OD IS SPIRIT, God is Good, God is Love, and herefrom cometh all life and light. Where God, there truth; where truth, there harmony, and where harmony, there is an absence of anything evil. It is a slander against God to say He or any part of Him is evil.

One can readily understand God is not the creator of evil. The God-part within the man-made body is not evil, neither is it evil after it passes from the body at the time of so-called death. The source of spirit, good, love, life and truth is not and cannot be the source of evil, harm, sickness, distress and other forms of unrighteousness.

Spiritual knowledge is the power by which the un-Godly is overcome. Water and oil do not mix and good and evil cannot go together any more than spirit and material are one. Each is a condition unto itself and it becomes a grave error to mock God and the Godly as evil.

We speak of evil and of a devil, of Satan, of a false god or idol, and it all means the same. These are of conditions that are not spiritual. The Nazarene communed with God, Spirit to Spirit, and asks, Deliver Us From Evil. Here was one who knew the material could not reach God, and surely we cannot by any stretch of the imagination suspect that He would associate as "evil spirit" with the Supreme Spirit. Let us take example from Him.

Since there is no evil spirit, let us not speak of it. When we do not understand what we should know to be the truth, then do not speak vaguely. Each individual is responsible for his own actions and misgivings, and it does not require any great degree of light to realize that violation of truth and of things truthful exacts the price thereof.

There are evil and wayward conditions, and one who is careless and disinterested may become surrounded by its destructive influences. This condition, when it overcomes us, or its wicked effects are cast before us, brings forth the cry, "It is an evil spirit," when in reality it is our own material shortcomings and the result of our own iniquities. God does not visit these things upon us. We attract them by our own actions.

In GENESIS 6:5 we read, And God saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. This prophet of days gone by had no misunderstanding as to the source of evil. The Psalmist sang, I will fear no evil for thou art with me. Here again a prophet well knew that where God is there can be no evil. Paul in his letter to the EPHESIANS (Chapter 5:15-16) writes, See then that ye walk circumspectly, not as fools, but as wise, Redeeming the time, because the days

One possessed with the devil is as one with evil conditions in his own environment or very midst. The Nazarene implied in His words to cast out the evil with the good. It was not by killing a man that the evil was removed, yet, if it were an evil spirit, how else could it be removed except by ending its earthly journey in a man-made body?

WORSHIP

FOR AS I PASSED by and beheld your devotions, I found an altar with this inscription: "To the Unknown God. Whom therefore ye ignorantly worship, Him declare I unto you." Paul never minced words, so as he addressed the men of Athens from Mars hill, he fearlessly criticised their ignorant forms of worship. To him, idolatry, or worship of idols, showed the excessive veneration for the material thing. It is not difficult to agree with Paul, for the Supreme Force does not desire, nor require, the vain worship of man through idols.

Idol worship is rank superstition. It has traveled down the ages, impeding progress, warping minds and casting the shadows of fear to shut out the sunlight of love. What heartaches it has left in its wake. Its sorrows are legion and it thrives on despair. It was born in error and developes like some plants, in dark places. It is the wrong worship of the Father, the God of Love.

The magnificent temples that were erected in which to worship an unknown god are stumbling blocks in the way. The cunning hand of art has created the material structure and studded it with gold, silver and precious stones, so that it stands as a work of admiration, but again the cry goes forth, "Whom therefore ye ignorantly worship, Him declare I unto you." The Lord of Heaven and earth dwelleth not in temples made with hands, and the material structure that many venerate will crumble into dust with passing time. The wondrous beauty of the temple of Solomon is lost to posterity, but the spirit of Solomon lives on. If we do not realize that we are temples of God and the spirit of God dwelleth in us, we ignorantly worship an unknown god. No flesh shall glory in the presence of God and on the border-line of eternity the mighty works of man are as naught.

COSMIC KINSHIP

OME, let us reason together, was a wise and timely invitation; so we repeat it as an invitation to the human family, barring no race, creed or cult, but with the earnest intention of valuable discovery. Our interest for the moment centers in the triune being called man, the thinking,

active genus of the great Cosmic family of which there are so many specie; of which no two are alike but each bears a relationship to all others, thus uniting one degree of consciousness to all other degress of consciousness throughout the Universe, and is largely the reason for the scientists attaching such importance to the similarity of physical construction that has led to the adoption of the Darwinian theory, that man is the product of evolution through the various states of animal life to his present degree of consciousness.

The schools that adopt this hypothesis have been vigorously opposed by the fundamentalists and orthodox groups, for to them such teaching seemed profane and reversed the whole order of their belief in God and His plan of redemption for the sin burdened soul of man. Neither the scientist nor the fundamentalist realize that the physical body of man and beast is but a habitation for the Ego, the soul, and that animal as well as man is attached to the source of Being, not because it inhabits a body, but because it is related to all life through and by the Spirit, which is God, thus establishing kinship with the Cosmos, which is Universal.

Having established that fact, we are prepared to go a step further: in order to avoid misunderstanding, we must bear in mind that man is the most evolved specie that we know, but that in no way proves that in man God has completed His plan of developed consciousness nor that perfection has been reached without including the soul of man. No one will dispute me when I say: as yet man is far from fulfilling the requirements by his own standard of right and wrong, but according to fundamentalist reasoning, the soul must grope in the semi-darkness of delusion, with only the Bible and his conscience to guide him. What a libel on the intelligence of Divinity. It places a limitation upon God's power, simply because they are unable to define the real contact between the source of supply and the human family, and ignore the teachings of Jesus, while claiming to be followers of him. Jesus was a mystic of mystics, having unfolded under the teachings of the oldest mystic brotherhood of the Orient, and was in no way the ignorant carpenter that the present-day teachers claim him to be. He was a well-informed man, a Master in every sense of the word, and a leader in introducing innovations that shocked the people of his day as the Spiritualist shocks the Pharisee of today even as Jesus shocked those of his time.

However, Jesus taught the Oneness of the Father and himself, applying the same relationship to the human family. Now, if that be true, why do the ecclesiastics claim his leadership while denying the principles he taught? They deny them because the burden of their guilt rests with them, and not upon a human or divine sacrifice, and man wants to shift his responsibilities to an intercessor, rather than assume them himself. But the law remains the standard of justice, and despite man's unwillingness to consider himself responsible before the Holy Tribunal, he is subject to the Cosmic generative law and must experience soul growth as God has ordained; and in order to receive inspiration and, through inspiration, knowledge and direction, a direct line is established between the various planes

of earth, allowing for communication with higher intelligences. In this manner has the TRUTH been transmitted to the earth plane, and the old facts known to man thousands of years ago are becoming the property of the people of the twentieth century. It has been the privilege of the Spiritualists to be the exponents of the Truth and to bear the brunt of abuse that every revival of science, philosophy or religion met with from the Pharisees of their time.

But Spiritualists have stood up for the revival of intercommunication between the planes of spirit and those of earth, until they are recognized by the more progressive type of people, and only the really ignorant or the prejudiced remain to be convinced of the kinship of the various expressions of spirit life, and the close association of spirit with human beings. Having thus established the Cosmic Radio, God has enabled us to receive the result of purified thought from the great teachers of the spirit planes, exactly as we are entertained or enlightened by the radio that brings to our homes the exact reproduction of voice or music created in cities hundreds of miles away. To be sure, there are times when static interferes with a perfect transmission of sound, and so does Cosmic static interfere with the transmission of spirit voices, and confusion results. But just as certain programs are educational as well as entertaining, so are some spirit lessons educational and interesting as well. Then, there are the broadcast messages of the purely elemental type, which in some instances are rather misleading for the recipient, or any one who witnesses the demonstration; this has led to misunderstanding and brought communication of spirit into disrepute, because the instrument (medium) either lacked spiritu ality, or because they were ignorant of the Universal Law, and it is due to the elemental manifestations that intelligent persons have held aloof from the Spiritualist movement, and have at tributed the manifestations to magnetic action or any other natural power because they believed that if spirits really did communicate with man, they would at least bring to him Truth and a high standard of morality, whereas much of the phenomena was of a crude and repulsive nature. They do not realize that there is a real Cosmic Kinship and that these elementals are a by-product of the great Spirit in formative state of being, no better and no worse than the inhabitants of the physical plane of which we are resident. And that a good, clean-living person of earth may be an angel as compared with some of the spirits who manifest, for they find a person who vibrates to a slow, or elemental, vibration, which corresponds to the wave upon which they can broadcast their message, and immediately they send forth that communication which will, according to their understanding and ability of perception, be truth, but very often their measure of facts is as different to the actual experience as our own miscalculation of events or standards.

This being the case, an adept should be careful to create a rapid and fine wave upon which the higher teachers manifest, and hold to the abstract rather than become intent upon receiving word from some special individual spirit, for in that way has many an adept been deceived by impersonating entities, who, rather than miss an opportunity to deliver their message, will claim to be the one for whom the sensitive has asked. This has led to much confusion and misunderstanding among Spiritualists as well as orthodox and fundamentalist groups who have sought to discover the truth, and who have become disgusted by the crude demonstrations and expressions purporting to come from spirit friends and educators, for, not knowing that elementals are residents of the lower planes, and fearing—they know not what—they discontinue their experiments with mediums and the Spiritualist movement. Still, if they conscientiously reviewed the conditions of orthodox movements, they must in

all honesty admit that the spirituality is lacking with them in a still greater degree than among the much criticised Spiritualists. I offer no apology for our mistakes; their name is legion; but I do say that our mistakes are no worse than those of other denominations, while we do and can bring comfort to the disconsolate, the bereaved, those who are outside the social pale—those despised and forgotten by all but God and us, and we can encourage a fresh start upon the highest and best authority. Thus we prove our Cosmic Kinship despite social regulations, and the ultimate redemption of the soul through its contact with Cosmic Consciousness, whether it speaks as the individual, or blends with the Universal.

THE FLOWERS

LORD, how manifold are thy works, in wisdom hast thou made them all: the earth is full of thy riches. Psalm 104.24.

The velvet covering of moss that transforms the woodland dell into a wonderland of beauty speaks in its own way of the omnipotence of the Supreme Force, God, as do the richly colored blossoms bursting forth from tiny buds. Mosses, ferns and lichens belong to plants that cannot boast an array of blossoms, yet they are singular in appearance and worthy of our notice, if only as a contrast to the flowering plants so familiar to us. The Creator has diversified the manner of growth of these flowerless plants, as he provides their reproduction from very simple and minute bodies known as spores,

instead of evolving growth from seed.

Flowers spring from flower buds in the same way that branches grow out from leaf buds. Now the places for buds are in the axils of the leaves and at the end of the stem. The axils of the leaves are marked by the hollow or angle on the upper side where the leaves are attached to the stem. The first bud to appear makes the main stem, and its continued growth week after week or year after year carries on the main stem. It is called the terminal bud, as its place is fixed at the end of the stem. The other buds that are to form branches appear on the sides of the stem. The bud arrangement, whether alternate or opposite, determines the peculiar placement of the branches. It is interesting to notice this in the winter time, when the leaves have fallen and the bare branches stand out prominently to view. Each fallen leaf has left a scar to mark

stalk separated from the stem and above the scars there are the buds ready to grow into branches in the spring. As there is

not room for all, only the stronger buds grow.

So as we approach the winter time of life and memory again reviews th: happenings along the lift's journey, the scars left by our shortcomings loom up menacingly to confront and remind us of the misdeeds of our years of youth and strength. These spots have been impressed on the spit to self and can be eradicated by the individual willingly working out his own atonement and gradually washing away the stain of guilt. This can be done in part here, as well as hereafter. If we only realized the difficult task that awaits us on our passing over, when with clearer comprehension we endeavor to make right every wrong deed, we would reach out while we are still here to acquire the light of understanding and wisdom, so as to purge ourselves and begin making amends for our transgressions. For this task is easier of accomplishment by one in body than by a disrobed spirit, who on reaching the far off shore stands there in confusion and bewilderment and knows not which way to

As the leaf buds develop into branches, so the inspirations we receive from time to time in the form of uplifting thoughts

might, if we held them for serious consideration, work out into deeds of worthiness or helpfulness to other weary pilgrims, who, lacking much of this world's goods, need the human touch of sympathetic aid to brighten their outlook on life.

As the flower buds burst forth into wondrous blossoms, wafting their sweet perfumes for all to enjoy, so the spirit, cognizant of the Creator's purpose in sending it forth, reaches out and takes on all the attributes of Godliness, thus radiating influences far reaching in their power for good and upliftment.

The duration of plants of different kinds varies greatly. With some the length of existence on this earth plane may stretch out to a thousand years, while with others a few weeks

or months may be the limit.

So it is with the allotment of time required by us in our travel here. Some individuals complete the span of life in a short time, while others totter along into infirm old age. The time of one's passing out marking the end of a short or long life as we reckon it, should be of small consequence, so long as the mission that the individual has set out to accomplish has been fulfilled. Unfortunately, if the objective has not been attained, it might be necessary for the spirit to again enter a body for another travel here to do what it had previously left undone.

We thank the brother for his interest. Our answers, briefly, are: (A) Moses knew of the truth of spirit communication and condemned its violations only. He was opposed to any witch, enchanter, charmer, wizard or necromancer who bound over one out of body to do the bidding of one in body for material purposes. Seek ye first the Kingdom of God, should be the motto of all who seek spiritual enlightenment. Any one who will call to the spirit loved ones to make a dollar grow into a hundred, or to tell them what business to get into, or what race horse to play, or to tell them who stole their belongings, or to bring iniquities upon another, or torment or unrest, and other "Black art," should be anathematized or avoided. Woe unto him who does mockery unto the gifts of God.

There are very very many today who call to the saints, to Jesus, Joseph and Mary for material instead of spiritual upliftment. Much rather communicate with the Father direct, and with that power given one, be true for righteousness sake.

(B) The feverish excitement prevails only where the LIGHT has not fully entered in. It is as a stage setting, and useless, and we are unalterably opposed to any one who will not conduct meetings in an orderly, simple and strictly spiritual manner. Every form of worship has its rituals, chants, bowing and bending of knees, formations and regalia, and it, with the burning of incense and display of images along the lines of the pagan and mysterious, is unnecessary. Communication with the Father does not require it, neither time nor place, so we stand steadfast for simplicity. Death is death and life is life. Let the living advance and progress in the spirit realms and do nothing to call them from their onward journey unless it is for the mutual upliftment of both communicants. Ask them not to do anything (possible or impossible) that you would not be willing to have asked of yourself, is a good guide and rule to go by.
