UST why do we say, "God created," instead of, "God conceived"? The latter is much more correct and nearer the truth; for God did CONCEIVE, and brought forth the human family and all the SPIRITUAL PROGENY of man, simply by applying the law of COSMIC GES-

TATION; and by coordination and classification, He was able to produce all kinds of physical phenomena, which in turn developed into a higher state of being, until it eventually reached the spiritual and intellectual degree of consciousness.

To actually create, one must make something from nothing, and that is simply impossible, for from nothing something cannot be made. The great CENTRAL SPIRIT, whom we call GOD, and of whom we know so little outside the Force that is called life, and for which we have no adequate explanation—that substance that lacks substance—that something that cludes the most skillful physician and which cannot be recalled once it had flown; is the nearest conscious interpretation we have for the DIVINE SOURCE of LIFE. Yet it is safe to say that we could not endure life were it not for the comforting thought that we are watched over and cared for by a power of which we know practically nothing, but in which rests our physical, mental, and spiritual security.

Many of the bible stories relating to the beginning of the human race, and all of the physical phenomena of the earth were merely allegories, for, lacking scientific proof of the CAUSE, symbols were needed to give incentive to the human family, in lieu of more authentic knowledge, and gradually they were incorporated into the records as actualy having taken place. So, we have God creating everything but the human race, and then, being dissatisfied with His creation, He added man, made from the humblest material; and, finding that a companion was necessary to complete the man's physical happiness, He then created woman, taking a rib from man in order to produce his

It is purely the creation, if I may borrow the term, of the masculine imagination, that God had to take from man in order to make woman, for by doing so He created woman subservient to man, and, therefore, she must be subject to his will and pleasure, and it was her actual duty to reproduce her kind, since hers was a secondary position. For many centuries, in fact running into thousands of years, this idea was held to be true by fundamentalist religions, and even yet there are millions of people who really believe that God employed mud in the manufacture of the first man and that it was necessary to take from Adam a rib to perfect Eve, his helpmate. They never stop to think how unreasonable it would be for a GREAT FORCE like GOD to begin creation without complete knowle

edge as to what and how He would accomplish each and everything to appear at His direction.

Naturally, when God determined to CONCEIVE the human race by the NATURAL LAW of COSMIC GESTATION, His plans were complete from the very beginning, and He injected SPIRIT into every atom that was to be used in this new form of being. That there were spiritual beings of a perfect and regular order is true, but the lesser degree of life, to be known as humanity, we might almost say, was in the form of an experiment, for was it not to develop up to that higher and more perfect state of being, and, in order to develop, it must start with a rather crude and very imperfect beginning.

While I do not like the term "experiment" in connection with God, yet it clears up a point in a manner that is more easily understood, and I trust the absurdity will be excused, for God does not have to experiment in order to learn through and by experiment the ultimate to which a thing will grow. It is known from the beginning how every phase will be developed and under what condition it can most easily be perfected. Some are able to use these spirit senses only in trance, in hypnosis, or in dreams. In this state we are "in the spirit," being totally unconscious of earth, but fully conscious on the spirit plane. In this state we can both see and hear. We can walk about with great ease and comfort. We go long distances quickly and without apparent fatigue. We note that life there is similar to life here. People have homes and inhabit them, have societies, schools, and carry on business efforts. In the dream state we renew old acquaintances and make new ones. We are apt to do and say ridiculous things, things which at the time of doing seemed logical and consistent. This is because of our own personal undevelopment. We have not yet found ourselves upon this new plane of life. Upon awakening, we at once become unconscious of all this life which, but an instant before, was all about us and of which we were a part.

This place where we have just been—what is it? It is our heavenly home, the first beyond earth. And, as there are heavens innumerable, some psychics have been able to visit other planes far removed from earth and to tell us of their experiences there. Spirits returning through mediums tell us of life as it is lived on these higher planes. Undeveloped spirits func-tioning on these higher planes of life find themselves weak and wandering of purpose, which may explain some of the inconsequential messages purporting to come from these realms. As the will power lies back of every conscious effort, so its continued use in governing not only the acts, but the thought processes of our every-day lives will greatly aid us in soul development, giving to us that self-mastery without which no worth while effort can be accomplished. We believe that earth has invaluable lessons for us, and that we should not draw back from learning them, lest we find ourselves unfitted to cope with greater difficulties later on. Instead of drawing back, let us push forward as conquerors.

Becoming spirit instead of mortal, we have before us lives of endless endeavor among other blessed ones of like nature, who, instead of trying to save themselves, are always busy helping others, and so indirectly saving themselves. As we go on let us add all things fitting to the completion of great life

work, which means health to body and soul.

THE FLOWERS

PLANTS render a great service to man and animals by purifying the air for them to breathe. At every breath, animals take in some of the oxygen in the air and change it into carbonic acid, which gas is formed when the oxygen combines with the carbon in the blood. This gas, also known as carbon dioxide, is breathed out into the air in place of the oxygen drawn in. Now, plants need the carbon, as it makes a very large portion of their food, and so they constantly take the carbonic acid from the air, decompose it in their leaves during sunshine, keep the carbon, and give back the oxygen pure. It is interesting to note that there is no power in the plant itself strong enough to do this. To be sure, the leaves are flat and thin, so that they can drink in as much sunlight as possible, but it is the power of the sun that helps the green stuff to split up the carbonic acid gas.

The individual traveling this earthplane has latent powers within himself, which, if exercised righteously, might accomplish much good for himself and others. But just as the plant needs the help of the tremendous power of the sun, so each pilgrim stands daily in need of the helpful strength and guidance from the Source of all power and wisdom. PSYCHIC DEVELOPMENT

LESSON VI



AST lessons have led easily and gradually up to this our sixth lesson in psychic development, and I trust that our class has followed us step by step, losing nothing that can in any way contribute to the most satisfactory results. The greatest dif-

ficulty I find with beginners is their haste to develop too rapidly and out of proportion to the time devoted to unfolding the sixth sense. They expect as much phenomena at their first, second, or third sitting as an experienced psychic receives after years of spiritual contacts. This is a mistake, for all growth that is steady and substantial must be slow and result from devotion to the underlying principles, if it is to be healthy; so psychic growth must result from application of principle.

Many who demonstrate psychical phenomena of the material order may contradict me; they may even point to their own demonstrations to prove the statement an error, but I, on the other hand, will, if allowed opportunity, prove my assertion to be founded on facts. Too much superficial, subconscious data is presented under the title of "spirit phenomena" which, if appearing to be directed to the sitter, results from previous knowledge, or is born of a desire on the part of the sitter for that particular manifestation. Avoid such mistakes by always emptying the mind of personal interests. If two form a class, it is helpful, or more may join their interests so that tests may be made to determine the quality of the manifestations. How many have observed the light, or aurora, that surrounds all objects, and especially the human body?

There is no greater proof of UNIVERSAL SPIRIT than the light which emanates from the body of an individual; for in every instance the light represents the mental attitude of the person at the moment that you observe it, and denotes exactly their mental, physical, and spiritual poise, or lack of poise. It is the VITAL LIFE FORCE, or GOD SPIRIT, that permeates every phase of objective life, and which baffles material science in its search for CAUSE that results in ACTIVE LIFE. No man has found the source, for it is beyond the understanding of man, yet the effect of SPIRIT FORCE upon human life in particular manifests itself in an emanation of light. The following are all favorable: Golden light, blue light, light rose color, green, purple, and especially, the white light of spirit. But none of these should be dark, or dense, but clear and radi-Tonight you will sit before a mirror, with a tiny candle placed at the side, all other lights extinguished, and, sitting erect as usual, you will look comfortably into the mirror and observe your own elusive, spiritual light, and also the changing expression of your face, which will reveal to you some pleasant and some unpleasant characteristics. This part of the lesson should not last for more than ten minutes at the most. May God bless you, my unseen children.

SPIRITUAL FREEDOM



EAL battle of life is for freedom. It has been raging since earliest times and will continue until the last barrier has been removed, when men will walk as gods, conquerors of their lower natures. Peace is not in sight, for there can be no armistice

Peace is not in sight, for there can be no armistice or treaty concluded to end the strife. Therefore, the hostilities

will continue to spread their doleful influence throughout the earth-plane and the lower spirit spheres. Let the fight continue, for it is the battle of light against darkness and freedom against slavery. The armies of ignorance are massed with all their shadowy conditions to contest every progressive movement of progressive souls, but justice patiently waits for the victory of right.

The first virtue necessary for spiritual freedom is patience. Nothing is to be gained by haste, so if at times we feel faint and discouraged, think of the patience of God. Bear in mind that when we speak of spiritual freedom we mean a state of spiritual development that one has reached on the road to perfection and a mastership one has acquired by having evolved step by step over his own mistakes and restitution of those mistakes, until he can at his present point of development exercise his innate divinity over any problem of life. In other words, he has reached a lofty perception from which he beholds the outline of his journey's end, and in wisdom he would not repeat the failures of his past. It is possible to fall from this high estate, but not probable, for the master is conscious of his sins committed when he was bound to material conditions and the difficulty which he experienced as he made good his short comings.

God's law of justice, the rule of perfection, applies to men and angels, worlds visible and invisible, and there is no exception to this perfect law. Therefore let it be understood that those whom we knew and loved and who have shed their earthly cloaks are not immune from the law just because they were associated with us by ties of blood or friendship. They have earned their reward, nothing more, and if they have accumulated sins of omission or commission which they cannot make right while in spirit, they must necessarily return to earth life and they will continue to so return until somewhere, some time, they shall have learned to live in accordance with the God is no respector of persons, and, while the human ties are usually sacred to mortals, it is due to our inability as yet to free ourselves from the narrow limits of selfishness. A broader view is necessary before we are spiritually free, and, unless we enjoy that vision of equality as Jesus of Nazareth taught it, our spiritual progress will be slow.

If we cannot be just we cannot claim freedom. If we refuse to accept the law by which we are compelled to work off our debts, we are still in bondage, without light and understanding. We know that we must pay the penalty for violating man's law. Is it surprising that God, being just, requires justice from his children? Is it just to believe that any creed can be of influence to excuse us from justice? It can be generally stated that any human being who cannot see the light has so much stored-up shortcomings from his former and present lives that his sense of justice is shadowed. In his enslaved state he considers spiritual freedom as nonsense, and, not being just himself, prefers the unjust schemes of men. In this environment he cannot be helped, and, while it is sad, repetition of earth life is the only teacher to open his spiritual eyes.

Spiritual freedom as we are trying to outline it will therefore only appeal to those children of God who have nearly expiated their mistakes and can see the light. They are dispelling from their minds the superstitions which no longer appeal as just and have begun to attract just thoughts, just deeds and just hopes. Their desires for spiritual freedom will be met as surely as their ignorant wants were formerly supplied. As they had attracted to themselves the environment of spiritual darkness, they can now rise from an undeveloped state, for they have desired to think their way out of bondage, realizing

that as one sows he also reaps. The whole aspect of life changes at this point, for aid that is offered to help to freedom is accepted instead of being rejected.

If we could read the records of our previous lives we could find a reason for everything that has crossed our present journey. The law would be seen operating as perfectly through the channels of human conduct as it does through the solar systems. Injustice is the cry of undeveloped mortals, but injustice does not rule the world. As we climb the heights of spiritual freedom we see that injustice is only apparent, not real. Throwing off our fetters of man's limits, we assert our divinity and approach God.

Man gives us plausible explanations for the sadness and sorrows of life, those seeming injustices which we claim oft-times pursue the righteous but which the sinner escapes. Do not be weak and blame it on God the Father, or perhaps sink lower with your inquiry as to whether there is a God. Where is that spark of the Supreme Force which you say is immortal? Do not call it luck, chance or coincidence, nor label it fate. Remember, free will is justice, and we were sent forth free.

The law operates without stops, balancing our daily deeds, but always providing justice. Thus we see that the average life of approximately thirty-five years is far too short for any human being to make full restitution, and even if three score years and ten were allotted to each of us, there would be many debts unpaid to society during one earth life. An opinion might be expressed that if one could not make restitution during his earthly life, could he not make amends when disrobed from body and avoid the necessity of returning to earth. Yes, he could, but the problem is more difficult when one has passed over the border. There, without physical body, he can only contact the earth by inspiration, and, since this is not often admitted to be possible by mortals, the inspirations when received are seldom acknowledged. It is true that vile suggestions also register in the human mind and were sent forth by undeveloped spirits, and, while these inspirations are frequently put into deeds, this is due to the ignorance of the mortal, who would emphatically deny spirit communication, although he acts upon it. But we had in mind particularly the contrite spirit, realizing its earthly shortcomings and desirous of elevating its existence, puts forth the earnest effort to make amends and often finds this is only possible by returning to earth life, for the earthly ties are too strong to do otherwise. The contrite spirit will incarnate at a suitable time and either live on a higher plane of earthly life than formerly, or, lured again by the attractions of the earthly, sink to a low condition, with more stored up debts to pay. Being more desirous for spiritual free-dom than anything else, it will however be attracted to a family where ample opportunity is offered to concentrate on the higher things of life, which are, of course, spiritual.

We create every situation in which we find ourselves here and hereafter. If men knew this to be a fact they would work with the law, not against it. Optimism would replace pessimism as the sun shines through the clouds. Men would be just as God commands and they will be when they have learned that it pays to be just. The despondent on the brink of suicide is not just to himself, his Creator, or to society. All who claim adversity and misfortune as excuses do not know the fruits of their own lives. We are vibrating in the gloom because we found our level and for no other reason. Like disobedient children of earthly parents, we only learn our lessons by experience and know thereby whether our creations are just or unjust. As we continue to make similar mistakes, do we not fear the word justice? It is because we are undeveloped and fearing justice, refuse to believe in it. It is more comforting to

behold what we think is injustice about us, as the sinner seems favored and the righteous sacrifices for naught. This is but the narrow view of the ignorant mind, and the broader view follows as men ask God for justice. Justice will be required, whether man asks for it or not, but when mercy and love rule the heart, what man could be unjust. He is willing to pass through the trials and tribulations without complaint, for he knows his just Father rules the universe. By accepting the conditions one has almost passed his period of restitution and longs to be perfectly just. With this understanding every effort will be made to avoid piling up additional sins or shortcomings. The way to spiritual freedom is nearing its end. Finally we can rise upon our past mistakes to the spiritual estates, for we have mastered every material obstacle. Until we are able to do this, we are not spiritual. May we accept graciously our rewards for things done and undone and henceforth abide by the law.

SPIRIT COMMUNICATION

A PILLAR of power and of strength upon which rests TRUTH is that of spirit communication. It is not anything that is new, for spirit communication is as old as creation. The only new thing about it is that the understanding is now broadening where formerly it was not considered as something worth knowing much more of.

The first evidence of spirit communication is the communication of life from that Supreme Force and Spirit, God. It is that spark or spirit or life that was first sent forth from the spirit realms to enter into a material contact. Its origin is spiritual and not man-made nor material. This spirit or part-God thus sent forth ever has the spiritual bond that permits of the divine power of communion between itself and its source. By this same divine power every spark has communion with each other no matter whether it again made its return back to the realms, or whether still traveling in body about the earthly realm.

We do not generally accept and appreciate the wisdom of Paul as written in the Epistles such as, "We have the mind of the Spirit." "Ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you." "The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God." "We have received not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God." "Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?" "Know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost, which ye have of God?" "Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love Him. But God hath revealed them unto us by His Spirit; for the spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God." "We know not what we should pray for as we ought; but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered."

One's loss of understanding and lack of confidence in the power of communion has resulted in seeking an intermediary or other form of mediumship by which and through which one would try to commune in "spirit and in truth." Thousands upon thousands who would thus communicate with the Father do so "through thy Son, Jesus Christ." There are many more who place their dependence upon other instrumentalities; upon the saints, the virgins and angels.

Spirit communication is one of the many blessings given by the Father to His children, and it is for all, young or old, here and hereafter, and since it is universal, it is TRUTH. The sad part is that so few reap its fullest benefits simply because most will not look upon it as the works of God, but brand it as the work of the devil. True, many have abused the privilege of communion and in doing so have denied its uplifting influences. There are other forms of communicating beside communicating with the All-Highest, and there is perhaps less understanding of these forms, still it would seem that there is however greater abuse and misuse of its provisions.

Before proceeding with what some of these lower forms of spirit communion may be, we would sound the warning of the consequences that may befall one who would violate the trust reposed in that one. The injury done to another comes back upon the wrongdoer and the harm so done either deliberately or ignorantly must be made right manyfold. Much rather communicate with the Supreme Spirit direct than with or for other spirit loved ones.

Perhaps next to communicating with the Father we have the privilege of receiving the inspirations from beyond the bor-These are pure in the degree of their source. Those coming from the higher realms should be much more welcome than those from the lower realms. The way to best determine their influence is according to their spiritual or material import. The higher the source the more spiritual the vibrations become. Those from the realms closer to this earth plane bring more inspiring influences of material conditions, and which are less spiritual and therefore not of lasting qualities. Our return form of communion is the thought we send forth or the word we express to the one with whom we would commune. If we would receive their help and their good wish then we should give them our help and our good wishes. Let us not do to them what we would not want them to do for us when it comes to things harmful, ever remembering both they and we must make our way onward and upward, and so must not interfere with each other's progress, but must ASSIST each other, if we would be true to the Love of the Father.

Another form in which we may have direct communion with those who are on the other shores, and which may come when our powers of receiving inspirations are less developed, is in visions and again in dreams. That which may be communicated in a vision ofttimes is symbolical and needs interpretation. Dreams (not the kind coming as a result of physical conditions) are more realistic and seem to be more in detail. In either case, much care must be given that not wrong understanding is taken. Here again may it be said, the best way to judge its meaning is according to its spiritual and not material interpretation. Anything that is based upon the Law of God is good, and let it be the guide for such interpretations. It may help to clearly understand this when we say that imagination is based upon mortal mind and its limited knowledge. It too can be of good intent, but we are considering communication with another, not with self.

Spirit writing is also a means of conveying a message we can indulge in safely if we do it rightly. Unlike what may be seen in a vision or in a dream, the writing is by our own hand with spirit control or guidance. Actuated by good motive, we write as the hand is moved to do.

Now all of these conditions can be through another one in body and in turn conveyed to us. This may be so whether we are developed to receive ourselves or not. Many will go to another and there find an inspiring thought, or be told of the vision or dream that concerns ourselves, or be given a written message that came through another but intended for us. In

any event, we should welcome only what is right and good and reject that which is not right. That is what those in spirit realms would do and who know the benefits of doing good KNOWINGLY. This spiritual knowledge is called LIGHT, and we can always reach to more.

We are dependent wholly on another in body for a message from the spirit side through trance conditions. This is where one gone over manifests his presence through another's body, borrowed as one would say. There are different trance conditions. Some are in greater trance than others, and the more one is in trance, the less that one knows about what has been brought forth for another. Where the trance message is understood by the medium, it seems to be because it was heard like an echo.

There are other forms of spirit communication and which are of a kind not generally recommended. These are trumpet speaking and spirit rappings. The trumpet message is both audible and understandable but difficult for a spirit loved one to endure. The spirit rappings of one whose presence is acknowledged will sometimes carry on a communication under a code, the different number of rappings meaning different things. Letters of the English alphabet are given in rappings, such as one rap or knock meaning the letter A, two meaning the letter B and so on until a sentence has been spelled out.

It is not for man to dictate how spirit communication shall be carried on. It is only that he share in the spiritual advantages thus created. It would seem that before one would say we cannot talk with the living, that he thoroughly investigate its many demonstrations of facts. One must not only follow in the lower stages of spirit communion, but keep going to the higher and better developments. Great good can be had from proper communion. Those who have gone before and who have reached a high destination can advise us how we should make our spiritual journey. They can explain many things man is unable to tell us about and which explanation is for the upliftment of the spirit.

We who are making our journey on this earth plane and who may be following spiritual guidance may in turn send forth the kind thoughts to such spirit loved ones who may be traveling in the dark. Their iniquities we can help to cover over with good deeds, and while we do this we cleanse our own conditions. Our forebears as well as those who may follow us and with whom we have earthly relationship especially share in the exchange of thoughts or messages much more so than those with whom we had no earthly ties. It is only after one tries to commune with its own and is not acknowledged that it will pass along to another, probably a stranger in earth life, but who will open the door and give a welcome.

All who would commune should do so for spiritual advantages and not for material gain. Every communication should be an improvement over any previous message, no matter in what form given. Whether the message is through prophet, artist, poet or composer, let us seek higher than materialistic levels. Then and only then can we continue and know how to carry on communion even after we ourselves are over the boundary.
