

Therefore a terrible truth is manifested when one understands scientifically what acceptance of (outer) influence or suggestion really mean; for the soul, the Unconscious Mind, must exist, and will do so, in the state of belief in which it lived whilst on earth, in the Life that is after Death, exactly in accordance with what it has really made its own, in the normal state of consciousness. Therefore, our Destiny in an Eternal Heaven, or an Eternal Hell (The Kingdom of Heaven or Hell that is within us) is in our own hands: to be made in accordance with the mind of God or the mind of the Devil. We use the foregoing not only because of its relationship to our theme—or that it bespeaks the mind and considered opinion of a scientist and major metaphysician, but for its REALITY! — a tremendous truth that few of us care to even think of—let alone REALIZE. As our channel opens it becomes wider and wider and a greater flow will come forth if we will but open the flood gates of ignorance and permit the flow to come through.

We have for a long time caused our brains to be obstructed. The brain is the bridge over which the life flows into outer manifestation through us. We should ever keep that bridge unobstructed by not having thoughts that grow into great barriers because we have not watched them, because we have given to them power until they grow so large it takes much to dislodge them.

And each and every one of you have been told many times that you are the master over your

own domains, you are the rulers and because of such you should remain upon your thrones and direct life and not permit life to direct you.

Remember, the qualified stands aloof but the unqualified permits himself to get down off his throne and mingle with the riffraff. If you would be qualified then learn to direct and control your life as you would have it expressed. That does not mean stopping life expression for fear that you might make a mistake, that does not mean that you should refrain from all that you would hope to do in life, but it does mean that you should think well before you act.

But as we have told you over and over again, if you become angry then this anger poisons you because usually individuals do not permit their anger to go forth as they feel it, they have been taught otherwise. We say to you if once you are angry or if you are caught in the turmoil of battle, it is difficult to control these emotions, but it is in the time of peace, it is in your moments of quiet thinking that you must learn to control yourself that you do not permit anger to enter in to be controlled. If you could but know it, the individual who permits himself to indulge in all these emotional conditions and then tries to direct them after he is once caught in the turmoil, finds himself mentally and physically in a state of dissension, but the individual who does not permit himself to enter into these conditions can direct his path and control outer conditions, but not if he opens the gate and permits them in. There is that difference. Keep them out first. It is easier than to try to battle mistakes if they have once entered in. Strategy beforehand will go far but means little when once one is caught in the maelstrom of this great struggle of life. Emotions carry individuals away. Emotions cause great whirlpools in which the individual loses his sense of direction. It is important that we learn not to permit these things to turn loose within us but direct the channel of life around them. Do not permit them to enter because once they are in it is next to impossible to direct them, it is next to impossible to suppress them without great physical and mental injury. If you do not permit yourself to get into mental conditions, if you do not permit those thoughts to enter, then you have nothing to come back. That is true self-control—control of the self, first, not last.

We would suggest that when you see a condition coming toward you that might throw you into a great turmoil, that you turn out around it even as you detour in your driving when the road is being repaired. You would not think of going directly on when you see a danger sign, you would stop and look about you for you know if you went ahead and found yourself in difficulties you would perhaps not get out, and that is true in your own lives. Recognize the danger sign first and turn out around it. Control yourself as you would control your car.

Life is not so complicated as we find most individuals trying to make it. If you are excitable, if you are nervous, if you are upset—why is it? It is because

you have permitted thoughts to enter in before you could control them and you then are being controlled for a few moments, and you no longer are master over your own domains, let alone master over conditions about you. You cannot hope to control life, you cannot hope to control your environment unless you can control the self.

It is true that every subject that we give forth to you leads us back to self-control, for that is the center of your being, but self-control is not self-expression, is not obstruction, is not fear, is not lack—but it is expression, it is life in its fullest, and if you will obtain the knowledge that would lift your consciousness to the higher ideals and thoughts, if you possess these ideals and thoughts, how can you have room for lesser ideals and thoughts? Then your lives of necessity express the greater good.

We hear individuals saying, "Then you advocate that we express ourselves regardless of whether they are good or bad thoughts." We do not, but we do advocate that you do not think bad thoughts. We would like to see you lift your consciousness to a position in life where you are proud to express greater ones, higher thoughts, higher ideals. Plenty of souls have been brought into the world and have no one to assist them in their growth. Every one of you can still fulfill in that way if you have the courage to do so.

There is no better time than now for you are still permitting mileposts to go by and what are you doing about it? You are going back in your minds over and over again and

# How We Are Classified

#### PART I

E ARE TOLD that the attainment of wisdom and power can only be acquired through study and knowledge of ourselves. We have seen also that the same laws govern the whole universe, and that if man can understand some of the laws governing himself or the tiniest atom he will have a clue to those which govern the solar systems and the greater system to which they belong. Scientists have discovered that an atom closely resembles a miniature solar system. This leads us to the thought that perhaps our great solar system in its turn is one of millions of atoms forming the body of some great Being too vast for us to picture. Such a Being might feel small compared to the world which He in turn finds surrounding Himself.

Let us carry this idea a little further. The atoms (the stars) forming the cells (constellation) of the body of this vast Being would not appear to be far apart to Him; seen by Him they would be intimately connected with each other, there being strong chemical reactions and influences between them, just as with the cells in our own bodies. When an atom from one

of our own cells is examined it is found to be composed of a proton (or sun) surrounded by various numbers of electrons (or planets) all vibrating at set speeds. Now, we are told that the proton is so small a part of the atom that it can be compared with a bee buzzing inside a cathedral! So that if we could become small enough to cling to that proton we should certainly feel as if we were clinging to a star in a mighty space, and it would be difficult to believe that our star was part of an atom in the cell of a very solid body!

Some scientists now claim that the ether itself is denser than the planets that swing through it, so you see we must reserve ideas about solidity until we are a little better informed.

The point made in this case is that through visualizing our vast giant we can better understand the intimate relation in which the stars stand to each other. Composed of chemicals held together by force or energy, the radiations from each star and planet strongly affect each other, carrying with them chemicals in a very fine and subtle form. Thus from the planet Mercury we should expect to receive rays of the wave-length that belong to Mercury, and containing mercury itself in a fine form; also certain other chemicals which are contained in the planet to a lesser degree. As our solar system is believed to have been formed from the splitting up of one star, every planet, every man and every atom within it must still be held and connected one with another by the interplay of identical chemical radiations. As an example, it is

said that a ruby is actually a fragment of that part of the original star which finally broke away to form the planet Mars.

The astrologer makes careful calculations of the chemical and spiritual influences set up by the continual changing of the relative positions of the planets and luminaries (sun and moon), and of their effect upon the microcosm or tiny replica which is man. The macro-microcosmic law comes into play also in the question of time. A man's whole life is said to be mirrored in the moment of his birth.

According to one school of astrologists a person's individuality, his positive side, his character, are determined by the zodiacal sign in which the sun is found at his birth. His personality, or negative side, is determined by the sign in which the moon is found at his birth. When he is born he is 'tuned in', as it were, to the play of the planetary influences at the time, and the vibrations set up within him rule him all his life, determining his reactions both chemical and characteristic, and the environment which they attract.

It is in this way that people are classified.

There are at present scientific experiments in progress whose object is to indicate the differing results of inaugurating the same chemical mixtures at various phases of the planets, and also the different reactions at such times in plants and animals.

The ancient sages had a great knowledge of this fascinating subject and considered it of paramount

importance. First of all they conducted endless studies about the planets, and we call the results of their research Astronomy. They next made extraordinarily complicated and exhaustive studies of the combined influences of the planets on both the earth and human beings, according to their different positions in the heavens at various times. The results of this particular research have come down to us embodied in another science which we call astrology.

Astrology divides the heavens into twelve portions, rather like the divisions of an orange. These divisions, called the Twelve Signs of the Zodiac, correspond roughly with the twelve months of the year. Each of these Signs is governed by one of the planets. According to the month of the year in which you were born you can tell which Sign rules your life, and consequently what sort of health you may expect to enjoy, and what your characteristics will be.

Astrology is such a lengthy study and so difficult a science that there are few really expert astrologers in the world. Those few who do exist usually belong to a family of astrologers, whose teaching has been handed down for generations. A genuine astrologer must make complete calculations of the interplay of influences, chemical and otherwise, of every planet upon the person or subject under consideration.

But anyone can make a beginning with a simple study of the Twelve Signs of the Zodiac, and although the information gained is only generalization, it is close to the truth and therefore helpful and can be used by those who have not learnt to cast a horoscope.

To attain his final development, man is supposed to be born under the Signs of the Zodiac one by one, to learn the lessons they teach. Sometimes he is obliged to learn one of these lessons for the third time, perhaps for the thirtieth!

This has all been beautifully expressed in the *Twelve Labours of Hercules*, which was written with a profound knowledge of both astrology and symbolism, and contains deeply occult meaning.

The ancients declared that the whole history of the evolution of mankind, the solar system, and the universe is described and foretold by the stars, grouped in a kind of mystic shorthand, and capable of perfect translation. Such translations are contained in many of the hidden archives.

With respect to our year, one Sign of the Zodiac, with its planet, is ruling from about the 21st to the 21st of each month.

The influences of the Signs overlap each other slightly, so that a person born between about the 15th to the 25th of the month is influenced by two Signs (being born near to their junction). This gives him a more complex character. The most composite influence takes place on the 22nd of the month, so we find many prominent characters born on that date, such as Wagner, Van Dyck, Byron, Bacon, George Washington, Hitler, Conan Doyle, Baden-Powell, Faraday, and Rider Haggard.

A person born during the first half of the month comes under the unmixed influence of the sign, and would therefore be of a more definite type.

It must be understood, however, that in dividing the whole of humanity into only twelve types we are merely taking the first step. We are only generalizing, and although we have made an important beginning we must not take it as the final word.

The birth of Christ took place at a rare and wonderful conjunction of the stars, by which they announced (in the aforementioned shorthand) that tremendous event.

The Three Wise Men, who were Astrologer Kings of Chaldea, had been waiting for this conjunction to occur, and when they saw its approach they set off to journey to Jerusalem, over which town it was apparent that it would take place. They arrived and told King Herod, who at once realized the significance of the conjunction, which heralded a new 'King'. Herod called all his wise astrologers together and 'inquired of them diligently what time the star appeared'. They were all much troubled.

History is full of stories illustrating the immense importance given to astrology, of which astronomy was but the foundation. All priests and governors in olden days had to be well versed in the science of the stars and in the science of numbers, and we find that this knowledge existed all over the then known world.

We have only time here to take a superficial glance at the way in which we can apply astrology to the understanding of ourselves, and also of racial and world conditions.

By means of this science it is considered possible to map out the whole of a person's life. This is done in the first place by using the law 'As in the Microcosm so in the Macrocosm', and therefore by postulating that the plan of a person's three score years is mirrored in the first day, and even in the first moments, of his life. In the same way the history of a race or country can be determined by the influences under which it had its inception.

These things can, of course, only be believed through the study of proofs. The way to obtain these proofs is first of all to study astrology (!) and then to consider the hundreds of horoscopes of famous people which are available, as well as the annals of history itself.

In Astrology the great law of cause and effect (Karma) plays a big part. If, for instance, a man is greedy, it is not magical to predict that at a future date he will suffer from a digestive trouble, or if he is rash and impetuous that an accident is very sure to befall him. The average astrologer will predict the accident, but if instead he would study the cause, and persuade the man to cure his rashness, Karma would be defeated or adjusted, and the accident need not happen. 'The wise man is master of his stars, the fool is ruled by them.'

A conscientious astrologer always tries to show a person what tendencies he has to master, instead of playing upon his love of sensation by describing future events. What does a man need with his future before he has any idea of how to deal with the present? Today contains all possibilities for those who know how to strive for them.

Astrology has been sadly neglected as a science, but lately it is beginning to come into its own again, under the patient research-work of hard-headed scientists who are quite unsuspecting of that which they are about to unearth.

One of the principal uses to which Astrology can be put is the thorough diagnosis of a patient, bringing to light the chemical deficiencies or maladjustments in his internal laboratory, and the planetary rays which he is able to assimilate and use, or those which are causing him trouble. This method will do away with all guesswork, it is claimed, as we are assured that it is an exact science and will play a large part in the future of medicine.

Some of the biochemical experts have declared that the twelve principal cell-salts found in the human body are ruled by the twelve Signs of the Zodiac. They affirm that a person uses up more of the cell-salt belonging to the Sign under which he was born, as that chemical is connected with the key-note of his activity. Therefore the first deficiency that occurs in his internal laboratory is this cell-salt, his 'birth salt', and the various symptoms of his ills may be traced primarily to this depletion. All this was ap-

parently known to the ancients, but as they gave to the cell-salts the names of gods, and described their activities in mythical parables, we are only just beginning to understand what they meant.

# SCIENCE

### How Man Heals Himself

plays the chords in his own life symphony, in harmony or in discord, through ignorance or knowingly. Usually, it is done in half-ignorance—the ignorant half being the unconscious reaction on the body. But the knowing half is done when he deliberately permits himself to indulge in anger, worry, prejudice, pettiness, etc., towards others.

The principles of the Drown Radio Therapy are fundamentally those which help man to heal himself. Their basis is radio activity, which, as we understand it, means the various rates of vibration of all things in the Universe.

We do not attempt to deal with anything outside of the energies in action upon the earth today, and for purposes of better explanation we will divide these energies into four parts. First, we will speak of the unit which includes all energies as *The Universal En*ergy. Since we are dealing with the body and its various functions, normal and abnormal, we will call the second body energy; the third we will call disease energy, which in truth is a sub-head of body energy, and the fourth we will speak of as earth energy.

All these energies we have spoken of vary in degree even as the scale of music. We have our full scale in music, and we have our full scale in the various vibratory energies, but there are the flats and sharps and the major and the minor vibrations in the group that we are speaking about, as well as in the scale of music. So it is too vast a subject to attempt to explain. The only part we are vitally interested in is that part which affects the body, since the diagnosing and treatment of disease is our work.

Now, I am fully convinced through experiments in our laboratory that all energies are composed of positive and negative flow, even as we have light and darkness, pain and pleasure, heat and cold. Just so are all energies vibrating at a certain rate composed of positive and negative.

All energies must flow in a circle, as there are no straight lines. Even though an individual is lost in the forest and he is convinced within himself that he is traveling in a straight line, the fact that he is negative to his position draws him back to his starting point and he finds he has traveled in a circle.

We prove that all energy travels in circles. As we send it out from the brain, since that is where it affects our lives first, it comes back to us and affects our whole bodies, usually the part of the body vibrating to its rate.

The energies that we are using with this instrument, called the Homo-Vibra Ray, measure for us the body energies of our patients as a whole, and the disease energies are segregated in their various organs. We find that the disease energy is negative to the body energy, but it is positive to the earth energy. One of our laws is that all positive energies flow toward the negative energies. The body energy has within itself its positive and negative energy, as above mentioned. While some authors declare that the left side of the body is negative, and the right side positive, I have found through actual experimenting and testing with a meter that this is not always true, even in the same individual. Just so, it is not true that an individual is always positive or negative. Since man has the ability to use his will, he is able to be either positive or negative according to his mental attitude. So there are times when the right side of the body is negative and the left side positive. We have found that the energy from the right side of the body seems to pass more fluently down the spinal column and through the nervous system, while the energy from the left side of the body seems to flow through the arterial and lymph stream. Thus, when we have a highly nervous patient, the energy is more concentrated in the nerves. With a patient having heart trouble, the energy is higher in the blood stream.

All of this has its bearing on the body and its various functions, but back and beyond it all lies the Supreme Will of man, which directs the health of his

body, or his lack of health.

We have discovered, if discovery it can be called, that part of the nerves of the body in their process of control over the metabolism of the tissue cells, control the growth of these cells, and the other part control the tearing down, or waste products of the cells. This does not mean that one group of nerves does this work and another group does something else, but it means that every nerve contains the two functions. The nerve cell, as we see it, stimulated by the spinal fluid (which in turn is stimulated by the vibrations of the Universal Energy passing through the brain), causes the controlled growth of the cells with its cooperative function, the blood stream. The latter flows through the nerve cell, working in harmony with it and taking care of the catabolic function of the tissue cells. In other words, the nerve cells control the growth of the body cells, and the blood stream flowing through the nerve feeds the tissue and cares for the waste products of the tissue cells.

But the point we wish to bring out is that the energy governing the growth or anabolic activity functions through the nerve cell (coming direct from the Universal Energy, as also does the negative or catabolic function). Were this energy to be cut off or eliminated, the body changes which would take place would be due to the catabolic or the unbalanced functions of the blood stream which bring about superation and so-called decay. When we have a tumorous growth, for instance, it is easy to reason that the part

of our nerve which takes care of the catabolic function is impinged to that part of the body, and the only energy flowing through there is the positive energy which is causing the anabolic activity, or growth of the cell. By the same method of reasoning, when we have superation in any part of the body, it would appear that the nerve cell is impinged, and that the energy passing through the cell is only the one that takes care of the catabolic functions and brings about an imbalance of the tissues, or superation.

I would say that the energy which passes over the nerve cell is a positive energy, and that which passes over the blood stream in the cell is negative energy. So through the body—the negative energy is carried by the blood stream and lymph stream, and the positive energy by the nervous system.

Over and above all of that is the positive and negative energy which makes us live and move and have our being upon the earth, and which is affected more or less by the light and dark forces carried by the rays of the sun, and the light and dark and cold forces of the earth. And back of it all, we cannot say that the positive energy coming from the Universal Energy is that which causes growth entirely, for its negative energy which passes through the blood stream is just as important. One flows one way and one the other; one does one phase of work, and one the other—and each is vitally important to the other.

Now, disease energy is that energy which comes from any part of the body whose positive or negative channel is impinged. Therefore, its own rate of vibration becomes slower in degree to the body energy and it no longer vibrates to the total, but sets up its own rate of vibration. This places it more in harmony with the earth currents than with the body currents, the earth vibrations being much slower and more sluggish than the body vibrations for they are cold magnetism. Therefore, disease energies in the body would be considered negative to the body energy, but positive to the earth energies, until they too become as a rock, or solid substance. Then they are likened to the earth energy more than the body energy.

In diagnosing for disease, we find only the lack of balance of energy of the body. In treatment of disease, we reverse our process and resist the body energy in the diseased part. In that way the negative body energies (which are disease energies) flow toward the earth, and the positive body energy is held in the disease area, lifting the tissue to its own normal rate. Through the process of metabolism constantly going on in the body during treatment, the new tissue cells are brought in at a higher rate of vibration until the affected part is lifted up to normal.

The diagnosing is done by tuning in to the disease

energies as they pass toward the earth.

We use no commercial electricity in this instrument, for that is a different rate of vibration to the body energy, even though it is all of the One Universal Substance. Like does attract like spiritually and we would miss our point if we used other qualities of energy with our instrument.

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
