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PSYCHIC UNFOLDMENT

In every issue of this magazine there will be published one of a series of lessons that will help those interested in Spiritualist Mediumship to unfold Psychic Powers, to understand the Philosophy of Spiritualism, and to learn the Mysteries of God.

To every Pupil beginning the study of Psychic Unfoldment:

Beloved Student:

These instructions are given to you because you are seeking the way to soul illumination and the Powers of God. Be Faithful in Heart, Search for the Laws of Life, with which knowledge you may acquire a life of Peace. Health, Wisdom and Love.

Enter into the study of Psychic Unfoldment with the feeling of earnestness and Faithful effort. Keep the thought in mind that immortality is the greatest of Life's Questions, and therefore give all Studies pertaining to Immortality the most important place in your consciousness.

All these instructions should be sacred to the student, and are destined to be a light on the path of Progression into a life of Eternal Happiness. Many Revelations will be unfolded unto you, but keep them as treasures to be guarded, for there is danger in "casting pearls before swine."

Ponder much over every lesson. Keep silent as to the Revelations that will come to you. Love Humanity, and your soul will unfold to miraculous powers, and you shall understand the Laws of God, which are natural laws.

LESSON 1.

If it is possible, have a separate room in your home where you may study without interference of other people, noise, or anything that would distract your attention.

This room should be regarded as Holy, for angels will be attracted there to help you. This is your Seance Room. It corresponds to the "Sanctus Sancti" or Holy of Holies of the ancient mystics. An inner room of the temple for the High Priests to enter to meditate on Spiritual things. The ancient Mystics used to have a room separate from other rooms to perform their rituals, where they assembled to commune with the forces of God.

The Seance room should be well ventilated, furnished to suit the student's taste, but with a small table in the center of the room. Have a candle burning on the table or a dim electric light burning in the room. Place a piece of paper and a pencil upon the table. Obtain a straightbacked chair to sit in beside the table.

If you do not have a separate room, select a quiet corner of any room in which you can concentrate without interference. You may sit alone or with some one else, as you choose; or even a group of people who would be as much interested in spirit manifestations as you are.

Select a certain hour in the day, (preferably in the evening) during which you may sit for unfoldment. Also select a certain day or days in the week, at which hour you may study uninterrupted. Let nothing keep you from sitting at the regular hour and appointed day or days. Regularity, order and rhythm are essential for rapid progress. It is the occurence of irregularity, disorder and discord in the world and Universe that result in catastrophes, wars. storms, etc.

Spiritualist mediumship is a quality of the soul and mind. Sex, age, size, race or creed have nothing to do with the unfoldment of mediumship. It occurs in all types of people, in various nations, climates and ages.

Seat yourself by the table, relax, sit with spine erect, feet flat on the floor, and hands palm downward on your knees or in a relaxed position. Think of your loved ones and friends who have passed the change of Death.

Do not doubt that the Spirit forces Forget your troubles and worries. will come to you and manifest. The attitude of the mind and body have a great deal to do with the unfoldment of the receptive Power of the Soul.

It is the mind that creates prejudice, not the soul.

If you care to sit in the dark, make the room completely dark, so that not a crack of light may enter from any source. It would be advisable to sit quite often in the dark, three or four nights a month, because darkness is negative and passive, which tends to make one receptive to Spiritual influences, while the light is positive and active, and one's attention is often attracted towards the many objects in the room. Another reason why it is advisable to sit in pitch-darkness is that when you see a light or luminous vapor or form appear in the darkness, you will know that it does not come from the outside. When you see a light in the darkness know that it comes from a separate entity from yourself, because your eyes do not have the capability of creating light in the dark.

As you sit, you will perhaps notice small lights of various colors about the size of a common pin-head or larger; you may notice floating forms of a vaporous appearance come in front of you, then disappear. These may appear more distinct later and

produce etherial forms of your loved ones, who have passed the change of Death.

You may feel cool breezes over you or extreme warm currents of air around you, or you may feel a sensation like a hand touch your face or hands or some other part of your body. These may be Spirits trying to attract your attention. A voice may speak or whisper to your mental ear, or a vision may appear to your mental eye, but do not be alarmed. Excitement causes disturbance in the Spiritual vibrations of those near you and they will leave. Fear and doubt also creates "static" in the contact of the spiritual vibrations.

It is said that a good sign of Mediumistic ability is to have a feeling like a cobweb pass over the face or hands. Raps or tappings may occur in the room. Strange feelings may come to you at first, or peculiar impressions, but realize that there is nothing to fear and that your loved ones and guides from the other side of life that have been attracted to you are protecting you and are trying to help you to sense their presence.

If you ever have the feeling to quit sitting for unfoldment before your hour is up, do so.

If you feel as though you should write down the various experiences or what you see or hear, jot them down on the paper lying in front of you.

Patience is necessary—do not expect to receive too much at the first few sittings. Sometimes it takes a long time to tune in to the broadcasting station of Spirit Power.

God gives everyone a talent or power to use in this life and it is up to every individual as his or her own duty to find it, unfold it, and use it to the best of his or her ability for the benefit of human progress. Bible Reading: 1 Corinthians— Chapter 12, verses 1-11.

- Psychic An individual whose mind and soul is perceptive or sensitive to the minds and souls of other individuals, whether in the body or out of the body—One whose intuition is developed in a very sensitive degree—Mediumistic.
- Medium—One who possesses the faculty of communicating with the Spirit World—One who can perceive Spirits and convey their messages to mortals—A Sensitive.
- Seance—A meeting of Spiritualists to evoke Spirit phenomena; a select scientific gathering.
- Meditate—To think in a passive, receptive mood—To ponder.
- Concentrate—To think of one thing or idea in an attentive mood, with the exclusion of everything else from the mind, without allowing wandering thoughts to creep in.
- 6. Mystic One who can aspire through the inward perception of the mind; a direct intercourse with God or the Forces of God; An Occult minded person—One who believes in Immortality of the Soul.
- Spirit—The soul—the intelligent, immortal part of man—Life. (The Spirit, sometimes is used meaning Cosmic Mind of God.)
