TO OUR READERS.

With this issue of the Bulletin begins a series of special feature numbers such as we never had before. The various interests connected with the University are gradually growing to an extent that such special numbers seem necessary because needed by the members who have as yet no own organ for their organizations. We begin with the Universal Theomonistic Association Number. Most of the members of this Association are members of the University, and, no doubt, will be delighted to have the Bulletin' give more detailed information. Members of the University and others who have not yet become members of this Association, are cordially invited to join at once. The small fee of 50 cents for a life-membership card will make this easy. In this connection, we wish to say that we are greatly hampered by lack of funds, but that if all members of the University and of the Association at once sent their subscription of only 35 cents for the Bulletin, and try to get also others to subscribe, it would not be necessary, as it is now, to pay the larger part of cost of printing and mailing the Bulletin out of the all too small General Expense Fund of the University, which is needed to defray many other expenses.

The Bulletin has already brought an article about the Theomonistic Association, in March, of this year; Theomonistic Socialism has been described in the Tenth Anniversary Number, this year (12c), and the International Declaration of Independence, in the same issue, referred also to this Association. The September issue, this year, gave some information about the transactions of this Association of its annual meeting. Theologians and others interested in Theomonism should order "Theomonistic Theology," by H. P. Holler, published 1907, price 30 cents. Economic questions are answered by the same writer's outline of "Economics," in the Oriental University Educator, No. 1, 30 cents. The information on Theomonism contained in the present special number embodies a part of the surprisingly great results of Prof. H. P. Holler's psychological laboratory experiments in graphic arts of spirits, announced already in the September issue. So great has been the result that Prof. Holler has already a whole volume of symbols and writings in the newly revealed spirit alphabet, much more than can be given in this issue of the Bulletin, although we extend this special number over several ordinary sizes of the Bulletin. Our only regret is that the lack of funds forbids it to bring reproductions of most curious symbols and writings, as well as of spirit photographs obtained, the latest photograph being that of Xebela (Tobias, or the Prodigal Redeemed), and Prophet Amos, who both lived before the Christian era. For this picture our friend, Mr. Saleeby, from Syria, was the sitter. A picture formerly obtained, with Prof. Holler as sitter, is that of Abraham, of the Old Testament, who is doing much to inspire Prof. Holler. The pictures of Jesus in possession of Prof. Holler were obtained by Dr. Hansmann, the famous investigator and experimenter in spirit photography, who is the sitter. We regret also that we cannot bring details about another phase of Theomonism, that of healing by spirits, a strong band of famous physicians and surgeons now in spirit land, performing wonderful healings every Wednesday evening, when Prof. Holler is enabled by the spiritual X-ray to look into the bodies of patients and detect the defects as well as observe the mode of healing by the spirits. All that is in the way of giving full publicity to all these most interesting, and from a scientific and utilitarian standpoint most valuable, evidences is the lack of money. Why cannot or will not some people benefit mankind and make large donations for this purpose? Many smaller donations would serve the same purpose.

A word to the "wise" ignoramus and the scoffing agnostics, as well as to slow ecclesiastics: Judge not what you do not understand, and avoid any attempt at placing yourself in an awkward position of explaining away facts; for you won't be able to disprove them! Why not benefit by them?

FIRST BOOK.

Based on Newly Written Spirit Messages Received from Jesus, Raphael, Xebela, King David, Enoch, Daniel, Abraham, Jacob, Elizabeth, and a number of more modern saintly spirits, since July 7, 1913, and arranged and brought into rhythmic form by Helmuth P. Holler.

Introduction.

- These are the new revelations, as true and as sure as the old ones, Given by spirits of heaven who gathered to open the way. This is the day of salvation, the day when the heavens are opened: Angels descend to the mortals to clothe them in spiritual array.
- Errors abound in the churches and meetings of higher pretensions, Those of a low Spiritualism have never received all this light. Many, however, are searching for truth which the angels proclaim now-Dark are the lies of the low ones; we angels from heaven are bright.
- Spirits in darkness and errors are ever confused and in falsehood; We of the kingdom of heaven are one in the truth from on High. Those of the netherworld hate you. But we of the heavens all love you, Wishing to help to prepare you. On what we are saying rely!

Chapter I. Creation.

- Once there was nothing but spirit, without any outward expression; Positive though was this power, a substance still void of all forms. Time was not measured by periods, eternity waited for motion Till there came gradual distinction, and names were created by norms.
- Mind has created all matter, but matter increased also mind-force. Aeons and aeons were passing till spheres of the heavens were known. Suns with their planets evolving, each sphere got its own special kingdoms: Minerals and plants were the first ones, and animals, too, were shown.

- 2. He will not come like a mortal; he's coming with spiritual powers:

 Men shall now work with God's spirits, the guidance of heaven shall be giv'n;

Churches without any spirit shall have all their power now broken; Movements against this our teaching shall soon from arenas be driv'n.

- 3. Hosts of great angels are working that justice and help may be granted.

 Those who are poor shall be aided and cheered who are now in dismay.
 This is the message of gladness, foretold by the angels to shepherds.

 Great was the joy of those shepherds: far greater be yours now to-day!
- 4. Many great truths shall be told you and hosts of great forces shall aid you,
 If you but watch for progression with patience, and love, and with hope.
 Dark is the day of deniers and cheerless the life of the godless;
 Those who are listening to satans forever in darkness must grope.
- 5. Many there are who are trying, like "Adam," to mount up to heaven, Leaving obedience and guidance: by follies of sin are they slain. Oh, do not think that it's easy when reading the Spiritualist writings. "Try every spirit, Beloved," said John, and now says it again.

Chapter IV. Eloah, Elohim, and Jehovah.

- Listen! We give you an outline of what may be known, for your guidance.
 Place every message besides it, and see whether truth or a lie.
 One is the Cause of Creation, we call Him "Omnipotent Father":
 Personal God, in the Center, a Father and Mother on High.

- 5. Mind is the center—quite amazing—and spirit from God makes a person;
 Forces and forms without spirit endure not forever in Him.
 Animals, too, are His creatures, and plants, like the rocks, which are living,
 Take all their life from ELOAH, but life that is darksom and dim.

Chapter V. Souls and Soul-Mates.

- Oh, what a scattering of life-force when people cohabit with others!
 Long, empty years are to follow, till finally union is found.
 All in God's mighty creation depends on such polar attraction:
 GOD and the Gods and the angels are soul-mates of spiritual compound.
- 4. Twain are the minds and the bodies—for spirits, like you, have their bodies
 —One is the power and purpose, one love all their own: two in one.
 Woe unto them who deride this; the truth is a sword that will cut them,
 For, of the worldlings and lustful quite happily married is none.
- 5. Pray that your bride or your bride-groom be chosen by God; like Tobias
 Found once his wife through an angel who guided him wisely to her.
 Are you here married, not mated, remain as you are, and be faithful
 Until the gates will be opened and you get a better transfer.

Chapter VI. Avolution by Aid of the Higher.

- 1. One is the world in its Maker, and one is the goal of all beings;
 Yet are there powers contending: the evil must ever be downed.
 Nothing is perfect, completed, even God is evolving in working.
 Two are the tendencies found yet; the better forever is crowned.
- 2. Sin, which is evil, once started when one of the creatures degraded,
 Taking his freedom (of growing) for license to choose only rest.
 God knew the dangers, His warning was ever a blessing to creatures;
 Heeding not what was forbidden, that creature forgot what was best.
- 3. Life is forever endangered, for life is a growth out of darkness; Unless the growing is upward, perfection of life won't appear. God knows perfection and gives it. His power can be had for the asking. Why, then, O soul, be so stubborn, and why not His warning thou hear?

Chapter VIII. Life and Its Responsibilities.

- 3. None of the Christlike are happy without any work for progression What in their faith they are able to take of the power from God. Here on this Earth all your likings will join you to heaven or hell sprites; Here is the time for decision. You reach on the ways you have trod.
- 4. Tremble ye lustful and greedy, ye scoffing and doubting great idlers!

 Great is the value of Earth-life, and great are your needs for reform.

 Spirits are listening to ravings, to prayers, to words, see your doings,

 Thoughts are not hidden from many: if evil, they act like a storm.
- 5. Marks, too, are left by each impulse, for these are the growth of your wishes.

 Loosen thyself from thy self-love and fasten to God, who is All.

 Life is a serious matter: the strong one gets aid from the stronger;

 He who is weak and is careless is dragged by like weaklings to fall.

Chapter IX. Guidance Better Than Creeds.

- Creeds are like crutches for weaklings. Endeavor to do soon without them.
 Pray without ceasing for guidance, and God will shed light and give force.
 - Link all your work to the angels. Their bands will surround and will aid you.

- 4. Strength is alone in great union, and union is heavenly, combining.'

 Going the ways of the worldling, with weariness you must plod.

 Why ever disjoin the forces, and why do you think that an atom

 Lives without force from the Life-Source, and matter can live without

 God?
- 5. Many of you are misguided by spirits of low mental power
 Working upon your emotions, while others impinge on your mind:
 Some, too, will instigate actions and drive you to deeds without reason:
 Spirits thus sooner or later the godless in fetters will bind.
- 6. He who is pure need not fear them, the children of God are protected.

 Evil attracts evil spirits, the good draws the angels of light.

 See that thy life be of goodness and truth be the aim of thy longing,

 Then wilt thou grow in God's favor; thy dwelling will then be bright.

Chapter X. Prayer a Current of Force.

Chapter XII. The New Dispensation.

- Woe unto pharisees, priestcraft! The little you have will be taken.
 Now, without popes, without church rule, the truth of the Kingdom shall come.

- 5. Once there was fear, when no savior had opened the way into heaven. Now there is comfort and blessing, since Jesus is coming again. Once there were leaders, half blind still, but now there are seers of heaven. Jesus is coming with power: the hosts from on high in his train.
- 6. Once there was death and destruction because of the errors abounding,
 Now there is life and redemption because of the truth we reveal.

Chapter XIV. Union and Protection in God.

- 3. God keeps His children quite safely without any outward protection; Those who rely on His shelter are shielded against any harm. Fear any outward pretension! And fear any pride in the formal! Strongest is he who is godly because he is held in God's arm.
- 4. Fear not that ye are forsaken: the hosts of God's angels are near you. Millions of faithless can't help you. One man with his God is at rest. Outward, some troubles may linger, the soul is at peace with its Maker. Soon will the things that are needed be given, and no foe shall molest.

THEOMONISTIC HYMNS

NOTE.—Reading of passages from the Scriptures touching on points mentioned in the Theomonistic Bible, and explained by the latter, and any other passages of a spiritualistic and really helpful nature, songs in character like the Theomonistic hymns below, and prayers for which the Lord's Prayer is the best model, as well as Theomonistic expositions and inspirational lectures, if inspired by spirits in the higher heaven spheres, are essential in Theomonistic circles, societies or churches. But the meetings are not to be devotional only, but shall embrace circles for psychic development, individual message-giving by true Theomonistic mediums, seances for healing by spirit healers, and for assisting the spirits in the netherworld. To defray expenses, members should be requested, but not compelled, to make regular monthly contributions, large or small, and collections may be made at public meetings, so that also strangers may contribute something. Ministers should serve the whole society, and should not give private "readings" for fees; for the curse of modern Spiritualism is the commercial medium who has degenerated into a fortune-teller who is occasionally endangered to fake, to satisfy those who paid and expect impossible things.

ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS BY BAPTISM.

Those who have been baptized in some Christian church are not to be baptized again, except they specially desire it. Infants are to be baptized only if the parents are Theomonists. Adults should express their accord with the main principles of Theomonism before baptized or admitted as members to Theomonistic societies or churches. Jesus has given us for our Church the symbol of footwashing, with the wish: "Help your neighbor." Footwashing and Baptism are, therefore, one with us. When receiving new members, it does not make any difference whether water is poured upon the head, the hands, or the feet; climate and custom must decide. Sometimes it may be better to pour water upon the hands than upon the head, and only in the tropical climate is the pouring upon naked feet advisable.

7. GOD'S HEALING THROUGH SPIRIT HEALERS.

Let the clairvoyant minister or helper arrange with spirit healers, former physicians and surgeons preferable, from the heaven spheres, to come on certain days, say Wednesday nights, to perform healing in the dark cabinet, when the patients surround a small round table on which they lightly put their hands, the right upon the left of the neighbor, not touching own second hand, when answers will be given by the spirits by tipping the table once for "no" and thrice for "yes," etc. They will tip to and hold it near the special patient to be treated, and the clairvoyant will be enabled by a spiritual X-ray to look into the body, diagnosing the alment and seeing how the healing is performed. As a rule, it will take from 6 to 20 treatments to cure serious and chronic cases; but the cure will be perfect, if the patient is not too old, and if treatment is taken regularly, once a week. Faith in God's power enabling the spirits is most helpful.

EXTRACTS FROM MESSAGES IN WRITING FROM HEAVEN TO H. P. HOLLER. From JEHOVAH, October 11, 1913.

Gave symbol of His name and the message: "We (i. e., Jehovah and His Soul-Mate) have examined your work, and find you prepared for the coming work to build a spiritual house, a gift of the Highest One."

From Jesus, the Mediator, October 10, 1913.

"I was the first man on Earth, 200,000 years ago, to receive the spirit of God. When such spirit is first given the creatures are to make a decision. We, I and my soul-friend, decided to go our way. But I have come again into the flesh and my work is both a redemption and an example to you. My soul-friend is now on Earth in the flesh, and she walks in the ways of God, preparing the way for my coming again, not in the flesh again, but in the spirit. We (angels) are making great efforts for justice on Earth and the aid to the poor. We try to save all, also those who are in the nethermost hell. The name "Theomonism" is entirely acceptable to us: we shall build the Kingdom of God. The visions of Lia Phail (see "The Kalpaka," Aug., 1913, publ. by Latent Light Culture, Tinnevelly, India), refer to Theomonism and my coming again. The power of the Catholic Church will be broken. Baha-u-llah is not the great manifestation of God. There are three divisions of the netherworld: the Bottomless Pit on the Sun, the World of Sin on Sat-

urn, and the Earthbound. Salvation is possible for all. The Millenium means the condition and time when the hostile power is bound, and this will begin when Xebela has prepared everything. Xebela is the Prodigal of my parable and Tobias of the book, as has been told you. Sin originated with the first disobedience of a creature. There are creations, like on Mars, where the people are specially developed and need no savior. There are other planets besides the Earth and Mars where souls enter material bodies, but they are not known to you. The great cataclysm, a change of Earth-axis, is not yet coming."

FROM RAPHAEL, WHO STANDS BEFORE GOD, OCTOBER 8-10, 1913.

He came with 120 angel attendants and stayed with us several days, to prepare us. "The Omnipotent God, the Creator of All, is a person in the center of the Universe. Jehovah, one of the Elohim, guides this solar system of ours. He is also a person. From Eloah, the God of the Universe, proceeded also the material world in ever increasing force. (Note—The German word "Ebengestalten" given by him indicates that growth of mind accompanied the growth of the material). There are other solar systems besides ours, and each one is guided by its own God. To distinguish the God of the Universe, we address him as "Omnipotence." Prayers are heard from stations, as far as they reach. It would seem that there are saviors on some of the other stars, but some creations do not need any savior: where the first decision has been toward the good.

FROM PHILIPPUS, ONE OF THE 70 DISCIPLES OF CHRIST, SEPT. 26-OCT. 4, 1913.

He came from the 30th sphere and said that he passed out 39 years after Christ. "Seek first the Kingdom of God, then all other things shall be added unto you. Like Jesus, we are obedient, in love, and we wait for the Omnipotence, God. We are preparing everything and Xebela will be in continual charge of this. Force will be so much united in you that you yourself become a helper to others. There will be so much united in you that you yourself become a helper to others. is such a great force around your work that no enemy can destroy it. A cover of the Higher Power overshadows you. Days of work approach now when the powers are united to fulfil the will of God. In struggle it began, in glory it shall end. Nearly all roads have now been straightened. Jesus, staying in the 43rd sphere of heaven, is the Door to the Father. Enoch is the only Metatron (protector against evil influences and powers), he stays where his work is at the time. He is the Helper of God. Abraham, staying in the 15th sphere, at present, has inspired you to write the "Theomonistic Theology" and is continually inspiring you, from Jesus. The symbols and the spirit writing you received belong to a special Word of God that has now gone forth. When other Words (commands) are given, other symbols are furnished. This one is for the Theomonistic Movement. Present Spiritualism is mostly under the influence of the lower spirits and the earthbound spirits, but even so it tends to the glory of God. Gradually more doors will be opened for the higher spirits to communicate. There may be false Christs, and we shall investigate the case of the Hindu boy you name, but they are taken away before they can do any serious harm. Jesus will not appear again in the gross material body.

FROM KING DAVID, 22d SPHERE, SEPTEMBER 18-23, 1913.

This spirit is often aiding the soul-mate of Jesus, and had come also to us before, but never staid so long. He wrote: "We both (i. e. spirits and mortal psychics) are in a narrow tunnel, and evidence will be brought forth against the enemies, and the way will end in great power and triumph. We shall walk upon the heights. We expect great help from the Highest Power. Much patience is required to do the greatest work, because many great angels must be sent. Many great powers are entering upon the work to carry out the plan of God. We serve the highest crown and we hasten toward the highest goal. We, Xebela, I, and a large host of angels, unite with you in great power, before the throne of God. Before union is accomplished, we have to go through many battles; but, we are upon the heights, and great strength is given us. Great is the influence of your work on Earth and upon other worlds. Manna from heaven will be given to you, your child, and your child's child: what has been prayed for has been granted. Step by step you have mounted the ladder. Let he who stands take heed, lest he fall. We straighten the ways waiting for you to step upon them. Throw all your cares upon the Lord: He will carry out everything well. Just now, a Command is sent forth from the Throne of God, giving us power to help you, so that everything turn out most Days of great power and glory are coming. Heavenly power will be gloriously. given you into all eternity. In unity is strength. Xebela and I will put a great protection around you. Days when you partake of the blessing (Note—referring to our celebrations of the Lord's Supper, the first Sunday of every month; for Jesus, when giving me the symbol of the Supper, wrote: "Eat and drink in remembrance of me. The blessing is yours") will bring you much fruit. Trust in Cod! He will load everything greatly as the bath premised you." He will lead everything exactly as He hath promised you.'

FROM XEBELA, TOBIAS, OR THE PRODIGAL REDEEMED, SINCE AUGUST 29, 1913.

"Xebela" means Fulfilment. Ever since we began our spiritualistic work at the beginning of 1912, one whom we addressed as "Angel of the Lord," from the 16th sphere (on Venus), having not learned his identity, assisted us most forcibly, once even an anti-Christ in the spirit world who misled Miss M. and other mediums was bound by him. It was Xebela who now almost daily gives us further revelations, by large complicated and yet fully explained symbol-drawings and by writings. He proved his identity in many ways. He also gave us his photograph, as Abraham had done. Among the very many messages we select a few: "Today, a great feast is given in heaven for those who through your prayers (Note-We devote Saturday nights after 9 P. M. specially to helping the spirits in the hells who are prepared and led to us by a band of former ministers and spirit ladies who were gathered by Bishop Brooks and Mimi, our co-workers, he being the soulmate of my writing medium, while Mimi is my own soul-mate, Phillips Brooks is dwelling on Deresius (8th sphere) and Mimi lives on Qabexi (9th sphere), two unknown planetoids or asteroids, have been released from the underworld, and they are being led into their new homes. A crown will be given you. The signs of heaven shall now be given to you. You will remain in the house of the Lord for-People will be prepared to communicate with the spirits of God. We watch over you against your enemies. We bring great power to you. We desire to work together with you, and we give you as you have need of. We multiply the value and bring you success. A crown is given to the angels who hinder those who desire to destroy. The higher and the earthly powers are joining together. The godless ones shall be dethroned. Do your work in the fear of God, and a spiritual mantle shall be given you now already. Your way is being made straight as a straight line. I am laying the cornerstone of which you were speaking yesterday. (Note-When in my address before the First Spiritualist Church, in Baltimore, on "Higher Spiritualism," I asserted that modern Spiritualism reminded me of the mystic work of the lodge when the temple cannot be built because the designing architect has been spirited away: that the cornerstone chosen by God who permitted spirit return is missing in modern Spiritualism). Days of power are now coming.

OTHER SPIRITS COMMUNICATING.

Innumerable other messages from other spirits of heaven have been received. We were systematically led higher and higher, and each step was most carefully explained, through symbols and writings in the newly revealed spirit alphabet in which all spirits write to us, so that evil spirits cannot read it and only those who are chosen by God to prepare the way for the coming Millenium may understand each step taken, as reported to us, i. e. to me (who am clairvoyant and can see the spirits) and my wife (the writing medium of great patience). Some of these spirits are Prophet Daniel, 25th sphere, giving us 2 symbols; Elizabeth, mother of John the Baptist, 21st sphere, 2 symbols; Metatron Enoch, from the 15th sphere, 2 symbols: Abraham, from 15th sphere, 2 symbols; Jacob, 15th sphere, 5 symbols; Wilhelm Vest (Father of my wife and Mimi), 10th sphere, 25 symbols. Wilhelmina Vest (Mimi), 9th sphere, 90 symbols; Rev. Dr. Christian Jensen, the founder of the Breklum seminaries, 9th sphere, 3 symbols. Bishop Phillips Brooks, from 8th sphere, revealing first the spirit alphabet and numbers, gave 33 symbols; U. S. Commissioner of Education, Dr. Harris, 7th sphere, 9 symbols; Mrs. Lena Haase, aunt of Mrs. Holler and Mimi, 7th sphere, 2 symbols. And many others, some of whom do not belong to the nearest Council of Forty surrounding us for the work of Theomonism (with whom and through whom innumerable higher angels associate and continually work now) from the 4th to the 7th spheres, among whom are Bishop Walroth, Rev. Kuhlmann, Capt. Munchow, Col. Ingersoll, Dr. Hansmann, Mr. Wiegand, Mr. Eberhardt, Miss Krebs, Richard Wagner, the composer of grand opera, and others, have all given us symbols, with meanings attached in writing.
