# DEMATERIALIZATION PHOTOGRAPHED!

Nationally known journals and pictorial weeklies have, for many years published what they call "The Picture of the Week."

In each instance these pictures are rare, unusual, thought-provoking and of general human interest. They are chosen from thousands received during the seven-day period and are selected, in the main, because of their clarity. The fact that seasoned newspaper men know that a picture always tells the story only brief explanatory captions are necessary.

Words fail and their meaning falls into oblivion when

compared to these picture stories and so, on this page there appears what could be classified not only as "The Picture of the Week" but also the PICTURE OF THE CENTURY . . . at least as far as psychic research is concerned.

In the past, Spiritualists themselves have been relegated to the background insofar as the scientific presentation of phenomena was concerned. The scientists and some of the staid psychic researchers always seemed to look "down their noses" at the way Spiritualist magazines presented their phenomena—always claiming that they (the Spiritualists) are not scientific. But now, Spiritualists

ists can say they are presenting concrete evidence, facts and cases backed by pictures—pictures that could have been obtained by most of the psychic research societies on both sides of the water. However, their smugness has long been apparent and prevented them from getting any modern-day evidence.

Have the efforts of the British and American P. R. Societies crystallized? We have only to look at the record. What have they done since the days of Myers and Hyslop. Absolutely nothing except try to prove what everyone knows, who has made a study of the case—that mental telepathy and clairvoyance are now more or less "scientific facts." They have also dabbled in marble counting and dice rolling in an effort to prove something or other.

#### At Chesterfield

The picture published on page 24, enlarged on this page, was the first taken when a group of Spiritualists assembled at Chesterfield, Indiana, February 17th. The medium, Rev. Fanchion Harwood agreed to sit and as an experiment have pictures taken of the phenomena. The group assembled, called together by me, was made up not only of people from the vicinity but many traveled thousands of miles to take part in these experiments. H. F. Miller, a medical doctor from Odessa, Texas, was one of the principal participators.

The photographer, David Payton, 1023 Broadway, Anderson, Indiana, was engaged

to take the pictures. Most of the story was told (March 25th edition) and this sequel serves as a fitting climax for results obtained.

We have already described how the pictures were taken, that the negatives were immediately developed in another portion of the Harwood residence at Chesterfield and that all the sitters were permitted to see these negatives one half hour after the seance ended.

#### Story Behind The Story

The picture (this issue) clearly shows that Dr. Miller's daughter Helen, appeared in such a way that no one could doubt the authenticity of this photograph. The fact that the lower portion of the spirit is partially dematerialized positively proves this phase of phenomena.

And now for the story behind the story. This picture was purposely withheld and not published until now for the reason that the editors of this journal felt it best to wait and see what the reaction would be to the picture published on page 24 of our March 25th edition. This picture appears again (right) and shows the same spirit, Helen, the daughter of Dr. Miller, fully materialized, the doctor being only several inches taller.

The other photograph of Helen, partially dematerialized, shows her father over a head taller. This was due to the fact that dematerialization was taking place during the time this photograph was taken. Time elapsed between the taking of these pictures but the features of Helen are definitely the same.

#### Never Can Tell

When the group inspected the negatives after the seance, the one showing the dematerialization did not look as if the experiment had been a success. Of course, after prints were made, we could see that for evidence, the picture of dematerialization overshadowed the second as far as evidence was concerned

At the time, Dr. Miller

thought it best to experiment again and see if he could get a better picture of his daughter. The result was the full form materialization and since printing this full form materialization of Helen (March 25th) numerous letters were directed to this office asking us to explain the apparent "double exposure," in the upper left hand corner over Dr. Miller's right shoulder. (See picture, Col. 2.)

Upon close scrutiny, the meticulous observer will notice that the right edge of the picture frame is not exactly at the proper angle if it were a "double exposure". Rather the right edge would be perpendicular.

When an experienced commercial photographer was asked about this, he said this could happen when the reflection from the glassed framed photograph on the piano was picked up by the lens and projected

over the picture above the Doctor's shoulder.

This photographer said this would happen when "the angle of incident equaled the angle of reflection." This photographer's name is Lewis H. Holmes, 20 East Third St., Jamestown, N. Y.

Now, read the photographer's explanation (left) this page.

Many experienced photographers will tell you that many times, the explainable is inexplainable and that things happen during the course of their profession for which there is no explanation, but even so, by no stretch of imagination, can anyone positively say that this is a "double exposure". This photographer who took the picture had no axe to grind, in fact, he was the only skeptic in the room.

The argument was put forth by one of our readers that there were two snaps made on the (Continued on Page 3)

Answering Our Critics

#### WHAT THE PHOTOGRAPHER

When the picture (below) was published in Psychic Observer, March 25th, 1950 issue, page 24, one of the severest controversies ever waged among Spiritualists was experienced. Some thought we had been taken in and said so. This picture was taken February 18th, 1950, after I had left Chesterfield. I was present only when the picture, page 24 this issue, was taken, February 17th. The reason for the second picture was that Dr. Miller thought the negative,-all present examined after the seance,-was not clear in that Helen did not seem to show up in a satisfactory manner. As it turned out the first picture, Helen dematerialized, was and will remain as a classic in the field of psychic research for years to come.

In answer to my letter to Dave Payton, the photographer who took both pictures of Helen, I received a full explanation. In his letter to me, Mr. Payton said: ". . . regarding the picture on the wall and appearance of the picture on Dr. Miller's shoulder. I used a tripod under my camera, just as I did when you were here for the first pictures, only I failed to release the press catch on the shutter. The press catch is a button that holds the shutter open while you focus on the ground glass.

"Then the white lights were turned off and I pulled the slide out of the camera, making it ready for the first exposure, but did not know that while they were getting ready, my camera was actually taking a picture of the frame on the wall, as it was the most white object in view of my camera.

"Then ten to fifteen minutes later, Dr. Miller was called forward, and stood in line of the frame and the camera when the infra red flash picture was made. I took this one exposure the following night after you left and this is it."

Intense interest in the how and why of this picture was also expressed by J. Gilbert E. Wright, retired research chemist, 111 Union St., Schenectady (5) N. Y. Mr. Wright is, in my opinion, America's foremost Spiritualist psychic researcher. His letter to me inquired as to the double exposure angle and I answered as best I could-not as yet having the above reply to my letter

to photographer, Payton. Mr. Wright's letter, dated April 4th, reads: "I had no intention of impugning the honesty of the medium (Fanchion Harwood) nor questioning

same negative, and that Dr. Miller was not in the first exposure. Eighteen sitters and myself know that at no time would Dr. Miller allow himself to be involved in anything of this sort. All these arguments fade into insignificance when the pictures themselves are offered in evidence. "Could be's" are NOT facts!

#### Much We Don't Know

Some ask why books were placed under the legs of the piano seat. When Helen, who materializes and plays the piano, asked to have the seat raised, the books were placed there. At this experiment everyone hoped she would play again, but evidently, the spirit collaborators had other ideas.

Another point that may be raised by the casual observer. Why are Helen's features, during the time she was dematerializing, clearer than when she is fully materialized? do not know. There is also evidence that dematerialization is taking place (see black portion throughout Helen's left upper arm). Since dematerialization is taking place why do her features remain intact? I do not know.

Then, there will be those who, when witnessing dematerialization, have seen the upper portions of the body and then the head near the floor.

The fact that Helen is gradually becoming shorter is sufficient reason to rule out the certainty of the exact location of any portion of any dematerializing form at any particular

Those who pondered over the apparent "double exposure" over Dr. Miller's right shoulder, will find no such discrepancy in the picture showing the form dematerializing.

I have been accused of being belligerent and intolerant toward those who are continually finding fault with certain types of phenomena. Possibly so, but I don't mean to be. I am always willing to have our readers write in and present their case, state their arguments, but when they do that, they should back them with an equal amount of evidence and not a lot of "could be's" and "but's, and's, if's" and a lot of statements which cannot be proven.


#### Nothing Ever Happens

I have also been told in no uncertain terms that the pictures already printed of the Harwood demonstrations bore no evidence but was not told the reasons. It seems to me that during the last 25 or 30 years, these same old-time psychic researchers have had plenty of opportunity to present what they think would be evidence but nothing has happened.

How people can argue about the pictures especially when they were not there is beyond me. The sitters assembled. The doors were locked. No one entered or left the room during the demonstration. And even so, had there been a continual parade going in and out, that would not account for the dematerialized form. As far as "double exposure" is concerned, let somebody come forward, who can walk around in the flesh-dematerialized!

# Hydesville Camp Opens June 24

The Hydesville Spiritualist Camp will open June 24th and close Labor Day according to Rev. Margaret Lewis, president. This will be the third consecutive summer session of this unique Spiritualist Camp located on Hydesville Road several miles south of Newark, N. Y.

During the past years, especially during the celebration of the 100th anniversary of Modern Spiritualism, thousands have visited this hallowed spot where the Hydesville Memorial "marker" designa s the spot upon which the original Fox Cottage was located.

Today, Hydesville Camp is fast becoming a representative center for Spiritualists-modern hotel accommodations and an auditorium, all surrounded by superb landscaping.

Although the President of Hydesville Spiritualist Camp is well known in the field of Spiritualism, having conducted a church in Albany for many years and submitted to various tests of her physical mediumship before groups of scientists in that part of the state, yet, few know she has demonstrated her mediumship in Albany's executive mansion at the request of Mrs. Franklin D. Roosevelt.

A clipping from the Albany Evening News, dated February 17, 1932, reads: "The voice of Fawn, spirit control of a Hampton Manor medium, has joined the chorus of political prophets predicting that Franklin D. Roosevelt will probably be the next President of the United

"For the first time in her life. Mrs. Roosevelt consulted a Spiritualist. Governor Roosevelt, preferring to hear the revelation second-hand, remained outside the room.

"The occasion of an experiment with the supernatural was a party given at the Executive Mansion for the staff of the executive department. As a lastminute inspiration, the Roosevelts invited Mrs. Margaret Lewis of Hampton Manor to give Spiritualistic readings.

"While professional ethics prevent Mrs. Lewis from discussing more questions asked her by Mrs. Roosevelt, she was willing to explain the reason for the cheerful smile the Governor's wife wore when she rejoined her guests.

"Mrs. Roosevelt's first question was whether her husband will receive the nomination for President and if so, whether he will be elected.

"The reply was that there will be two other strong contenders for the nomination, but that Governor Roosevelt will probably get it. Fawn and the other spirits seemed quite confident that if he obtains the nomination he will be elected."

Rev. Lewis was referred to

as "the Hampton Manor medium" because she resides in the section of Albany known by that name. Her address is the same today, 55 State Road, Renssalaer, N. Y.

#### Medium's Escort

When asked about this incident, Rev. Lewis said that Eleanor, not only invited her to give clairvoyance, but sent a 6 ft. 2 in. state trooper, two police cars and a limousine so she would be properly escorted to her destination. This is the only case on record where a medium was invited to the Governor's Mansion in Albany. The Albany Evening News item included a picture of the medium, Rev. Lewis, standing beside Mrs. "F.D.R."

Seals on a package of 5x7 filing cards are broken before the audience and the cards are passed out for examination. In a wicker basket, the cards are collected and given to two persons, unknown to the medium, who are called to the rostrum to assist in the demonstra-

#### Precipitated Writing

A dozen or more colored crayon pencils with sharpened points, are examined by a committee. In this instance, I was one among twenty persons selected. Two ladies held the basket. Rev. Bias put his fingers on the shoulders of the ladies and asked: "Can you hear a rustling of papers?"

Dora Shepard, an assistant, replied: "Yes."

Then, Rev. Bias asked the audience: "Can anyone else hear it? Come forward, some of you, so you can hear.'

About twenty went forward. A faint rustle of paper could be heard. Rev. Bias then said: (to his spirit collaborator) "Sylvia, rap on the basket."

Then a tap, tap, tap could be distinctly heard by many in the audience. About fifty spirit messages were received. I asked for statements from those who received the cards. Amongst them were: Jennie Lewis, Manchester, Iowa, who received a message from her husband, Leslie Webster, in his own handwriting.

On some cards, the writing was so small, a microscope had to be used to read it. Reversed writing, known as mirror writing, also was demonstrated. All of this demonstration takes place within a few minutes. Amazing, incredible, but true! These testimonials can be checked by anyone who is interested. After the demonstration, I examined the pencils. Some of the crayons had been used. Spirit chemists evidently use the physical material to draw from in order to produce this phenomena.

#### Bias At Jamestown

Rev. Bias is scheduled to demonstrate various phases of mental and physical mediumship here at Jamestown, N. Y., May 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th. He will be sponsored by The American Foundation for Psychic Research, Inc. Menninger, president of the American Psychiatric Association: "For one thing, we forget that the human body is only a house in which a person lives and not the man himself. We assume that when we see the physical being of a man, we see the person. We should pay more attention to the personality within the body."

Science and Spiritualism's proof of immortality of personality are growing closer and closer together. Spiritualists know that the body is merely the vehicle through which personality and individuality express, because the "dead" have come back and proved their identity after the body of flesh is buried into the earth. Jesus, the great scientist demonstrated this fact over two thousand

# The Picture of the Century

When the first photograph was taken of Helen, spirit daughter of Dr. H. F. Miller (See Psychic Observer, March 25th, 1950) numerous letters were received—asking for an explanation of the *double exposure* over the Doctor's right shoulder.


The photograph, this page, rules out any accusation of this sort. In fact this picture of a dematerialized spirit is definitely perfect in that no criticism whatsoever can possibly be forthcoming.

The taking of this picture by Payton was witnessed by nearly 30 persons, including the editor of this journal. Fanchion Harwood, one of America's foremost materialization mediums sat in the cabinet back of the black curtain. All present have already vouched for this photograph. The negative was developed 30 minutes after this seance ended. A committee of three, followed photographer Payton and, in an outer room, watched the negative being developed.

There are records and pictures showing that Sir William Crookes was photographed with the materialized spirit, Katie King,—walking arm in arm with her but through the mediumship of "Florie" Florence Cook, there is no photograph on record showing a partially dematerialized spirit on the floor with Crookes. Nor is there a picture showing medium Cook—with a materialized spirit,

Many of the Crookes photographs were destroyed. It seems that records and rare pictures of an evidential type have an uncanny way of disappearing when those who spend a life-time in research leave their findings in the hands of those opposed to the case for personal conscious survival. When the evidence is too good, certain die-hards become enraged but if there are apparent loopholes, these same intellectuals become masters of the situation by talking about red herrings instead of the actual phenomena produced.
