphins, who are the friends of poets and all who are benefactors to the human race, recovered the body and brought it to the shore, where it

was found by Hesiod's friends. These then gathered together, and using the poet's own dogs, trailed the murderers until they were captured; then threw them into the sea so that they should receive as punishment exactly the same kind of death they had caused the famous poet.

It is not always possible, in the after life, to make complete restitution to the person who has been wronged. But before much advancement can be made in that realm, injuries to others must be paid for, if not directly to them, at least by rendering some commensurate service to society. Unless we are willing to pay for our transgressions, their persistence as factors in our finer bodies weights us down, Saturn-like, so that we drop to lower vibratory spheres. As progress consists in moving to higher levels, and such movement is accomplished through refinement, these self-centered, destructive and therefore downward pulling vibrations must be sublimated into those which are constructive and uplifting.

Repentance, like most other activities, can be approached from either a negative or a positive direction. All make mistakes, all take actions which later they regret. Under these conditions the negative approach is to feel sad and despondent, to dwell on the effect of the mistake and to feel miserable because it was made. Yet this sackcloth and ashes method of repentance is disastrous to the individual, and because it unfits him for constructive work in the universal scheme, still further injures society. The discords he thus cultivates attract to him misfortunes, and these hamper him and make him less effective in that which he should do.

The true way of repentance, either here or hereafter is the positive approach in which the error is acknowledged, but is not dwelt upon in thought nor permitted to cause mental anguish. Instead, the individual recognizes he has injured someone, or retarded the progress of society. He therefore focuses his attention, desires and efforts on paying this debt to society through doing something for the individual injured, or at least for society, which

Viewing the food situation from its deeper aspects, the processes of ingestion, digestion, secretion and excretion become involved in the mysteries of alchemy-physiologically called metabolism-that cunning, mysterious and ingenious vital phenomena that readily converts the food ingested into the more complex human cell, blood, bones, lymph, heat and energy, etc. Thus the lower forms of life inherent in the foods ingested are fused with the higher and more intelligent human cells, and transmuted or sublimated, so to speak, to an accelerated vibratory activity, impressing or liberating the absorbed nutriment with the higher potencies of the human organism.

The gamut of physiological processes, namely the impress given to the food subsequently to become an intrinsic part of replenished bodily cells, are progressive or retrogressive, constructive or destructive, according to the purity, intelligence and power residing in our THOUGHTS AND MO-TIVES. For only the pure mind can give a sound and progressive direction to the activities of the body, while an impure, fitful, purposeless or selfish mind interferes with the normal rhythmic rates of vibration, prohibiting harmonious function of healthy cellular activity. Evil thoughts and words, fear, worry and anger-while eating or otherwise-condemn every atom of our body and retard the upward and onward evolutionary flight of the food partaken of, by infesting it with our destructive vibratory forces. This misapplication of natural law rebounds back to man-the thinkerwith an impact most destructive to his body, producing morbid instead of sound tissue change in the organism.

Vegetarians and Humanitarians who are cognizant of the unity of all life and their obligations to the sub-human or animal kingdom, must not consume natural foods selfishly by concerning themselves unduly with what benefits will accrue to themselves only by the adoption of a rational dietary. They must also help, by wholesome and lofty thoughts and motives to liberate, sublimate and elevate the foods ingested by uniting them with the ascending or more progressive manifestations of vital force resident in the normal human kingdom, and thus yield to the nutriment consumed energies more powerful, with more latent dynamics or potential force. Has it not come within the range of common experience that the adoption of a rational dietetic regimen has been powerless to sustain a cure, so long as the patient continues to acidulate his feelings? Thus food, which in the final end processes of metabolism, would have been potentially or actively alkaline, is rendered acid by our wrong thoughts and feelings. Equally and strikingly significant is the fact that this acidity is carried back to the mineral and vegetable kingdoms in renewed life cycles, thus reacting unfavorably on the whole

of nature. Humans breathe in oxygen and exhale carbon monoxide, which includes two atoms of oxygen to the molecule. Plants, including all vegetation and food-bearing trees, take up this gas from the air, which will support neither respiration nor combustion, decompose it by liberating the oxygen and retaining the carbon for the gradual building up of the plant. Thus we see the unceasing reciprocity in nature, the human kingdom impressing the vegetable kingdom with a purity or non-purity, resulting in either a normal growth or a degenerate yield.

Nature would be powerless, either for good or ill, were it not for the influence of mind over matter, exhibited in the relation of man to his environments. The living sapphire of the grape, the animated gold of the orange, the spirit of the ruby and emerald in the apple, coupled with their luscious exhilarating flavors-or on the other hand, the deadly poison of the hemlock, the venom of the snake, the deadly ferocity of the beast of prey, etc .constitute, one and all, the fateful but law-governed returns of human modes of consciousness, the rebound of dynamic thought, the progeny of the mind nursed and reared in the zone of motive, and projected by imagination as creative, fashioning impulses into the various kingdoms of nature, molding their character and tendency.

The progressive works of beauty and power in horticulture; the constant advance in grandeur and magnificence of the annual exhibitions of flowers, fruits and animals indicate the advance in grandeur of the human intellect, reflected in its influence on nature, its creatures and environments. The lily can unfold its symbolic purity; the rose its queen-like poise and swelling beauty; the pansy its sweet, pensive appeals; the chrysanthemum its lingering charms of grace and coloronly because the minds, active in the cultivation of these flowers have chosen the good, the true, the beautiful as inspiring and guiding motives. Nor would the apple, the pear, the orange, the grape, etc., ever have been able to reveal their treasures of palatable exuberance and nutritional force, had not man's ingenuity elicited them from their primitive types of small, bitter, valueless berries. There are biological records by which the inquirer is able to trace the career of the magnificent Belle-Fleur apple from the most insignificant beginnings in the Peruvian woodlands of South America. Similar origins are back of the French prune, the California fig, the Bartlett pear. Every step in the pathway of man's cultural endeavors-no matter how cluttered or roughshod the way -is at once a eulogy of the past and an incubation of greater potentialities in the future.

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

In January, 1933, it was my privilege to enter a class for trumpet demonstration. The work there was indeed commendable. Often one of the many aluminum trumpets would come slowly down from its position in mid air and rest softly across my hands. It was all performed in the dark; but no one can yell "fraud," for I have an answer of my own. No strings were attached to those trumpets in any way, for I could feel them from one end to the other all around as they slid back and forth through my fingers. Once I heard a voice say, "Hello, child," through the trumpet; and twice when I was unable to attend the class, members informed me one of the trumpets came to rest upon my empty chair and remained there throughout the evening. The medium conducting the work prophesied I would become a leader in Spiritualism, and the etheric forces wanted me to know it at that time.

It was in this class that I first felt a materialized hand upon my head. It did not startle me in the least. It was comforting. It was quite different from the feeling of a human hand placed upon one's head, for I could not feel it being placed there. I only gradually realized it was there after a time, then it faded away; but it seemed as heavy as a hand of flesh while there.

Then in March, 1933, came the much talked about earthquake of Southern California. Our connections with class and church were interrupted for some time, but we joined friends and held nightly seances in their automobile on top of a hill. In the city below the fire and ambulance sirens screamed away, making the tension too difficult for us to receive very much. However, the souls who came to us needed help, and we prayed for their progression.

They had been taken in the disaster, and many of them we had been well acquainted with on earth only a few days before.

At sixteen I entered the psychic unfoldment class of Reverend Mary-Emmons Pirtle of this city. The teachings received there were wonderful, emphasizing the philosophy of Spiritualism rather than the phenomena.

The lessons were taken down in shorthand by a stenographer in the group and passed out each week in complete form to members of the class. There were about sixteen of us in the beginners' group, and Reverend Pirtle conducted a more advanced class on another night. Thus there are many who have received these same beautiful teachings.

Our instructor from Spirit was Brother John, as we called him, who came through Reverend Pirtle as she was taken in trance. He had known but little earth life—eight hours—having gone to spirit that shortly after birth. He is a very high soul but is not an ancient teacher. His sister lives here in Long Beach and is a beautiful healer and trumpet medium.

Then most glorious to me was my adoption by Morning Sun, the healer, and thus my name: Mulna. Chief Morning Sun is the ancient East Indian sun worshipper who heals through the instrumentality of Reverend Pirtle. I love to hear him talk in his native tongue; but he can speak English, too, though brokenly. Morning Sun lived on a castle island over 700 years ago. He informed us the island is no longer in existence, having been buried by water now for more than 100 years.

Morning Sun promised to look after me throughout my life on earth, and he named me "Mulna," meaning "Little Sun" in East Indian. That is the name I have chosen to be known by in my writings and lectures throughout life.

This great soul always comes to me shedding a light as bright as the sun in the eastern sky could ever be. Often at night he soothes me to sleep, and in the mornings he awakens me with a bright ray across my bed. All of us who are in contact with Reverend Pirtle are constantly comforted by her dear Morning Sun. I have seen him many times, and he is indeed a remarkable sight: seven feet tall, dark skinned, white robed, strong, yet gentle.

In the same class I became acquainted with my spirit writer, Marguerita, who has inspired me in literary values since the age of twelve. She, too, is a beautiful soul. She lived in France years ago as a teacher of Truth. She is of Grecian parentage, born in early Greece; and from there she entered France. Her writings are illuminating. Sometimes I can scarcely see the page upon which I am directed with my pen because the brilliance there is so radiating, and she leaves me with a feeling of spiritual ecstasy. There I find a soul affiliation. Together we are planning to put our first book of verse on the market, and are succeeding beautifully in our plans.

To climax all of my past experiences I was healed by Spirit just a little more than a year ago. In October, 1936, I was involved in an accident where I fell from the running board of an automobile. It was my spirit friends who tried in vain to get me safely inside the car; for they could see ahead-I could not. But others in the physical whom I happened to be with obstructed my attempts to climb inside, and thus I fell and resulted with a badly fractured skull, a punctured ear drum, a broken blood vessel, and a partially fractured jaw. Physicians predicted I would be bedridden for six or seven weeks at the least because of my ear. Through the Spirit World. and my faith in God, I astonished physicians and was walking around, perfectly well, in four weeks' time.

This I have exemplified for you in order that you receive my testimony as to the healing powers that be. I am only one in millions who have experienced the same.

caused harm.

Another Greek legend narrates that Neptune was very much in love with the goddess Amphitrite and greatly desired to marry her. This goddess, however, had taken a vow of perpetual celibacy, and consequently refused his proposal. Neptune, after pursuing his courtship in vain, finally called to him the Dolphin and told him his difficulties. Acting as a mediator, the Dolphin succeeded in persuading the goddess to marry the sea-god, and as a reward was placed in the sky as one of the constellations.

Neptune in astrology is the octave expression of Venus, the planet of love. The love he rules is not the ordinary Venus type, but an expression which is devoid of the physical element; an ideal love which, rather than express in physical marriage turns to celibacy. Yet when those who thus love are able to sublimate their affections so that they express as a complete circuit of energy which flows between the two, blending completely their thoughts and feelings, as pictured by the ribbon binding the two fish which Neptune rules, they are more truly married, in the inner sense than those who enter merely physical matrimony.

Life in its various expressions tends to move from lower levels of expression to higher levels of expression. This is not merely true of the aims of action and the acquisition of ideas, but is equally true in emotional expression.

According to the findings of psychology, the normal love life passes through well defined evolutionary stages, moving from an expression which is suited to the infant's capacity to such heights and complexity as the individual is capable. These successive levels are now so well recognized that they each have been given definite names by which they commonly are recognized in psychological literature.

The infant's affectional interest quite naturally centers about himself. This level of the emotional life is called the Narcissus stage. As the infant develops there is a transference of his love from himself to a parent. This level is called the OEdipus stage. The third level is when the growing child transfers his affections from members of the family circle to some person of the same sex outside the family. This stage usually just precedes the change at the end of adolescence. The fourth transference, which normally occurs as the youth approaches maturity, is toward some member of the opposite sex. This stage is the level of marriage. The fifth transference should not be from husband or wife, but merely a widening of the affectional interests to include the children, which normally are now a part of the family.

Neptune, however, when its influence is powerful in the birth-chart, is never content with this fifth level, or state of

will be of as much benefit as he has affectional expression. Up to this point Venus has dominated the love life; but it is here, if progress is to continue, that Neptune exerts his power.

> The children grow up, marry, and have homes of their own. Thus the sixth level of expression of the love life expands the affectional interest to embrace humanity at large, and causes the individual to work as if he were responsible for its welfare. And if the proper transference is made, husband and wife are not less in love, but more so. Yet the physical aspect of union has been left behind and instead, an inner exchange of energies takes place. This is the regenerate union, which is excluded by physical union.

> Therefore, when the Dolphin persuades the goddess who has taken a vow of perpetual celibacy to unite with Neptune, it is indicated that after man has passed through the tomb he can rejoin his mate; but that unless he remains in the lower spheres of the astral world, his affectional expression will not be similar to physical marriage, but will be that complete blending of finer forces which is even more satisfying and which when accomplished on earth is termed regenerate marriage.

Is seems, according to still another Greek story, that Arion, the famous lyric poet and musician, who was a native of the island of Lesbos, went to Italy with Periander, tyrant of Corinth. There he attained both high honor and great riches through following his profession.

After making such a success, it was quite natural that he should desire to return to his old home for a visit and he embarked on a ship to make the journey. The sailors on the ship, learning of his wealth, determined to murder him and get possession of it. But just before they put him to death they granted him a last request; that he might play on his lute. The music attracted a number of Dolphins and as soon as he was sure these were present, Arion jumped from the vessel into the sea and one of the Dolphins immediately took him upon its back and carried him safely to land.

Paralleling this, there are those of the invisible world who, if we will but tune our thoughts to them will be ready to help us make the adjustment to the after death life. Those who die in terror, those who with no preparation meet sudden death and those who are unduly attached to physical things, often are difficult to help for some time after their passing.

The thought-forms built by their fear may be so strong that those whose duty it is to help them to realize that they are quite safe may be unable for some time to impress their consciousness. In sudden death, the person may not know he is dead and may resist the attempt to convince him of his true condition. Or if he is earth-bound he may refuse to move from the vicinity

That shell which we call body in itself has not even nature intelligence. We are told that the hair and nails continue to grow but that is only for a short time. It does not even respond to the warmth and generating influence of the Sun and planets. It has become red earth again.

Many will say, true, but can God be manifested without Nature or matter? And we must answer in the negative, for in this world kingdom Eternal Nature is the cause to manifestation. A positive cannot be explained without a negative. Light would not be distinguished without darkness and yet what is darkness? Electricity is not seen until it meets its ground or negative. God is not manifested without man yet there can be no man without God. Therefore how can there be more than One Being, Essence or Substance, and that Spiritual?

A few words here from Hermes Trismegistus may not be out of place, for in them we find the consubstantial union of Divine Mind and the so-called Mortal Mind. He states:

"For the Mind being God, Male and Female, Life and Light, brought forth by His word, another Mind, the Workman: Which being God of the Fire, and the Spirit, fashioned and formed seven other Governors, which in their Circles contain the Sensible World, whose government or disposition is called Fate or Destiny.

"Straightway leaped out, or exalted itself from the downward born Elements of God, the Word of God into the clean and pure workmanship of Nature, and was united to the Workman, Mind, for it was Consubstantial; and so the downward born Elements of Nature were left without Reason, that they might be the only Matter.

"But the Father of all things, the Mind, being Life and Light, brought forth man, like unto himself, whom he loved as his proper Birth, for he was all beauteous, having the Image of his Father."

We realize this question cannot be reasoned out and understood without a knowledge of all three kingdoms, which again are only one kingdom, but from these studies we can learn the source of the Idea that All is Spirit.

In the Christian Science version only one Principle or kingdom is considered which would be that of Jacob Boehme's Second Principle or of God's Light World. The kingdom of nature is not considered. And who will say that we as Spiritual Beings should consider any other but our Father's Kingdom in our Life manifestations? If it cures all

sickness and disease to hold in the Mind, in God, that he is the ONLY power, why delve into the Kingdom of Nature which even Jacob Boehme refers to as the Spirit of Error?

If as Jacob Boehme says, "Take away Nature and Creature and then God is All," why not have this attitude of Mind. After all do we learn from nature upward or do we learn from God downward? In other words, if man "fell" by his contact with Nature, why not remain Spiritual; why accept matter or nature as any part of our Spiritual World?

Jacob Boehme explains the Prima Materia or First Matter of Evil in his Three Principles. Note he says matter of evil. Matter is constantly referred to by the old scholars as being without reason, and evil; the spirit of error or the contrarium, a divisibility of the One. Now the question seems to be, can the absence or opposite of the One Principle be Spiritual or have Life, Intelligence or Substance? Quoting Boehme, we find:

"Indeed there is no difference in God, only when it is required from whence evil and good proceed, it is to be known what is the first and original fountain of anger and also of love, since they both proceed from one and the same original, out of one mother and are one thing. Thus must we speak after a creaturely manner as if it took a beginning, so that it may be understood.

"For it cannot be said that fire, bitterness or harshness is in God, much less that air, water and earth are in Him; only it is plain that all things have proceeded out of that Original. Neither can it be said that death, hellfire or sorrowfulness is in God, but it is known that these things have come out of that original. For God has made no devil out of Himself, but angels to live in joy to their comfort and rejoicing; yet it is seen that devils came to be and that they came to be God's enemies. Therefore the source or fountain of the cause must be sought, viz., what is the Prima Materia, or First Matter of Evil and in the Originality of God as well as in the creatures, for it is but all one thing in the Origin; All is out of God, made out of His Essence (being or Substance) according to the Trinity, as he is one in Essence and threefold in per-

velous dream put the necessary spurs to my ambition. Sleep had now flown to be supplanted by a seething flock of thoughts. What should I do? How could I paint? When could I find time? One needed money, a studio, paints, time for such a pursuit. The longer I reflected upon the seeming impossibility of realizing my dream the more poignant did my sorrow become. But solace stepped in with the morning sun in the shape of a strong vibrant thought. "All things spring from the center of the Self," something seemed to whisper to my weary mind. "I must have firm belief in myself," I answered this secret whispering. "I must experiment and find out what latent forces dwell in me," I went on arguing stubbornly. "The wherewithal will come. It will surely come," said my optimistic self. Vague murmurs of my soul urged me on, egged me to do that which I yearned to do. It was thus that later in the day I went out to gamble with my hardearned skimpy savings. My footsteps took me to the nearest art-store where I reveled in the thought of possessing the whole shop while I conscientiously selected the lowest-priced material. Armed with these treasures I hastened back to my one-room home and locked myself away from the world. Then I began to paint!

In frantic haste I painted, sketching as I went along the pictures that came my way in their steady passage before my mind. They were not, however, in any way connected with animals nor any of the scenes witnessed in my recent dream. Painting pictures of animals had never had any attraction for me. Upon closer reflection, the animal paintings of my dream were no doubt symbolic in nature. Urged by an unseen force, I now depicted the most wonderful castles poised on islands. Doubtless this urge might find its explanation in atavism, since castles were a part of my ancestry and even exist to this day for prospective heirs to fight over. But at that time I was oblivious to all around me, dead to the material world, save the contact with the material which helped produce my sketches. I was submerged in ecstatic creation. The fact that I was actually producing something which my own eye could recognize as fairly passable and that, in particular, I was forcing my brush to bring forth colors which thrilled my soul, sufficed to make me forget the world. At last my fund of motives seemed to recede and my craving having been gratified for the time being I set myself to enjoy

the rapture of gazing upon my own creations. There were dozens at my disposal, reminding me somewhat of the plentifulness of pictures in my dream. I never could have dreamed, however, that such a wealth of unbuilt and unsketched castle-complex ever dwelt within my world of imagination. But crude as they were, at the time, no doubt they produced in me an indefinable sublimity of emotion. This was, I suppose, in consequence of the unburdening of a psychic weight. It led, however, to other things of greater importance to me as has become evident in later years. This was my first day's experience in the art of painting, with my inner Self as an invisible instructor. Most unfortunately, I destroyed all my castles as soon as I had made some progress in the world of art. Psychologically, if for no other reason, they would have been of interest. But more were to follow and of even greater interest!

Gradually I came to appreciate the value of the nightly meditation in connection with my painting. Let me say here that by meditation I mean the definite concentration on some given thought or problem to which solution is sought, the concentration being accompanied by certain words just as if in the act of repeating a prayer. It became a habit with me to meditate just before falling asleep-silently or out loud if conditions permitted the latter. I would take some certain problem in connection with life that puzzled me. I would then repeat certain words or sentences over and over again in connection with this problem. would direct this petition to the universal forces or to the Spirit of some planet, or to the Christ principle in my heart. It would all depend upon the knowledge I was seeking. I found that as a result my dream-world became definitely and clearly instructive. It especially appeared to bring me into contact with these same three whiterobed figures during the first year of my painting experimentation. I became firmly convinced that I was going to paint fearlessly, regardless of what the world might say, these three ancient men vanished forever, much to my regret. I have not had the pleasure of meeting them for the past twelve years, although I have contacted other beings who have been helpfully instructive in the dream world and which instruction I invariably find in my waking state to be applicable in some direction or other.

In view of the foregoing it appears to me that if a community or district having more or less clearly defined natural boundaries gives off a distinctive vibration-a composite of all the vibrations radiated in the district—that these vibrations might set up in the bird or animal familiar with that district something like an urge to go in the direction from which this vibration emanated. I have never known of such a theory being advocated, nor have I ever heard of any experiments along this line, but it would account for the ability of the pigeon to find its way home over unfamiliar terrain to its familiar cote, and for the storks before mentioned to find their way from Palestine to Poland. They would only have to act on the urge set up by the vibration, to follow the radio beam to its source.

This hypothesis seems to be verified in a measure by experiments with bees of which I read recently. Several bees (twenty I believe) were placed in a sack and taken some miles beyond their usual range and released. If I remember correctly, about eighty per cent of them found their way home. Another batch of equal number were then placed in a sack, taken an equal distance from home, whirled around and around a number of times and then released. Of this second batch only a small number -about eight per cent-found their way home, and then only after considerable time had elapsed. It would appear that whirling them around for a time before releasing them had destroyed their sensitiveness to the vibrations from the home colony so that they were unable to orient themselves sufficiently to find their way home. All these bees were marked (I have forgotten how) so that the gentleman making the experiment could hardly have been mistaken.

The swallows of the old mission of San Juan Capastrano here in California, introduce another complication into the problem. These swallows nest habitually in the old mission. Every fall they leave for some place, the location of which is not known. The peculiar part of it is that they leave on the same day of the month every year and return on the same day of the month in the spring. This phenomena has been observed and recorded by the Padres of the old mission for fiftyseven years. Evidently these swallows are in some manner able to reckon time far more accurately than are human beings without the aid of a calendar, and it is difficult to account for this by any theory of animal intelligence so far advanced.

This vibration theory is founded on known facts, but it does not give a complete answer to the question of how birds and animals find their way over great distances. There is the salmon for example that are spawned in fresh water, generally in a small stream far inland. At an early age they go out to the open sea, and they do not return to spawn until maturity, at four years of age. Yet it has been demonstrated that they return to the very stream in which they were spawned, and that stream could hardly set up a vibration in which there was anything familiar enough to induce them to return to it. To attempt to formulate an answer to this problem is to open a wide field for speculation and conjecture; but there must be an answer somewhere. if it can be found, and we will seek this answer in an extension of the vibration idea.

As nearly as science has yet been able to determine, all matter is resolvable into electrones and protones; negative and positive charges of electricity. That is an atom, which composes all matter composed of one positive

charge of electricity, or protone, and of a varying number of negative charges, or electrones. The number of electrones in an atom determine its character: that is, what material it is, and every atom of different kinds of material have a distinct vibration: a different frequency or rate of vibration. This is true not only in regard to the earth, but throughout the entire universe as well as has been determined by means of spectrum analysis. This would make it appear that the universe is, primarily, electricity or something very nearly akin to it. In other words, the universe is vibration since electricity is practically pure vibration. This is a physical fact, in so far as present day science has been able to determine. Vibrations, then, appear to be not only Cosmic force, but Cosmic substance also; they are the reality, while the material is the shadow. If this be the case, then it is easy to understand that these vibrations must contain everything in the universe, potentially, including all knowledge and all consciousness: most certainly they would contain directional vibrations of some sort. I do not mean by this that these vibrations would be individual for every bird, beast or man, Cosmic vibrations are universal, not individual. What I do mean is that there would be some kind of directional vibration that the individual bird or animal could, in some manner, interpret and use for its own individual needs.

This hypothesis may appear far fetched, and possibly it is. It is difficult to see, however, how some actions of birds and animals can be accounted for in any other manner. Moreover, this theory of vibratory influence, whether it be terrestial or Cosmic, on this type of animal action brings such action definitely within the same category as that of what, in the human consciousness, we are accustomed to call *intuition*.

of the earth to a more congenial environment.

Commonly the individual after leaving the physical body falls asleep. This may be a long sleep as in the case of an earth-bound soul, or it may be but a moment's lapse of consciousness. But during it the individual moves in his astral form to the level and place where his new birth takes place. This is not the environment where later he will find himself, but a transitional region. It is here he awakens into a knowledge that he has entered a new life.

The newly arrived persons are thus permitted to grow accustomed to the new condition gradually, before each grav-
